as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the combined towel and
tote bag;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the combined towel and tote bag;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the combined towel and tote bag;
FIG. 4 is a side view of the combined towel and tote and bag
from the opposite side of FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is a back view of the combined towel and tote bag;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the combined towel and tote bag;
and,
FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view of the combined
towel and tote bag with the tote bag reversed and the towel
inside said bag.
The cross-hatching represents conventional fabric and is
understood to extend throughout the areas represented.

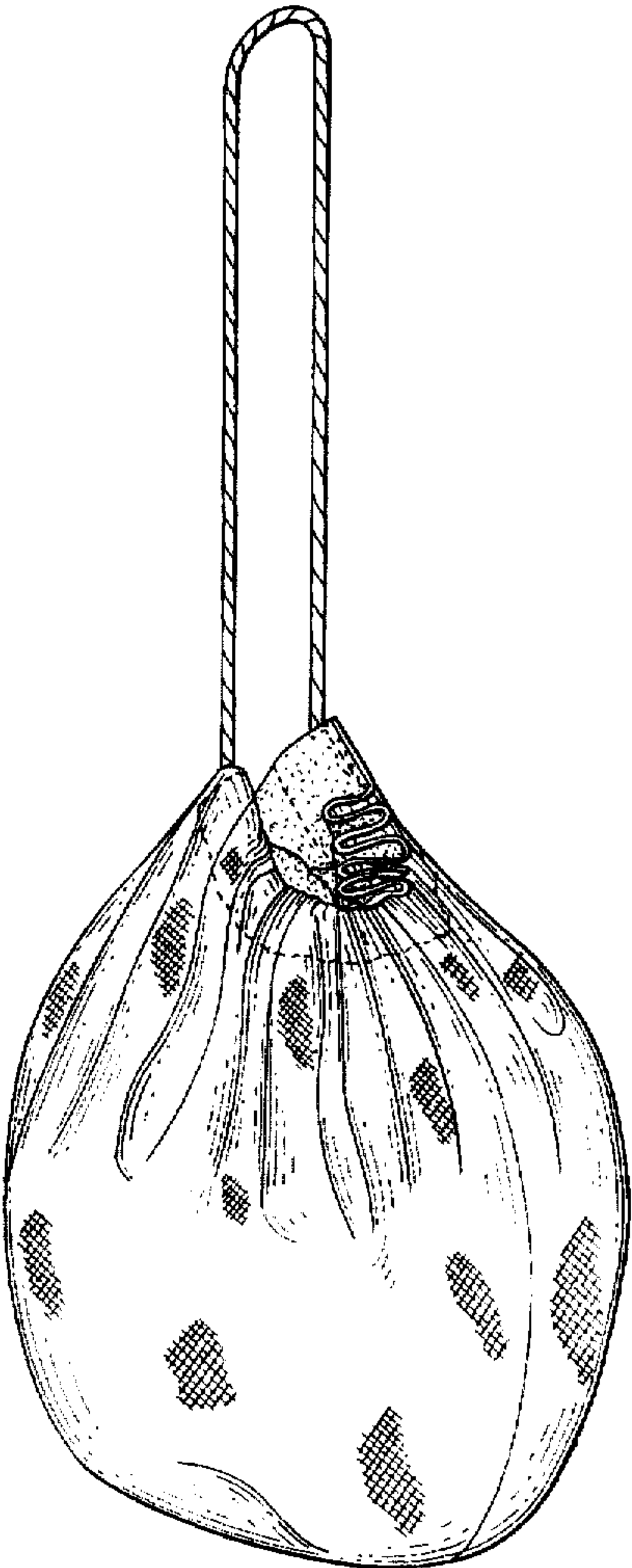
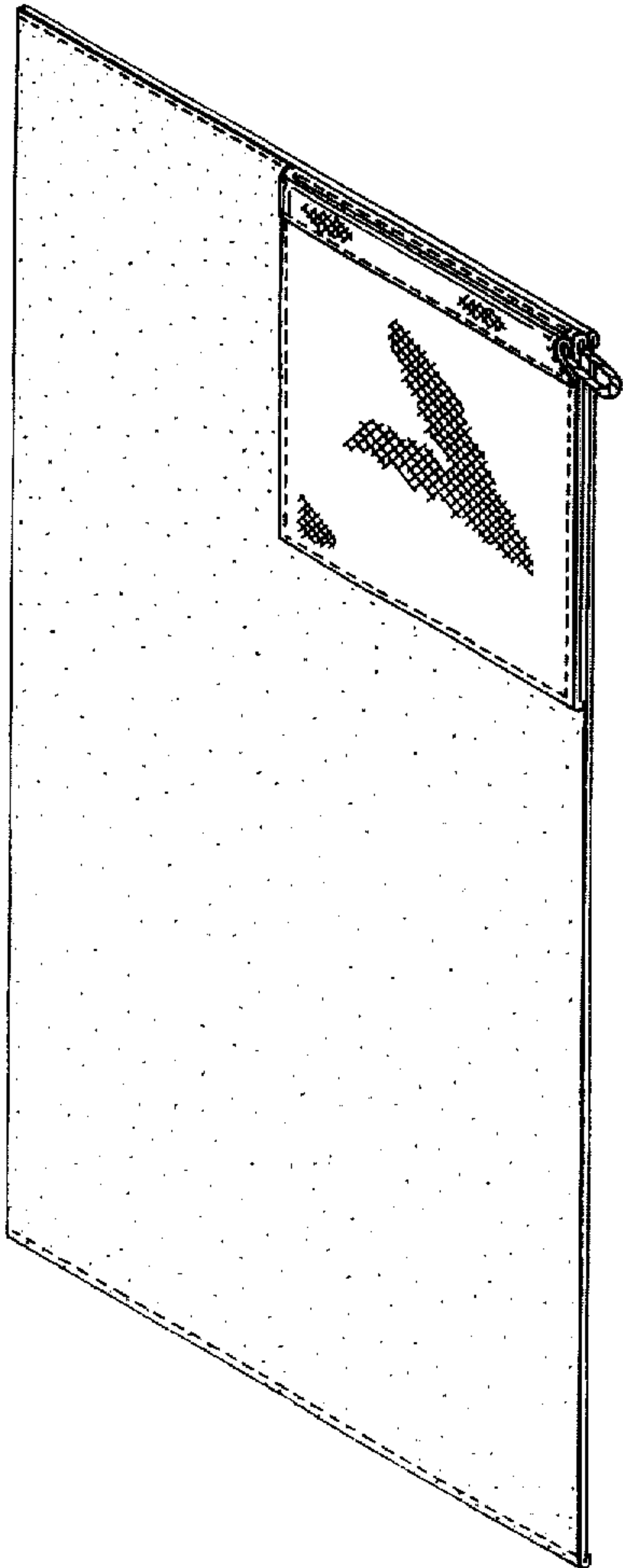
