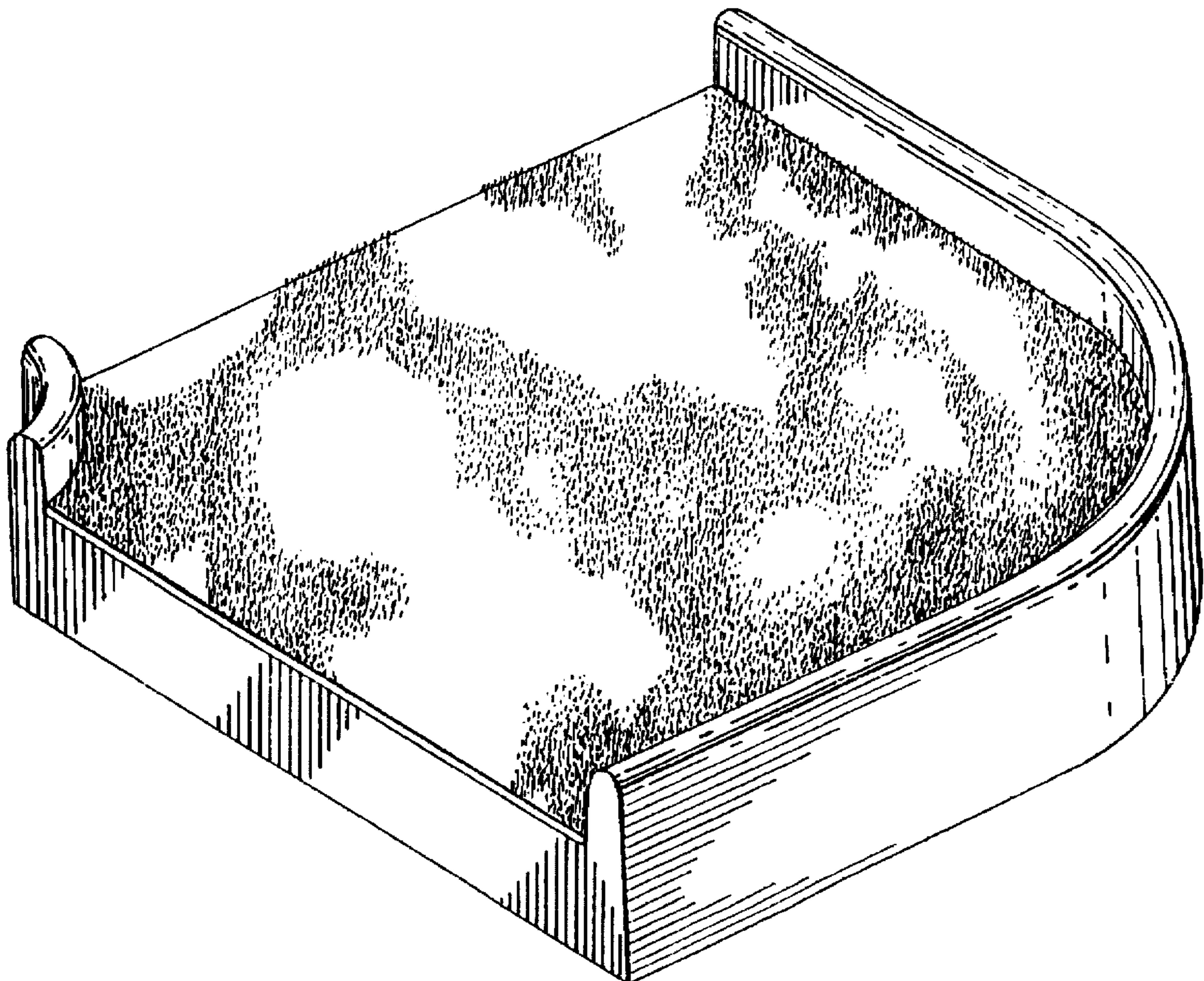
The ornamental design for the putting platform module, as shown and described.

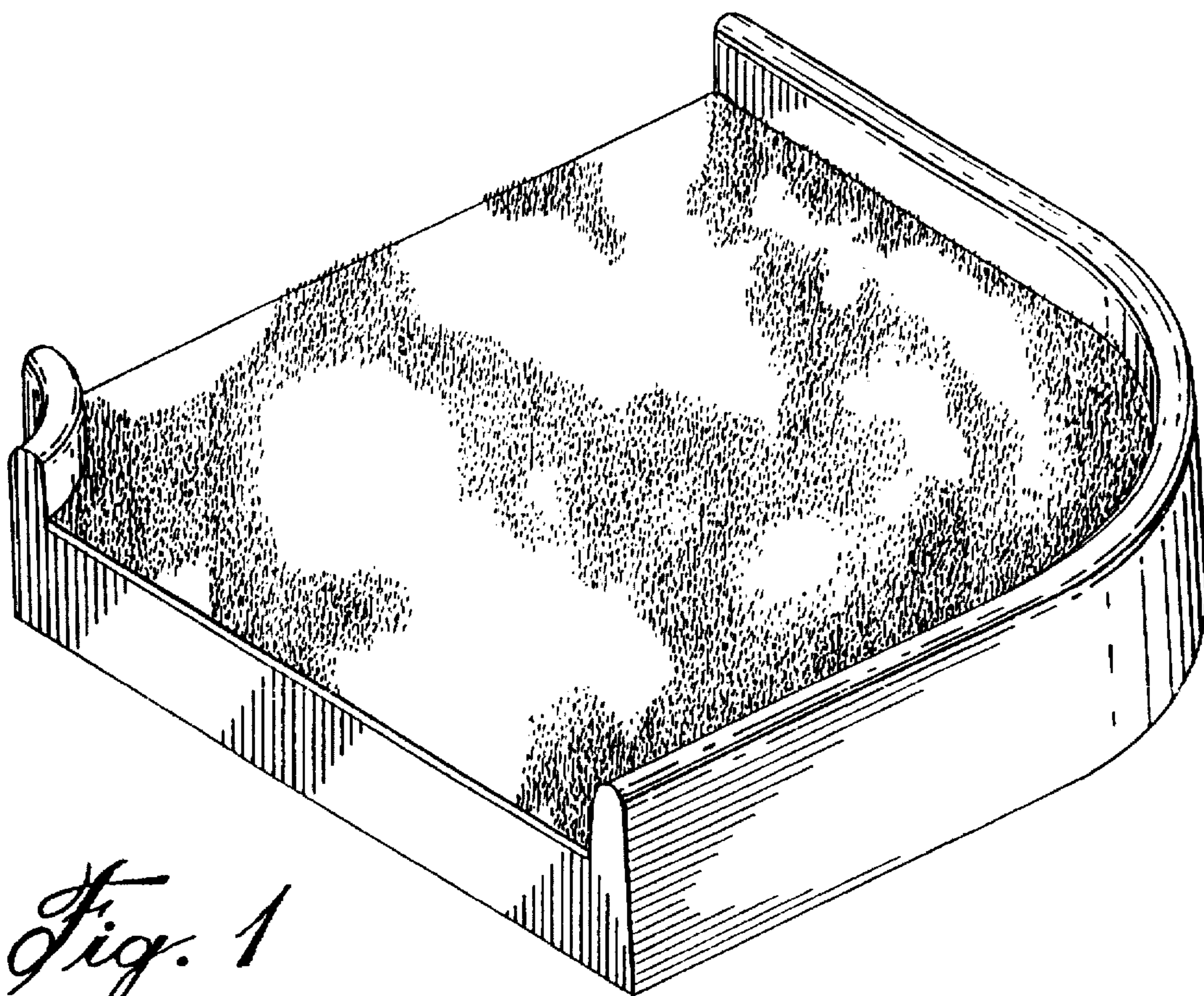
**DESCRIPTION**
