[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf tee dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf tee dispenser showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of thereof, the bottom plan view being identical; and,

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image.

The broken line showing of the golf tee and rope in FIG. 1 and the lettering in FIG. 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
