DESCRIPTION

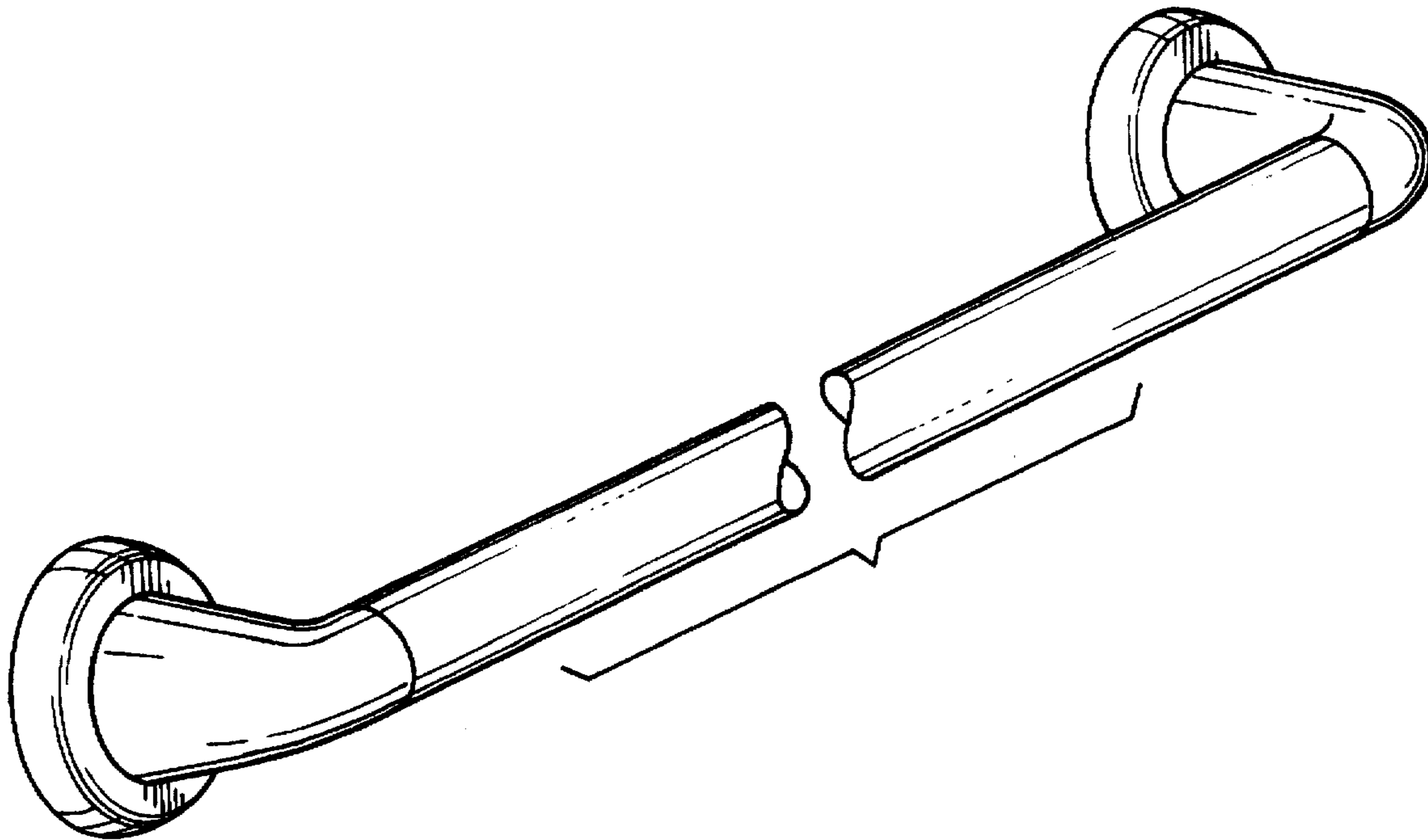
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a towel bar showing my new design;

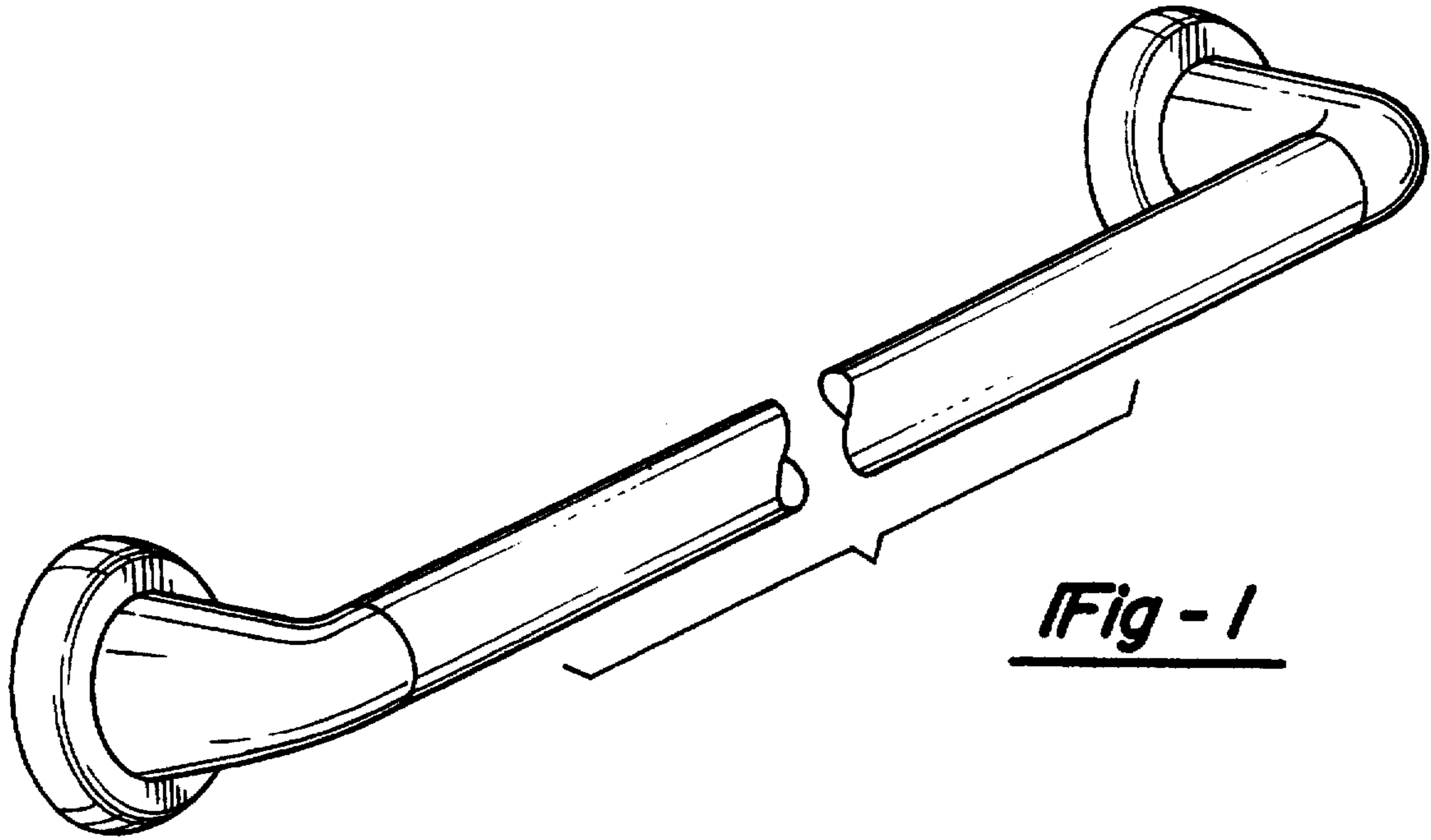

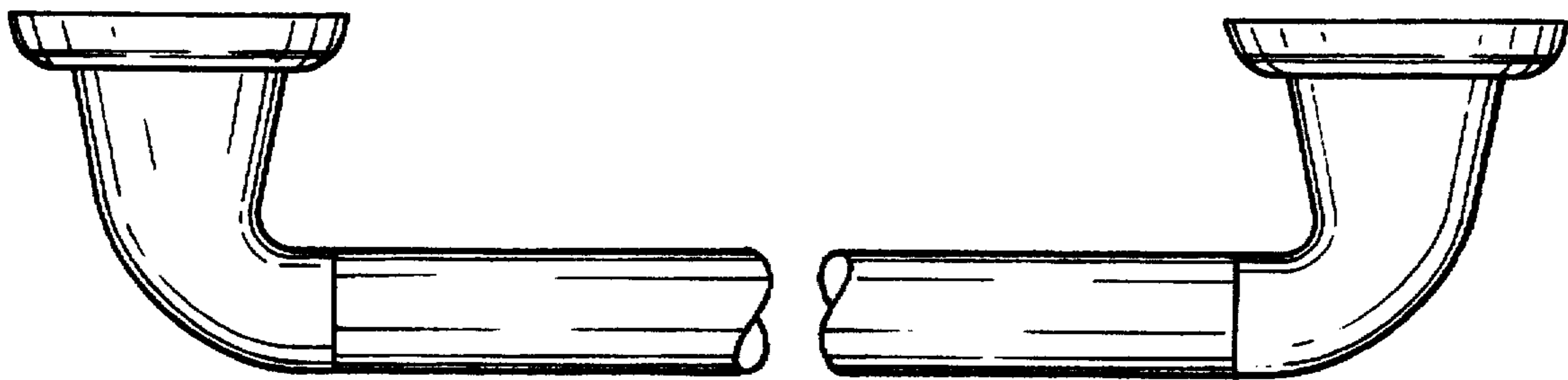

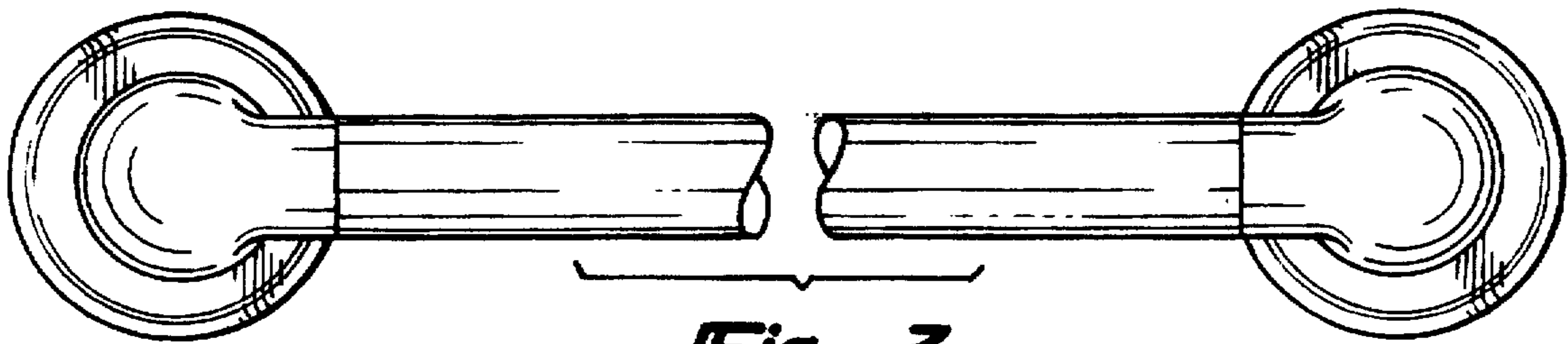

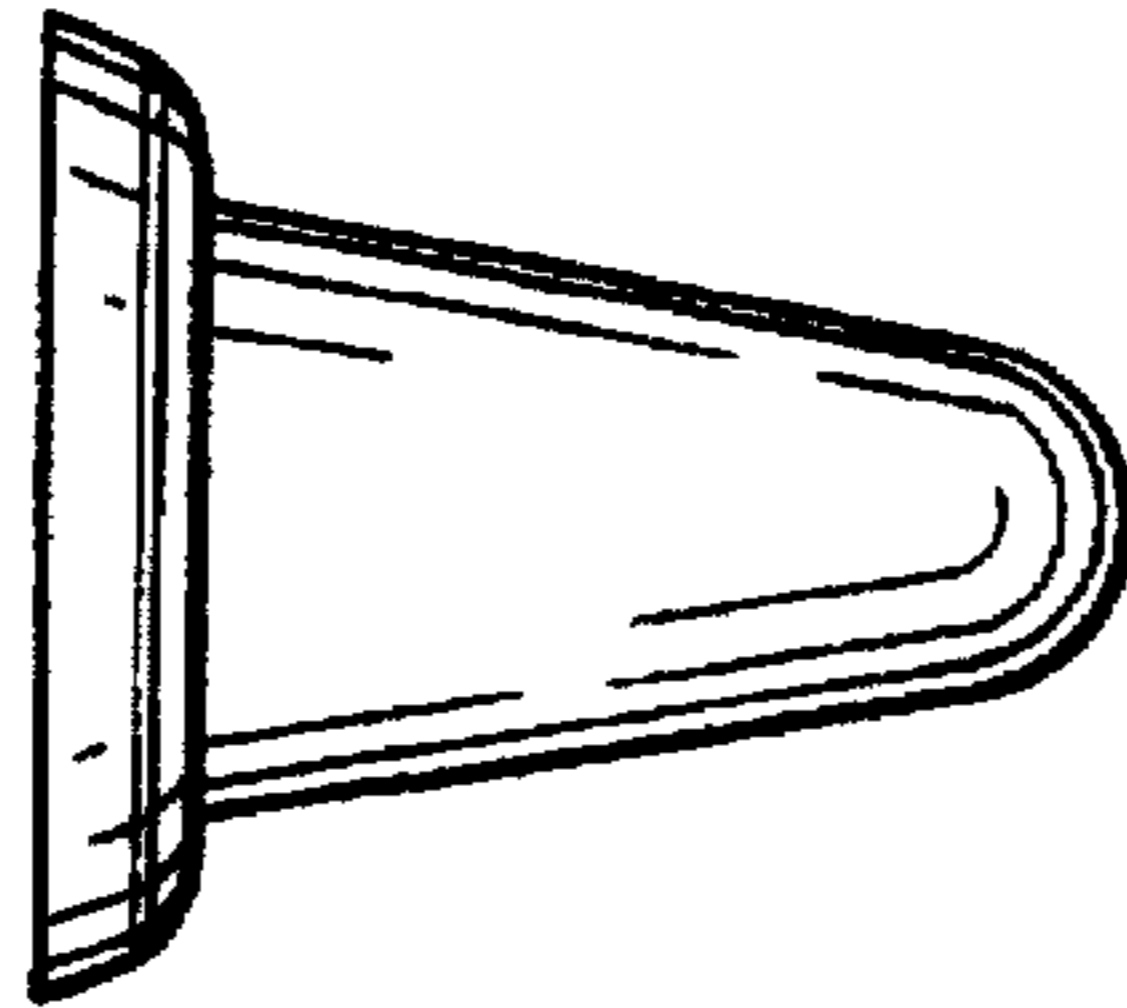

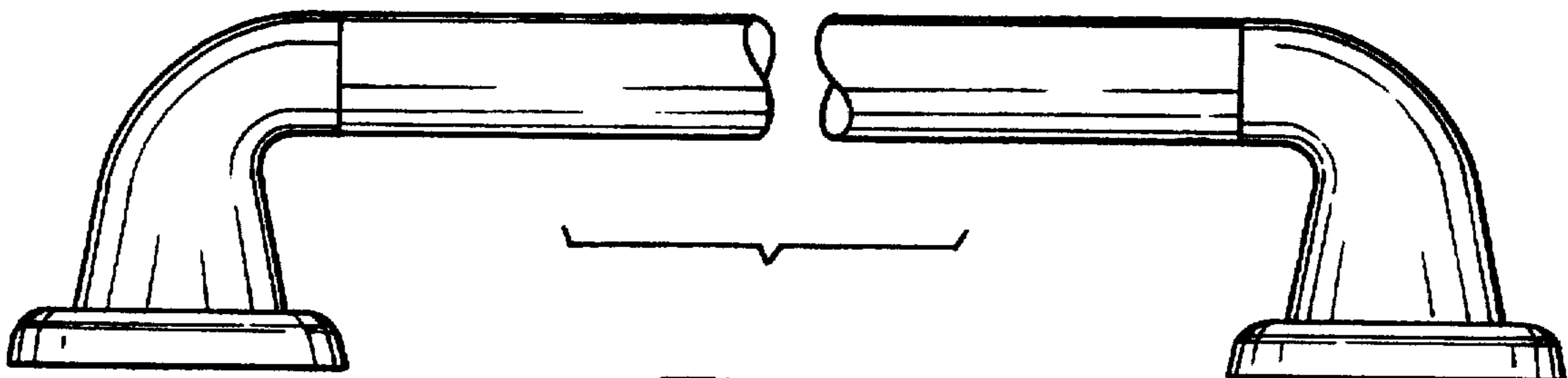

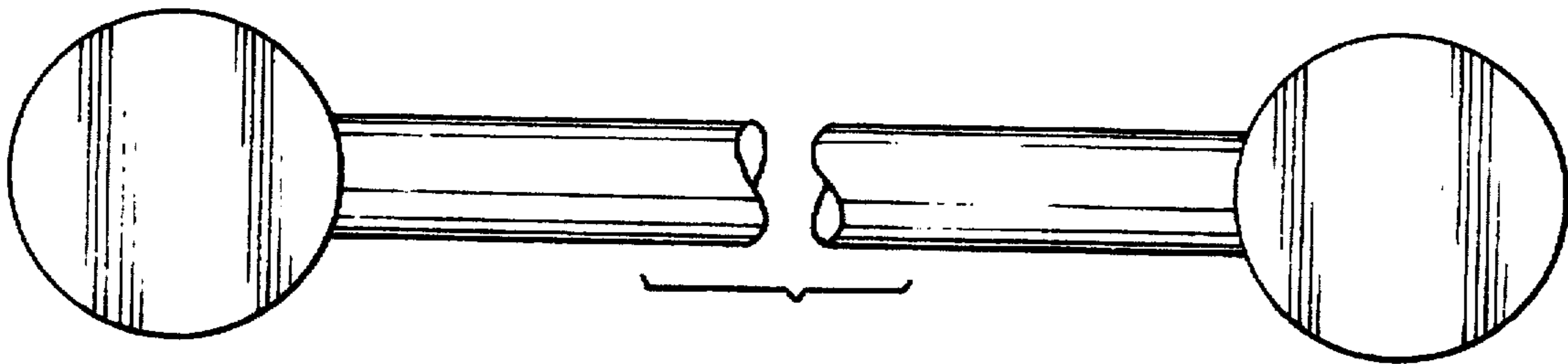
