DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a chair showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,













