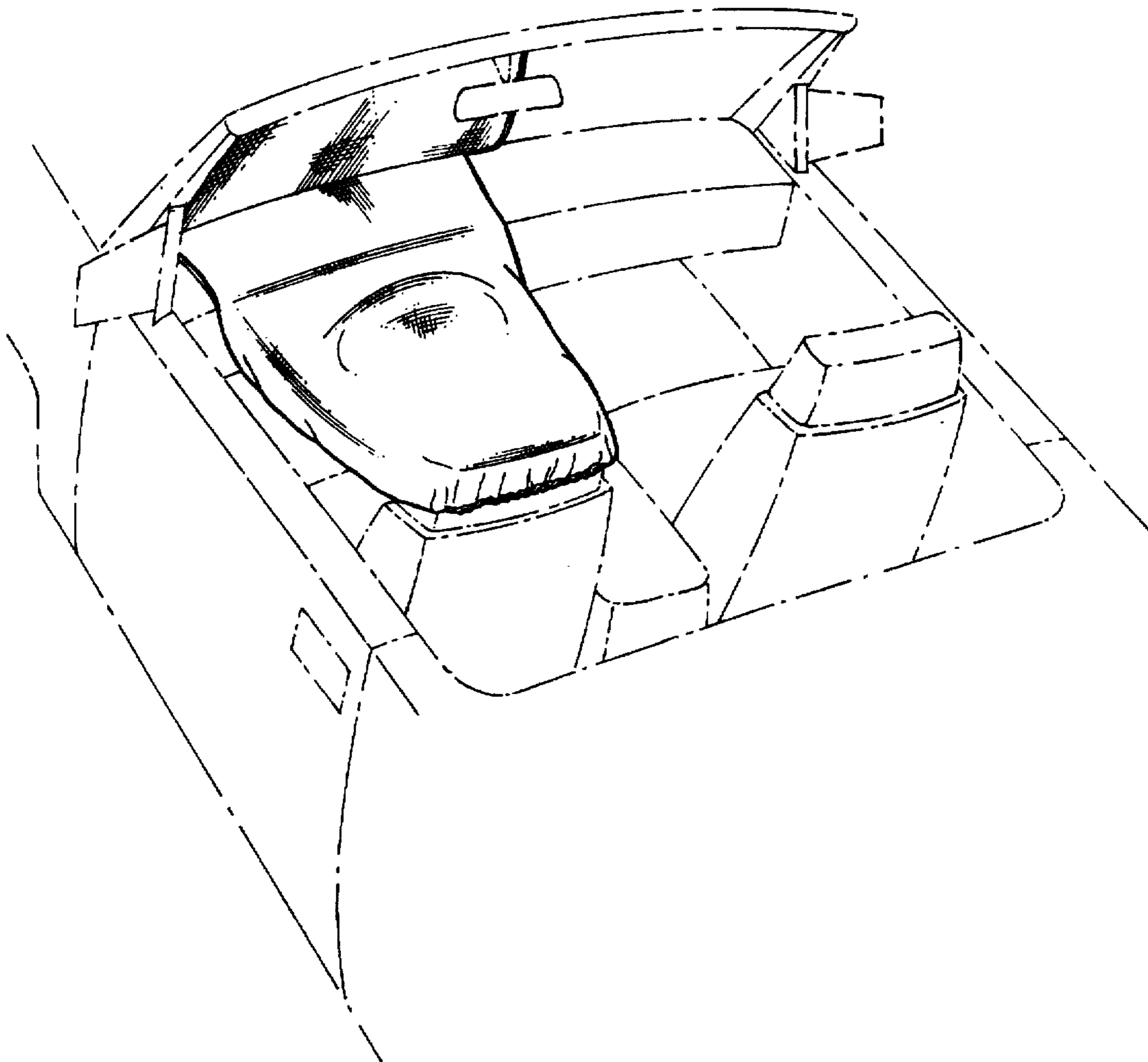
FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking at the top of a automobile sunshade showing my new design thereof;

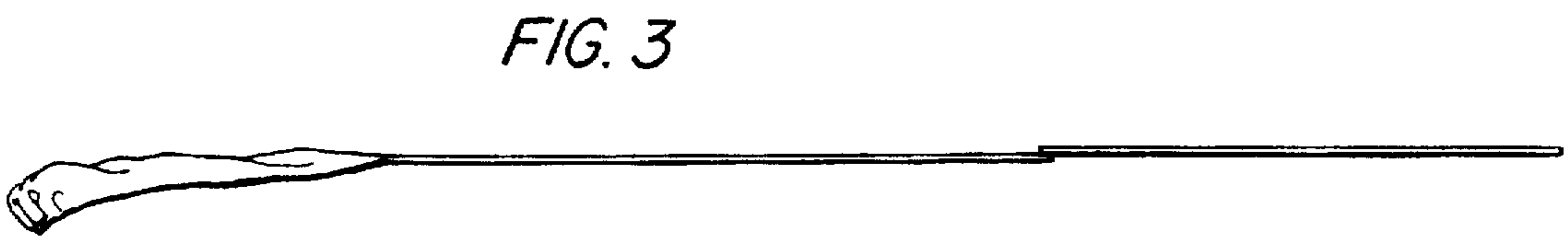
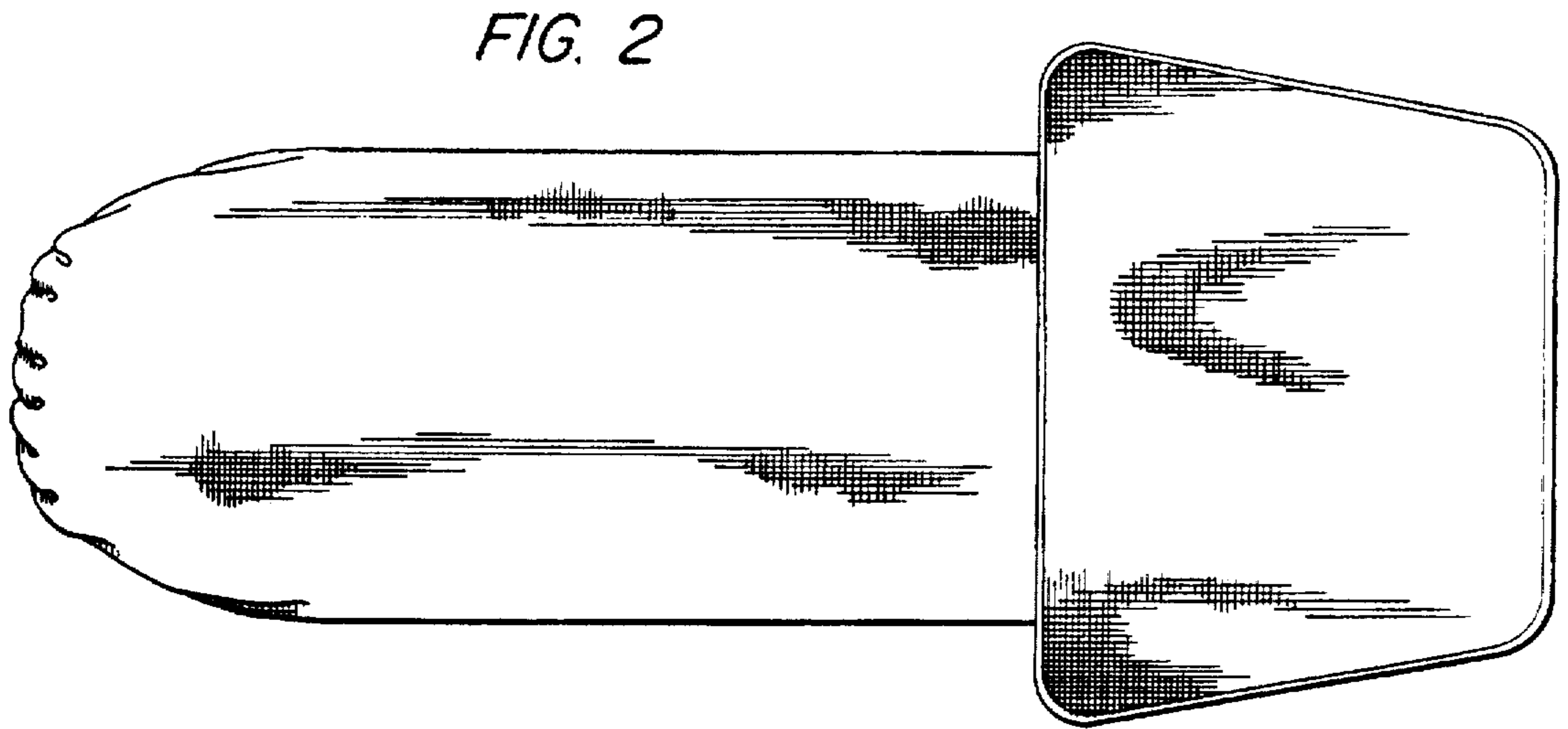
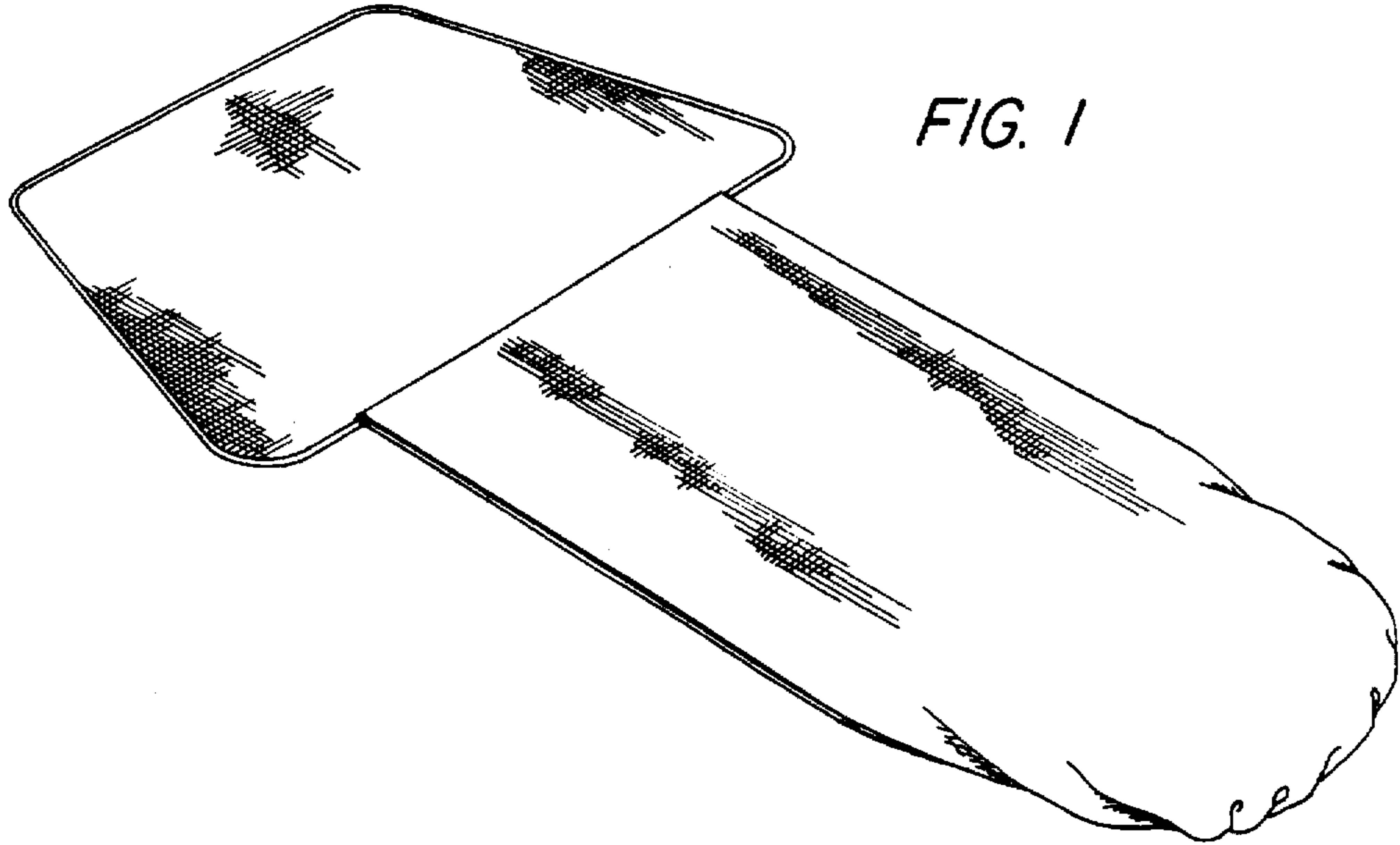

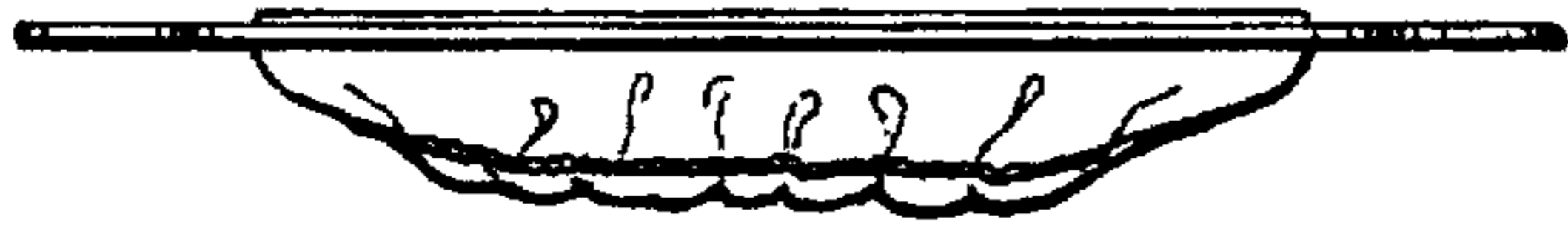
