The ornamental design for a curtain rod holder, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the claimed curtain rod holder;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof the left side view being a mirror image of the right side view.  
The broken line showing of a fragmented curtain rod and curtain is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

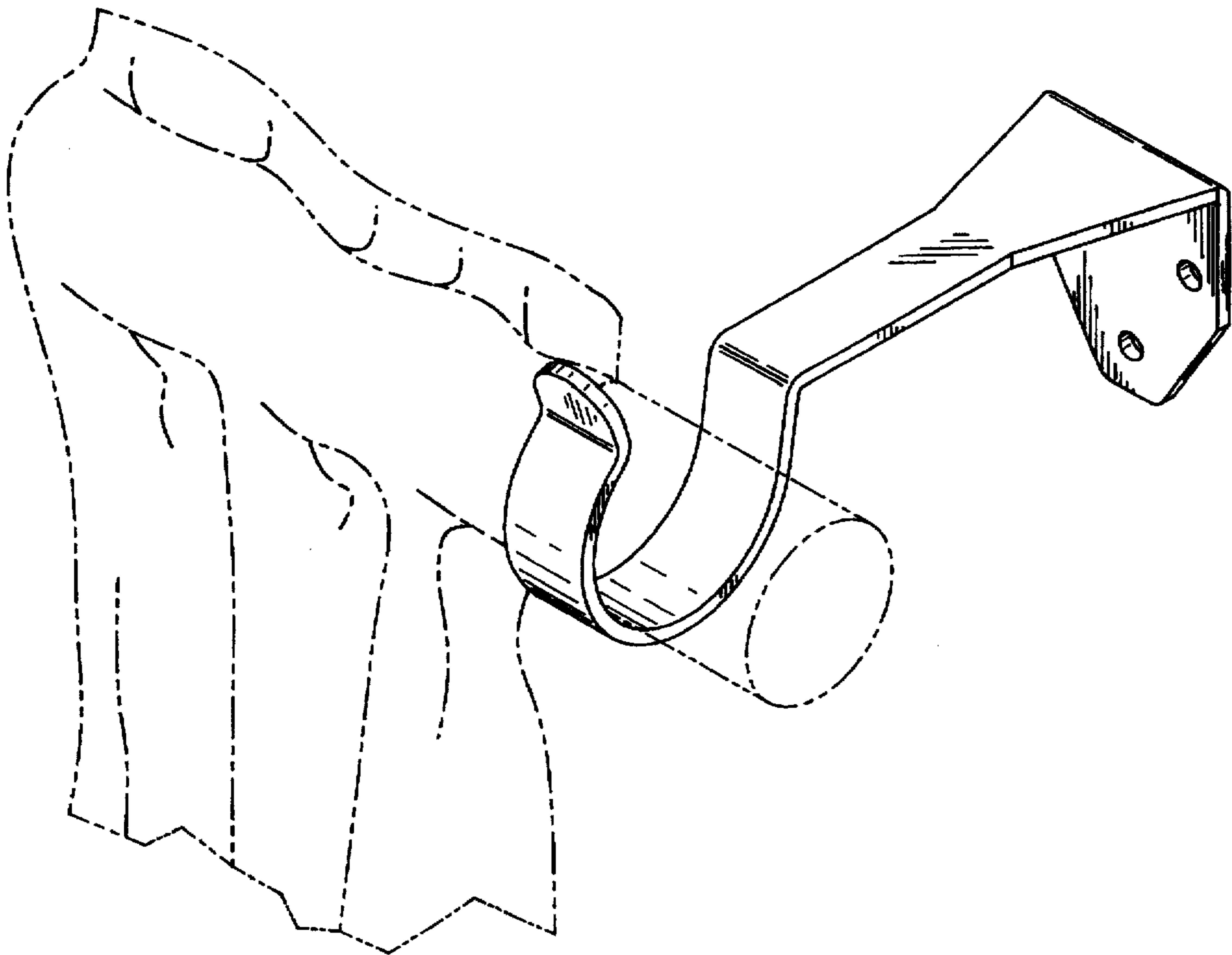

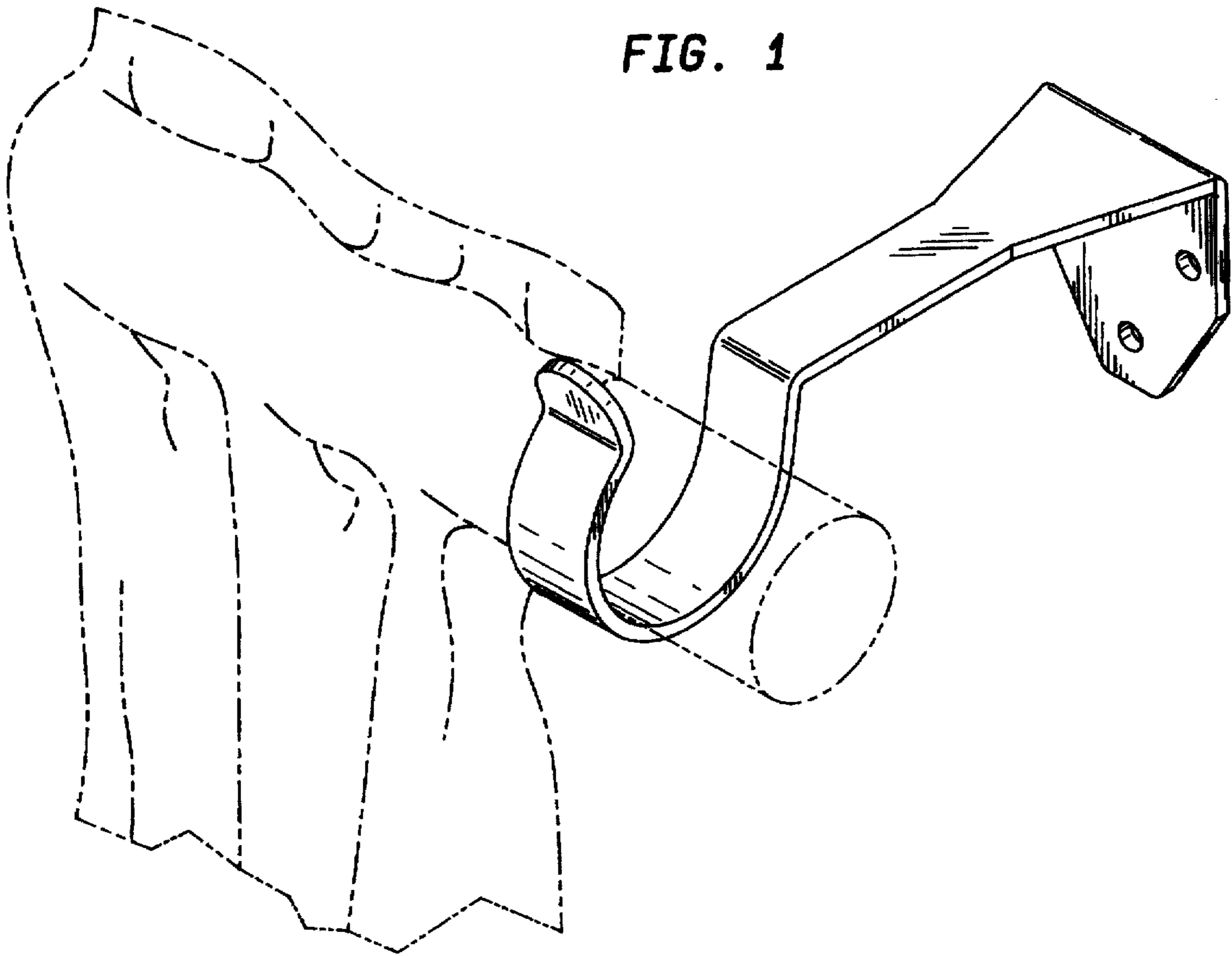

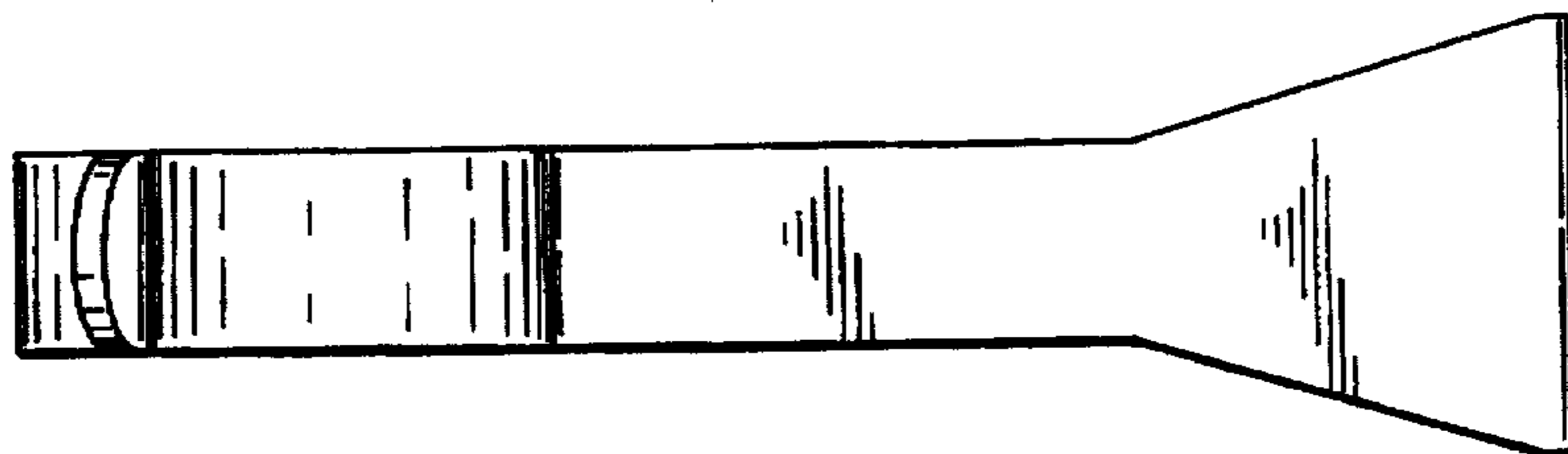

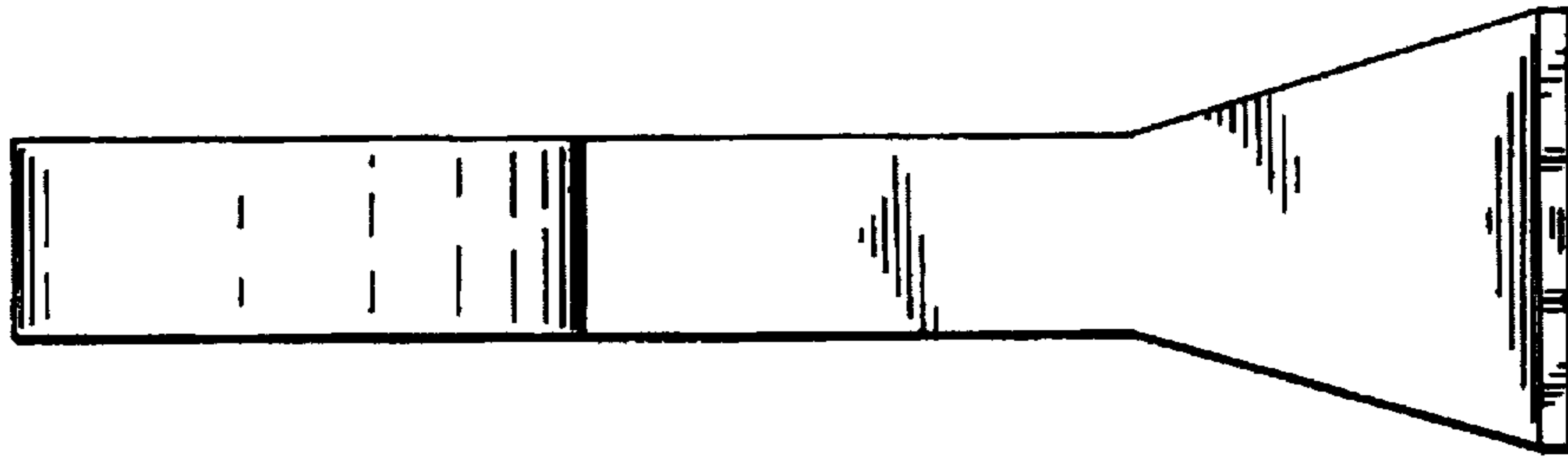

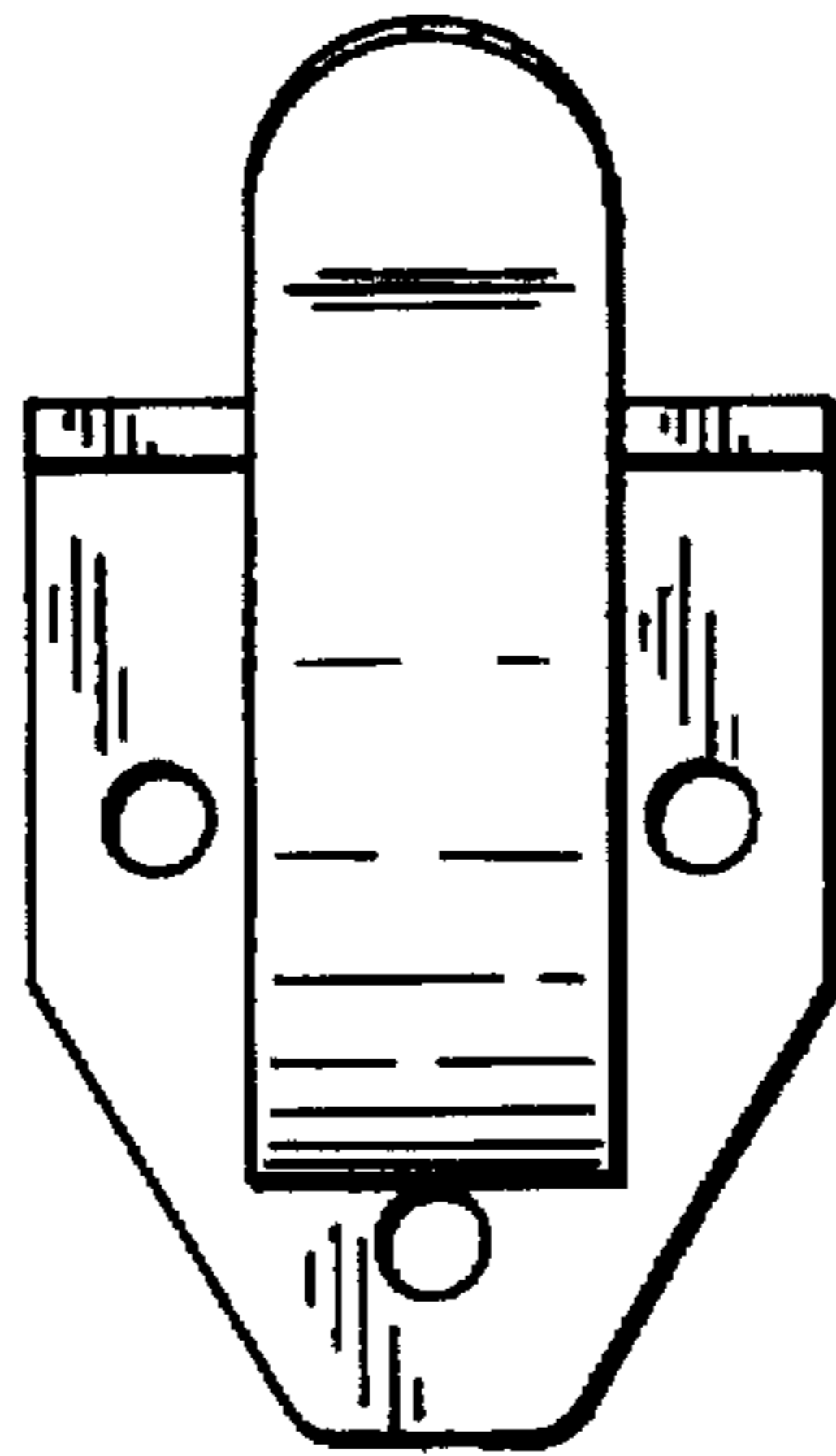

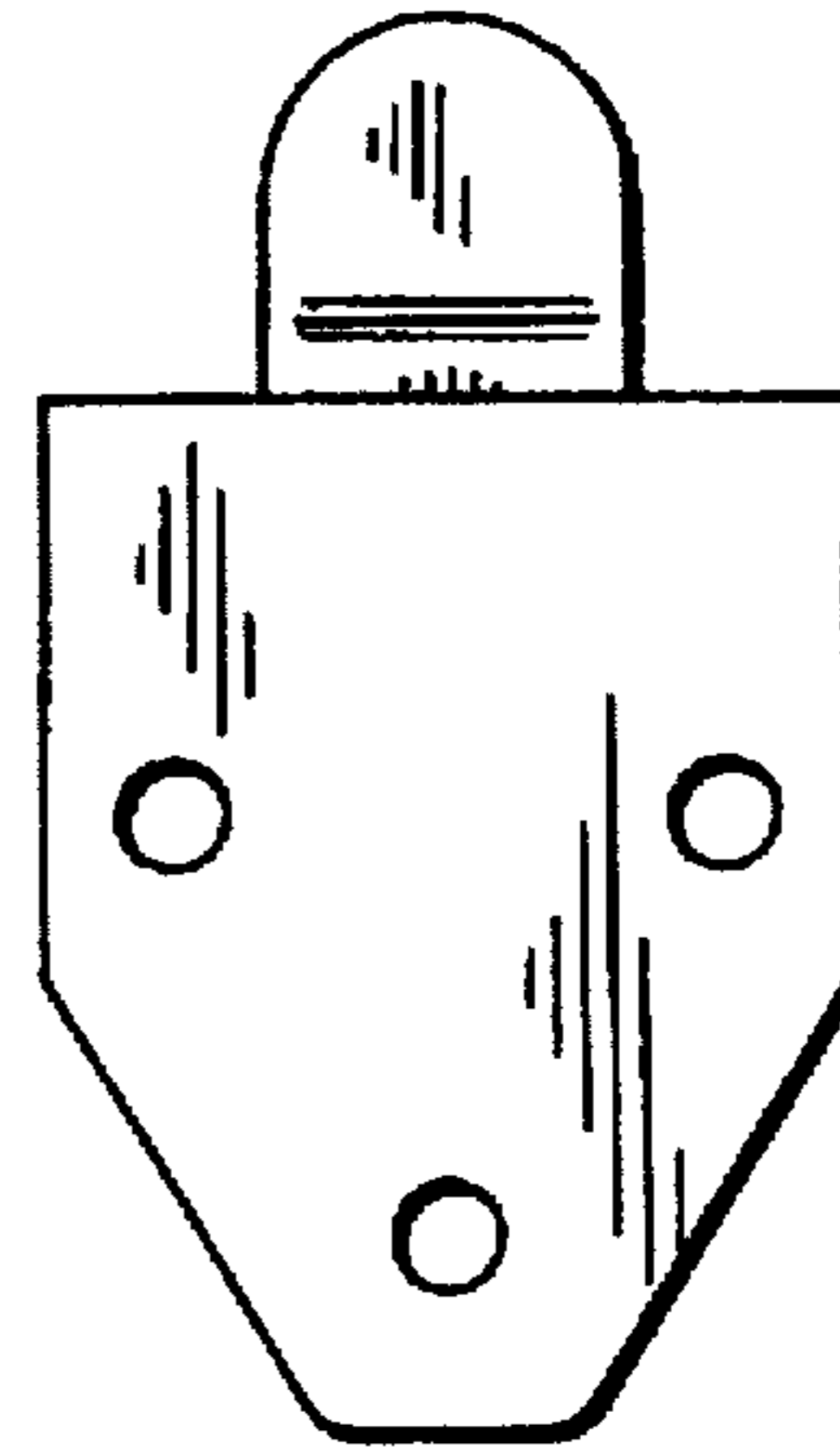
