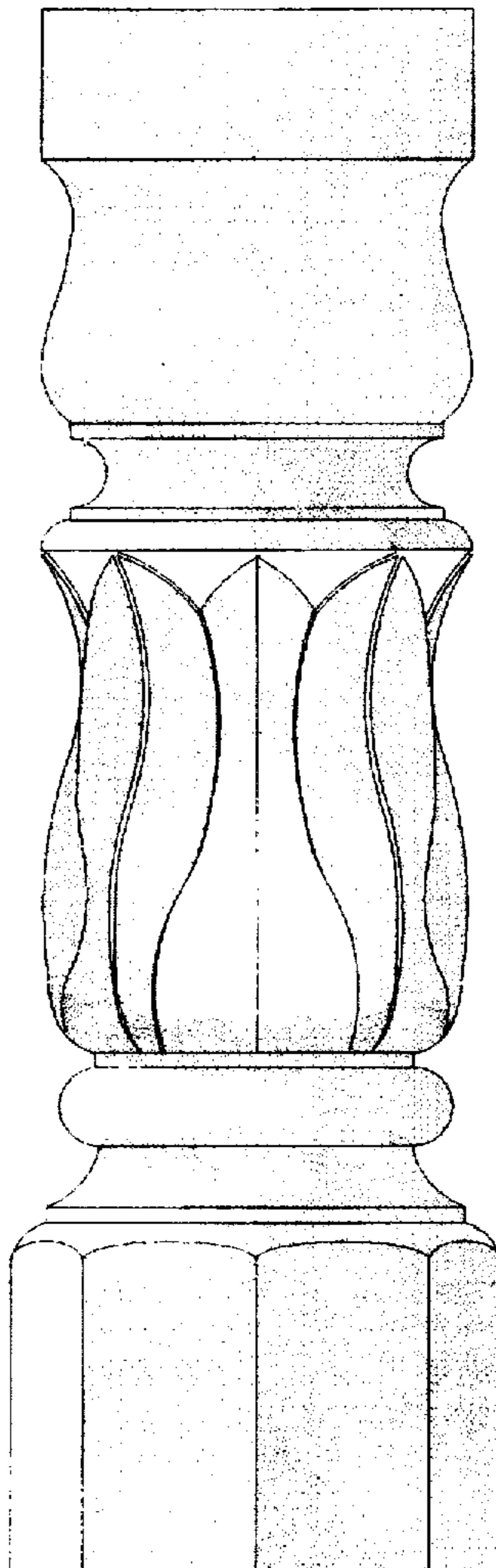
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a furniture pedestal with leaf design, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a furniture pedestal showing my new design, the rear elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

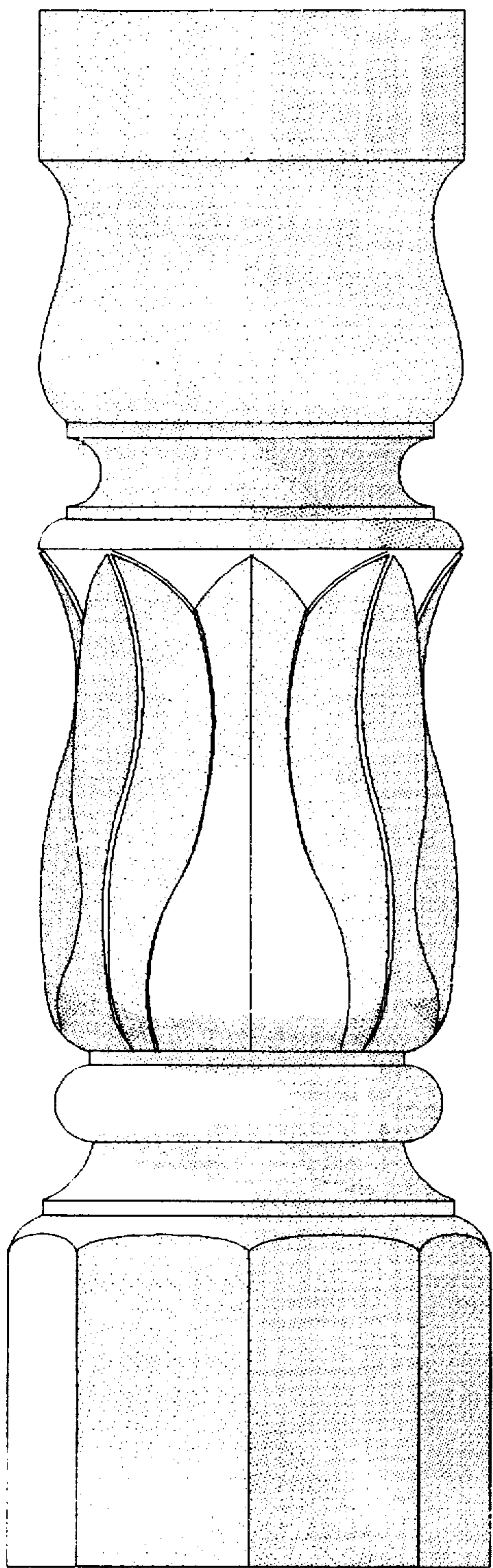

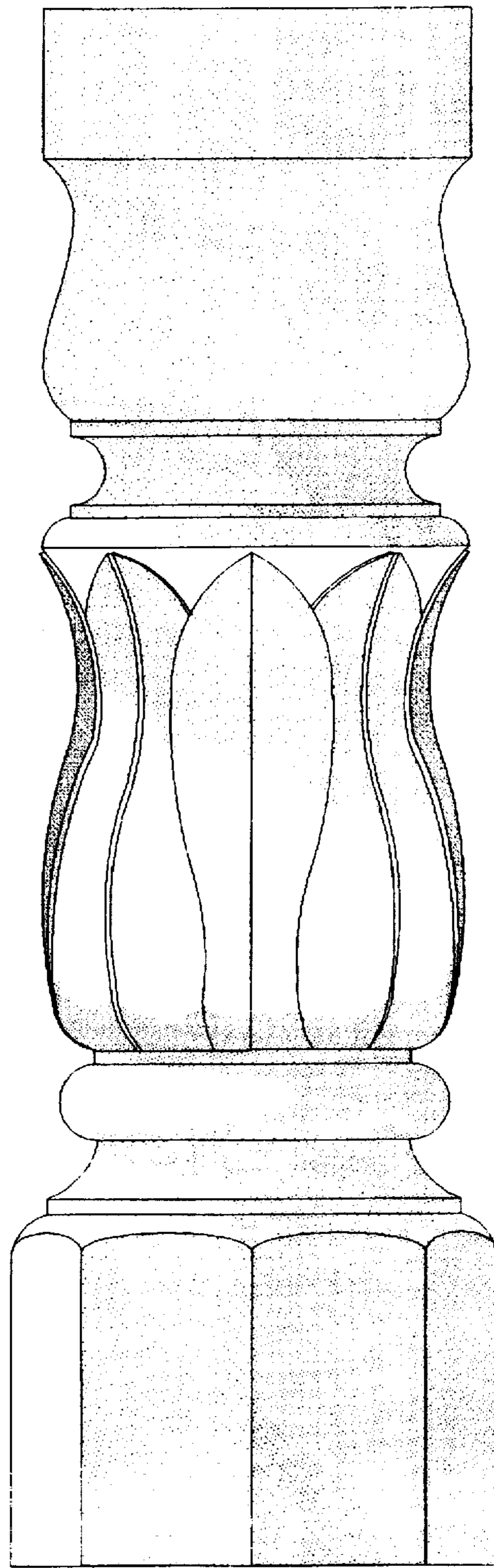

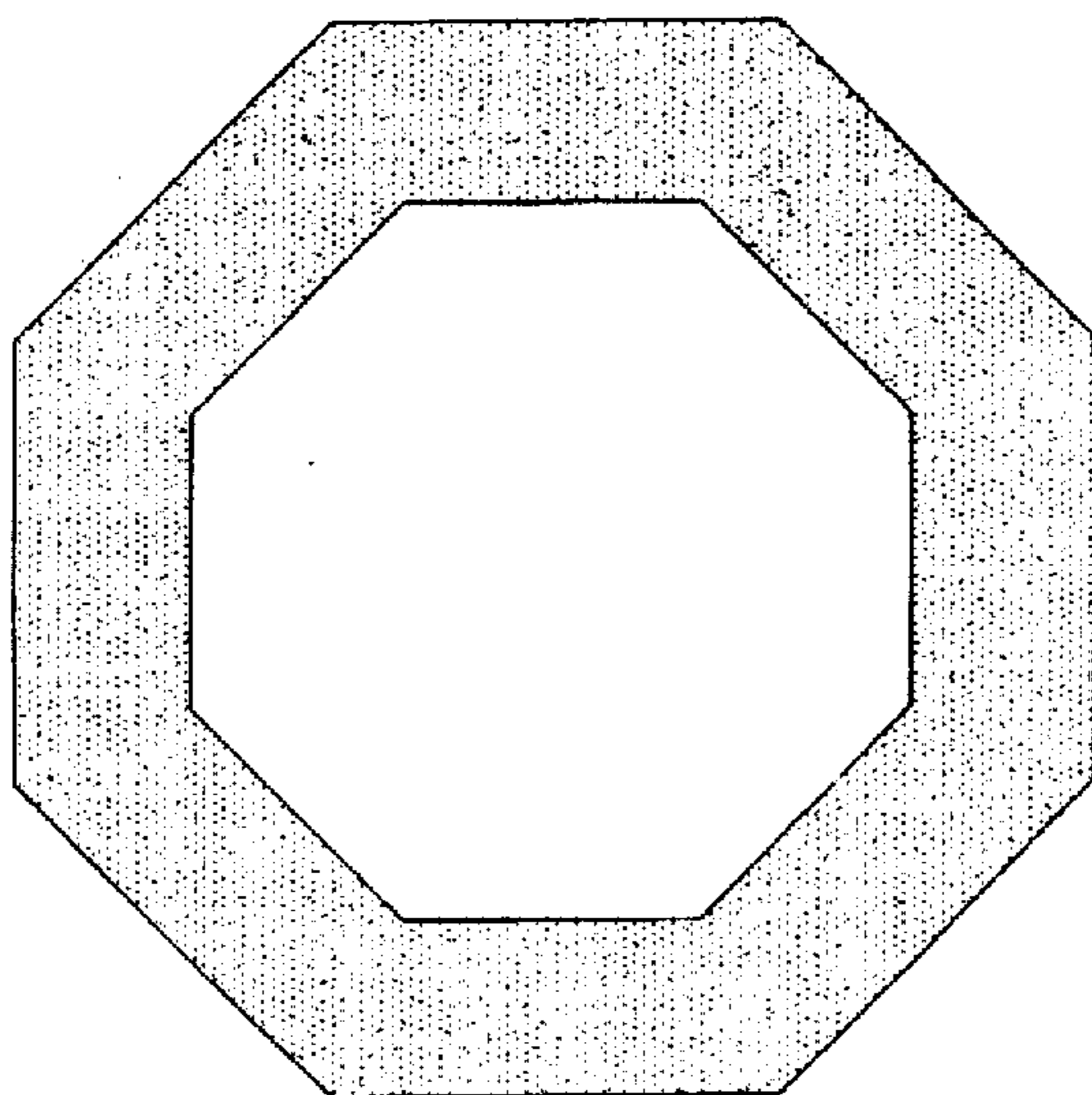

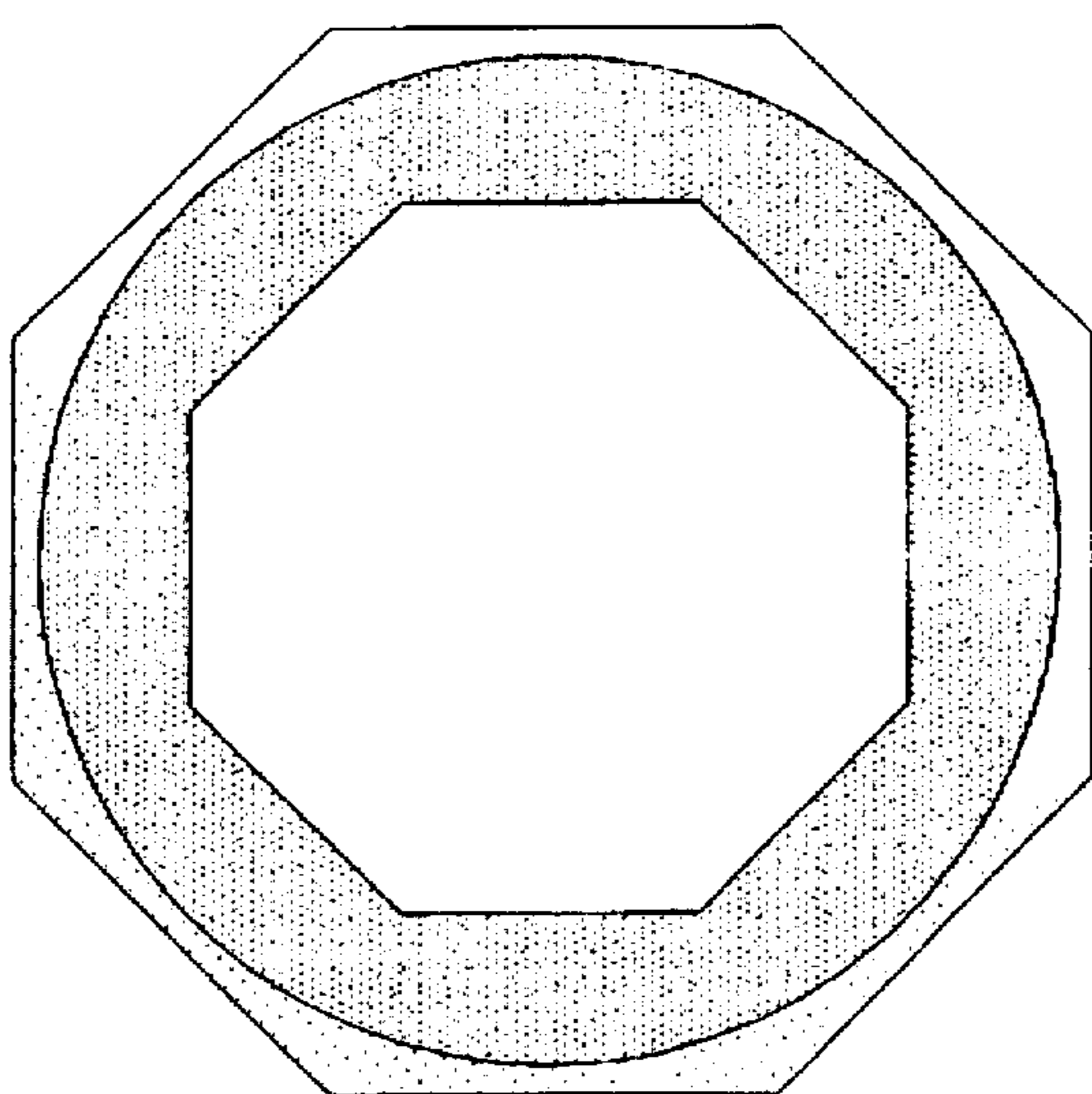
