FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a chair showing the design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

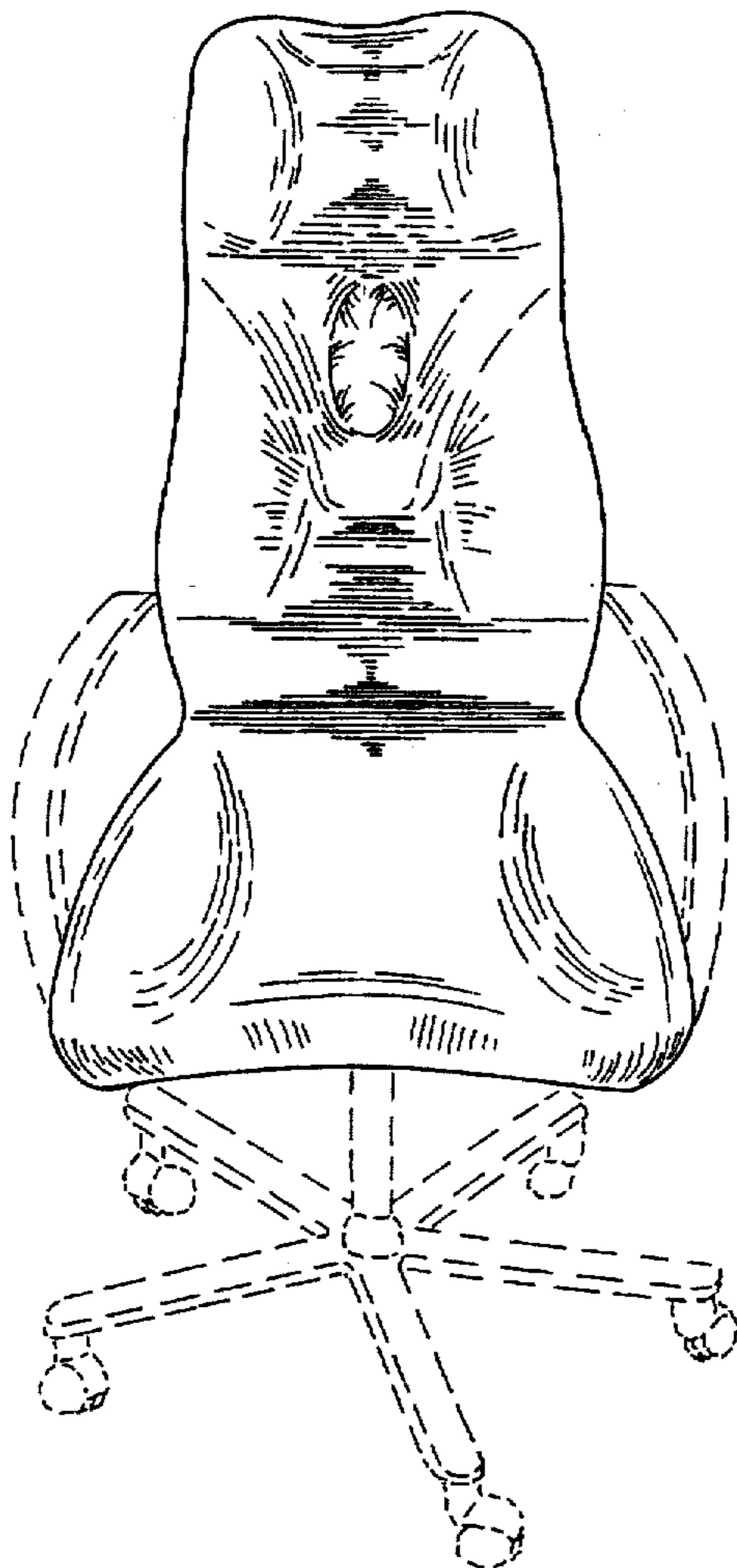
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of a chair showing the design;

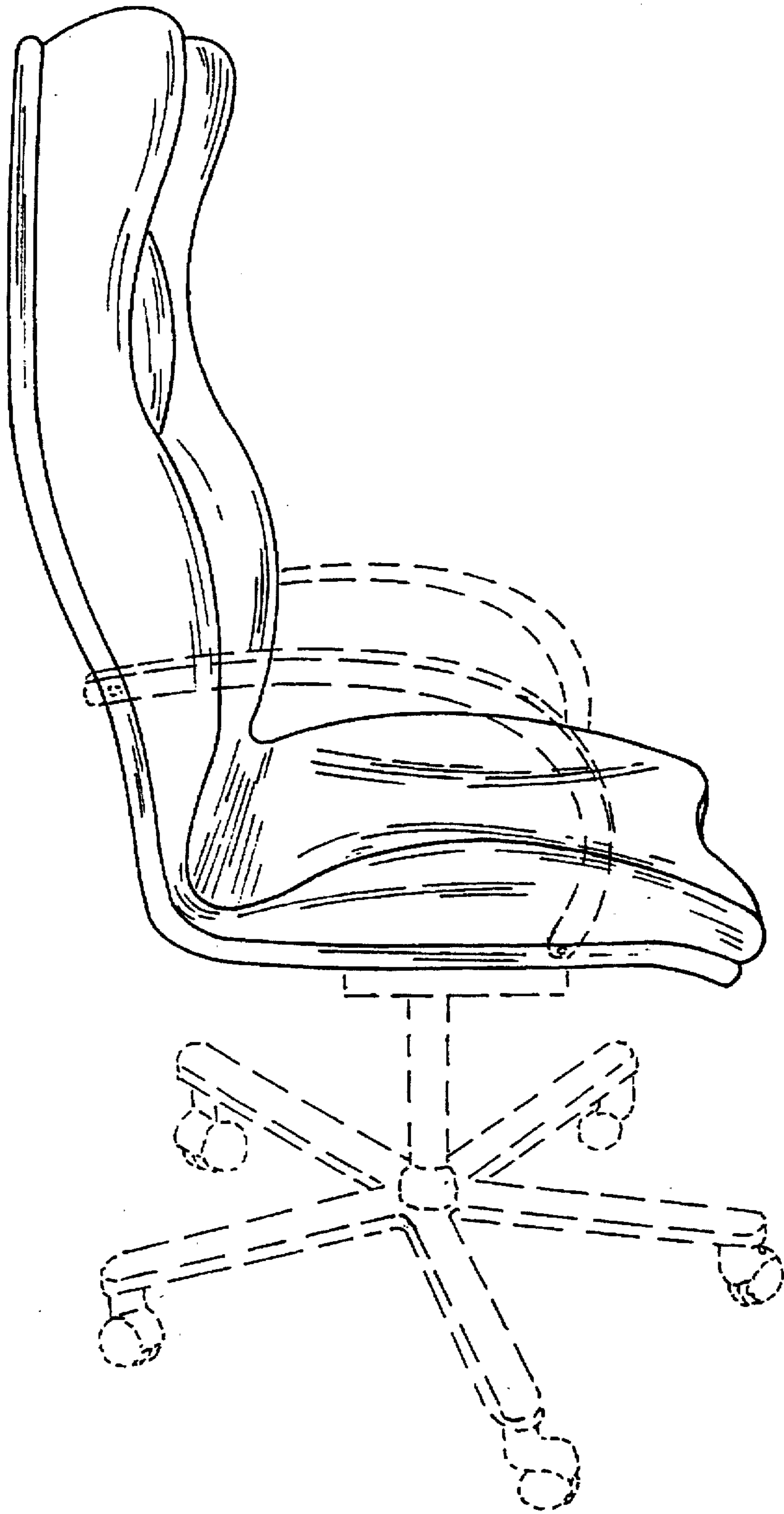
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a chair showing the design; and,

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of a chair showing the design.

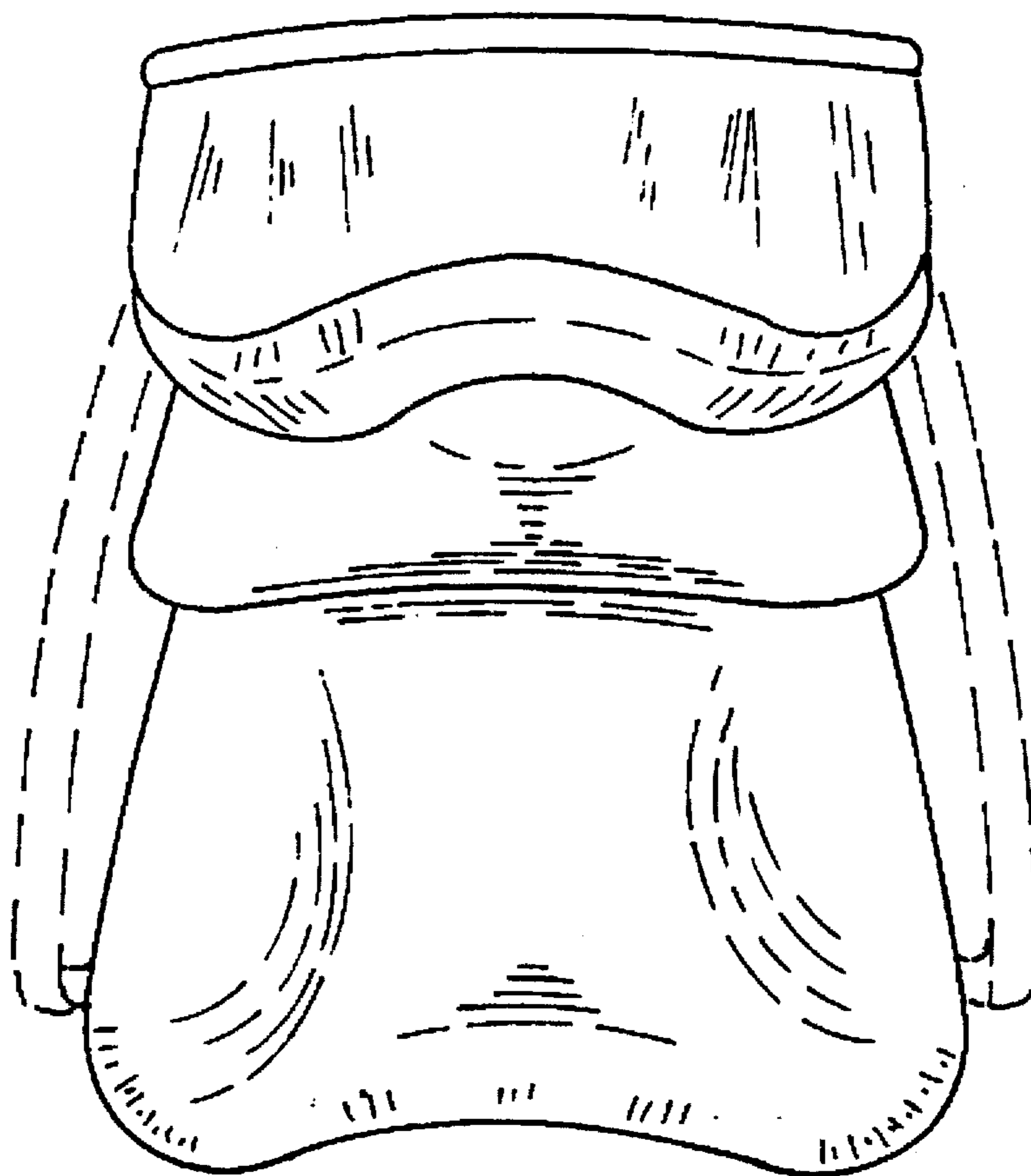

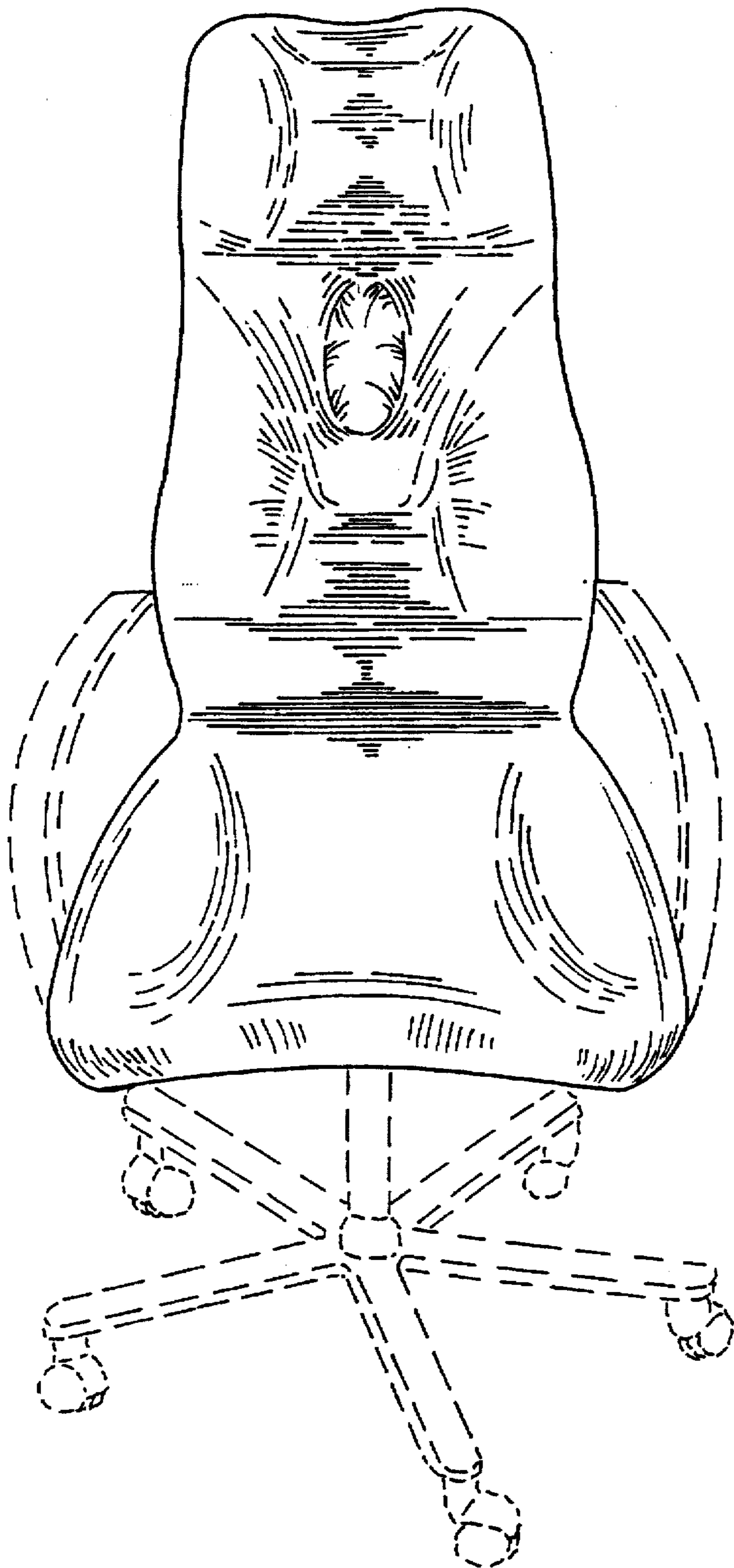

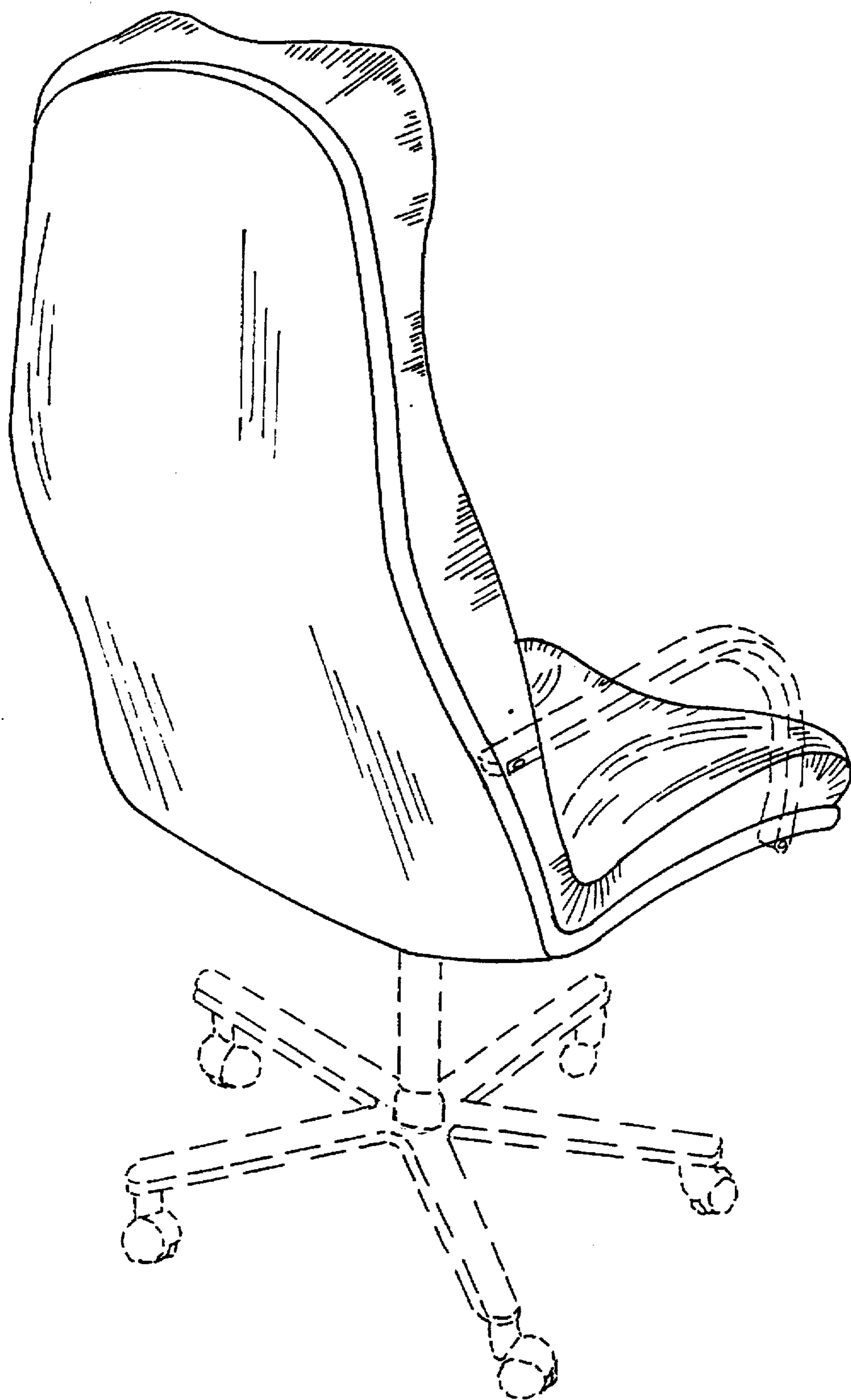
