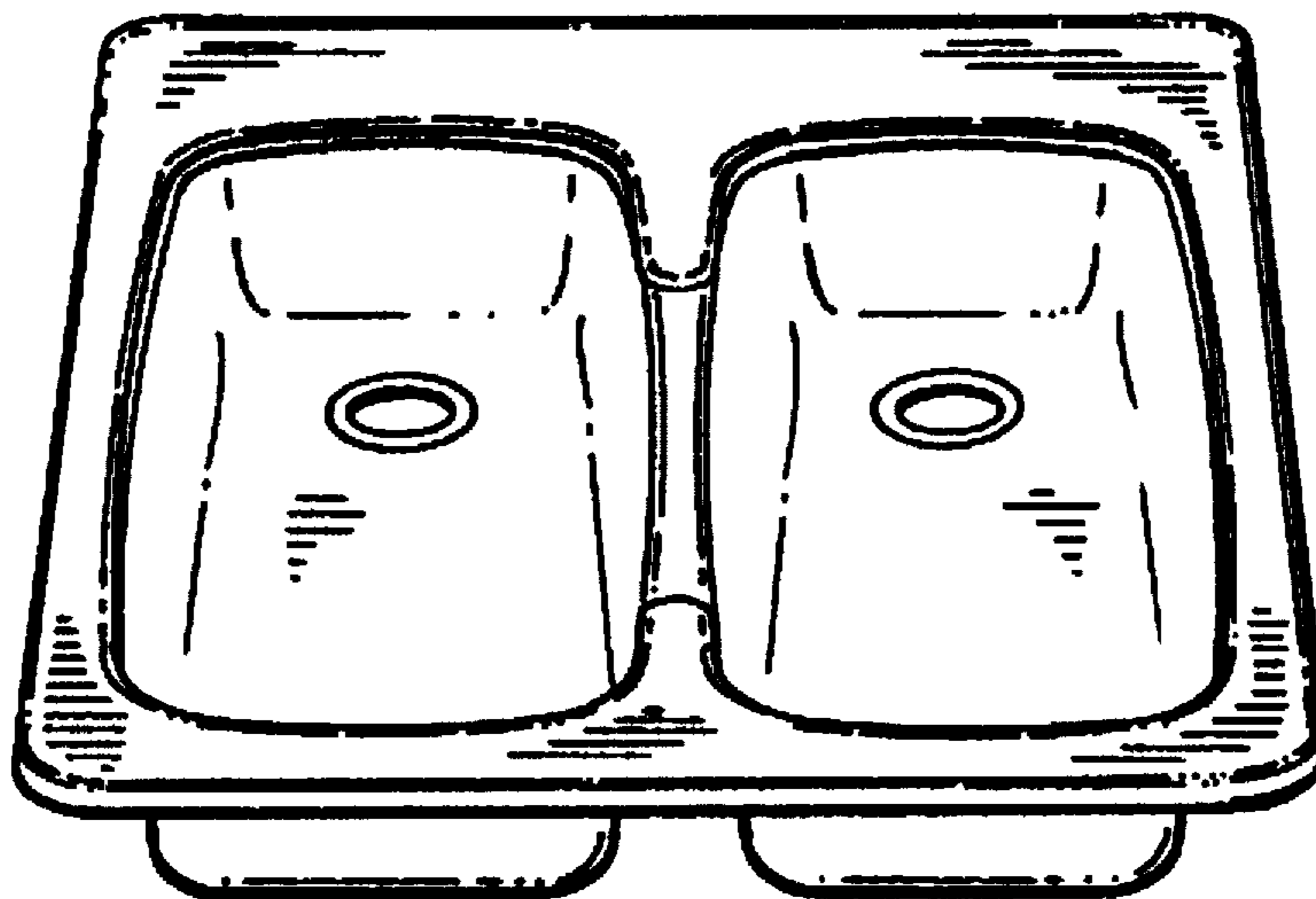
[57] **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a first embodiment of plate-mounted sink bowls showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the first embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

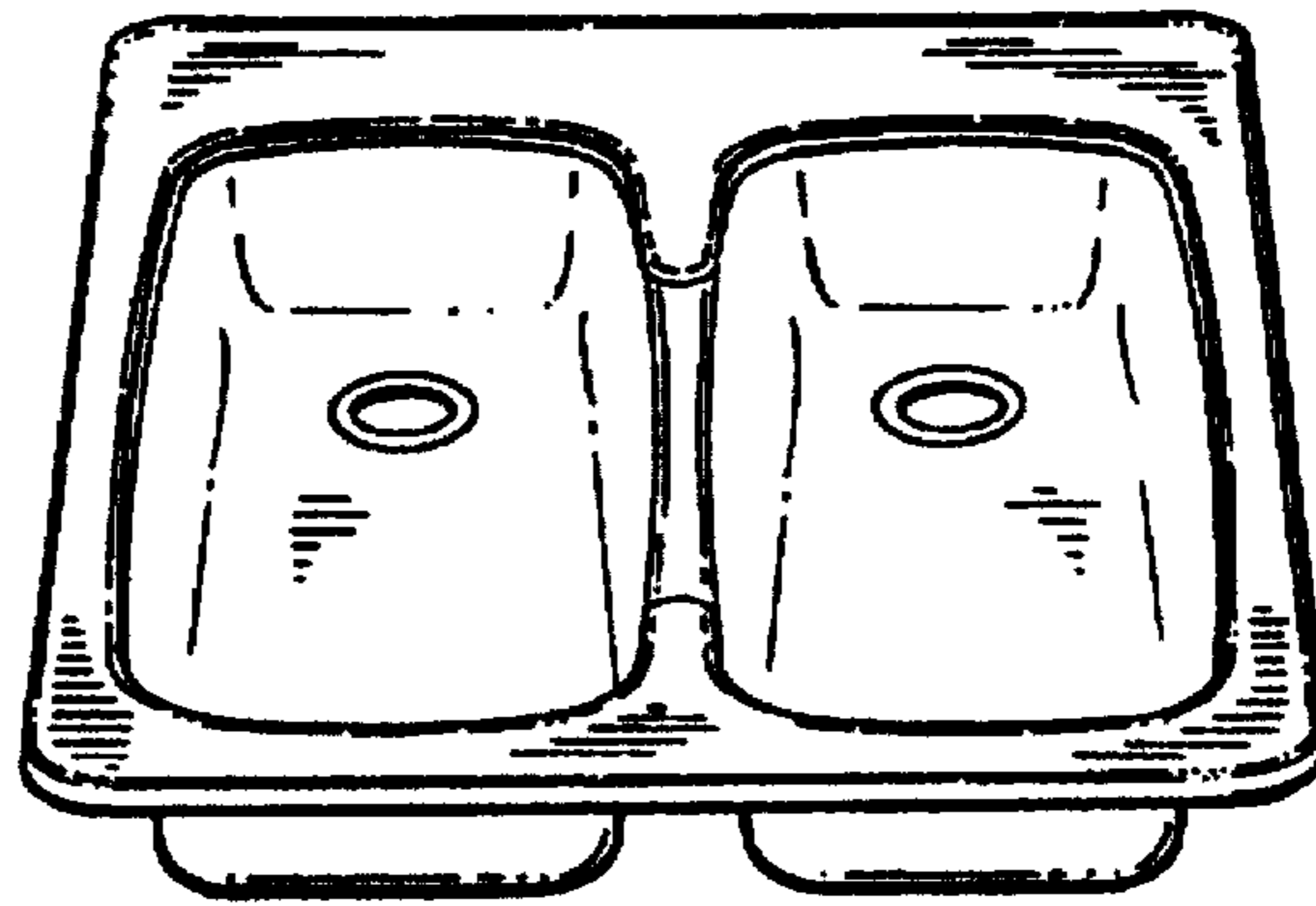

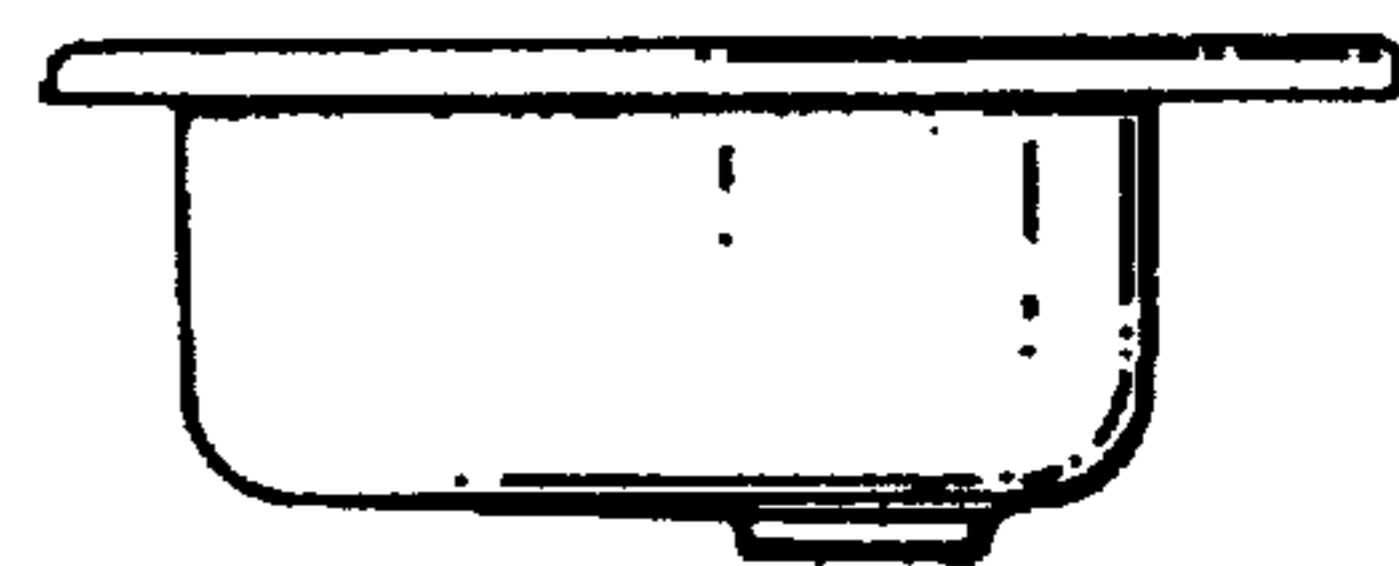
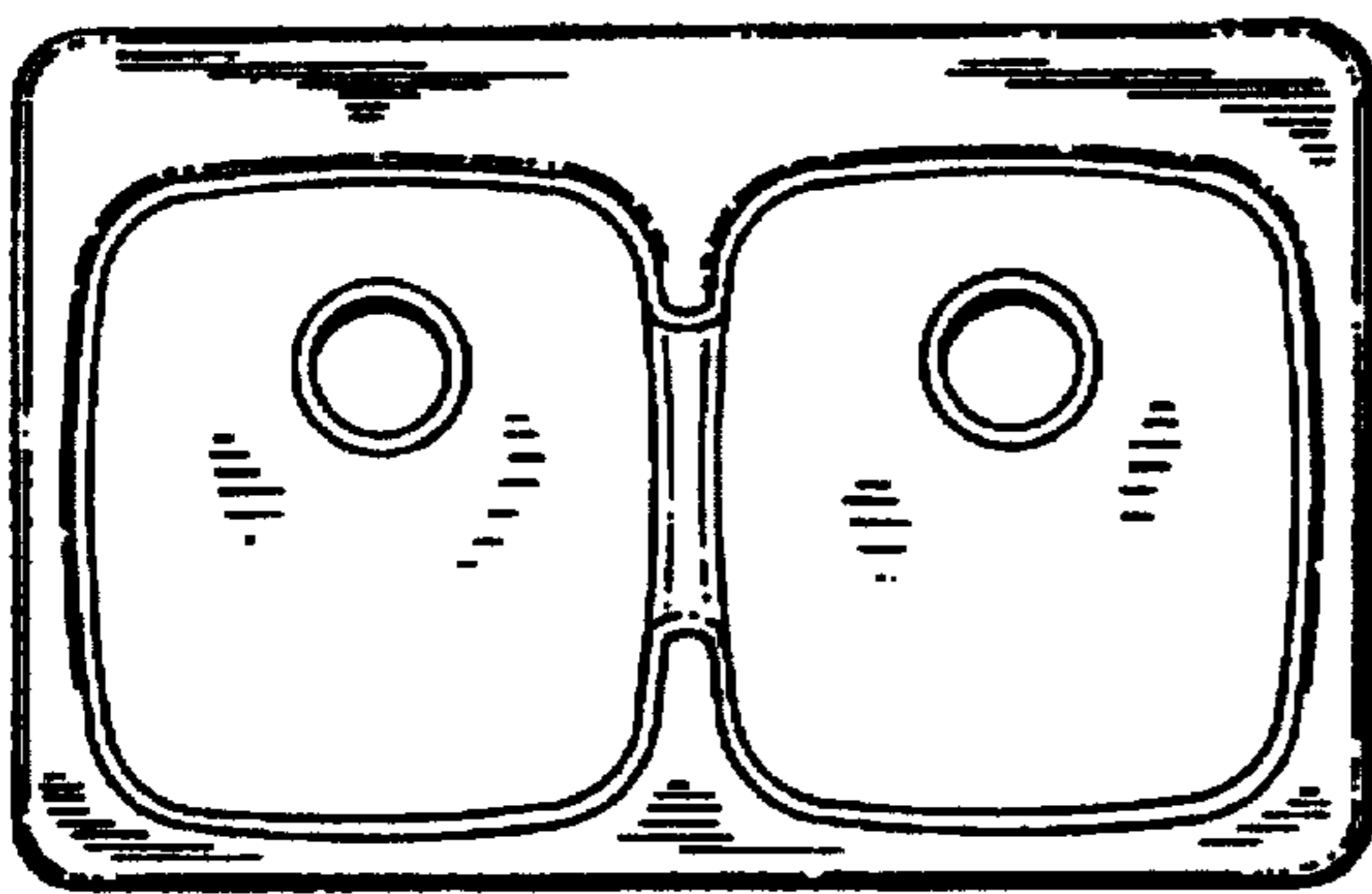

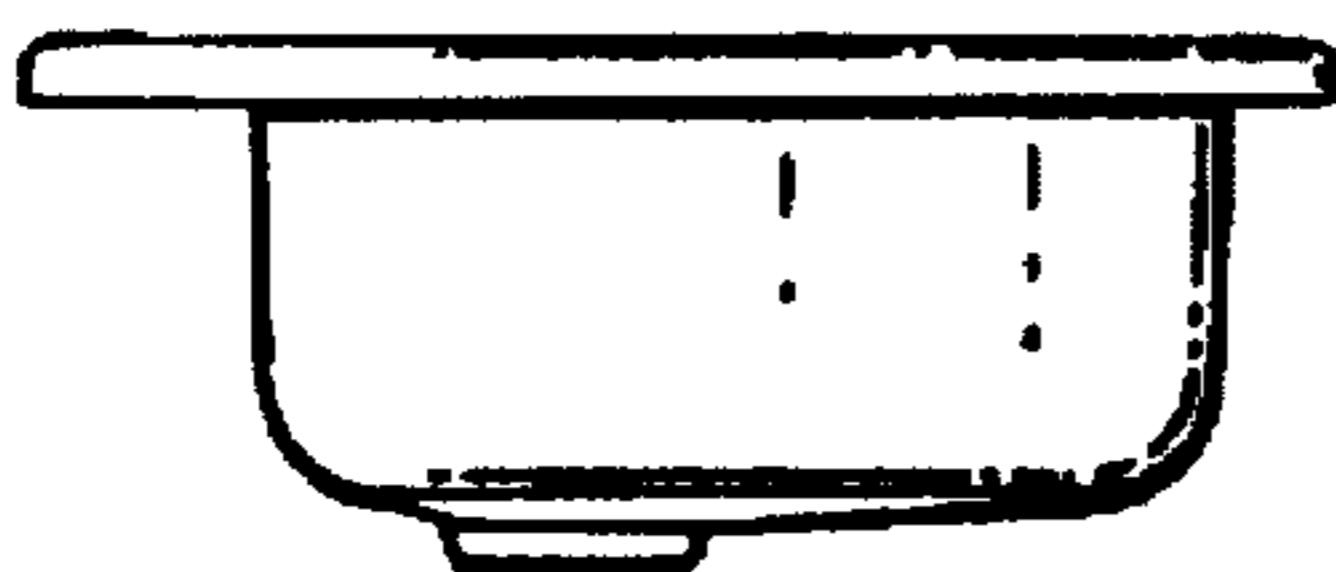

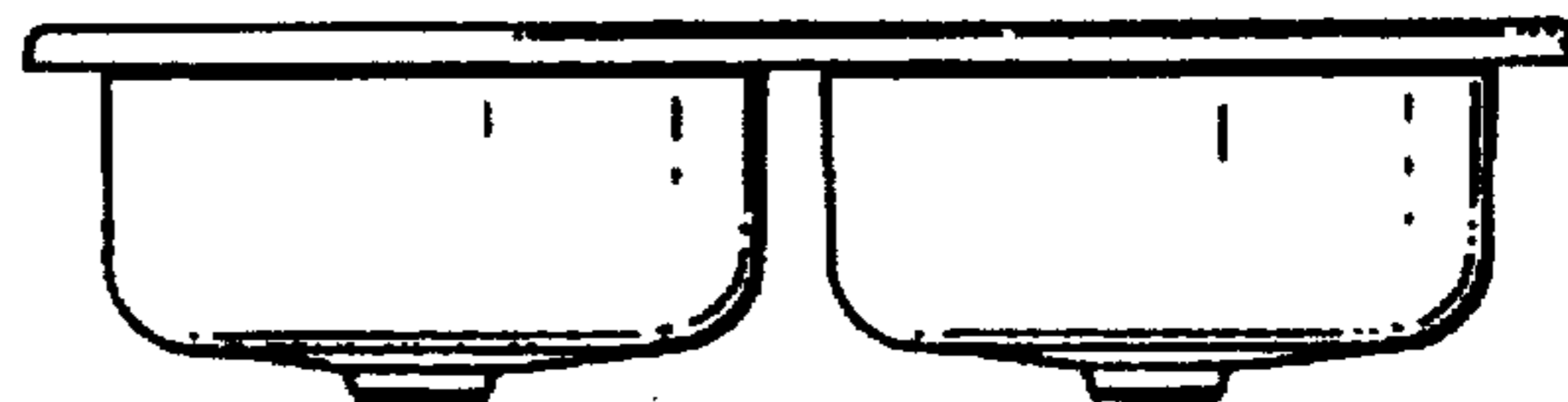
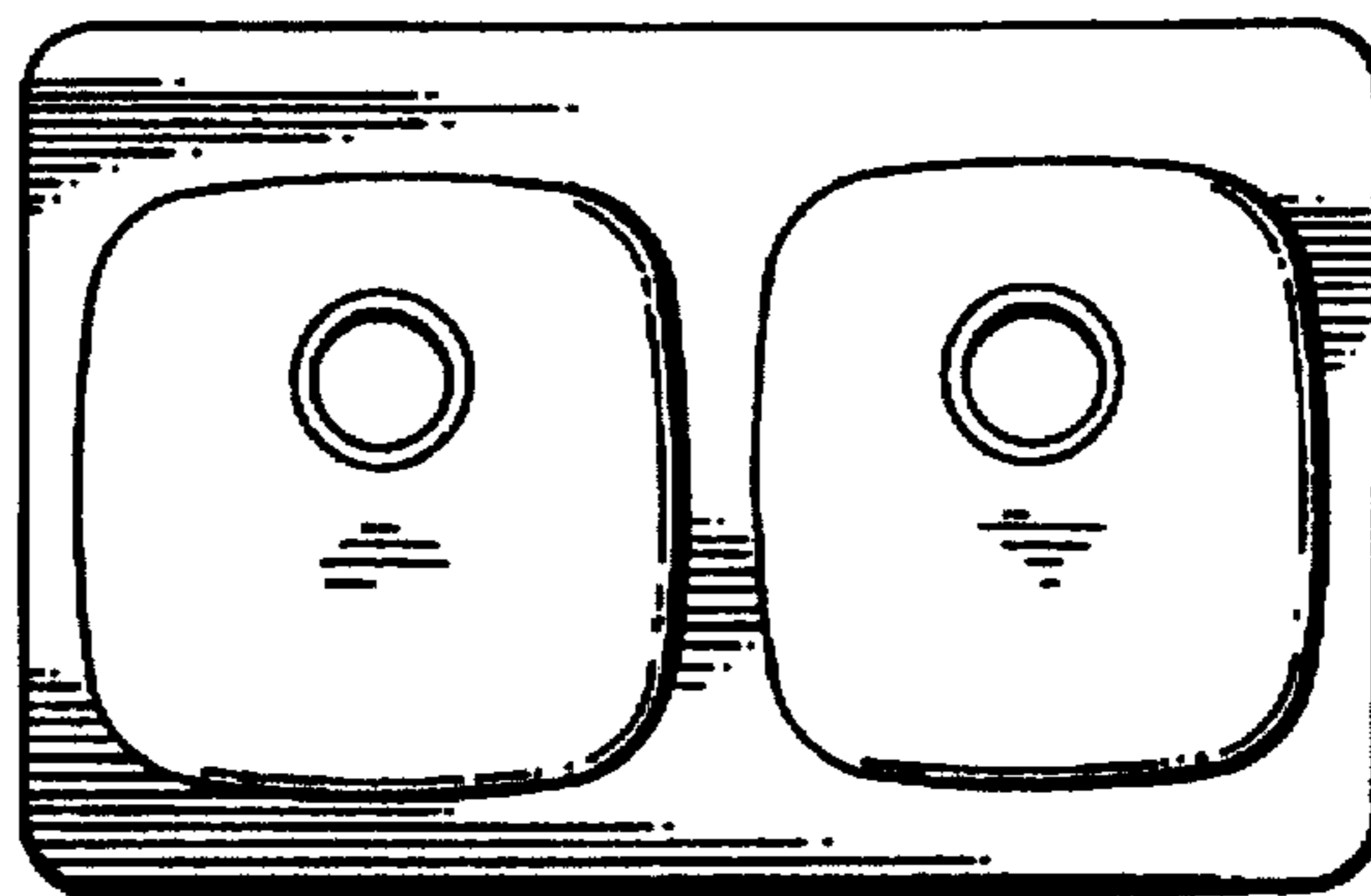

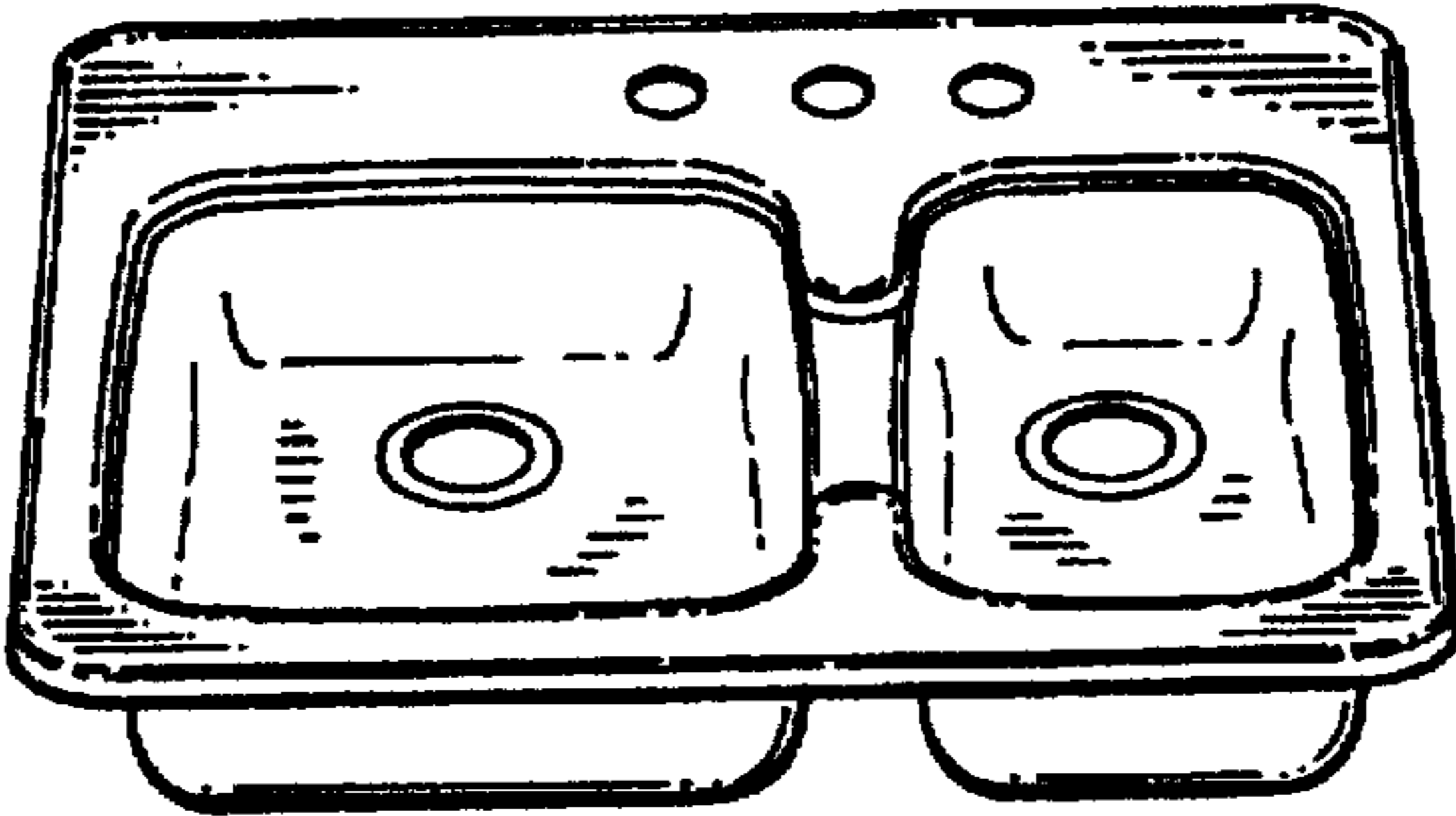

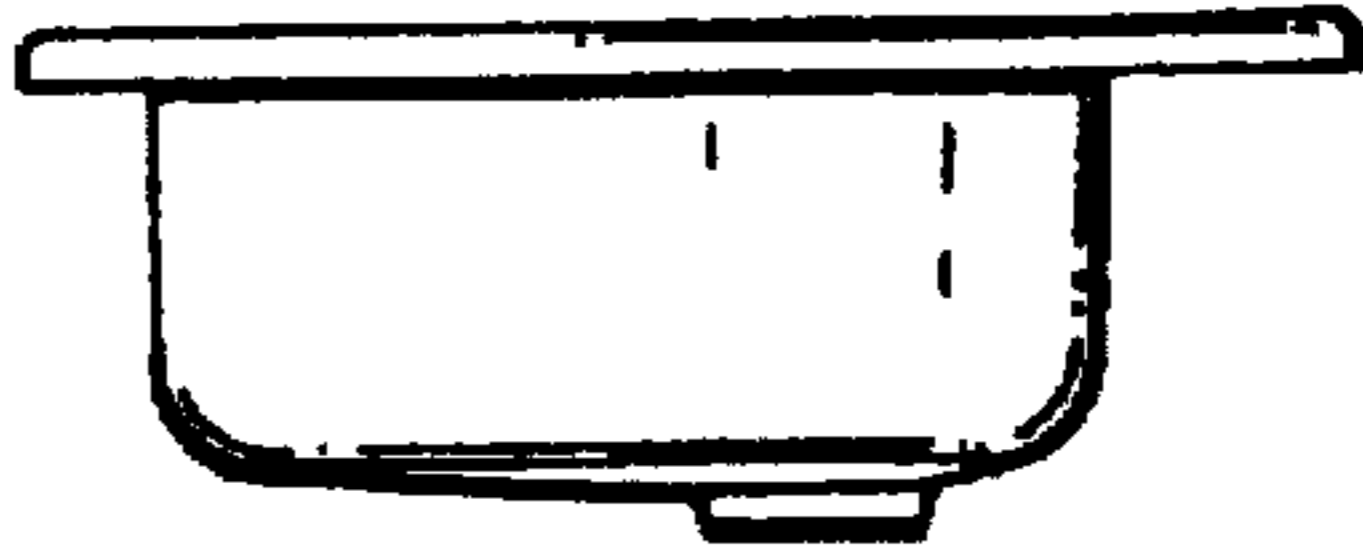
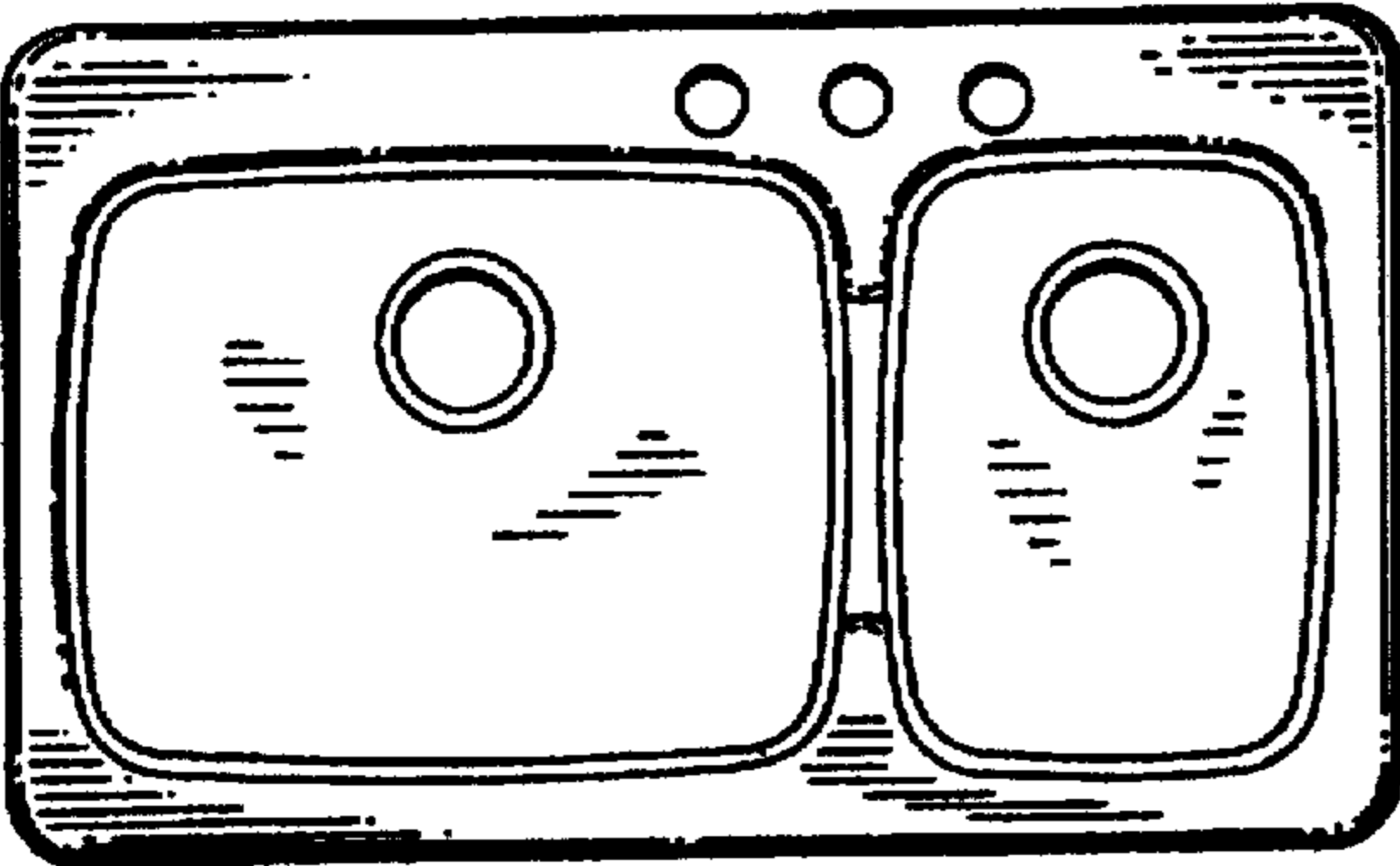

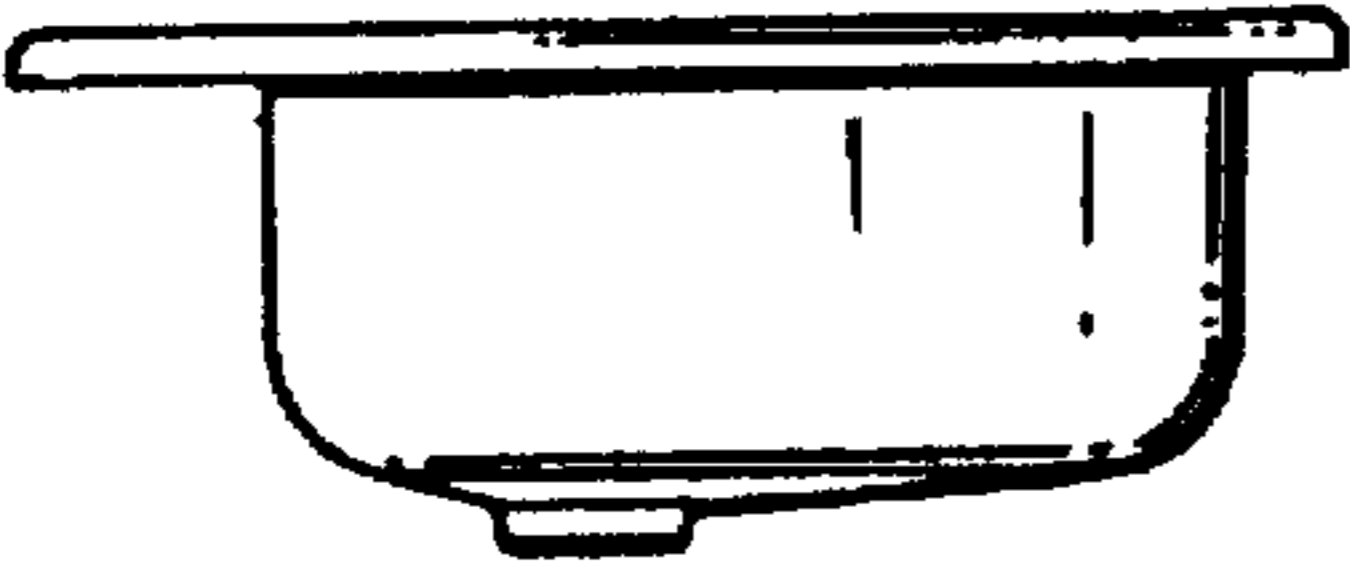

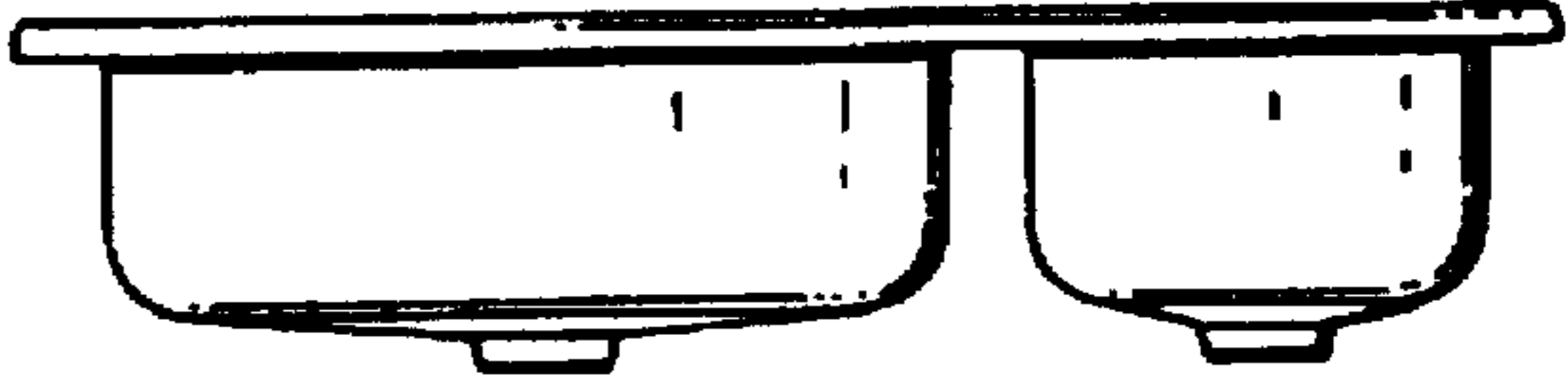
