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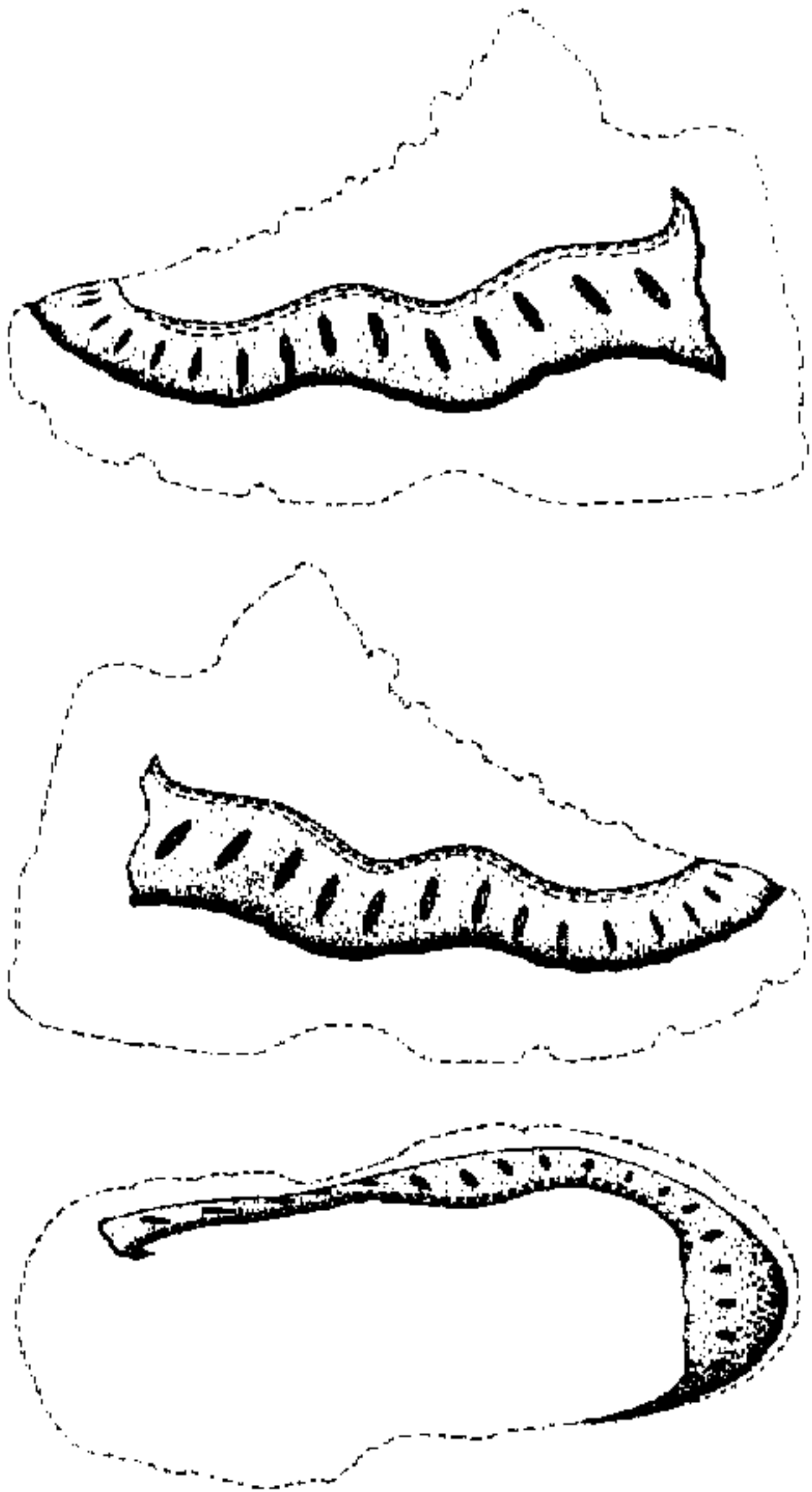

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a portion of a shoe upper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a frontal perspective view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the portion of a shoe upper shown in FIG. 1.

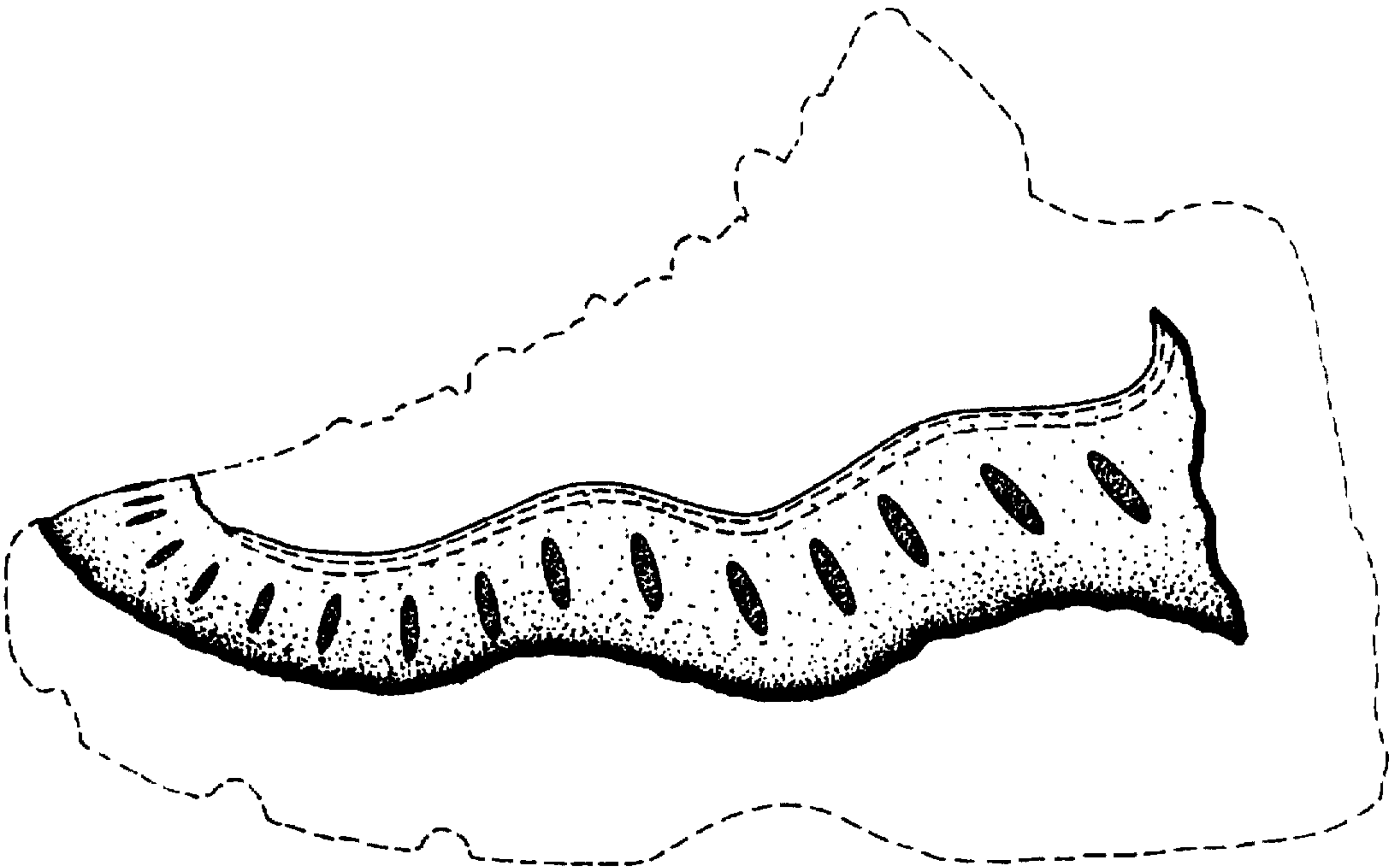

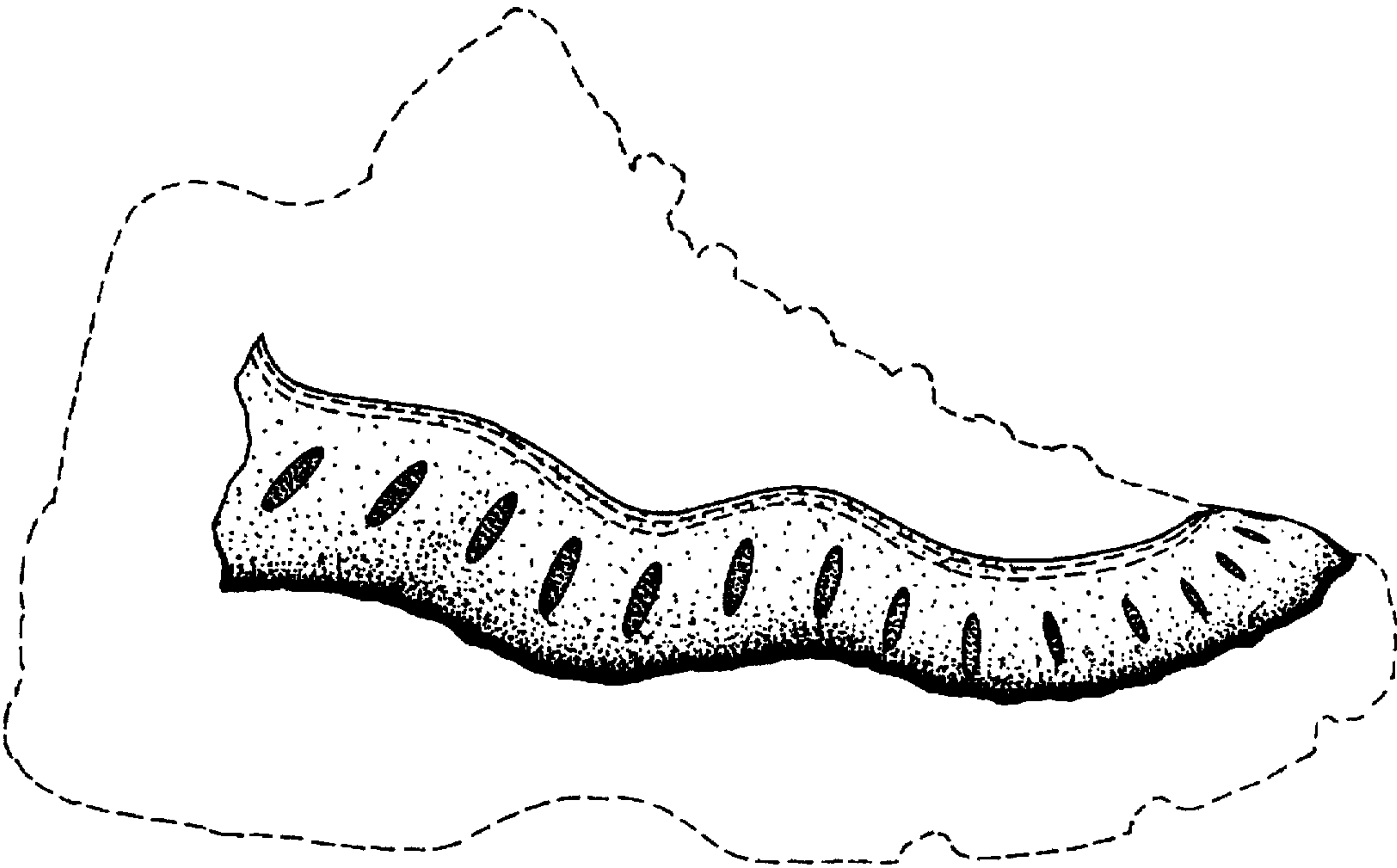

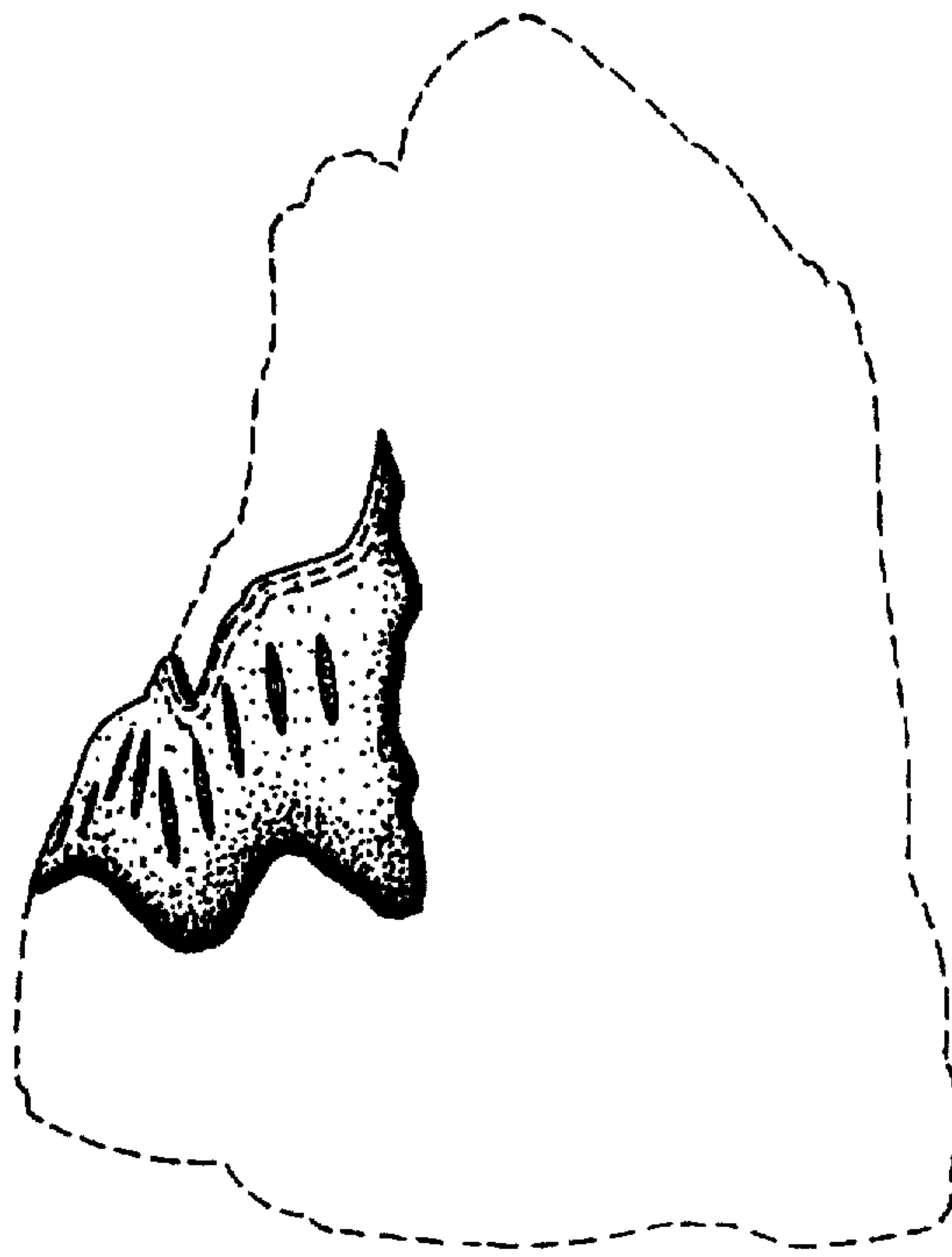

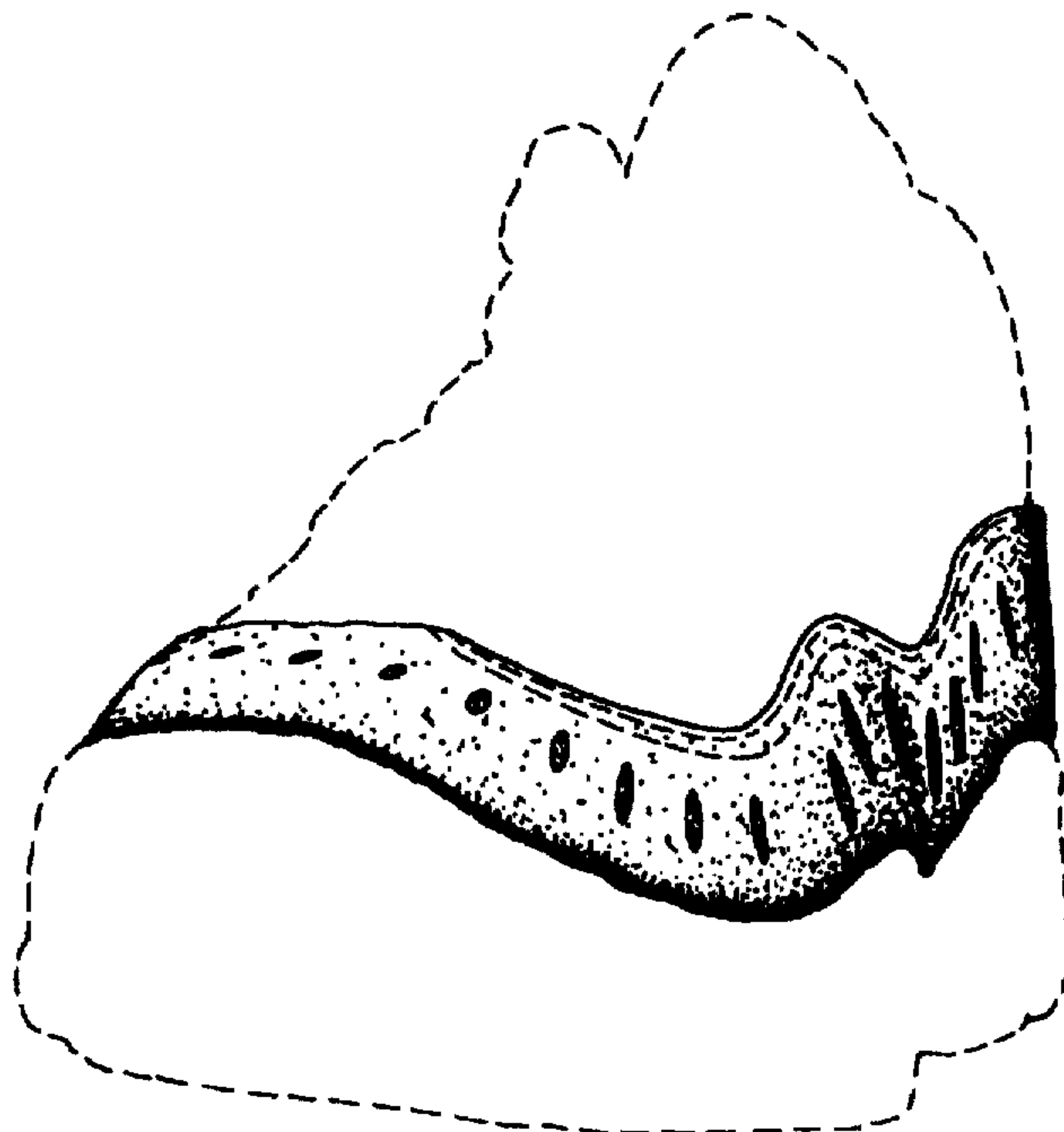

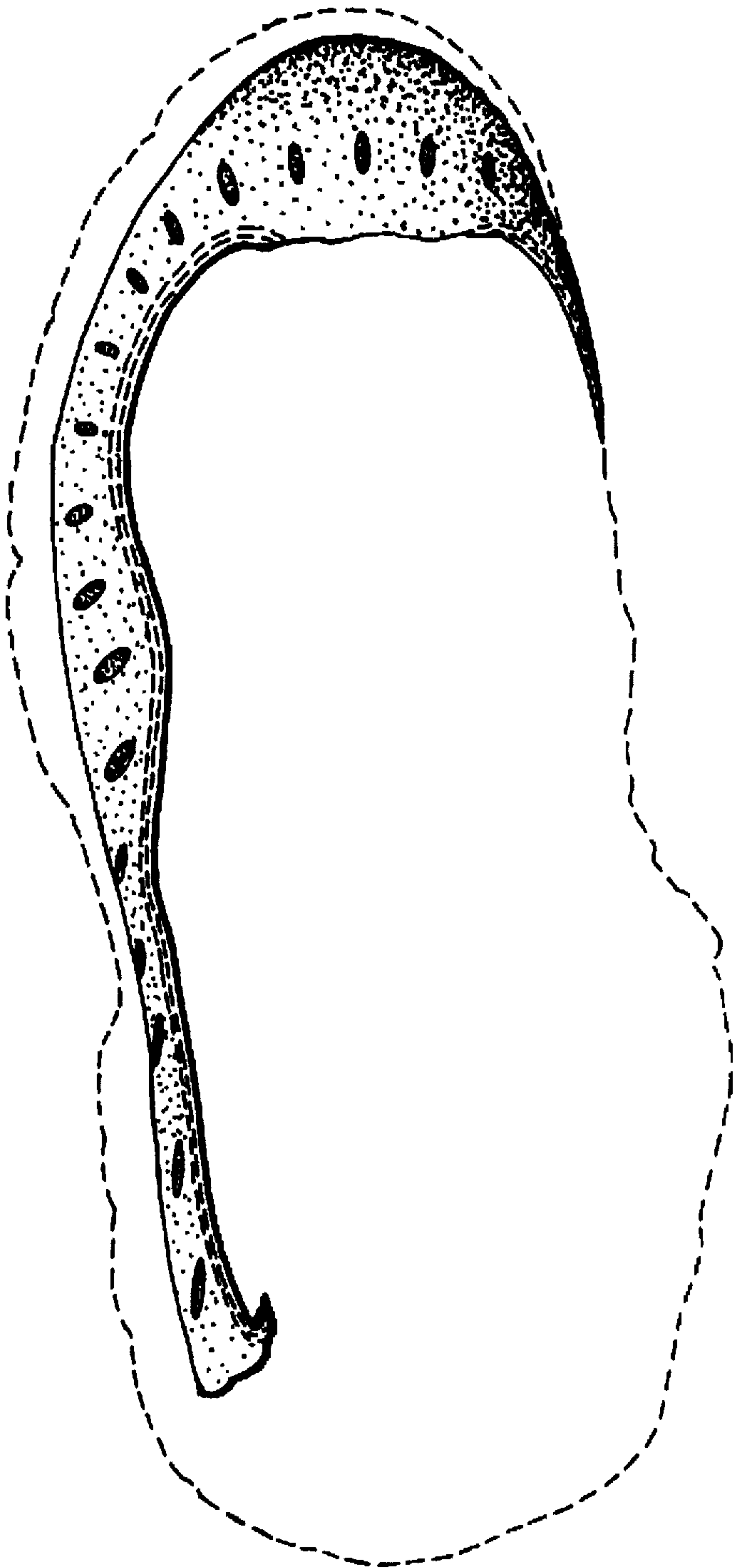
