The ornamental design for a bathtub liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and side perspective view of a bathtub liner, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

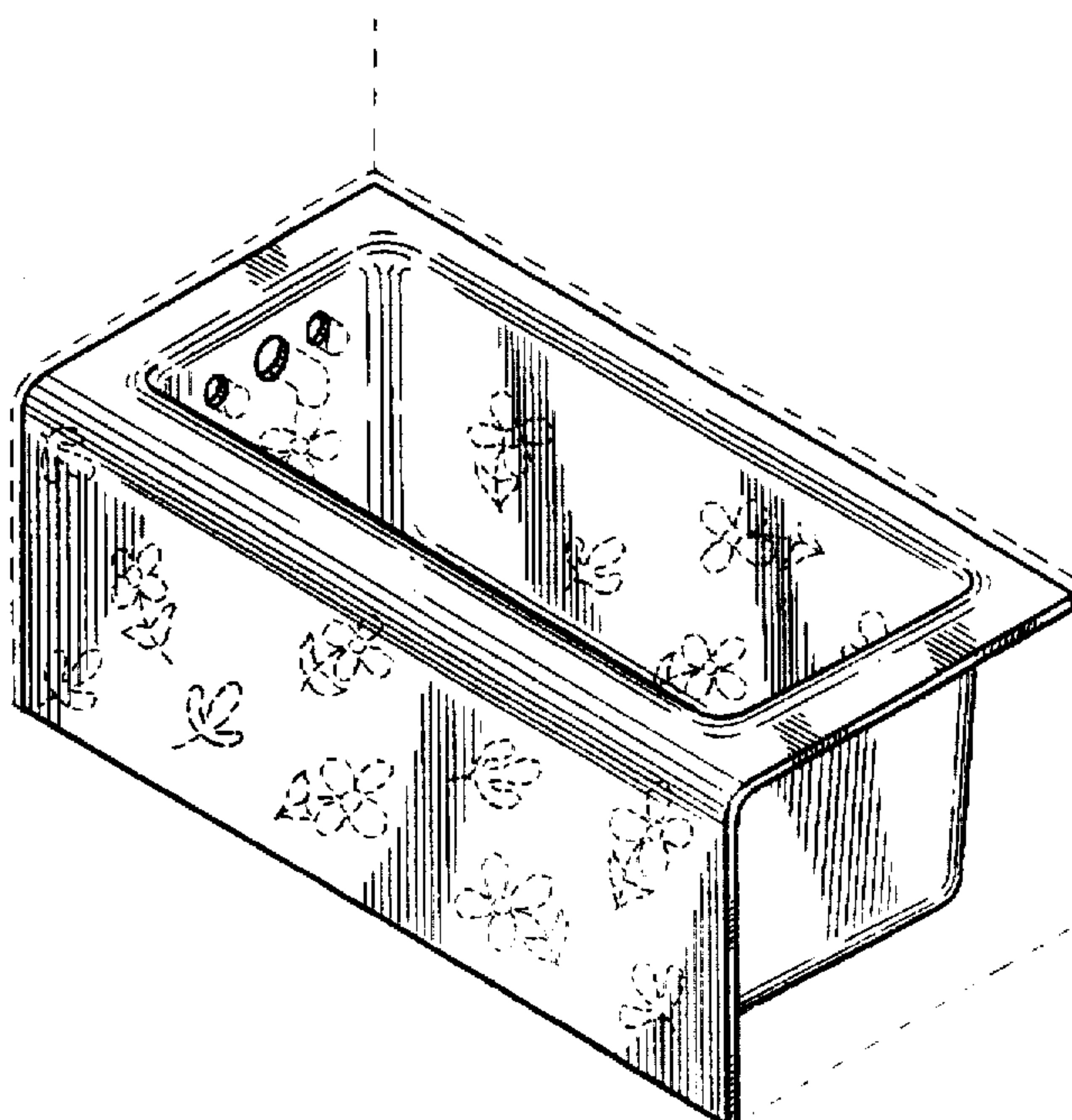
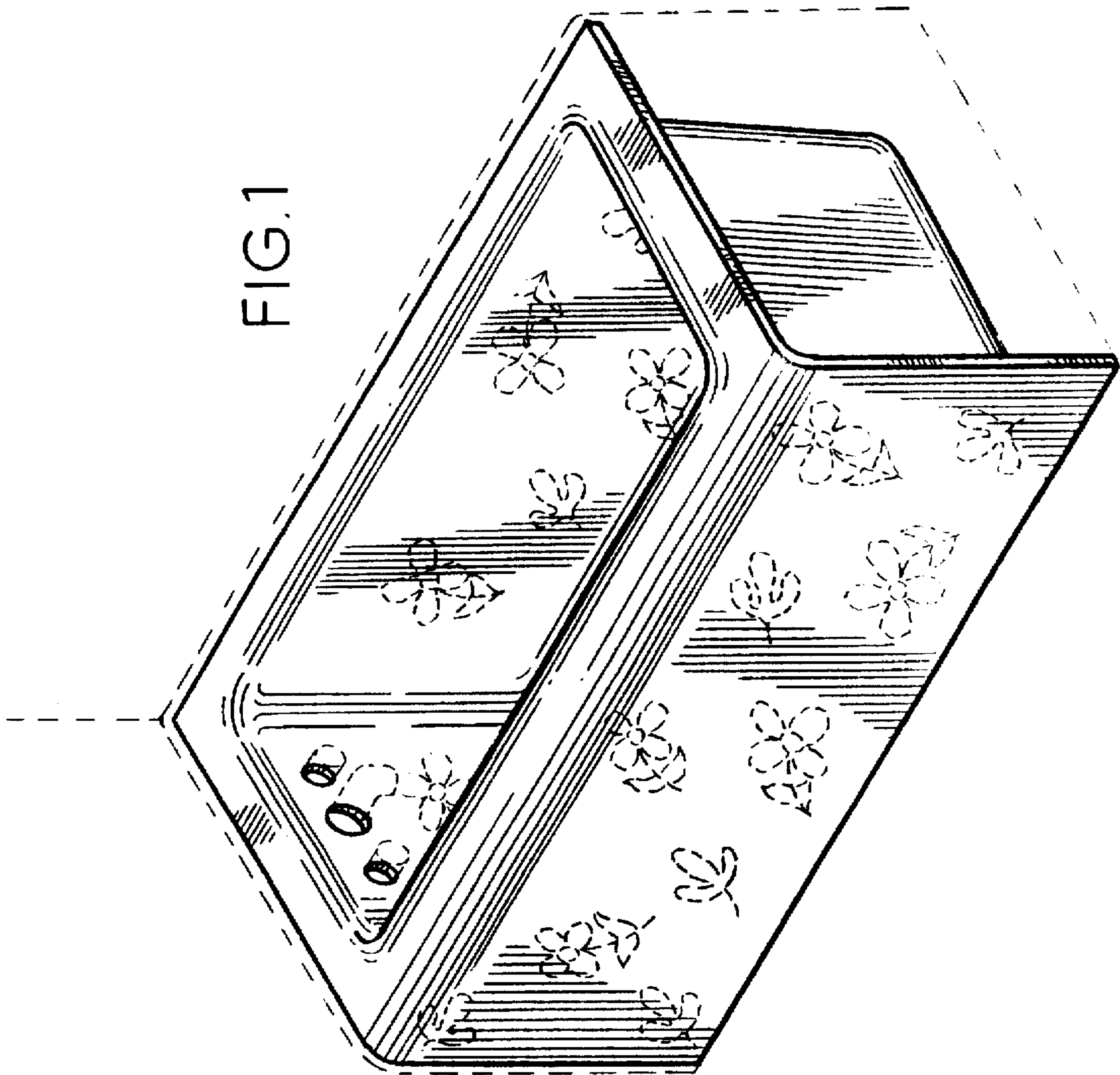

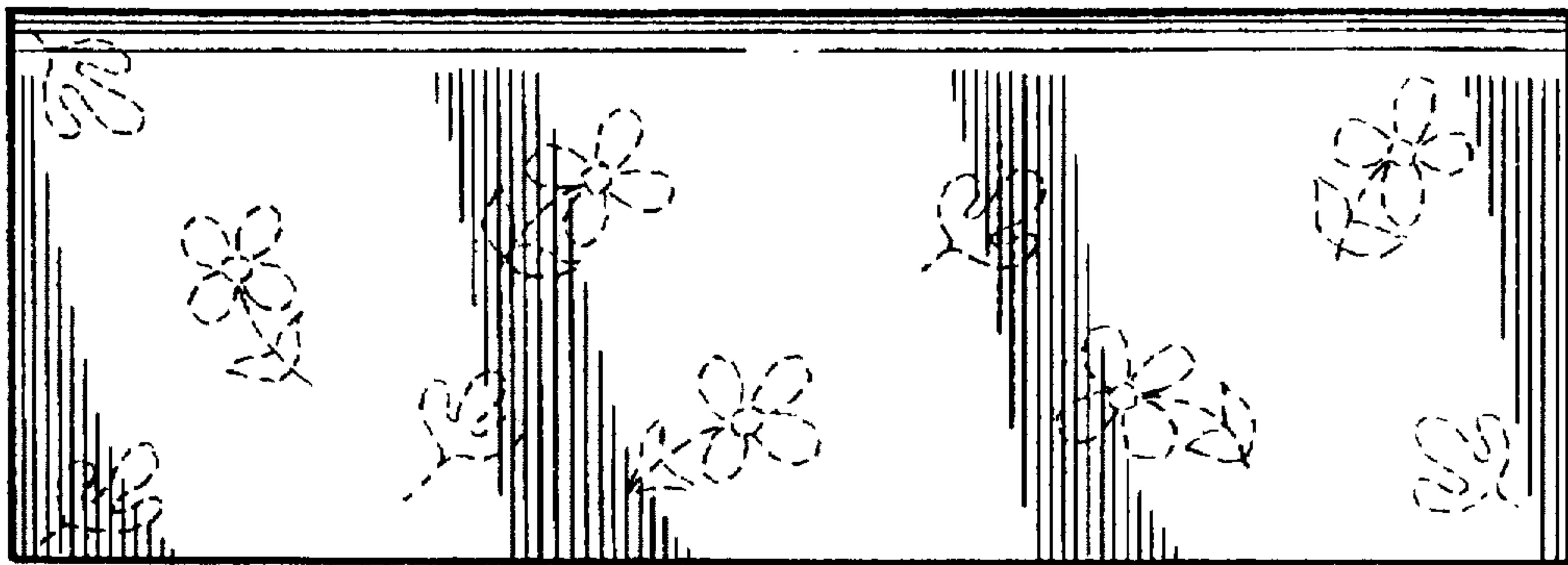

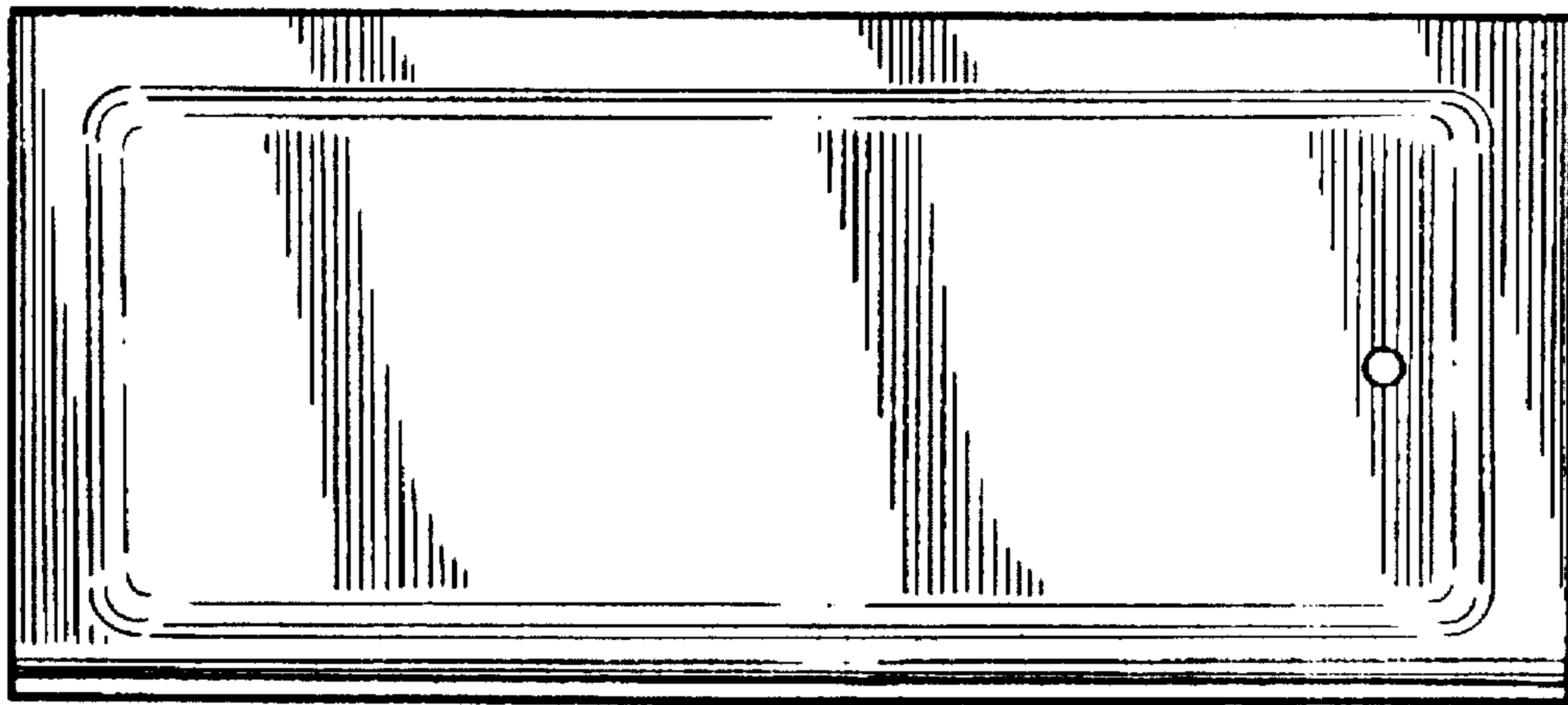

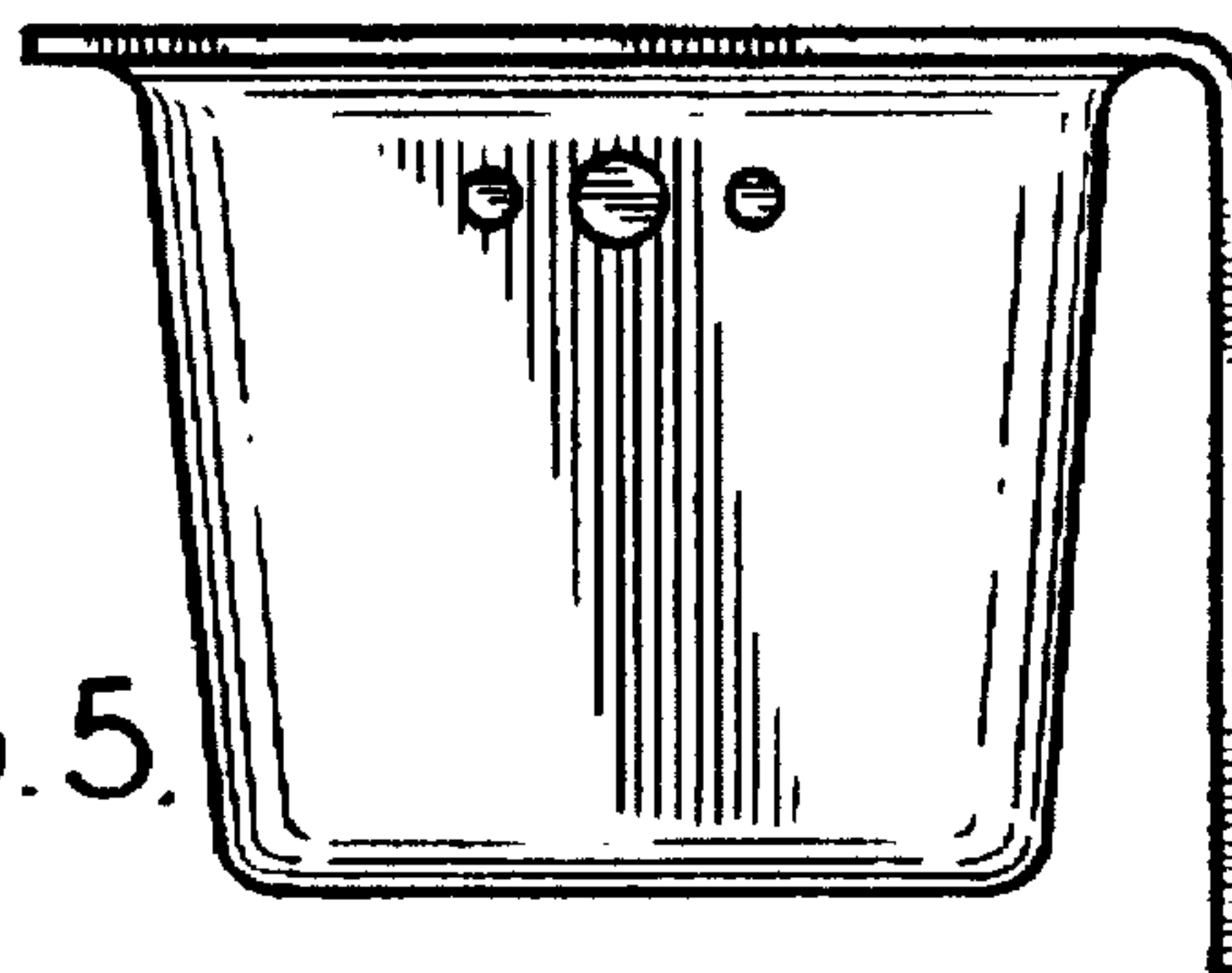

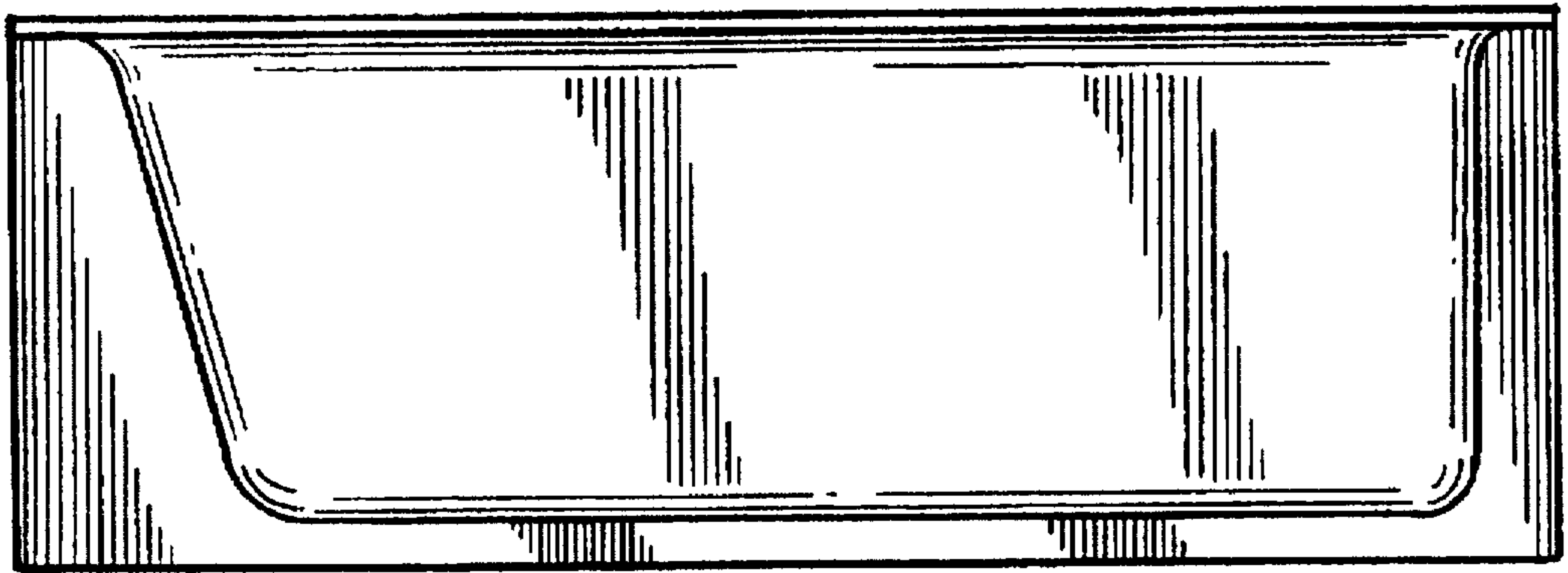

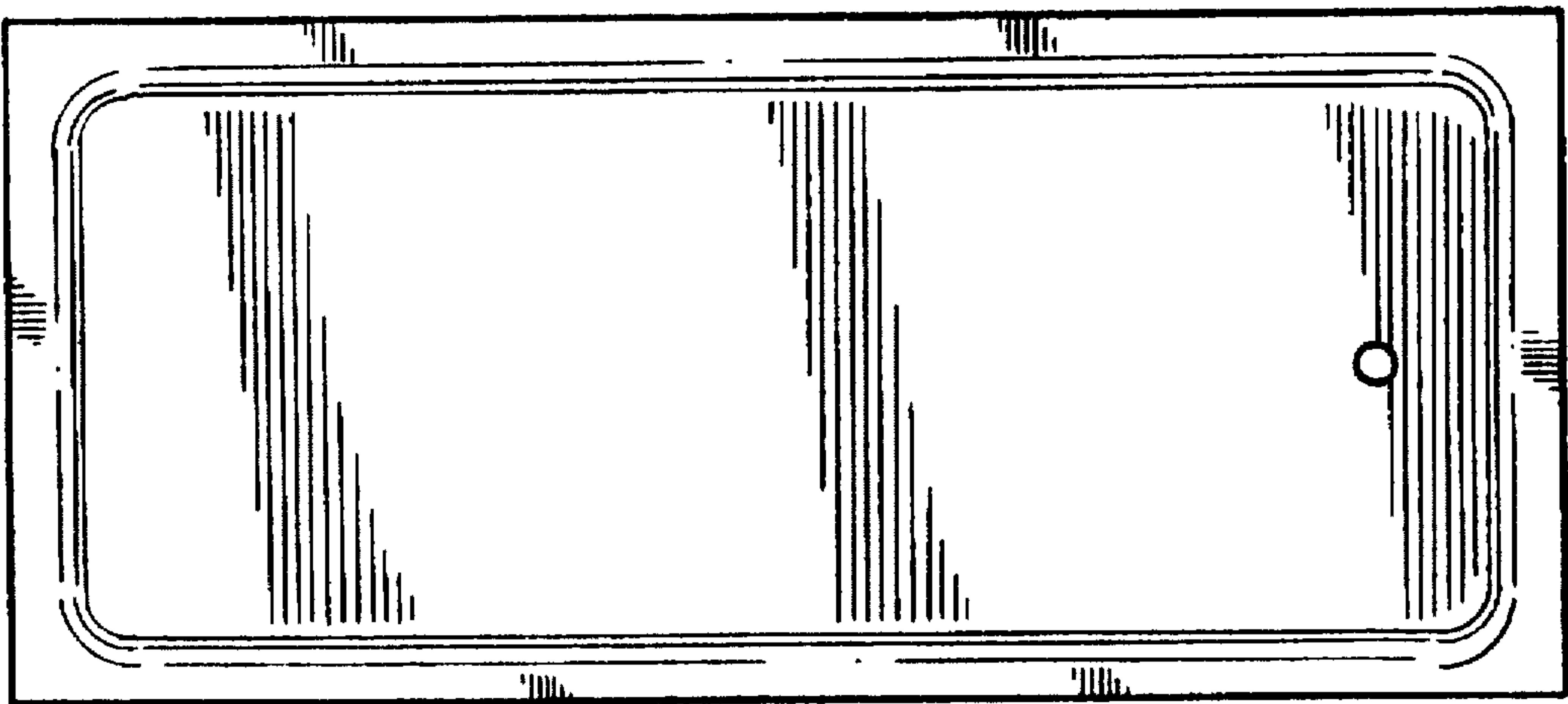
