The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

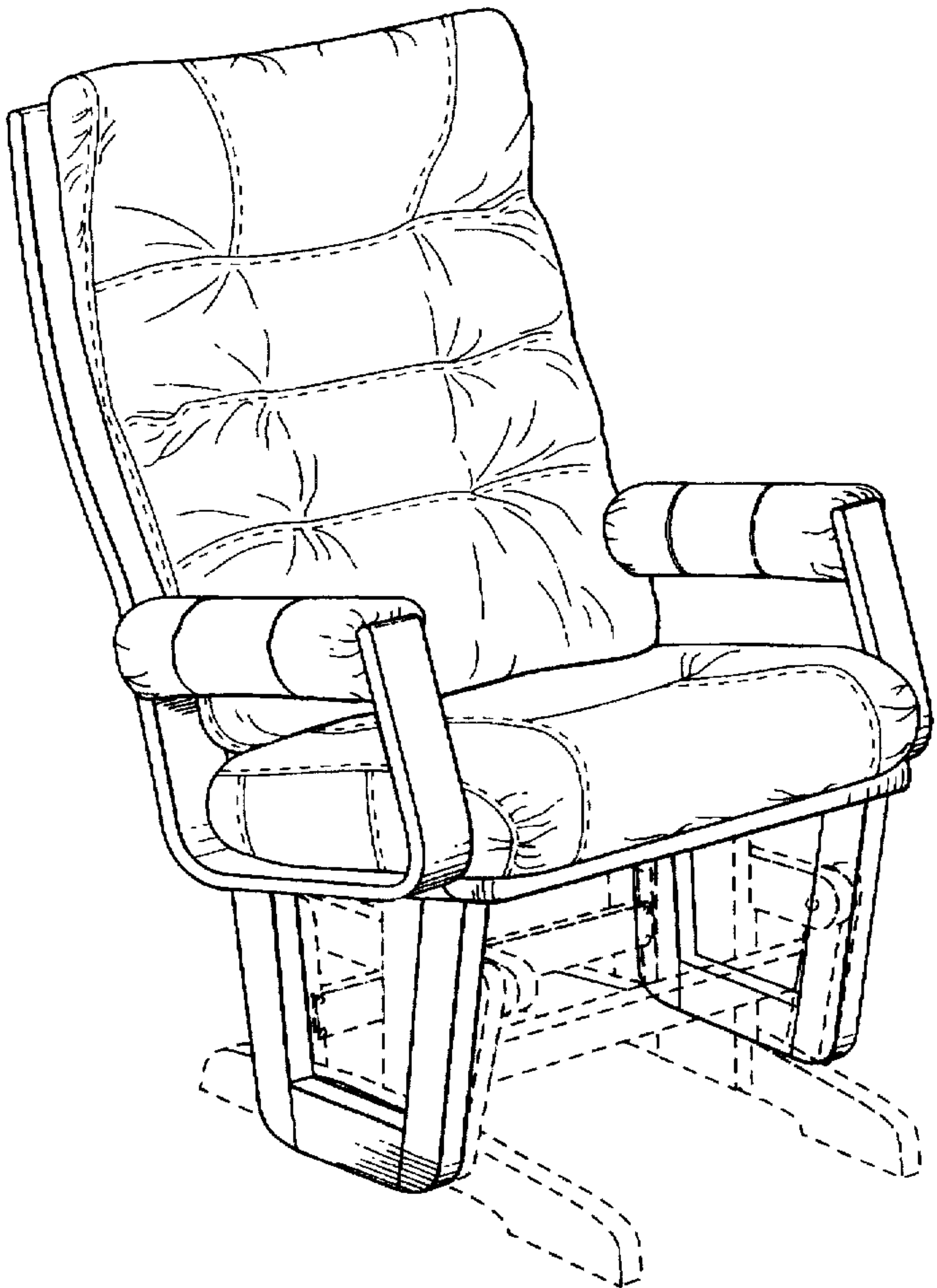
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the chair;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the chair;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the chair;
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the chair;
FIG. 6 is a top view of the chair;
FIG. 7 is a left side view of a first variant of the chair; and,
FIG. 8 is a right side view of a first variant of the chair.

The broken line showing of a glider structure in FIGS. 1 through 5, 7 and 8 is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

FIGS. 7 and 8 depict a variant which differs from FIGS. 1 through 6 only by the configuration of lower side frame/leg-like members.

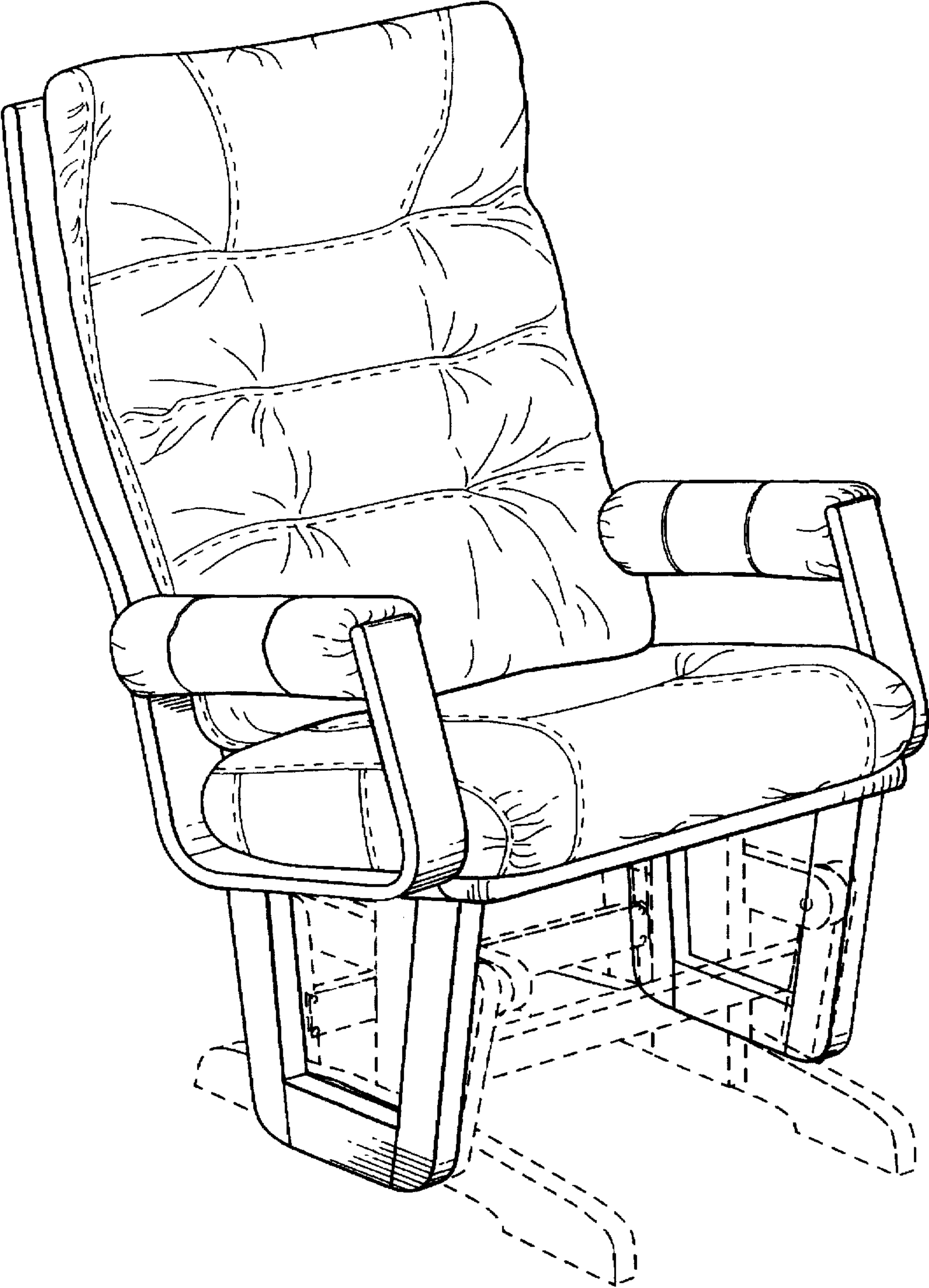

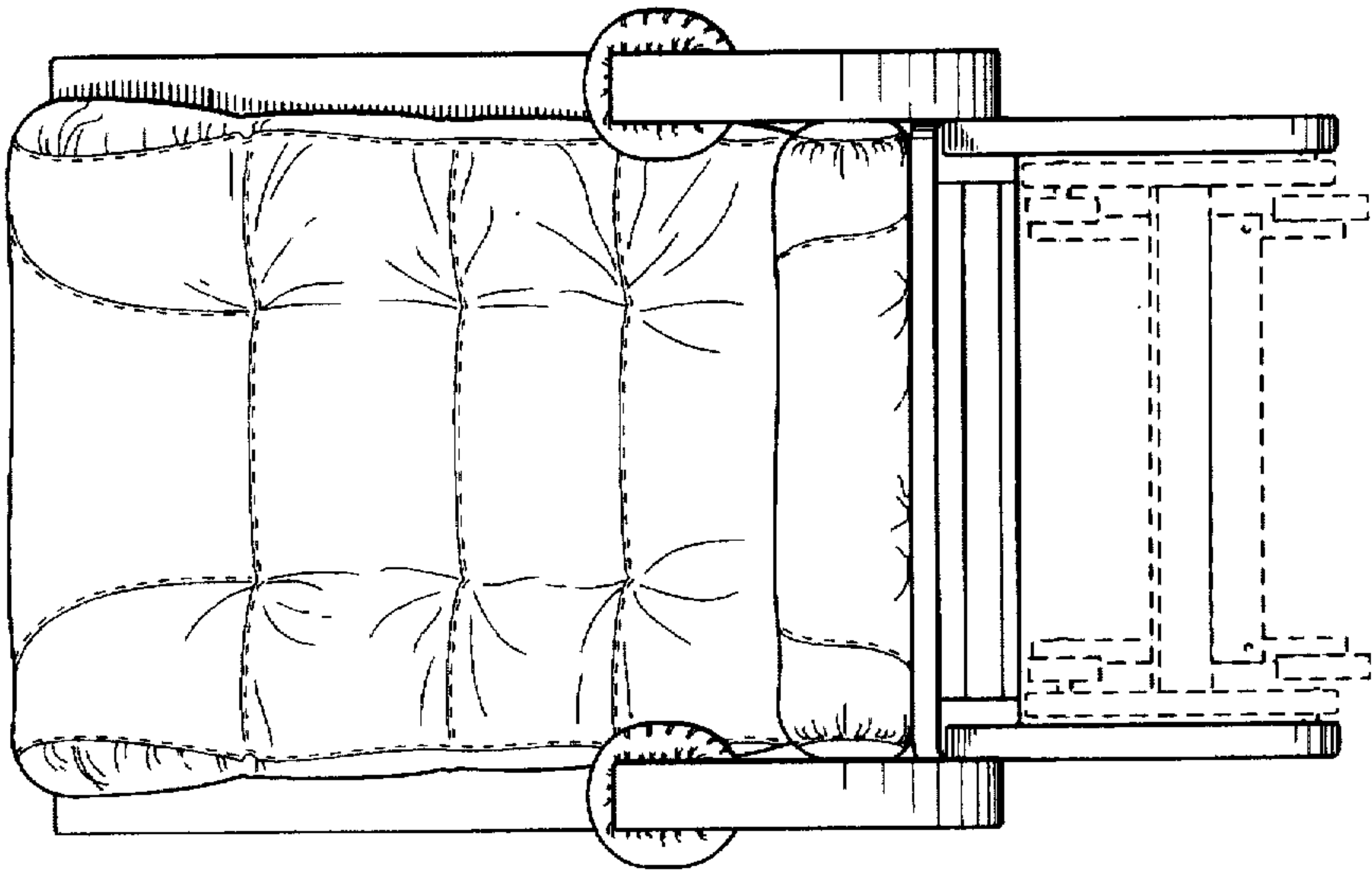

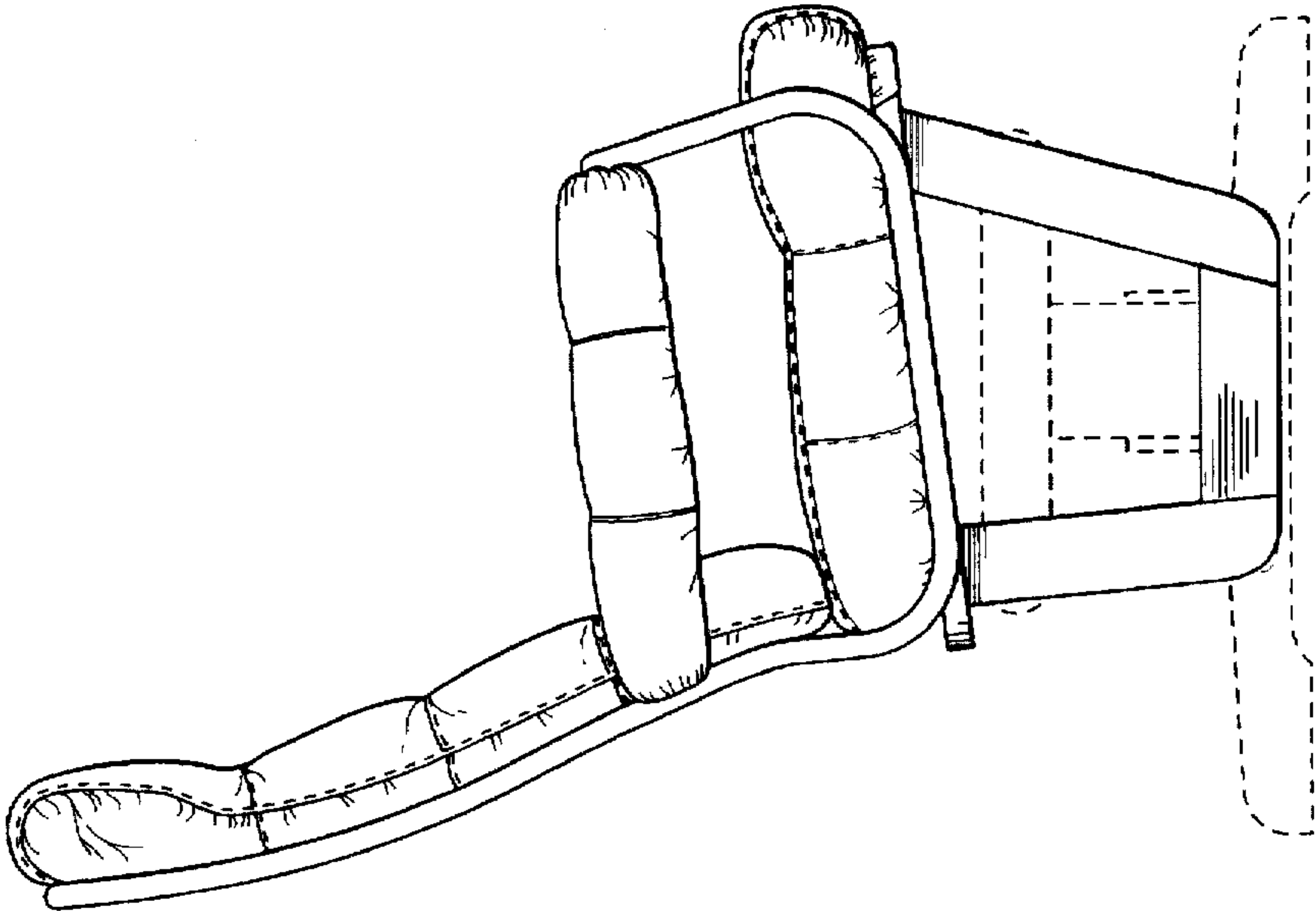

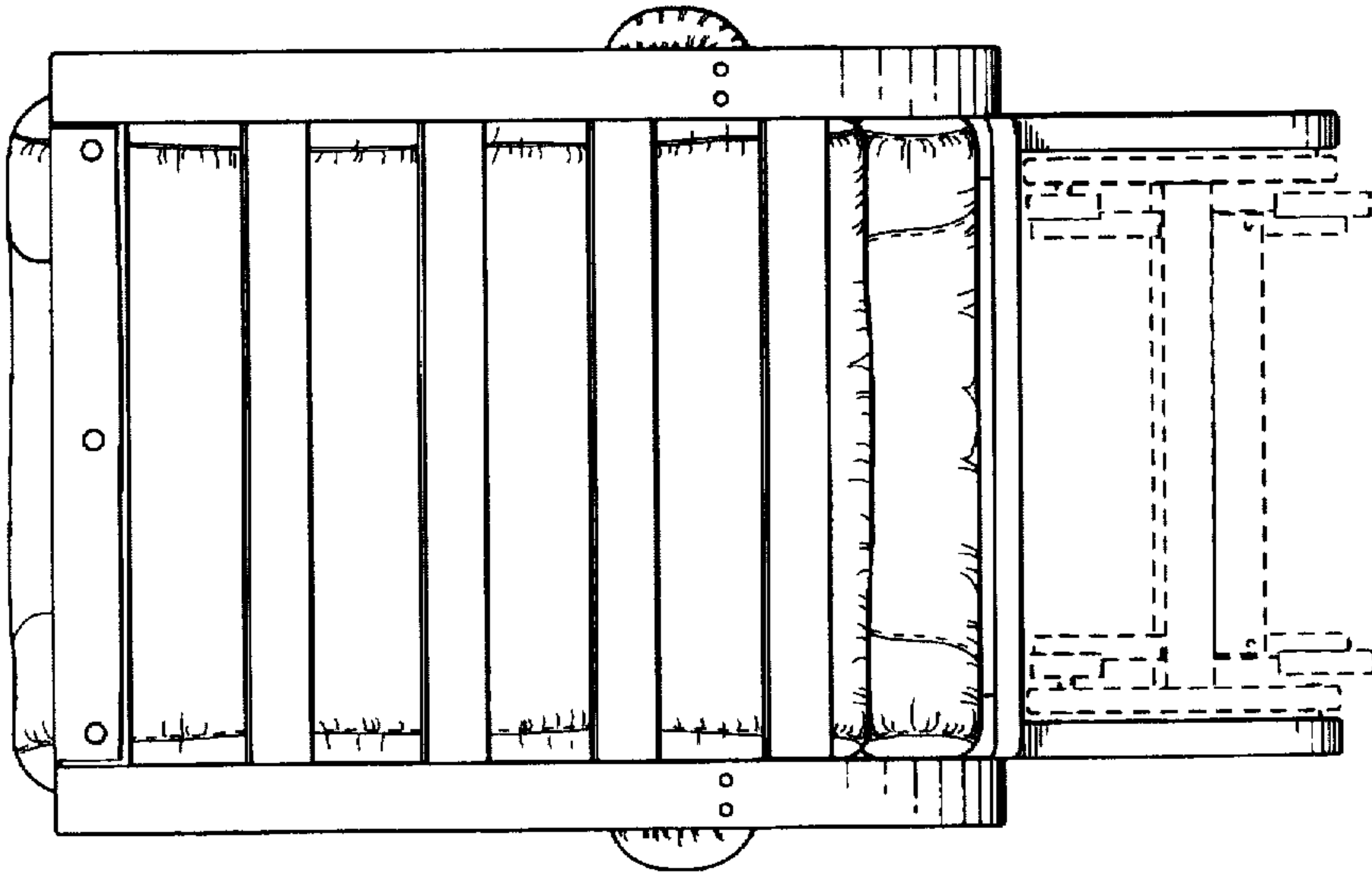

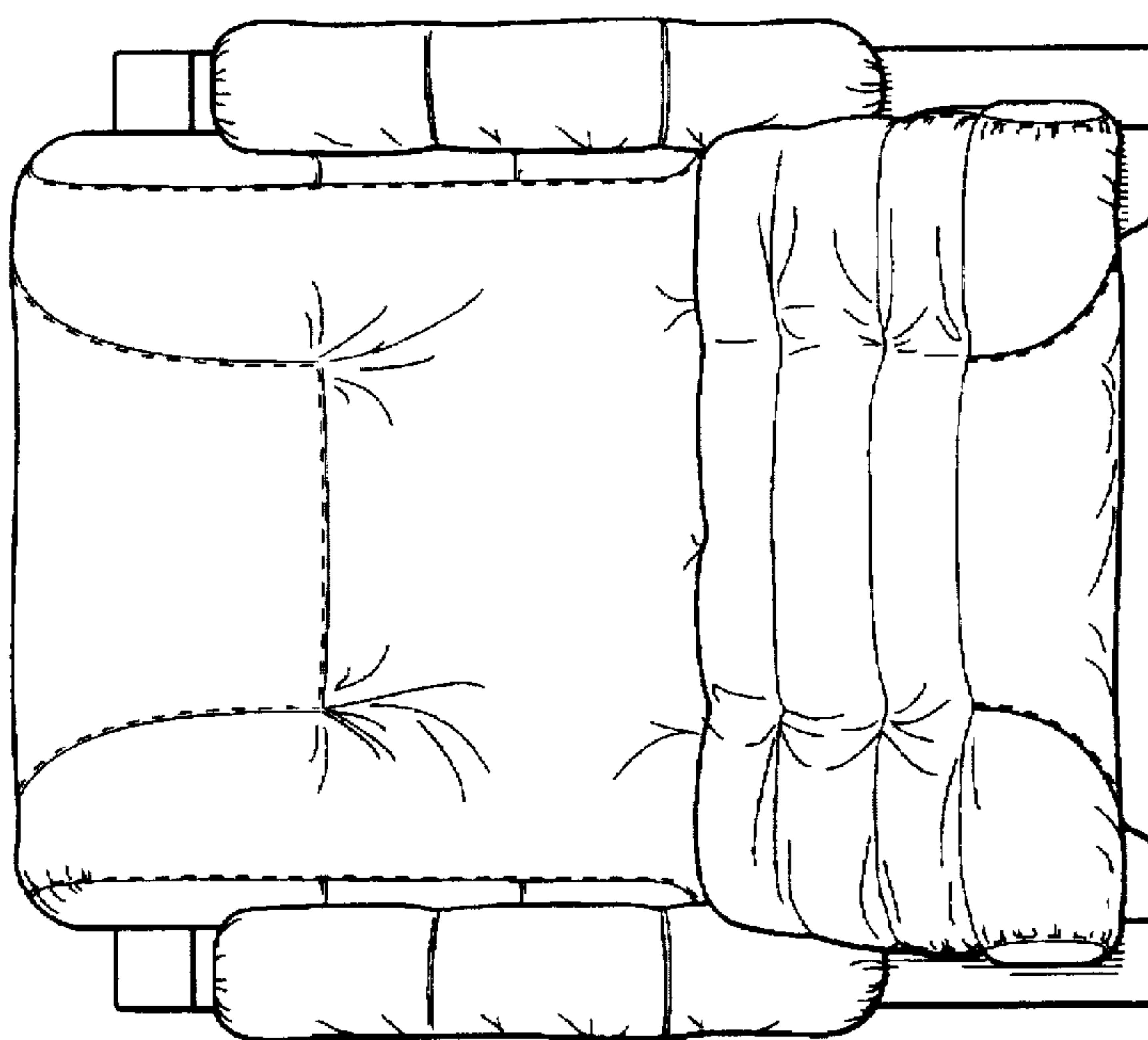
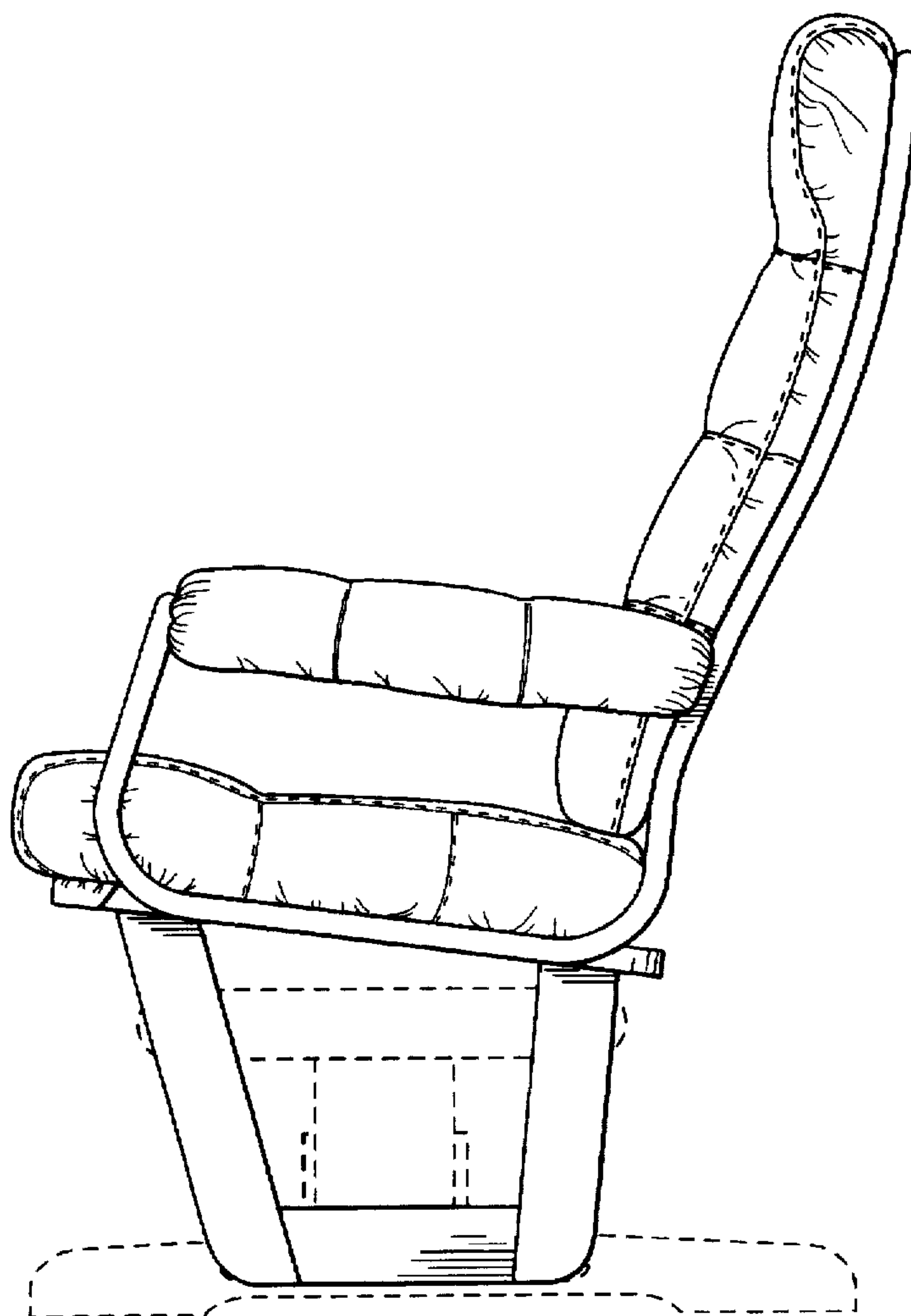

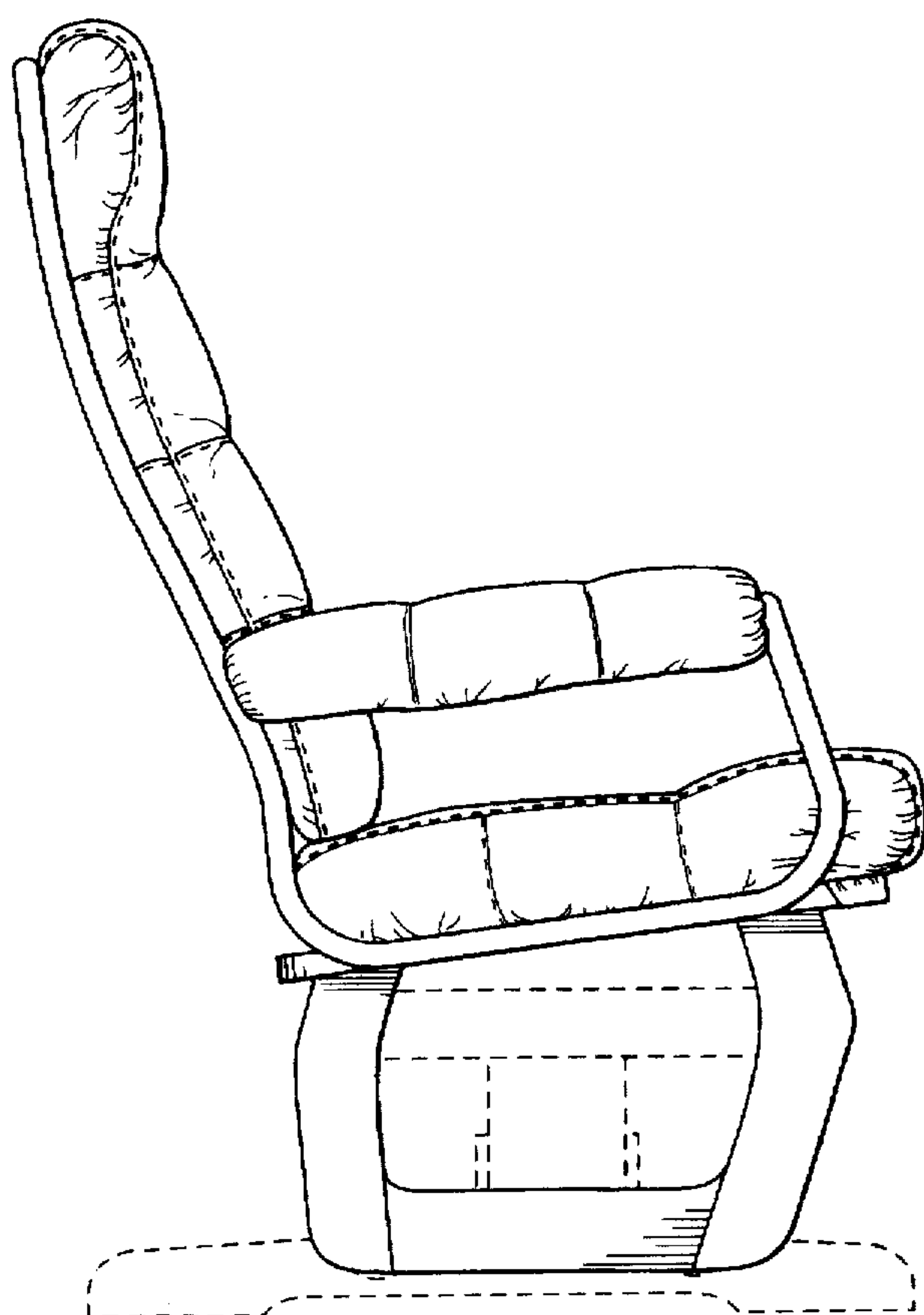

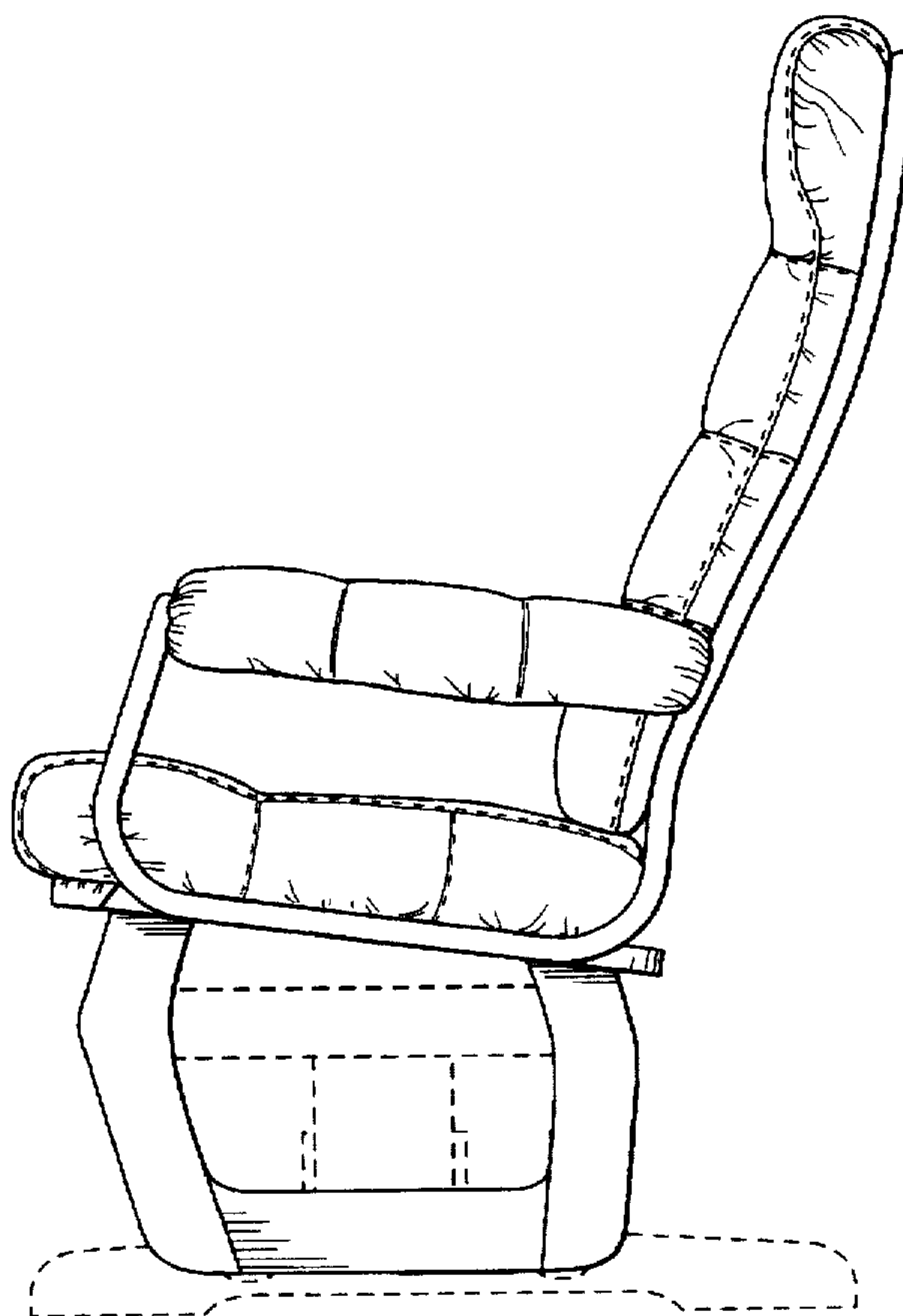
