DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a thermometer showing our new design;

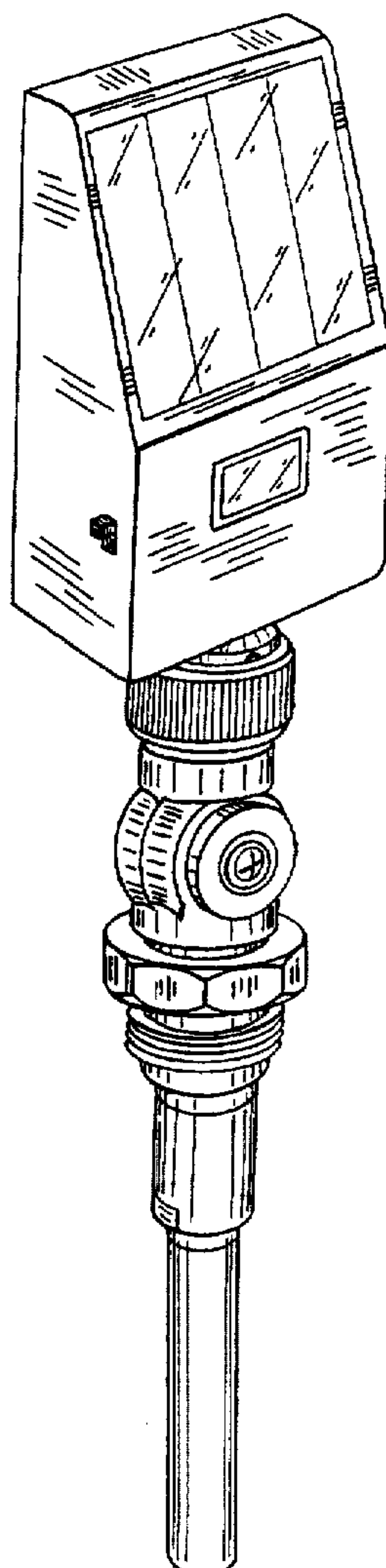

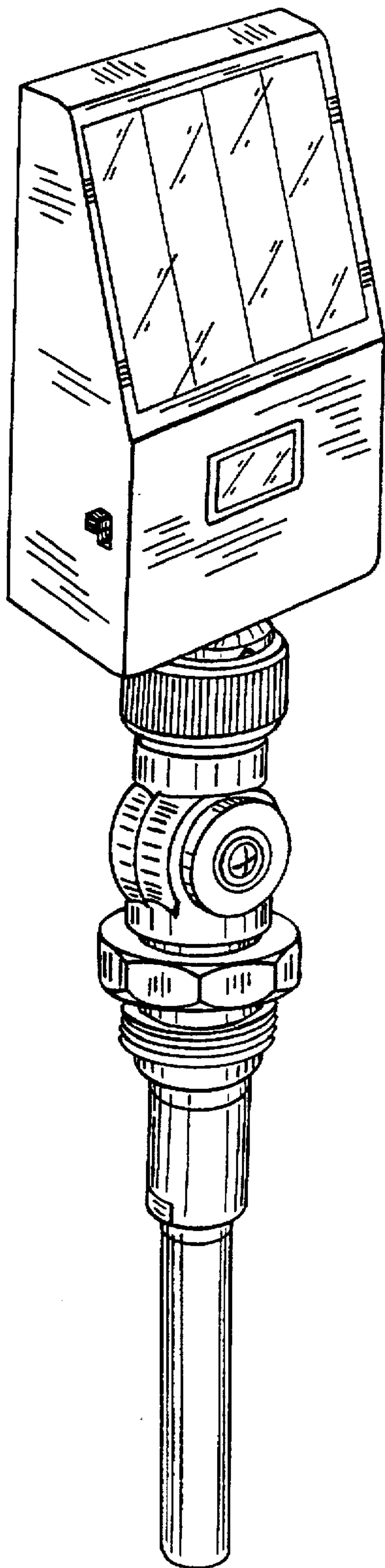

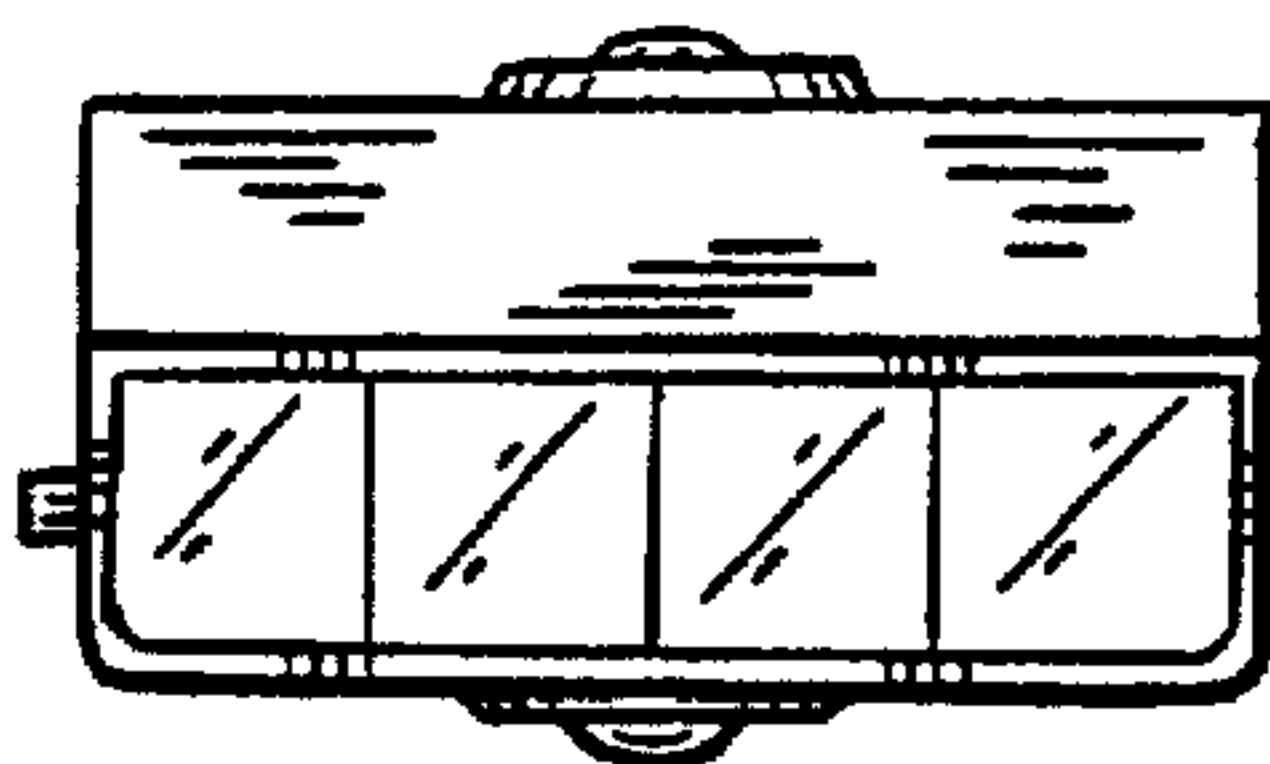

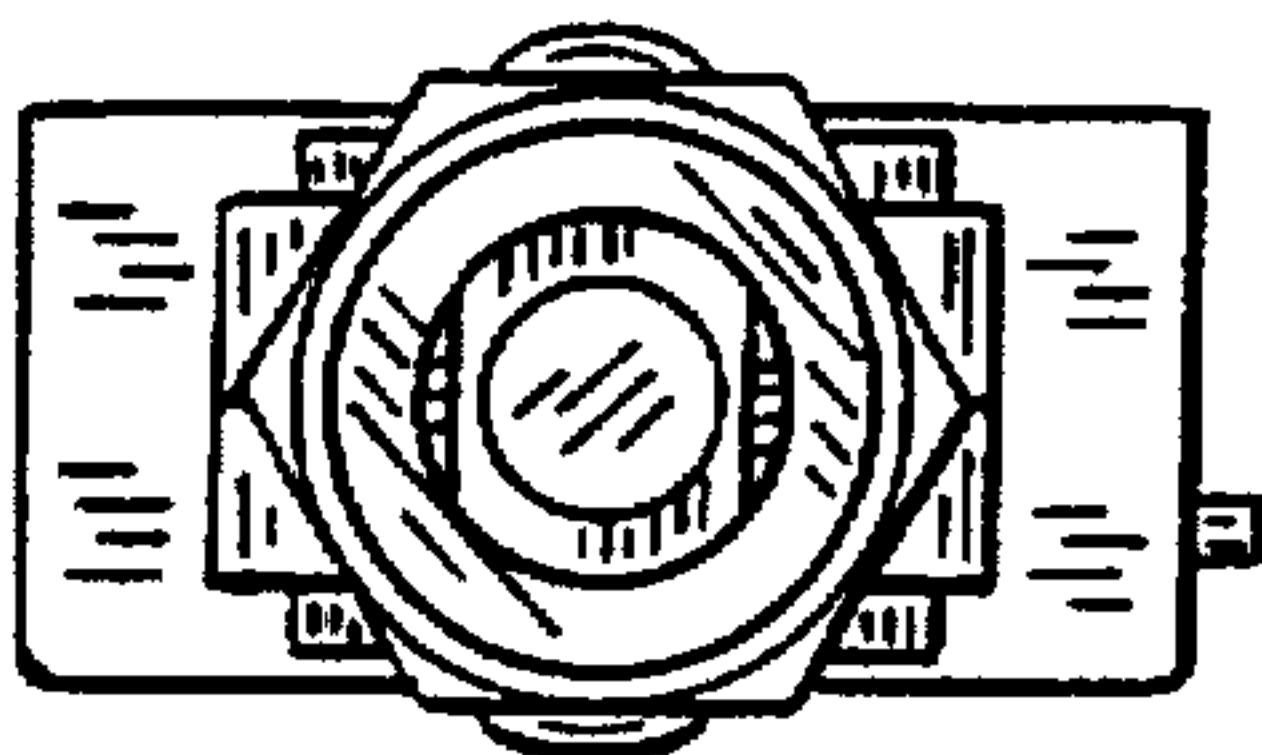

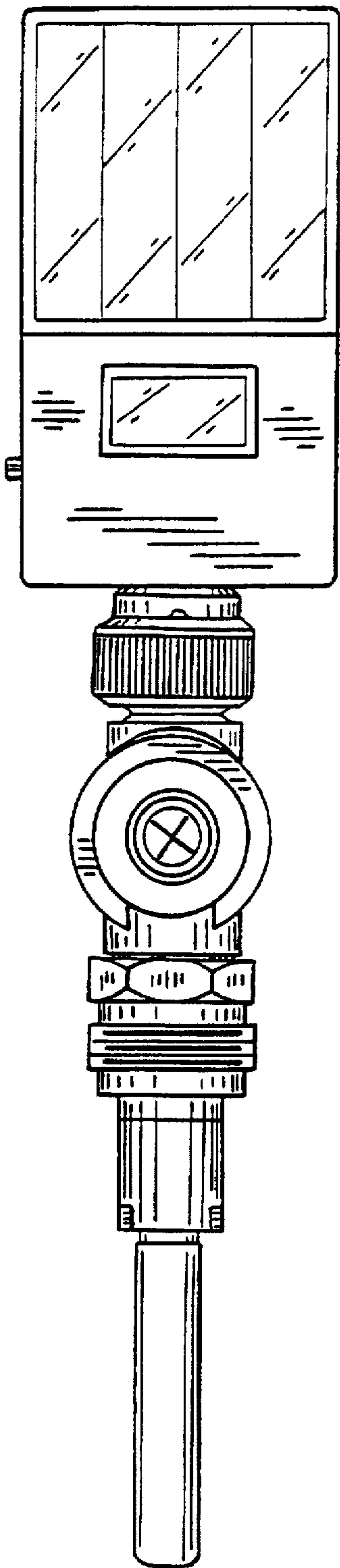

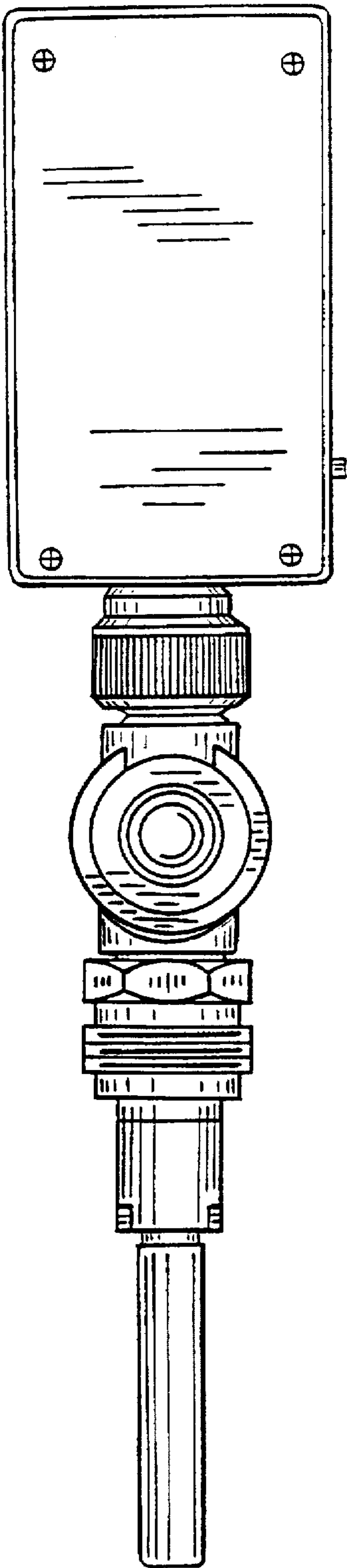
