FIG. 5 is an end elevational view of the other end of the pillow and memorabilia trays, for burial casket of FIG. 1;

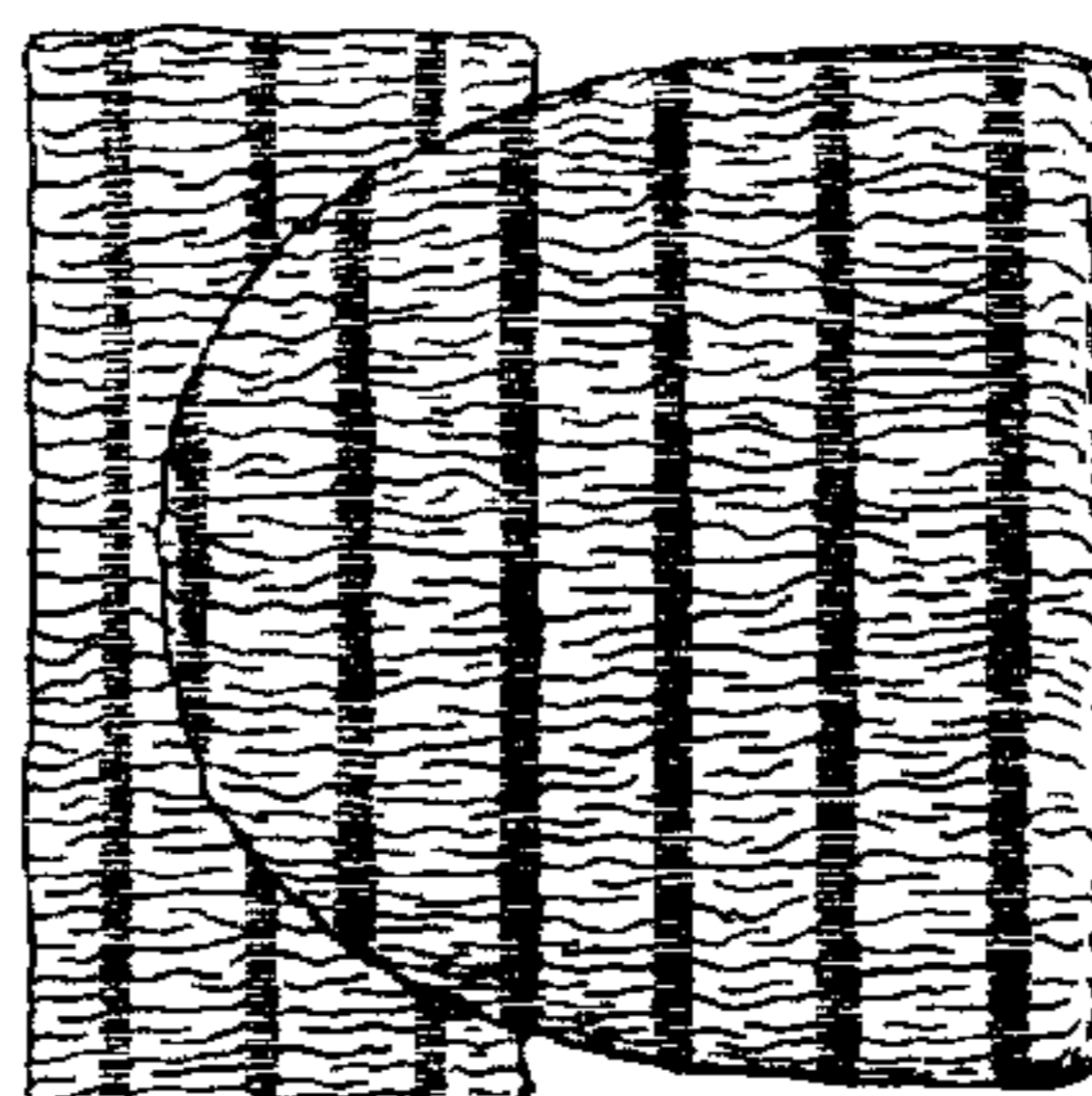
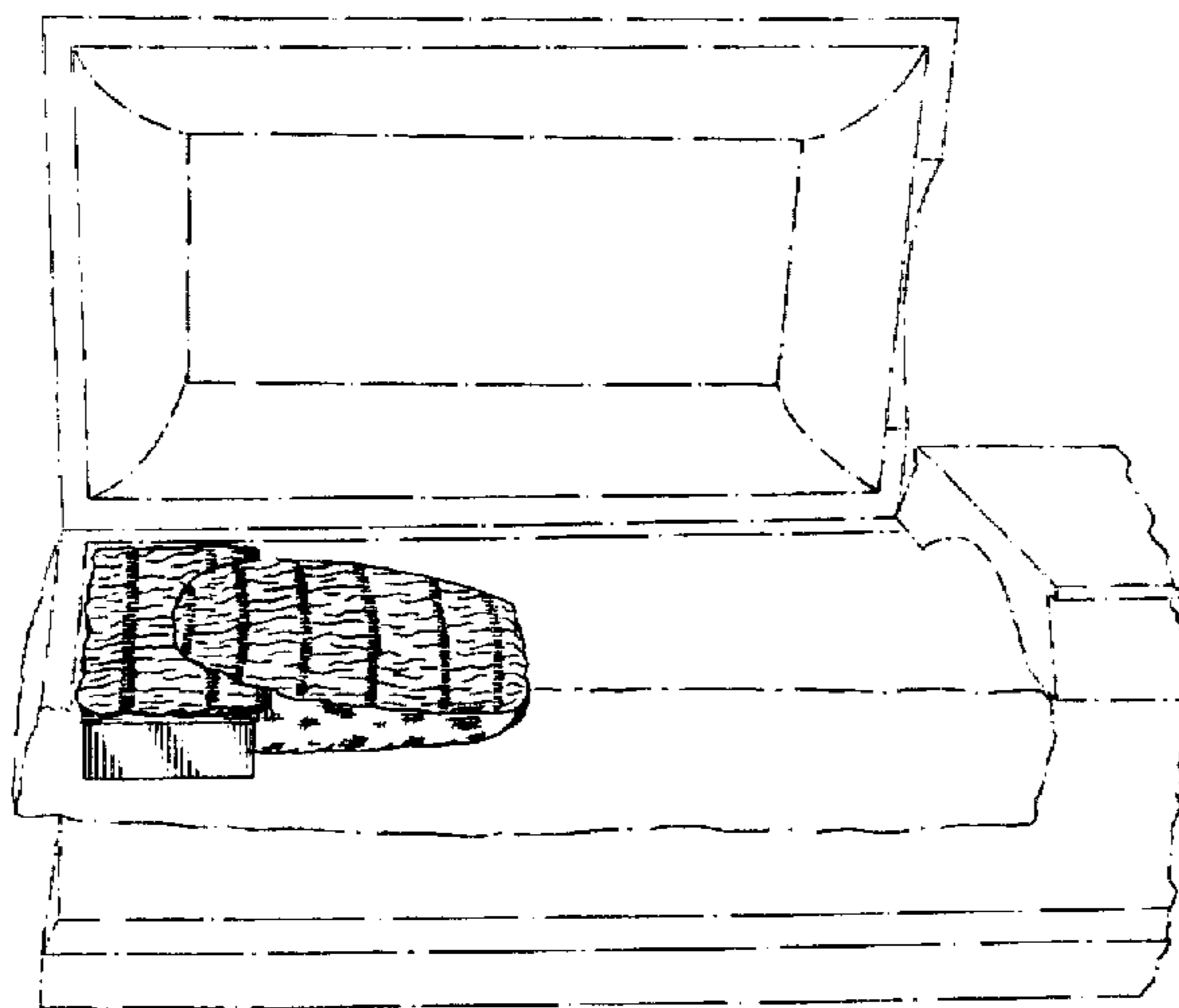
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the pillow and memorabilia trays for burial casket of FIG. 1;

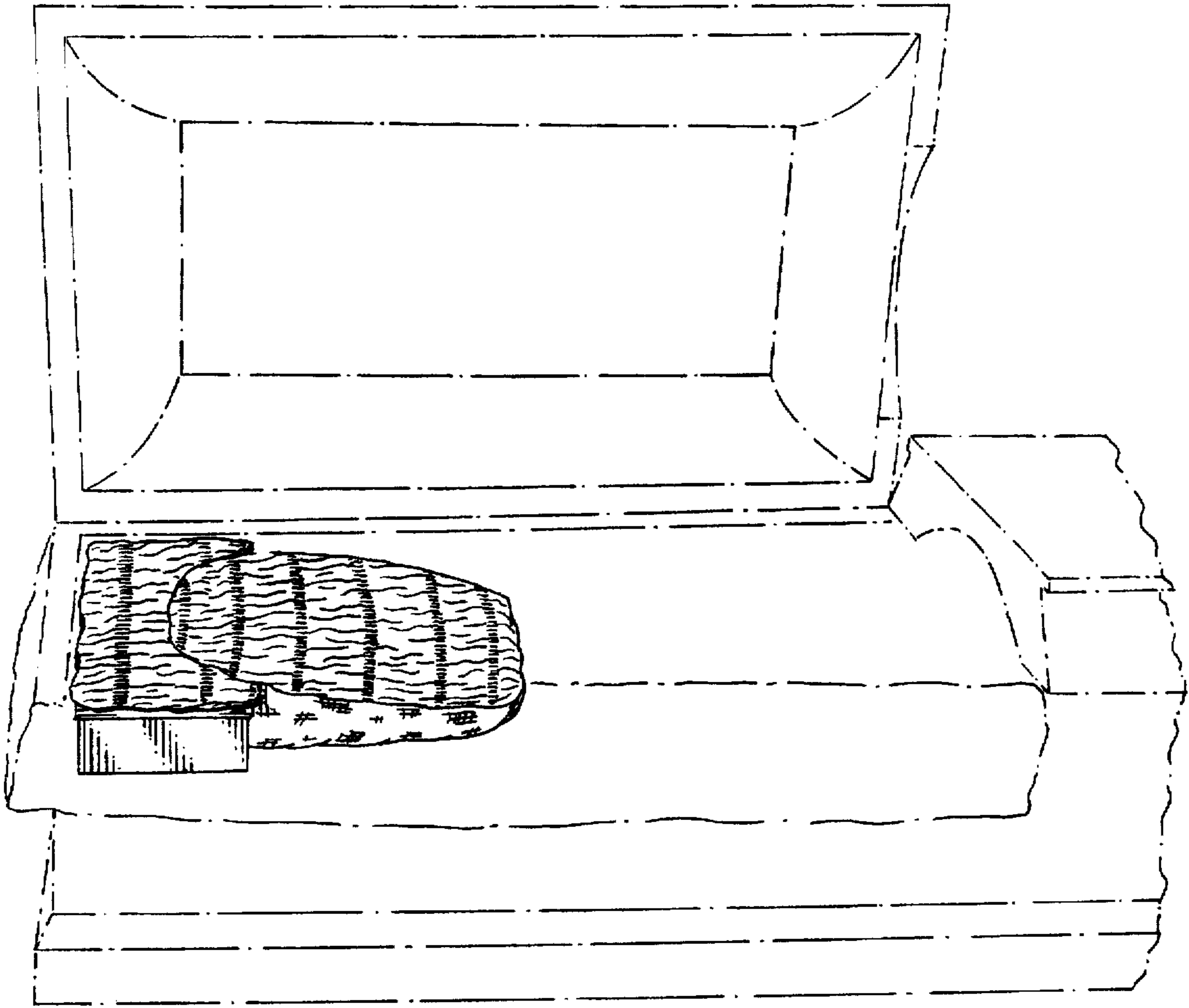

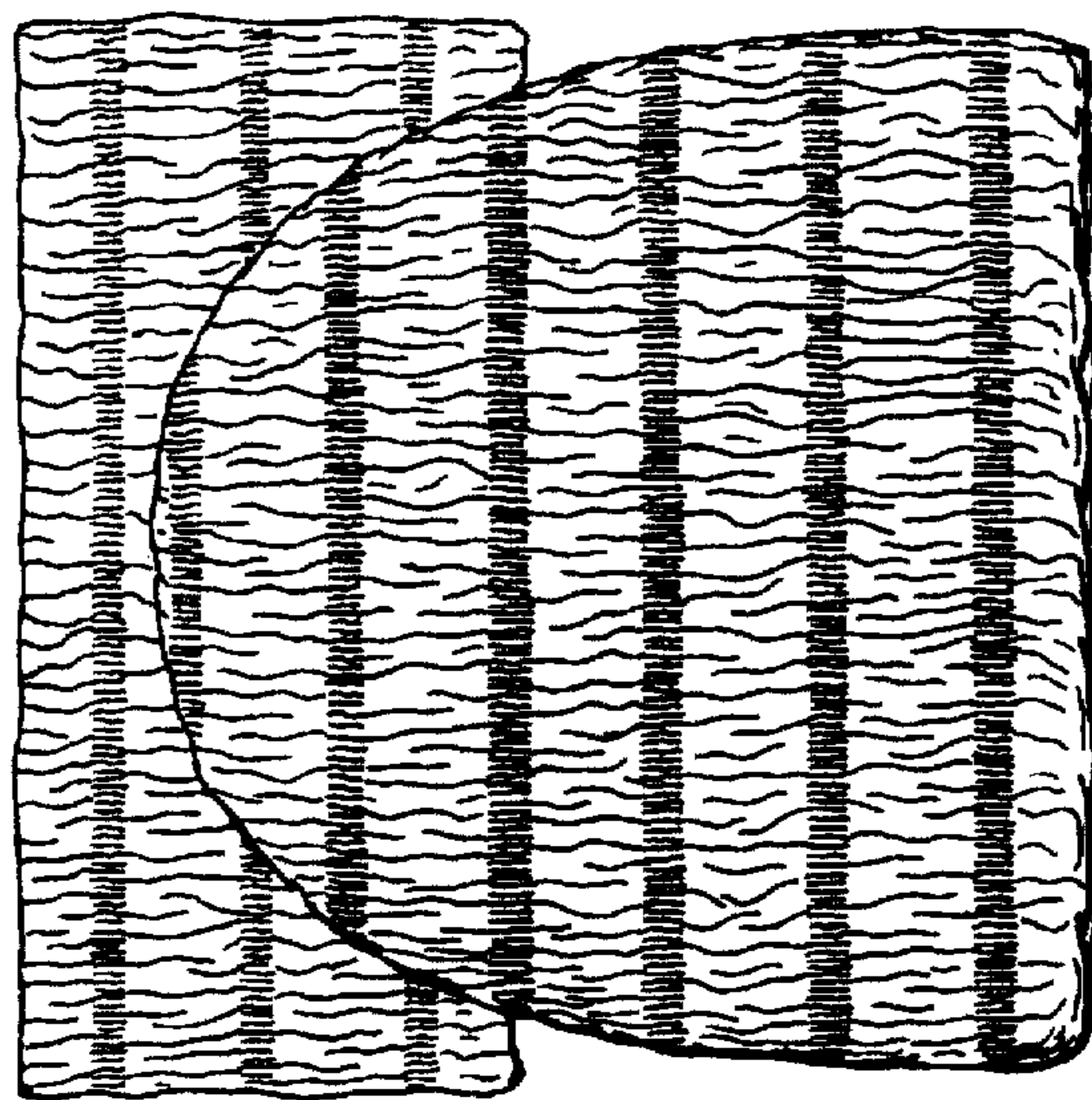

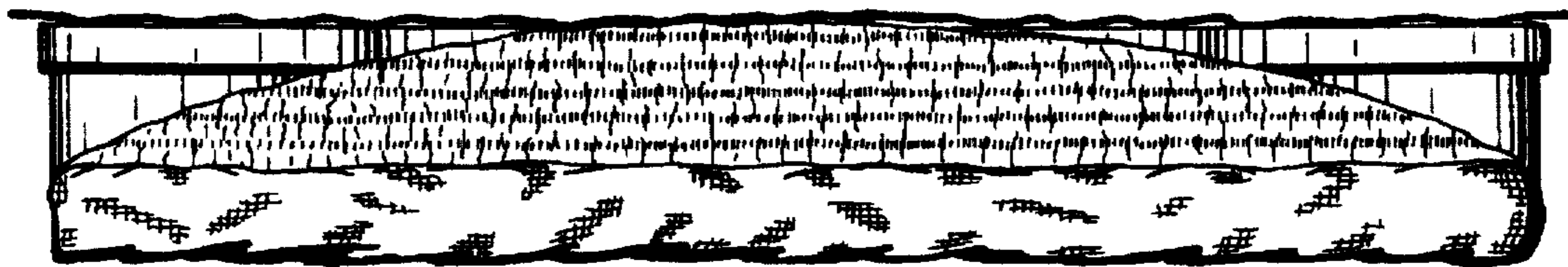

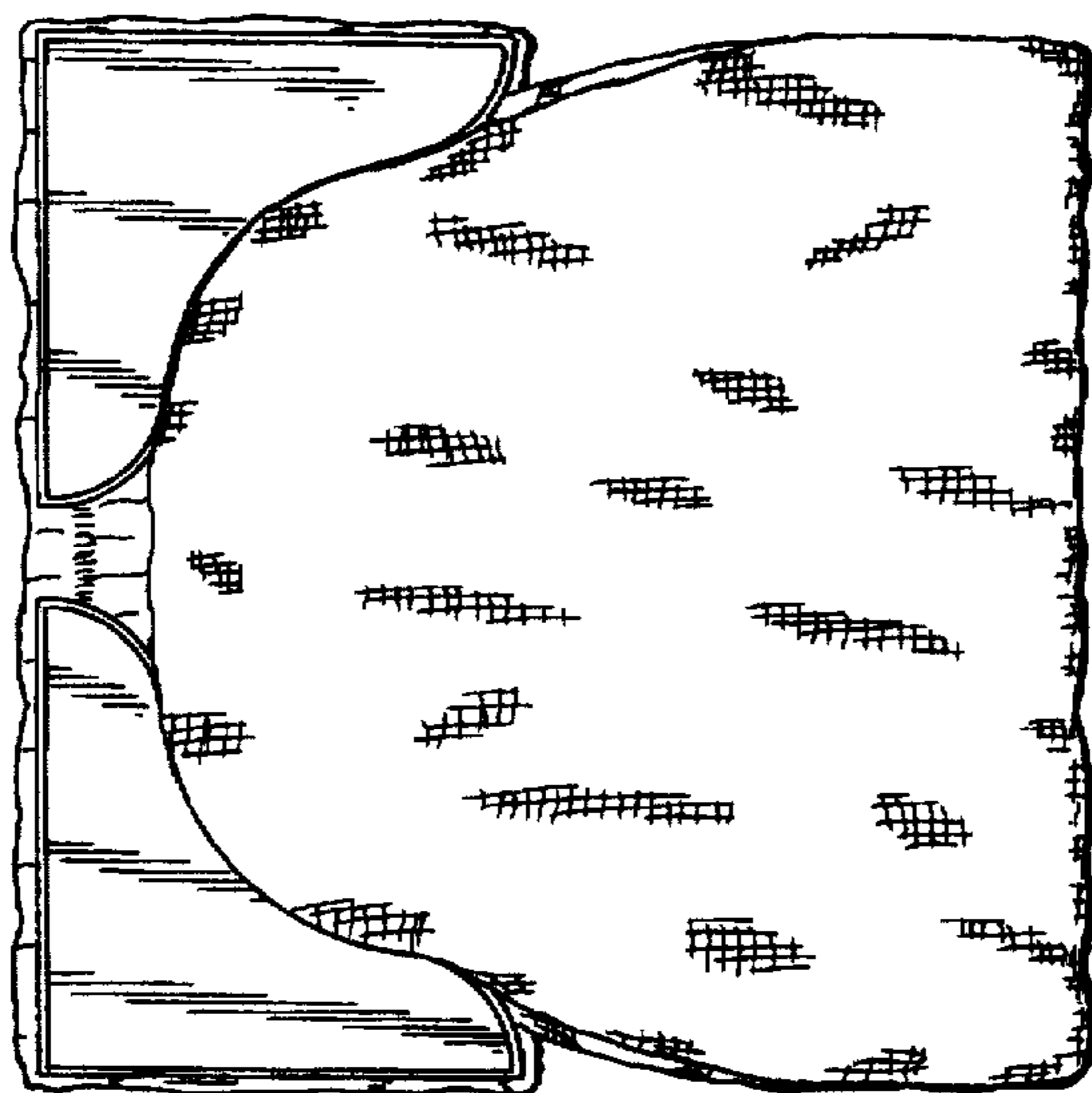

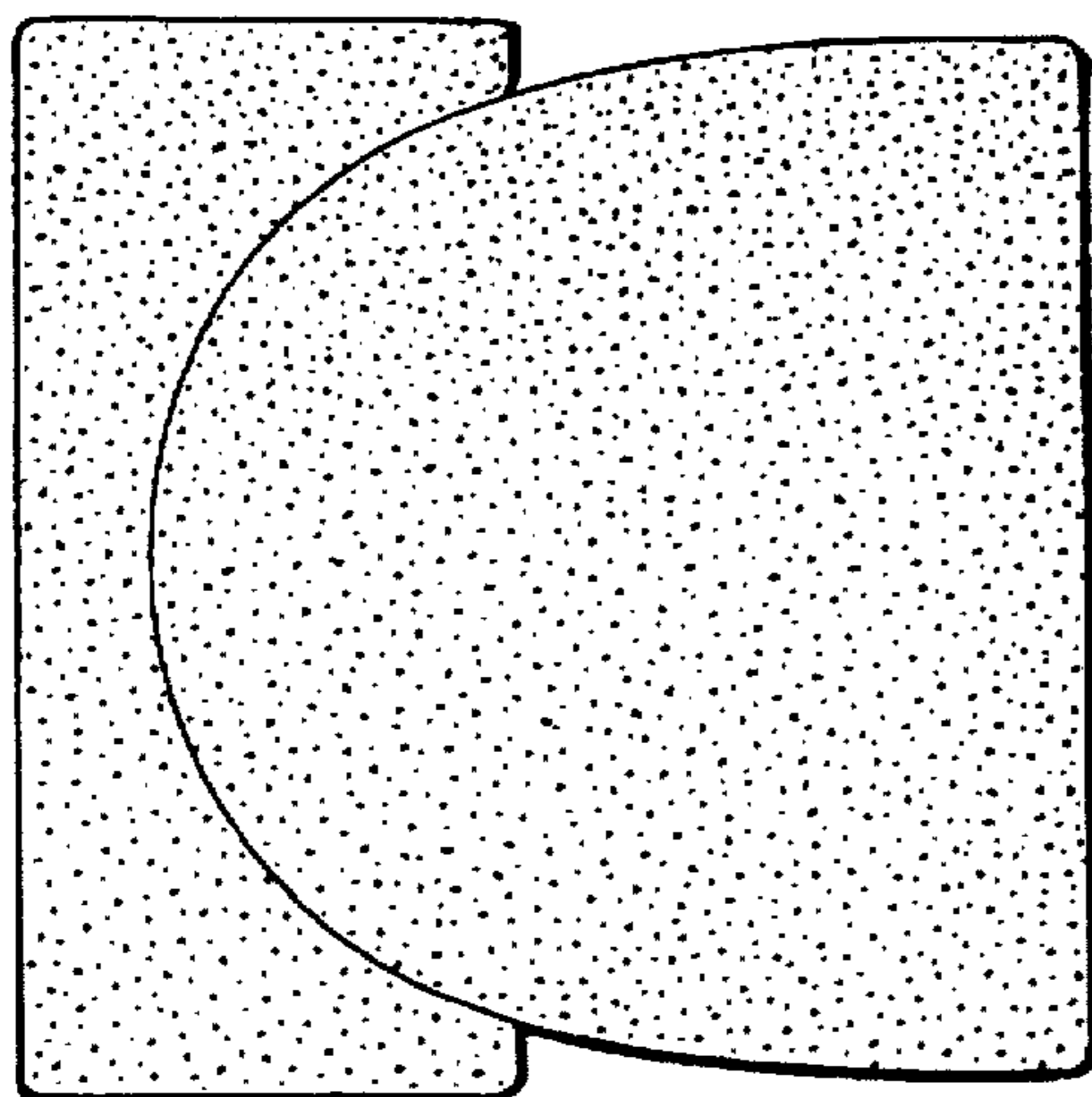
