[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cushion for a household pet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

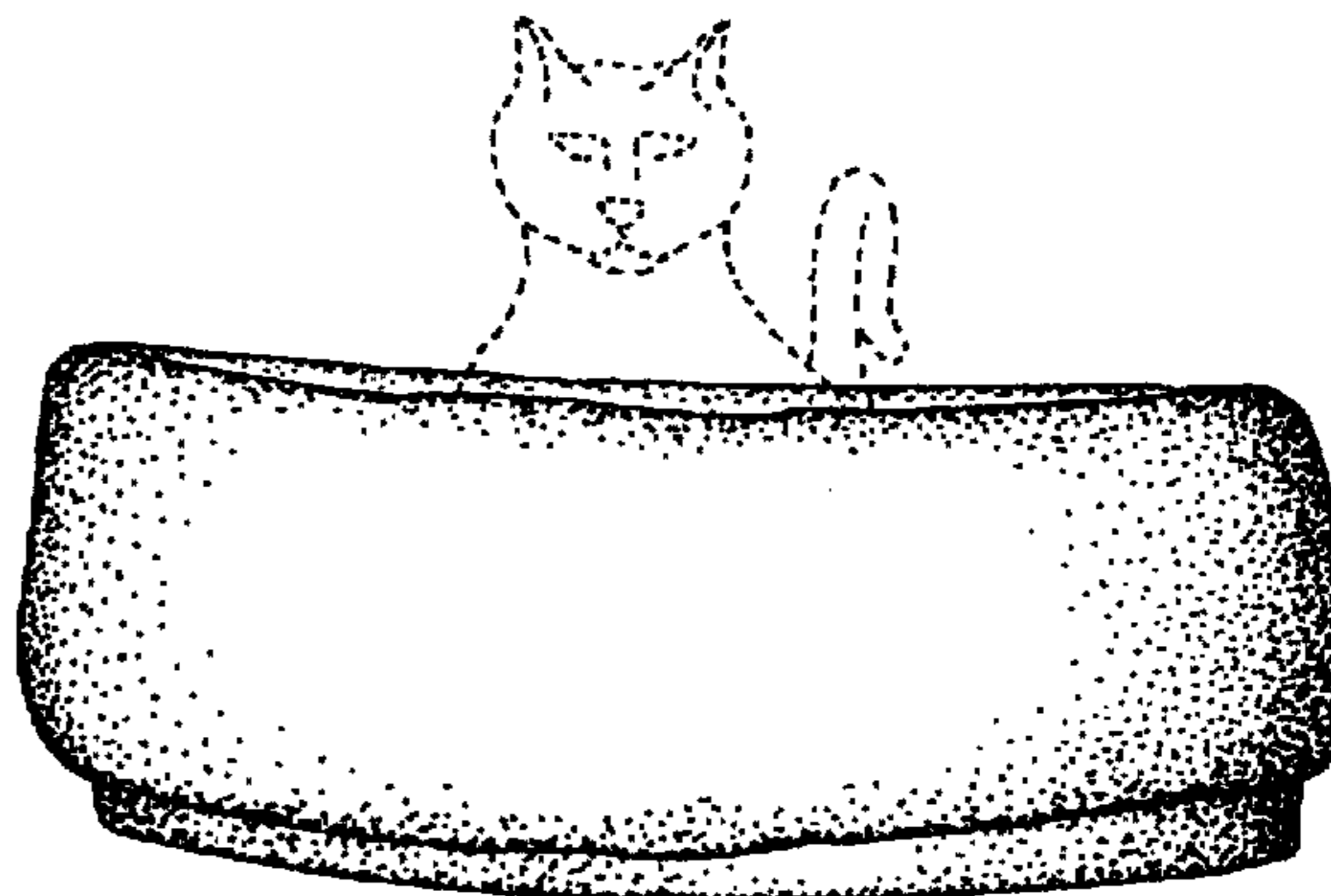
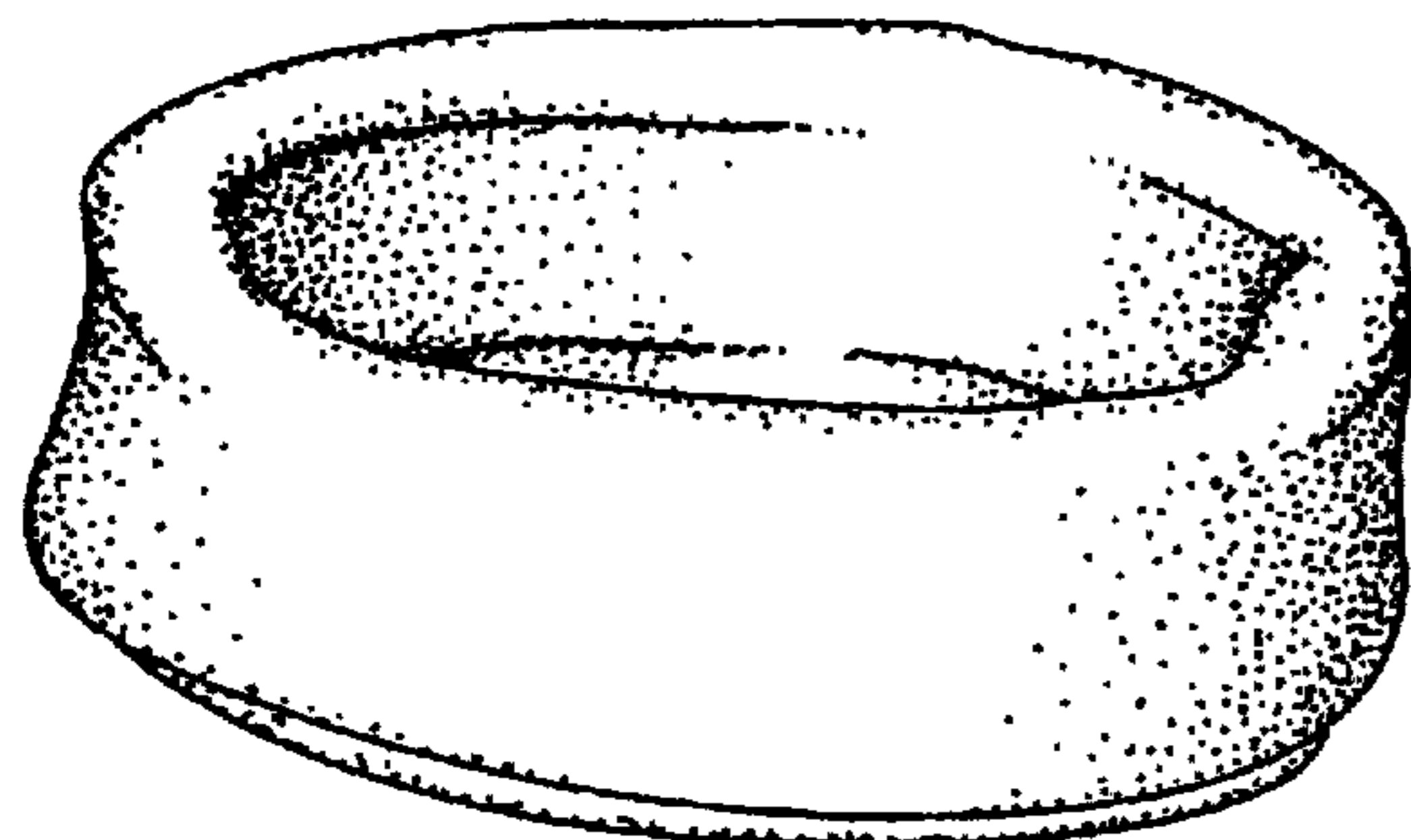

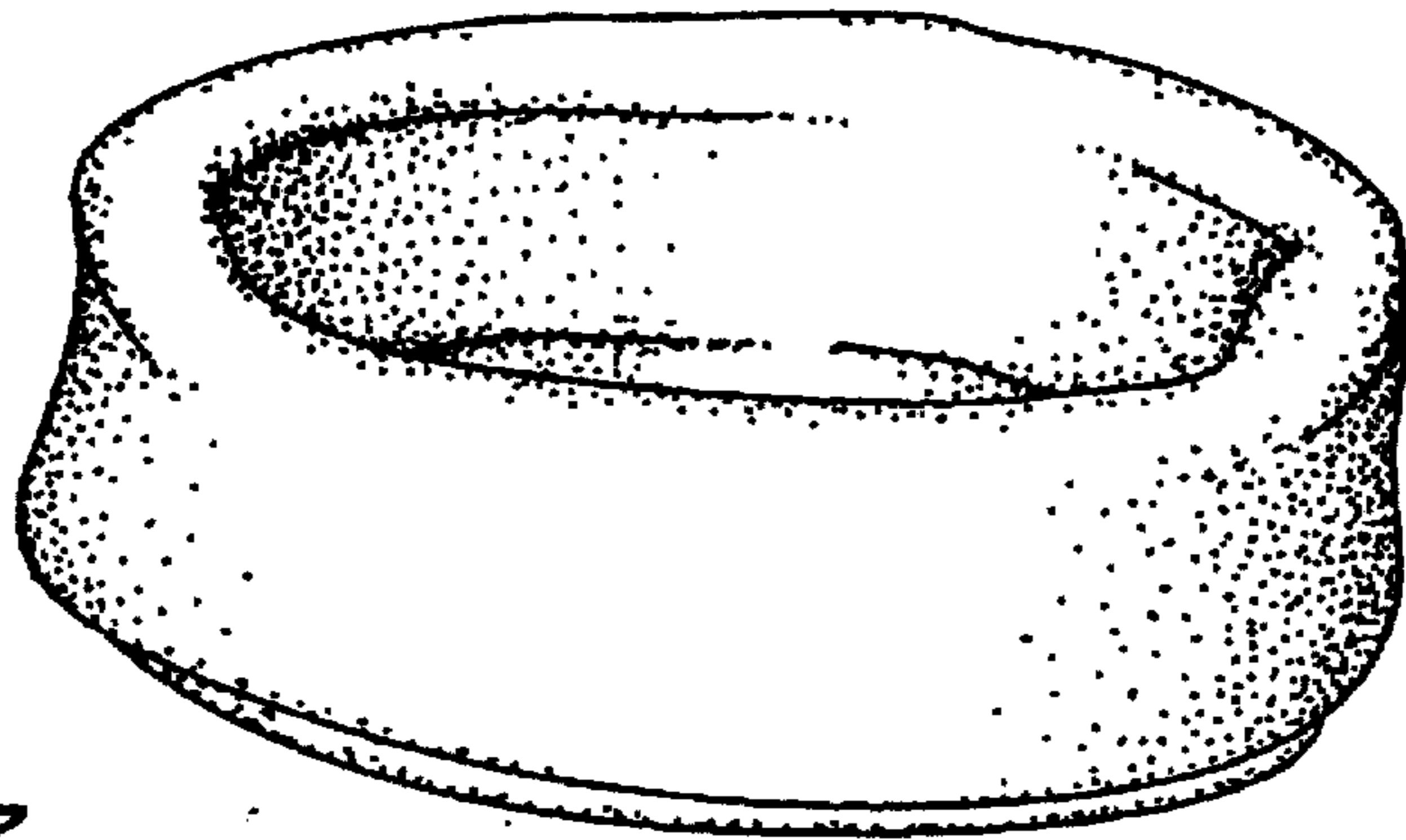

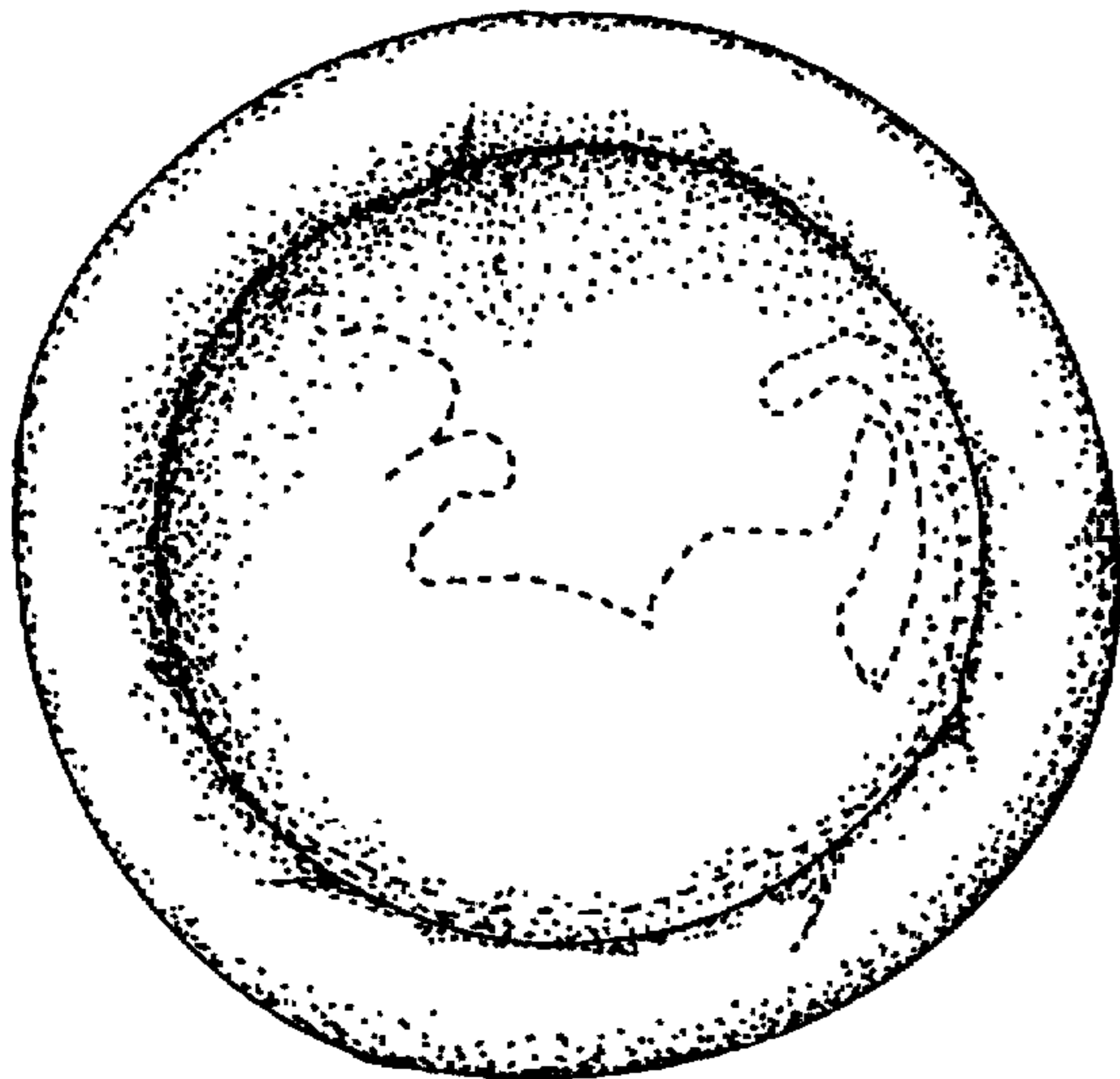

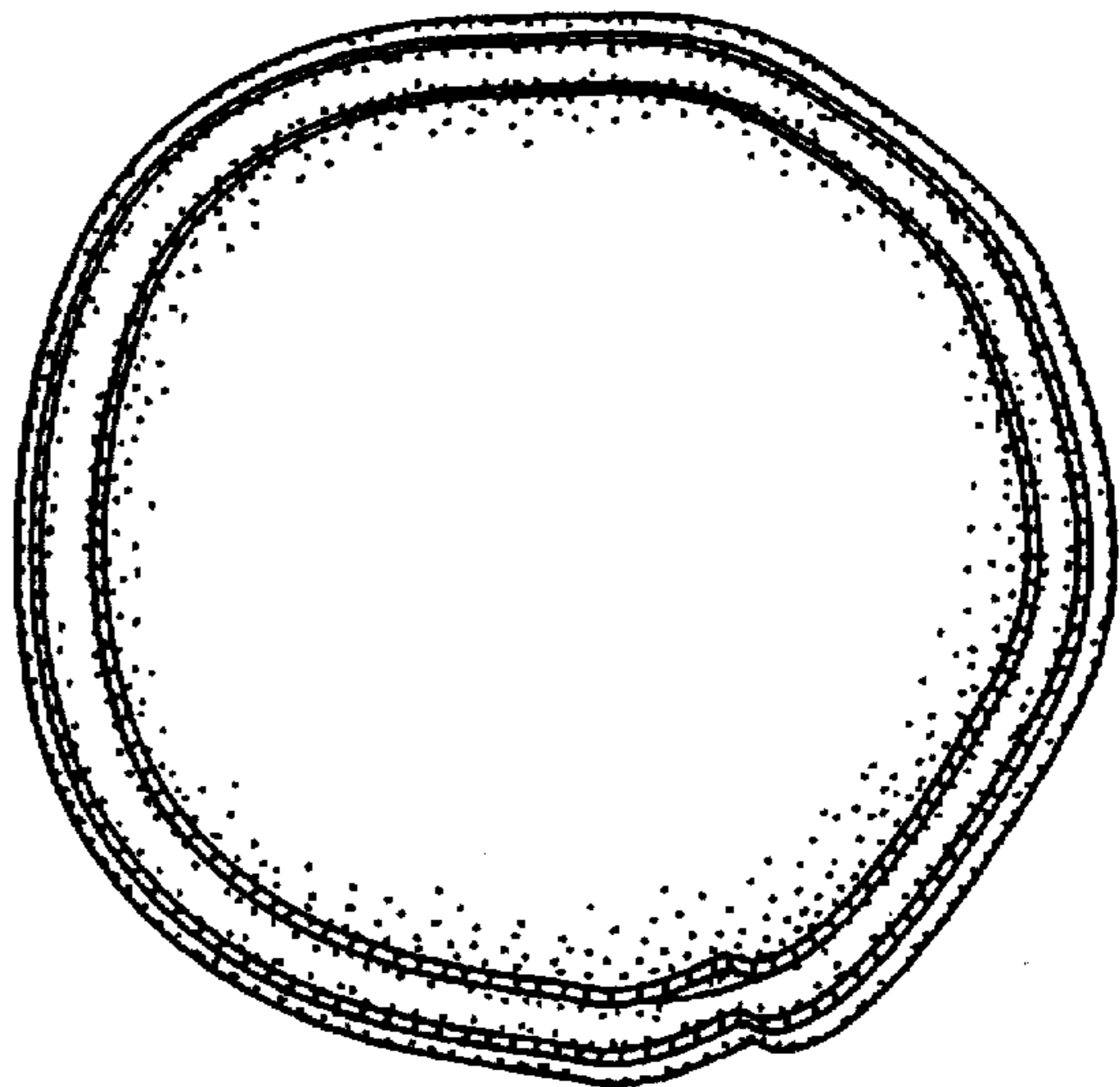
