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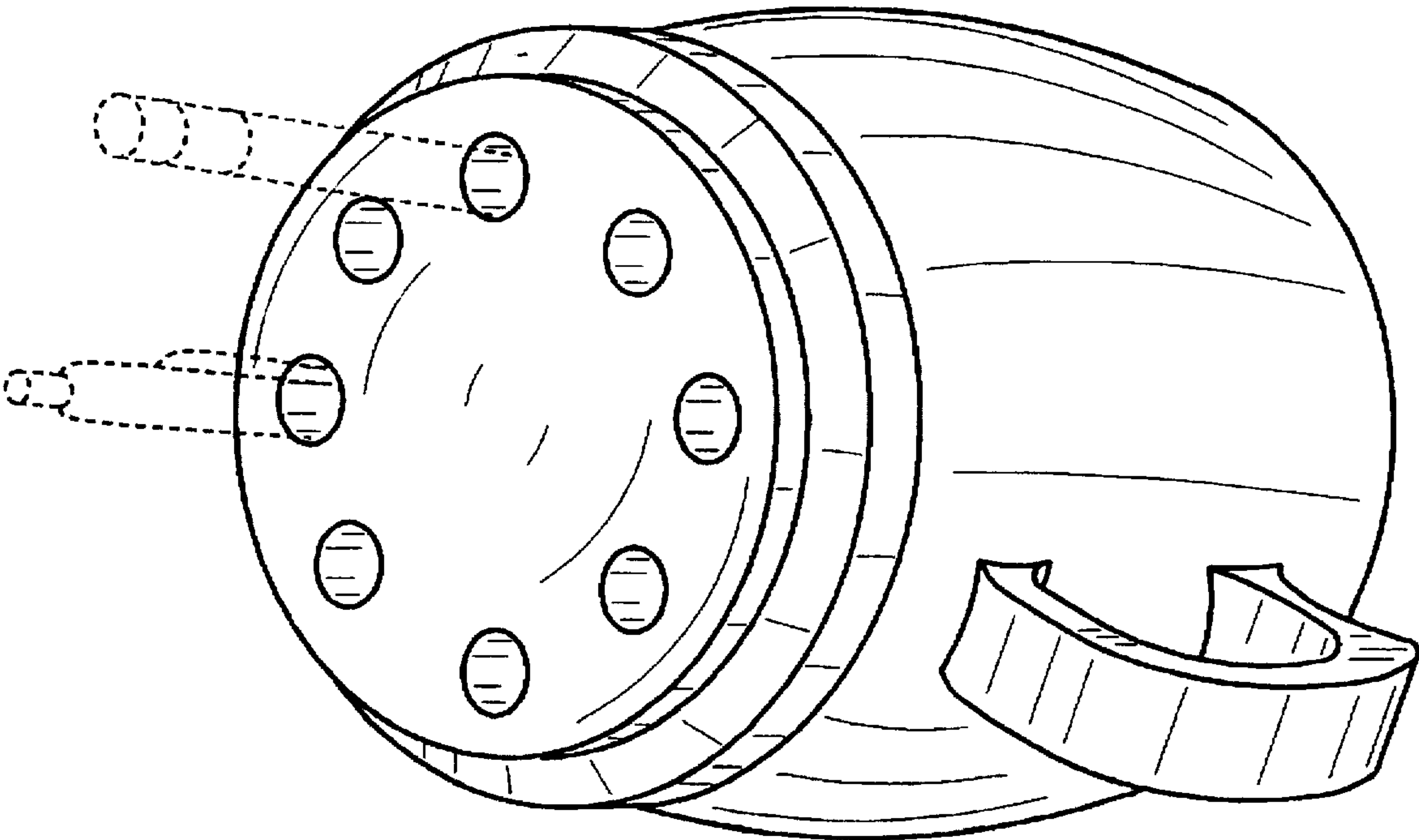
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a holder for elongated implements, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view showing the holder for elongated implements of the new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a front view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 2. The broken lines showing a pencil and pen are for illustrative purposes only. The pencil and pen form no part of the claimed design.

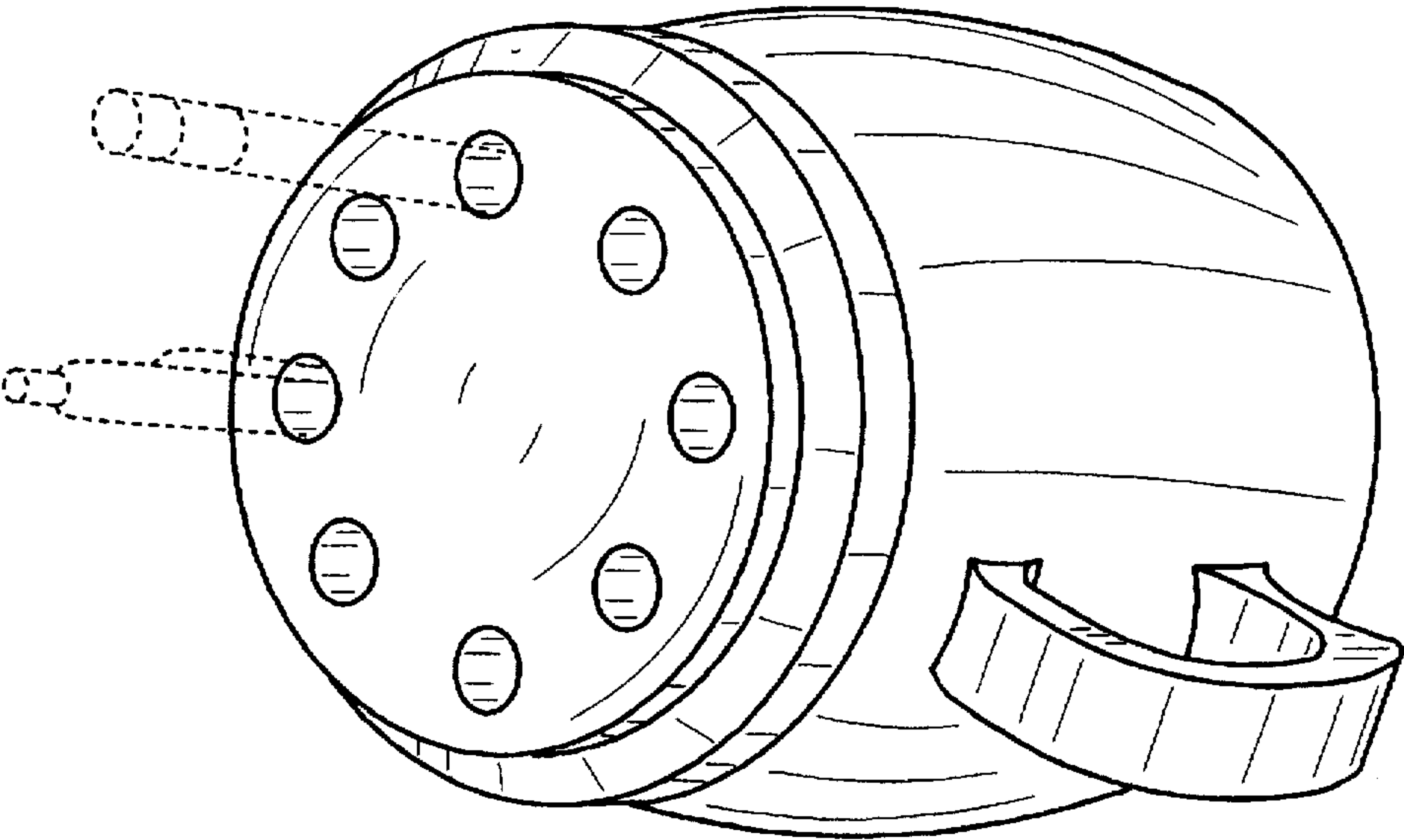

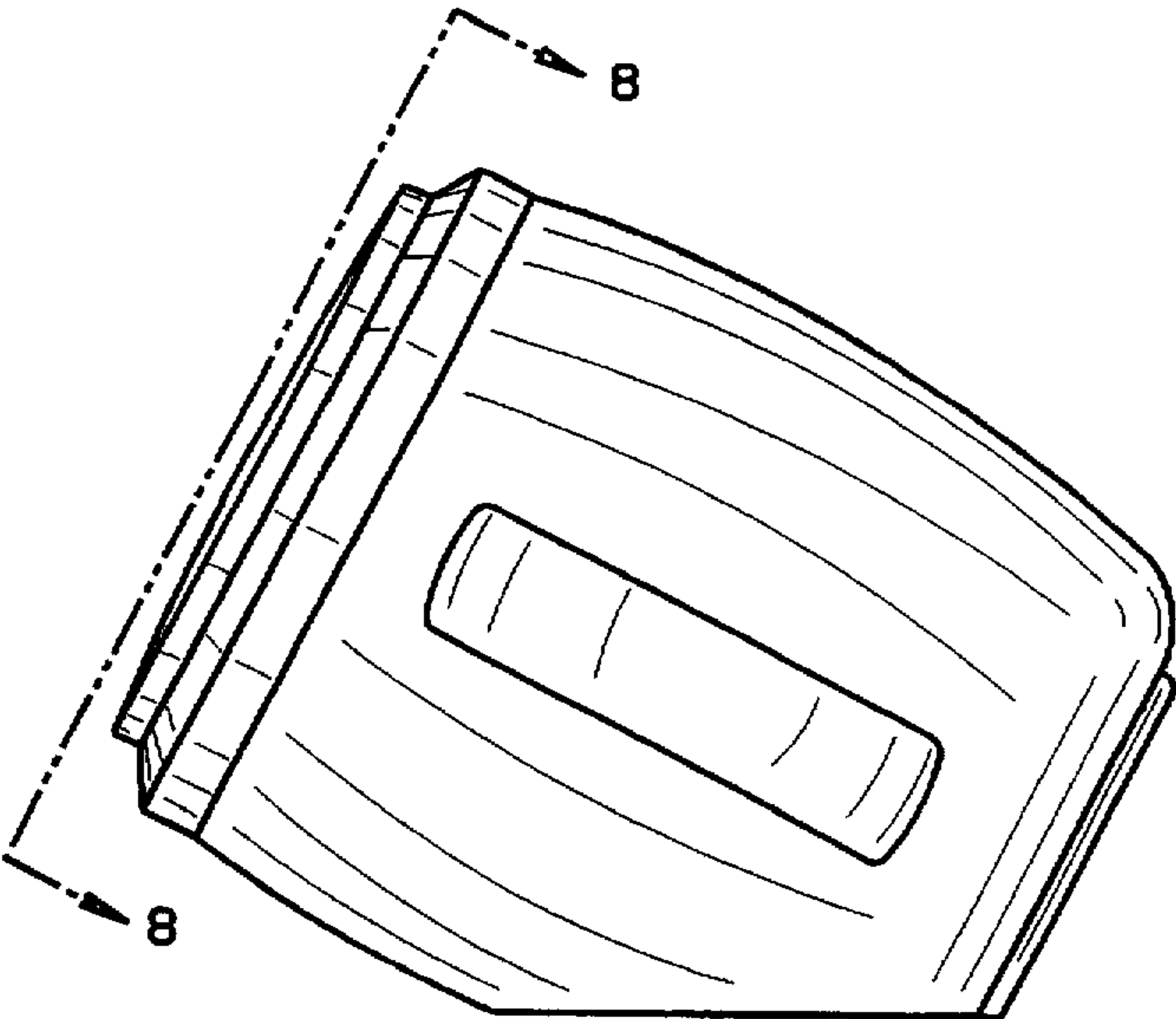

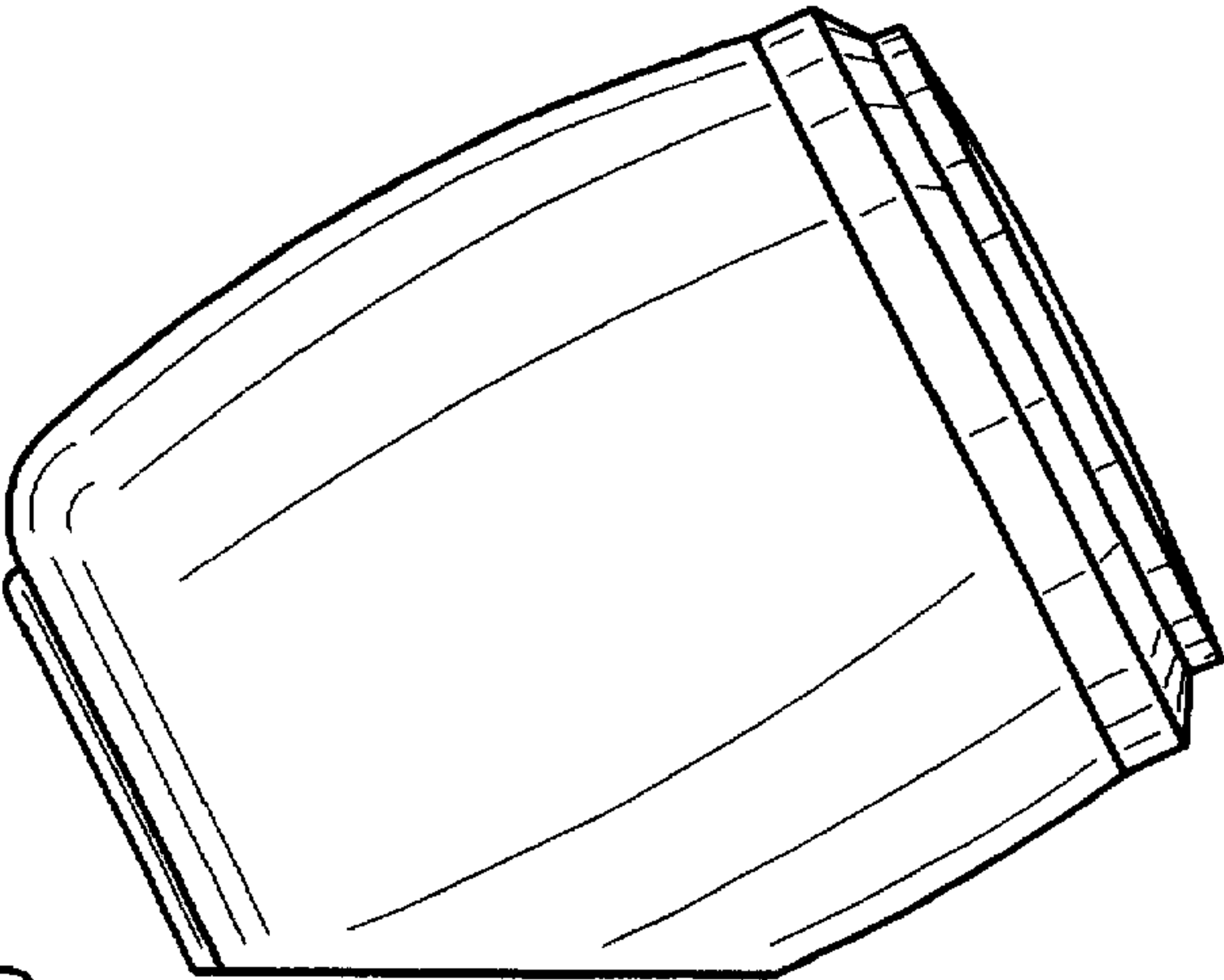

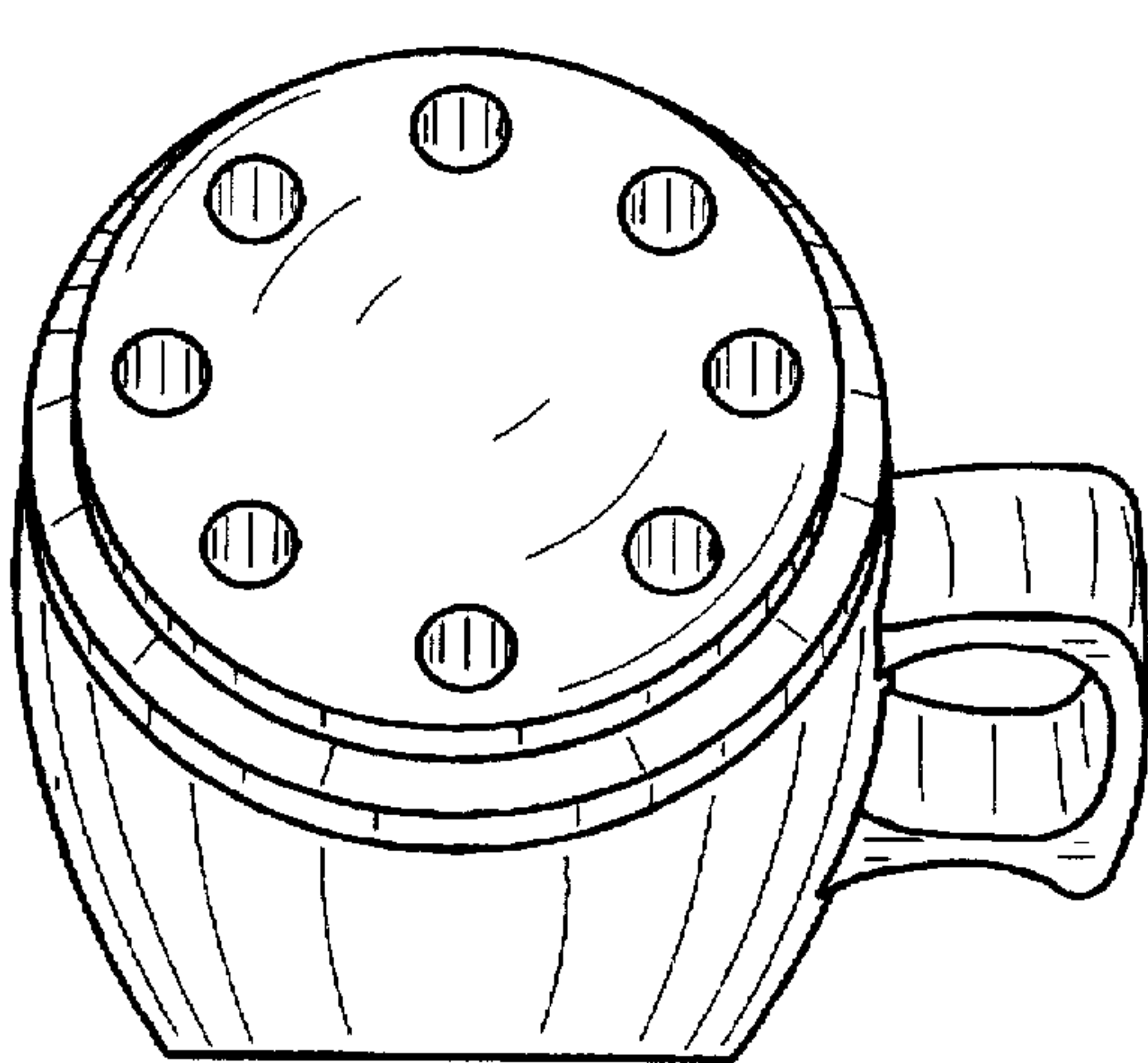

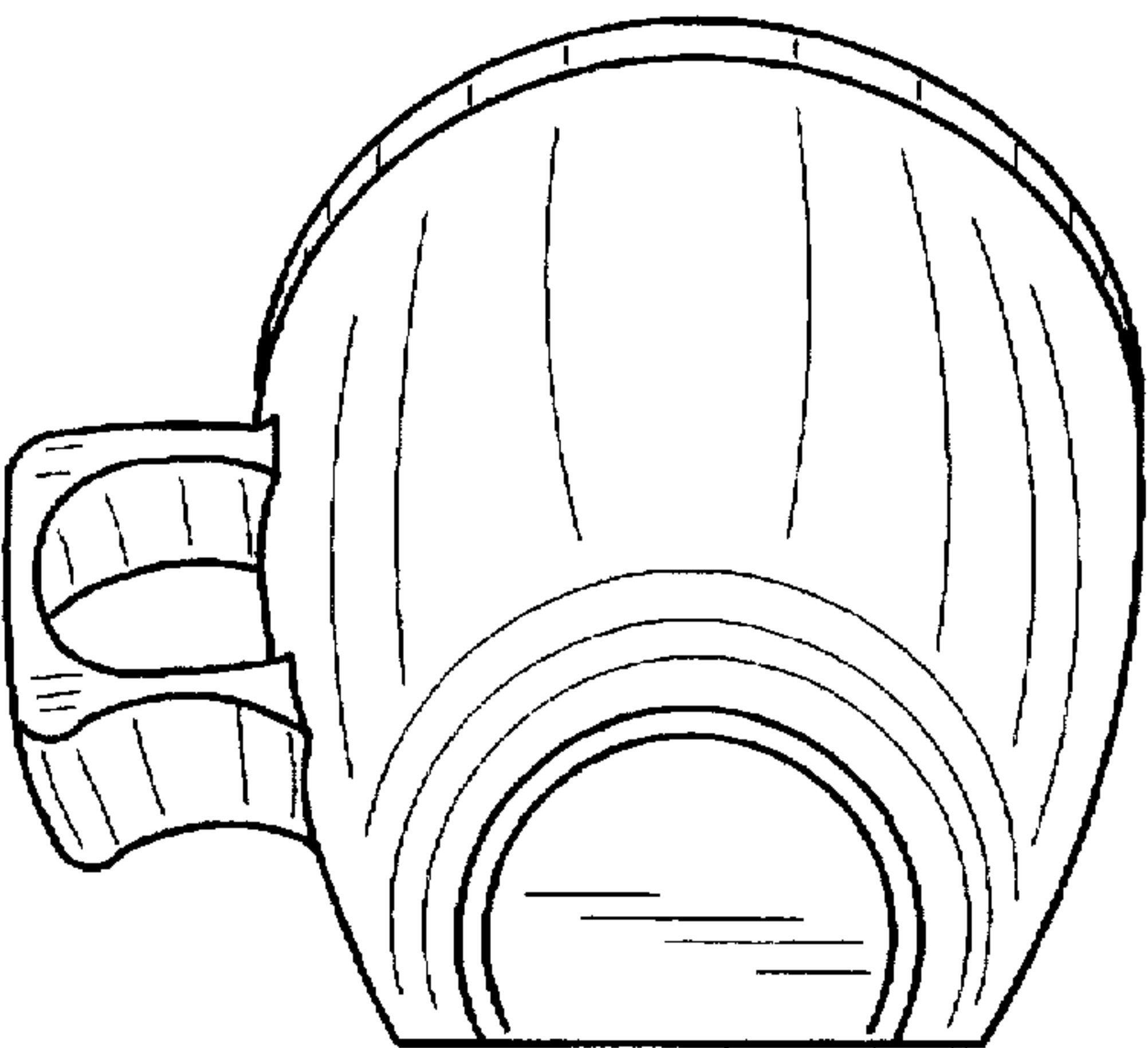

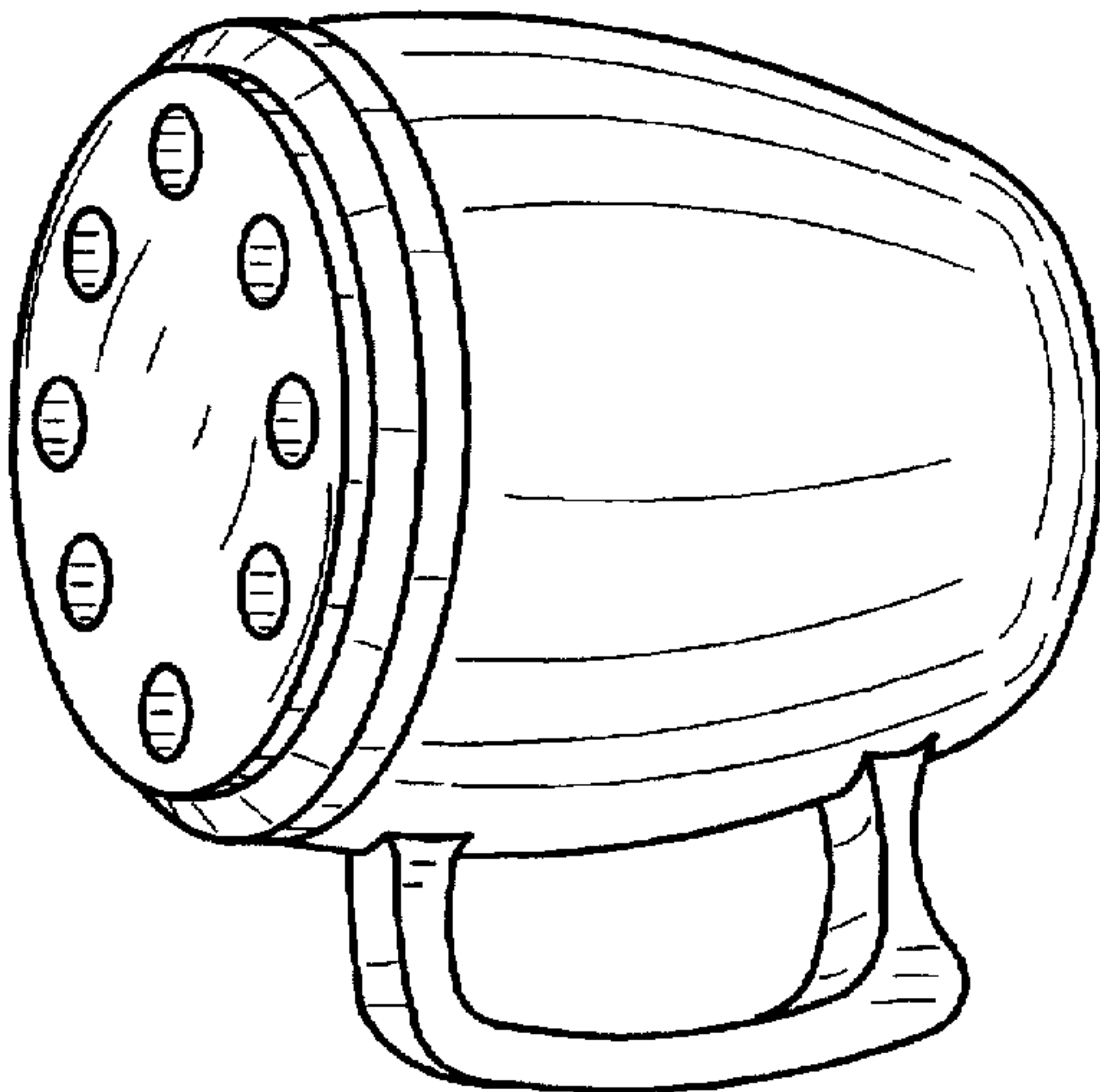

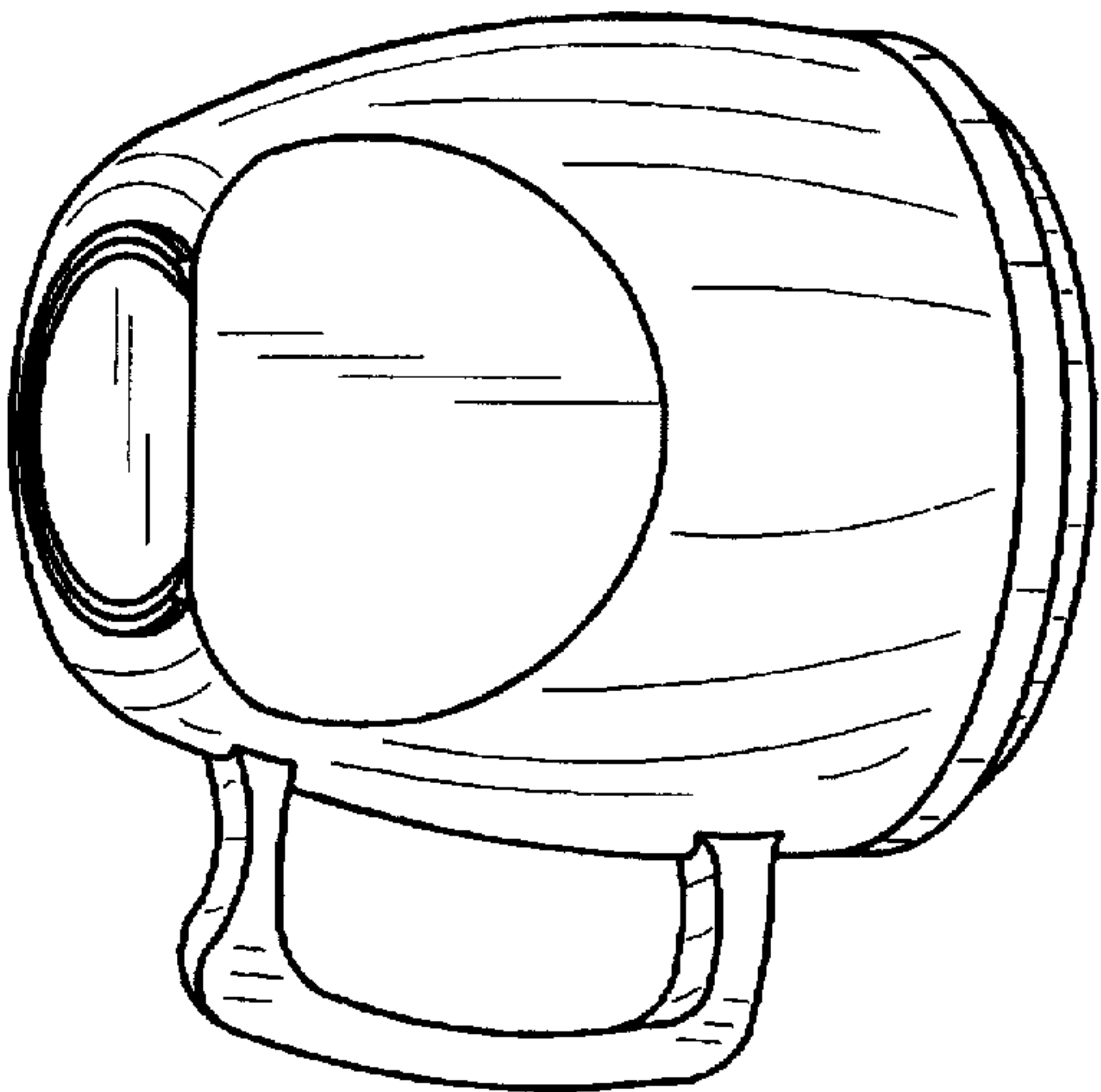

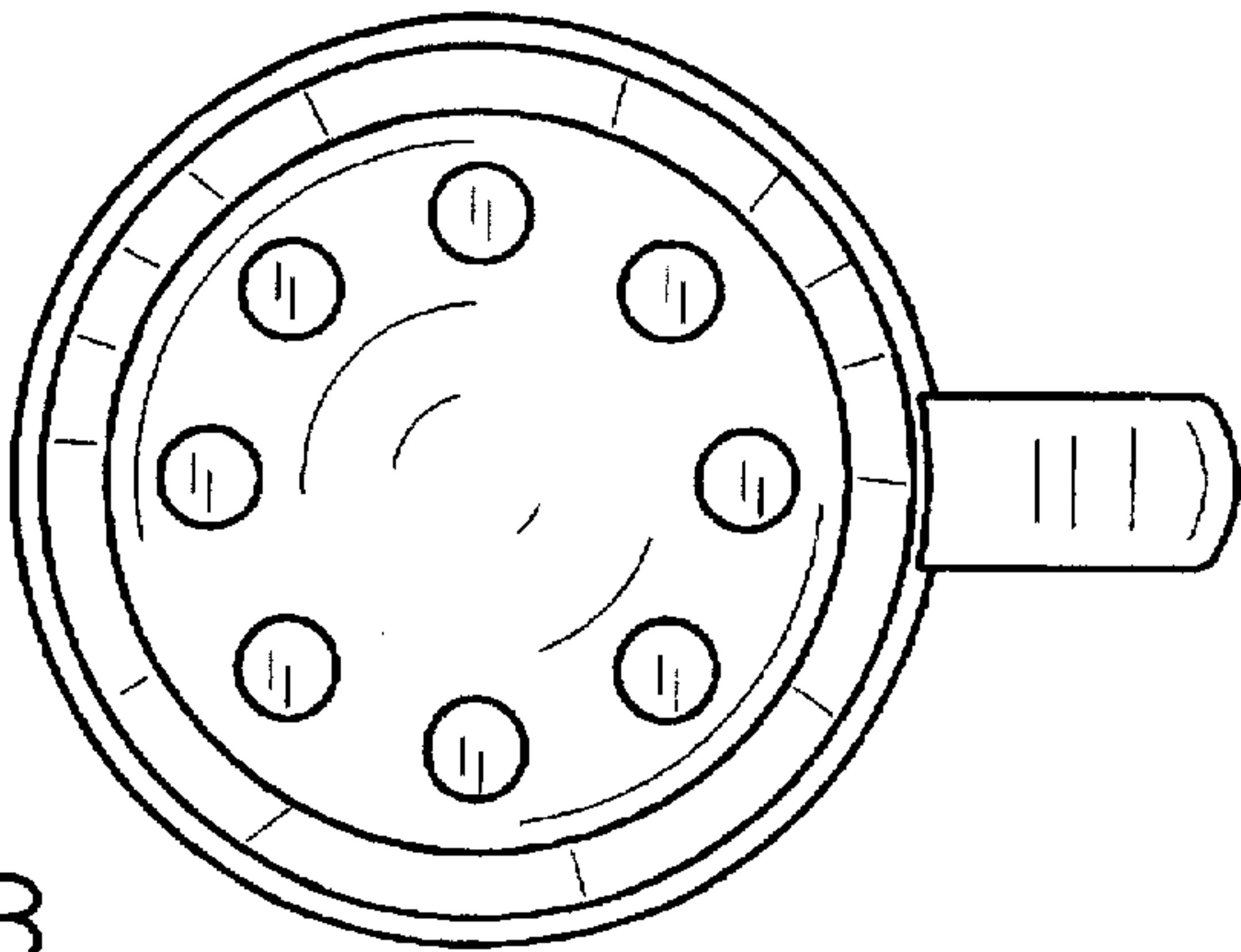
