FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

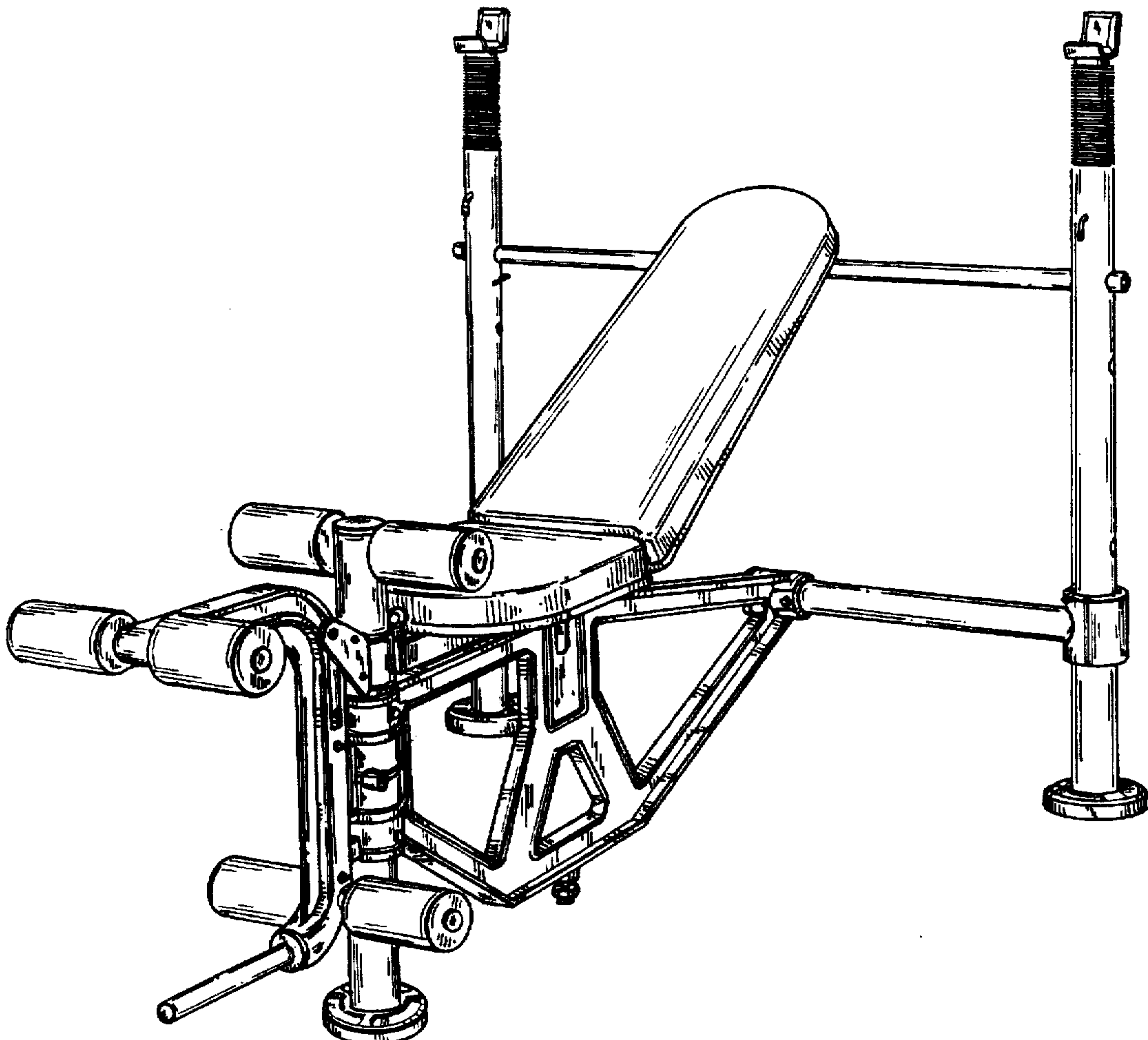
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

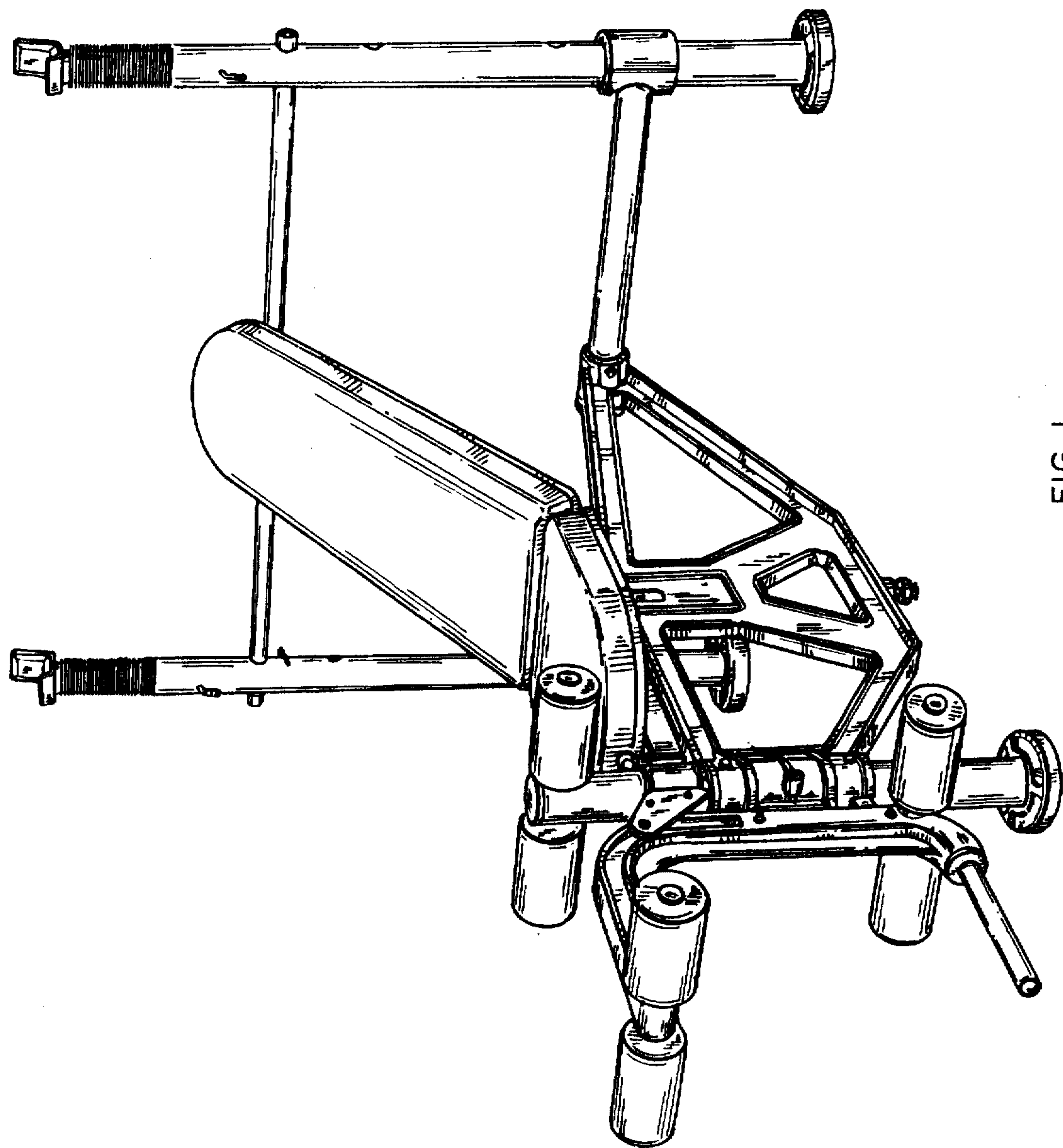

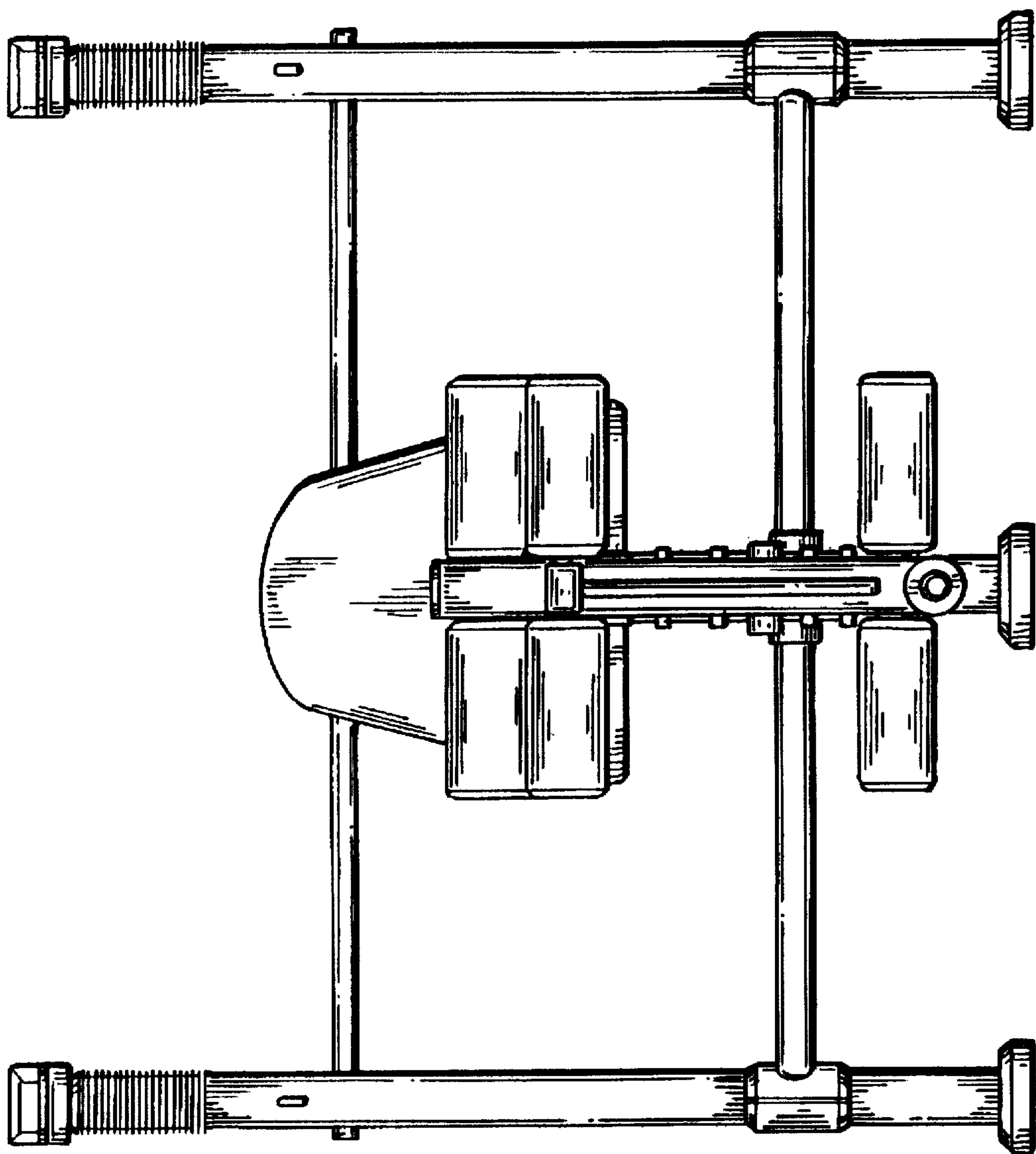

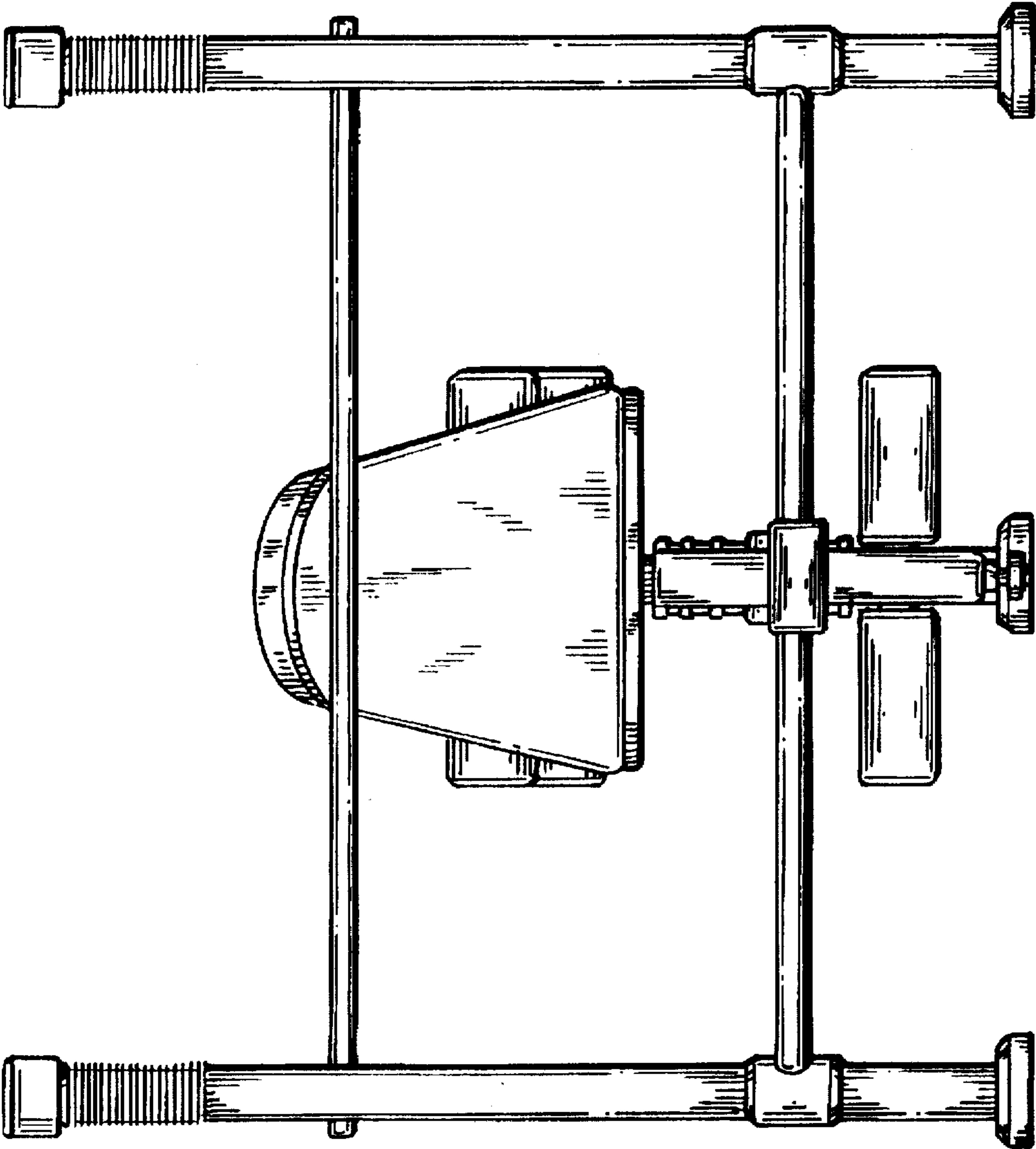

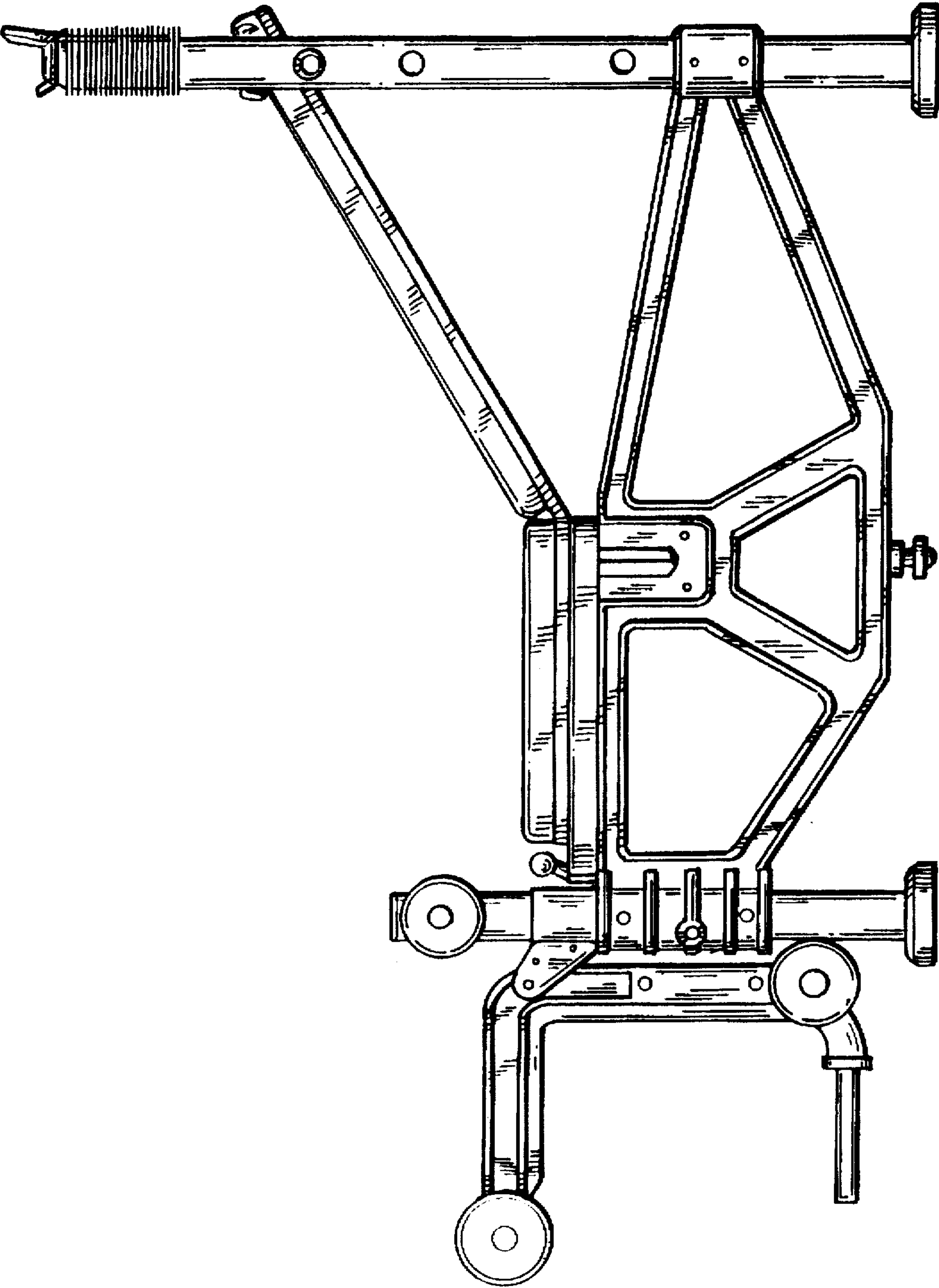

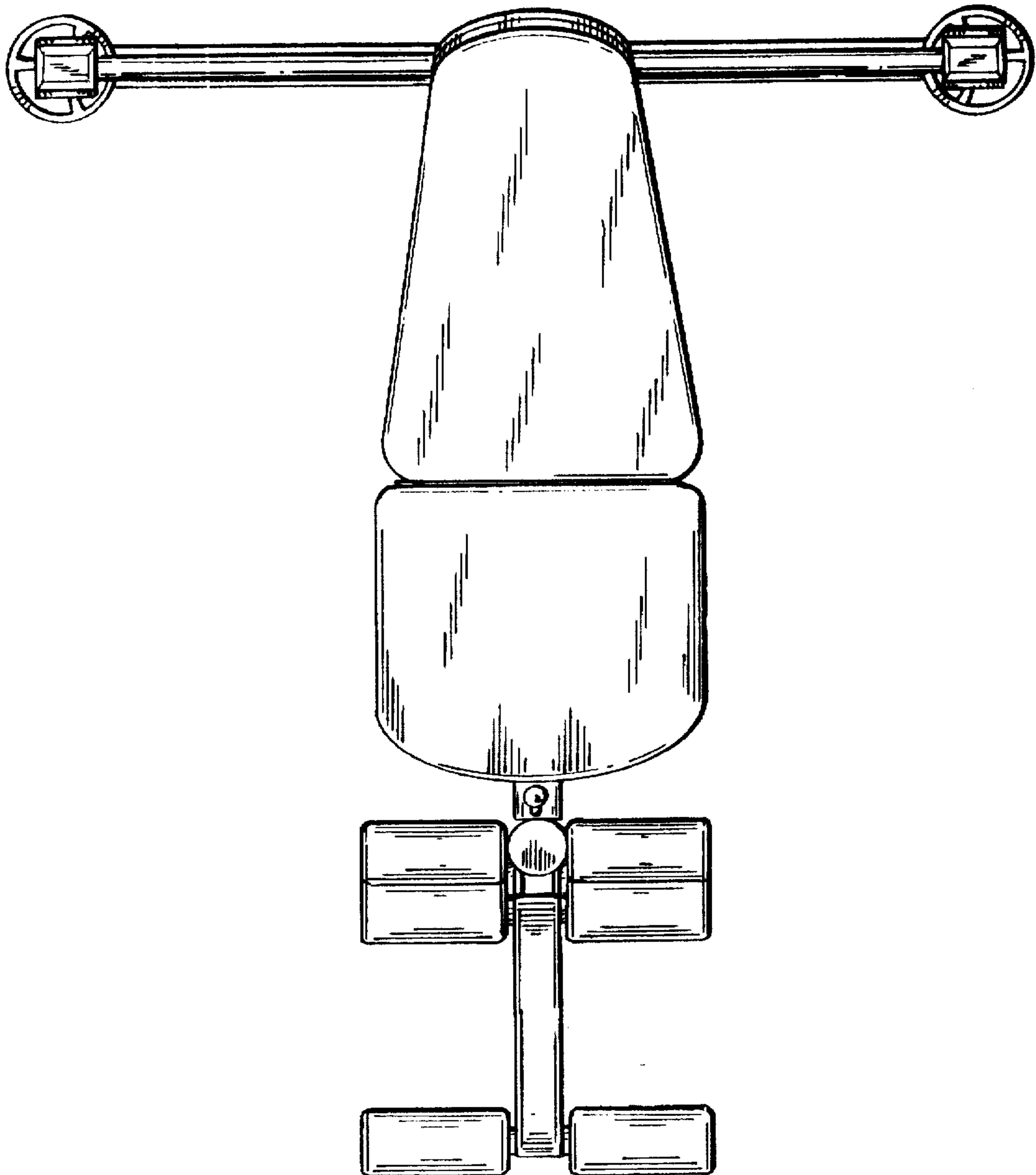

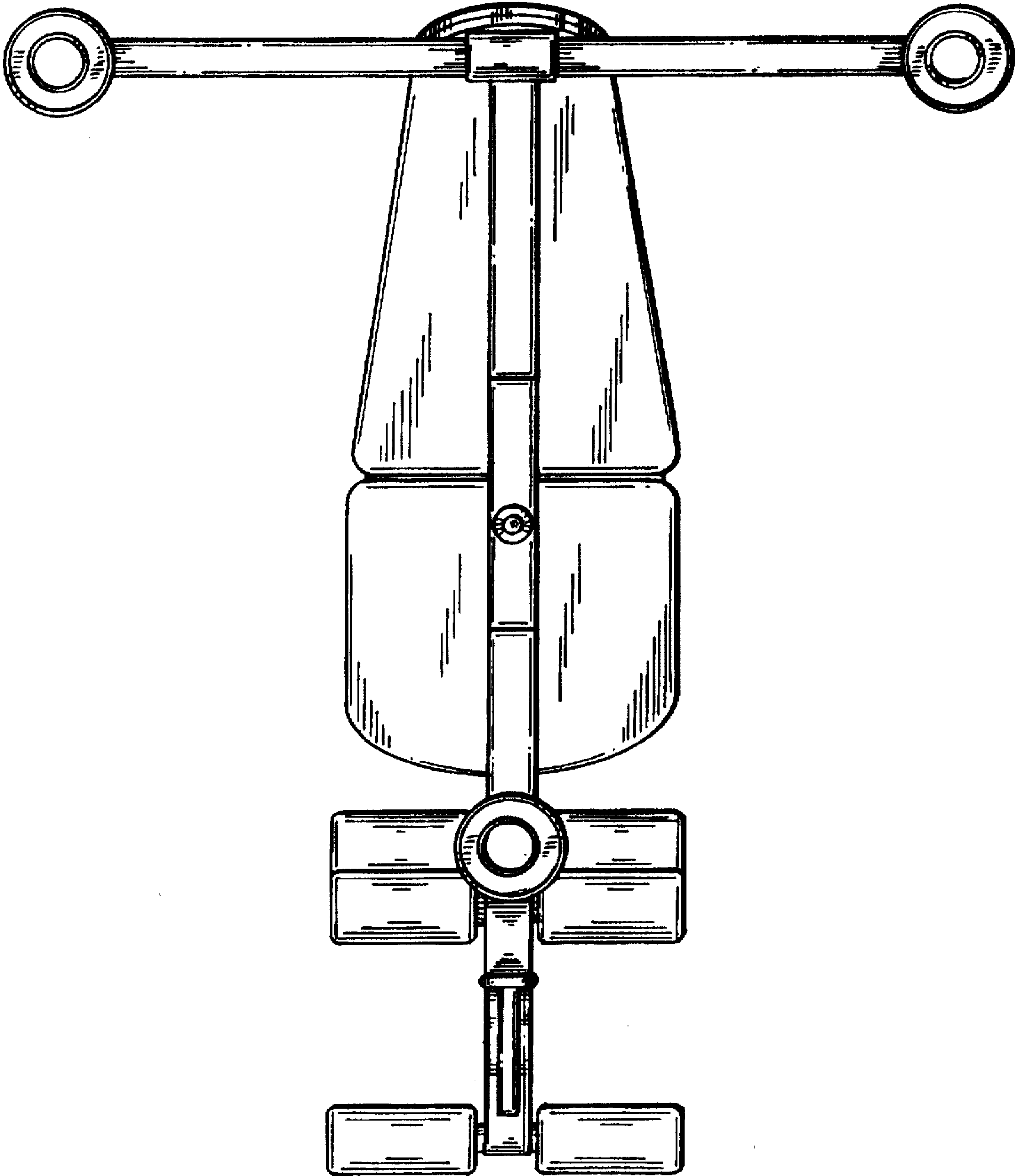
