DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top elevational view of the chair design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom elevational view of the chair design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the chair design of FIG. 1;

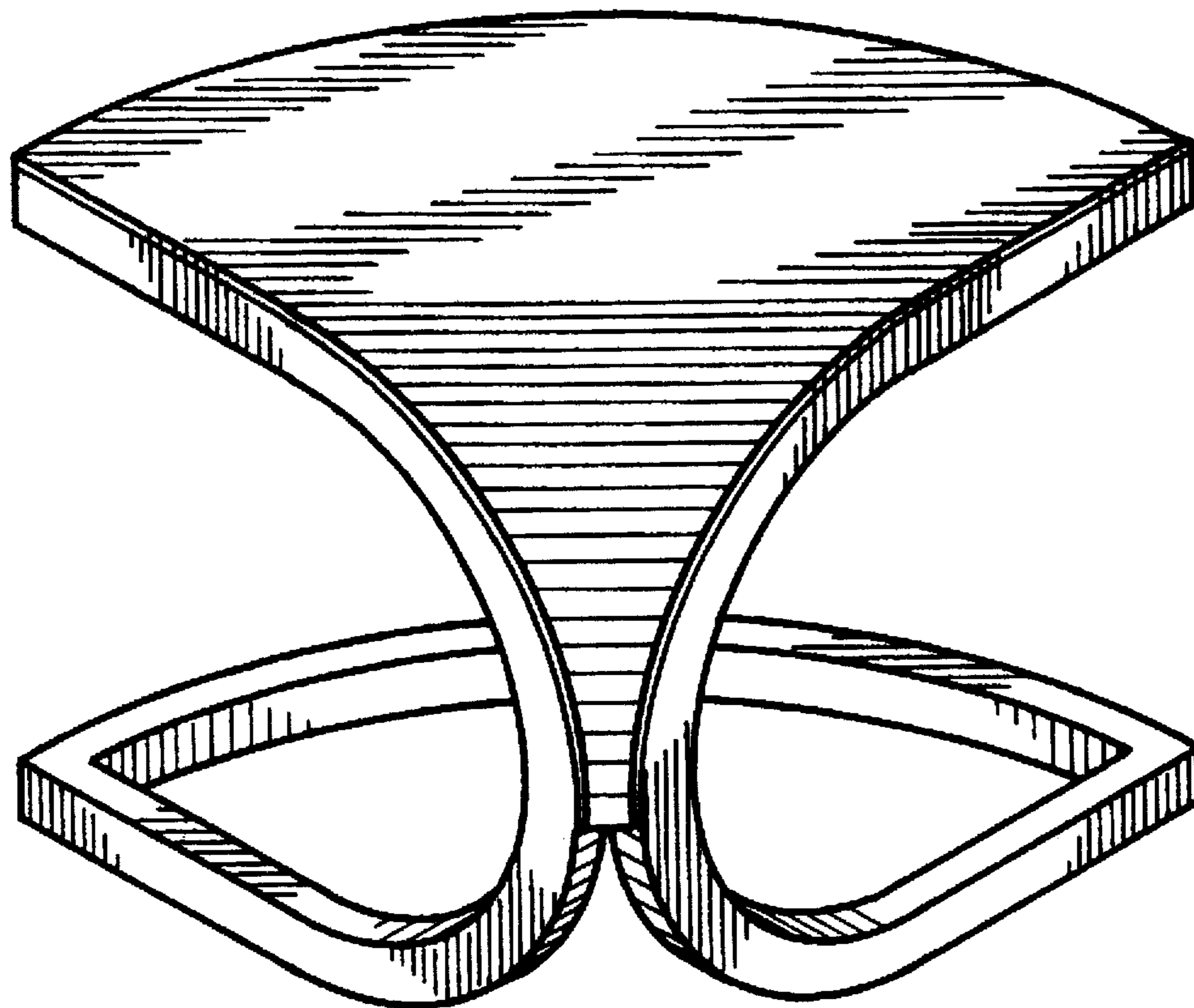
FIG. 5 is one side elevational view of the chair design of FIG. 1;

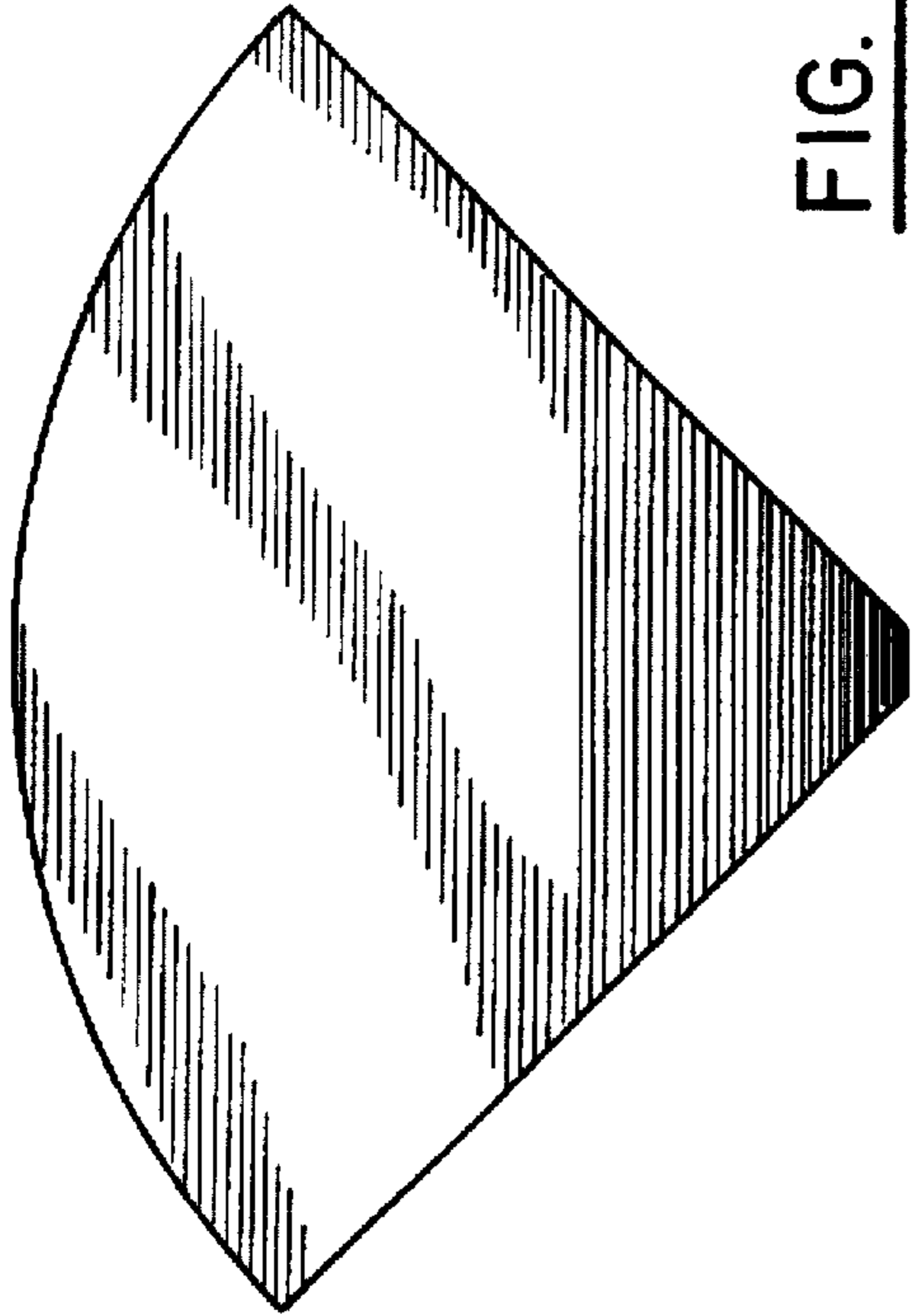

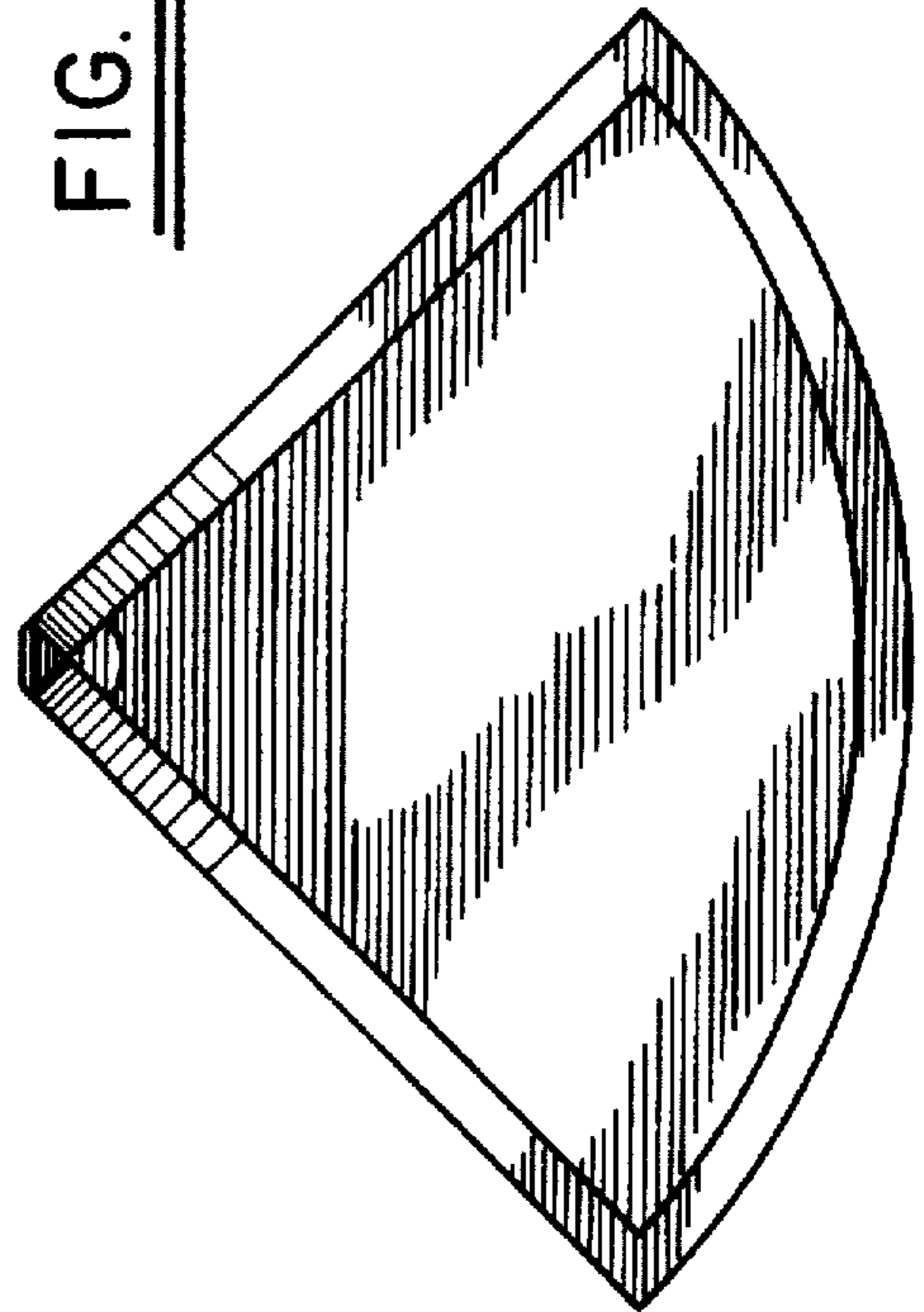

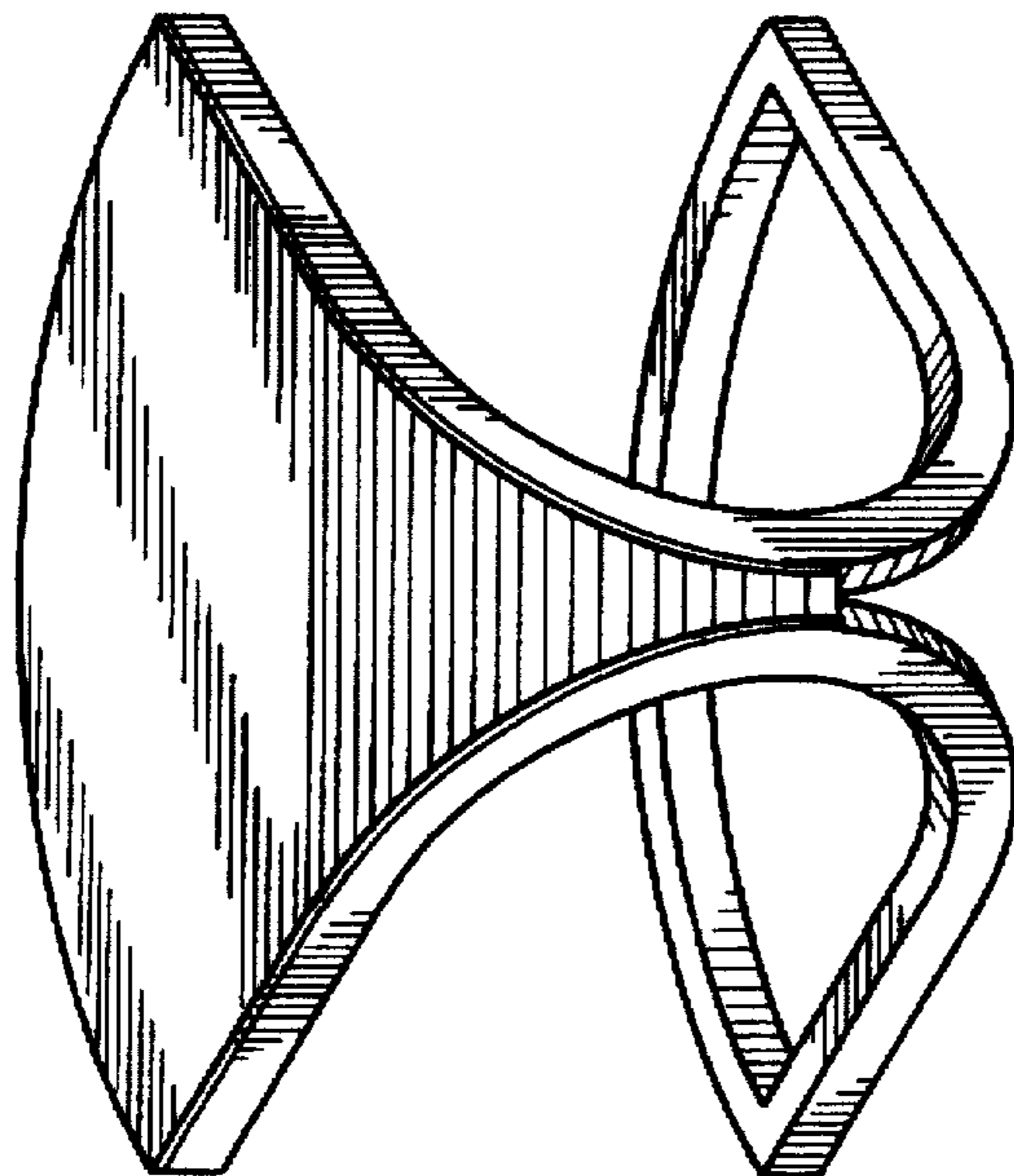

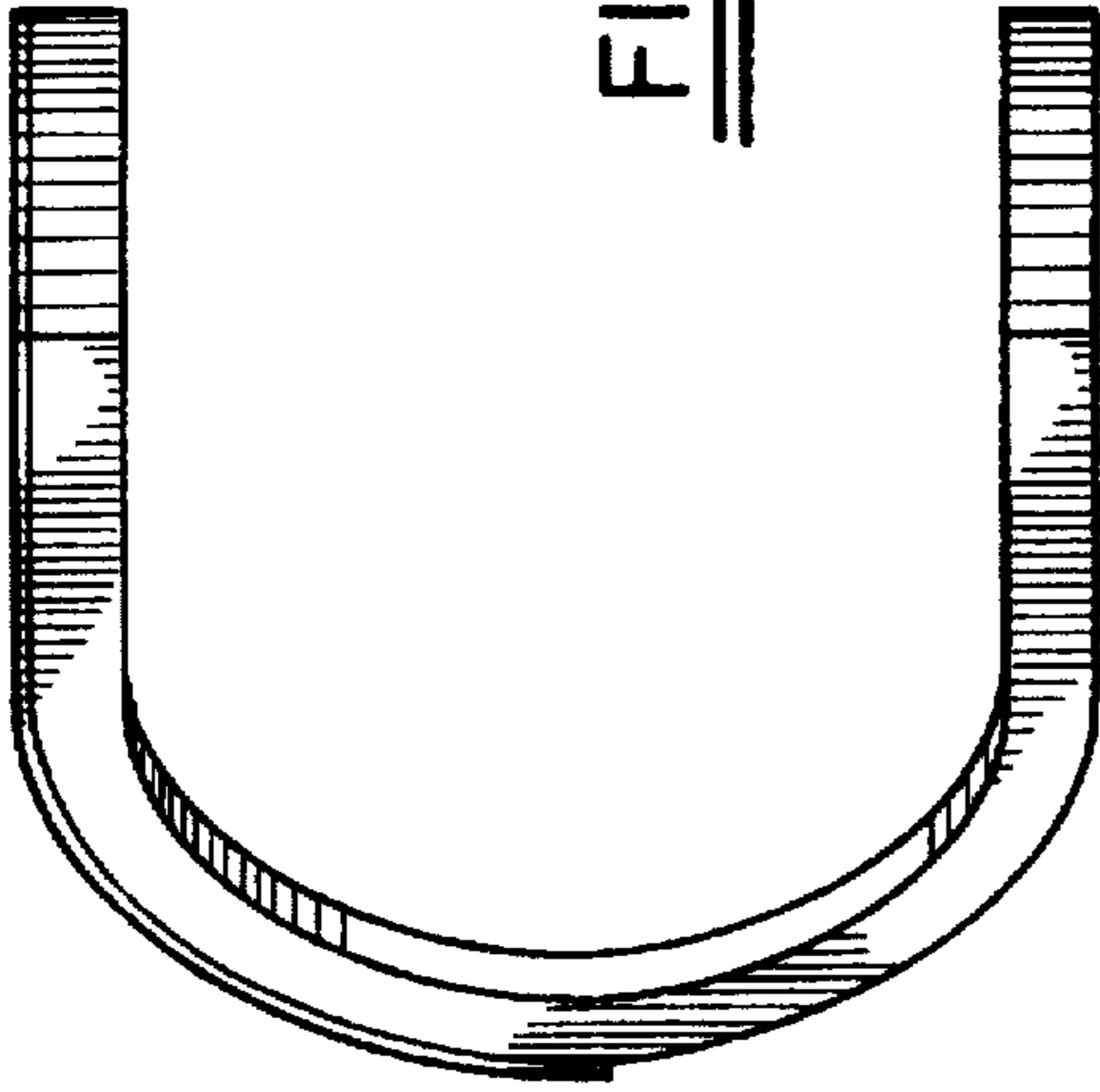

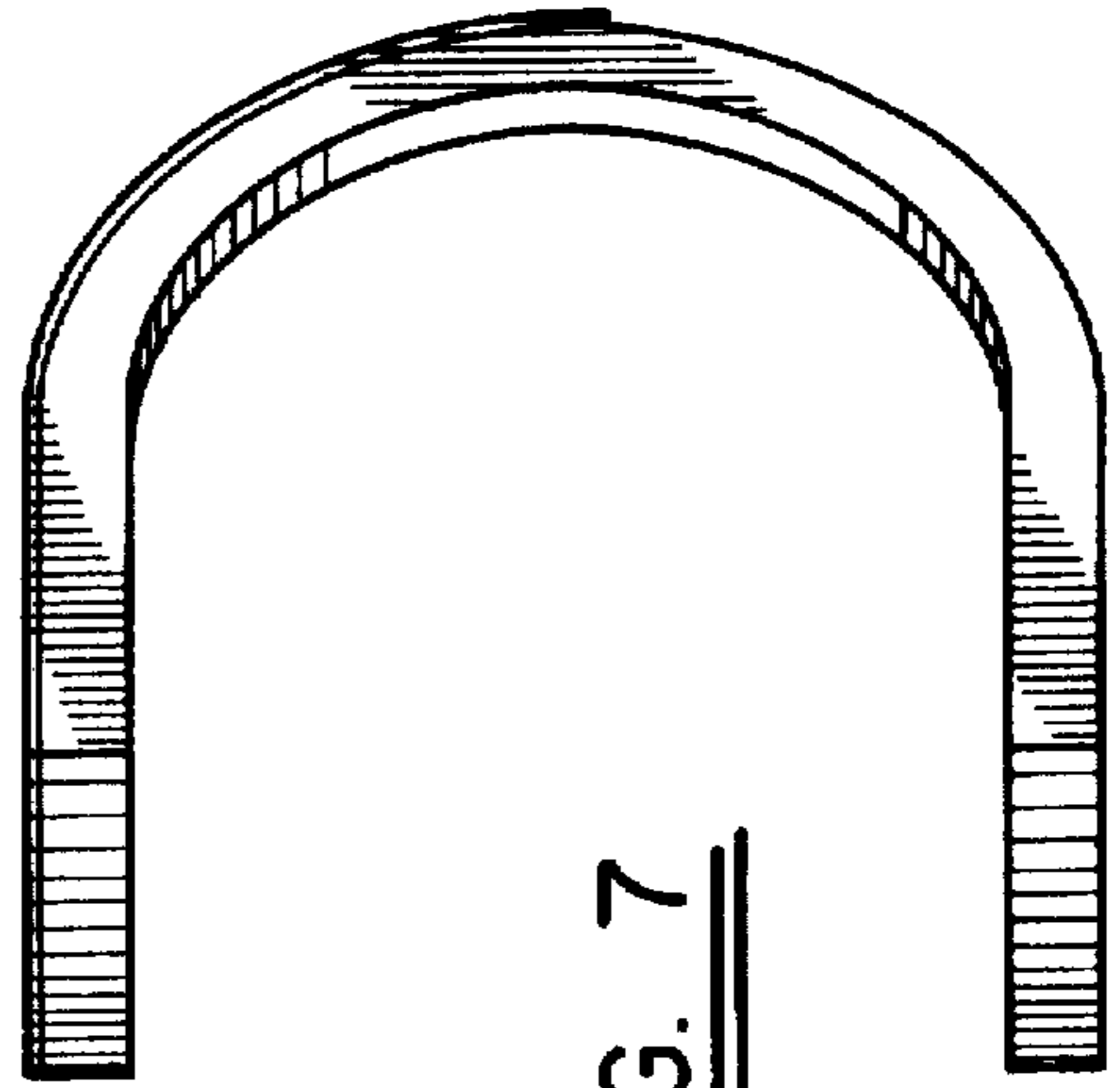

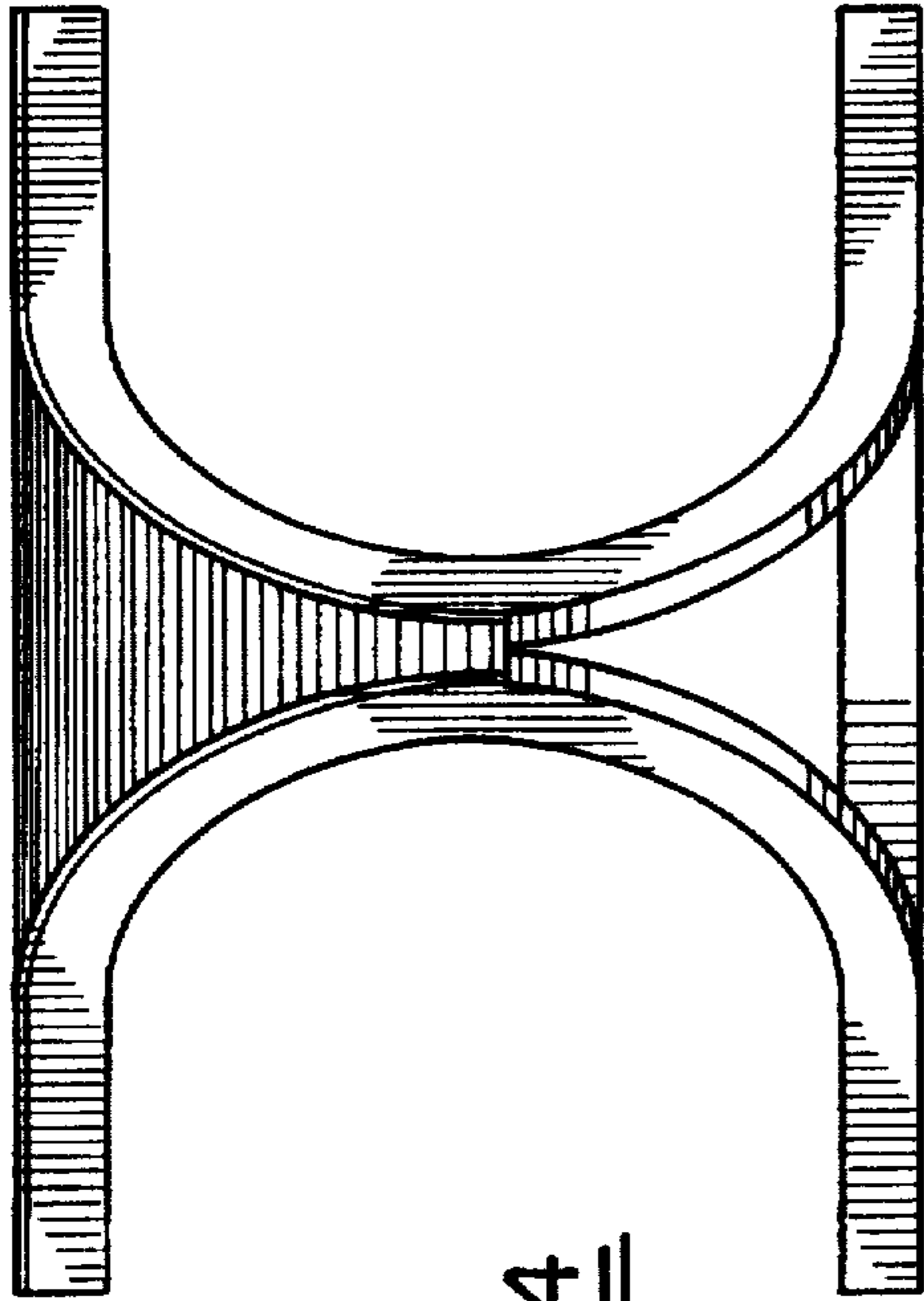

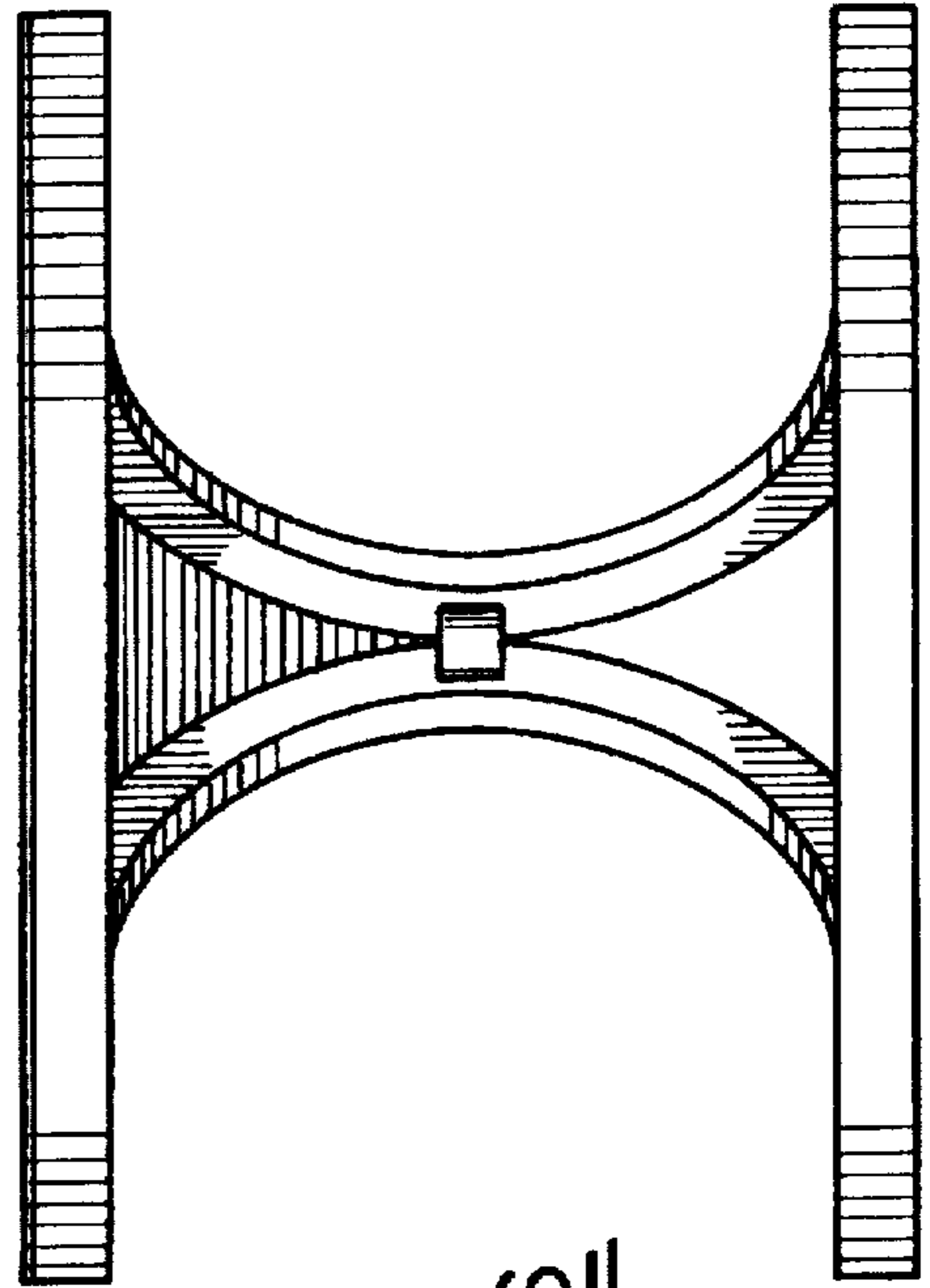

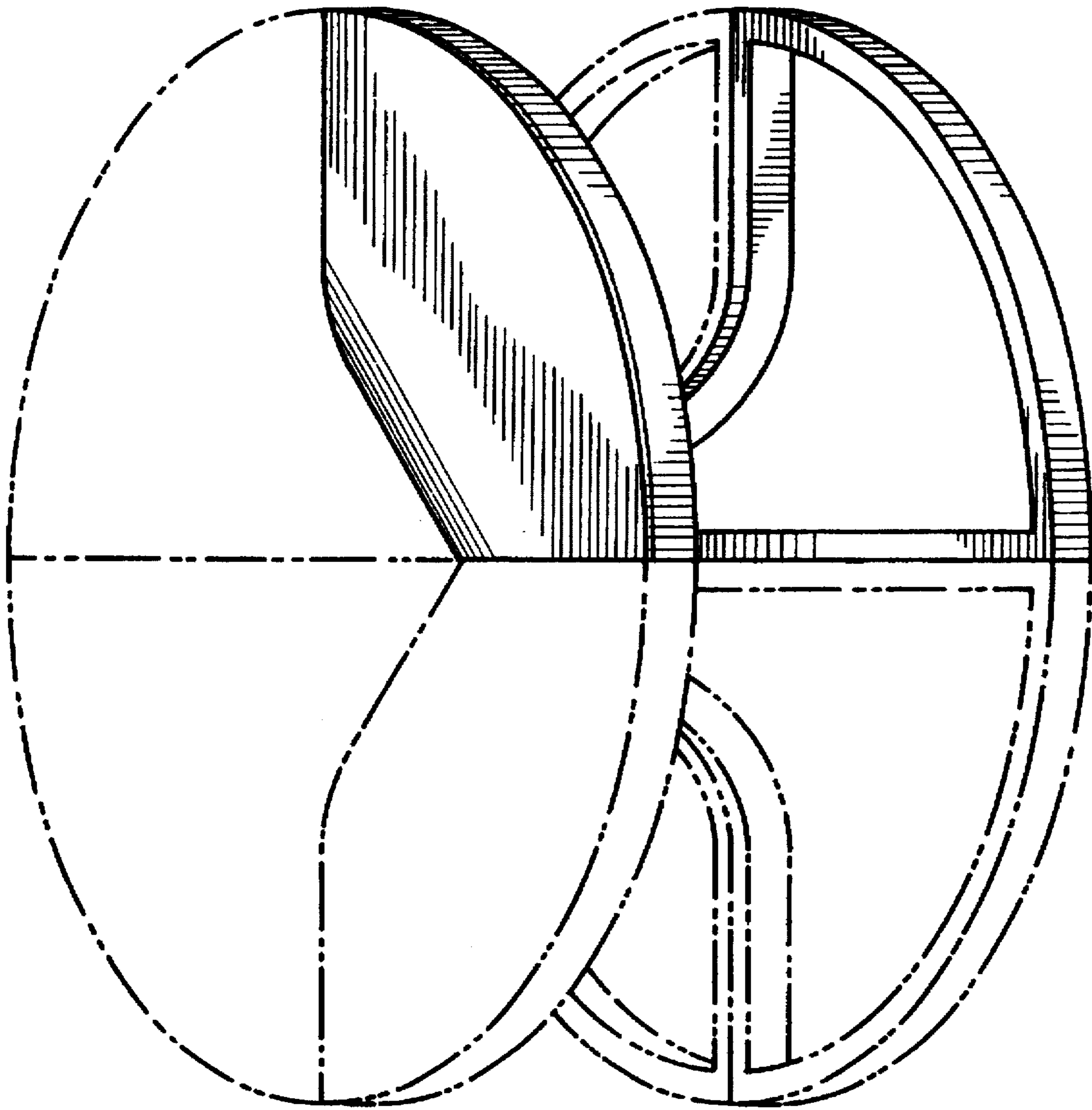
