The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and left side perspective view of the new
chair design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary front and left side perspective view
of a second embodiment showing a modification thereof;

FIG. 9 is a fragmentary rear elevational view of the modi-
fication of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a fragmentary right side elevational view of the
modification of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a fragmentary front and left side perspective view
of a third embodiment showing another modification
thereof;

FIG. 12 is a fragmentary rear elevational view of the
modification of FIG. 11;

FIG. 13 is a fragmentary right side elevational view of the
modification of FIG. 11;

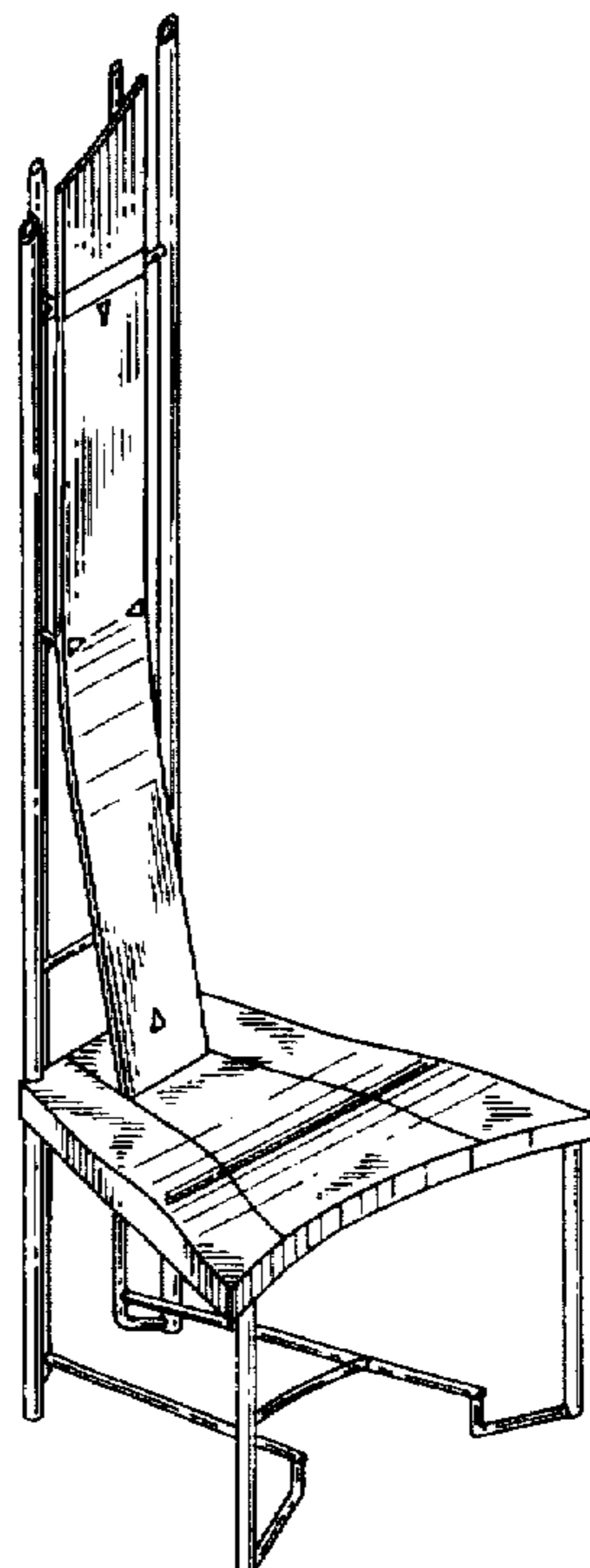
FIG. 14 is a fragmentary front and left side perspective view

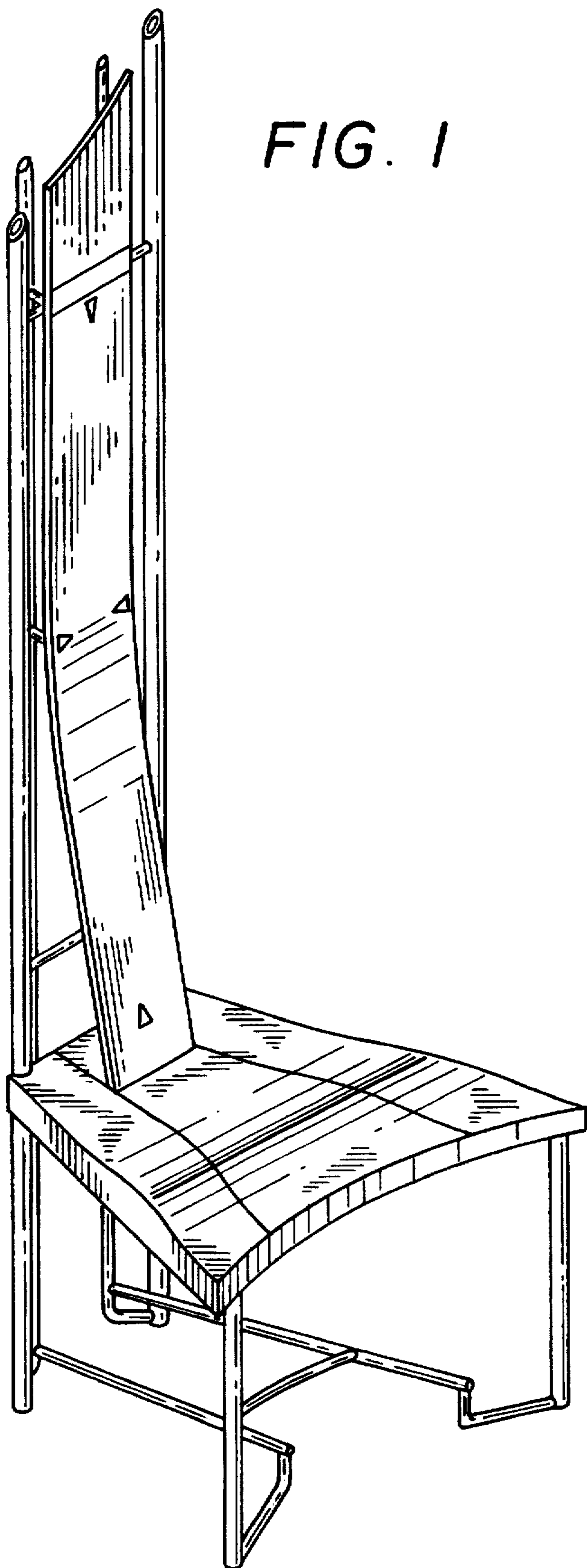

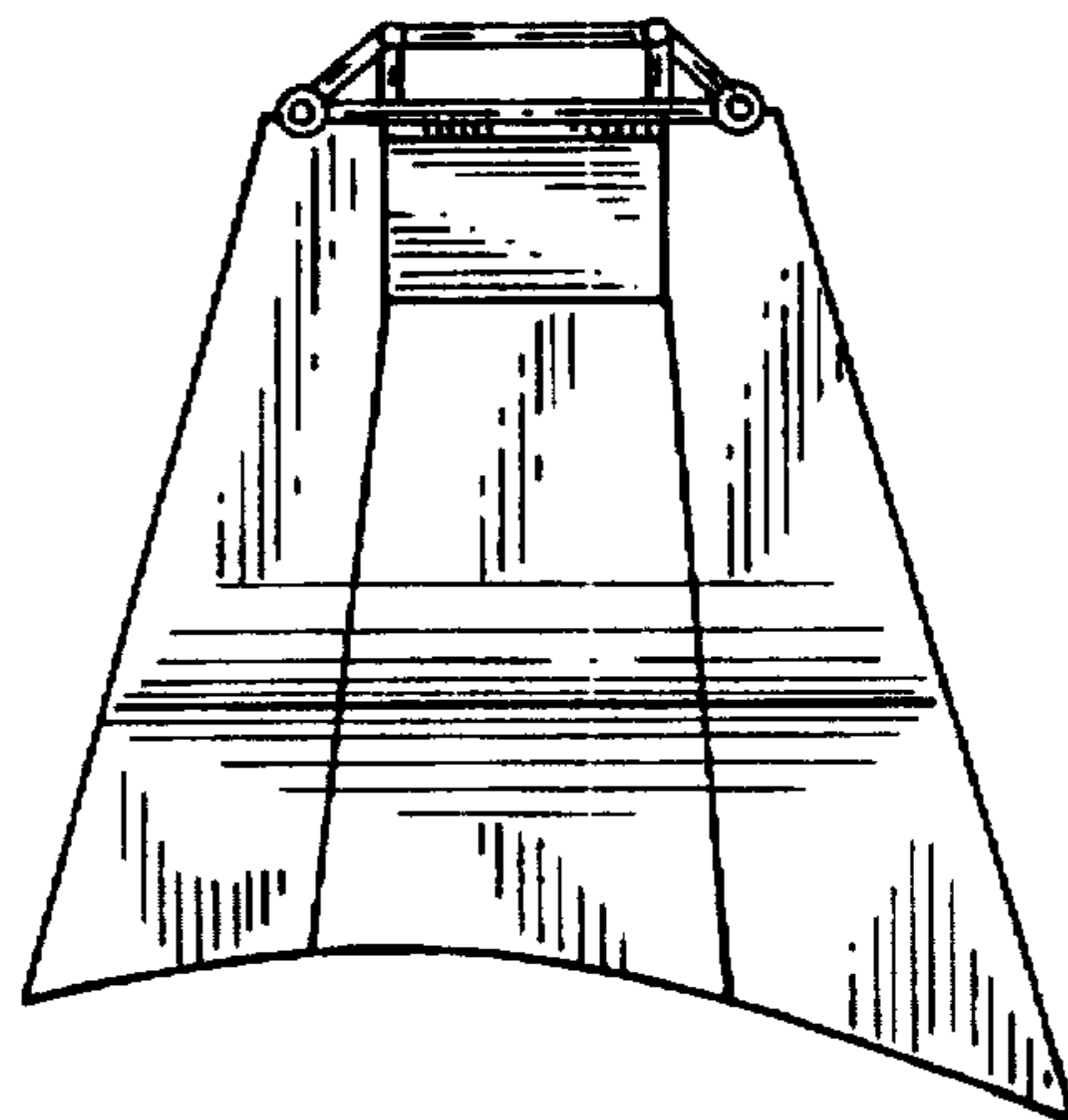

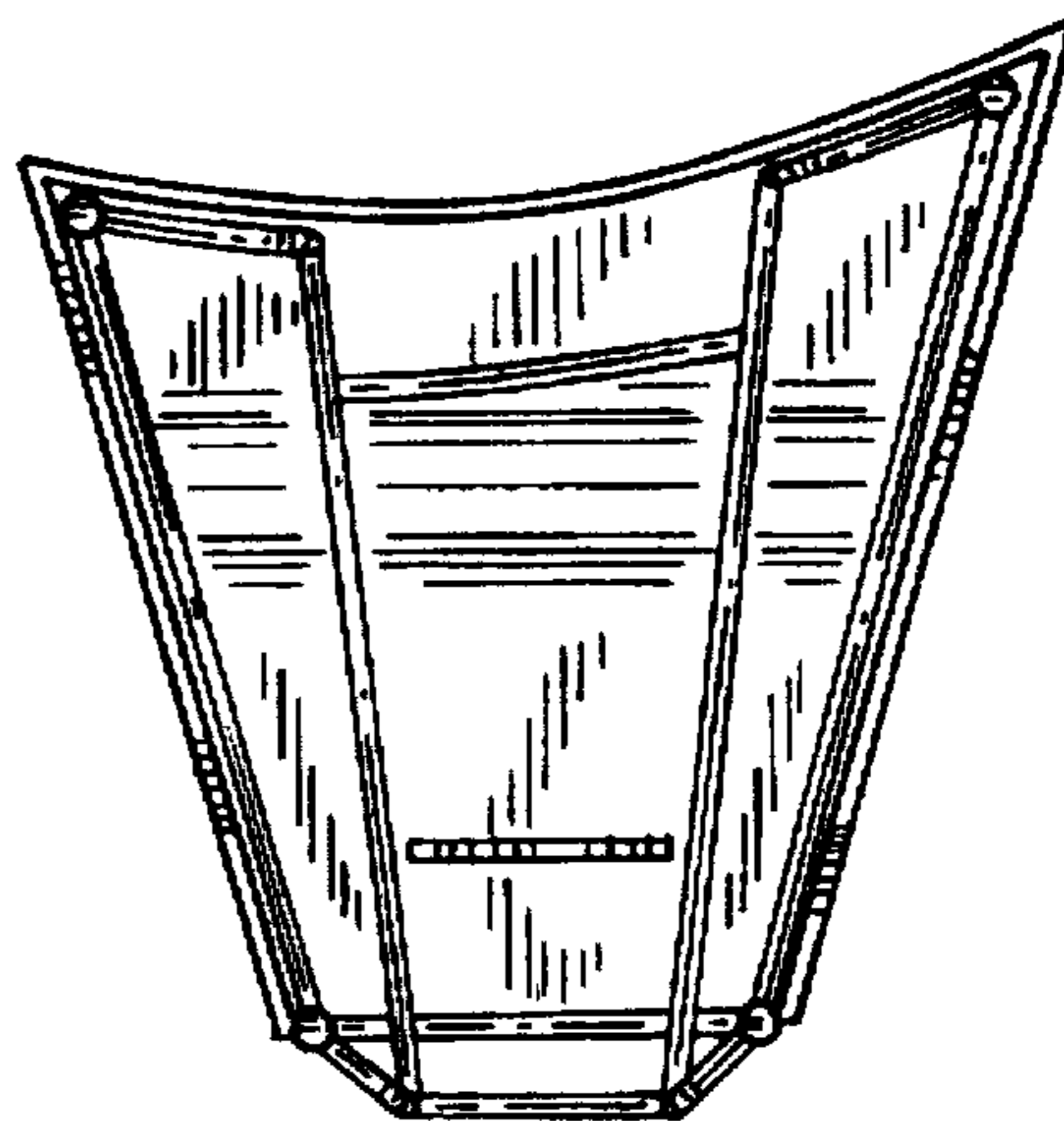

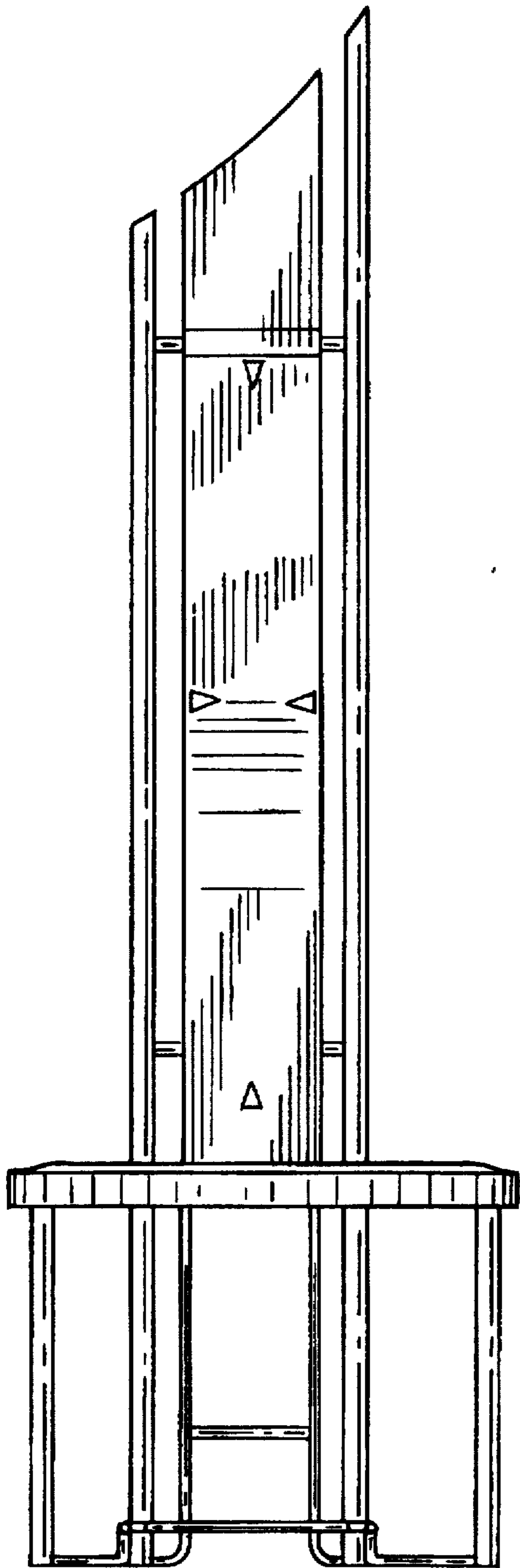
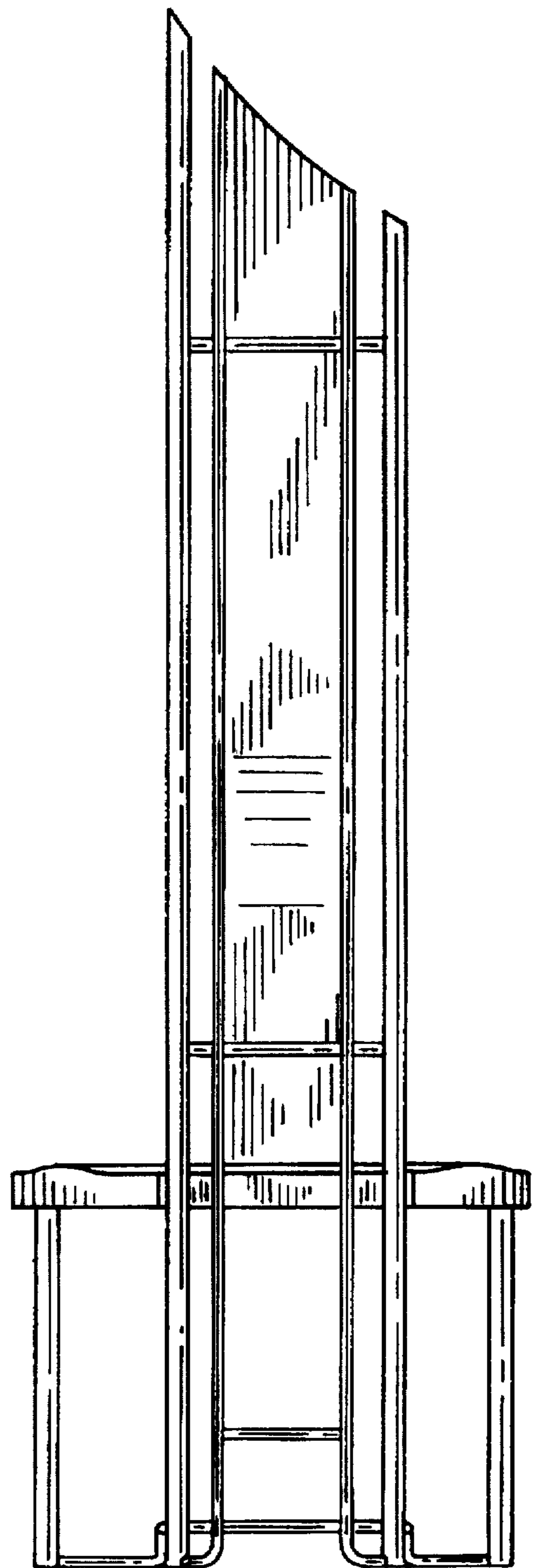

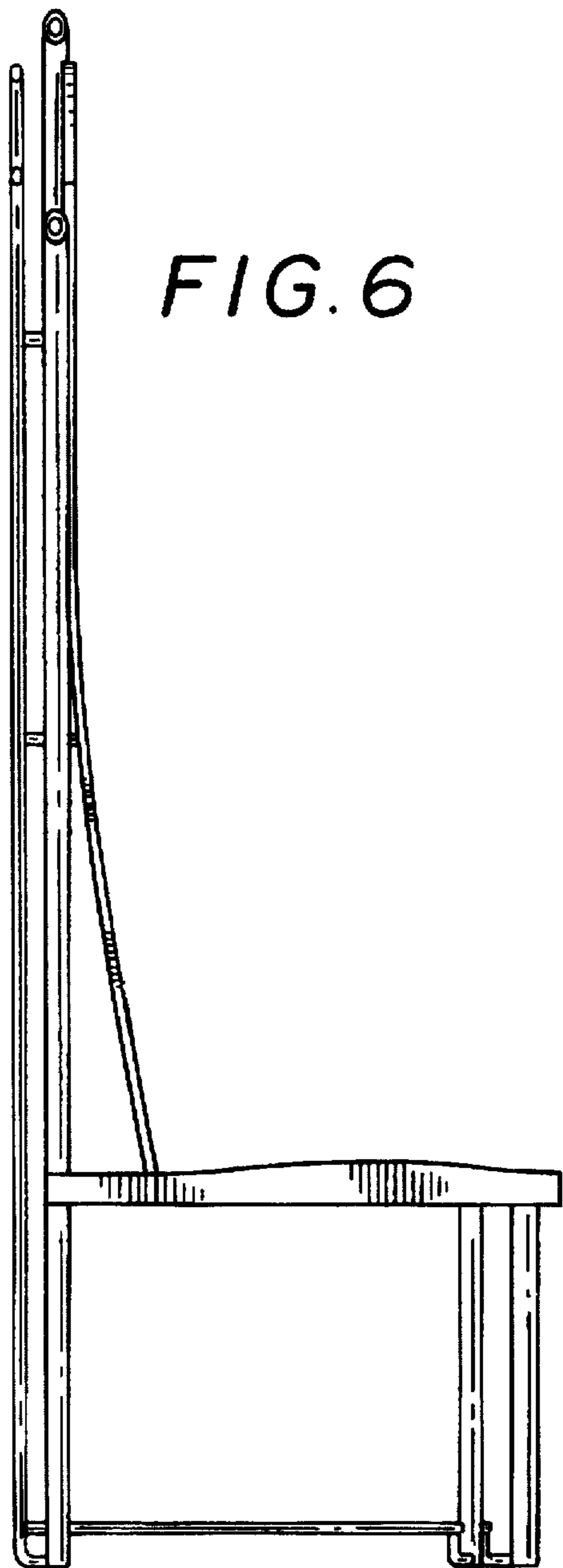

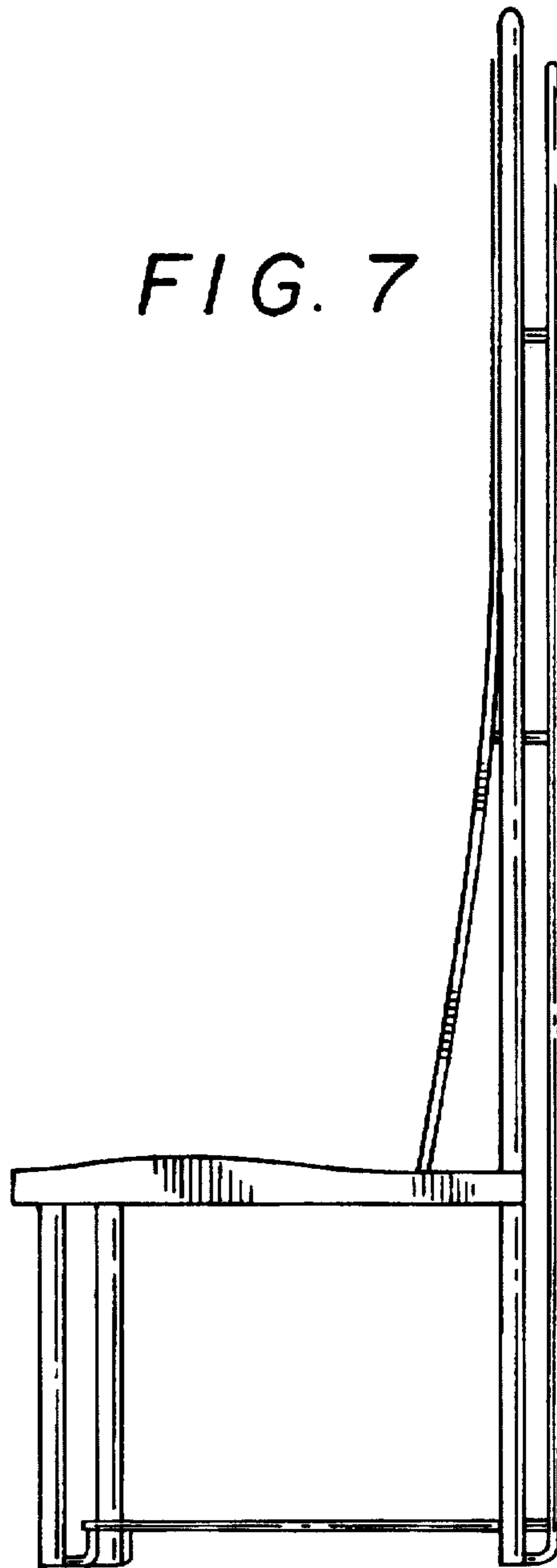

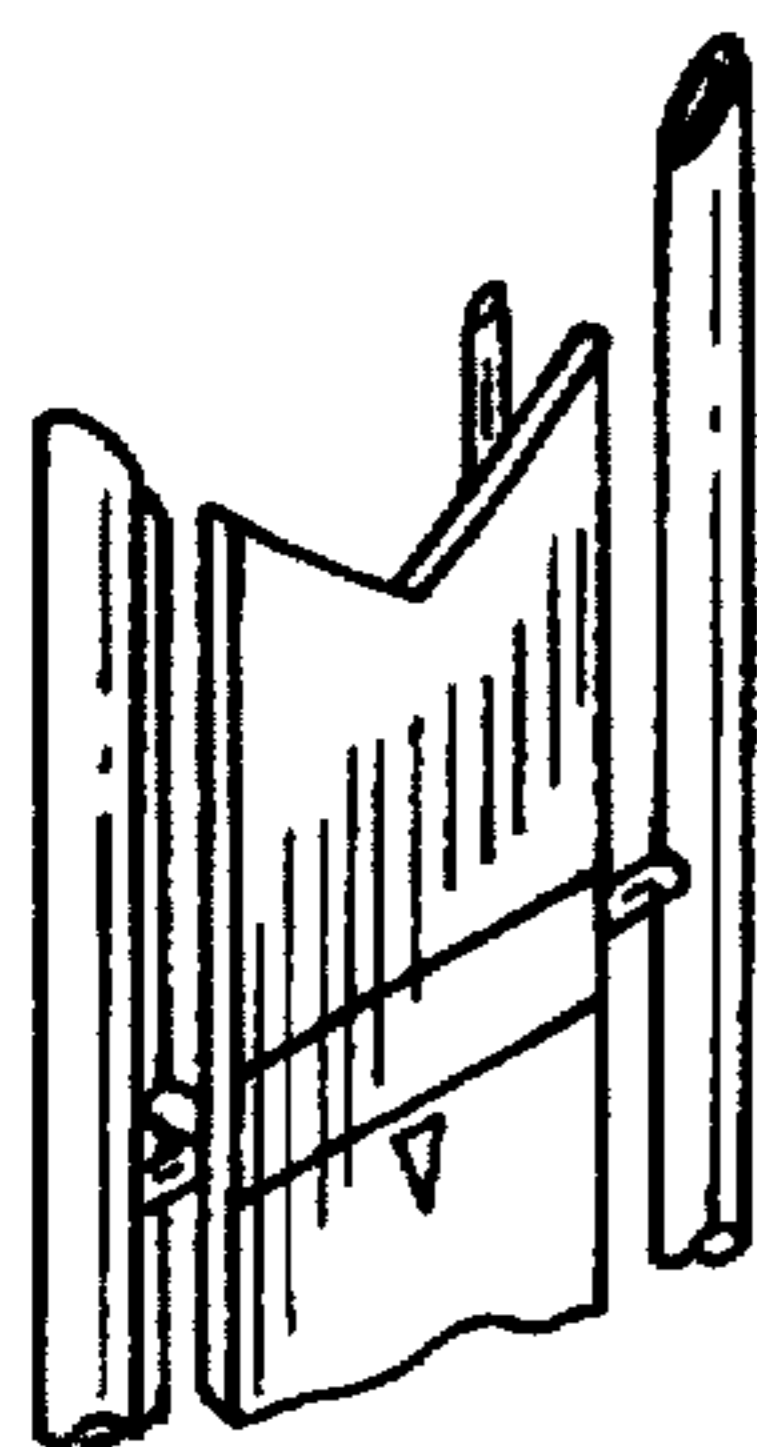

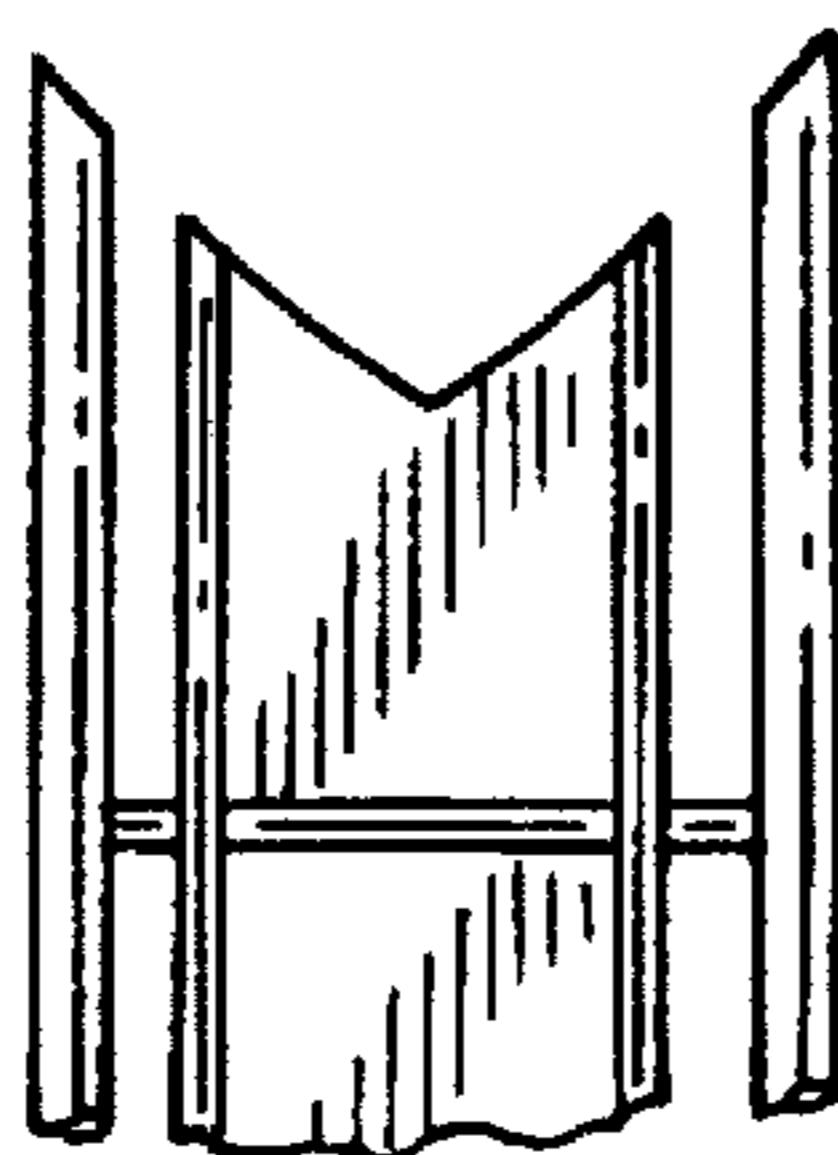

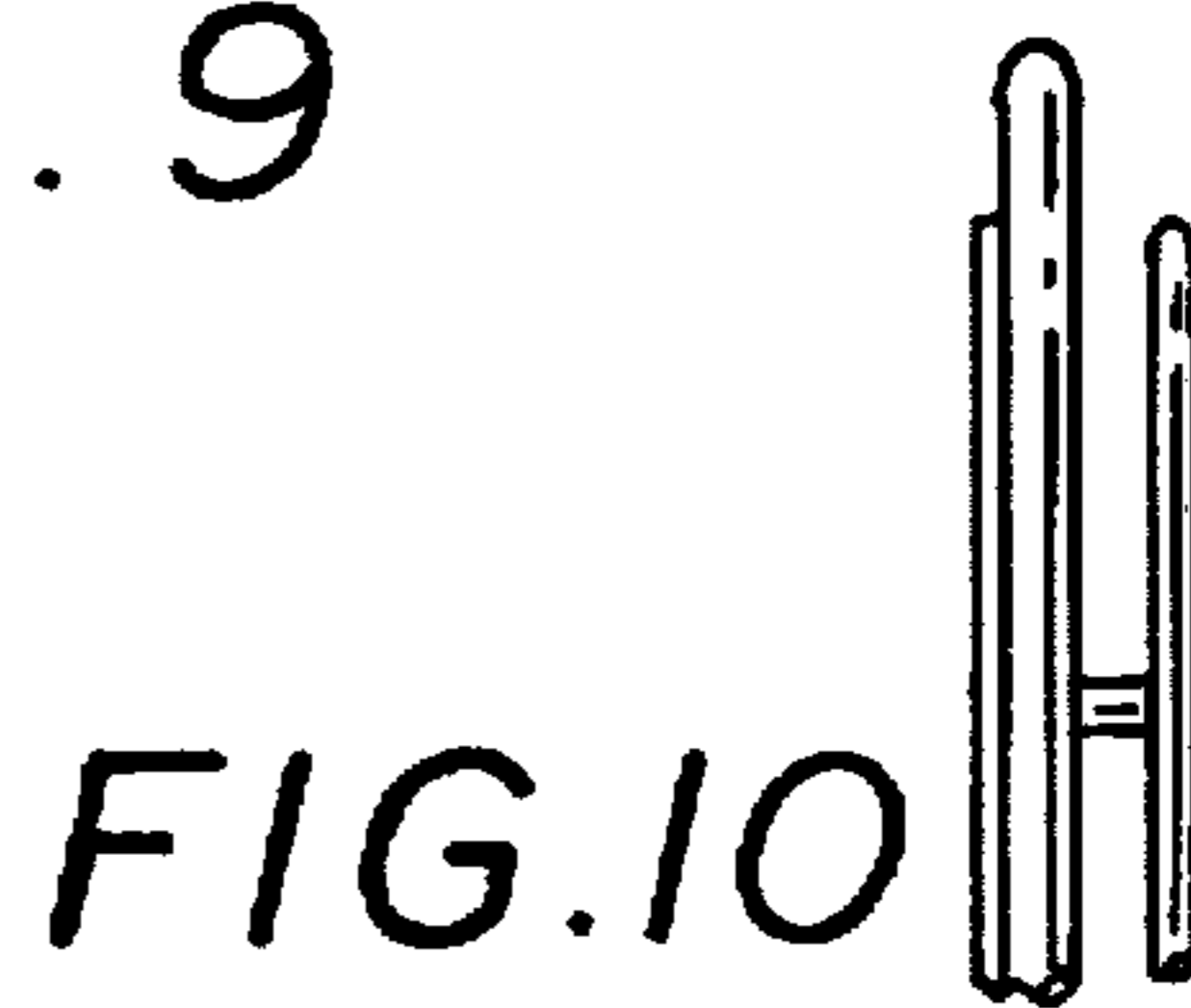

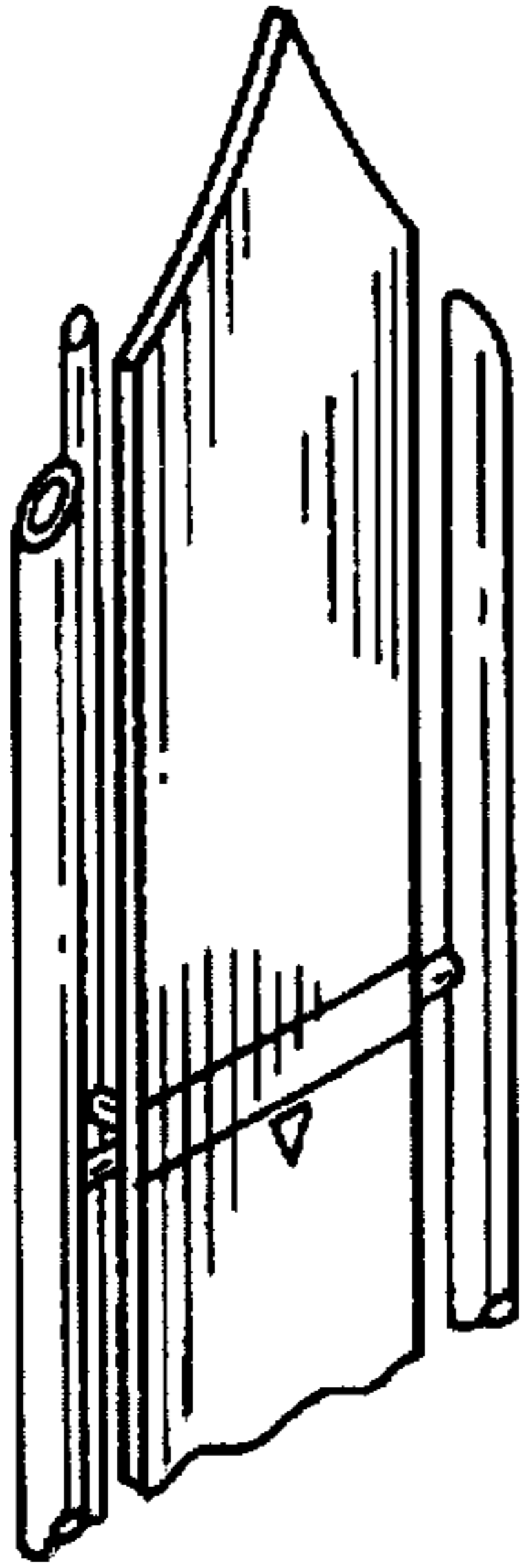

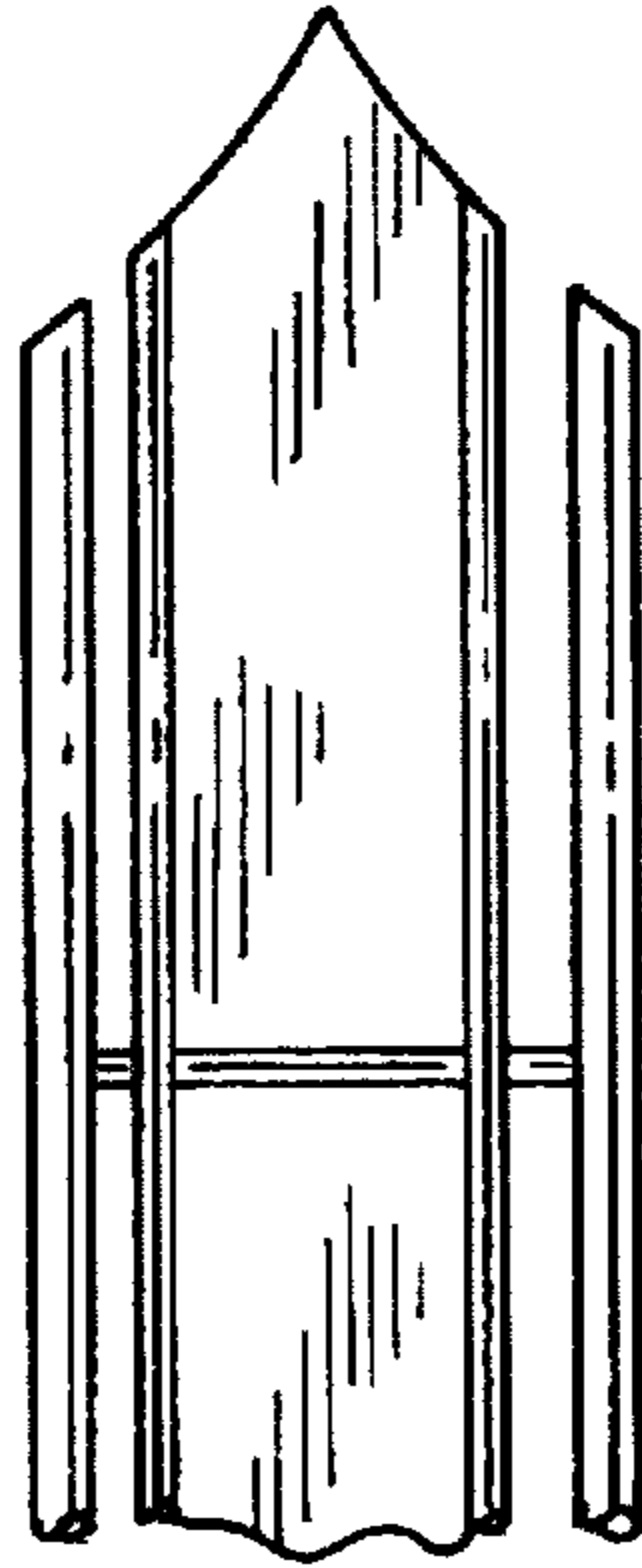

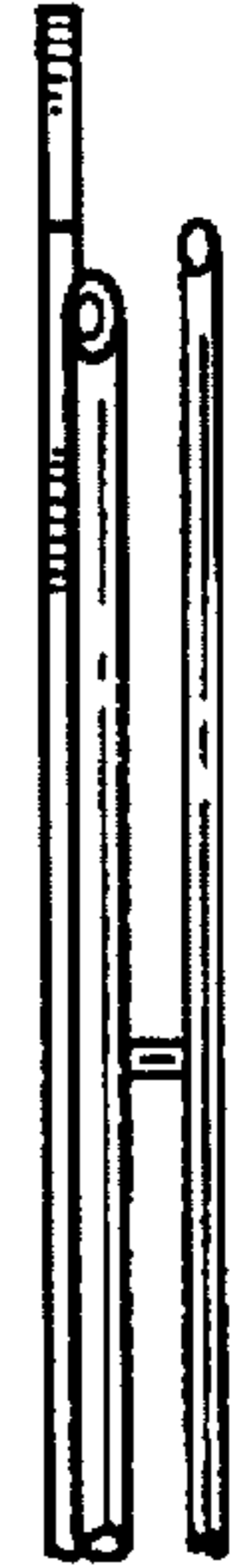

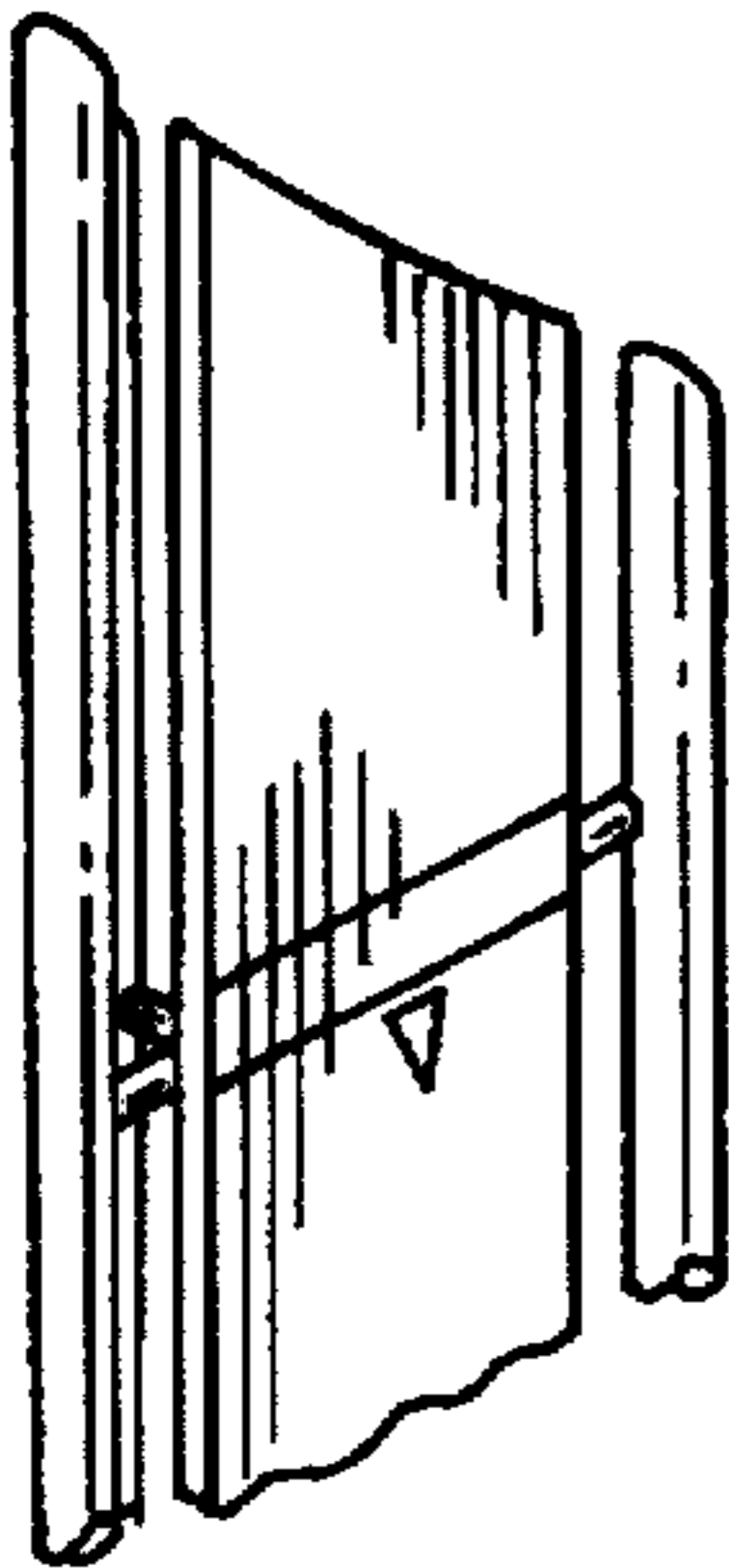

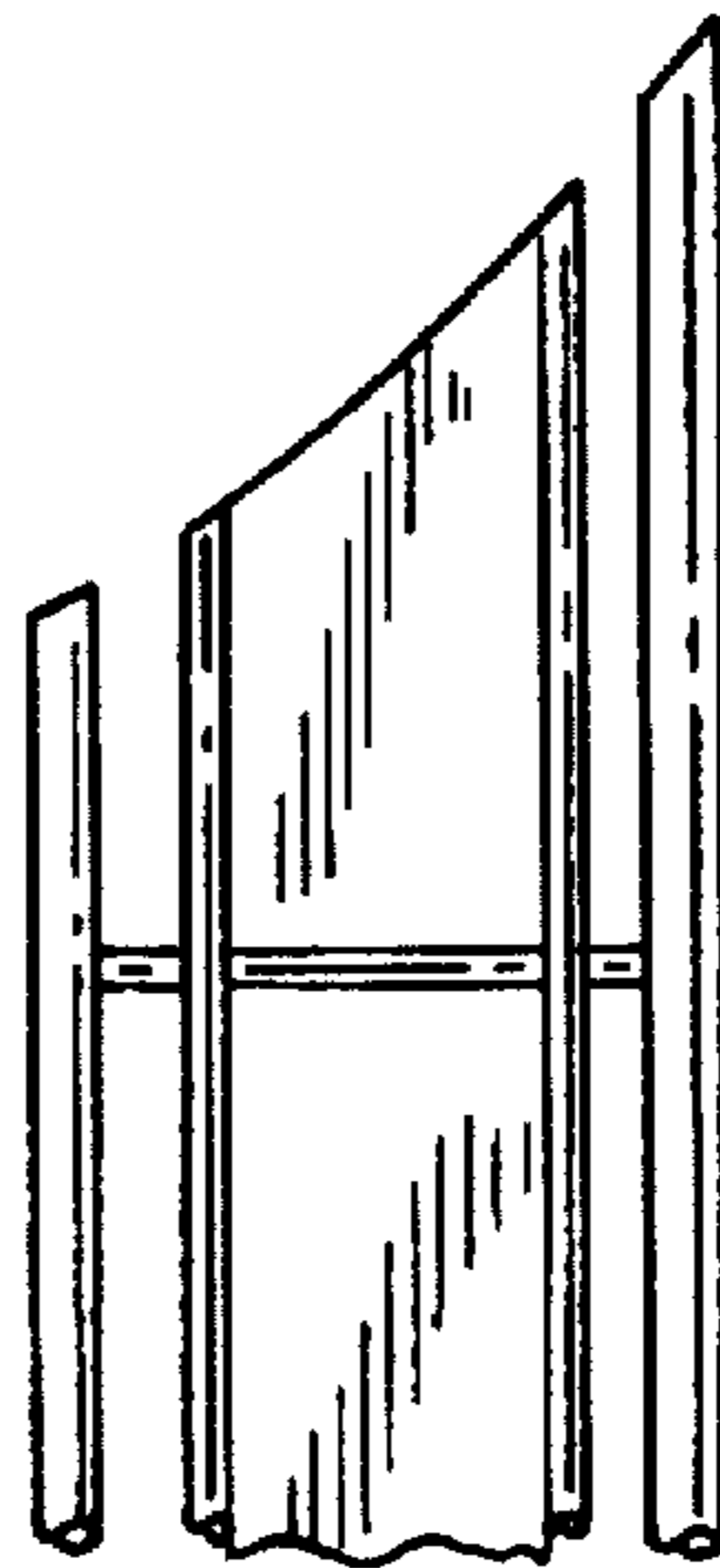
