DESCRIPTION

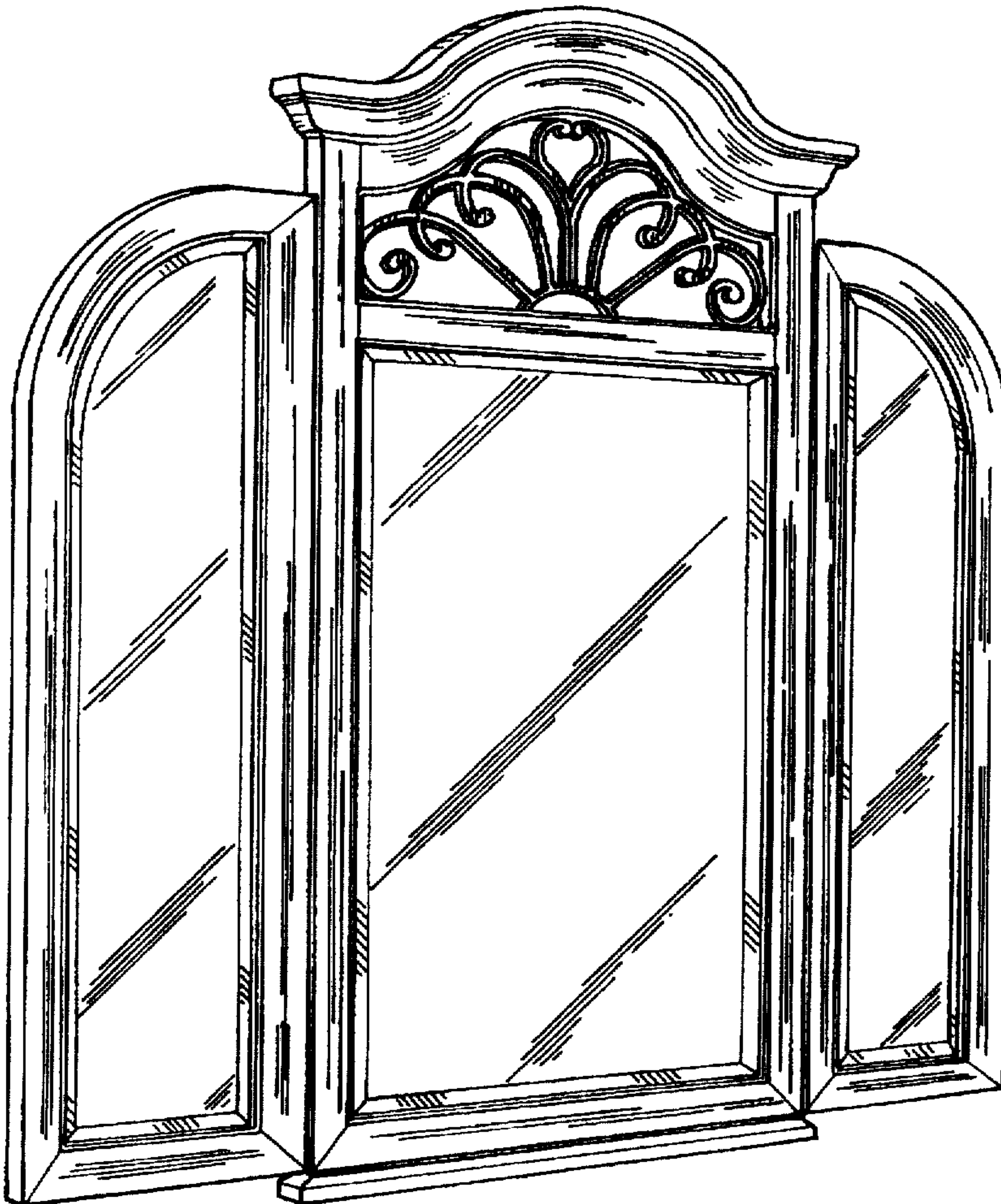
FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a mirror showing

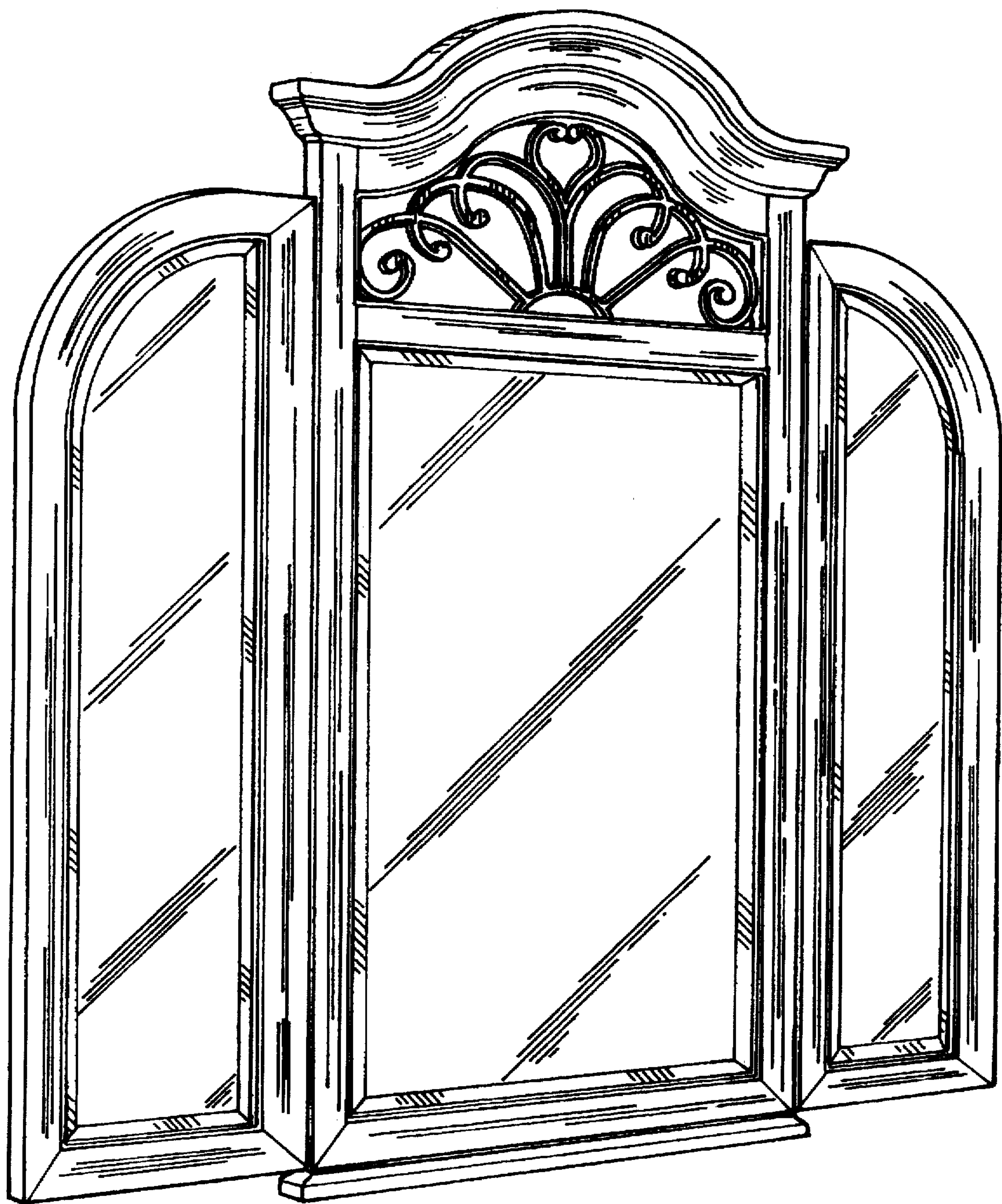

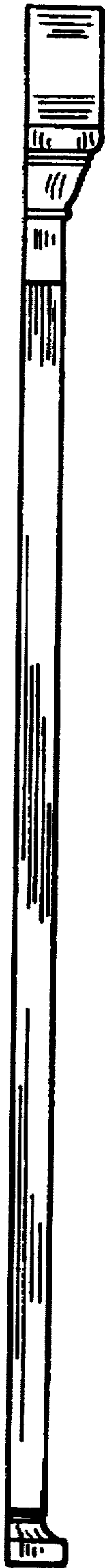
