[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a drain tray for a household appliance, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded top perspective view of a drain tray for a household appliance showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view of the removable front wall;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of FIG. 2, the undisclosed opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross section taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged cross section taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the base as disclosed in FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational of FIG. 9, the undisclosed opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 11 is a reduced scale top plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 11;


FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 14 is an enlarged fragmented cross section taken along line 14—14 of FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 15 is a top perspective of FIG. 1, the broken line showing of a fragmented appliance is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

The fragmented FIGURES in the drawings are shown for ease of illustration.







