The ornamental design for an inflatable shoe boat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an inflatable shoe boat showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

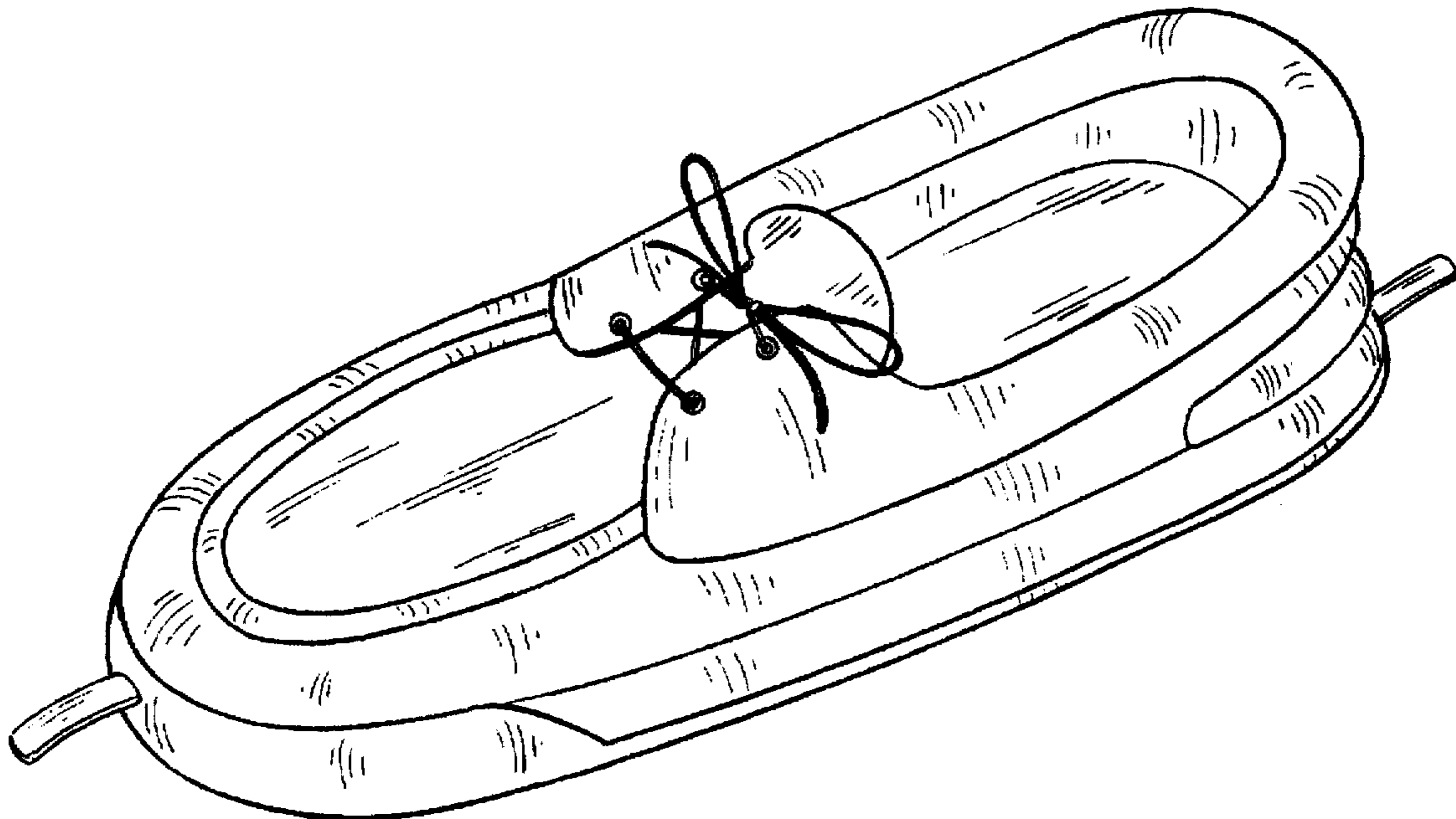
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;

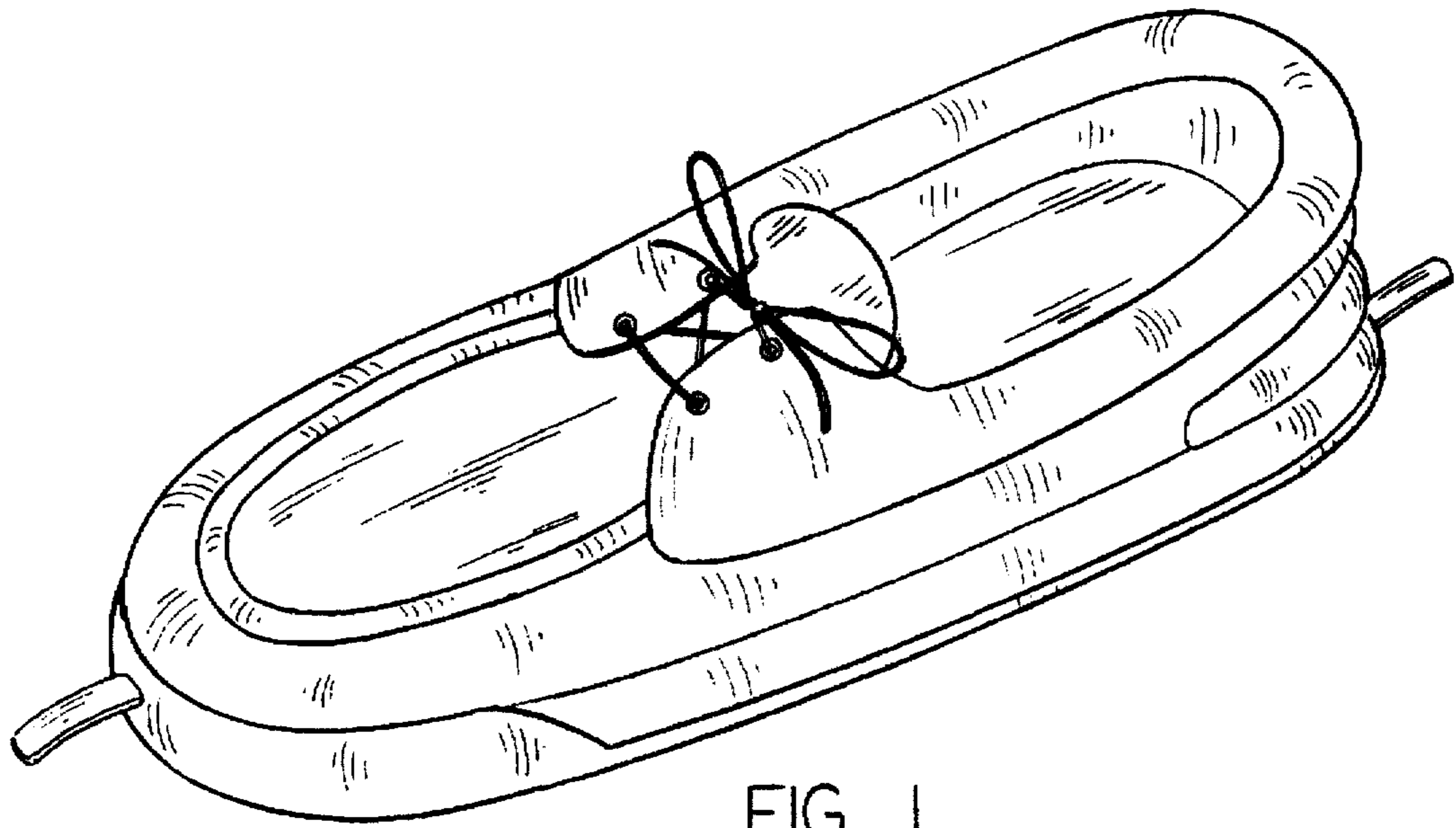

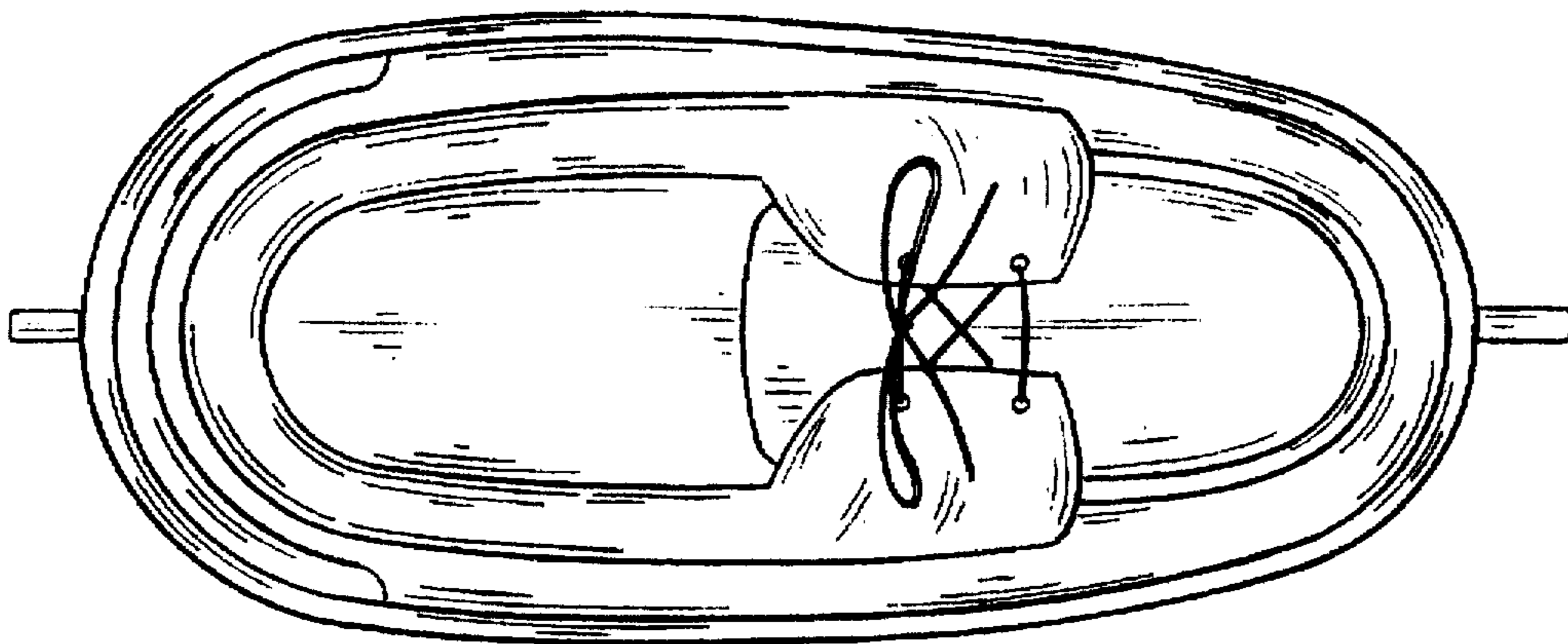

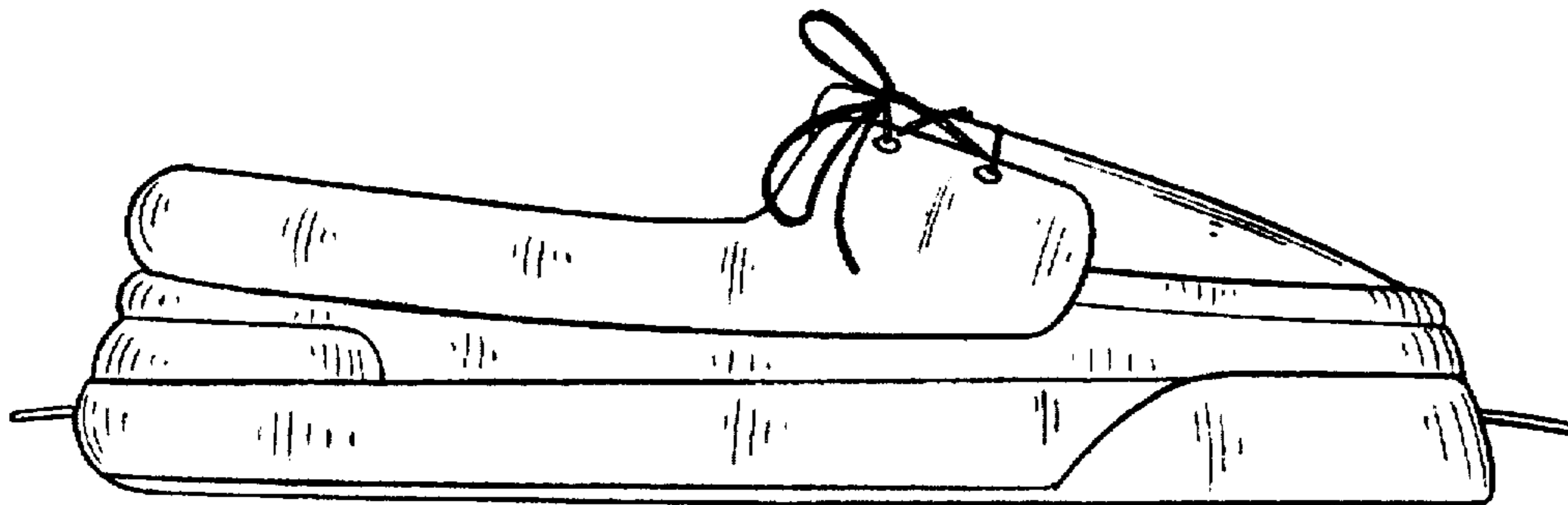

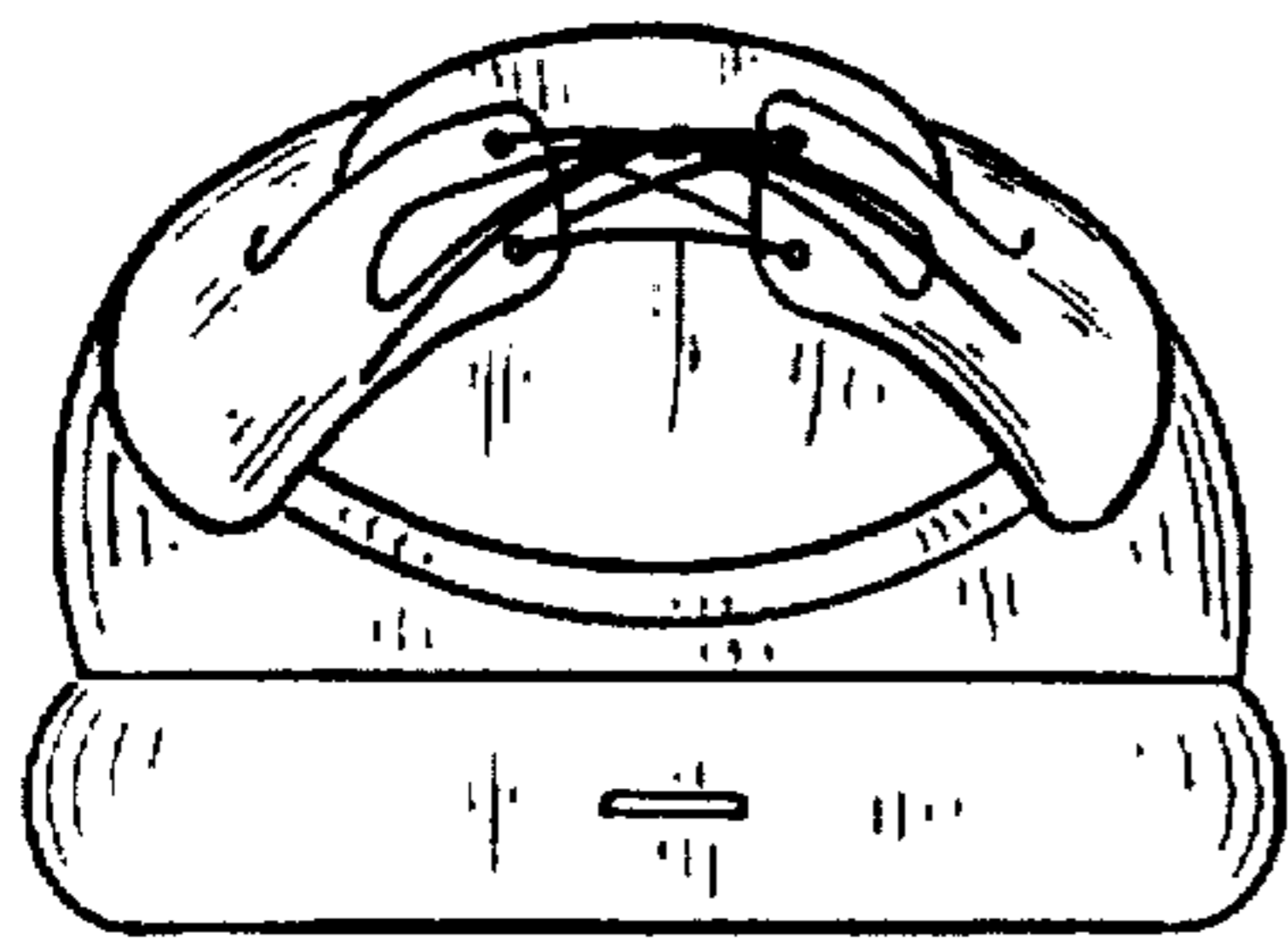

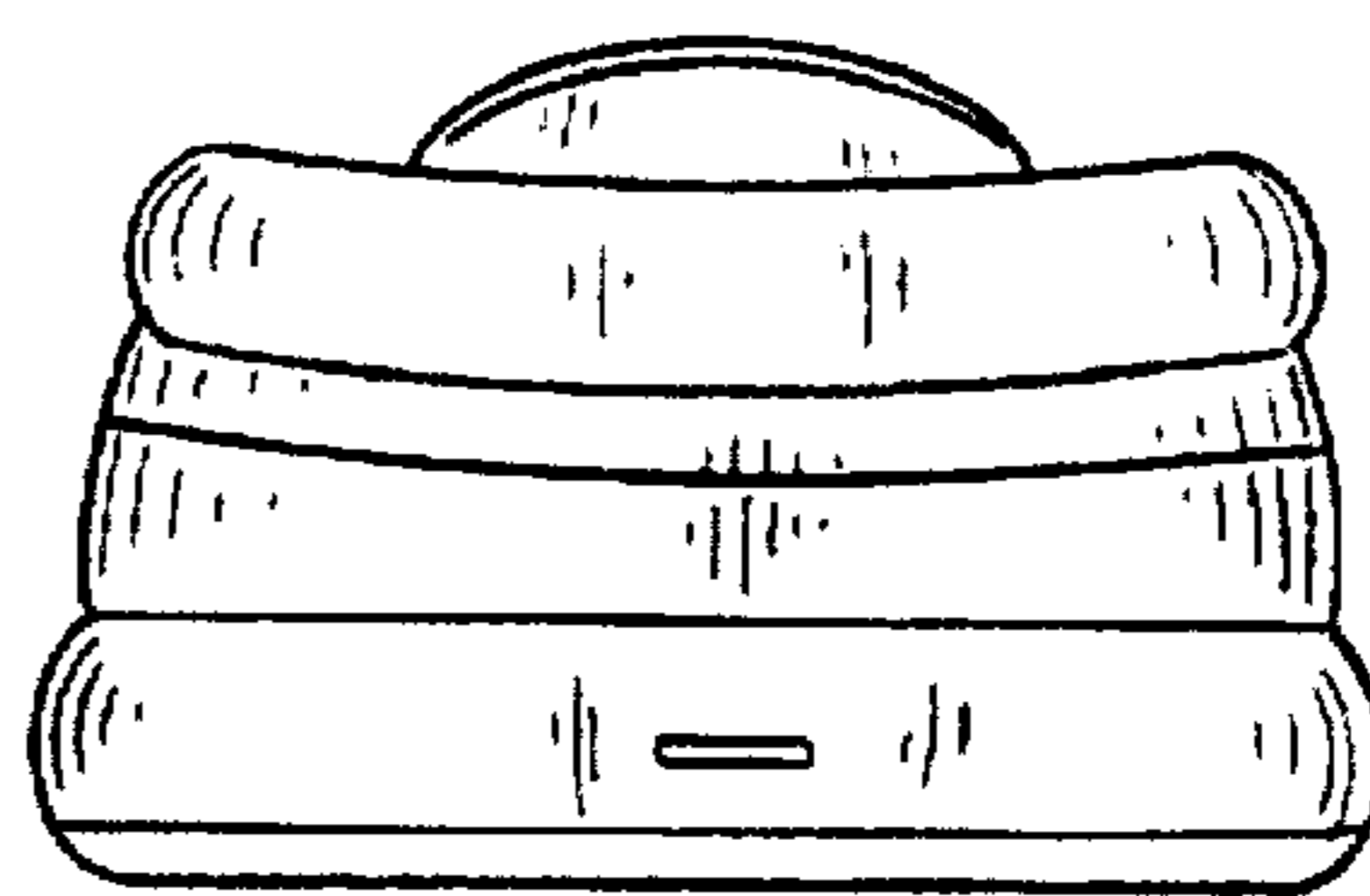

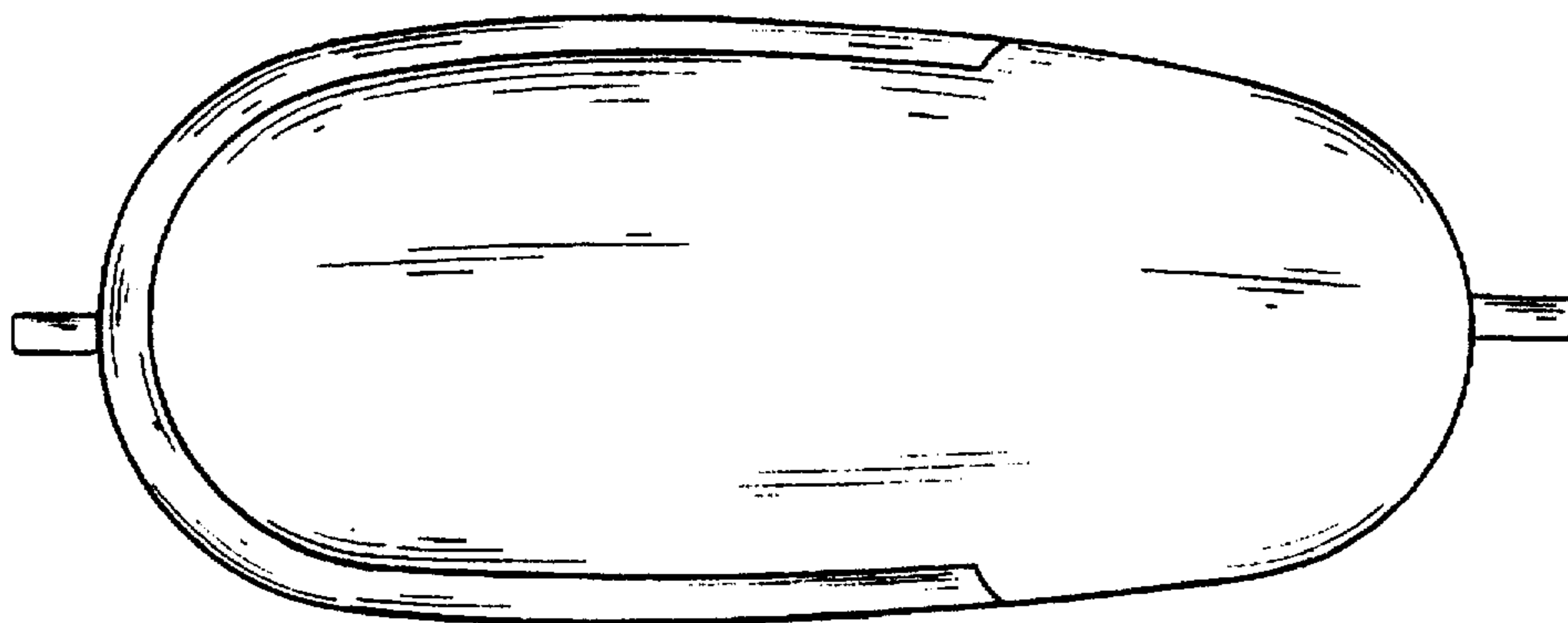

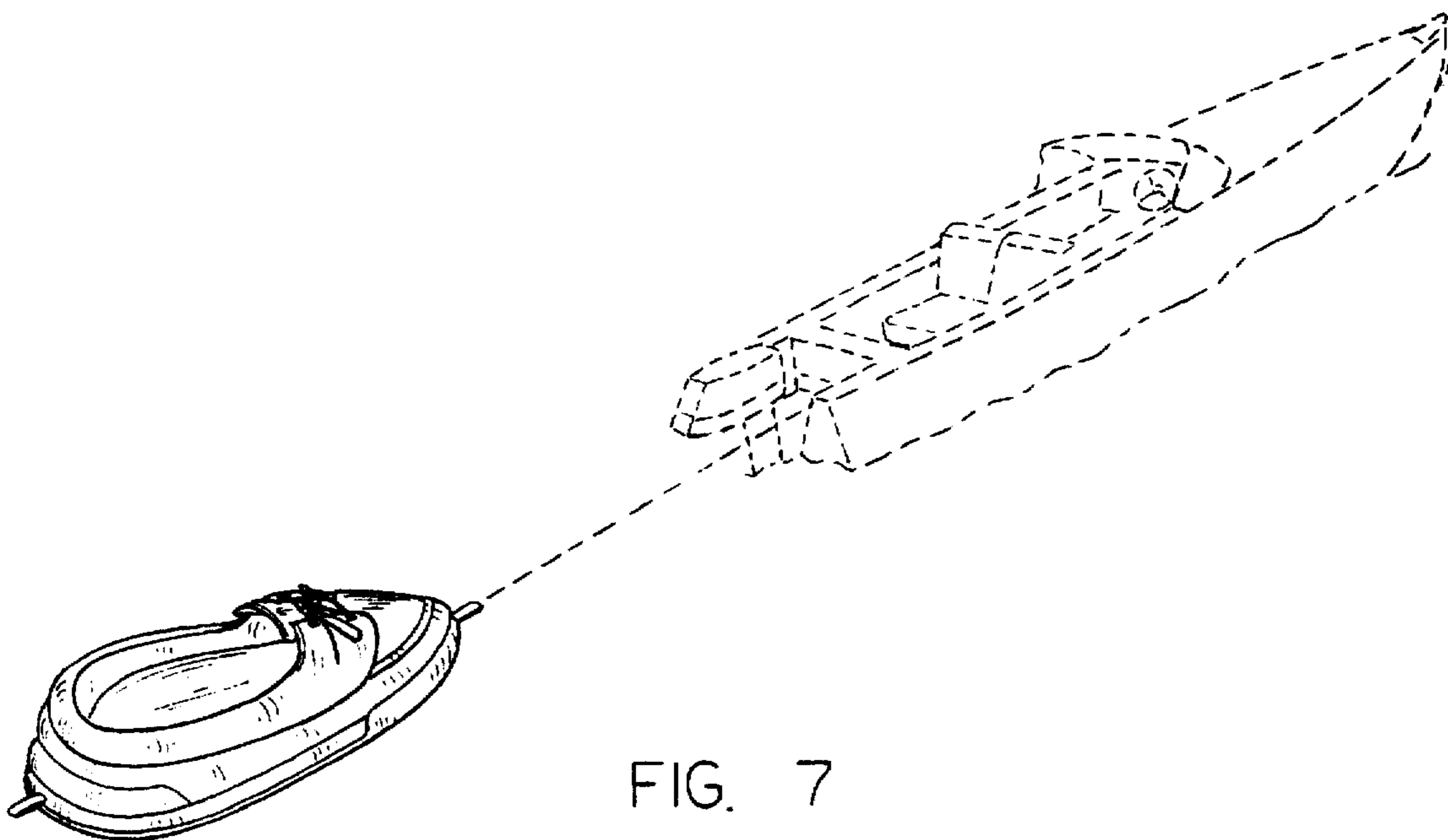
