The ornamental design for a chess set, as shown.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 30 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 31 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 32 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;


FIG. 33 is a front elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 34 is a rear elevational view thereof.





































