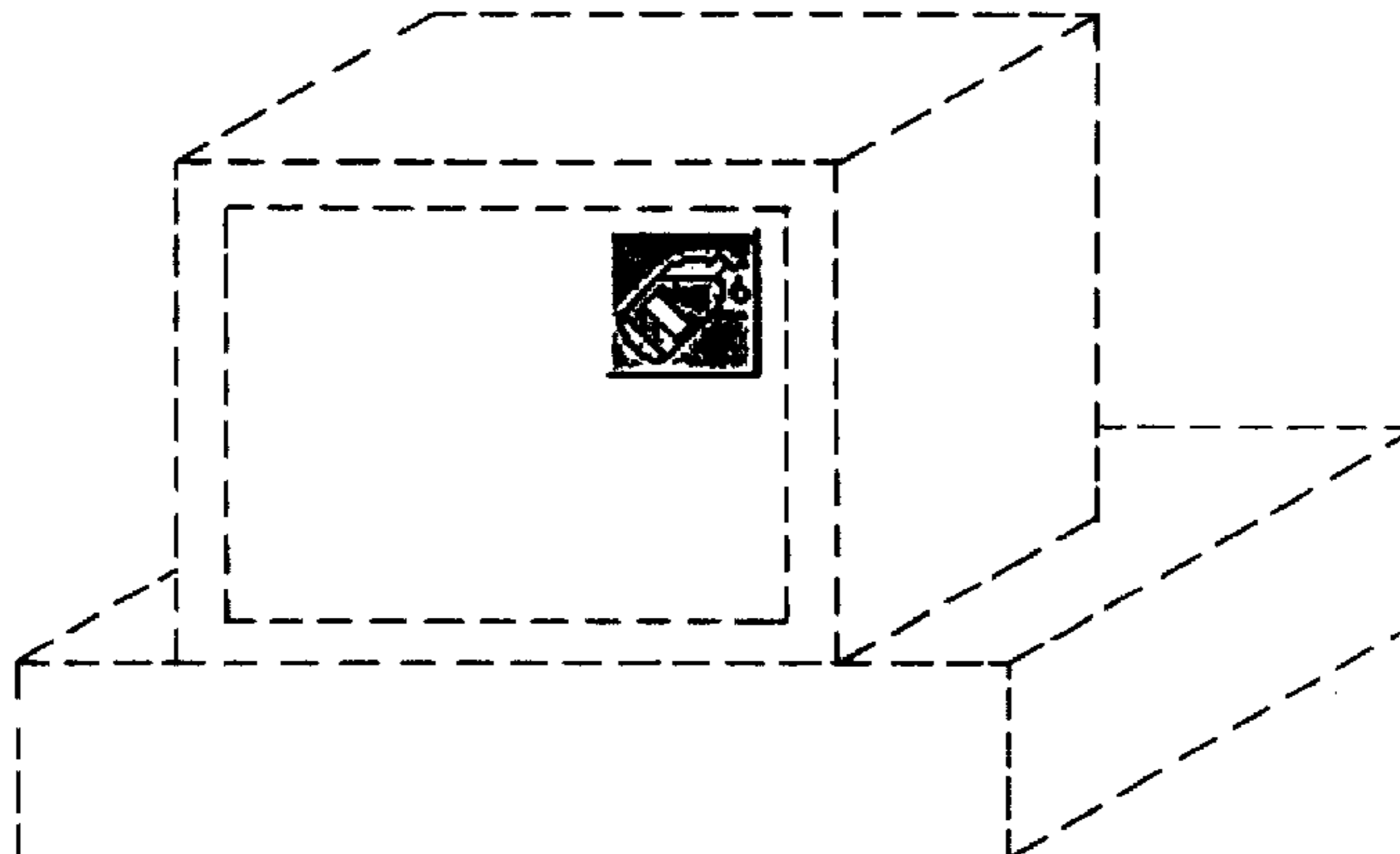
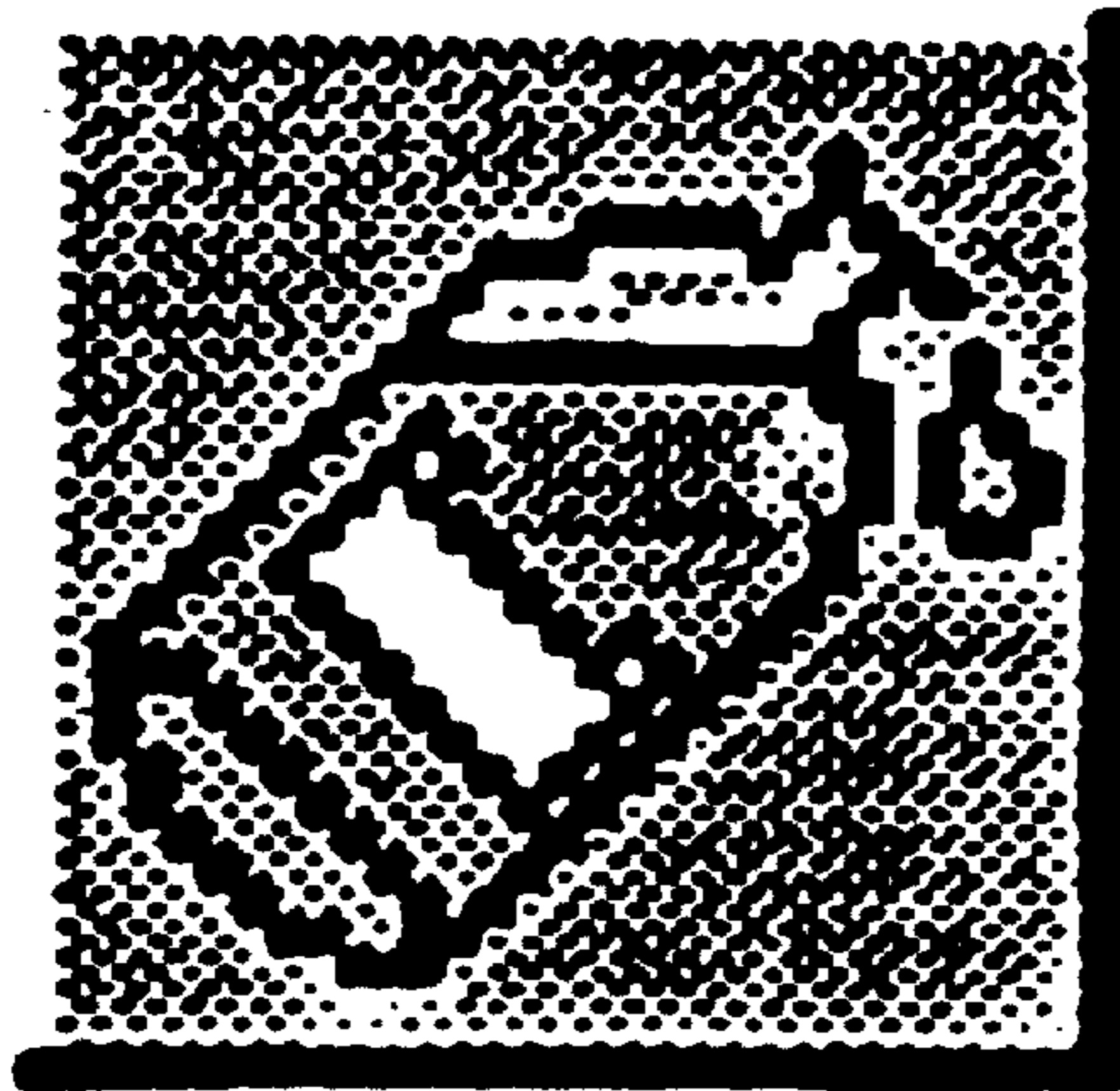
The ornamental design for a icon for a display screen, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

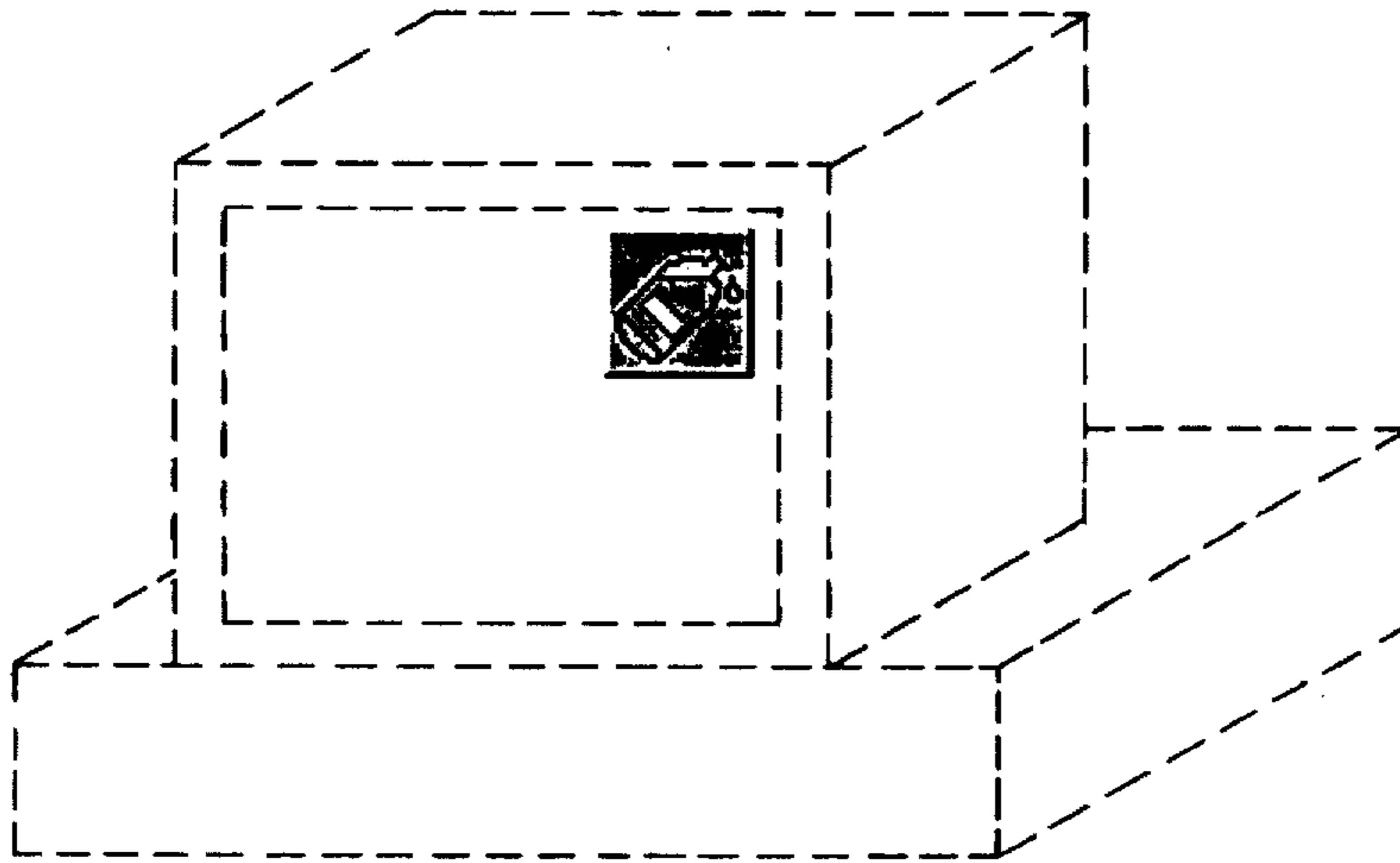
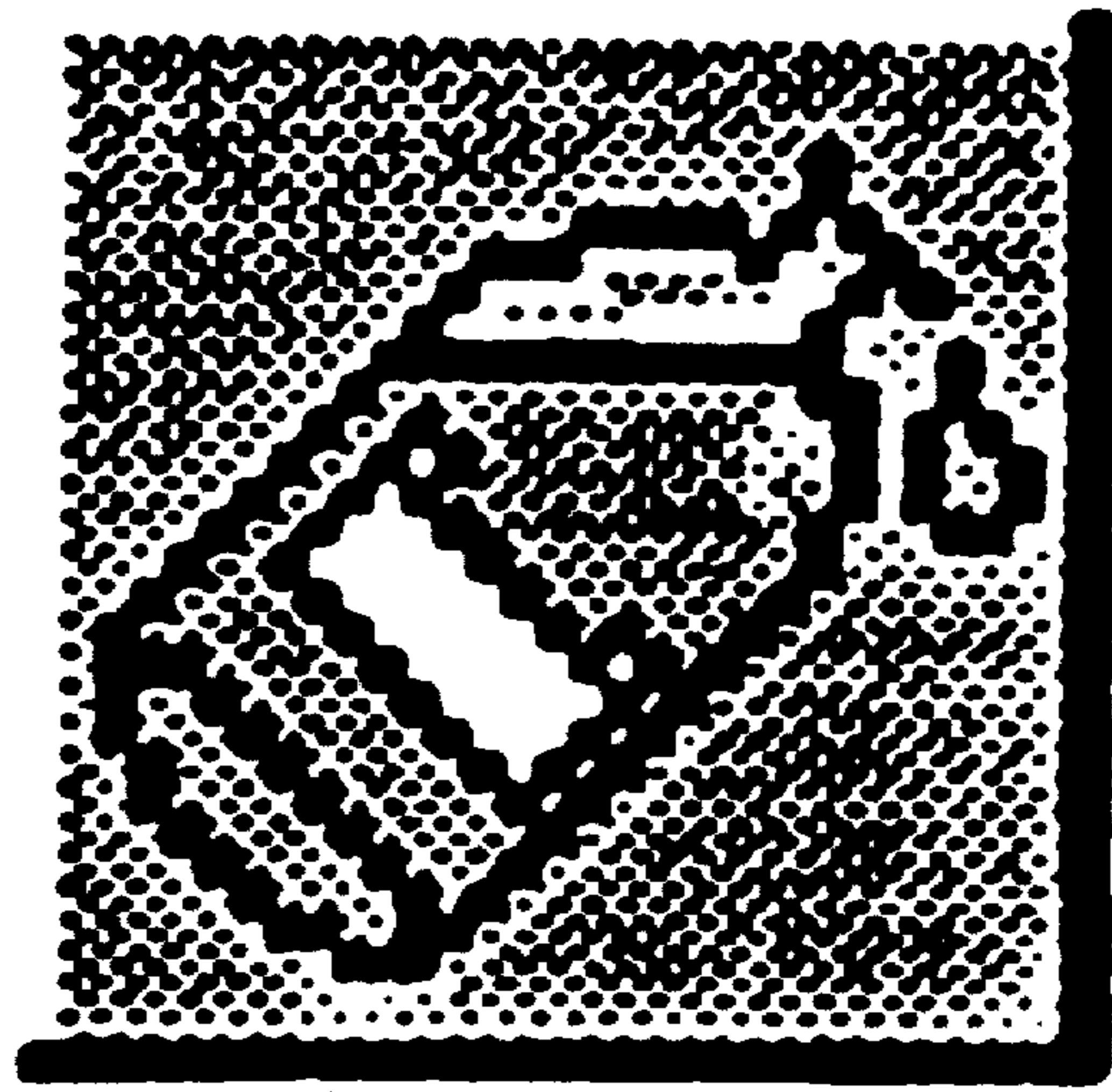
FIG. 1 is a front view of an icon for a display screen showing my new design, on an enlarged scale, the icon is shown separately for clarity of illustration;
