[57] **CLAIM**

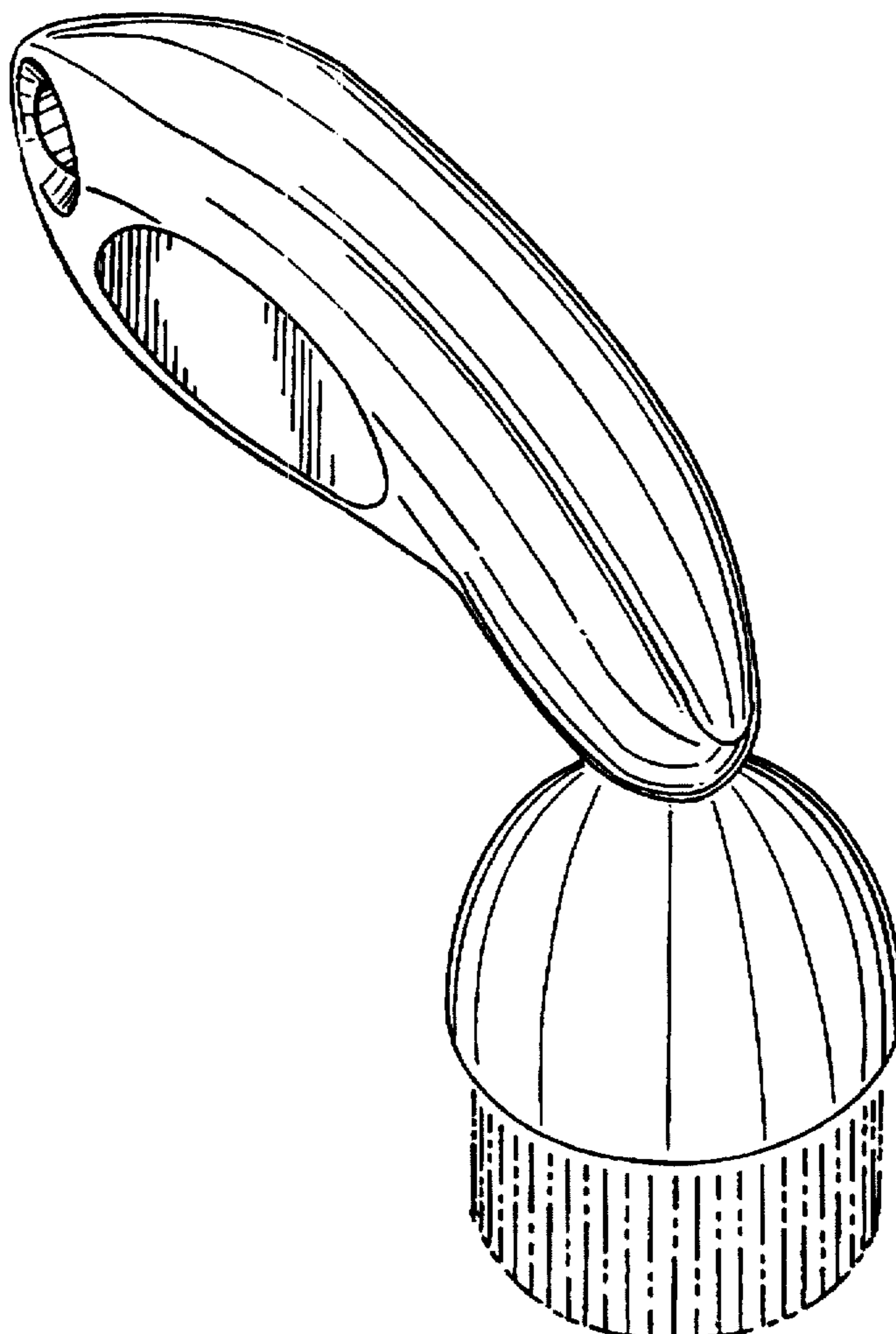
The ornamental design for a kitchen brush handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view;  
FIG. 2 is a right-side view, the left-side view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top view;  
FIG. 4 is a cross-section through lines 4—4 of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 5 is a cross-section through lines 5—5 of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 6 is a cross-section through lines 6—6 of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 7 is a bottom view;  
FIG. 8 is a front view; and,  
FIG. 9 is a back view.

The broken lines in FIG. 1 represent bristles, and form no part of the claimed design.

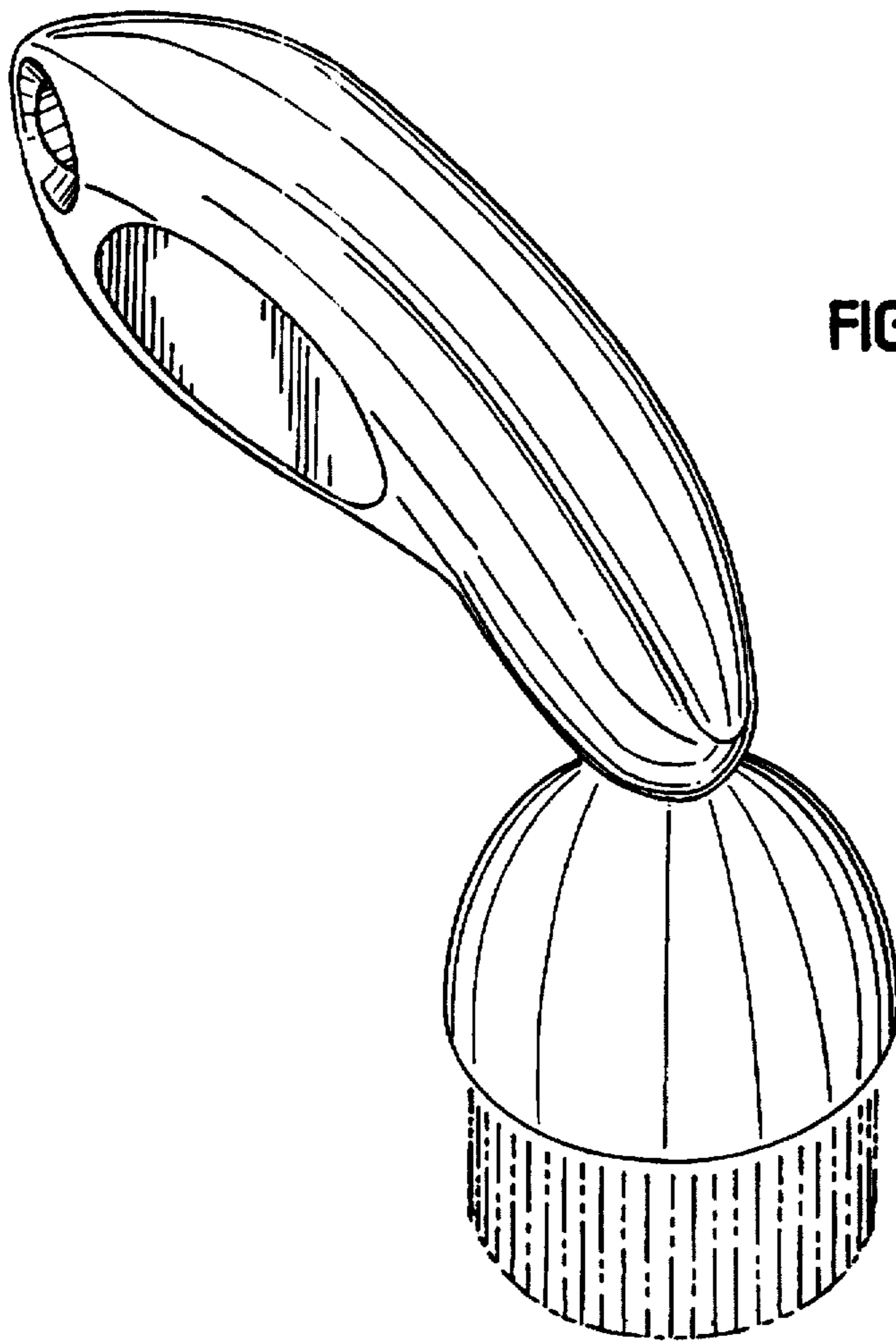

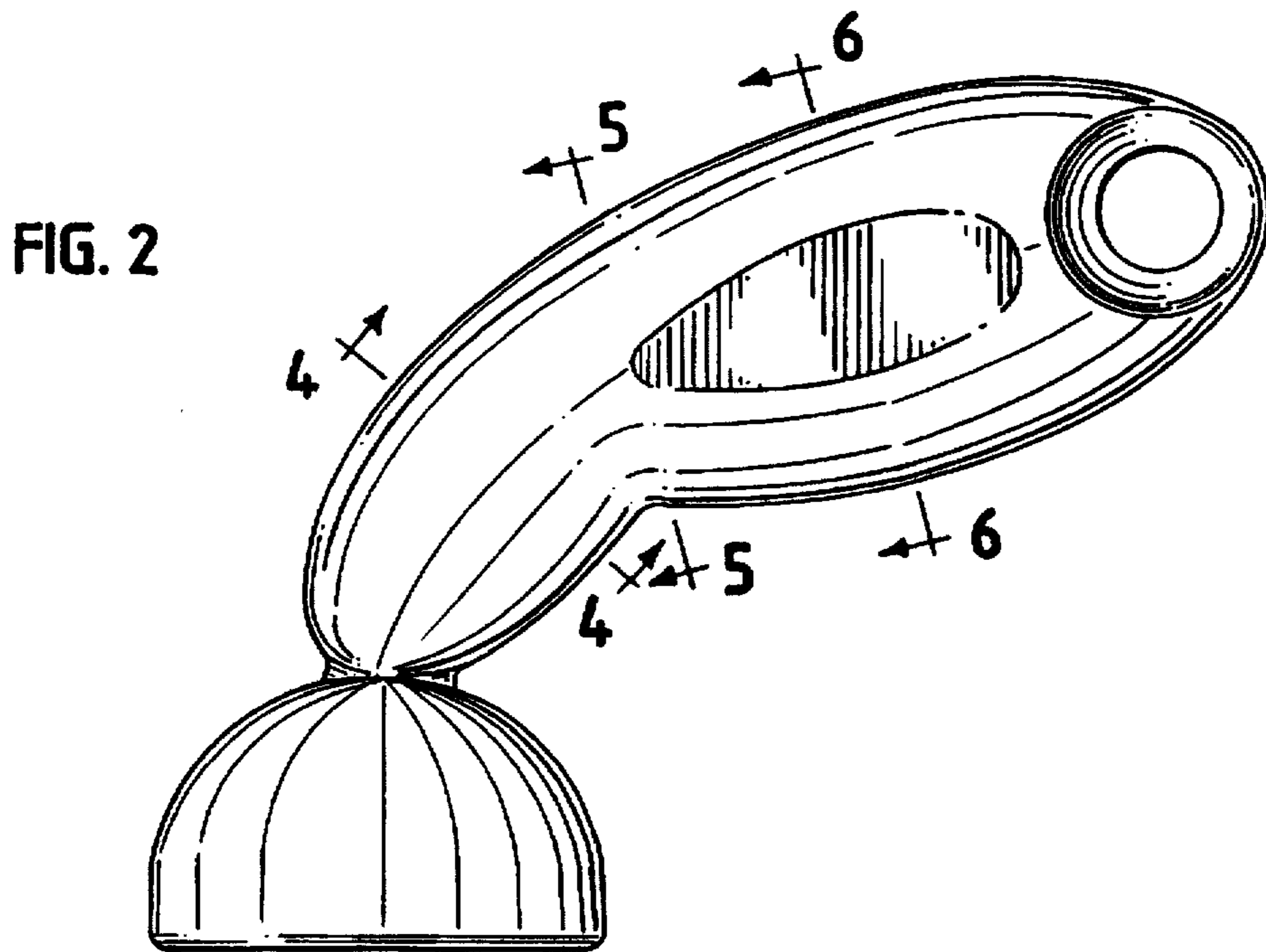

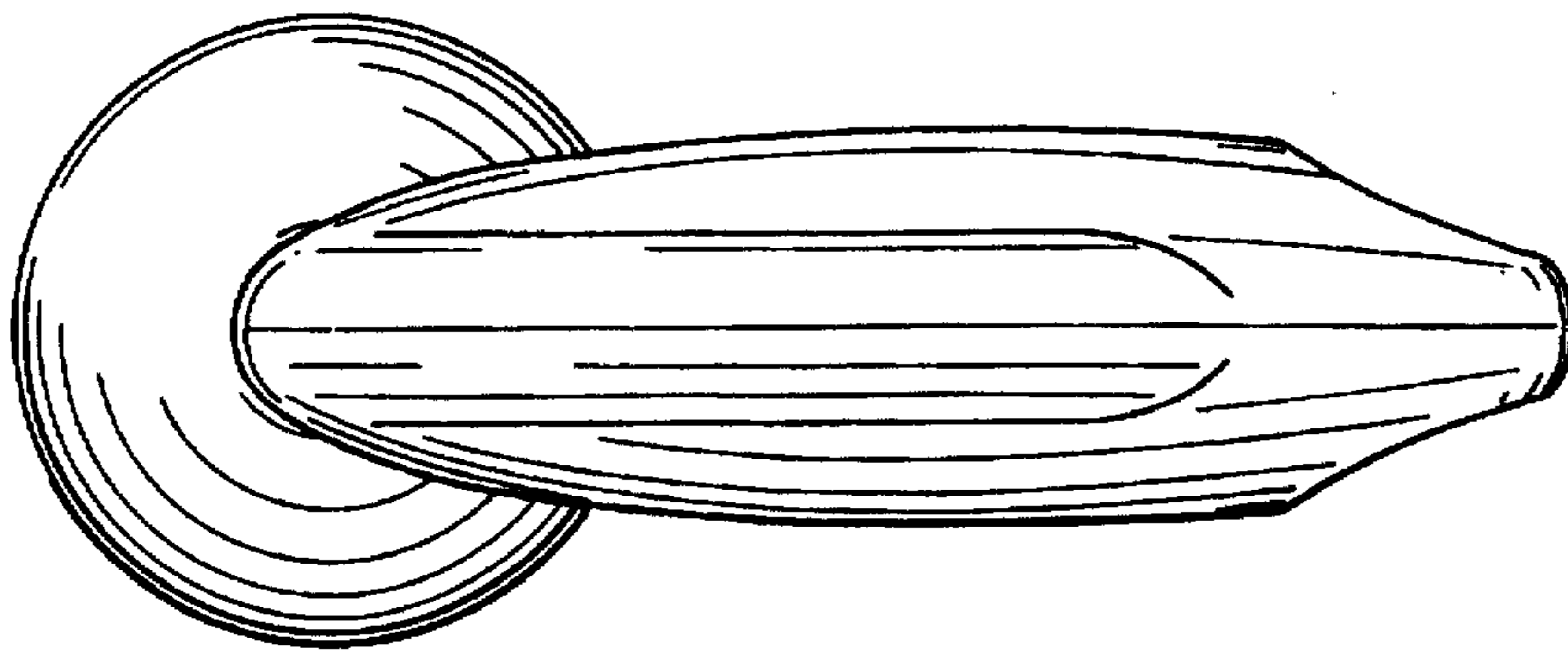

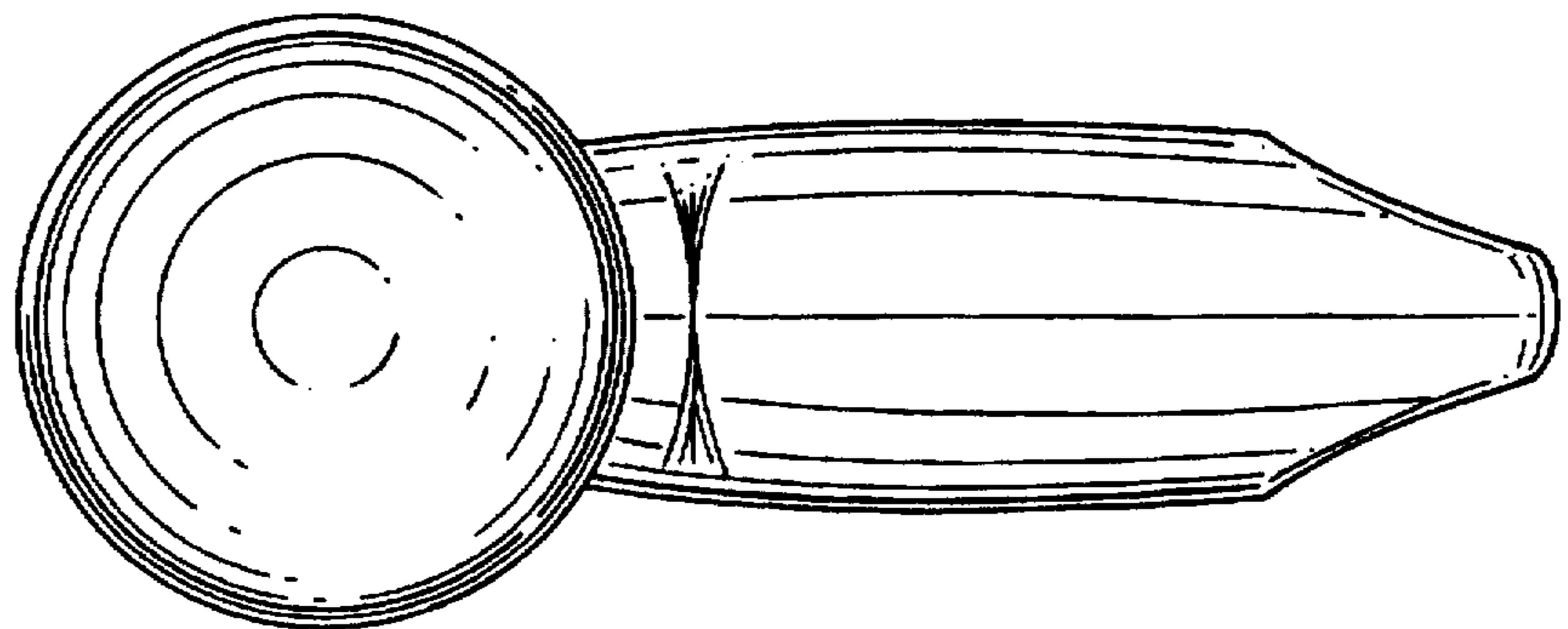

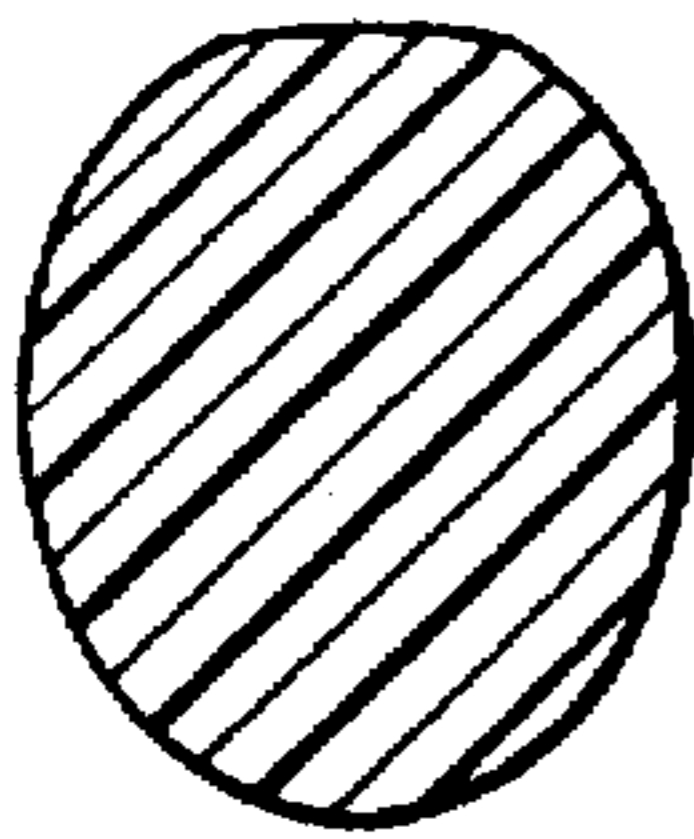

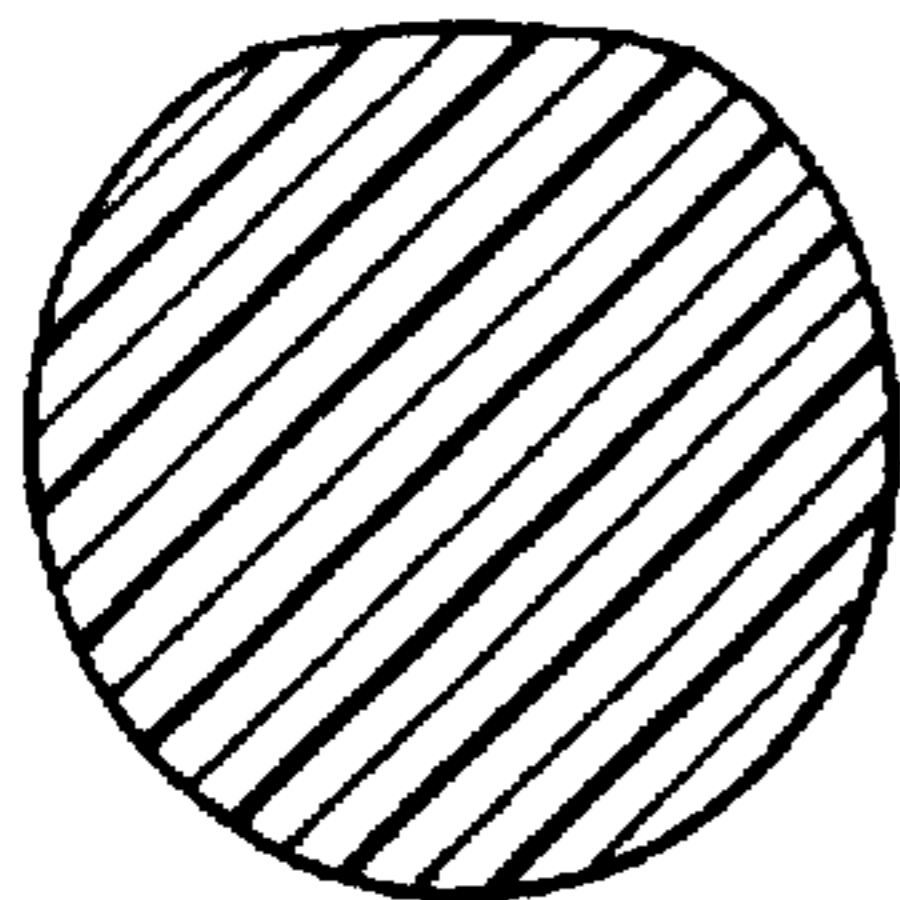

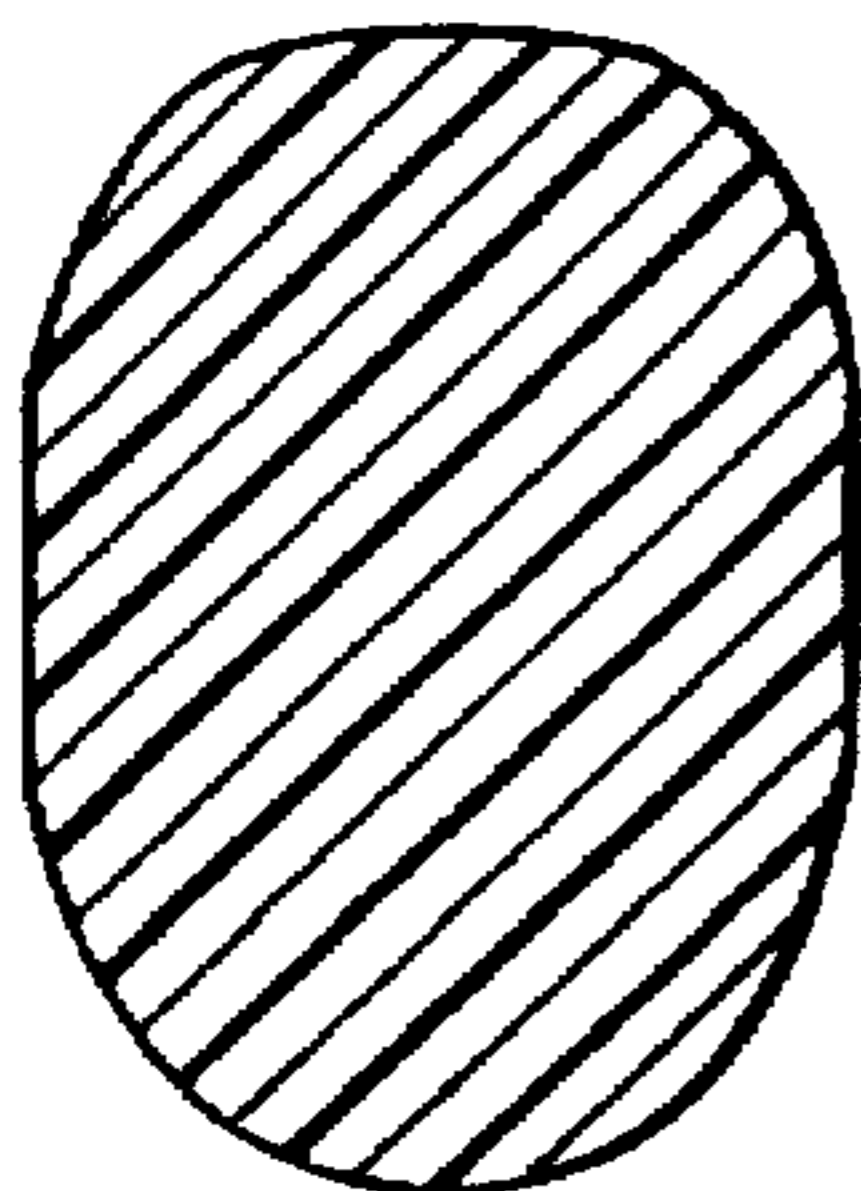

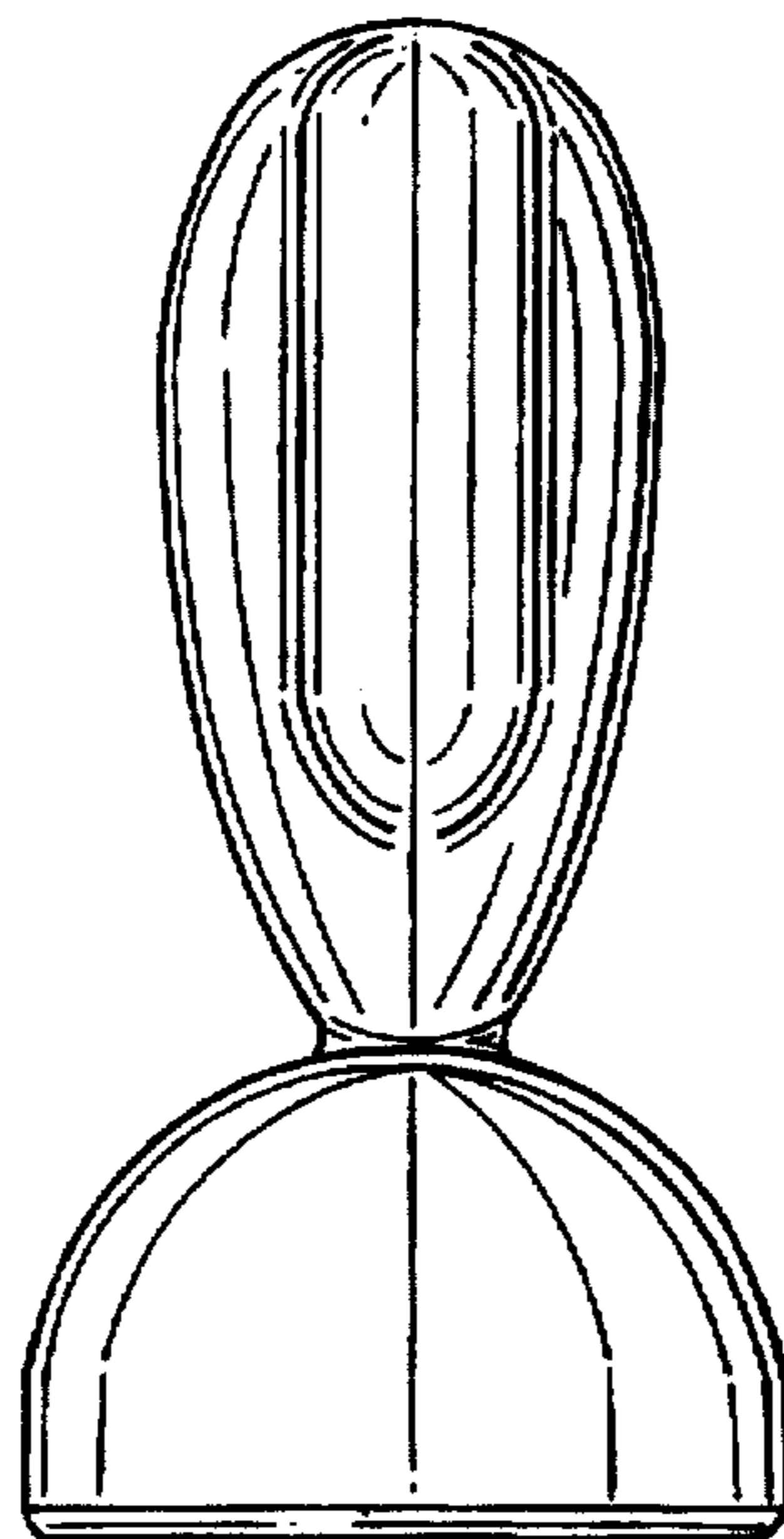
