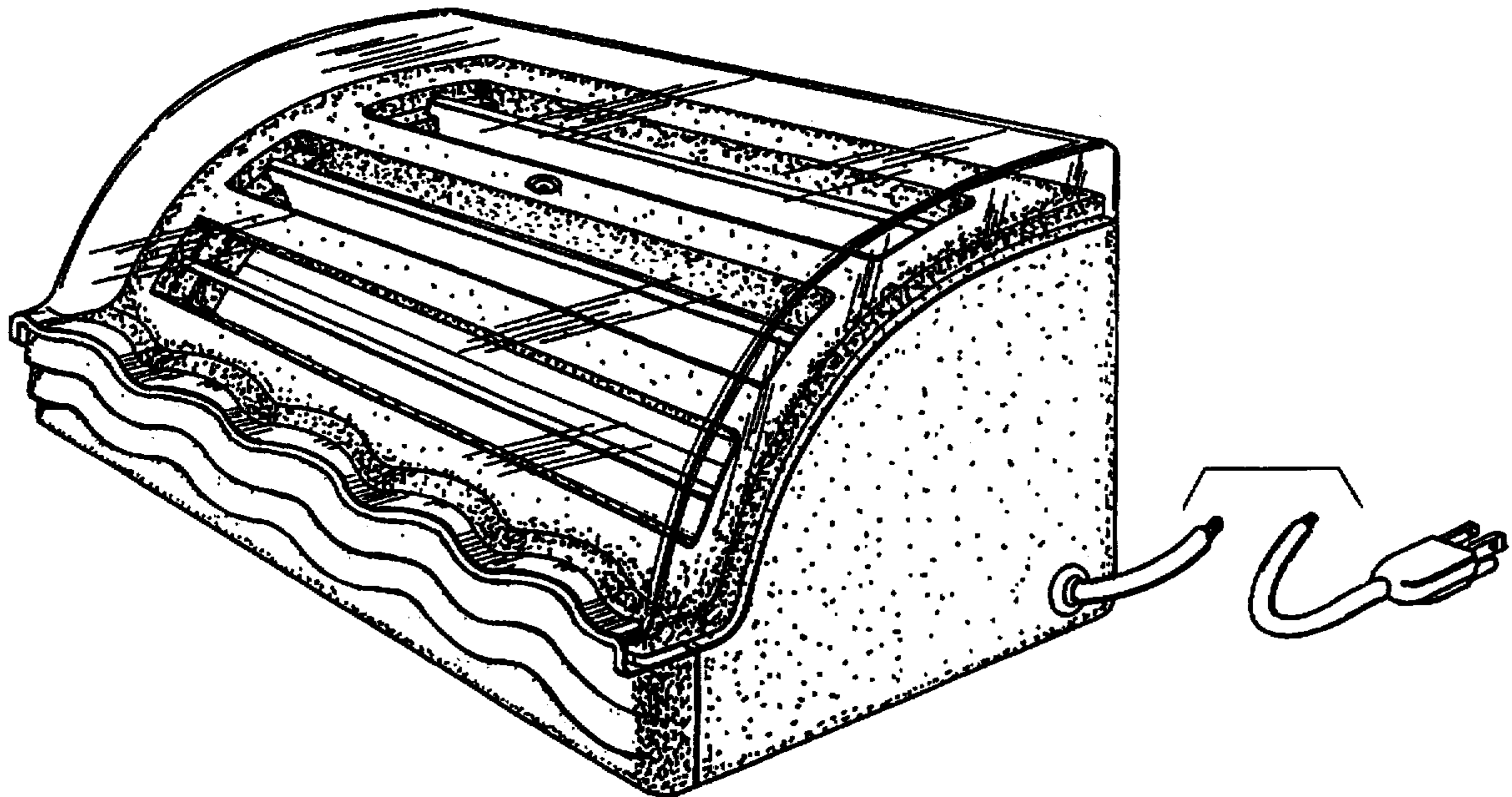
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a heating unit for hair clips, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right side perspective view of a heating unit for hair clips showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof. The cord element is shown partially broken away in FIG. 1 to indicate indeterminate length, and omitted in the remaining views for ease of illustration.

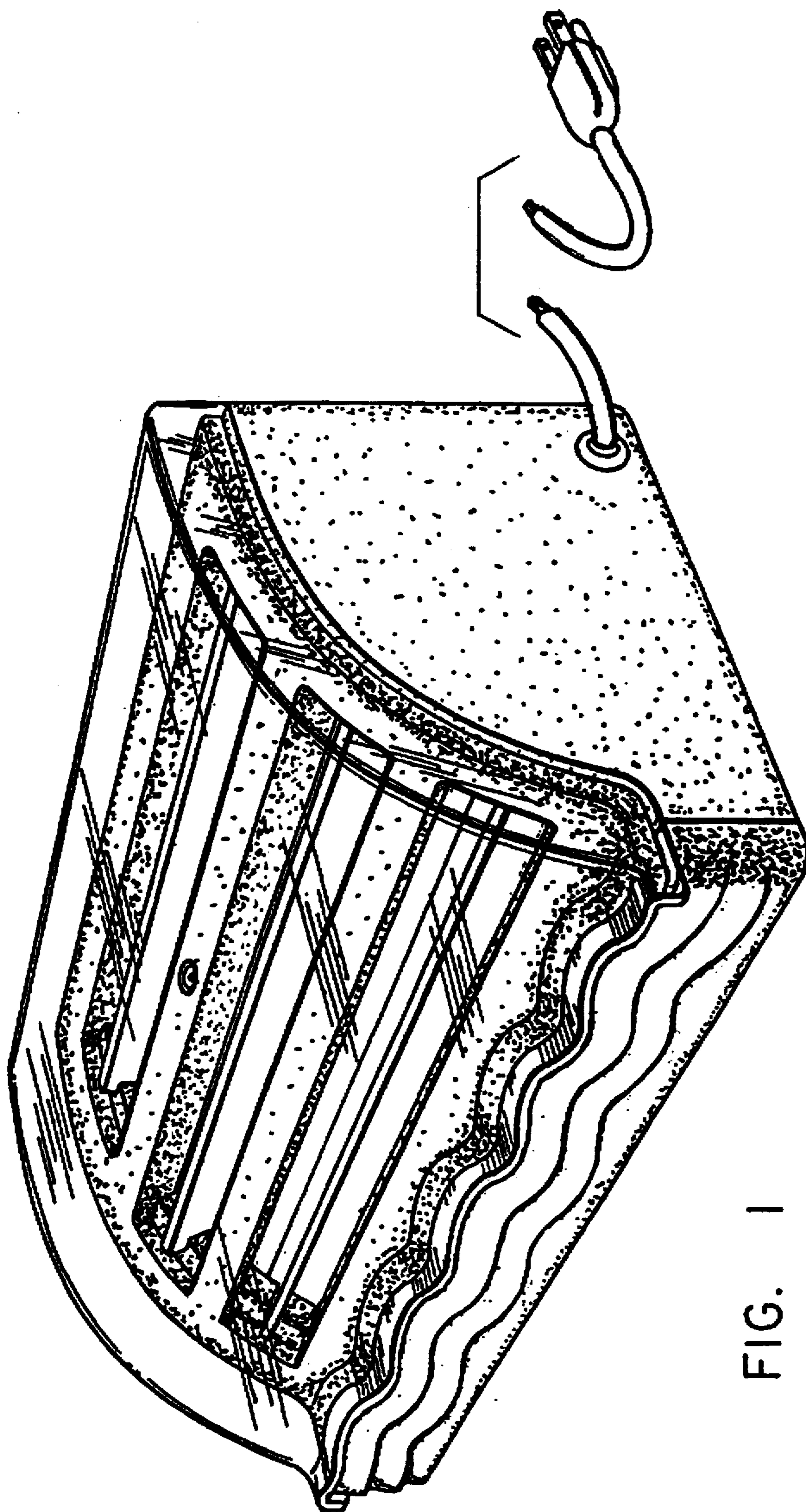

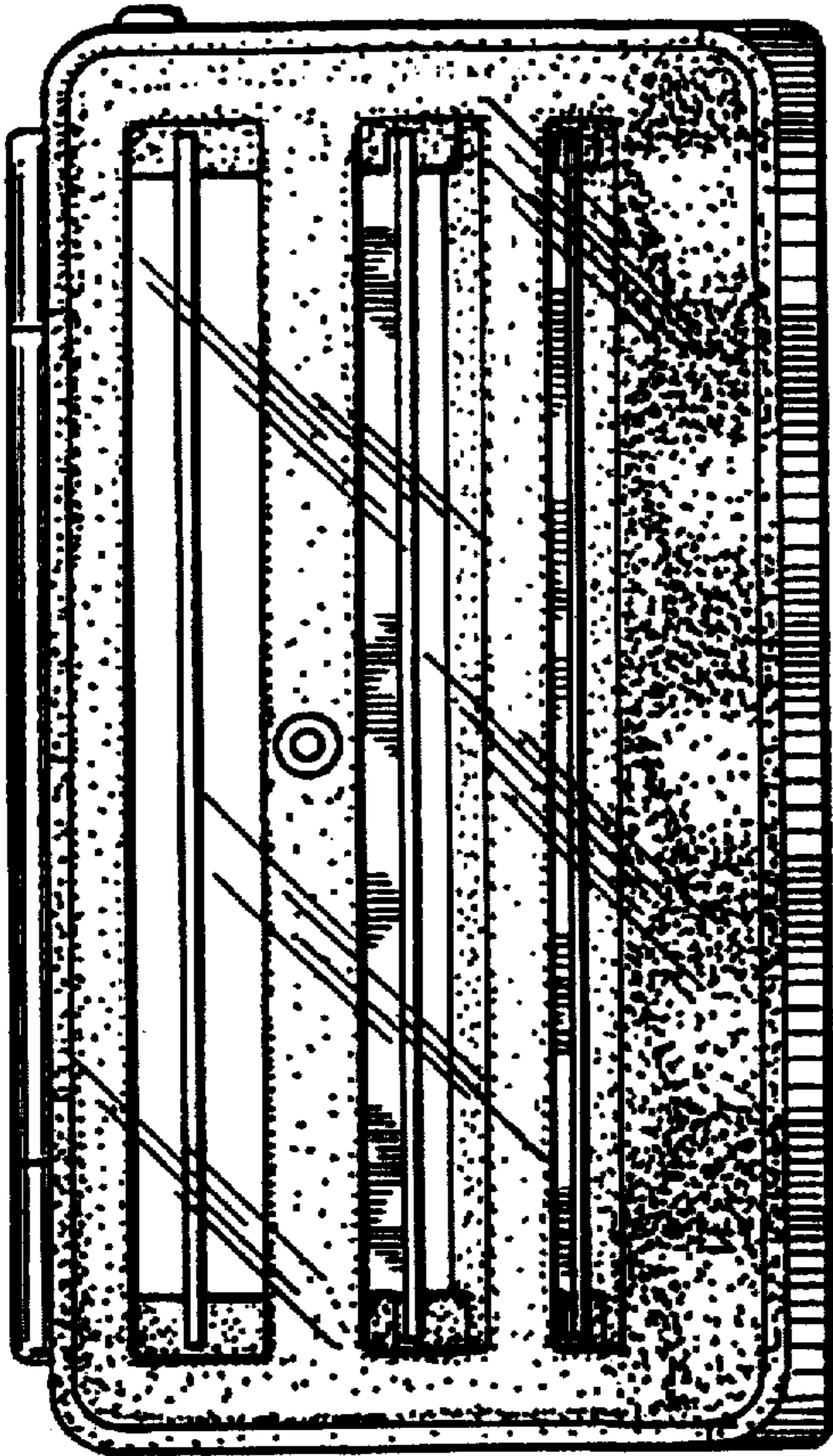

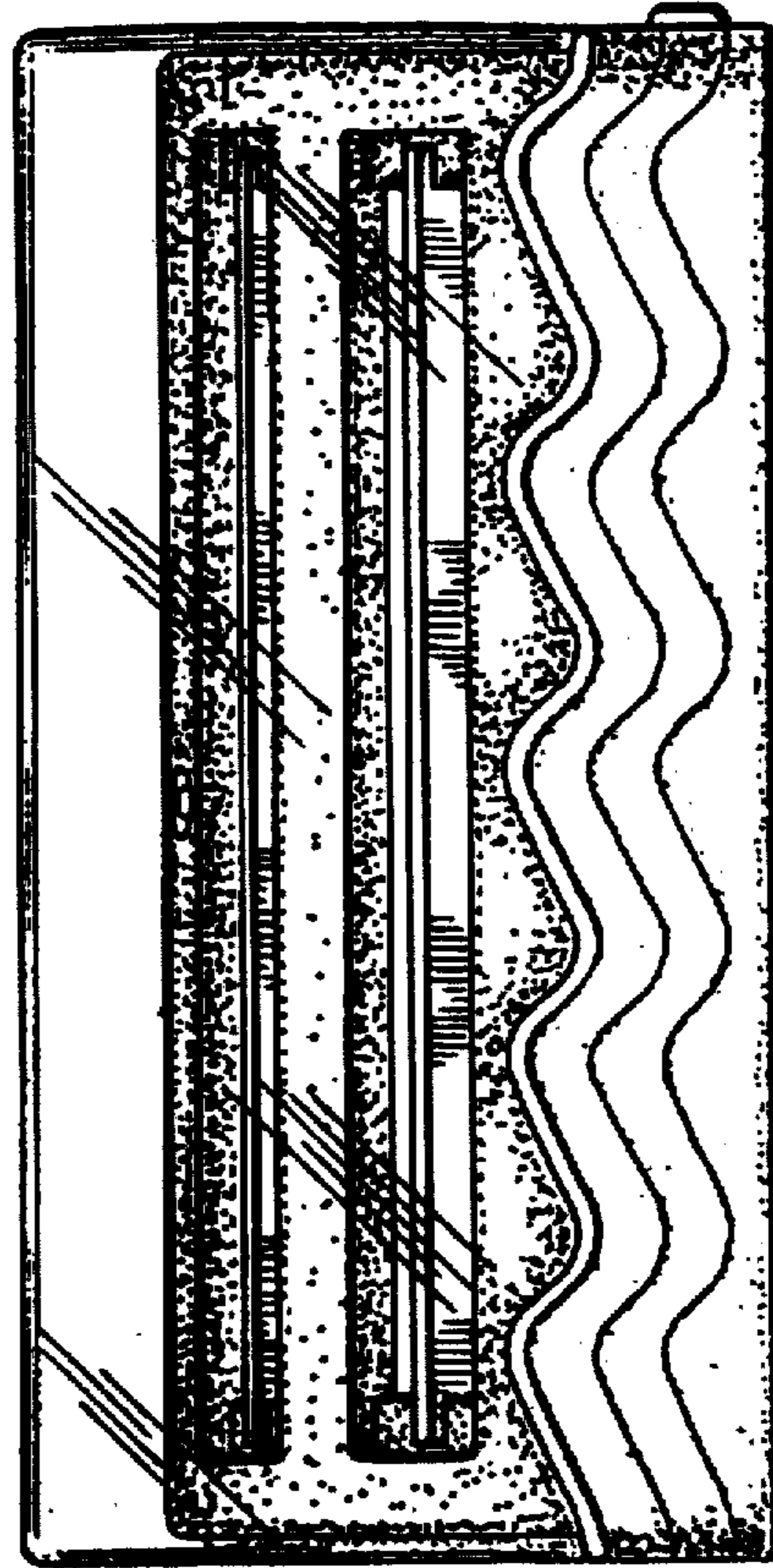

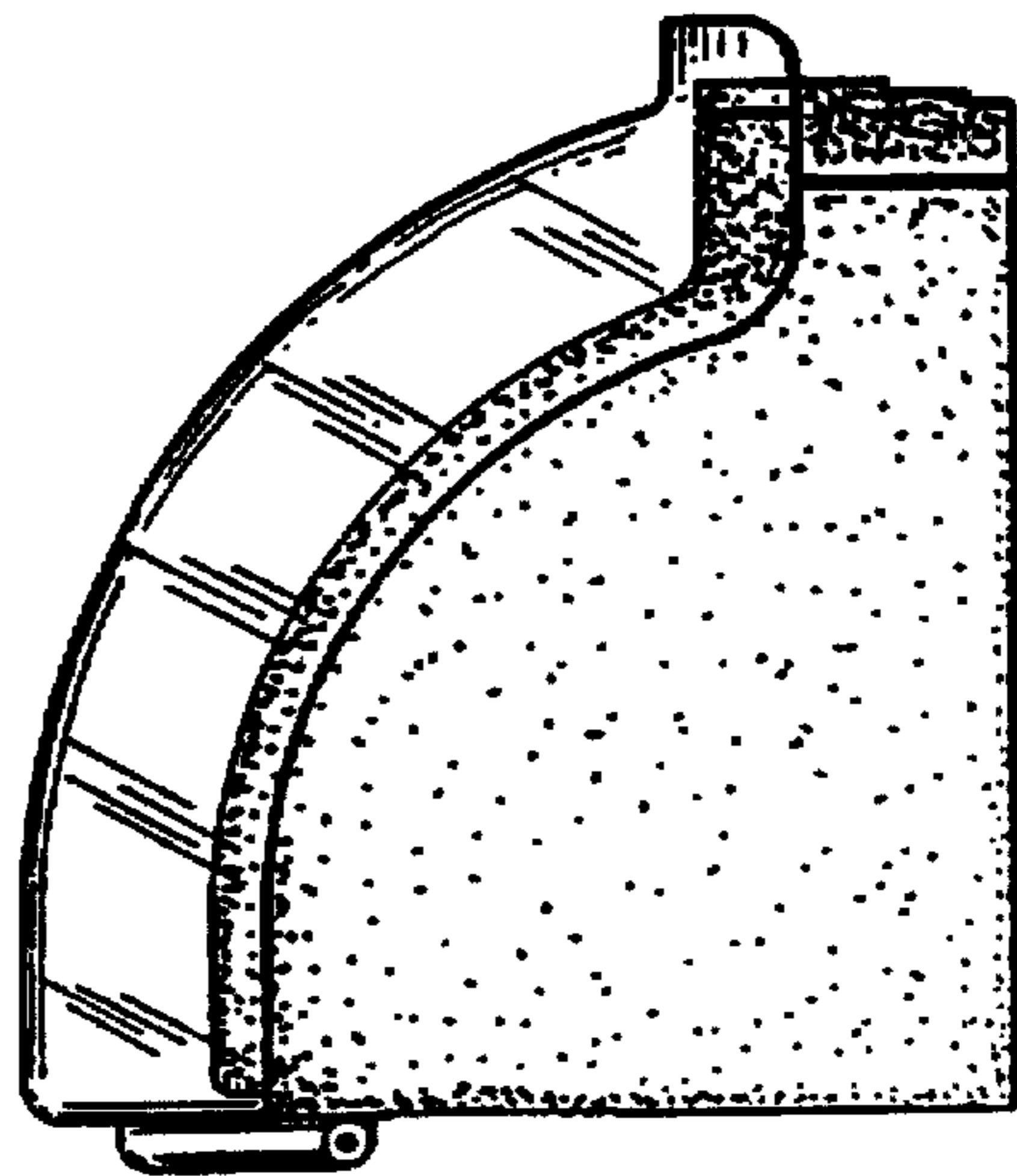

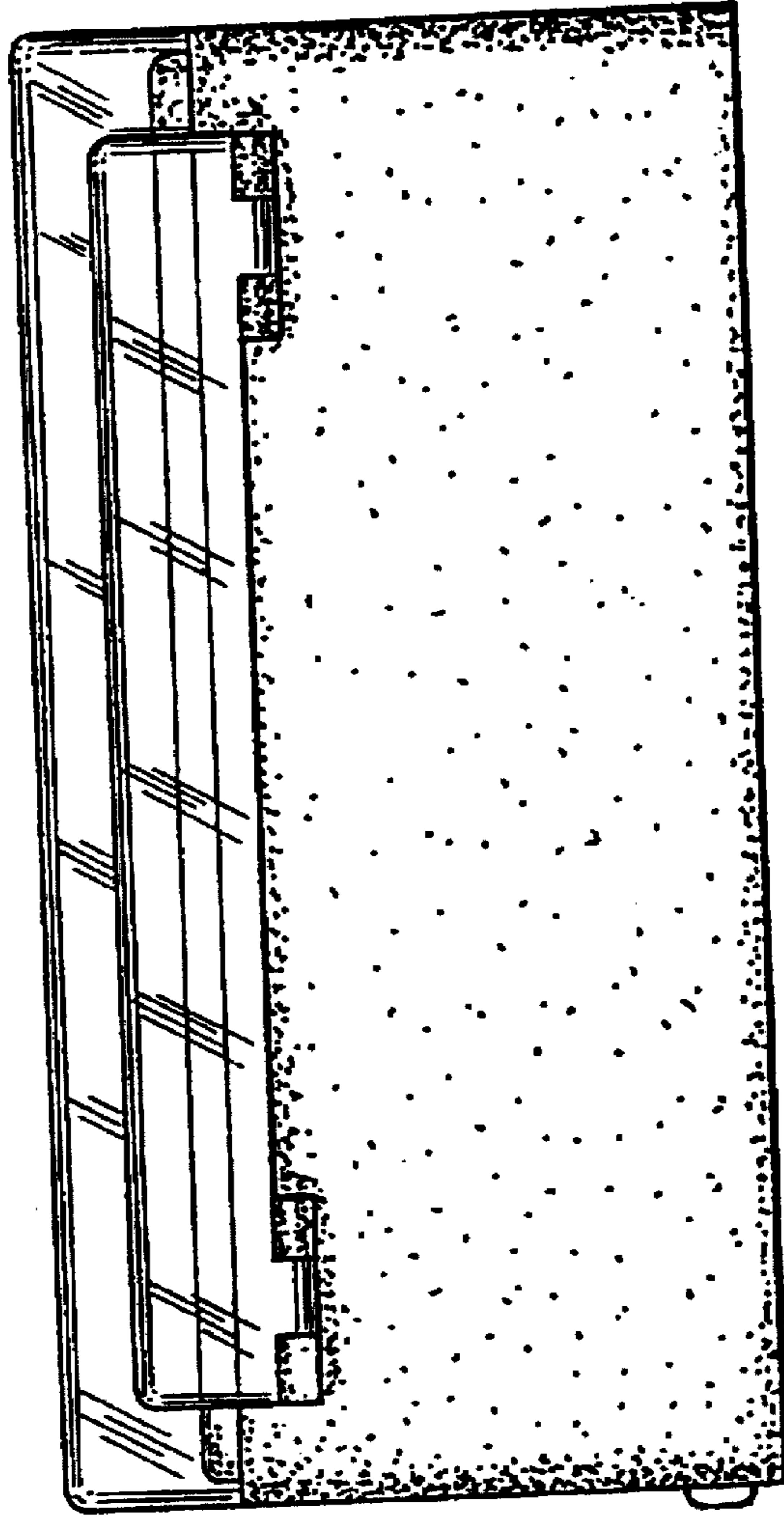

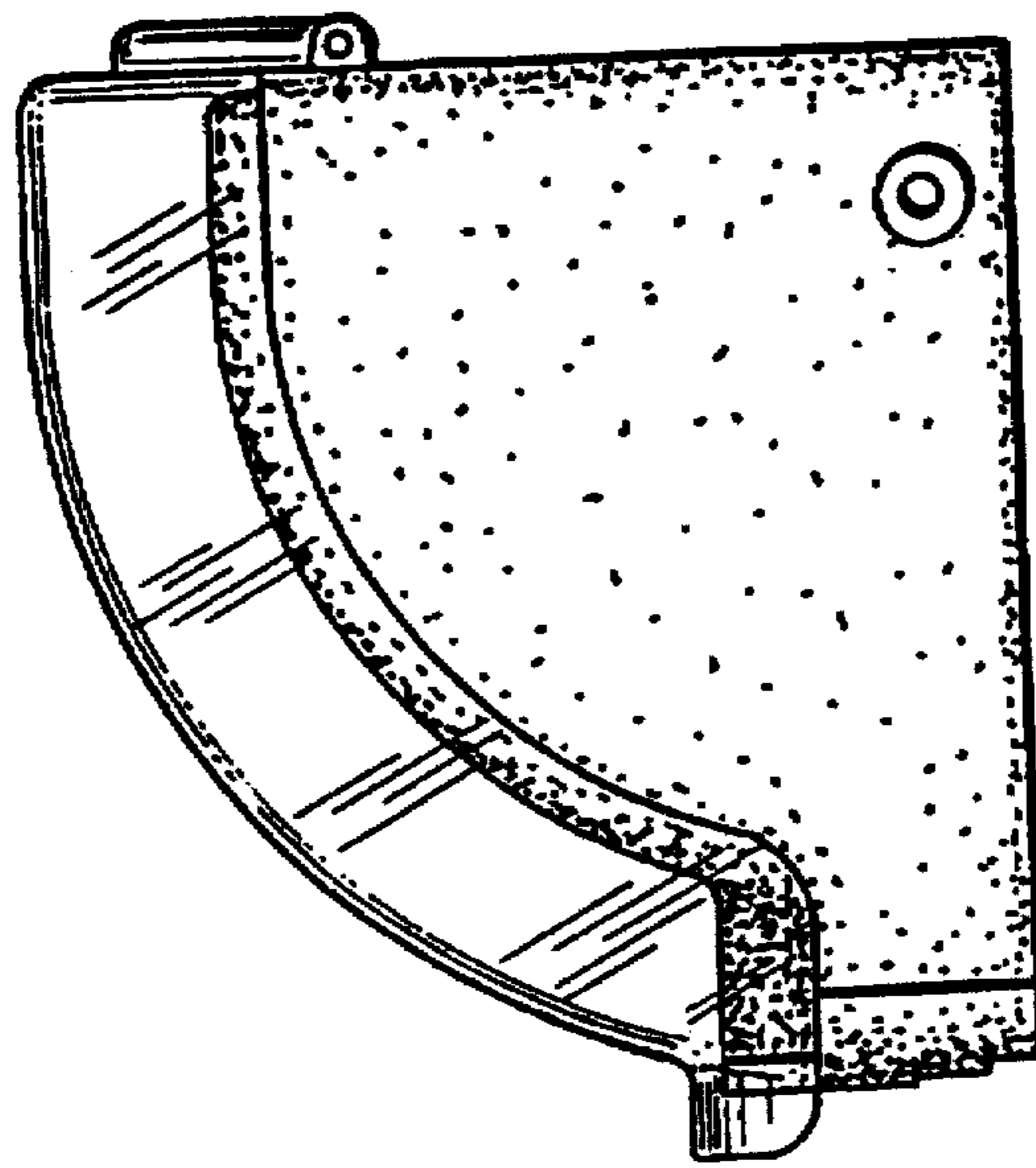
