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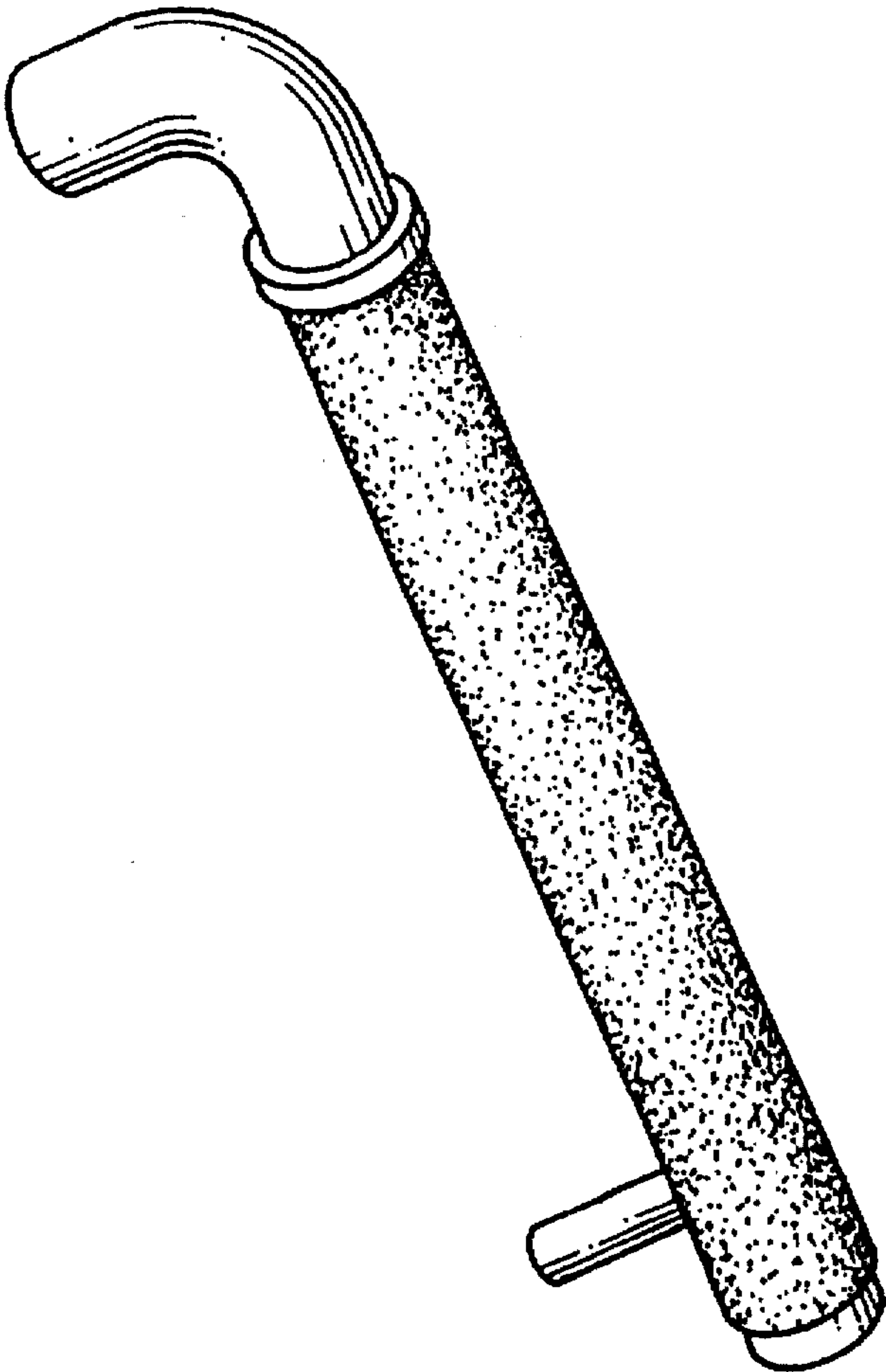

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side perspective view of a cane door pull
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the undis-
closed left side elevational view being a mirror image
thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

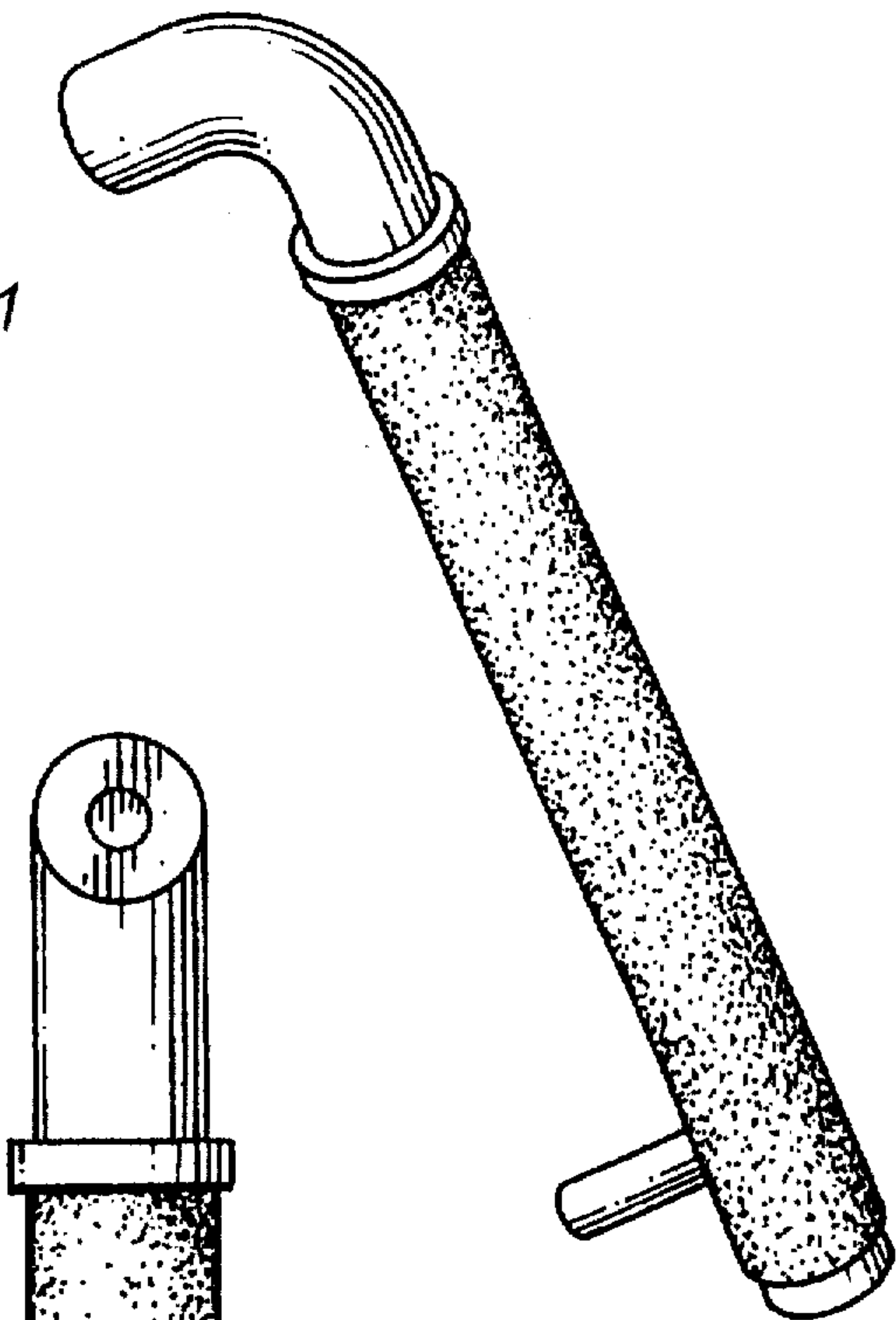

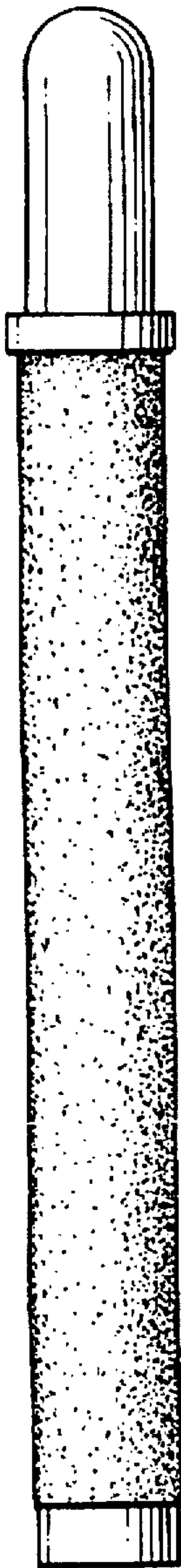

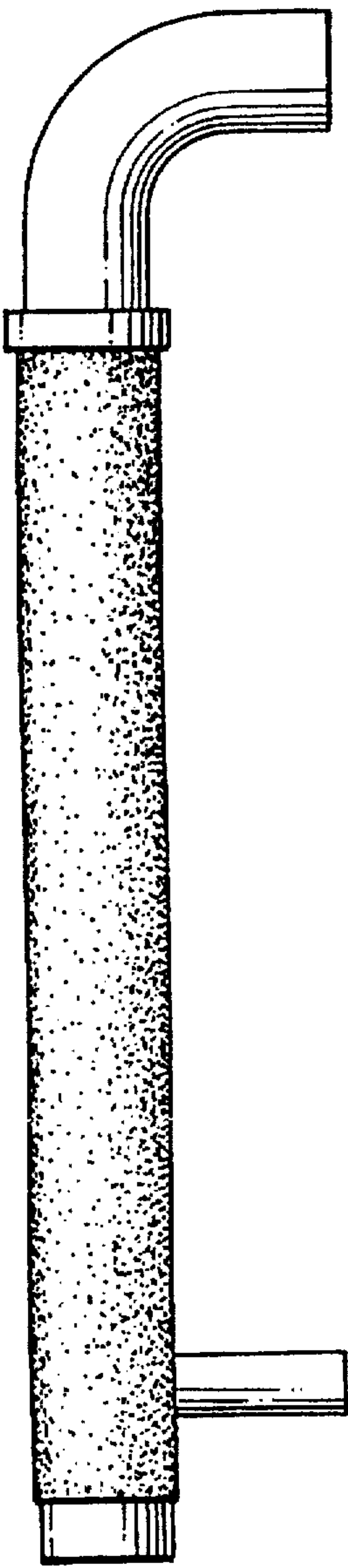

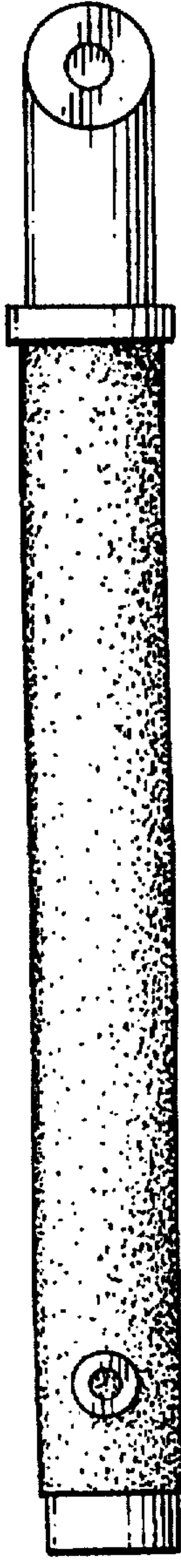

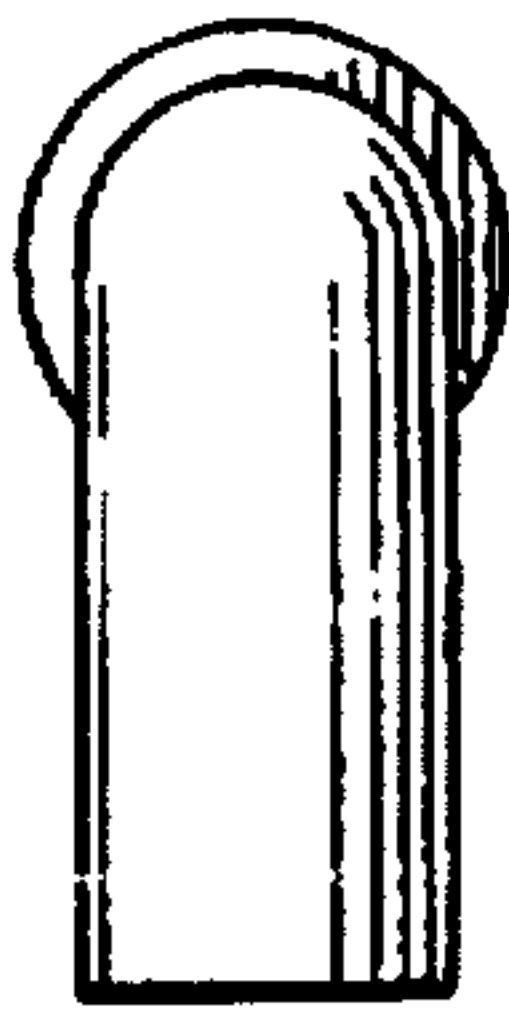

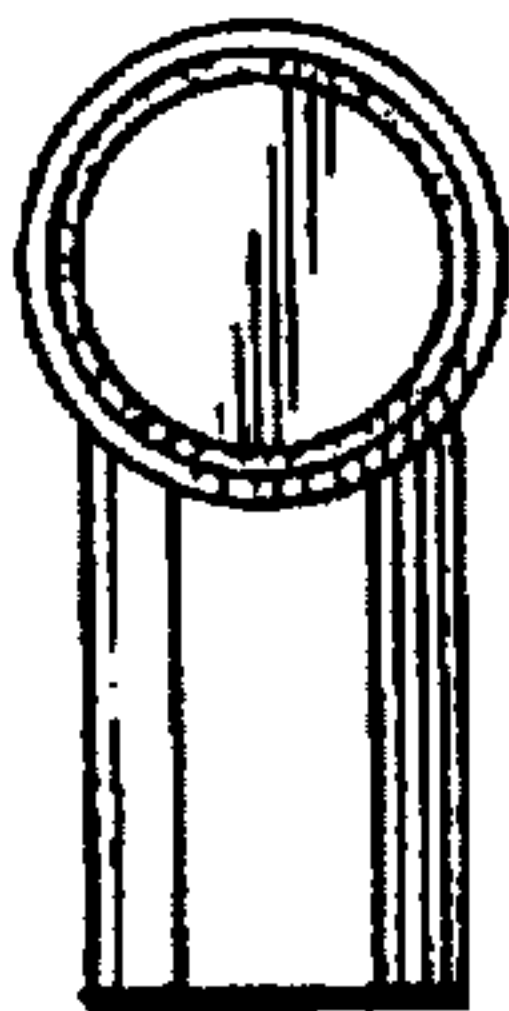
