[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a top surface of a wipe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The single FIGURE is a top plan view of a top surface of a wipe showing our new design. A unit of repeat is shown within the broken lines.

The broken away portions on each of the four sides of the wipe indicate that the design has indeterminate length and width.
