**DESCRIPTION**

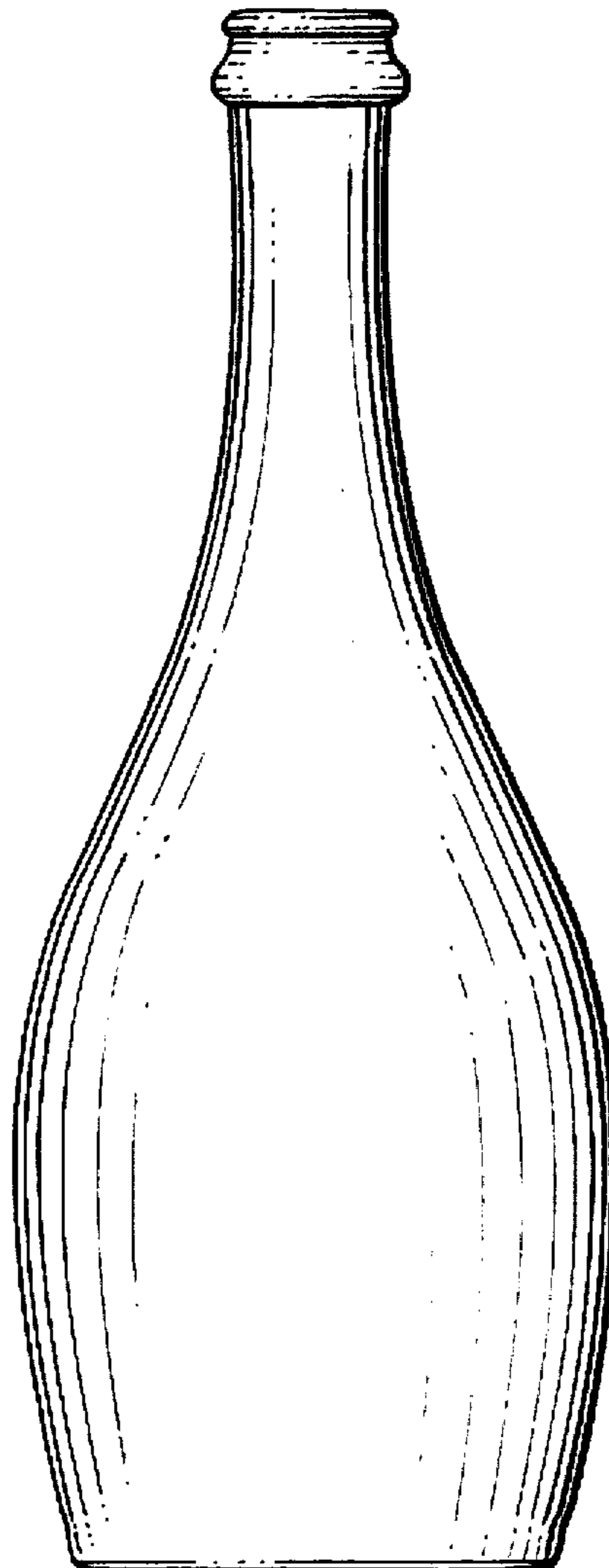
FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a bottle showing my new  
design, the rear elevation is the same;

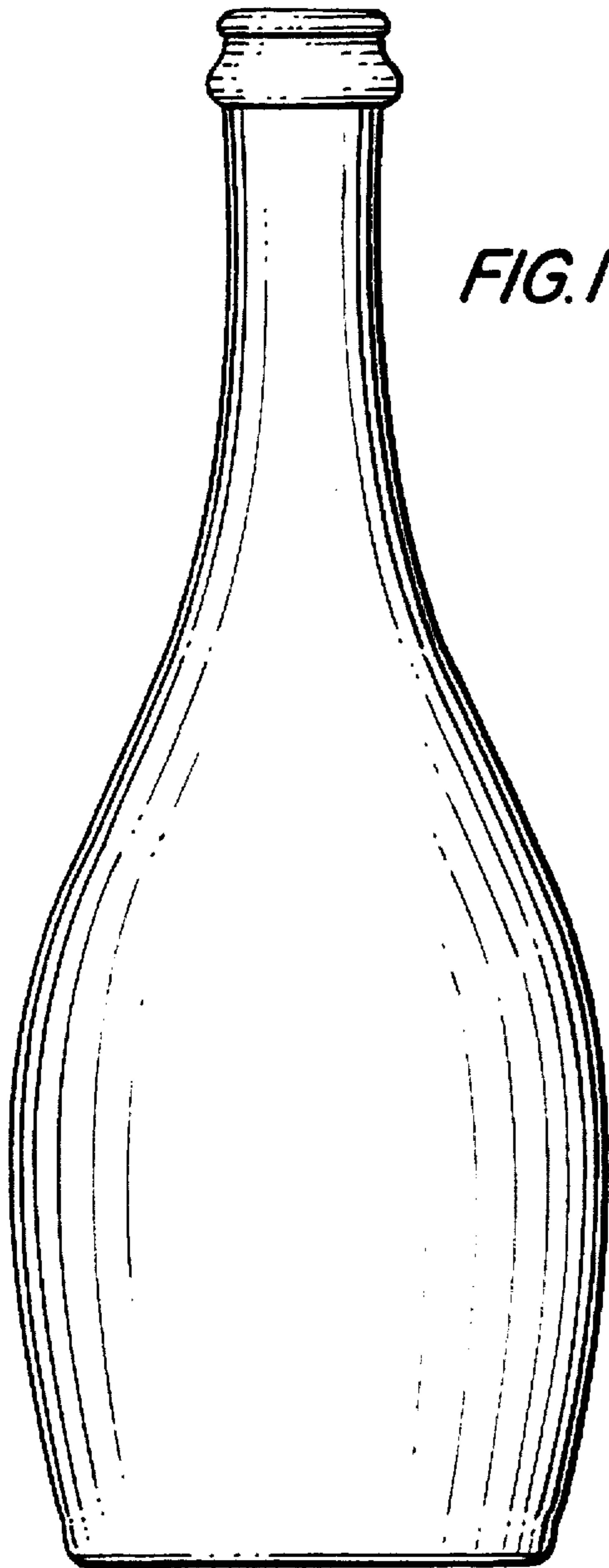
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof, the opposite side elevation

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and,

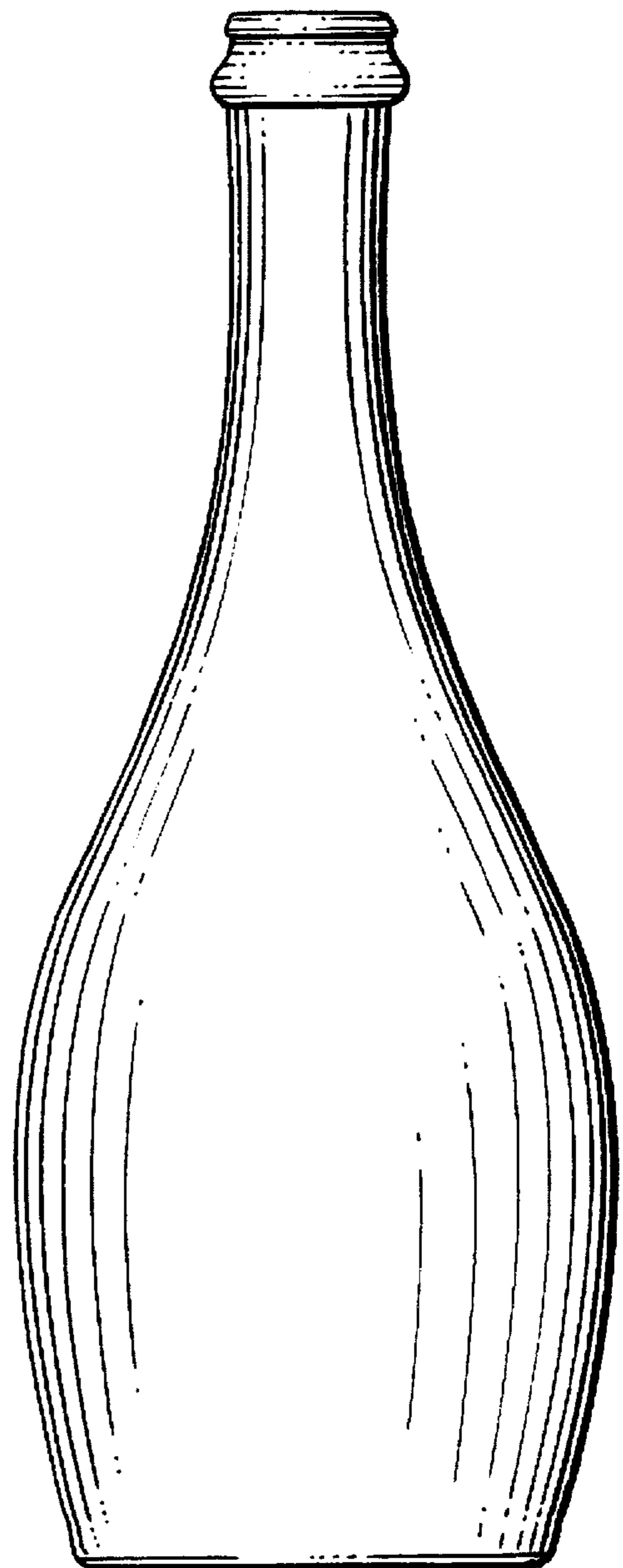
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of FIG. 1.

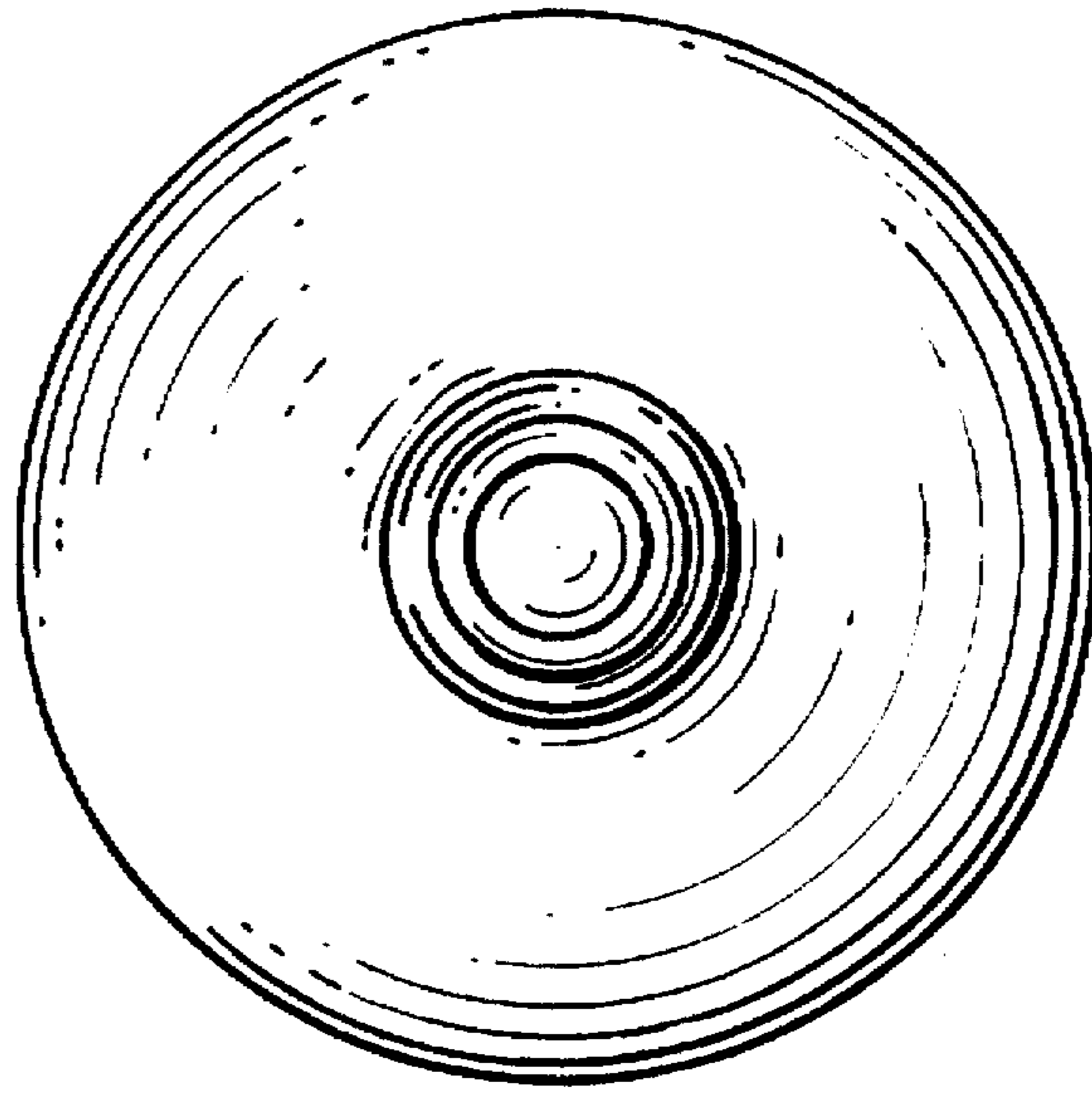
