FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of the truck cab sleeper assembly with the nested roof fairing illustrating the movable roof deflector portion thereof in an opened position;

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a side elevation view of one side thereof, the other side being a mirror-image of the one side;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a side elevation view thereof of an alternate embodiment of the truck cab sleeper assembly with a nested roof fairing having rear side-panel extensions;

FIG. 14 is a side elevation view thereof of the side opposite to FIG. 13;

FIG. 15 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 17 is a rear elevation view thereof.

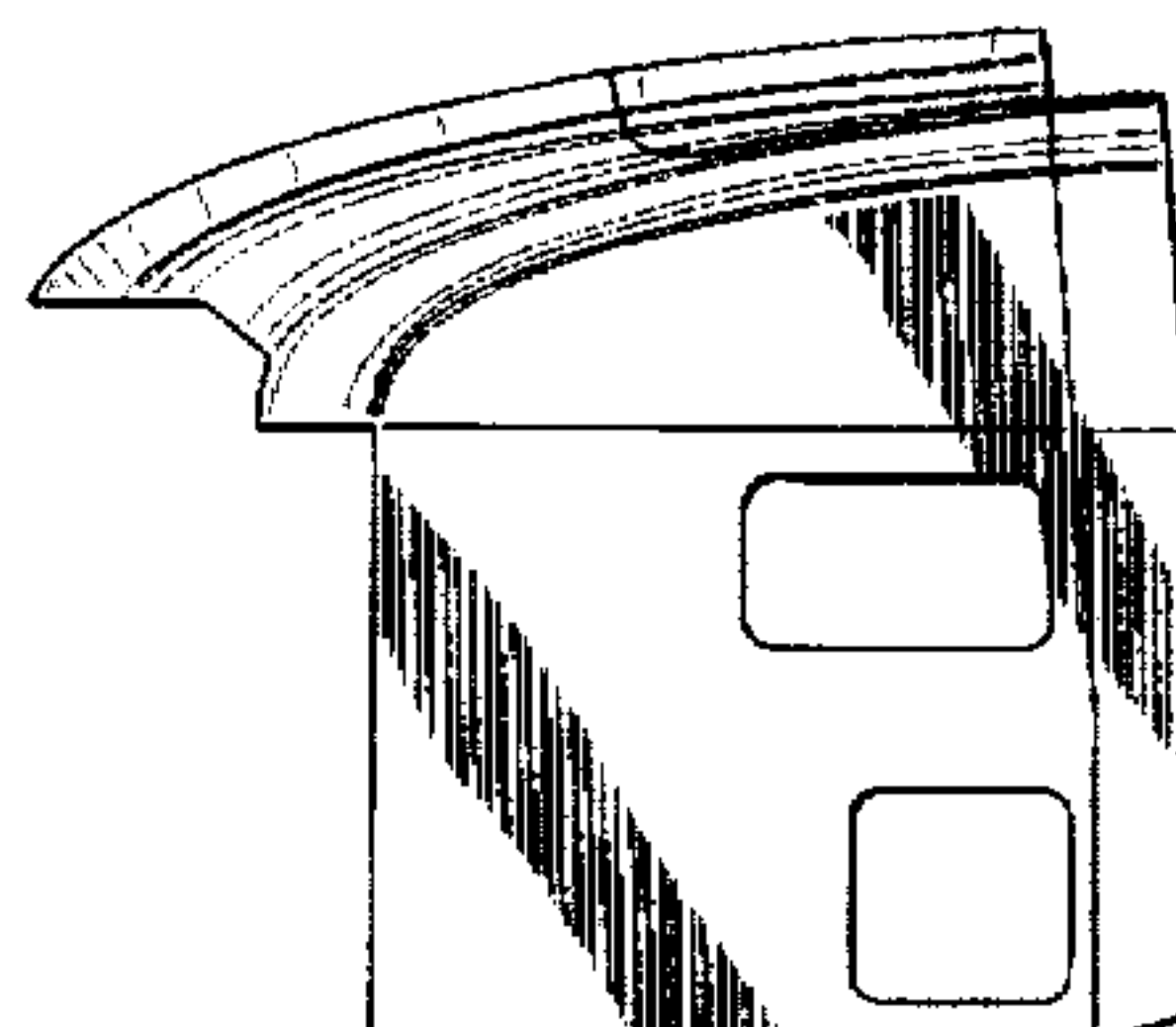
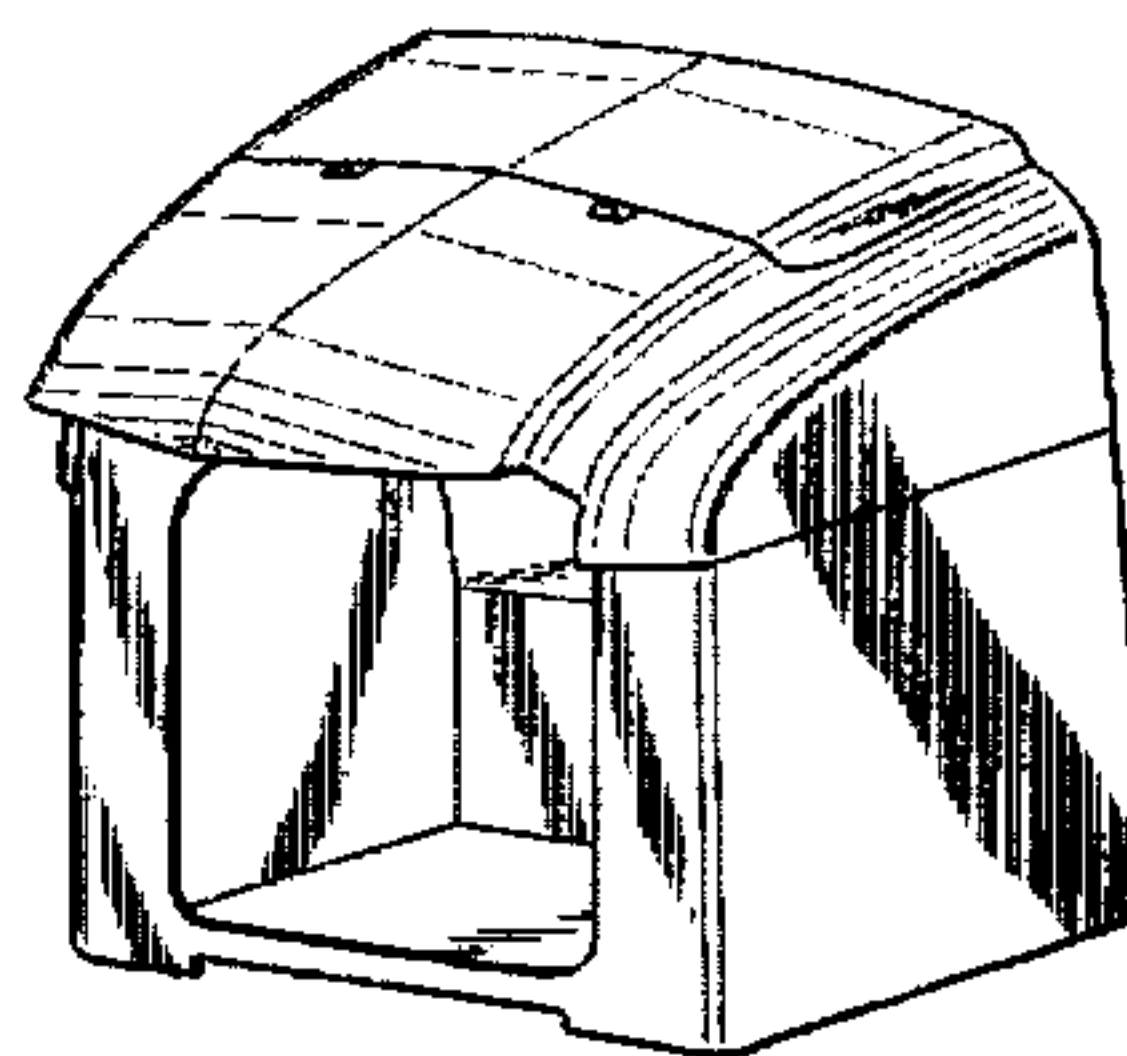

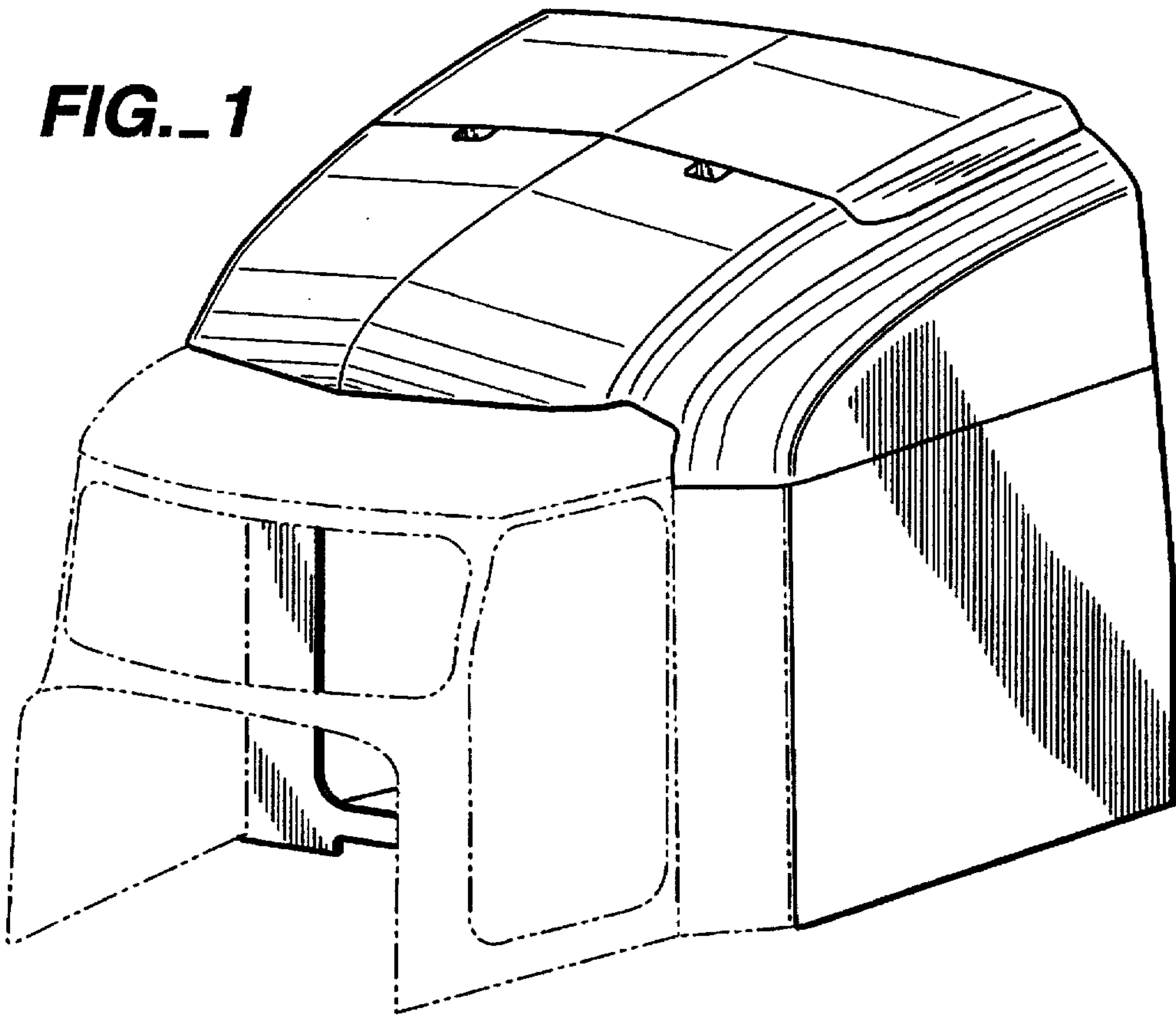
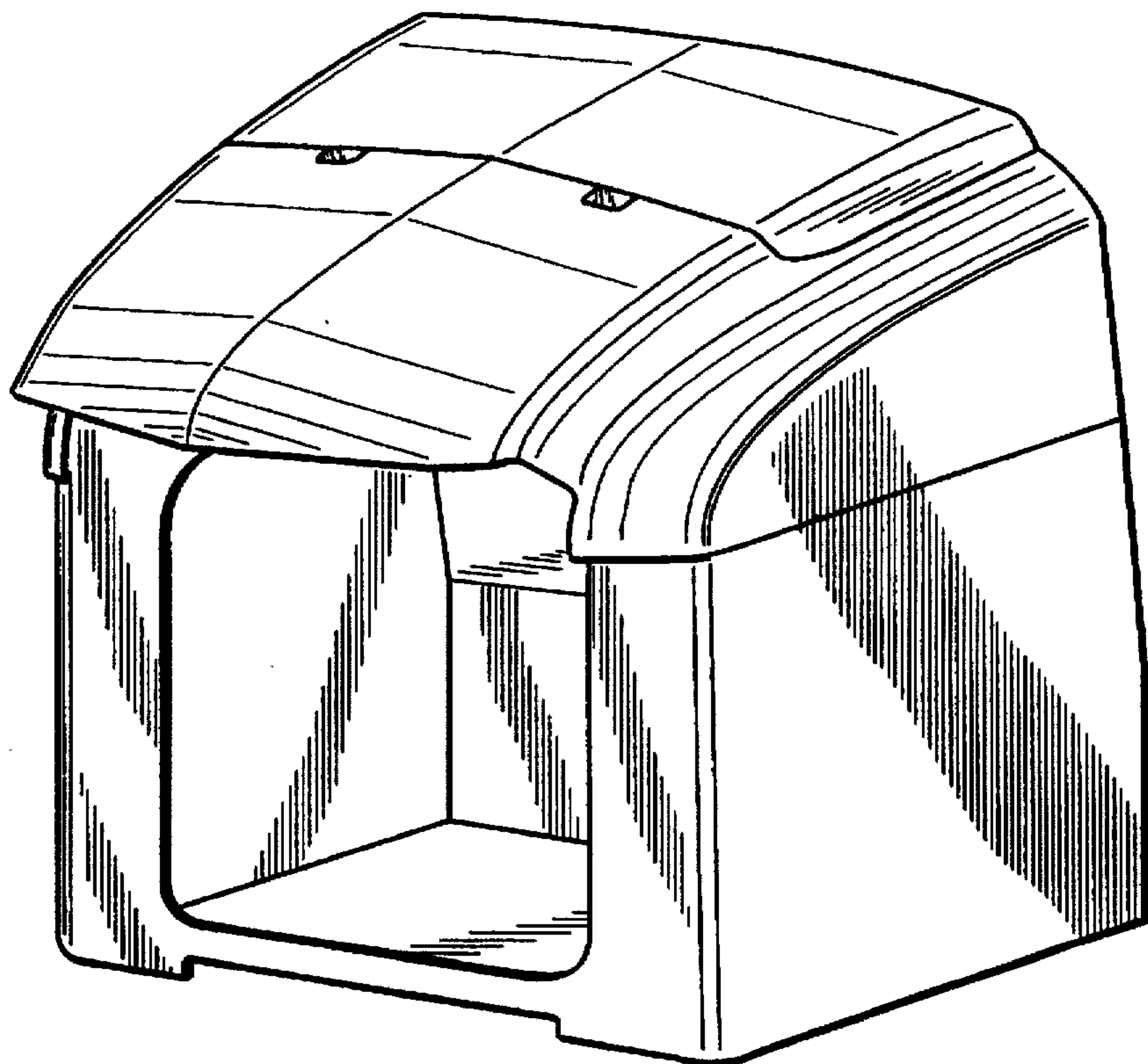

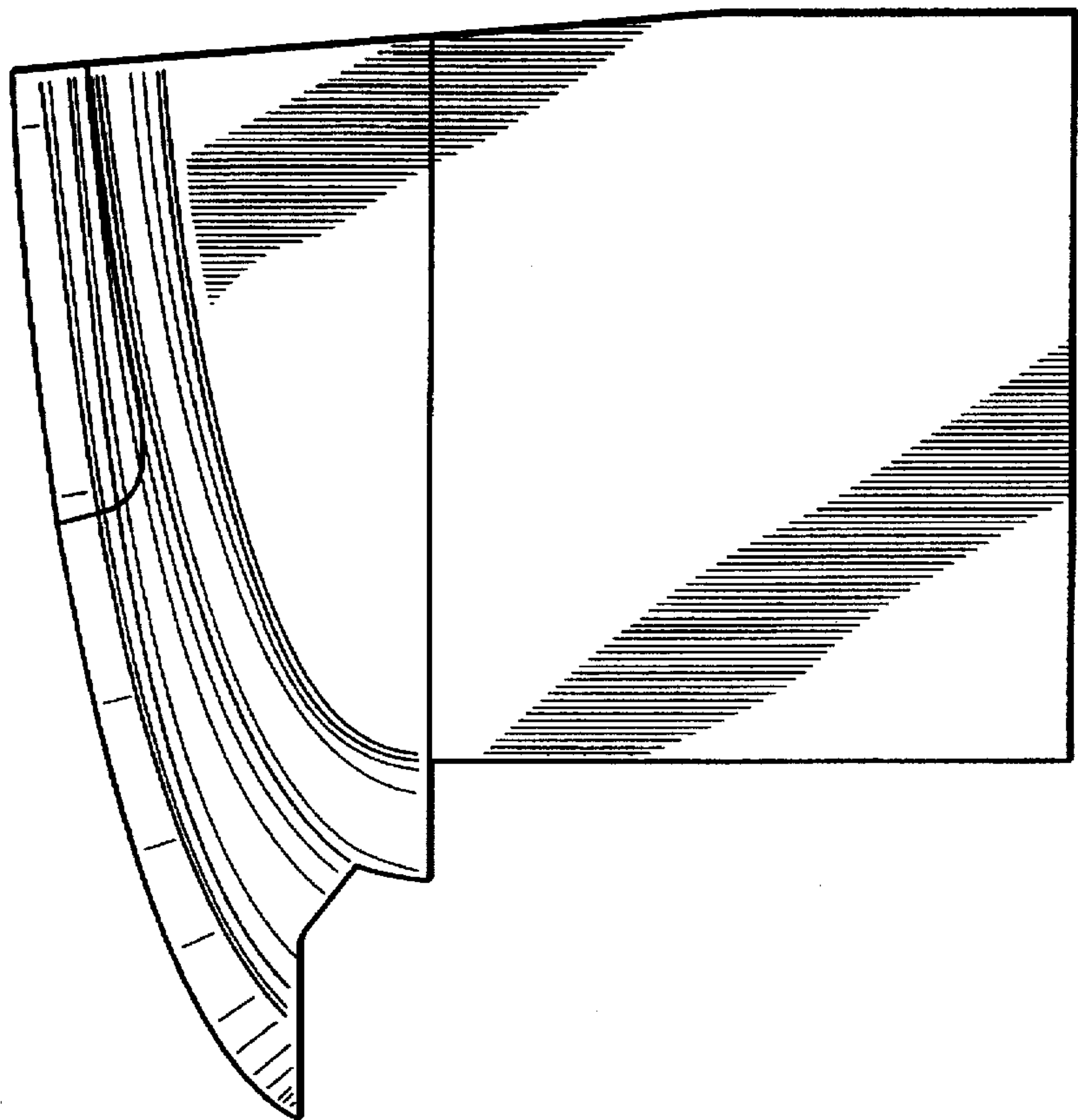

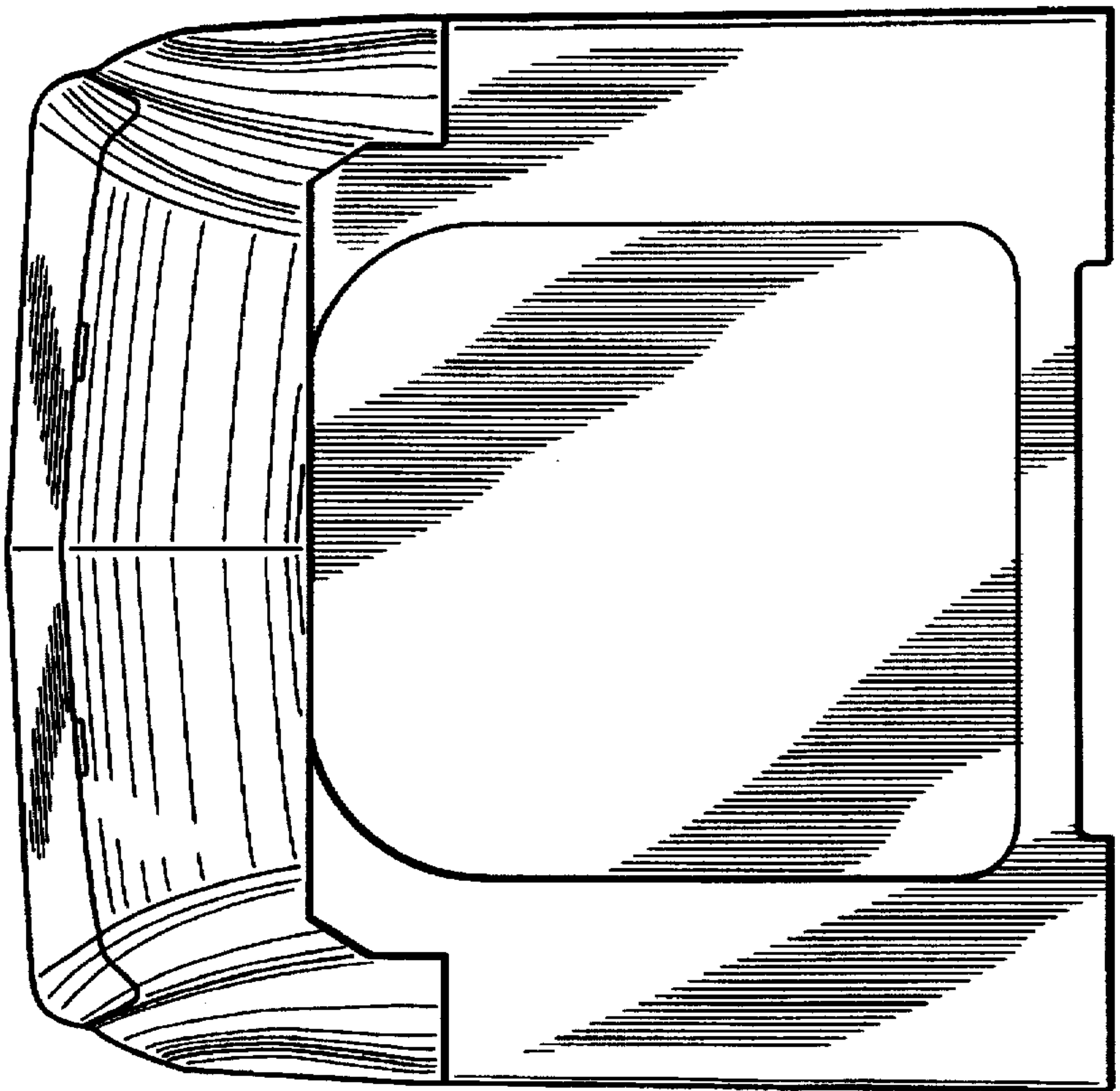

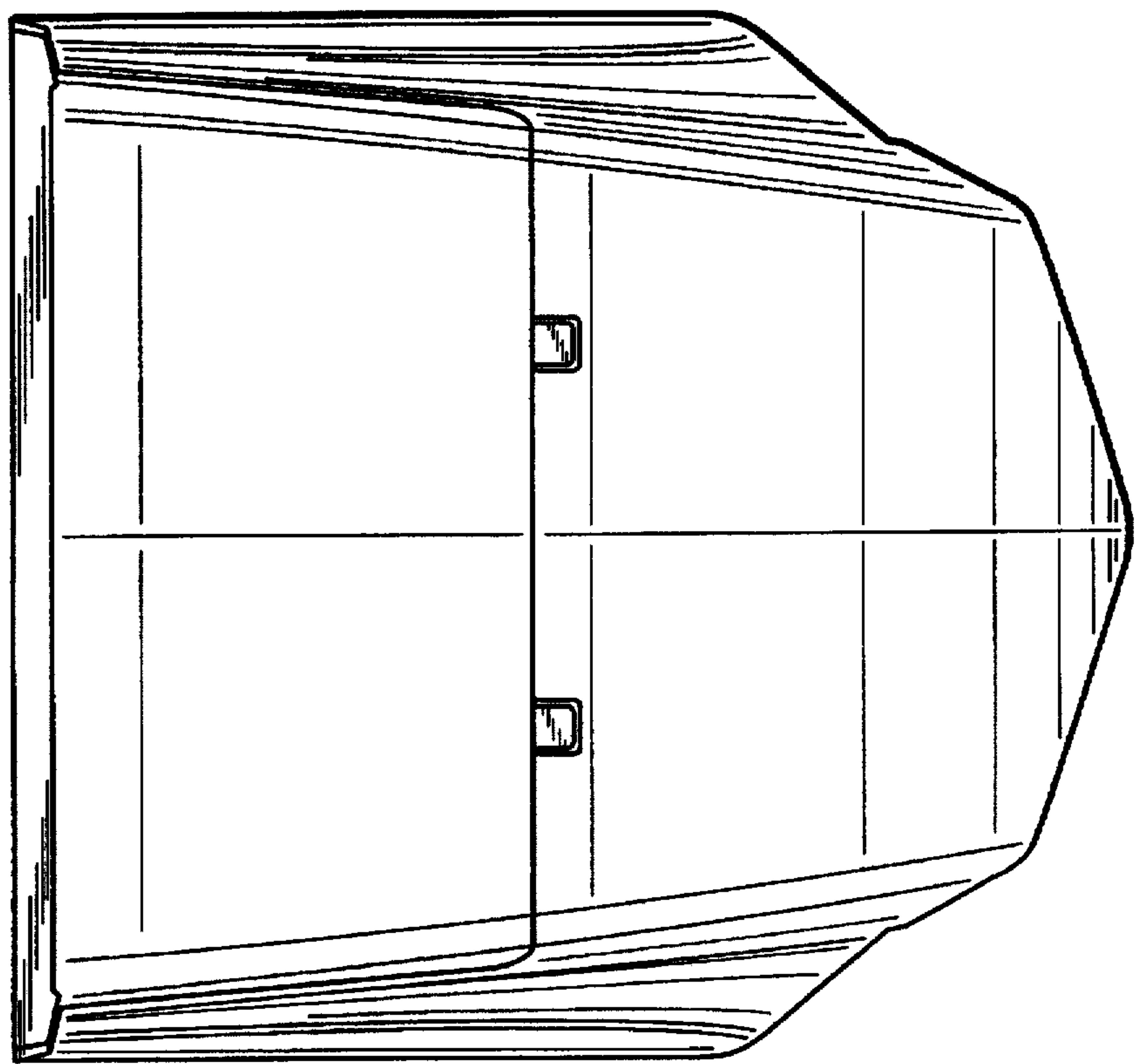

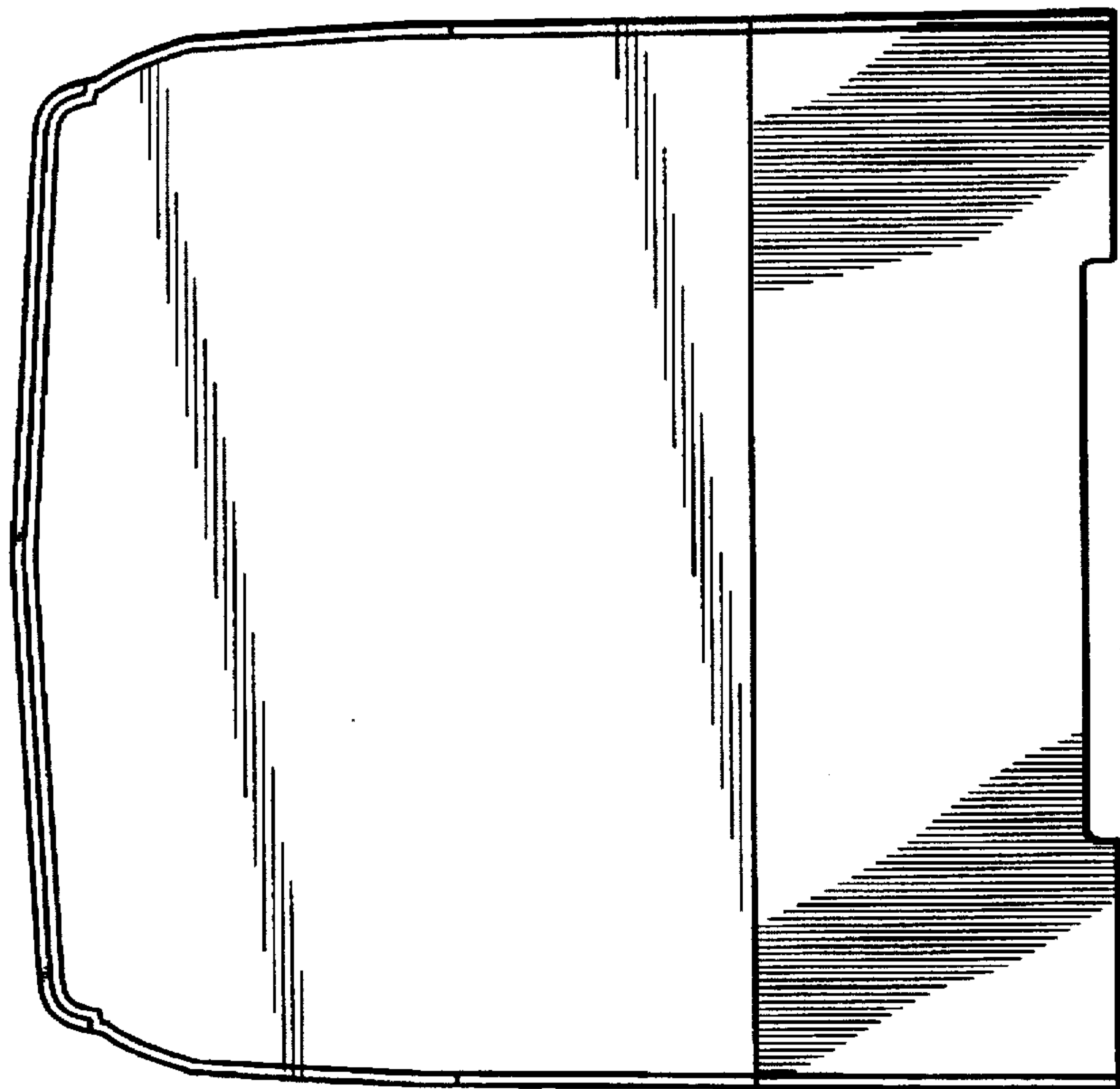

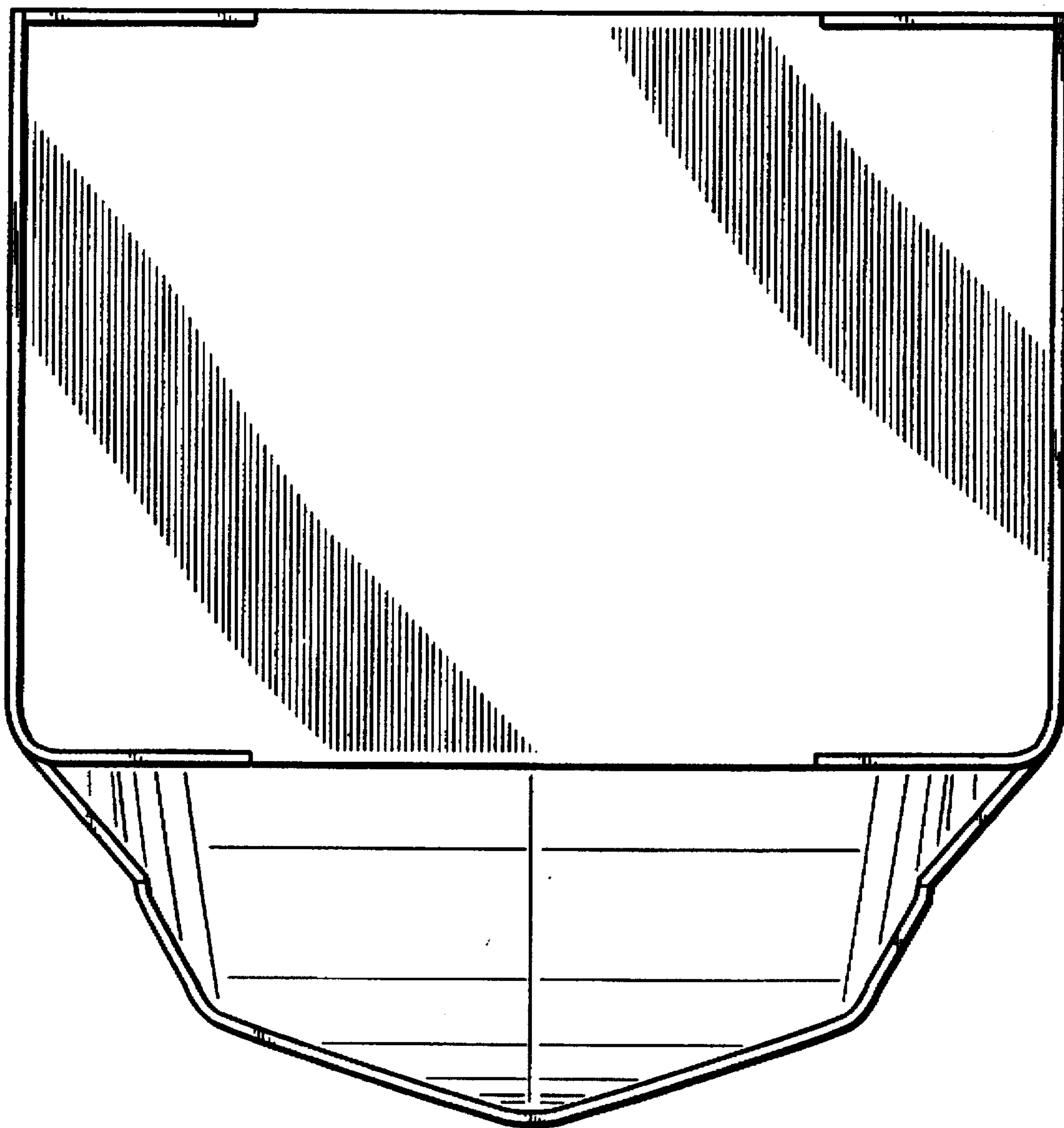
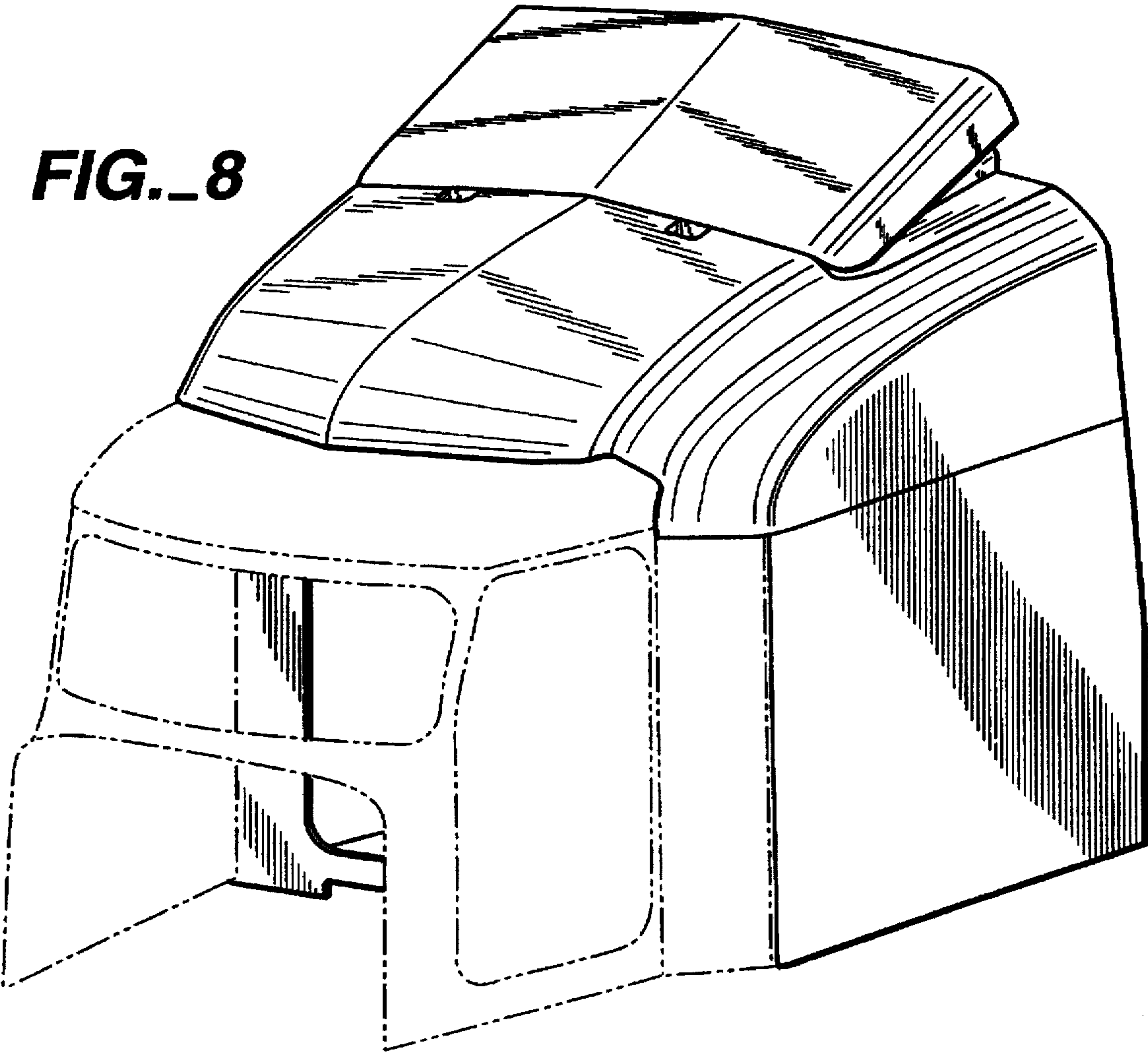

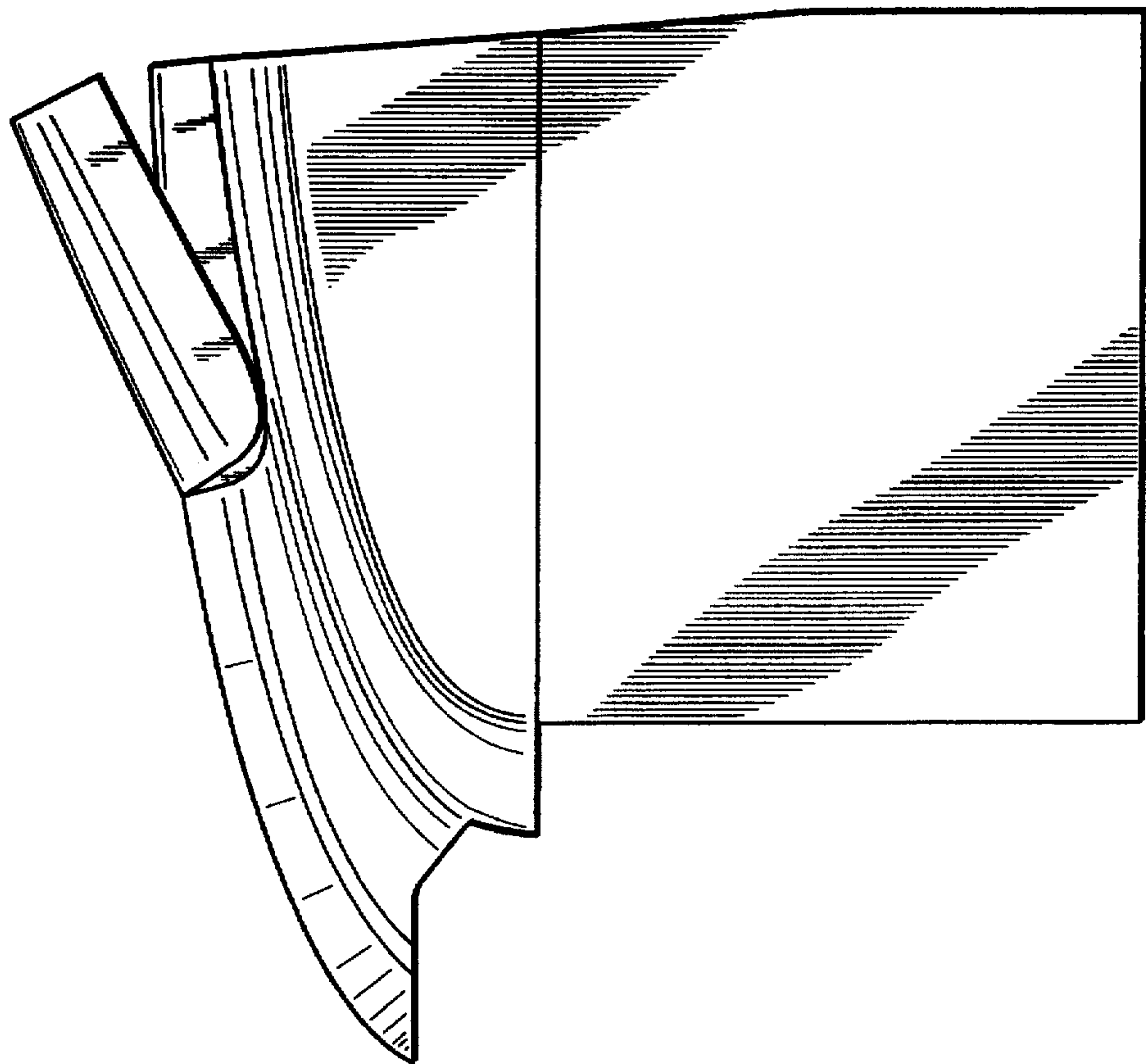

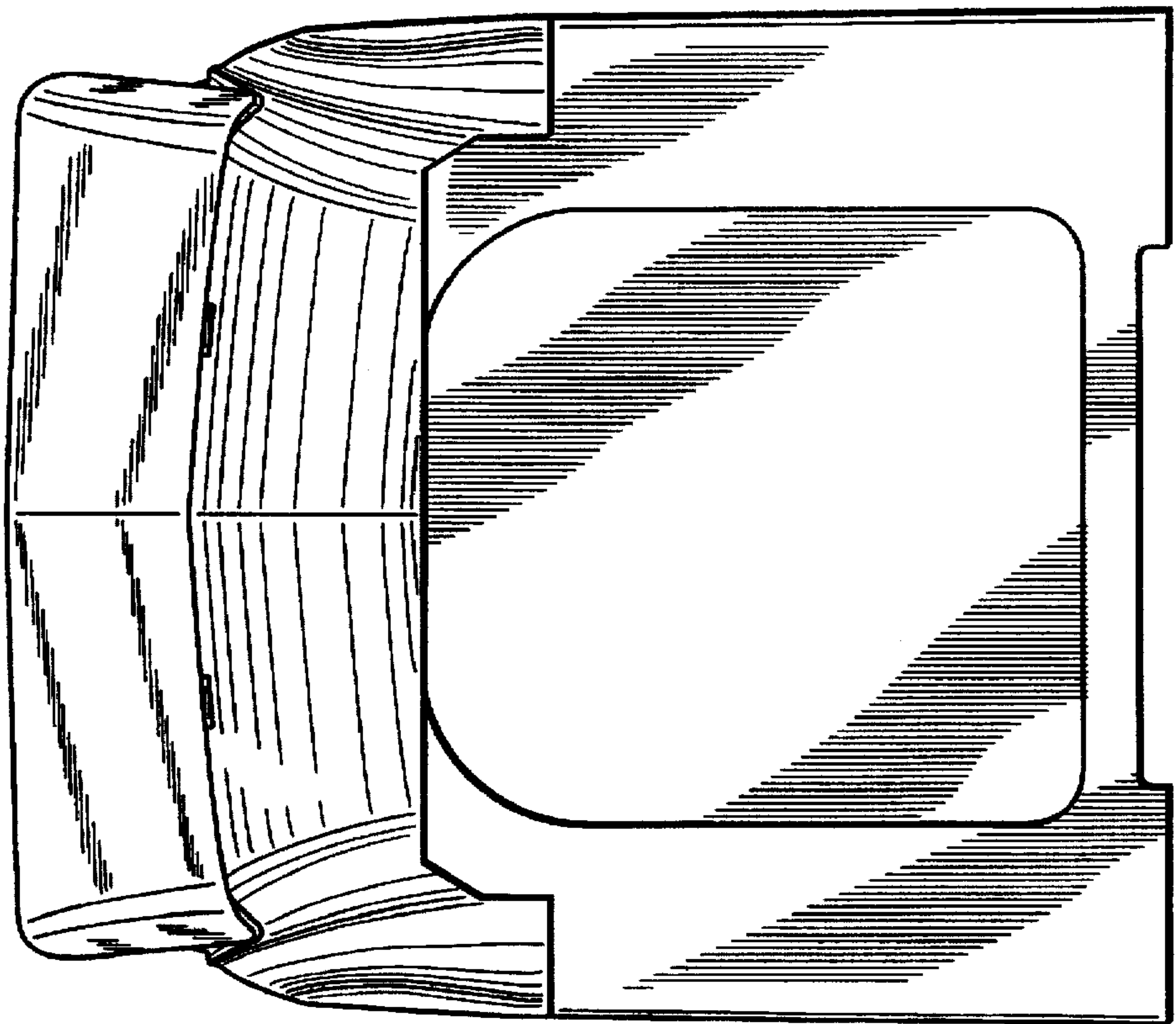

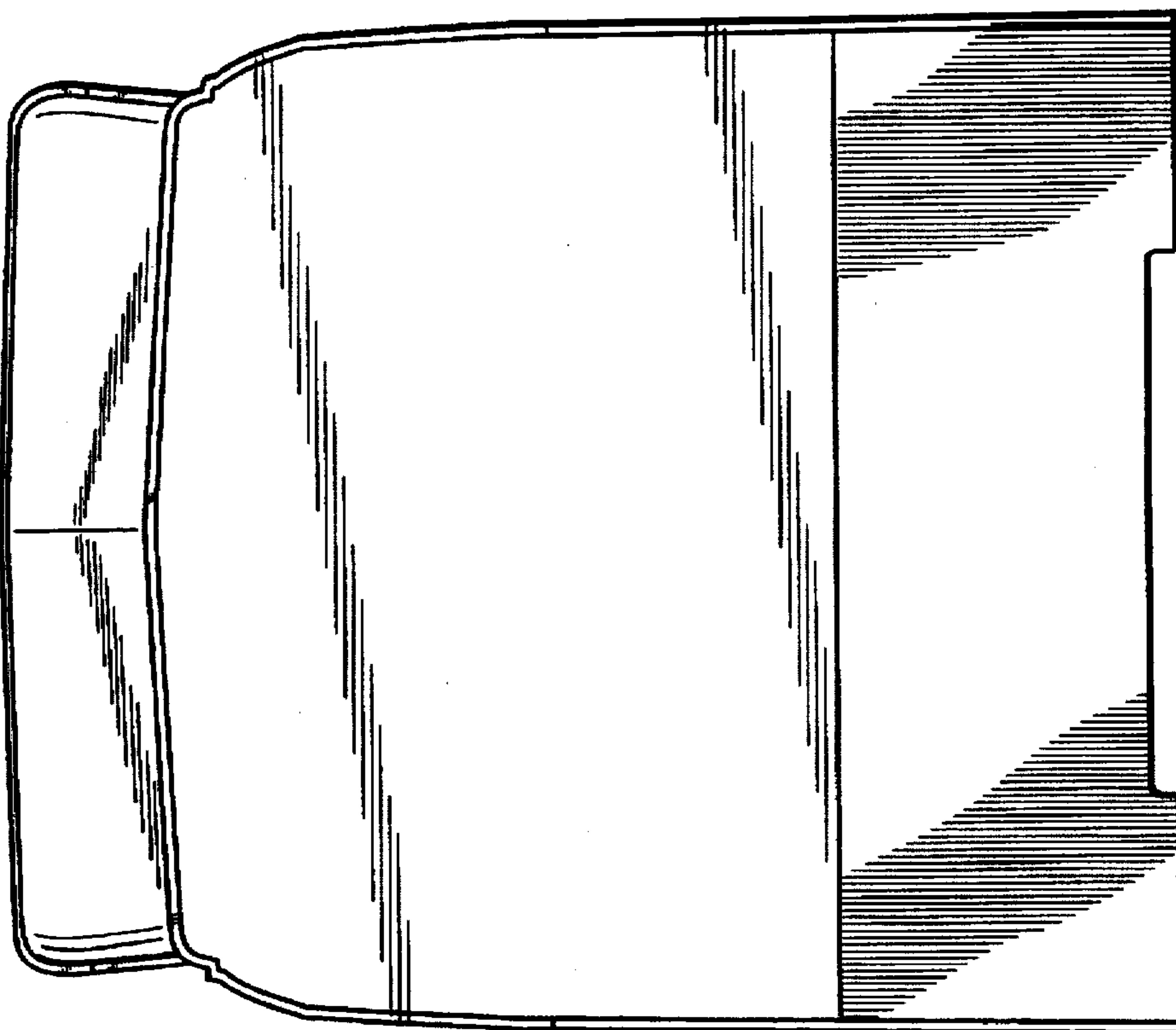

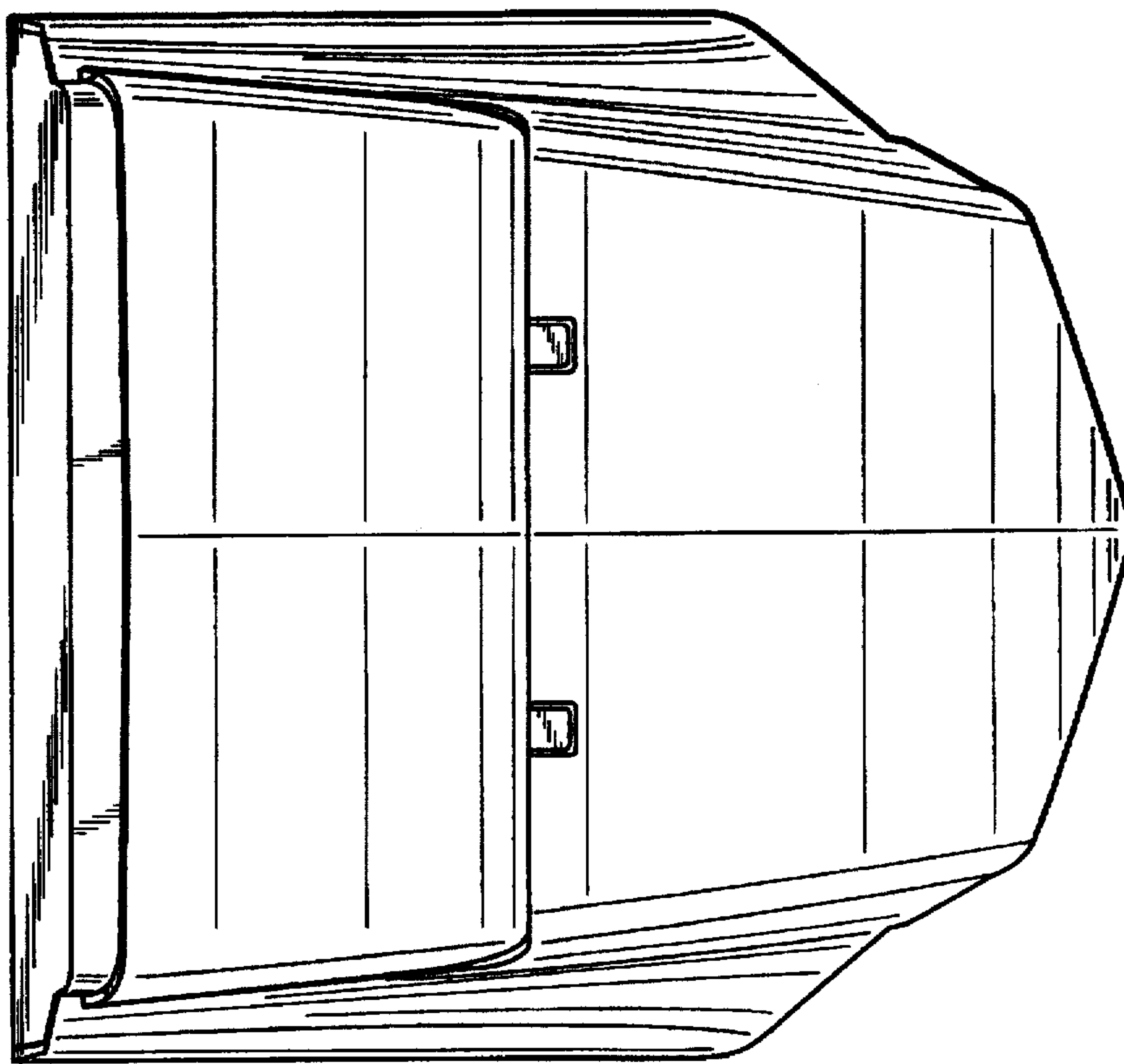

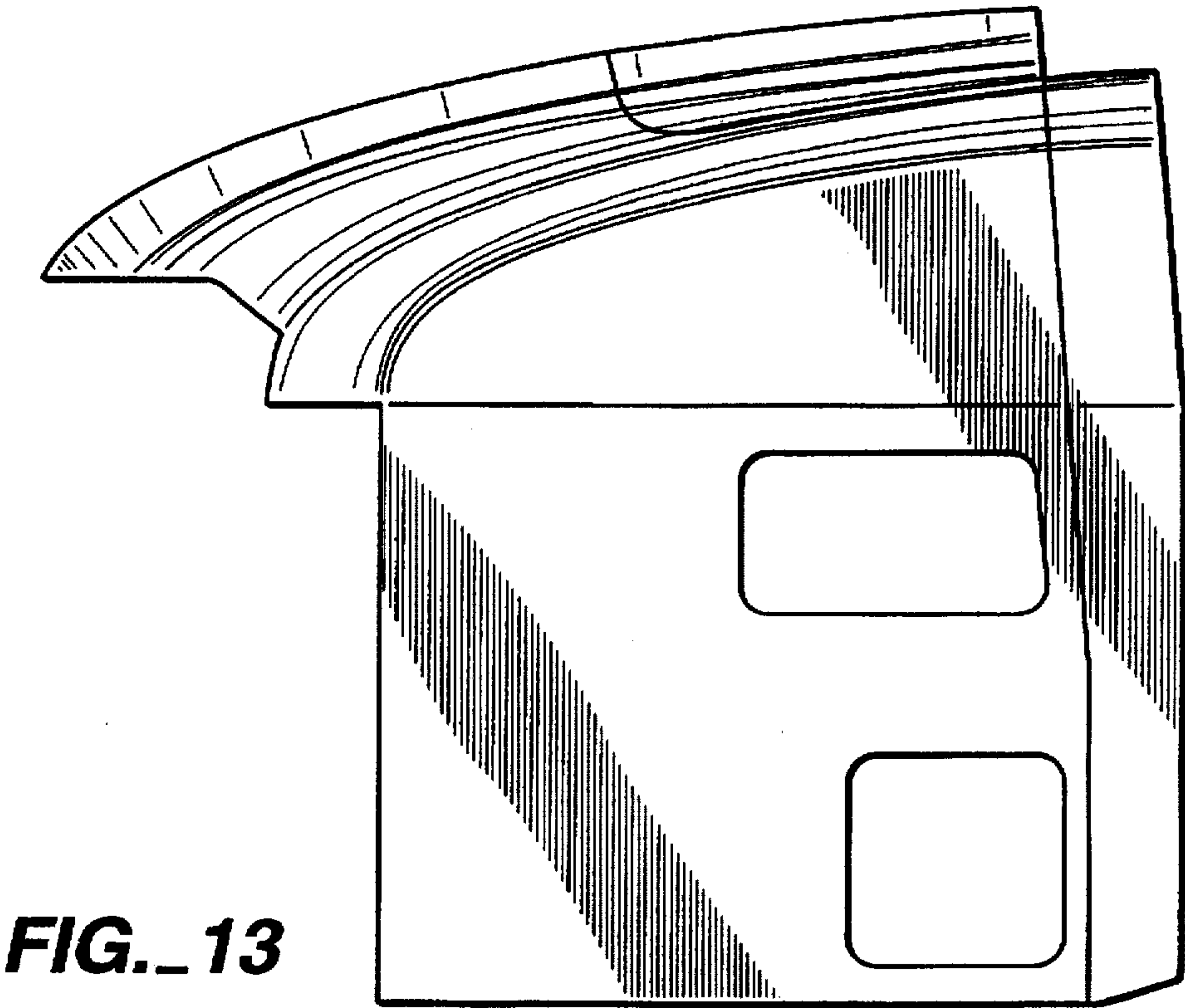

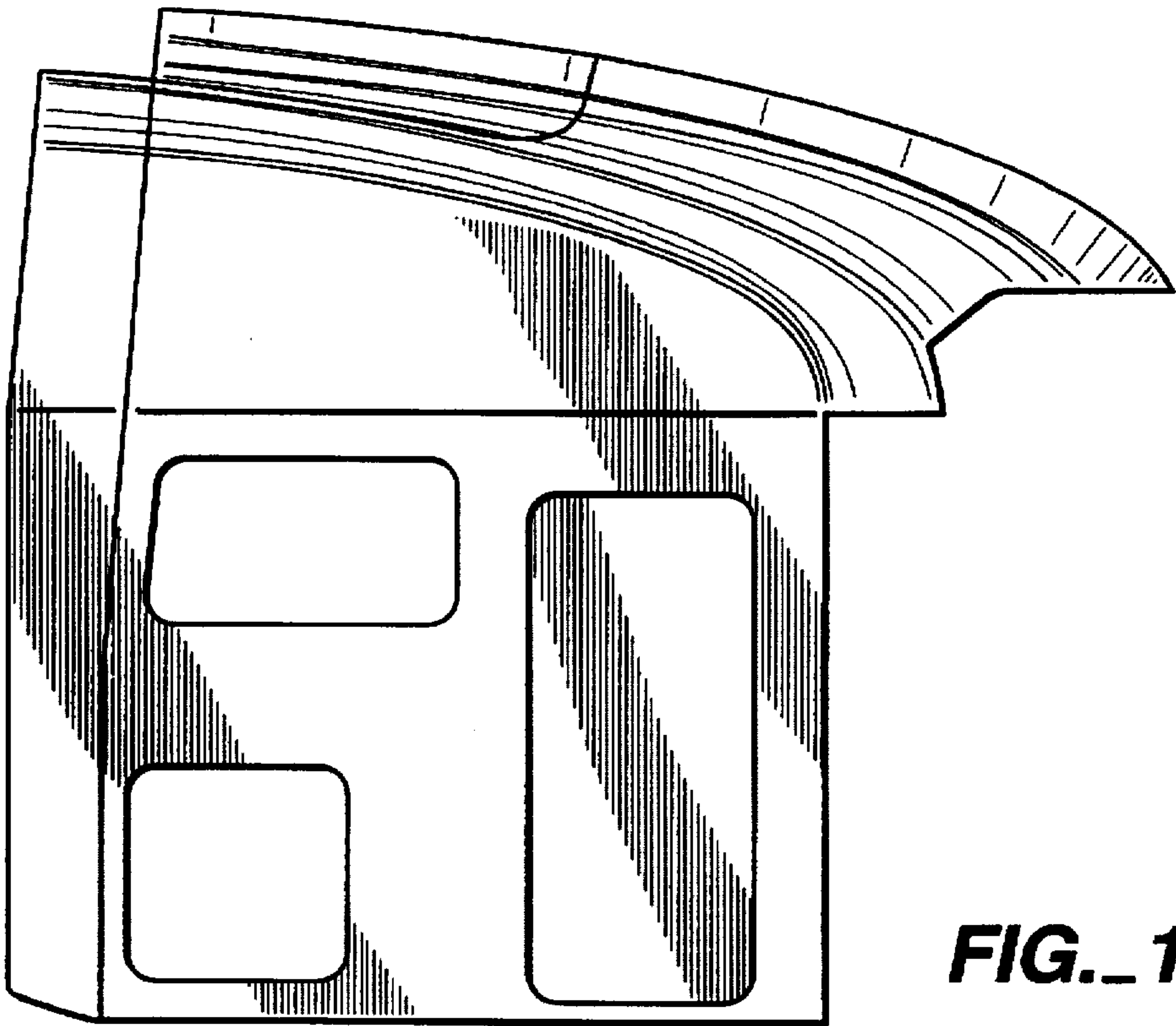

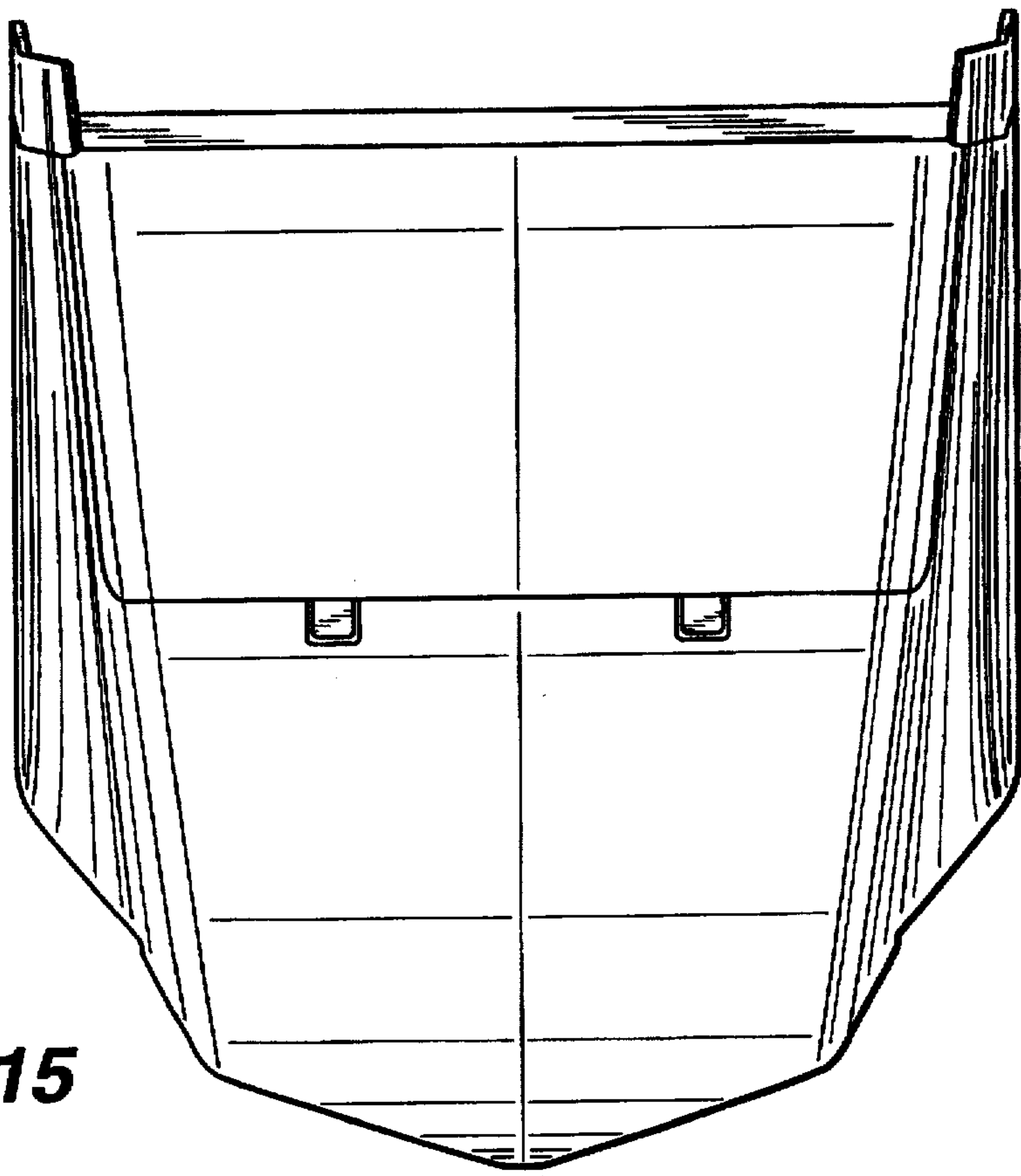

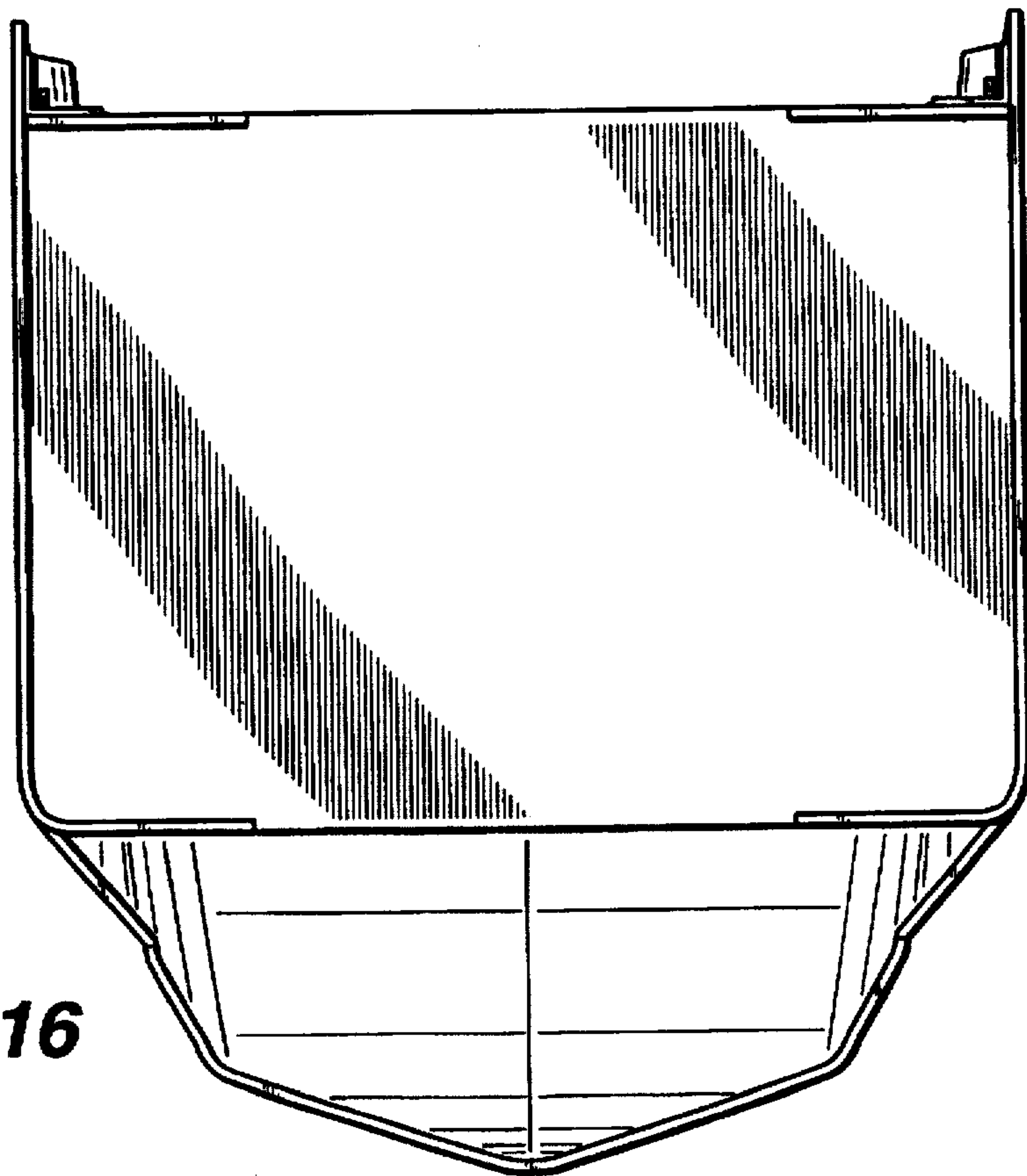

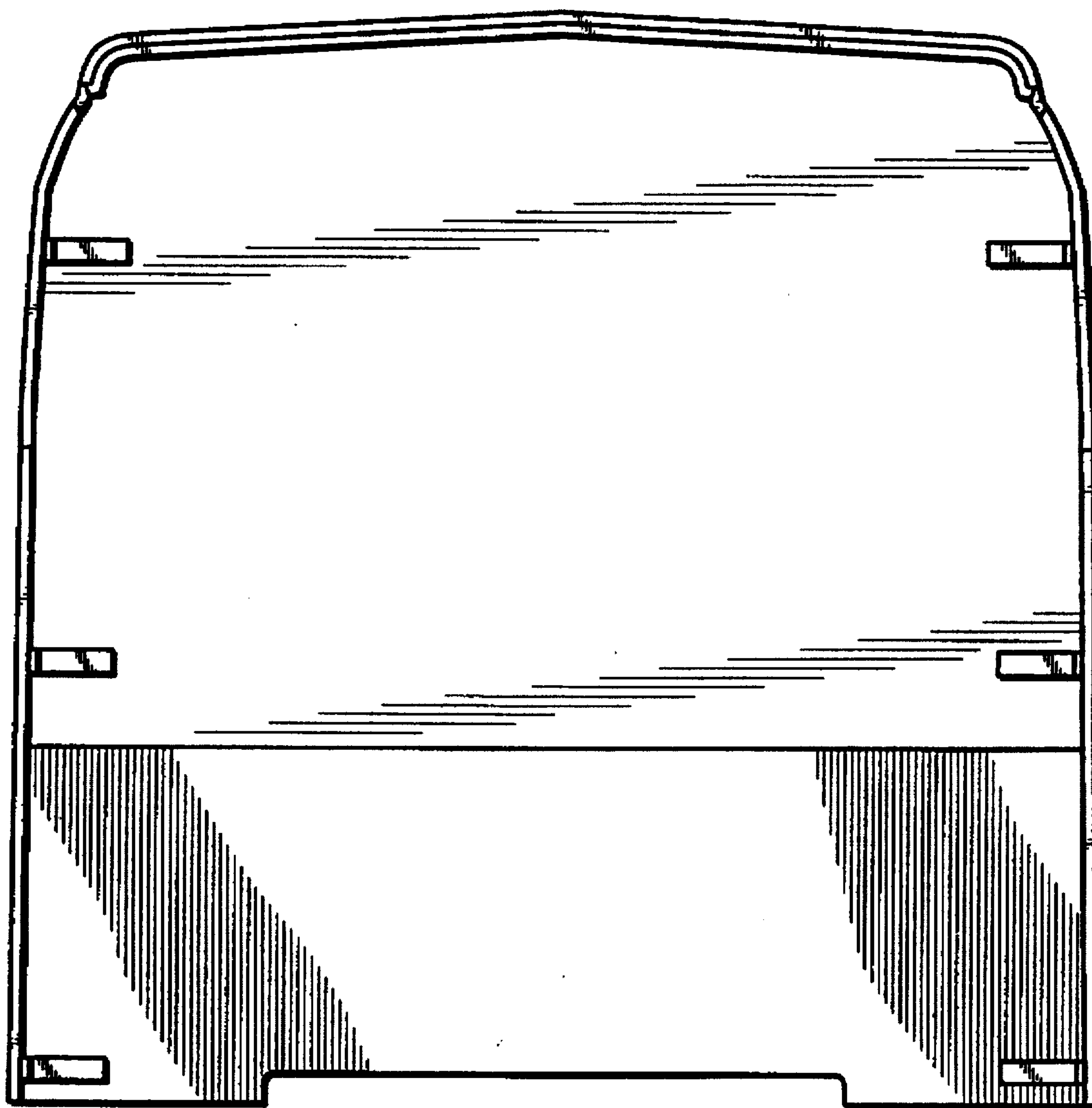
