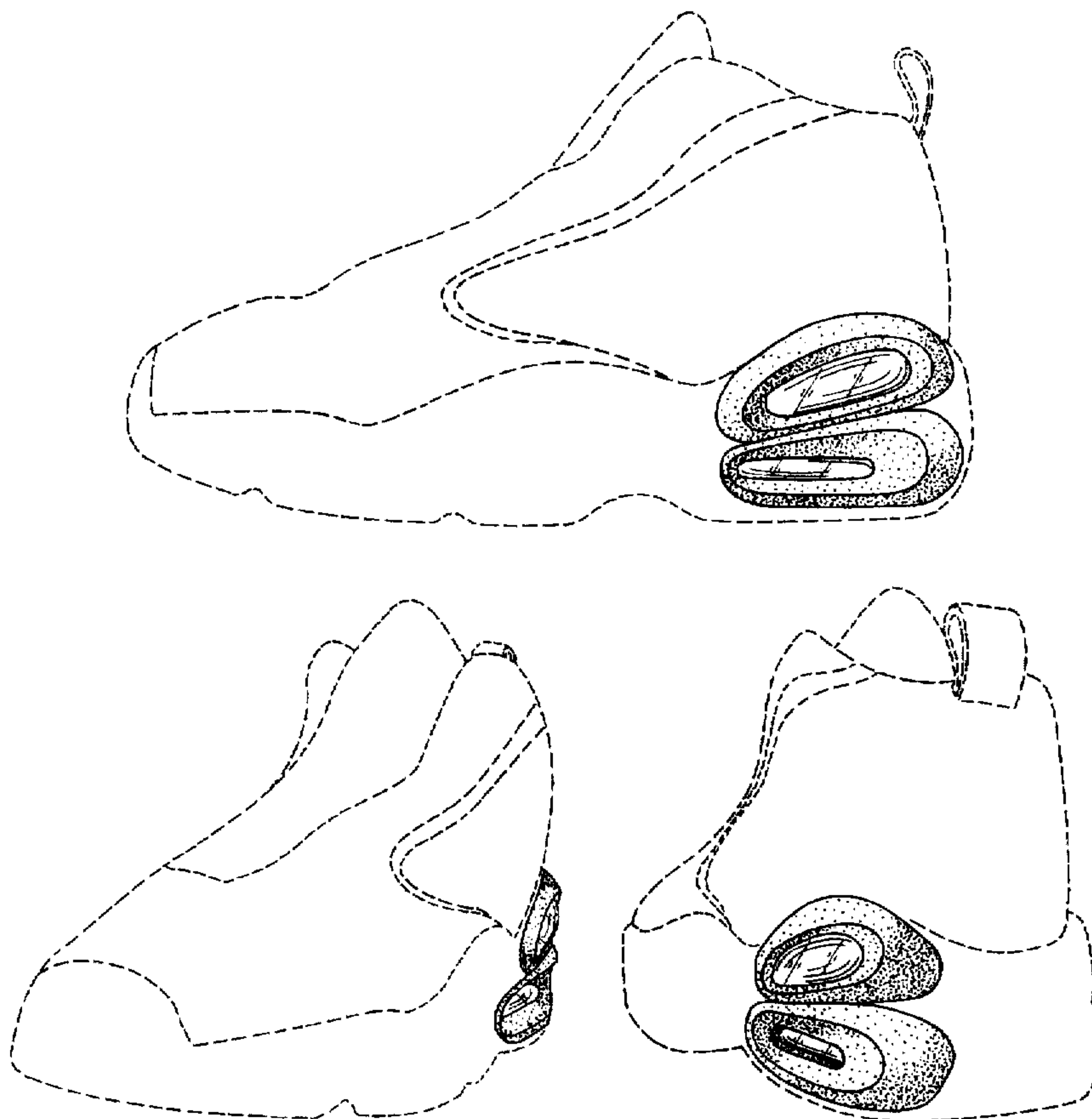
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an element of a shoe sole, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an element of a shoe sole showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.  
 The broken line showing of a shoe upper and the remaining portion of the sole in FIGS. 1-4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

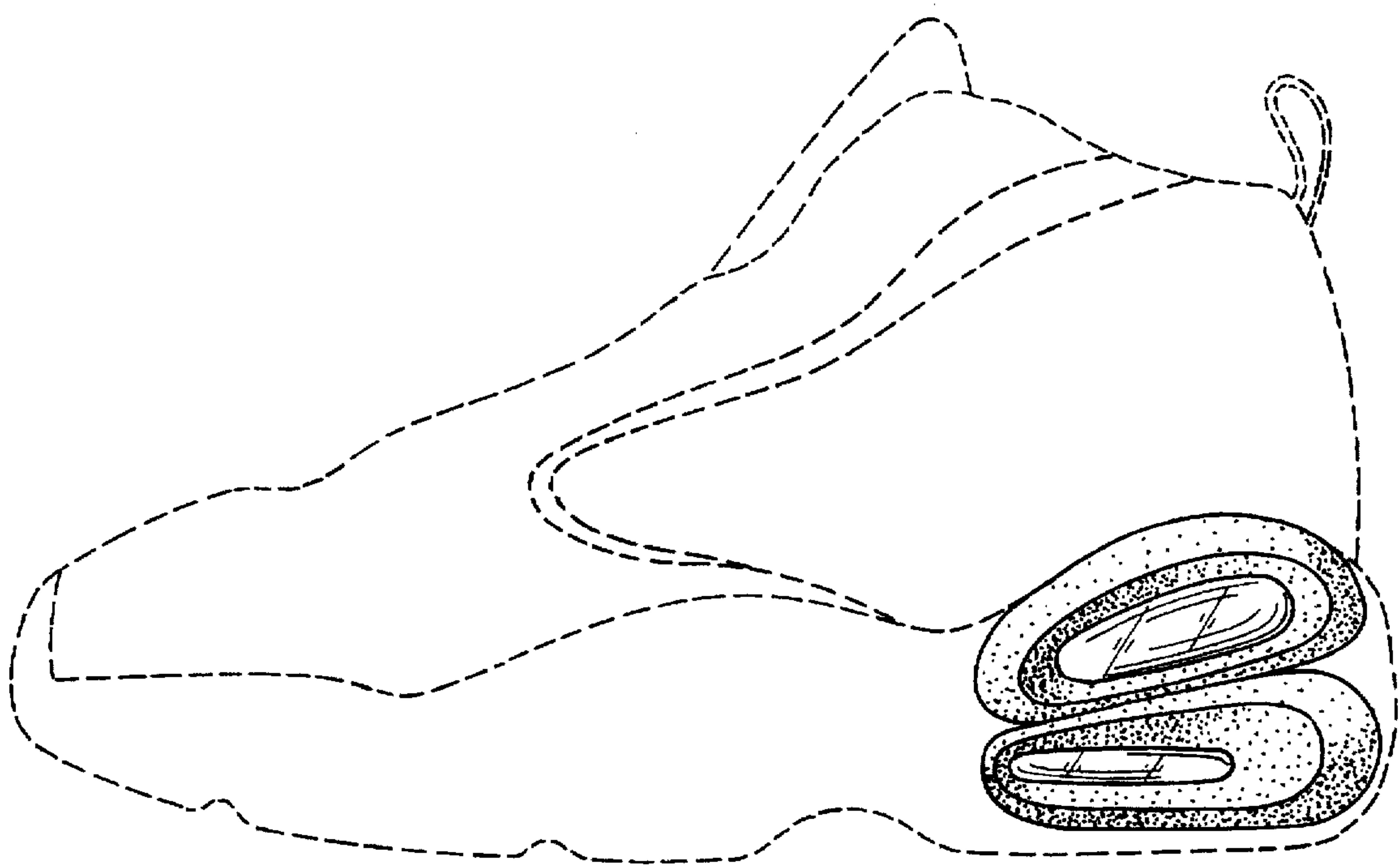

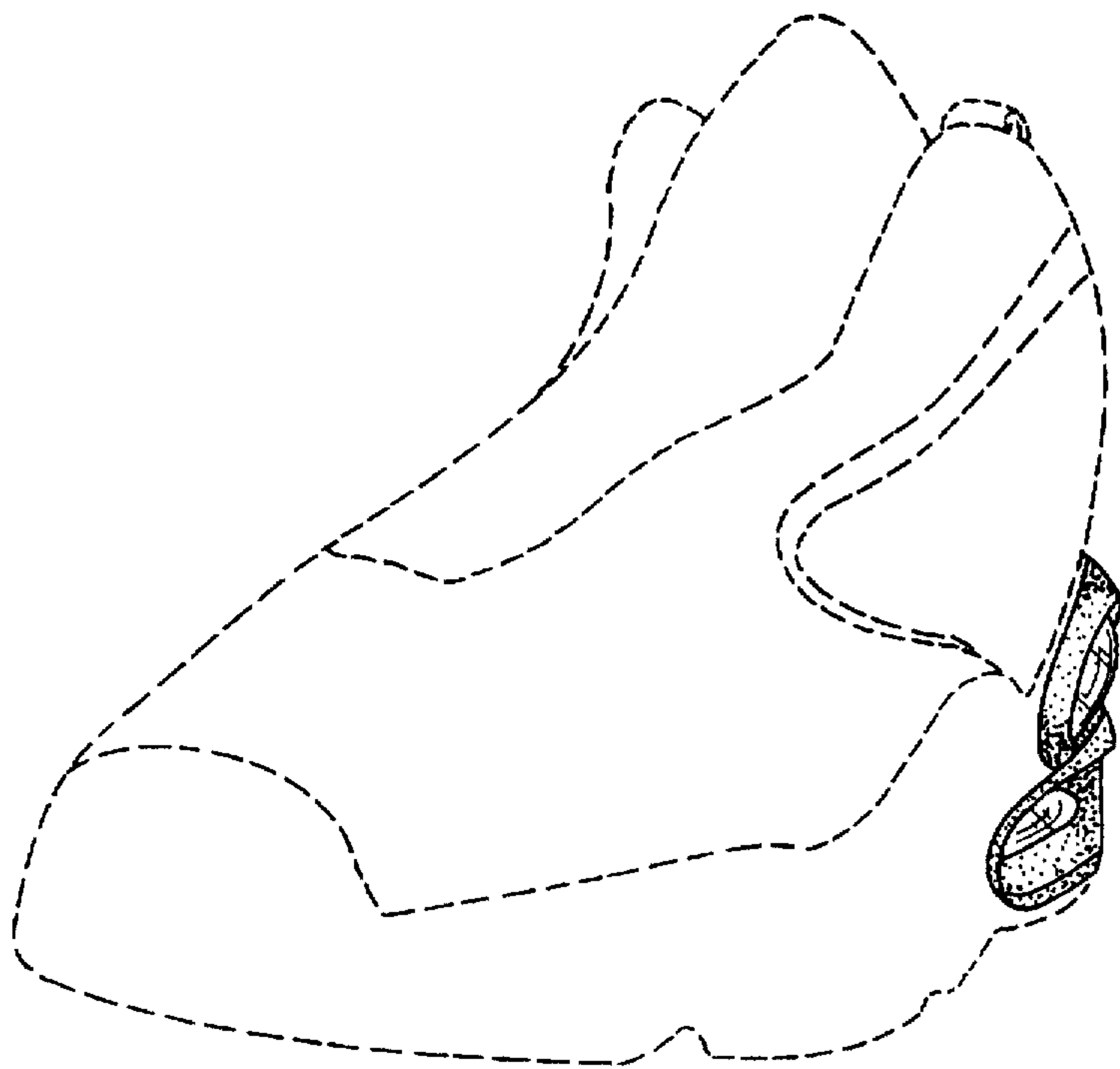
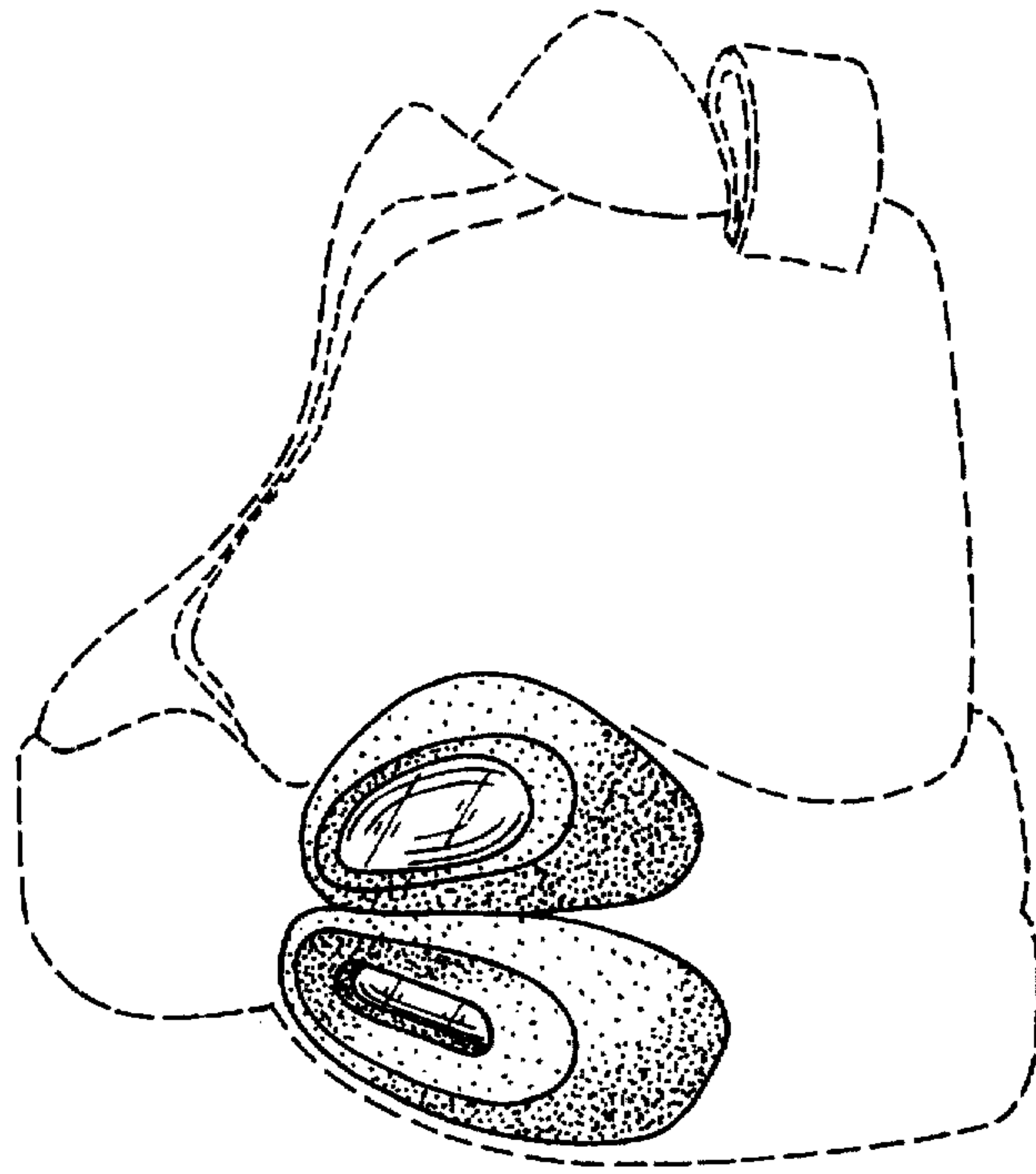
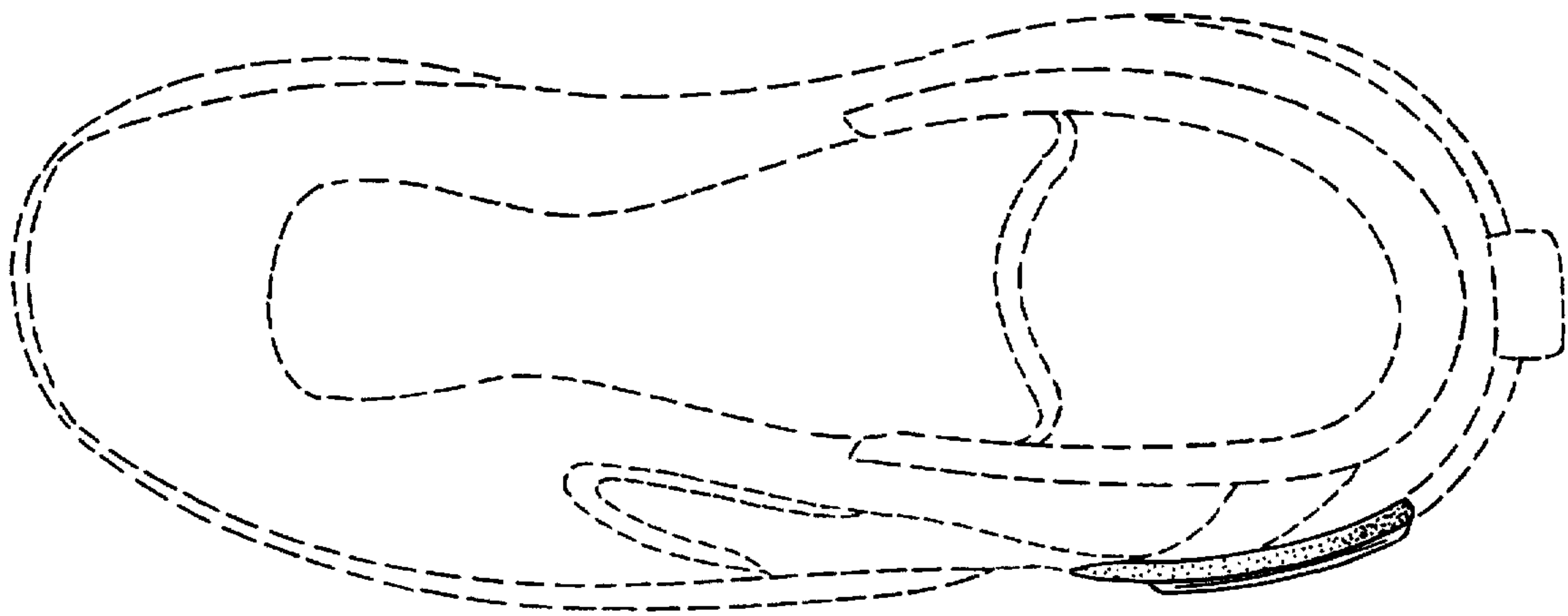
