FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a portion of a shoe outsole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

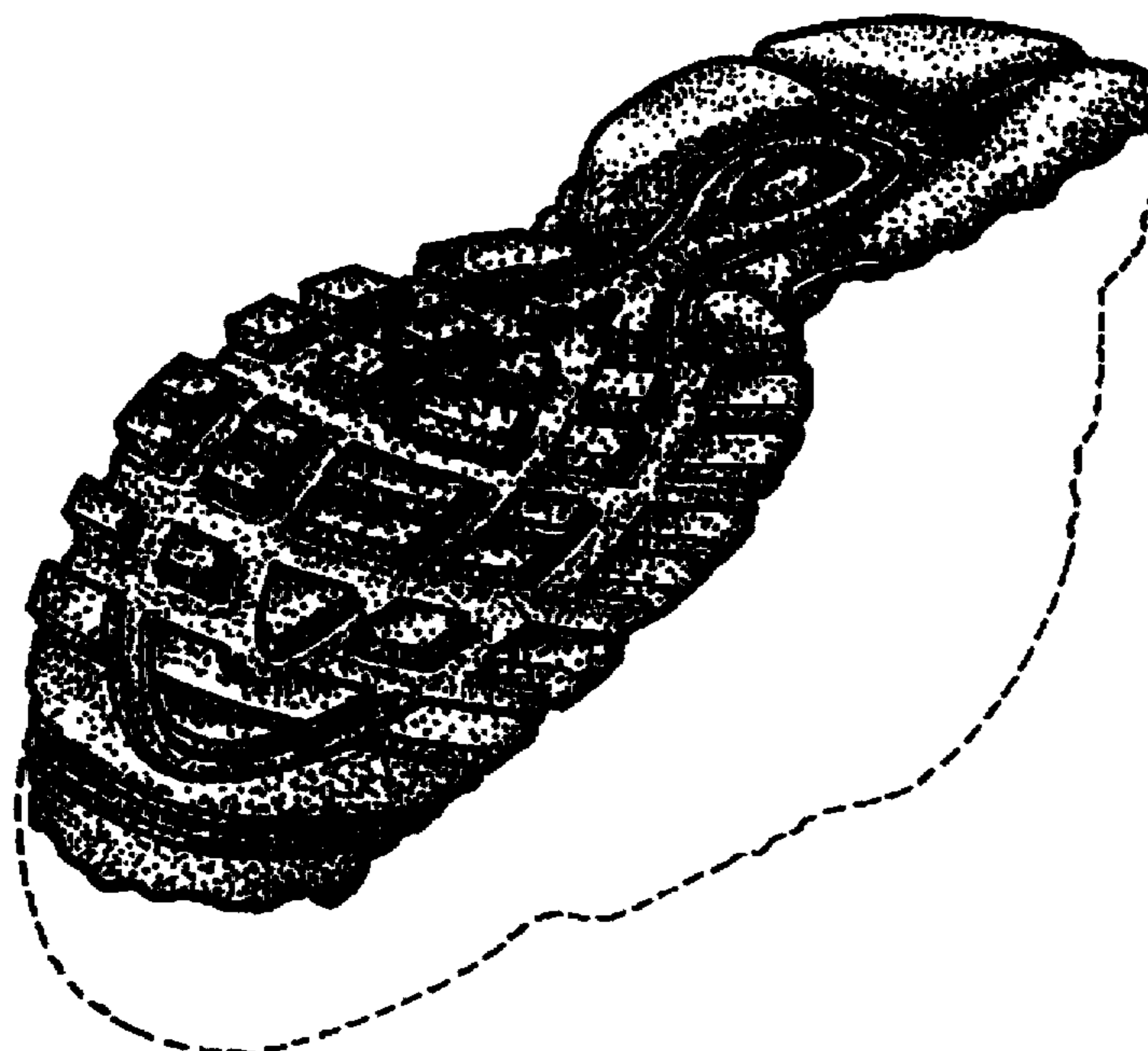
FIG. 3 is a profile view taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

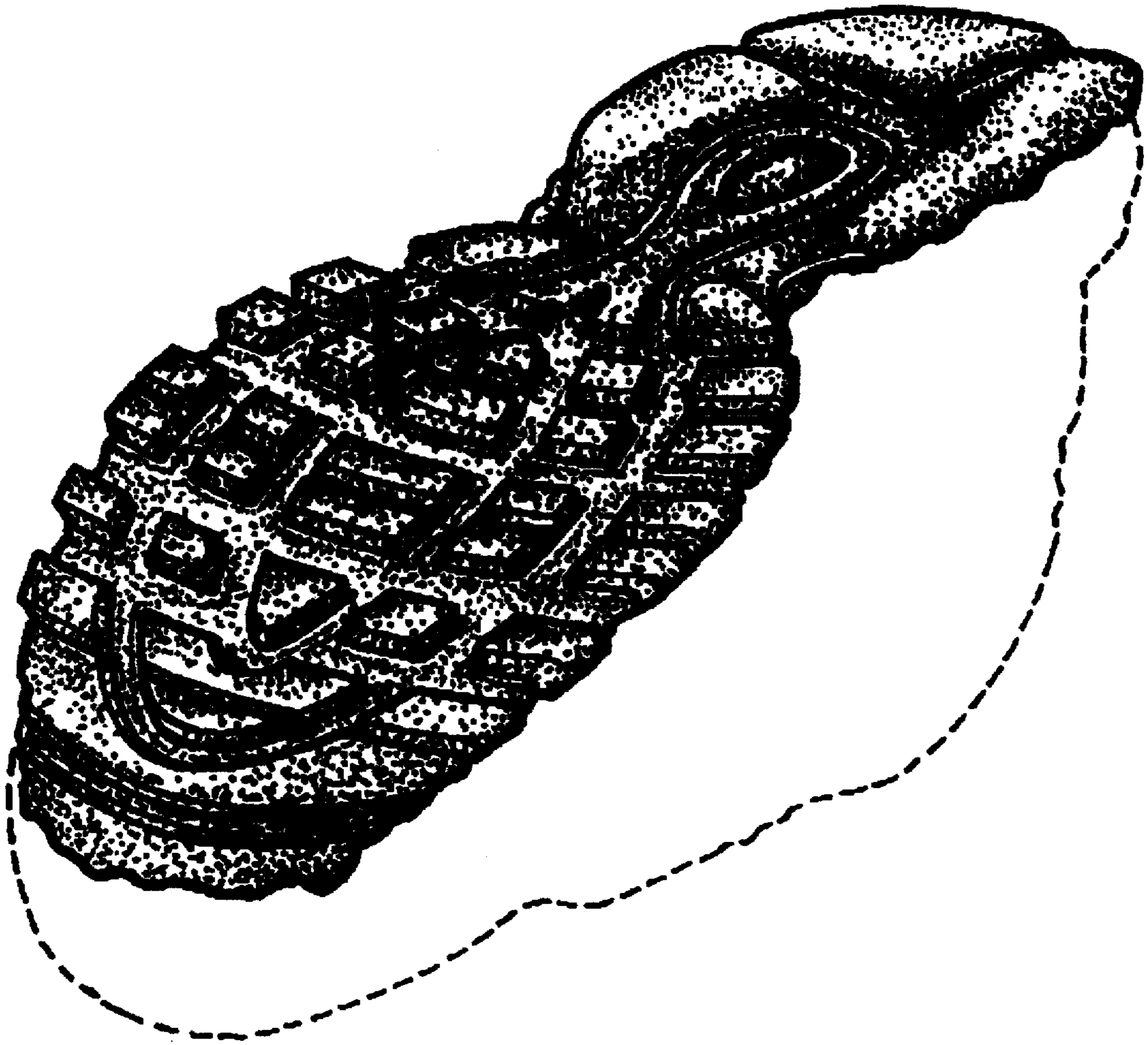

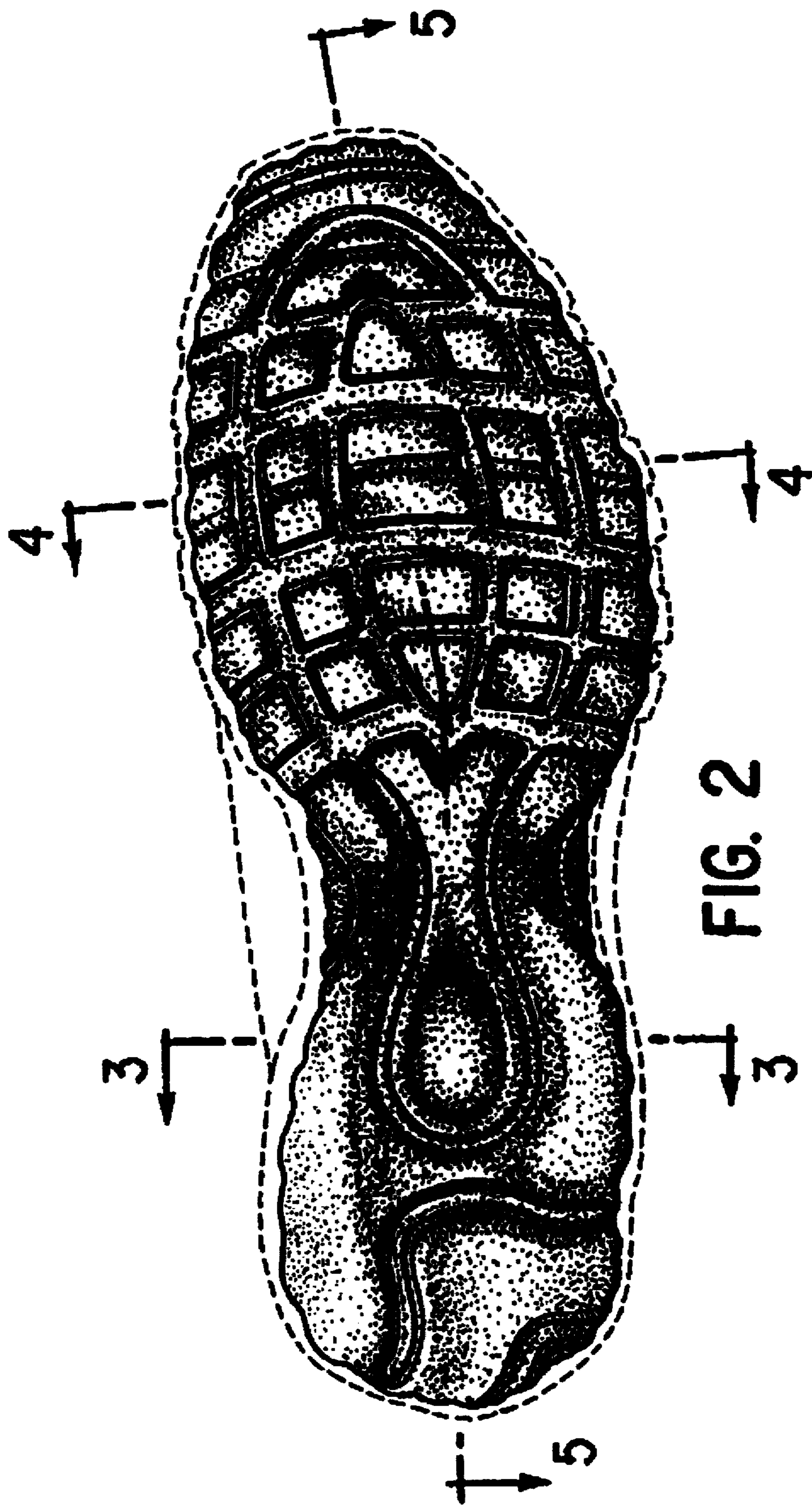

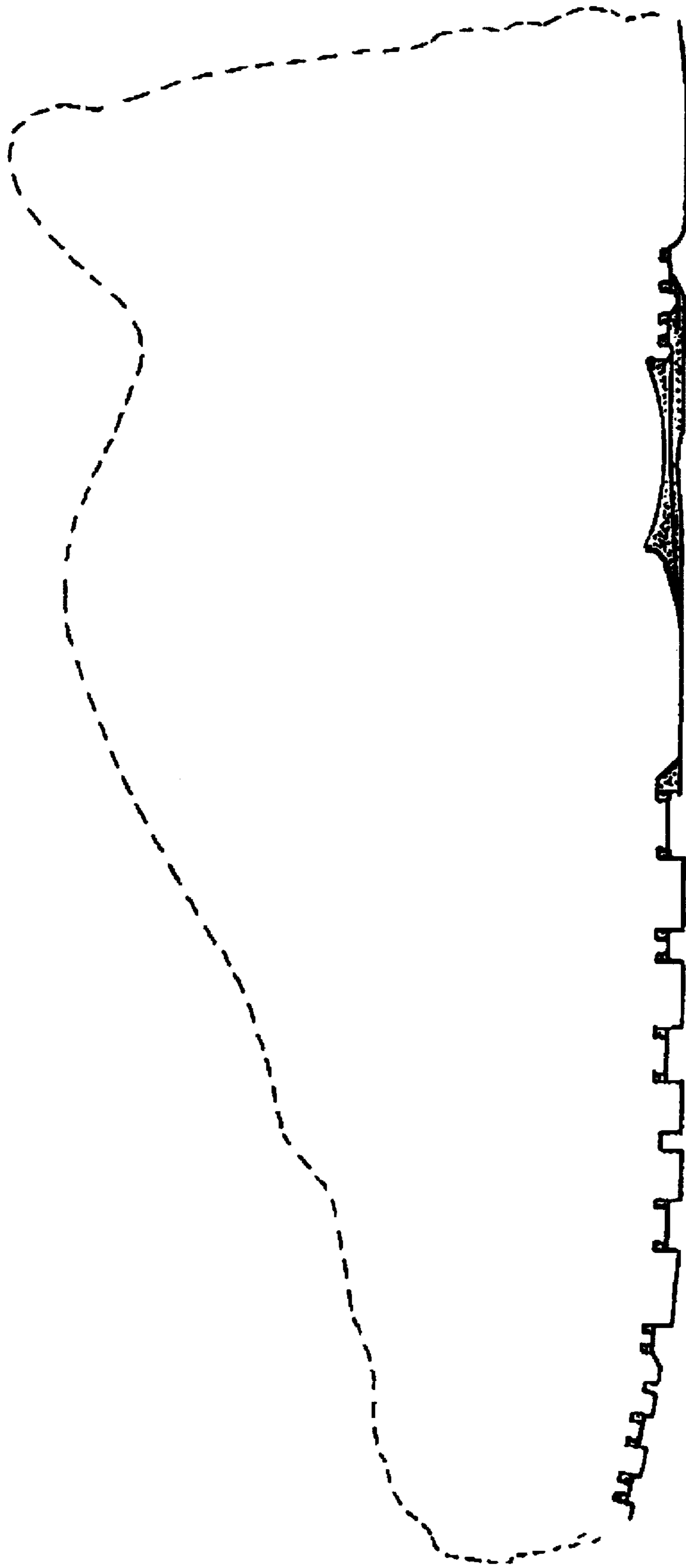
