DESCRIPTION

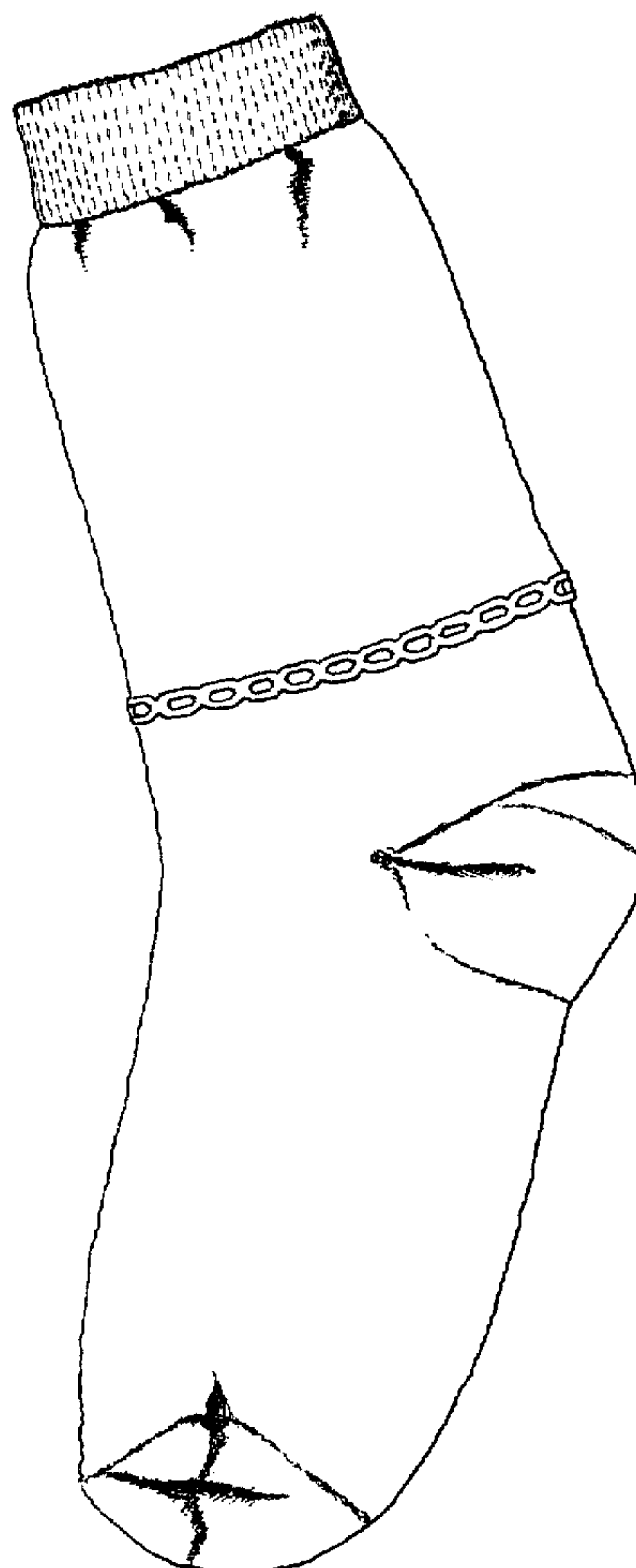
FIG. 1 is a front elevational of a sock with simulated ankle

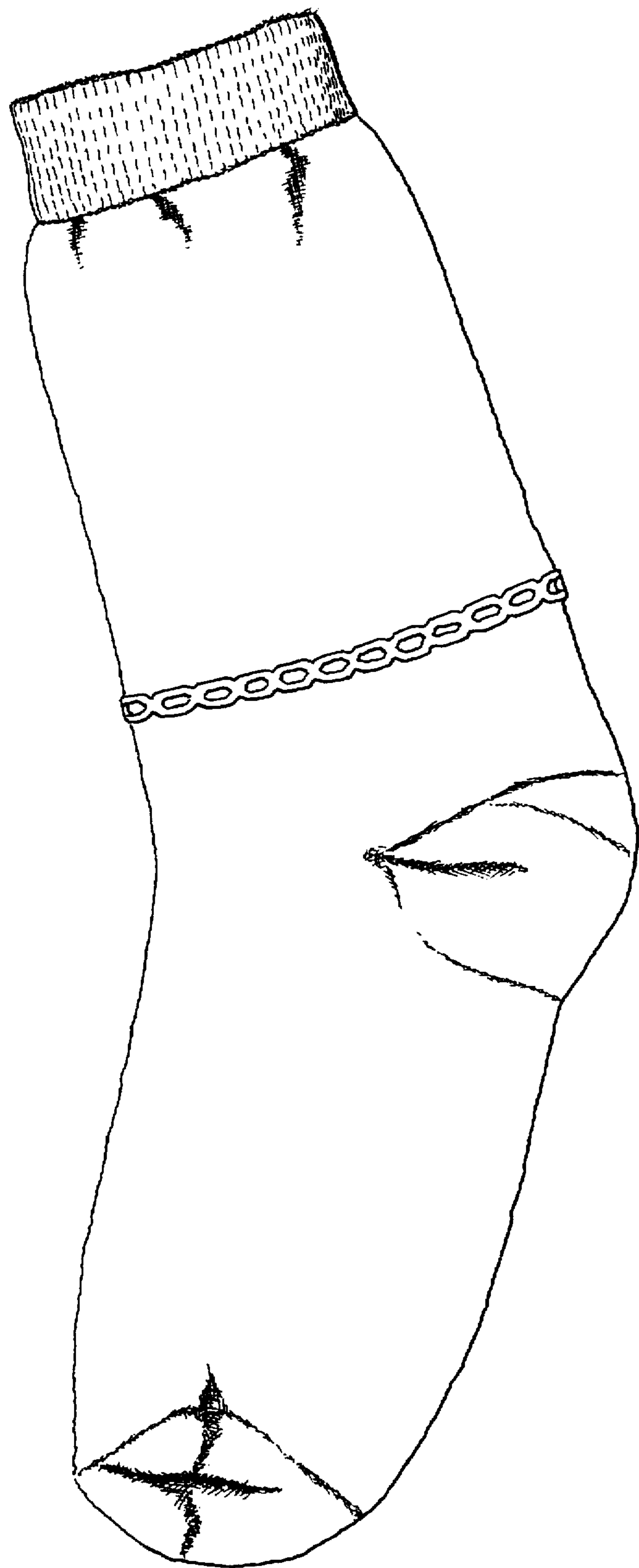

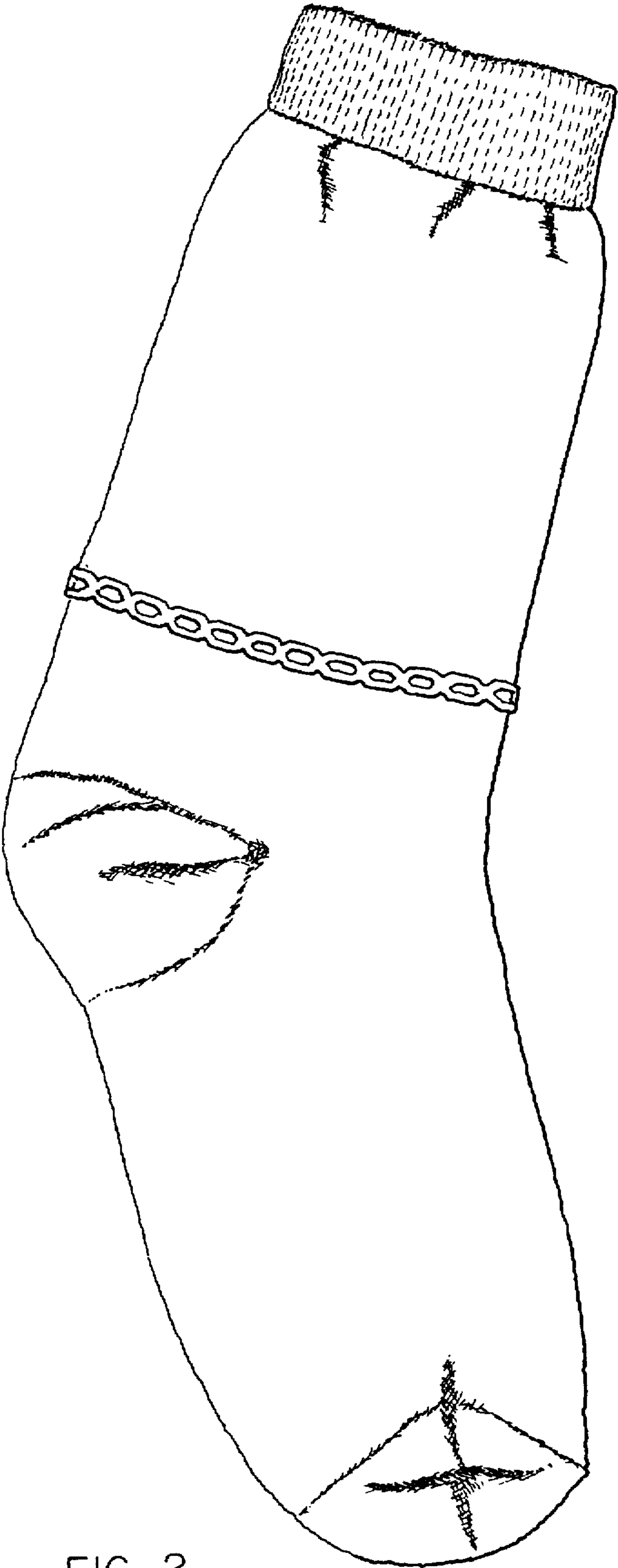
