FIG. 10 is a fragmentary right side elevational view of the modification of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a fragmentary front and left side perspective view of a third embodiment showing another modification thereof;

FIG. 12 is a fragmentary rear elevational view of the modification of FIG. 11;

FIG. 13 is a fragmentary right side elevational view of the modification of FIG. 11;


FIG. 14 is a fragmentary front and left side perspective view of a fourth embodiment showing a further modification thereof:


FIG. 15 is a fragmentary rear elevational view of the modification of FIG. 14; and,


FIG. 16 is a a fragmentary right side elevational view of the modification of FIG. 14.































