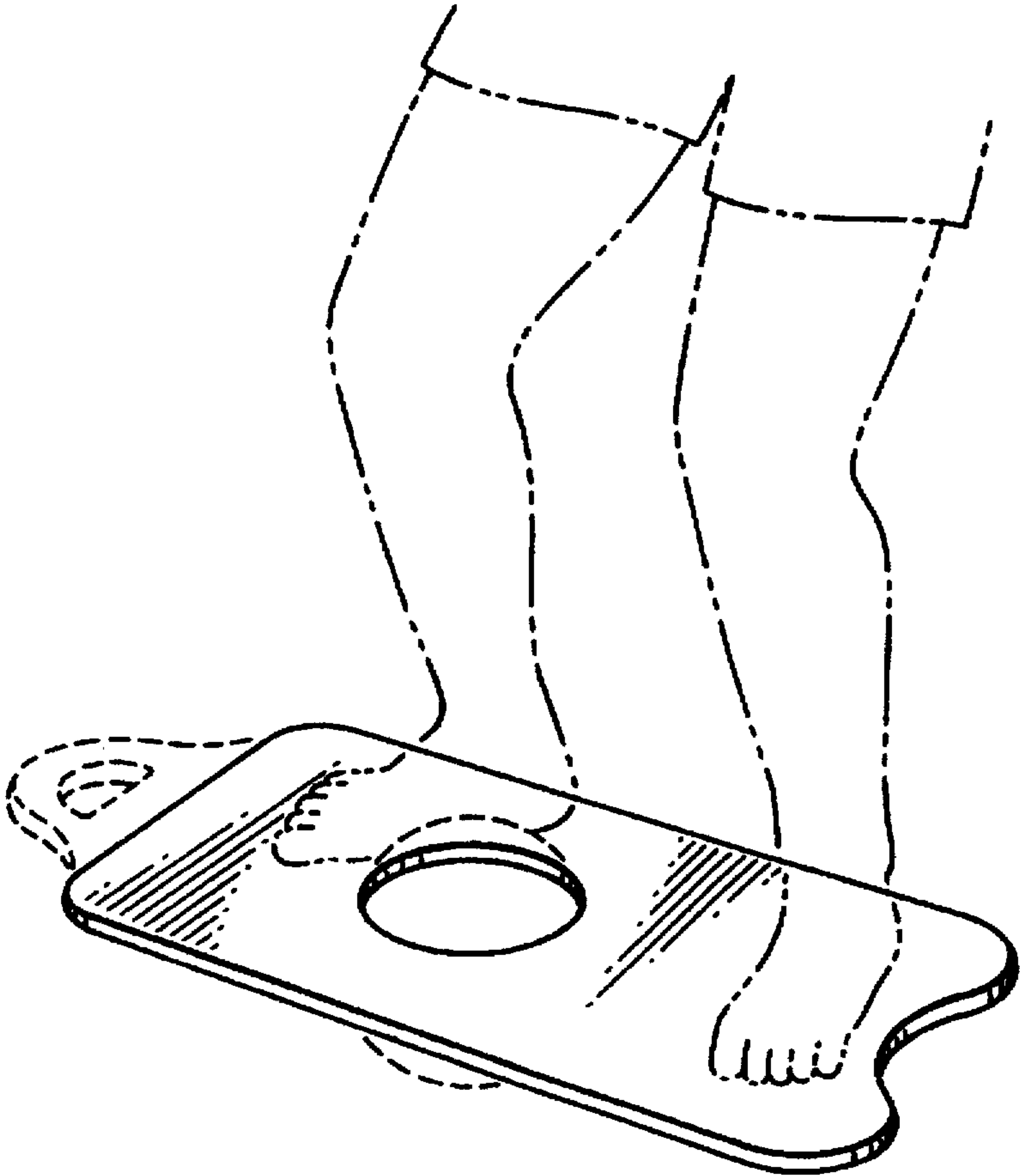
The ornamental design for an ankle board, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the ankle board, showing my new design in use, the broken line showing of the handle, ball, and the lower body of a user is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design;

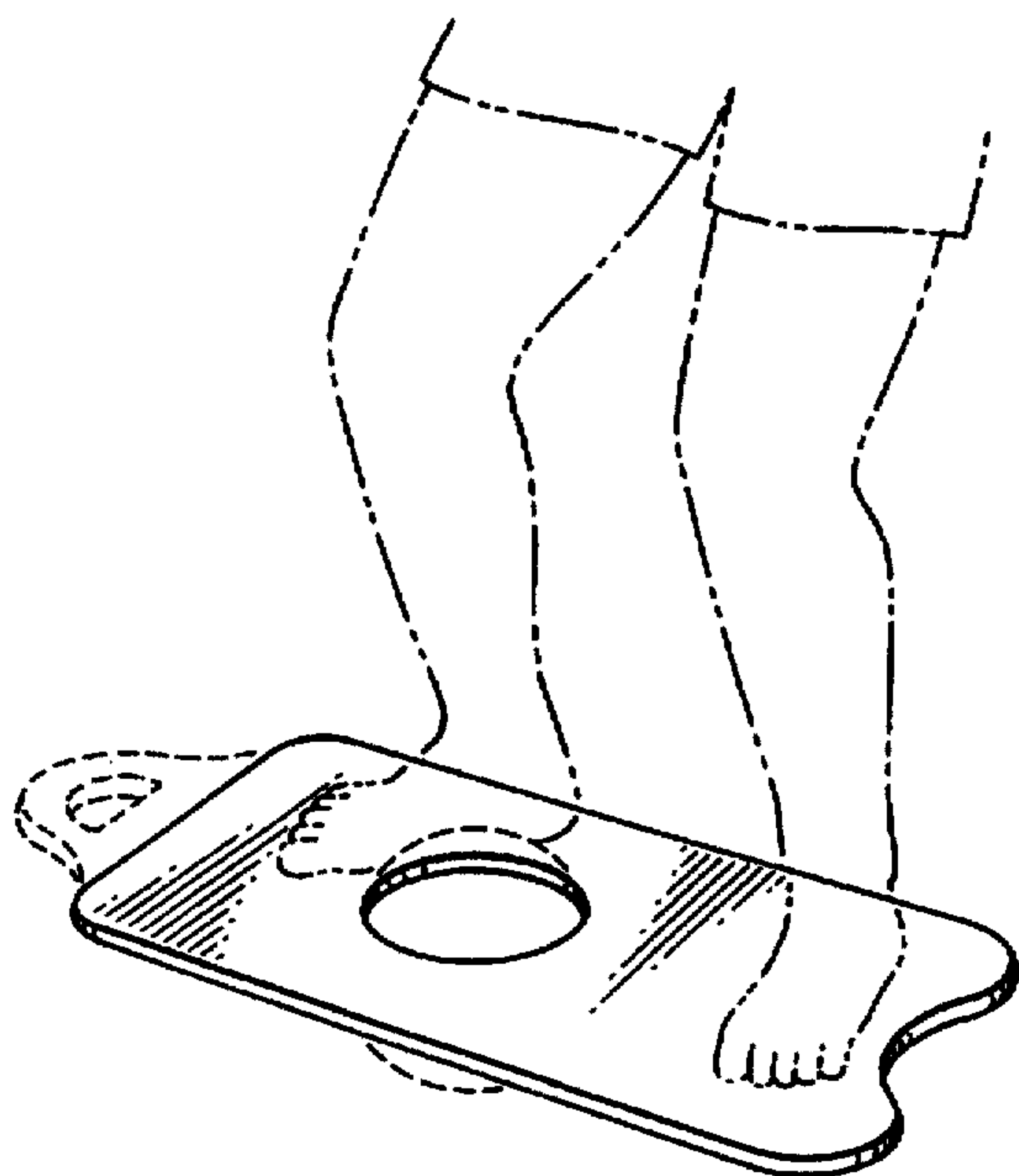

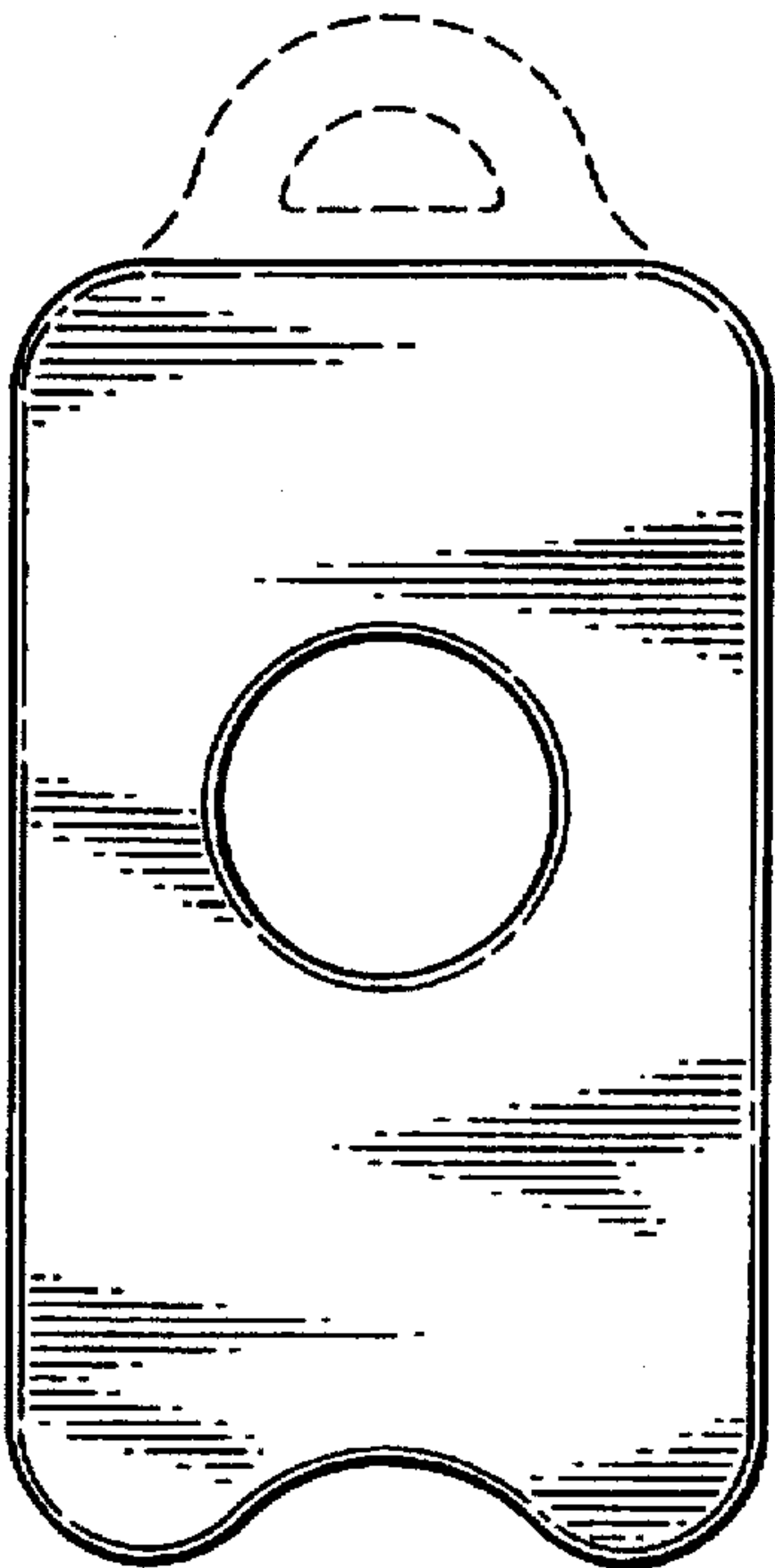

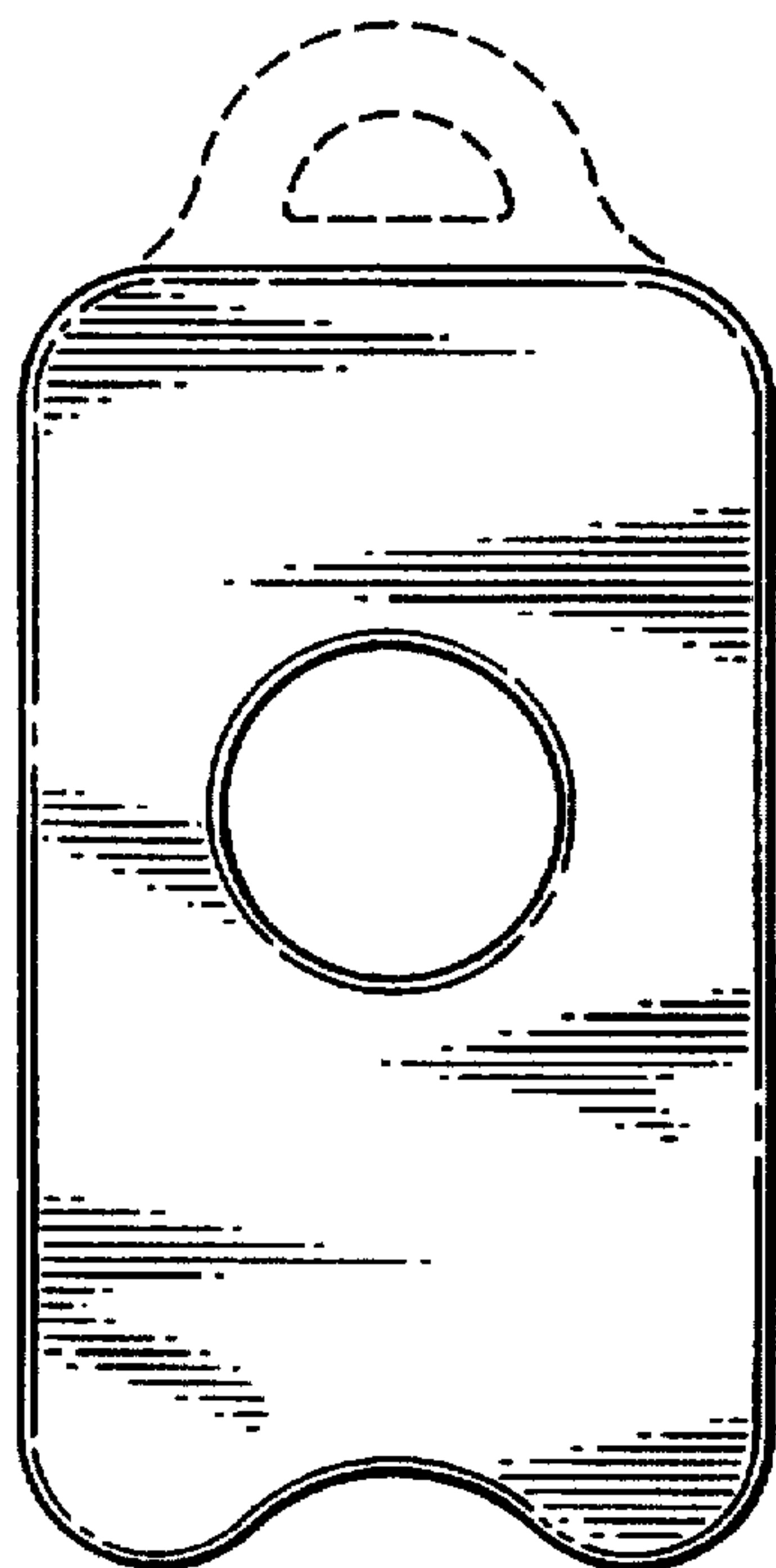

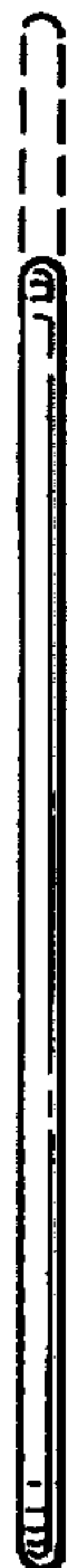

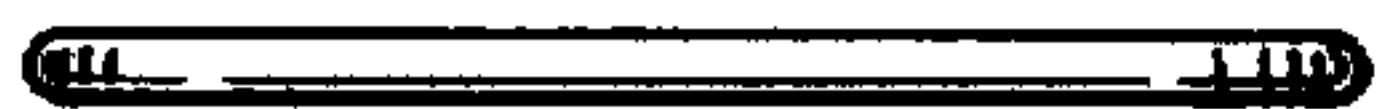
