DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a shoe brush embodying my invention;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the side opposite that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a view from the left end of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a view from the right end of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a bottom elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a side elevated view of a shoe brush embodying a modification of my invention;

FIG. 7 is an elevational view of the side opposite that of FIG. 6;

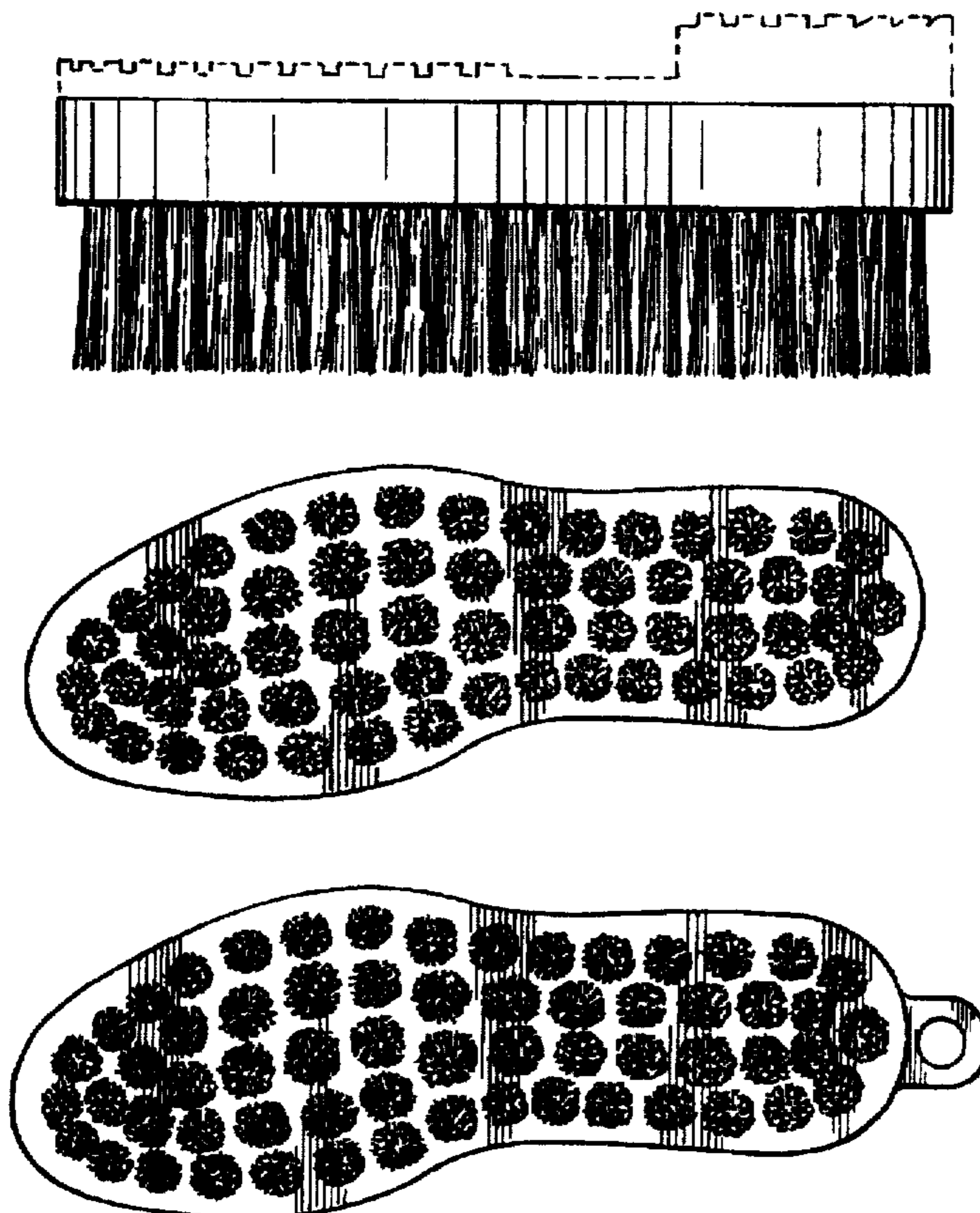
FIG. 8 is a view from the left end of FIG. 6;

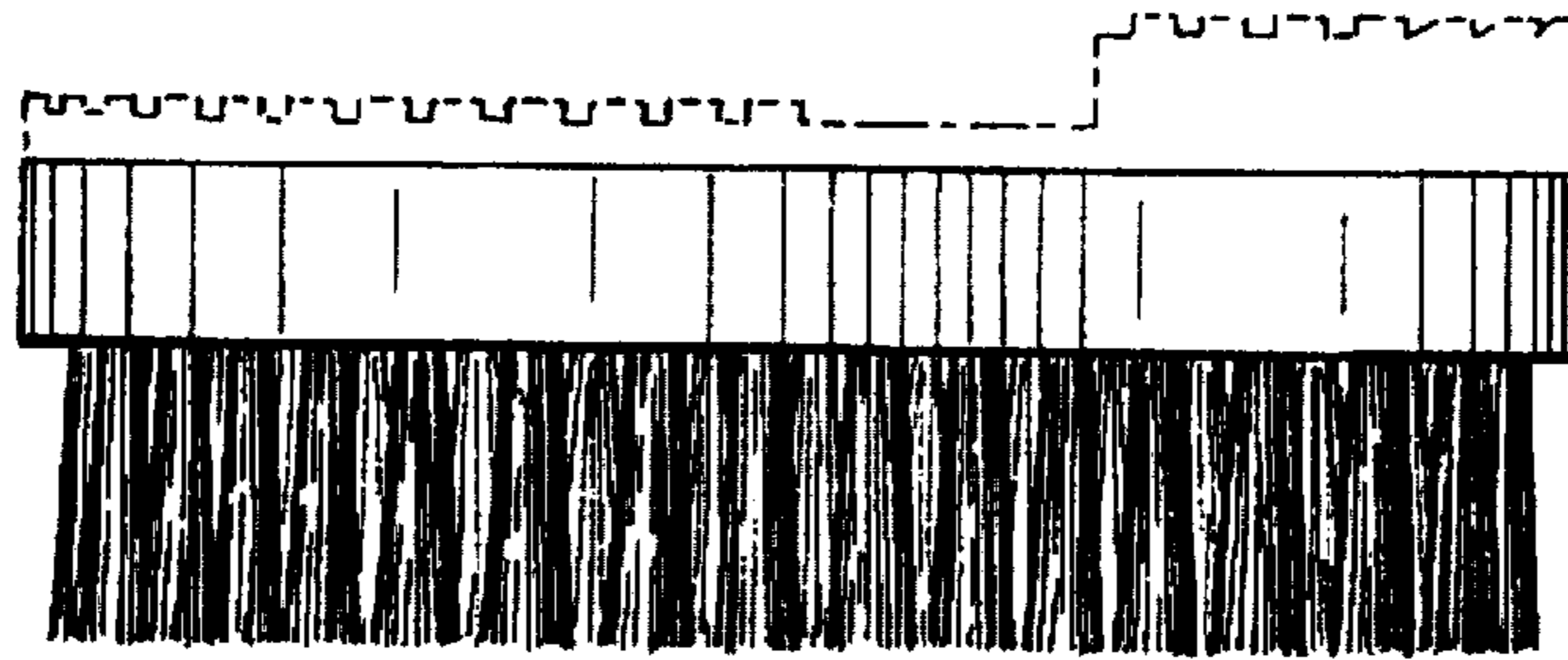

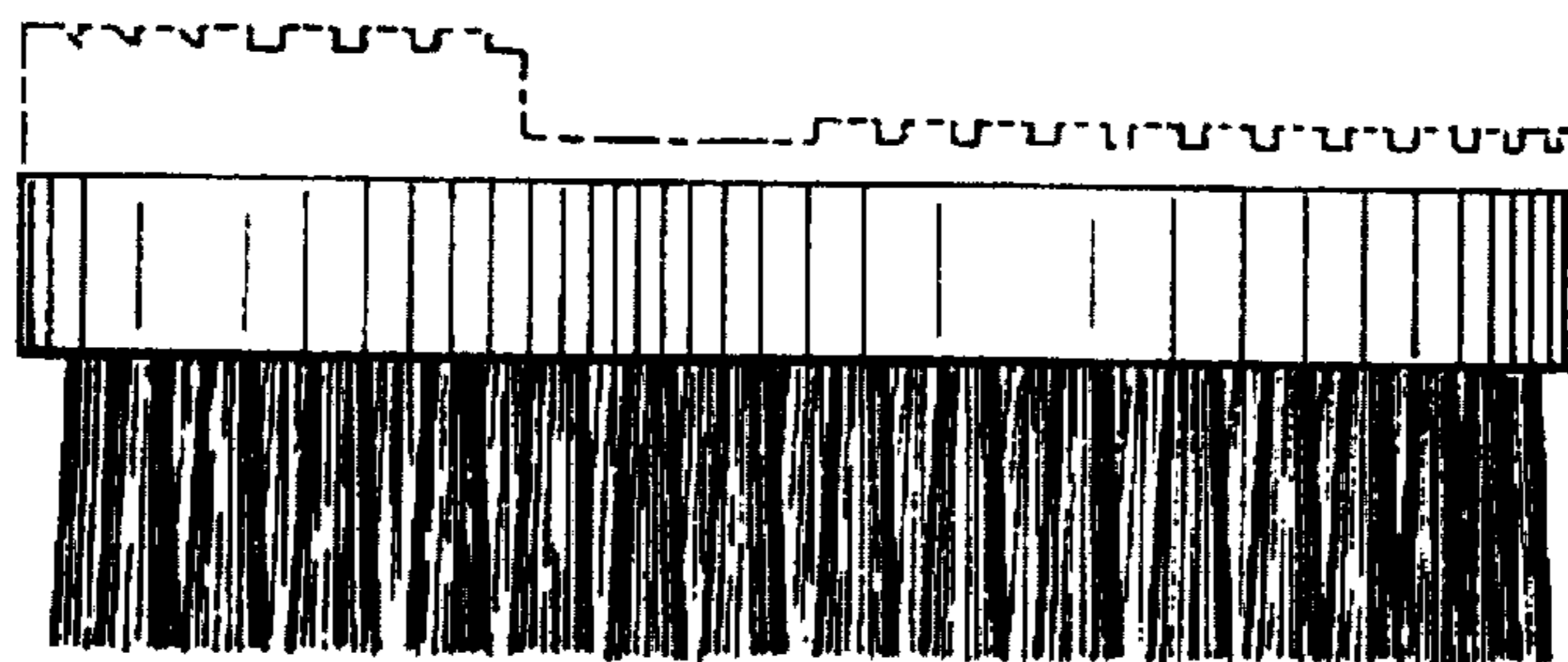

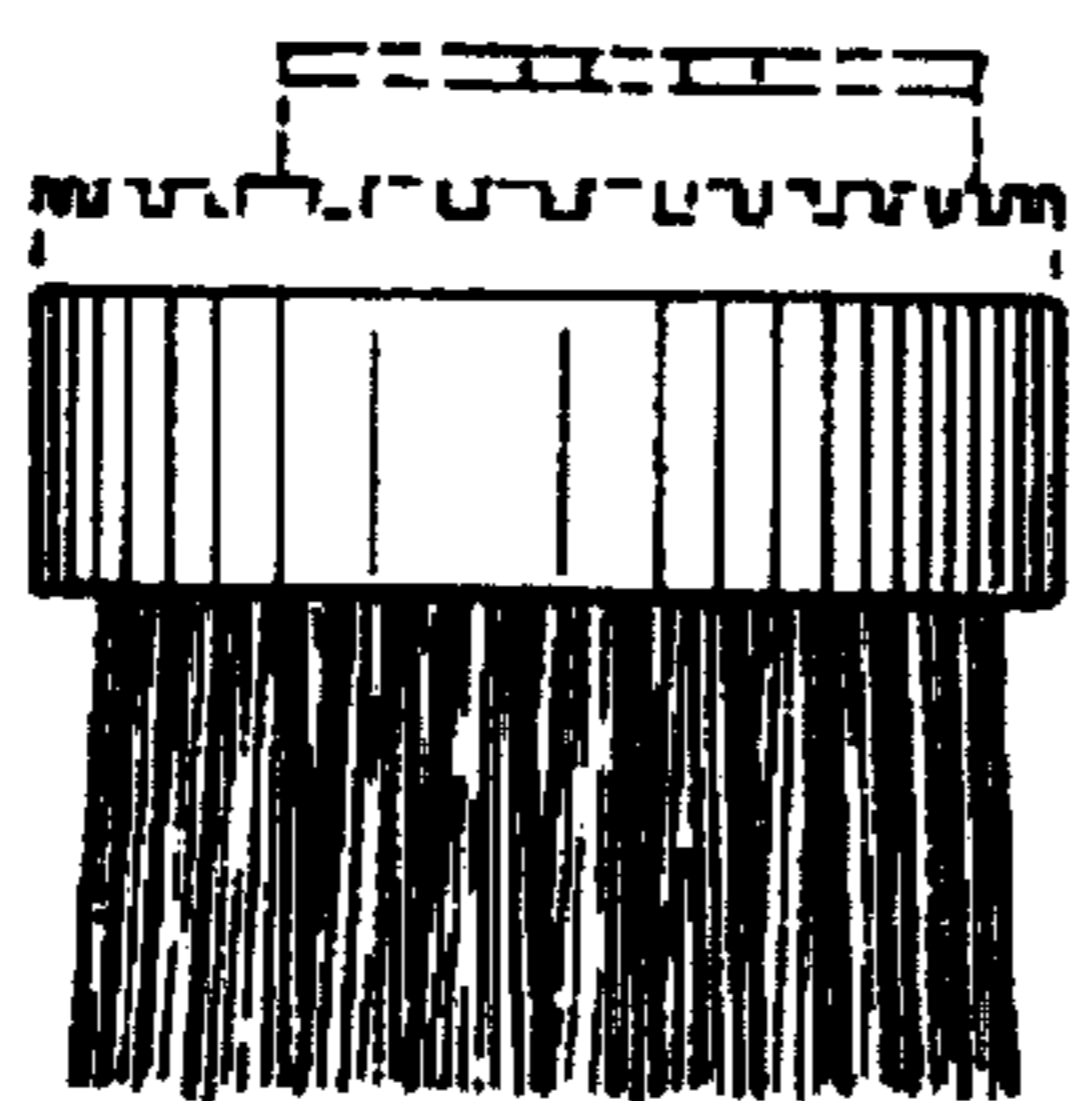

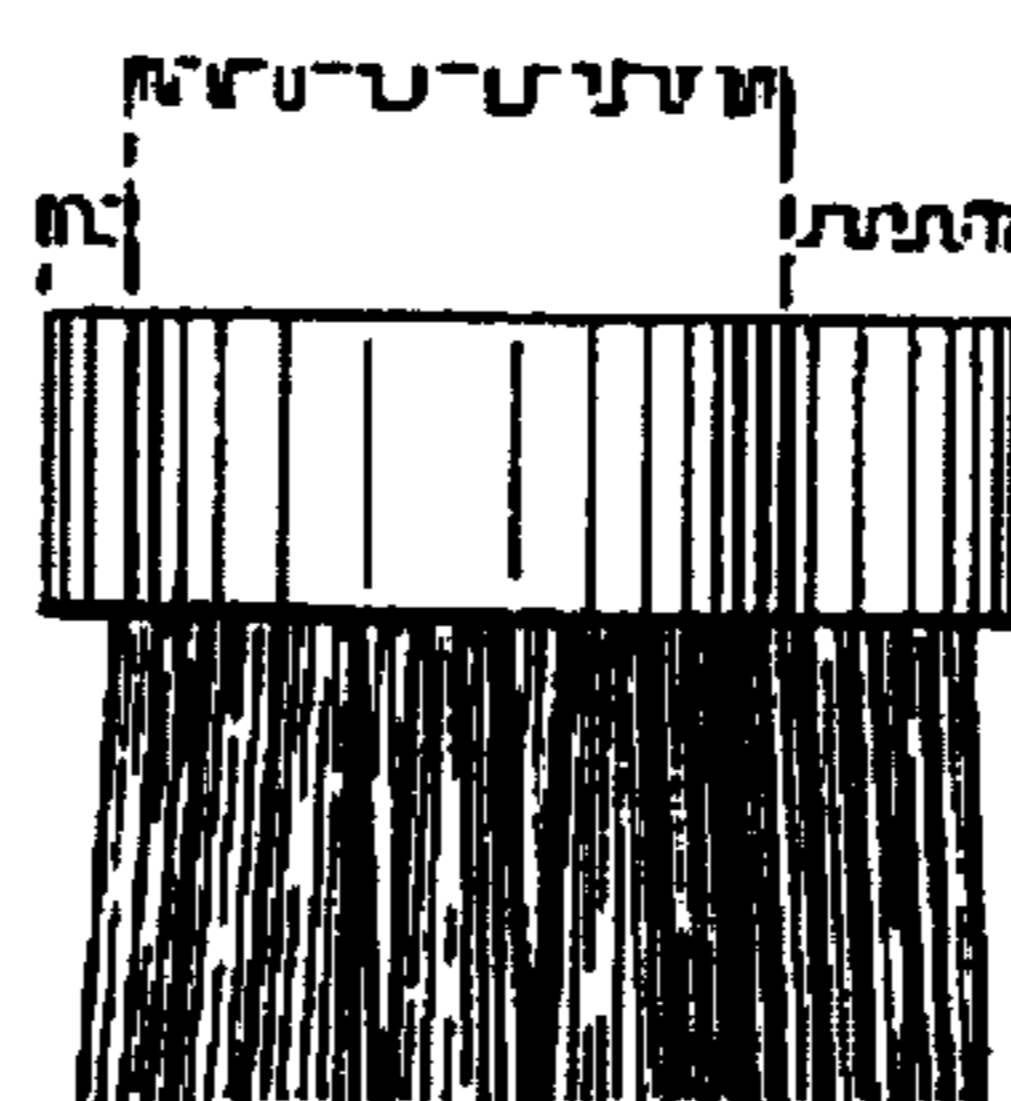

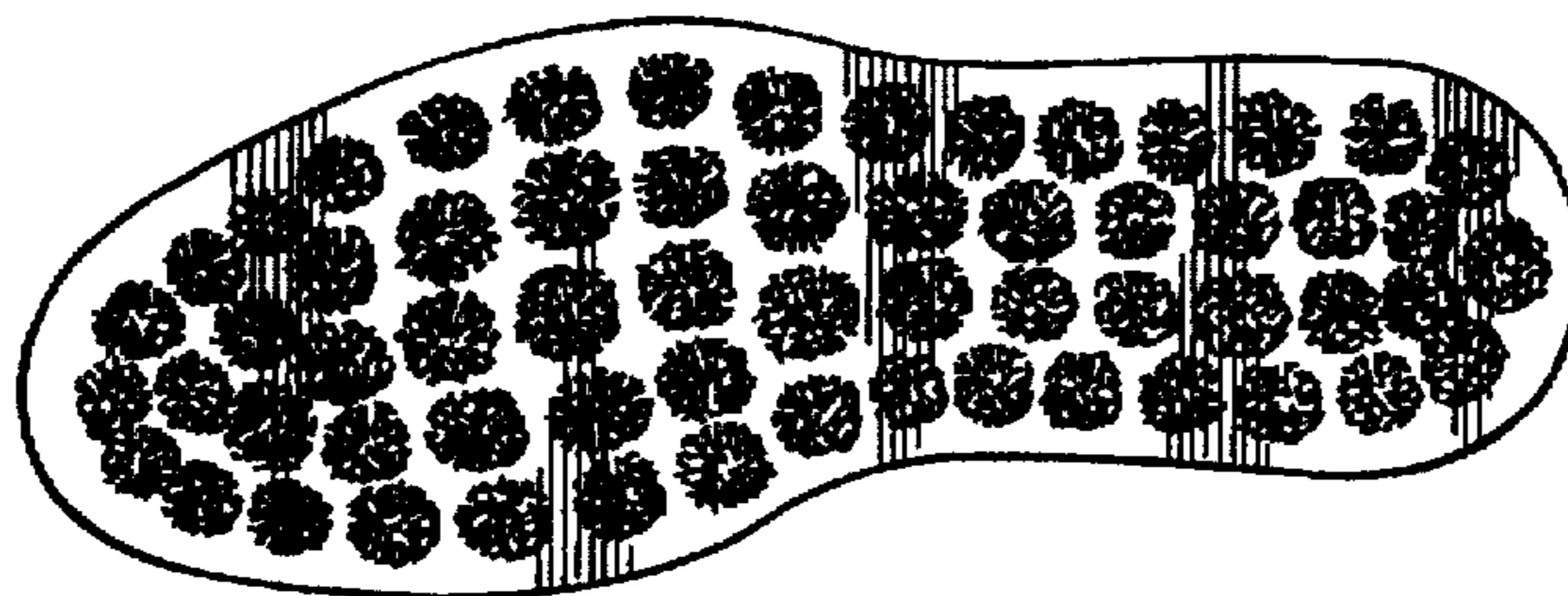

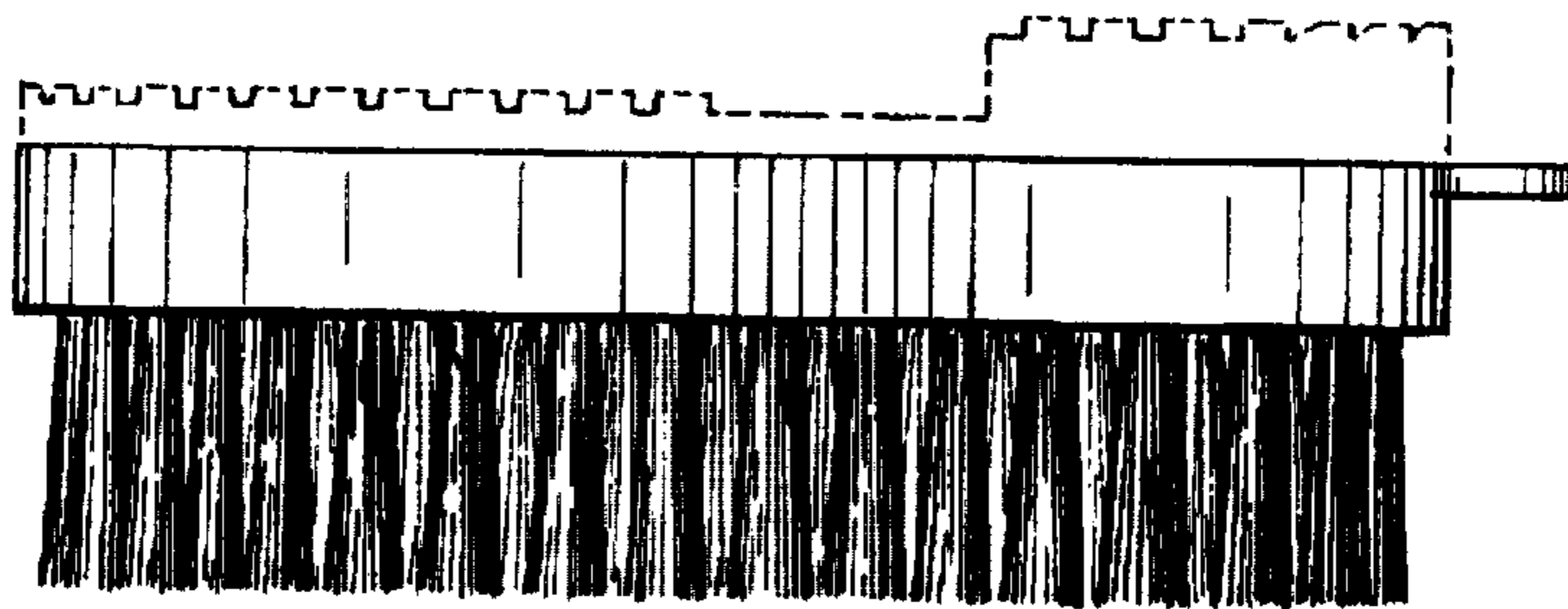

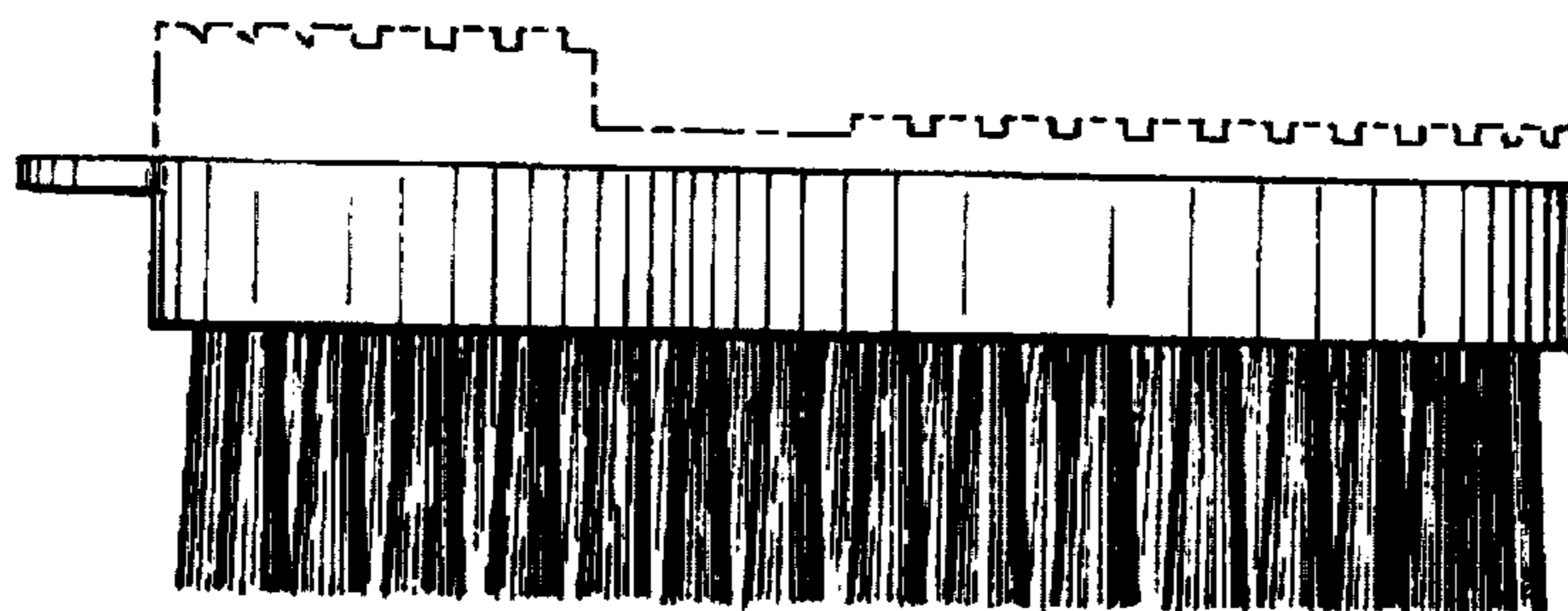

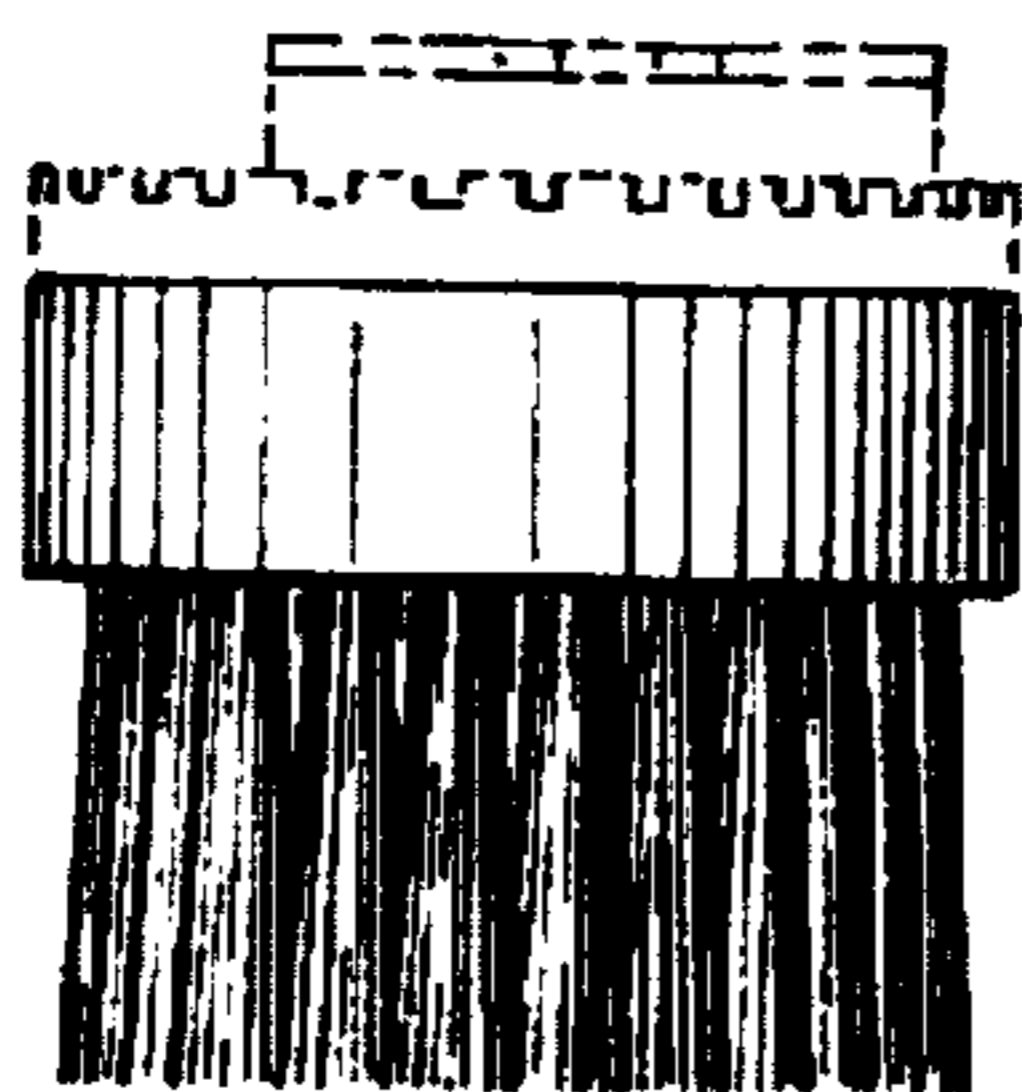

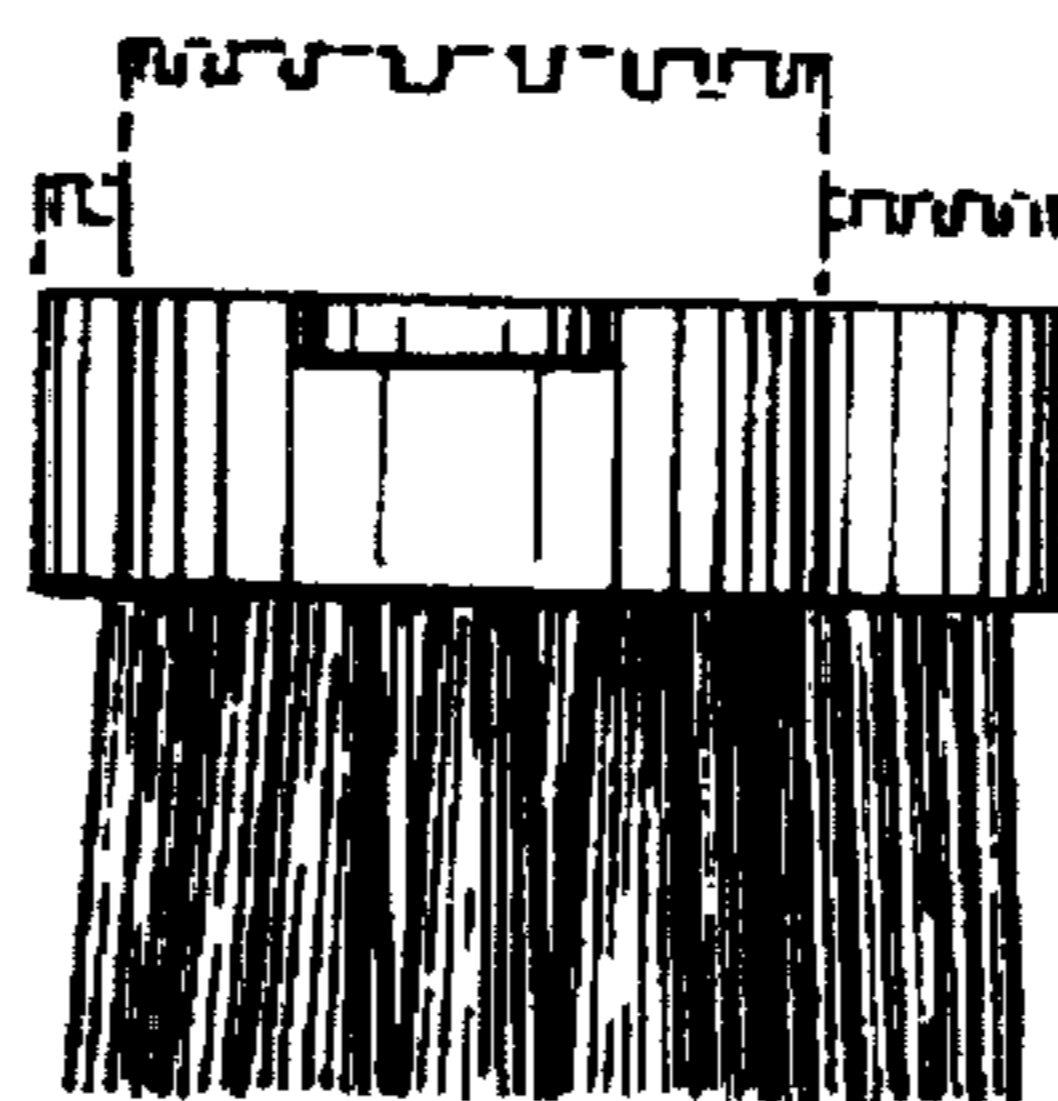

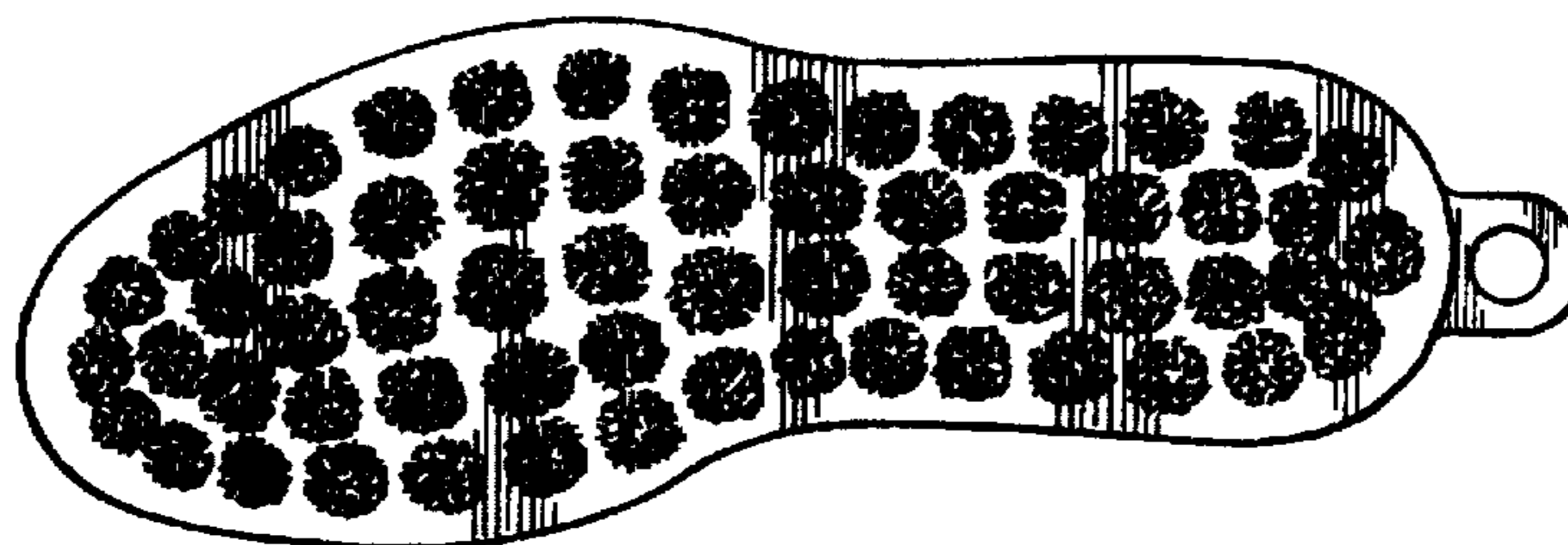
