DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an element of a shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

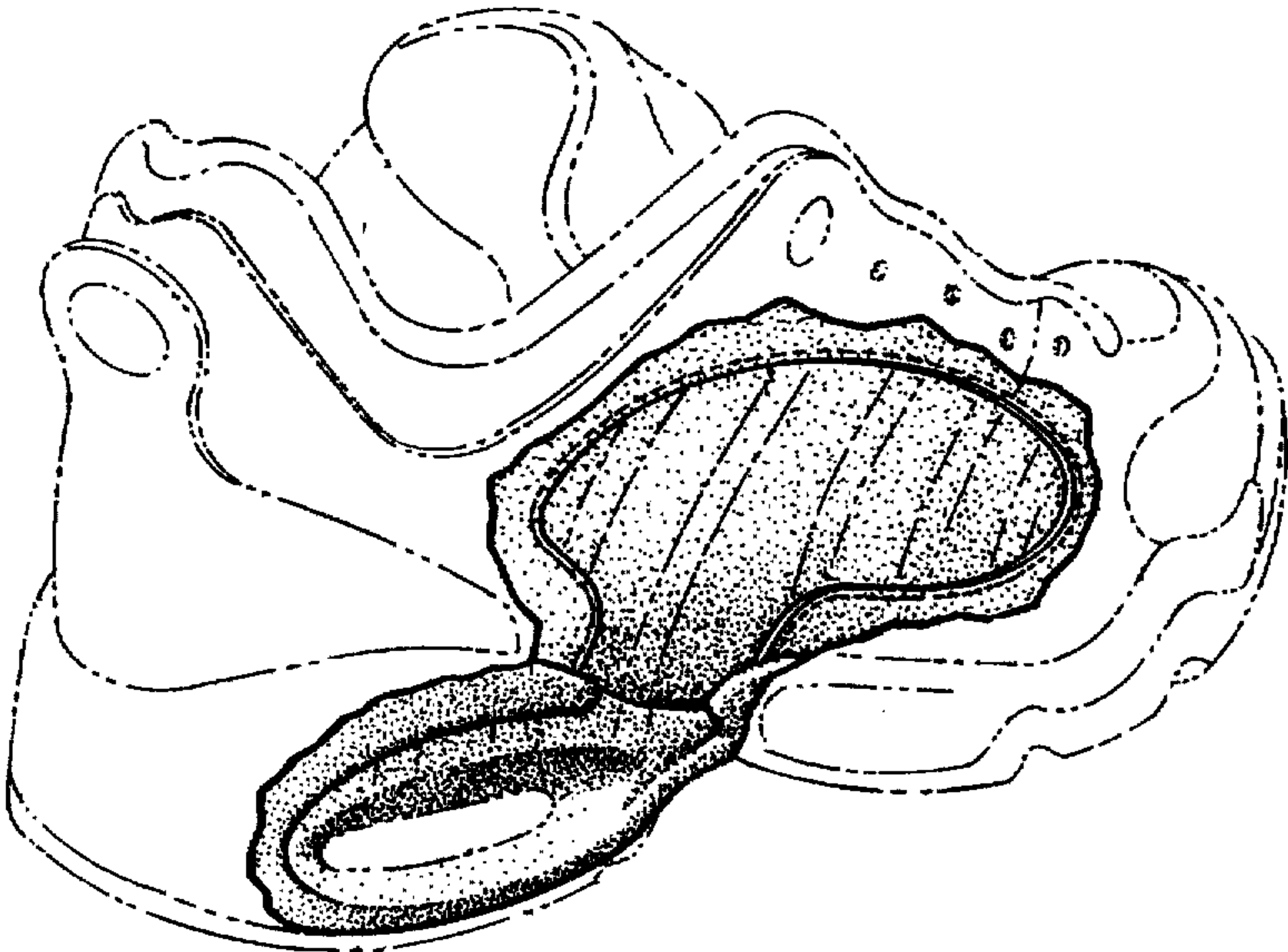

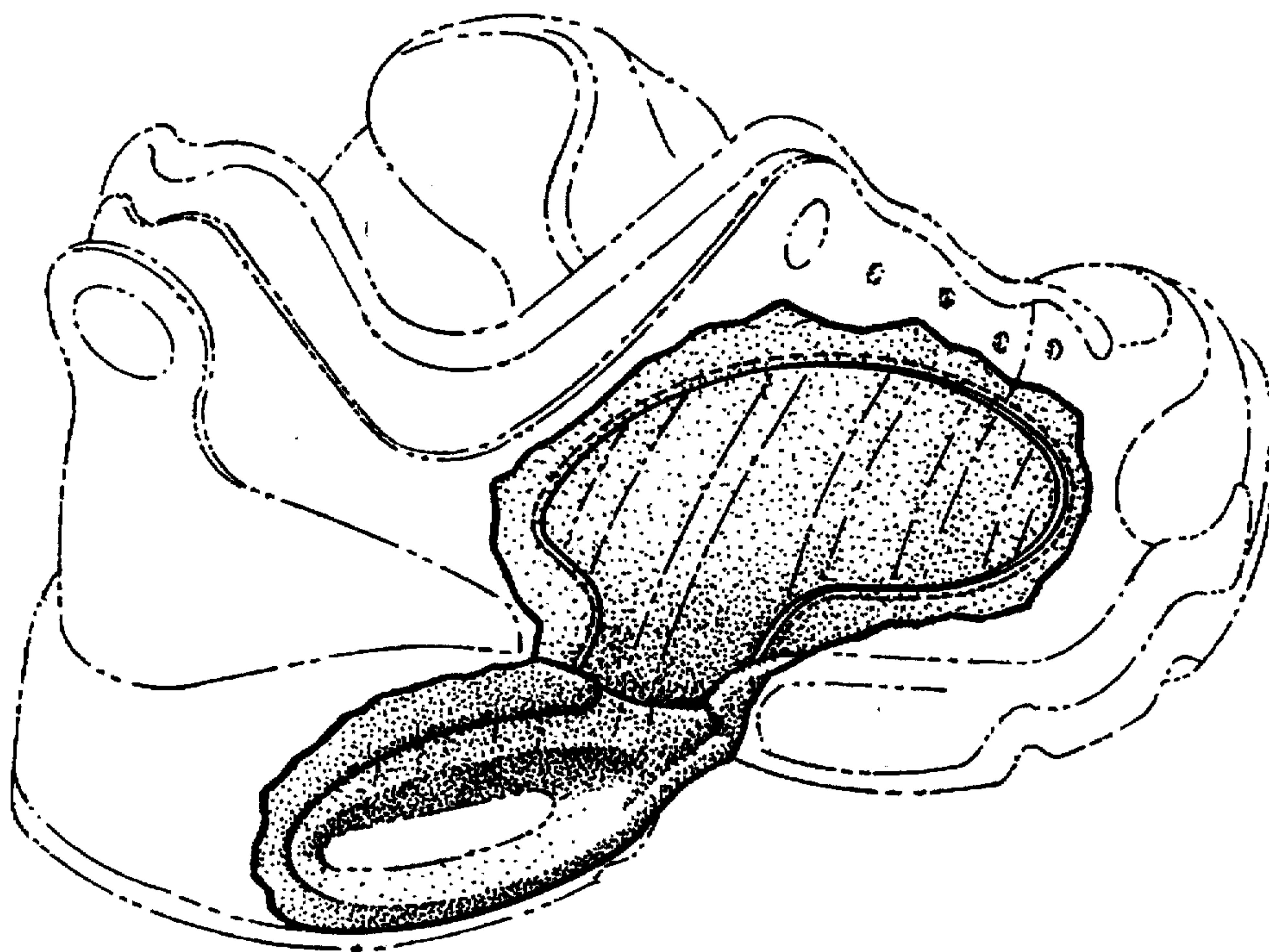

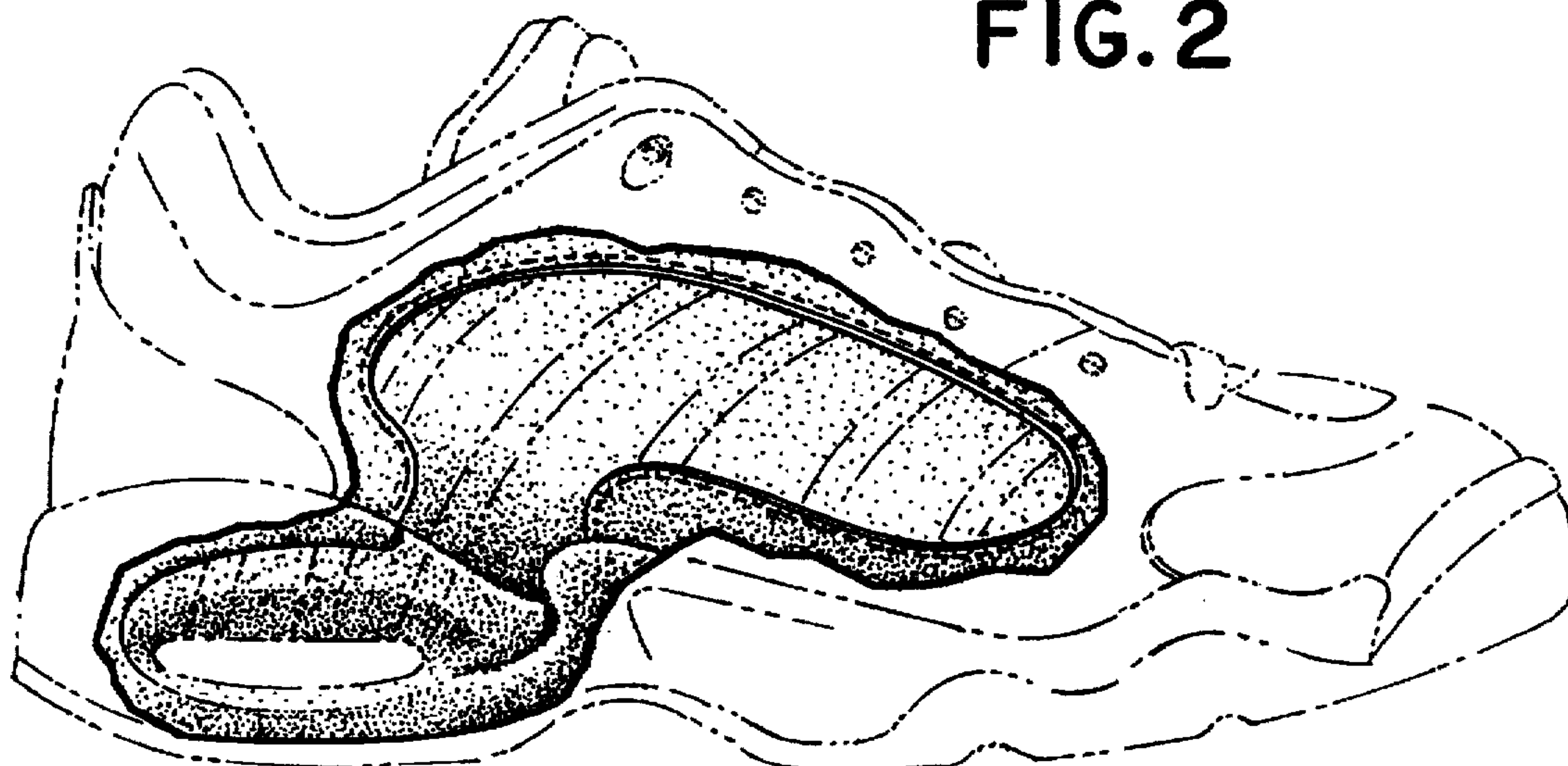

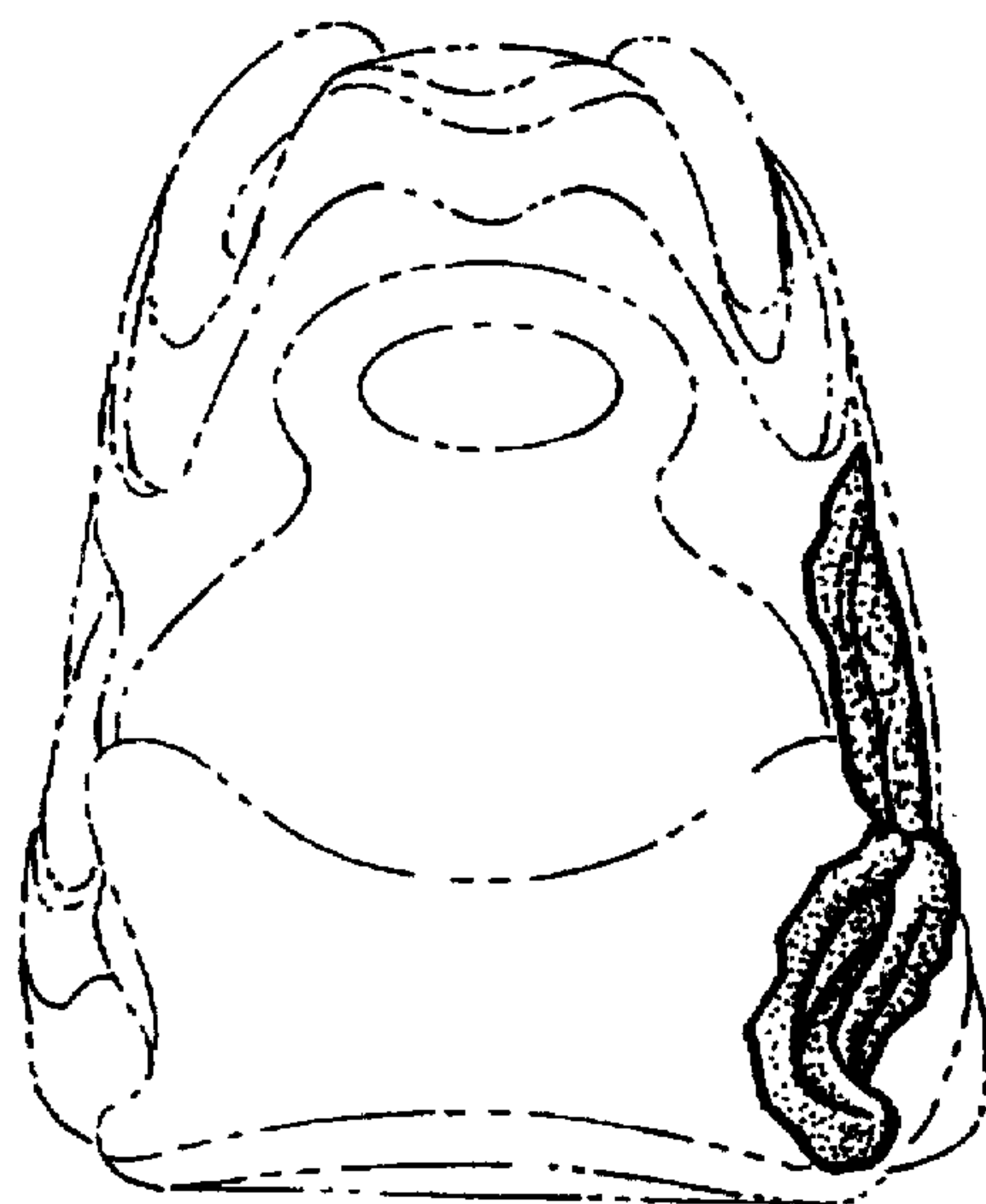
