FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the design of FIG. 1; and,

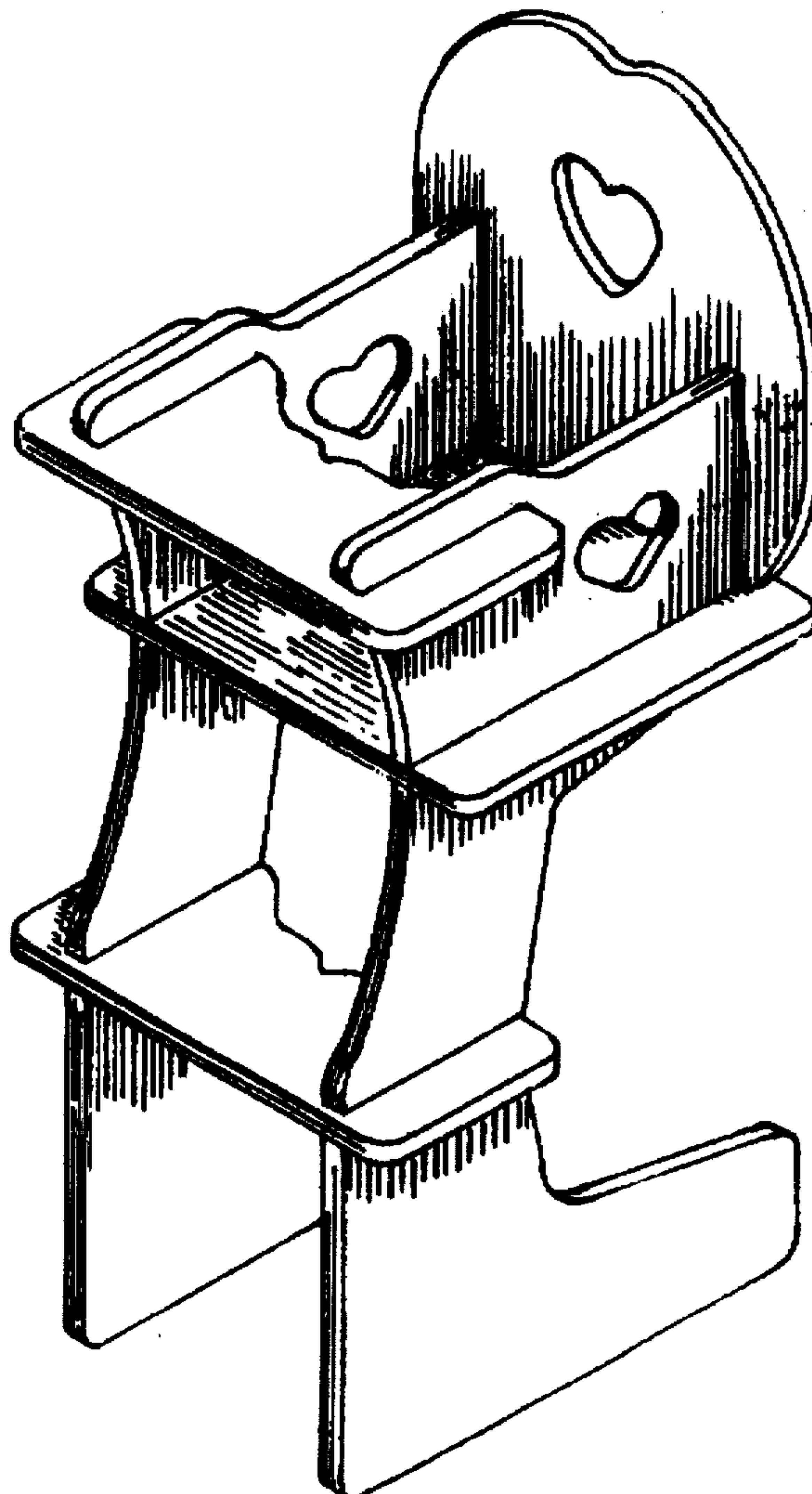
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the design of FIG. 1.

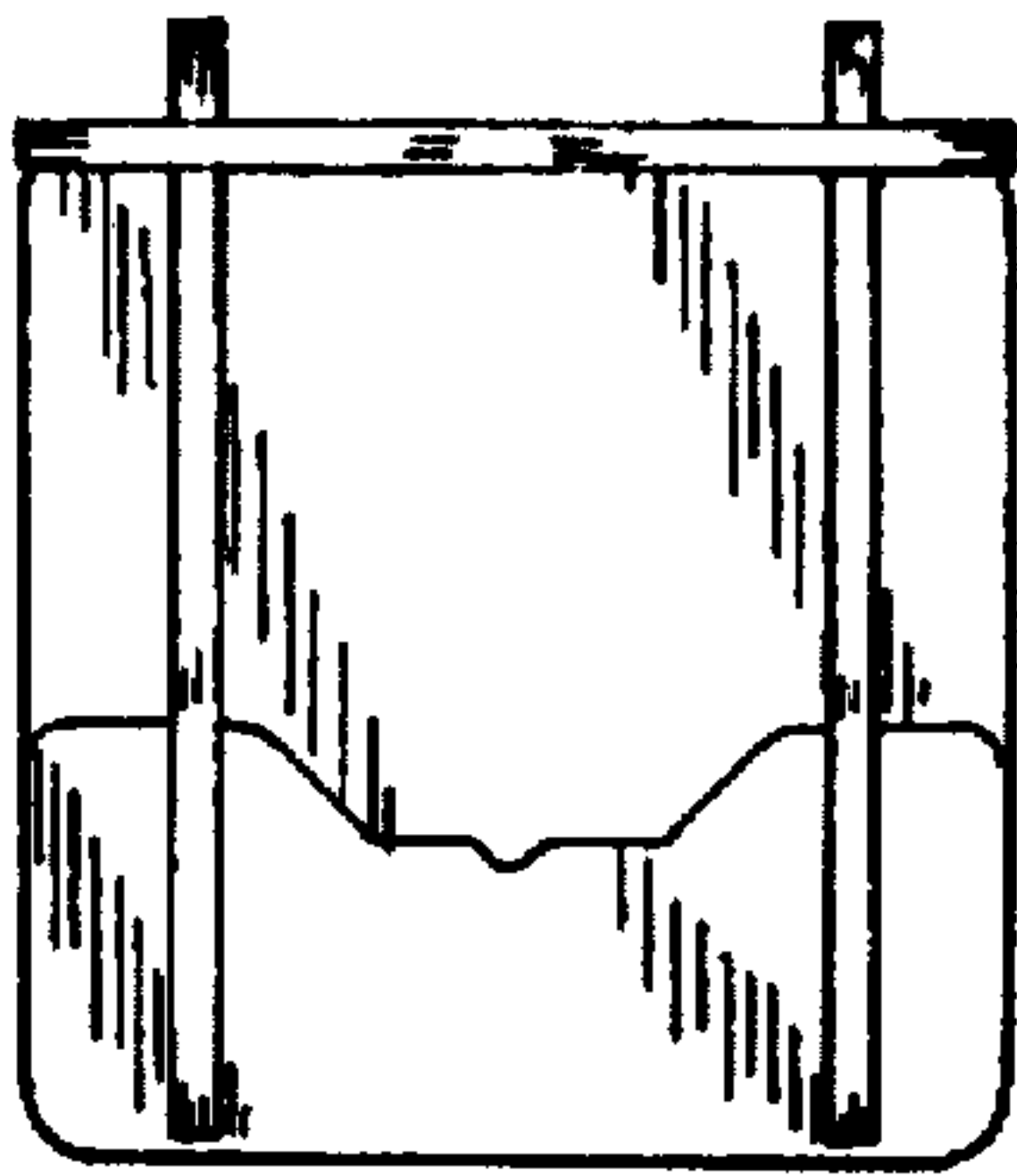

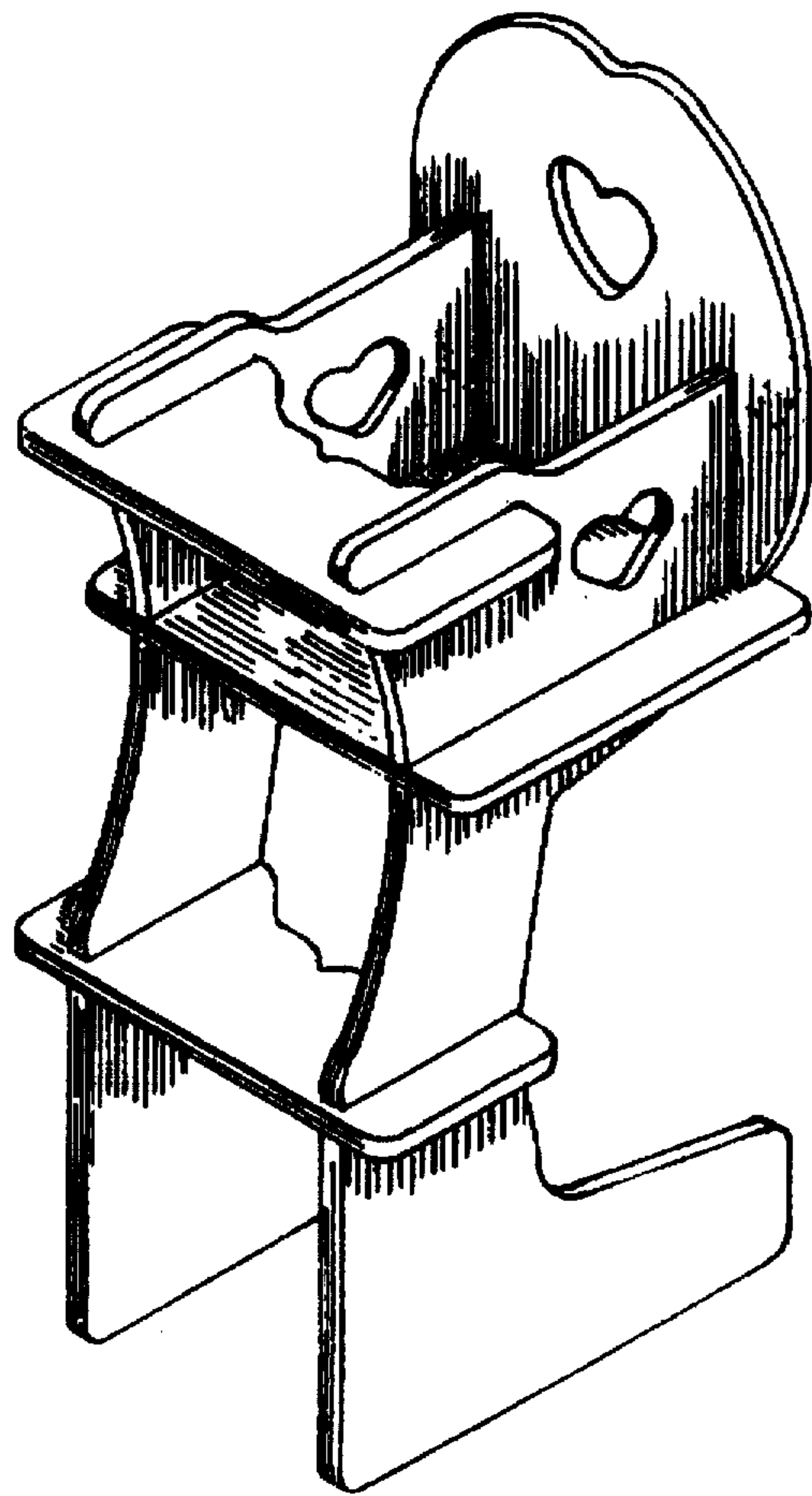

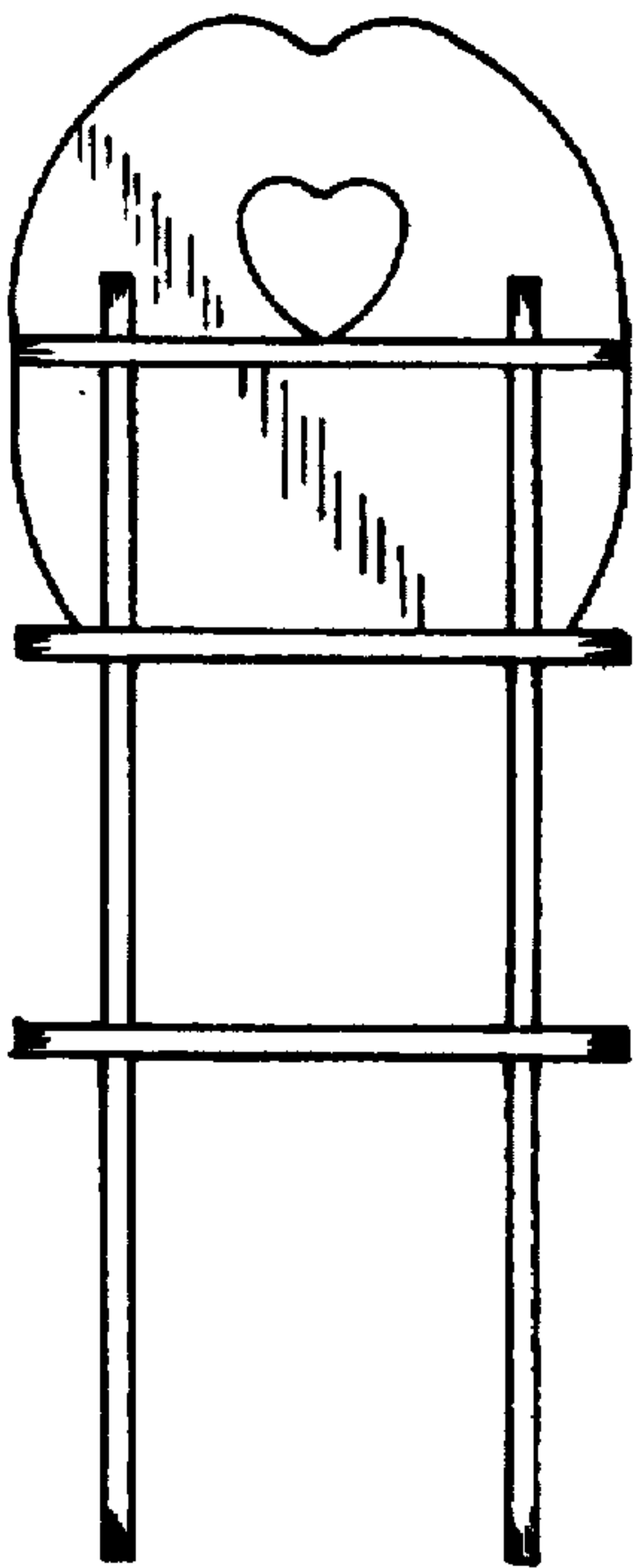

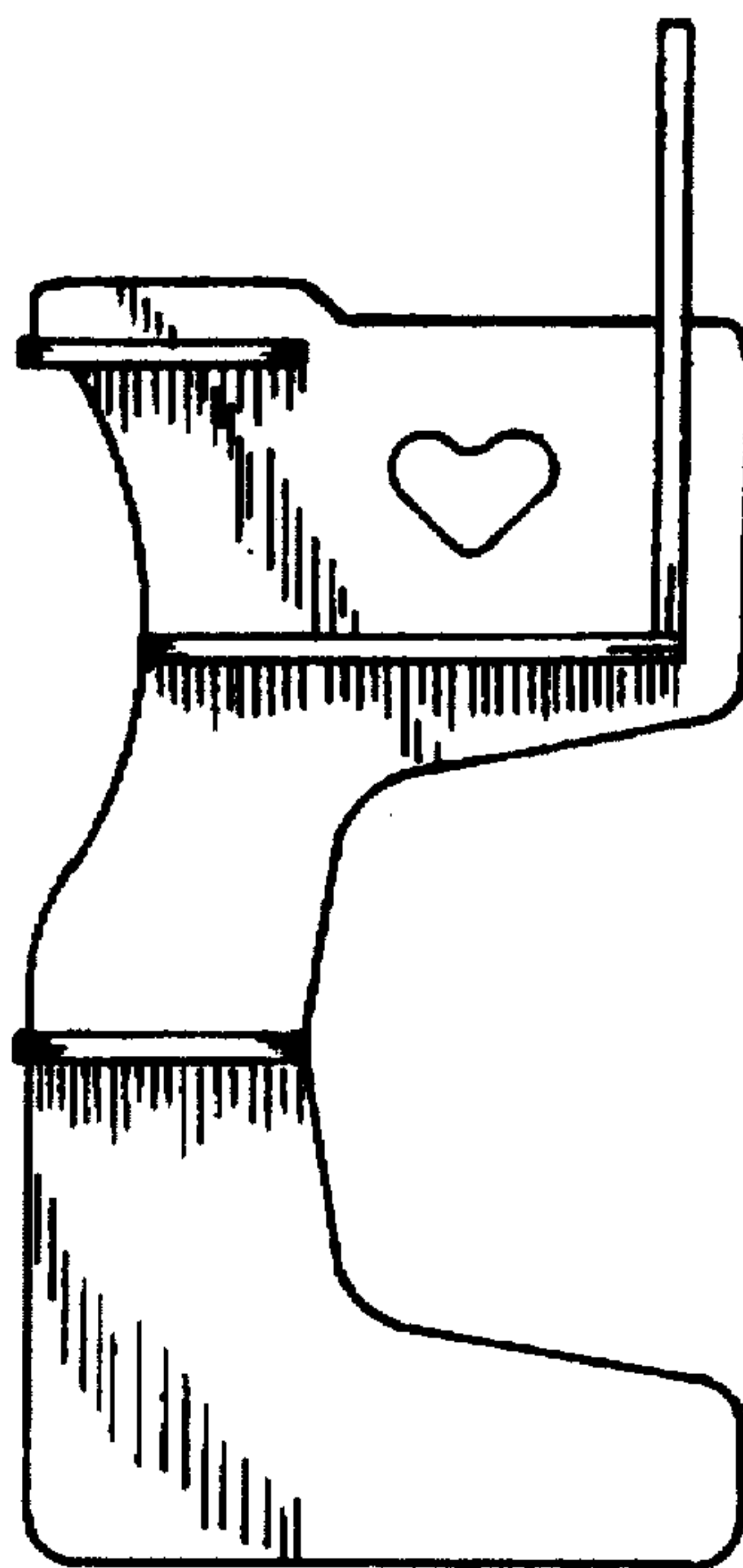

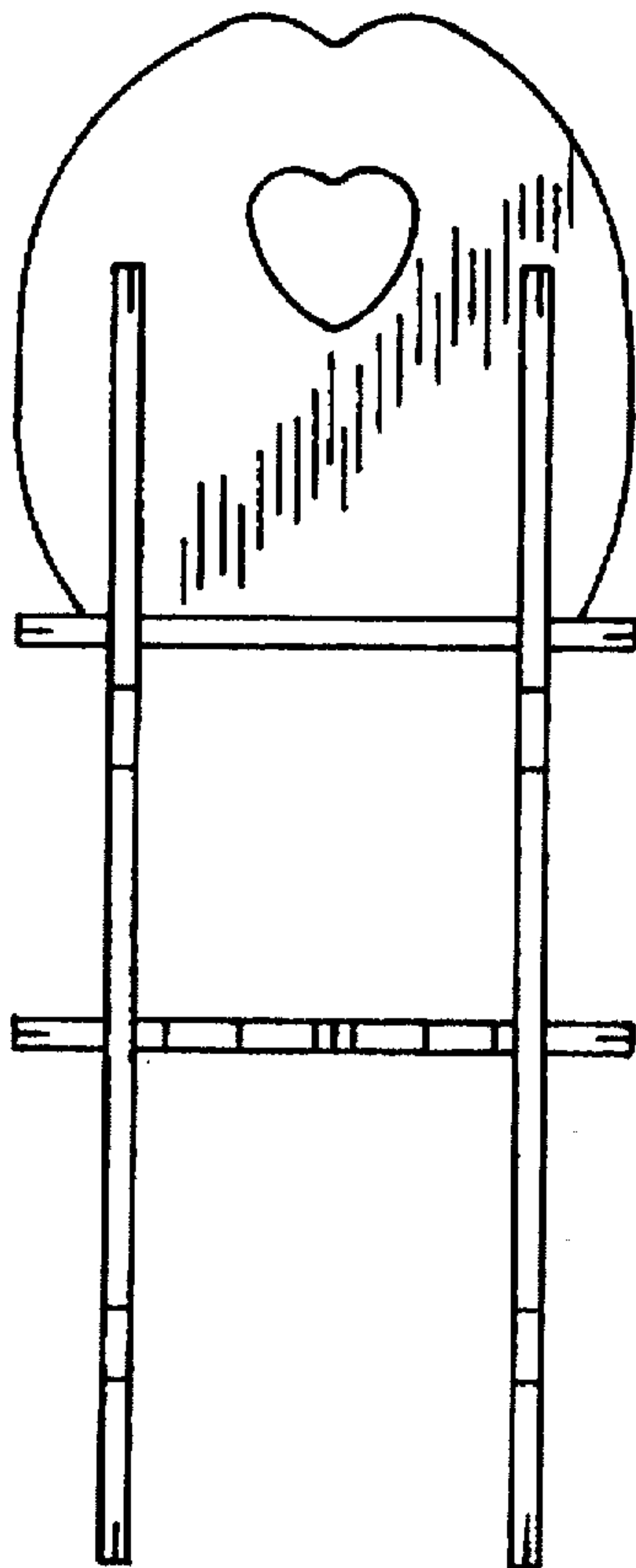

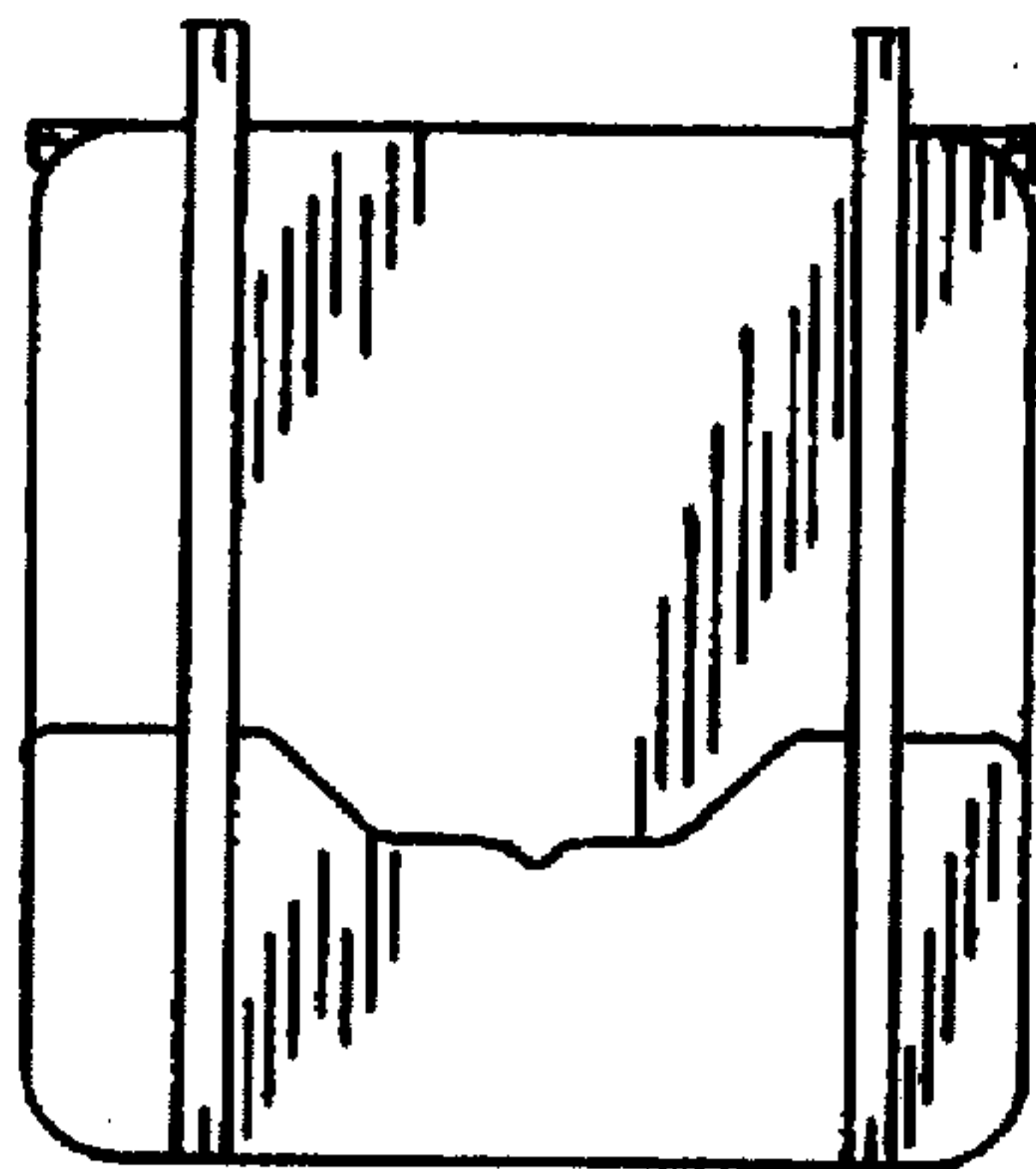
