[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pager coin holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pager coin holder showing my new design; the broken line showing of the pager and coin is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the pager coin holder shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation of the pager coin holder shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation of the pager coin holder shown in FIG. 1;

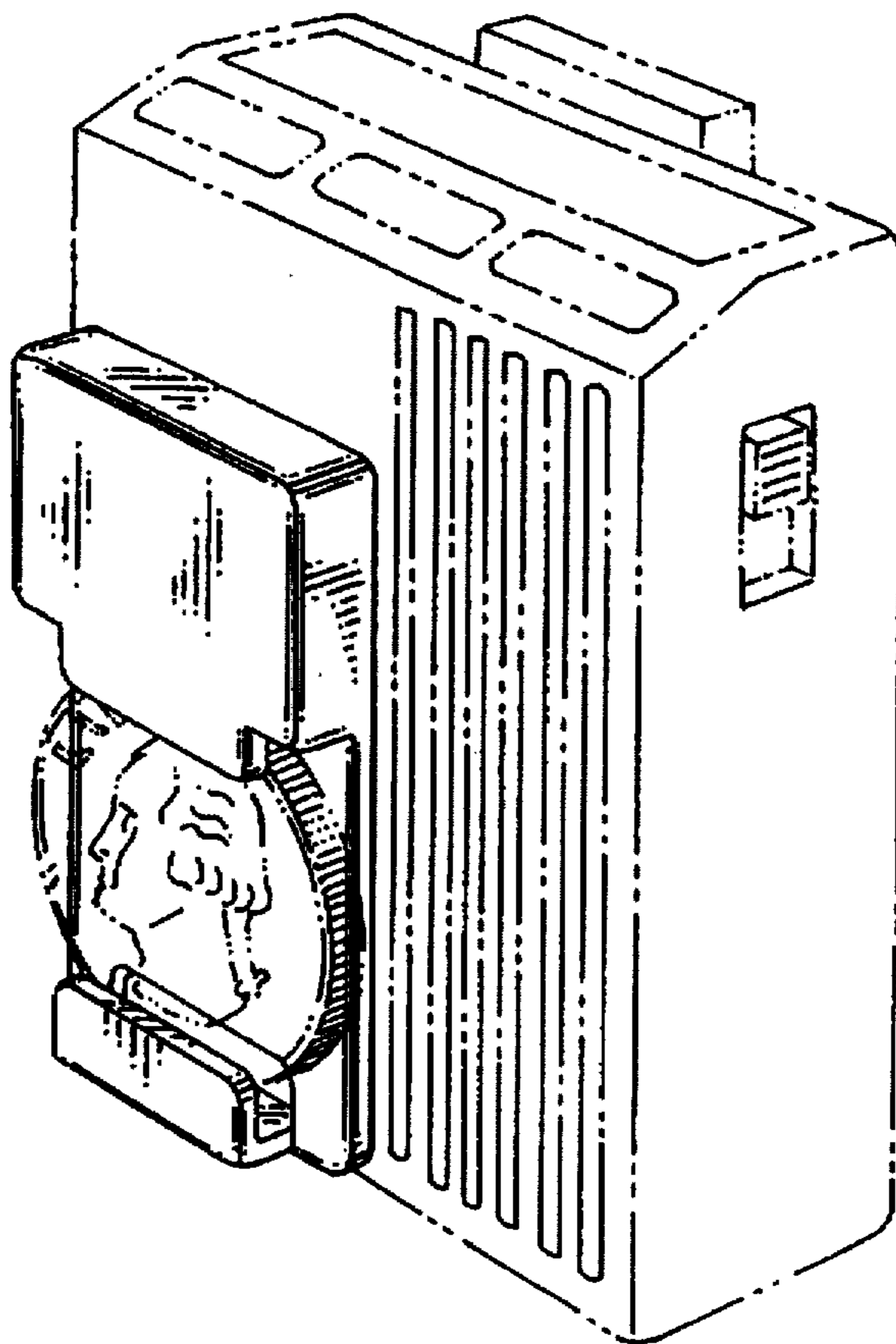
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the pager coin holder shown in FIG. 1;

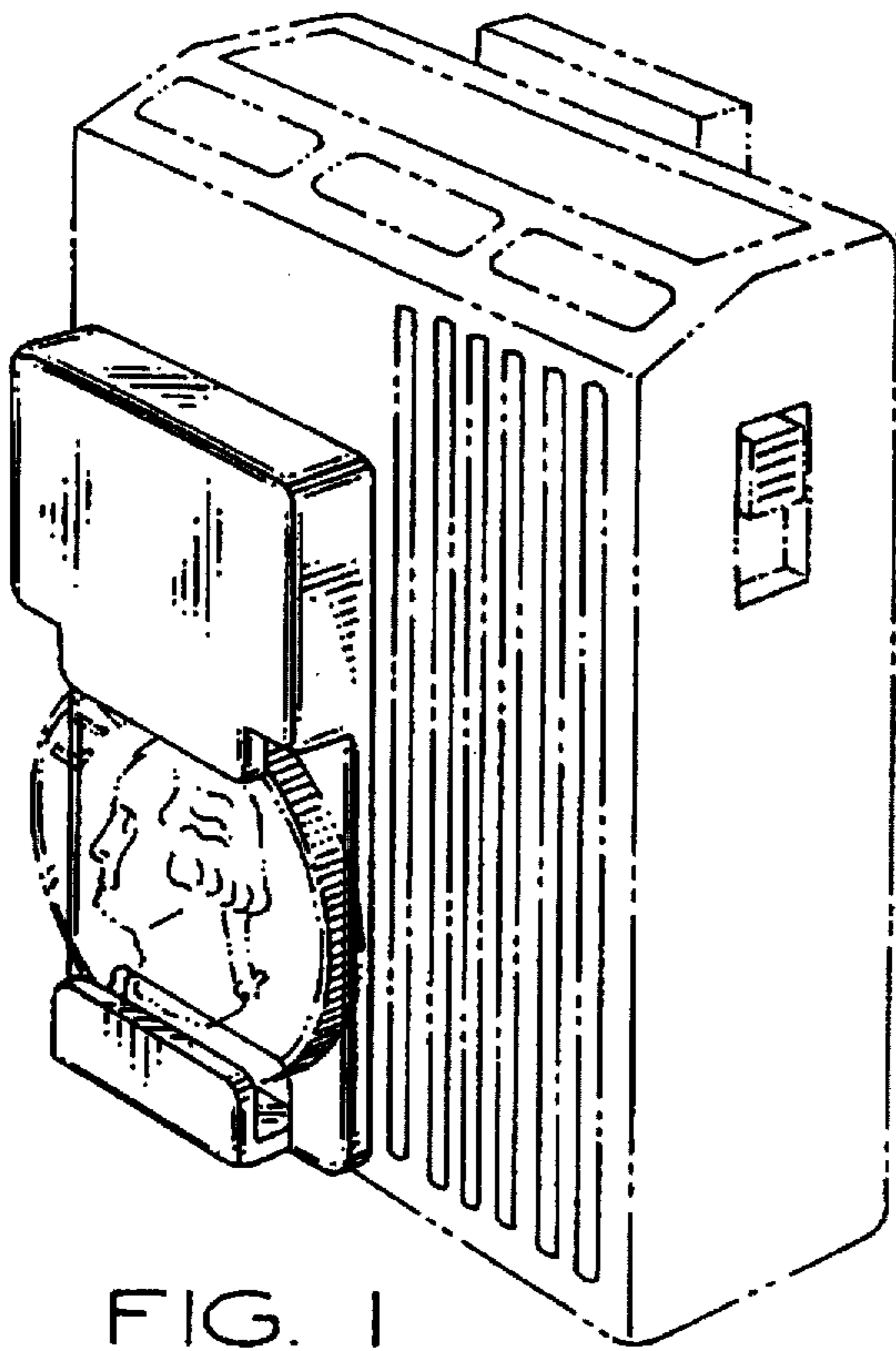

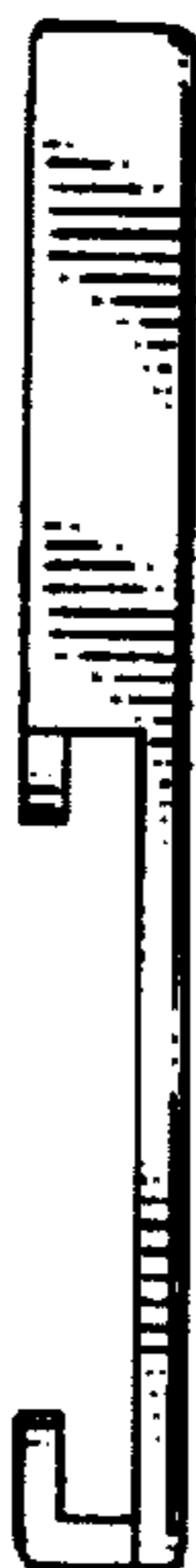

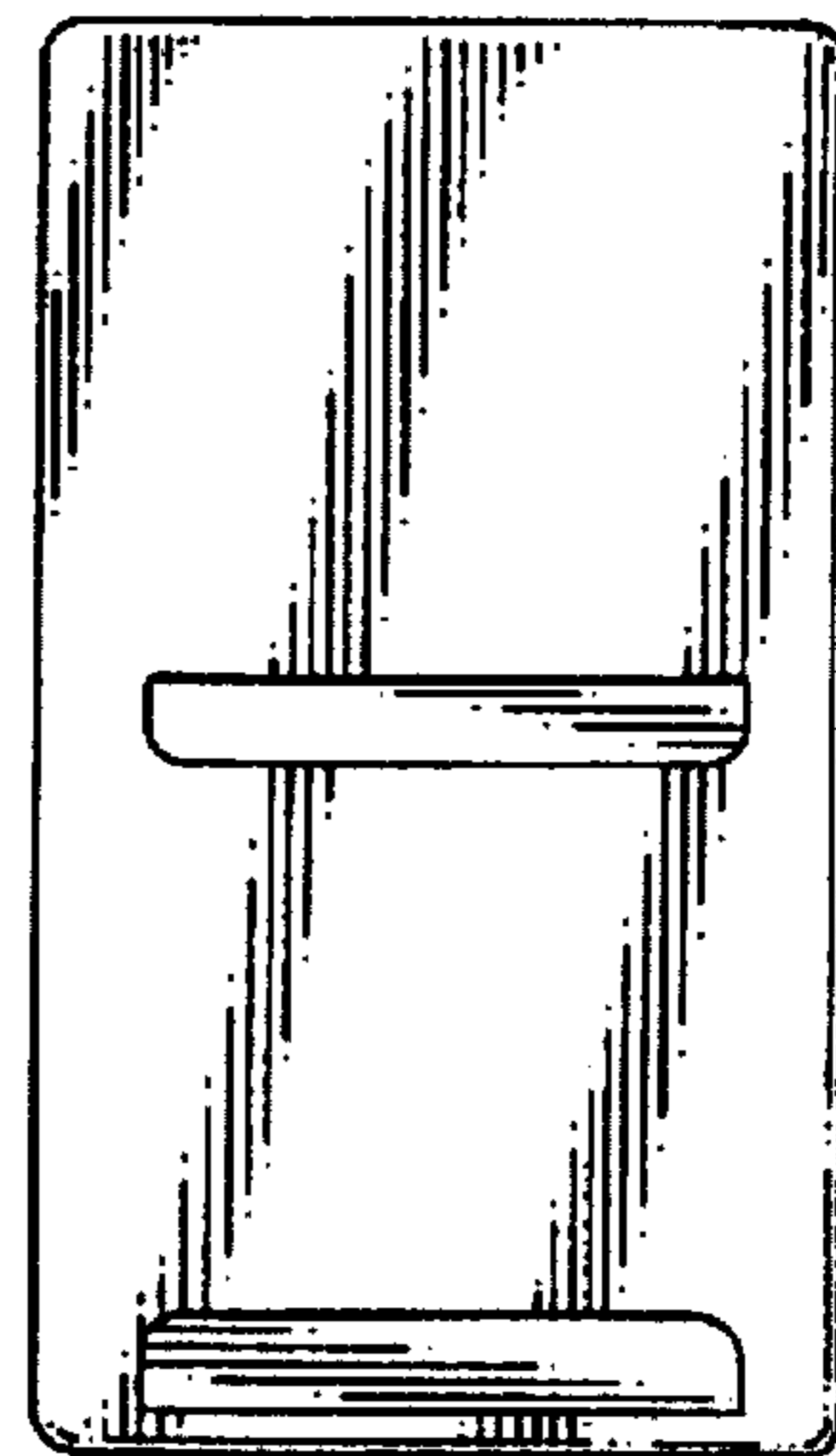

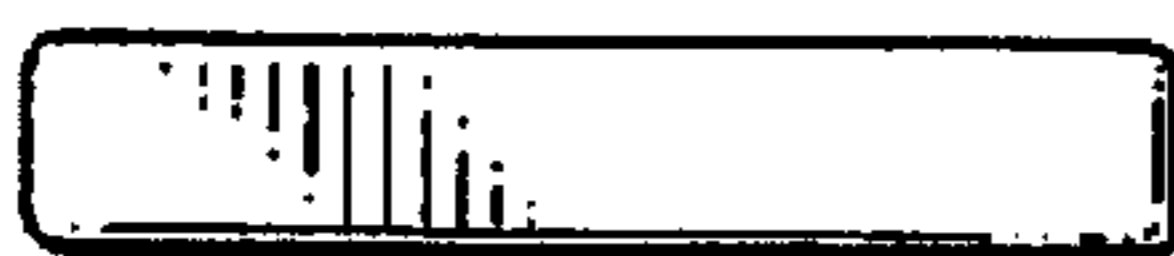
