fishing rod section showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a plan view of a fishing rod with our fishing rod
section incorporated therein;

FIG. 3 is a plan view of our fishing rod section;

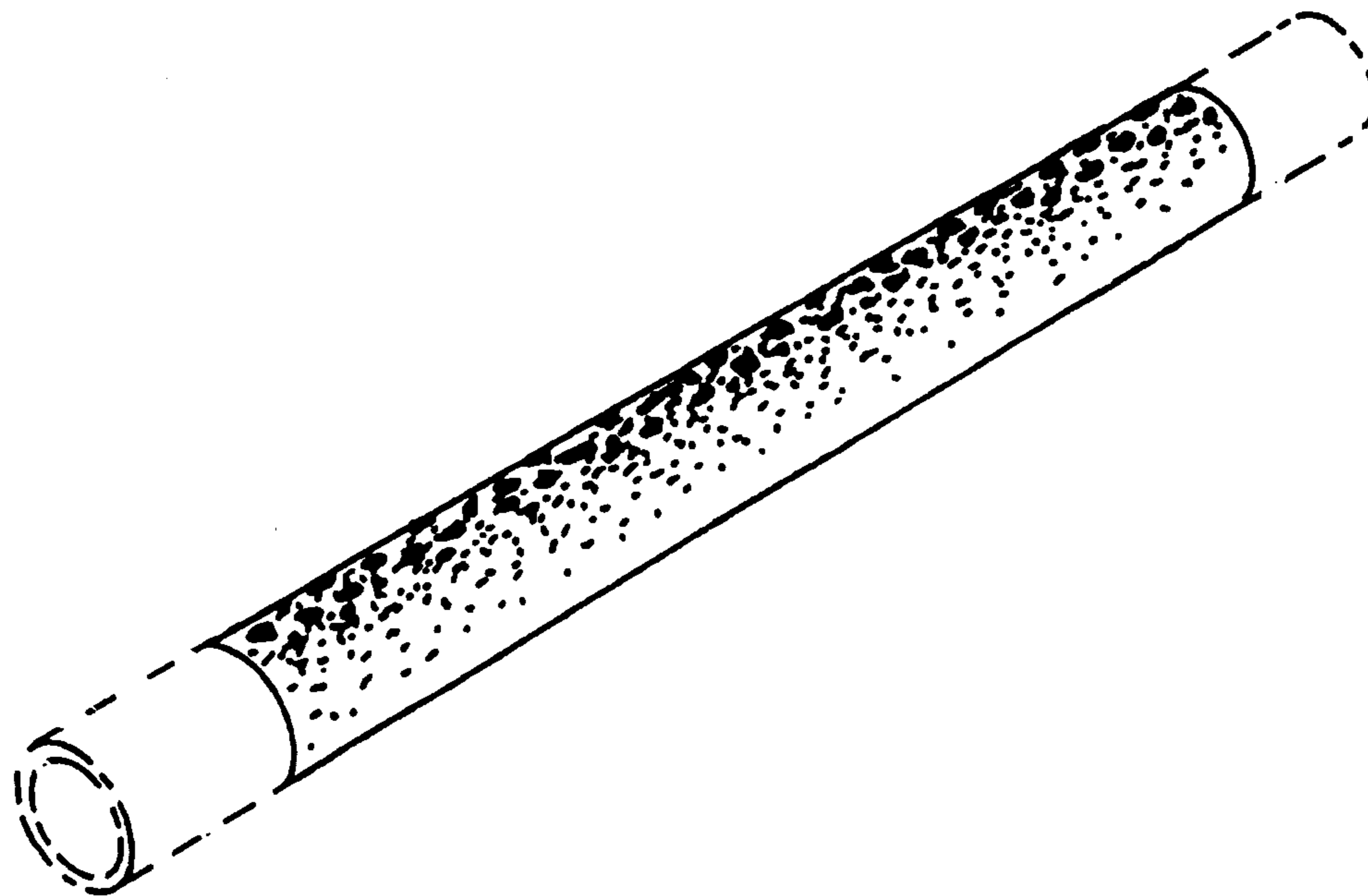
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof;

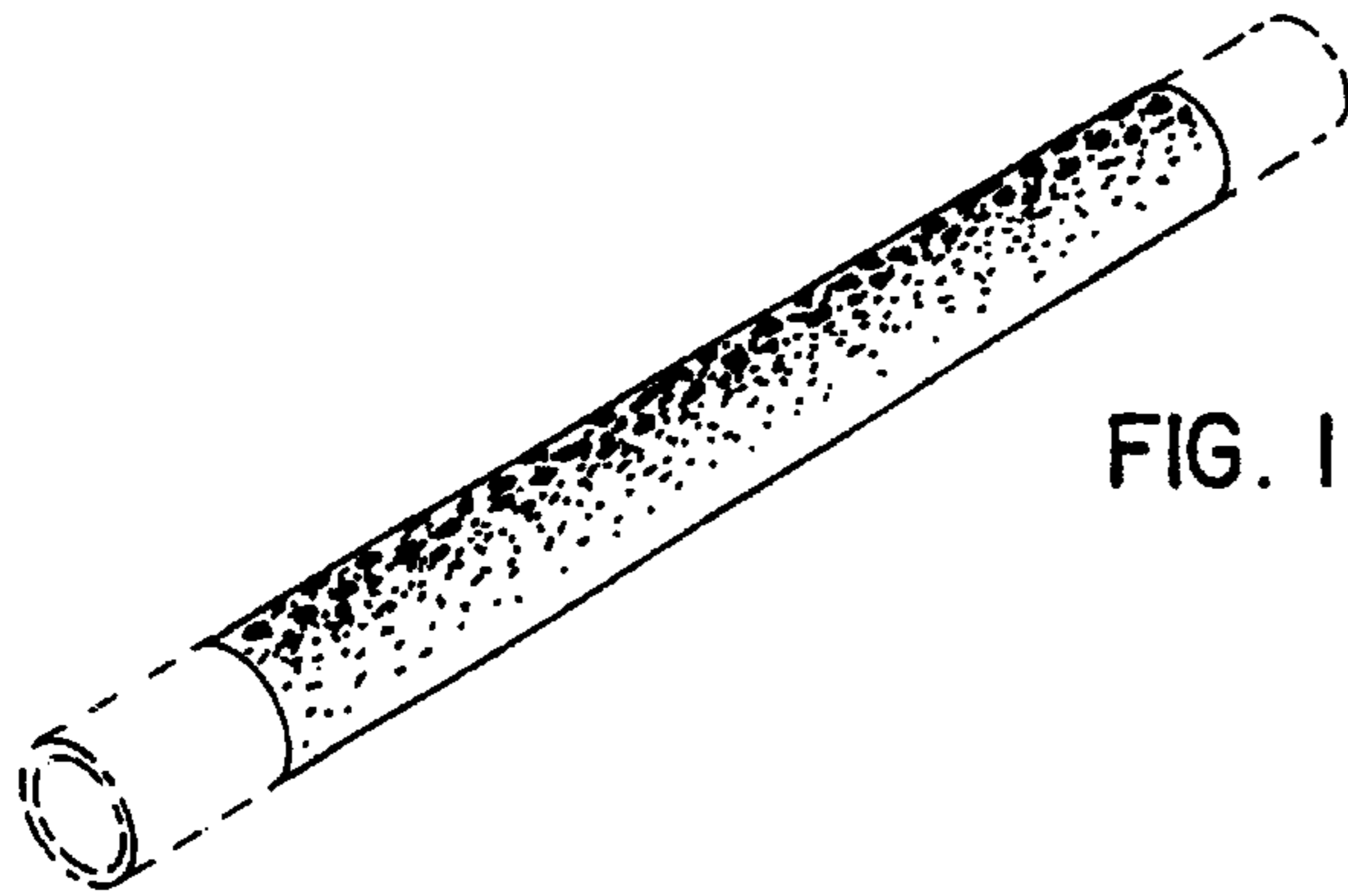

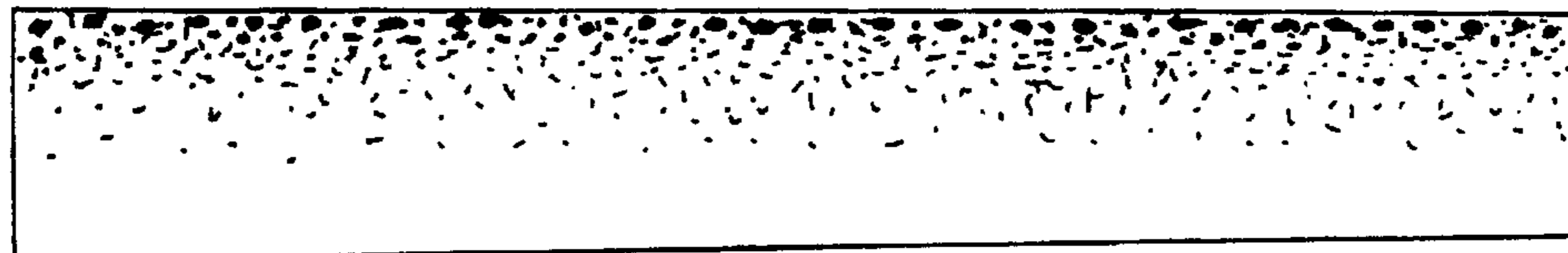

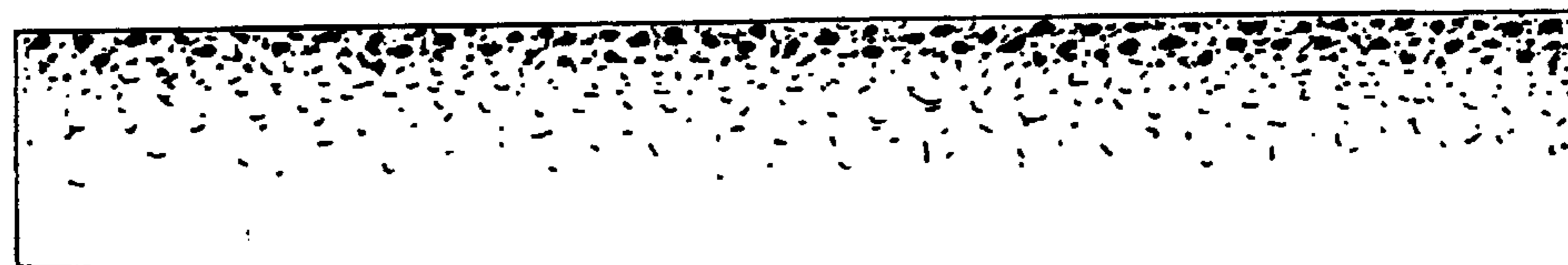

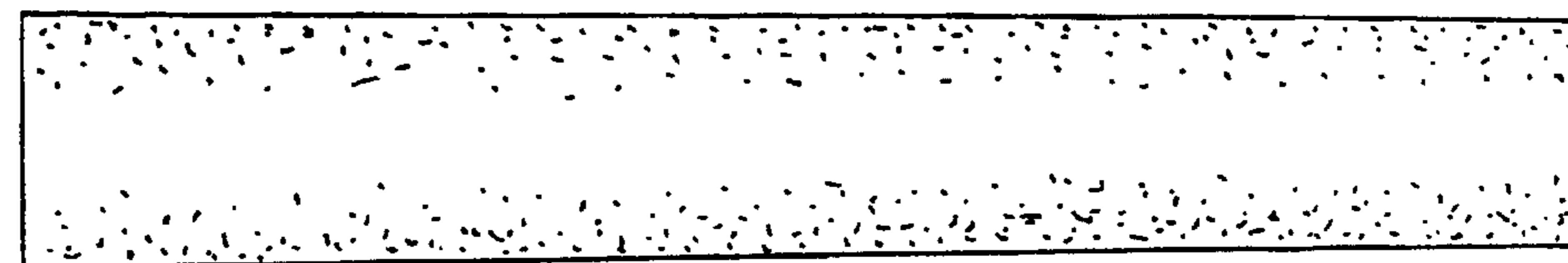
