The ornamental design for a playground slide, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is perspective view of the playground slide design;

FIG. 2 is a front side view of the playground slide design of the subject invention of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the playground slide design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the playground slide design of **FIG. 1**;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the playground slide design of FIG.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the playground slide design of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a top view of the playground slide design of DIG.

The broken line showing of a slide support on FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.












