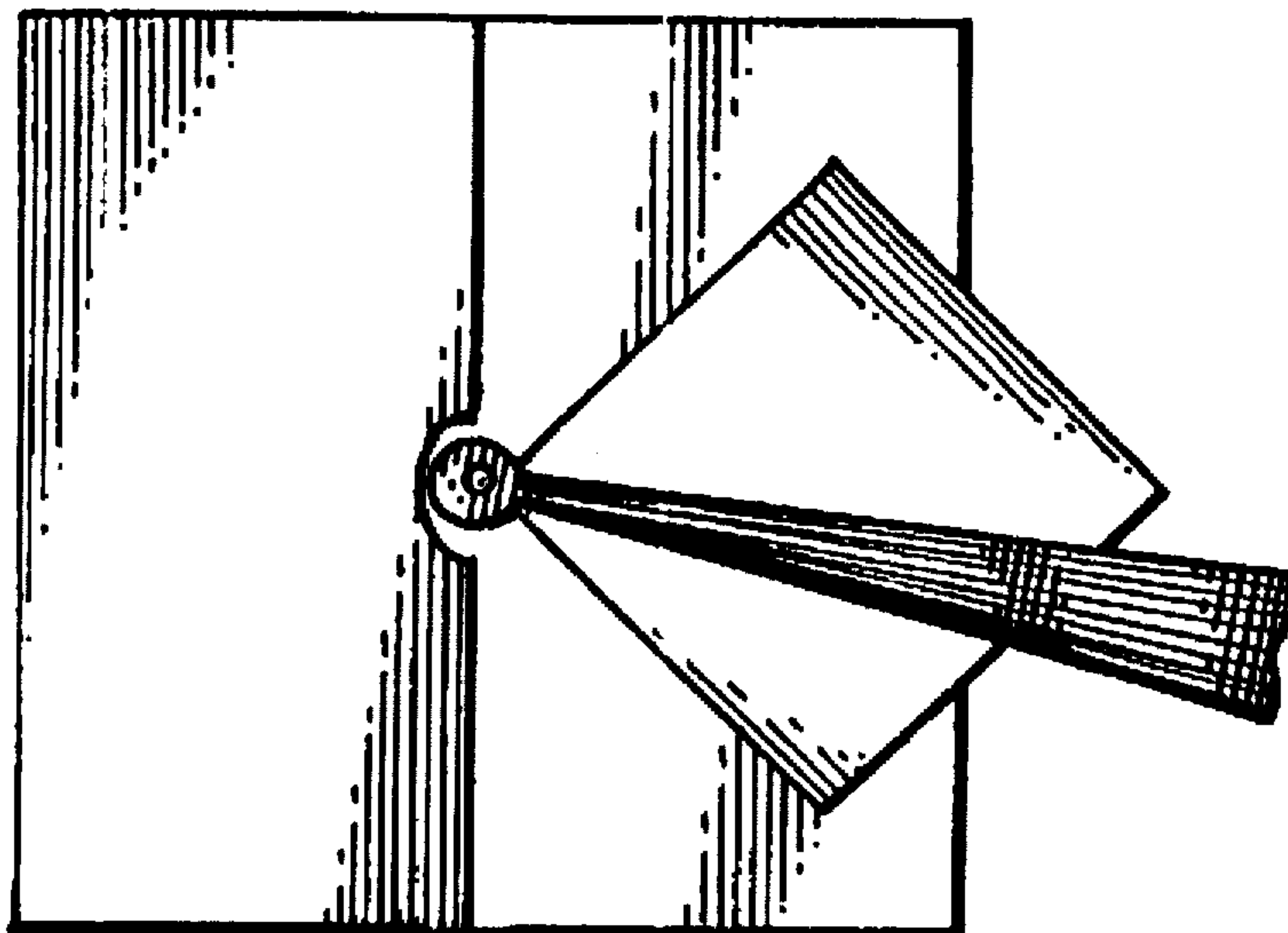
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mortar board graduation card showing my design;

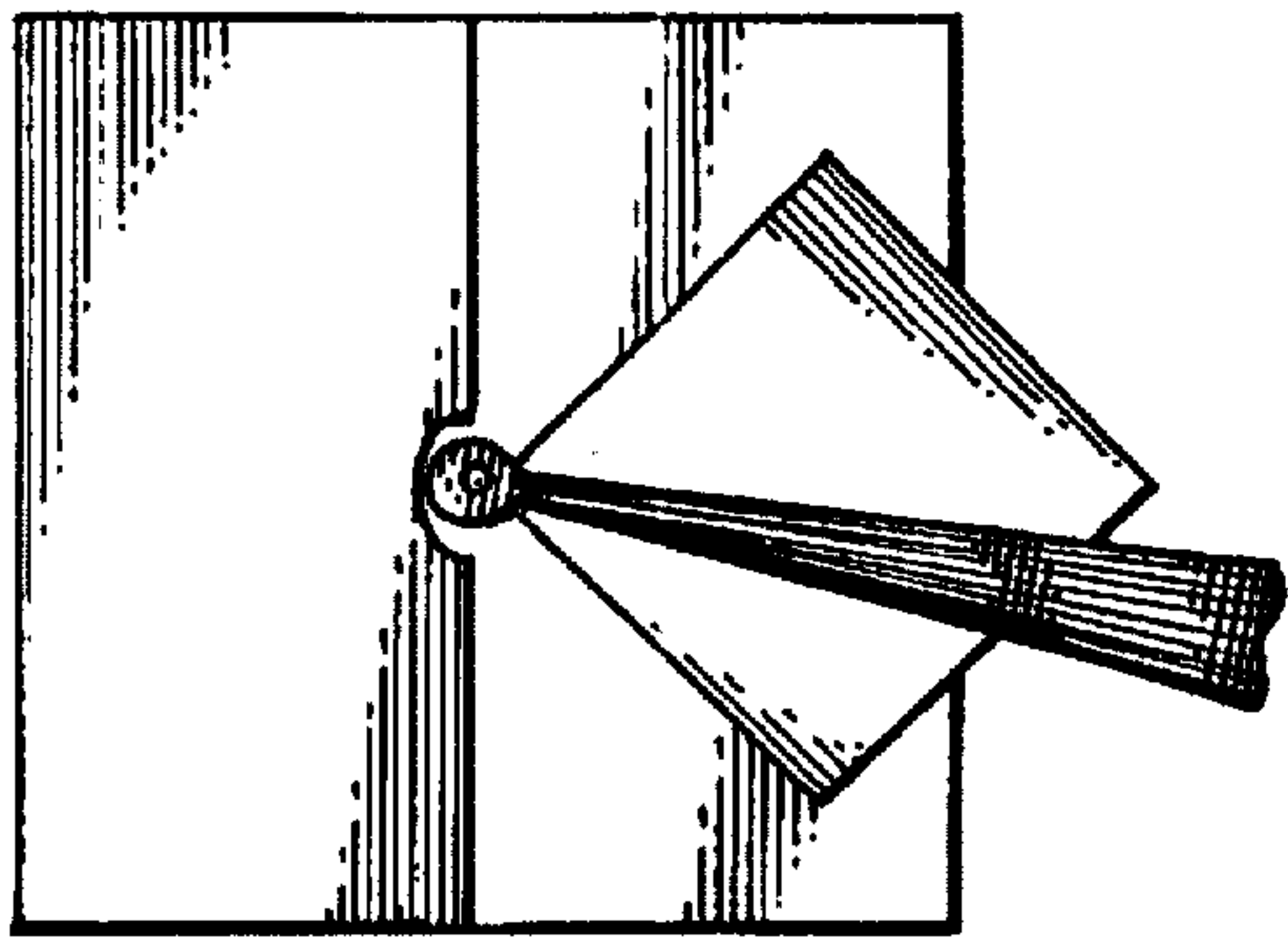

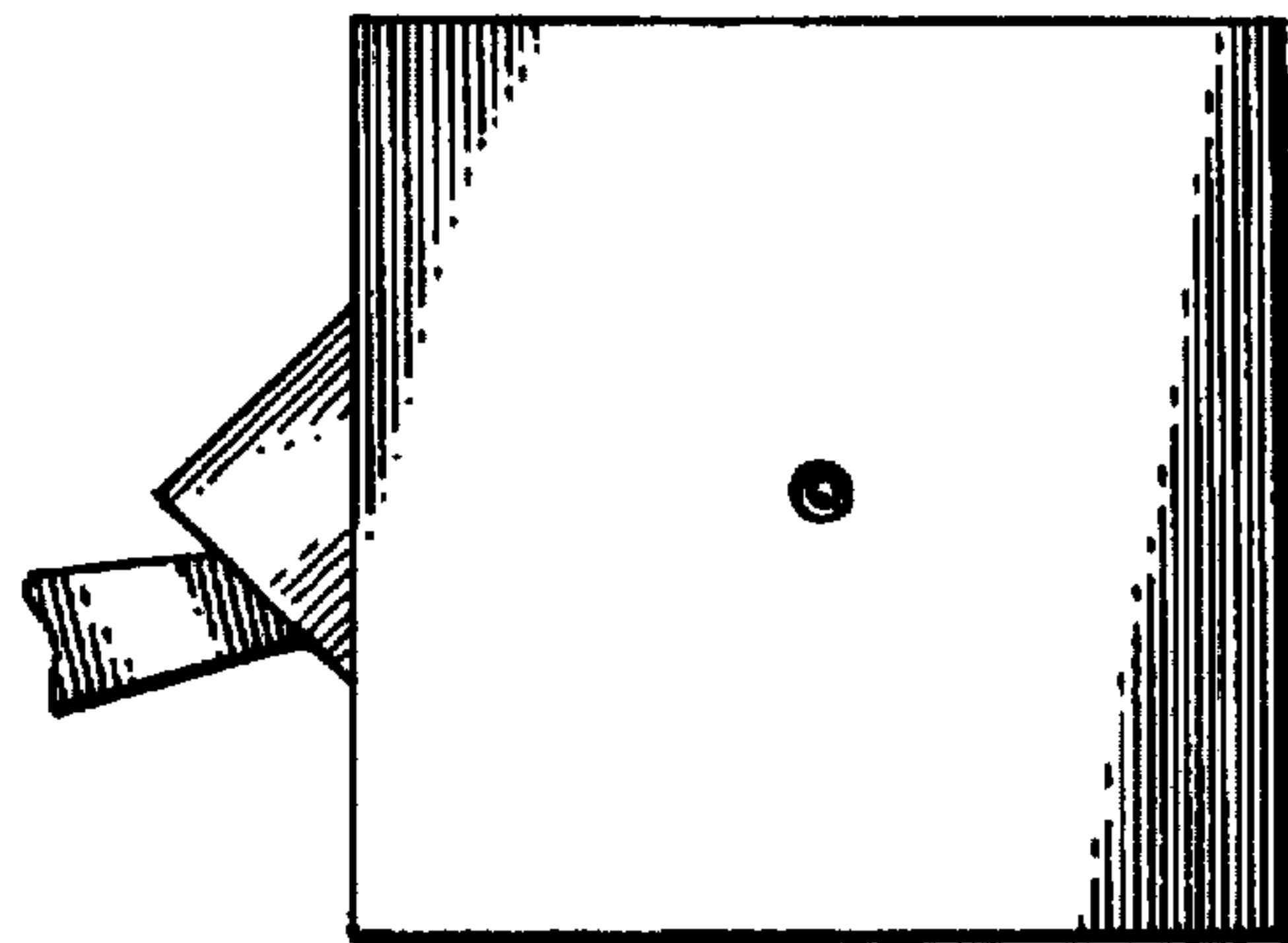
