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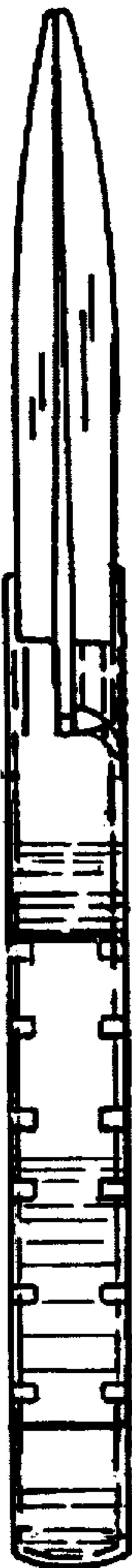

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cutting shears that are a present invention, looking at the front end, top and right sides;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the right side;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is a front end elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view; and,
FIG. 7 is an elevational view of the left side.

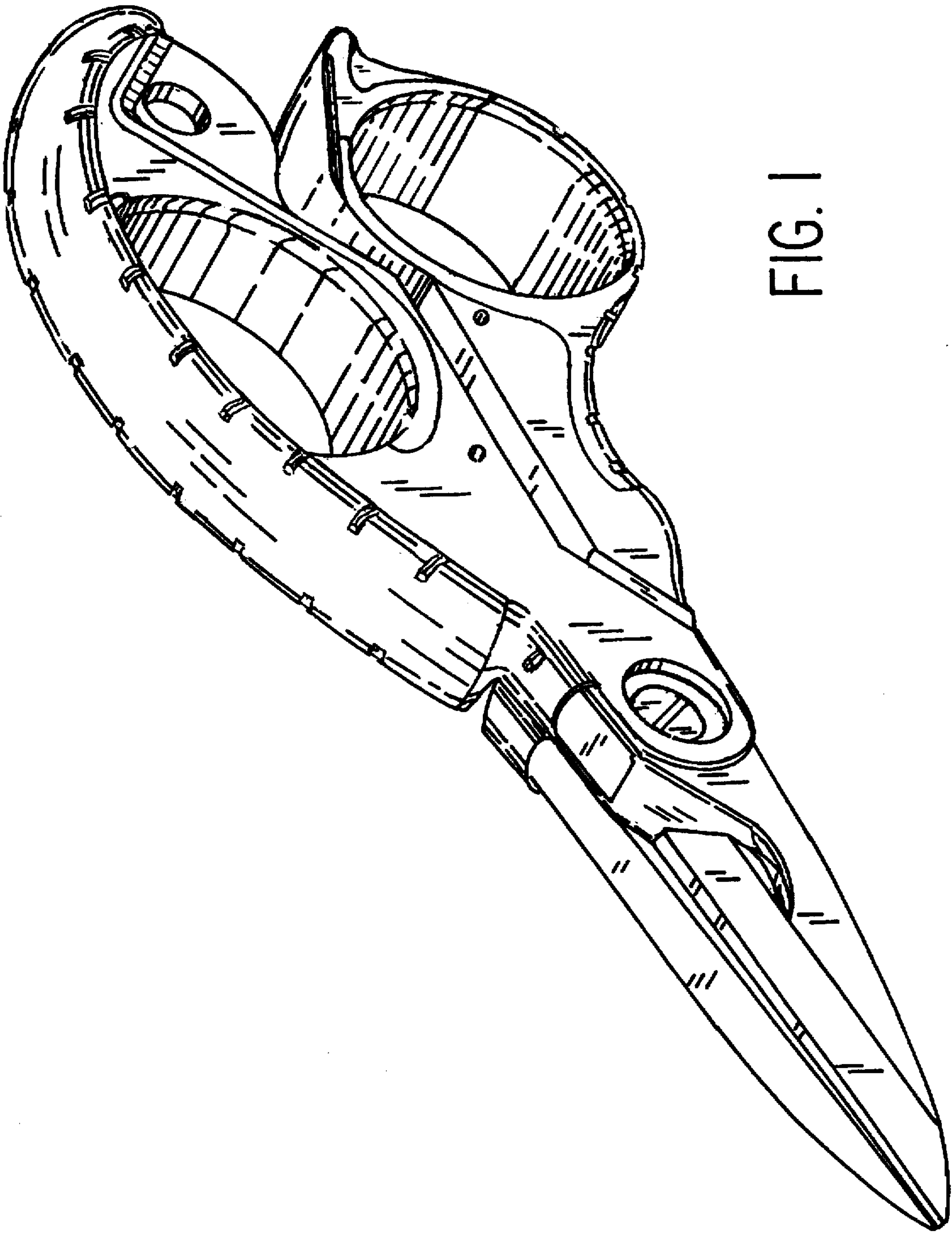

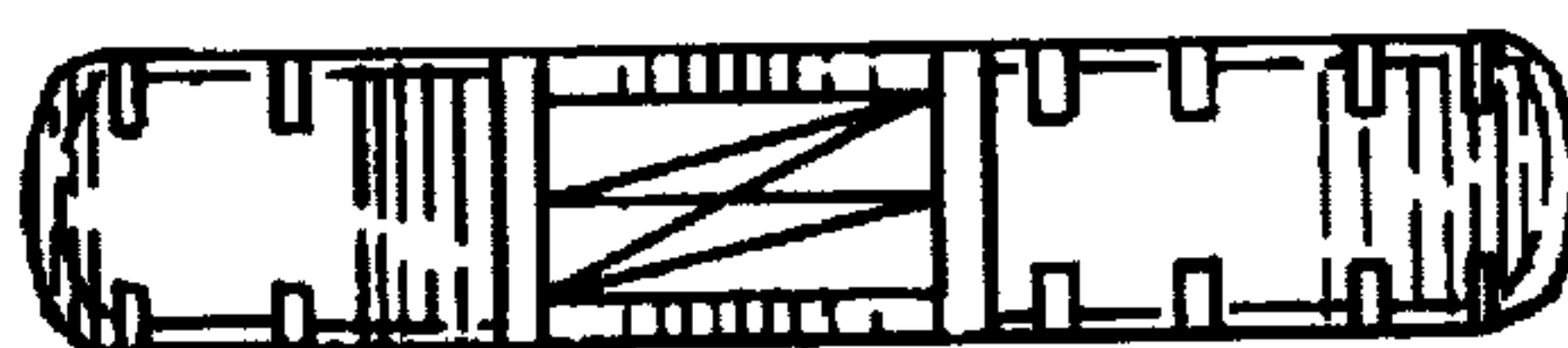

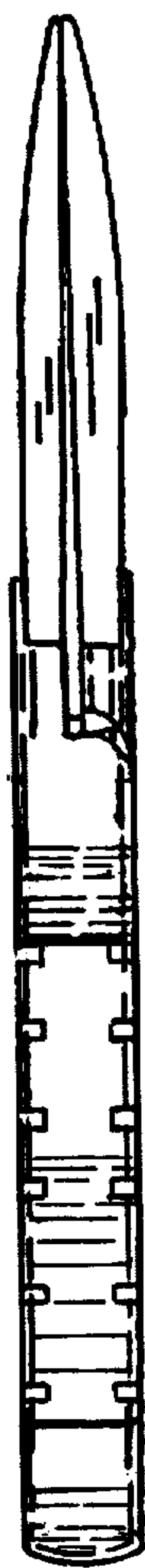

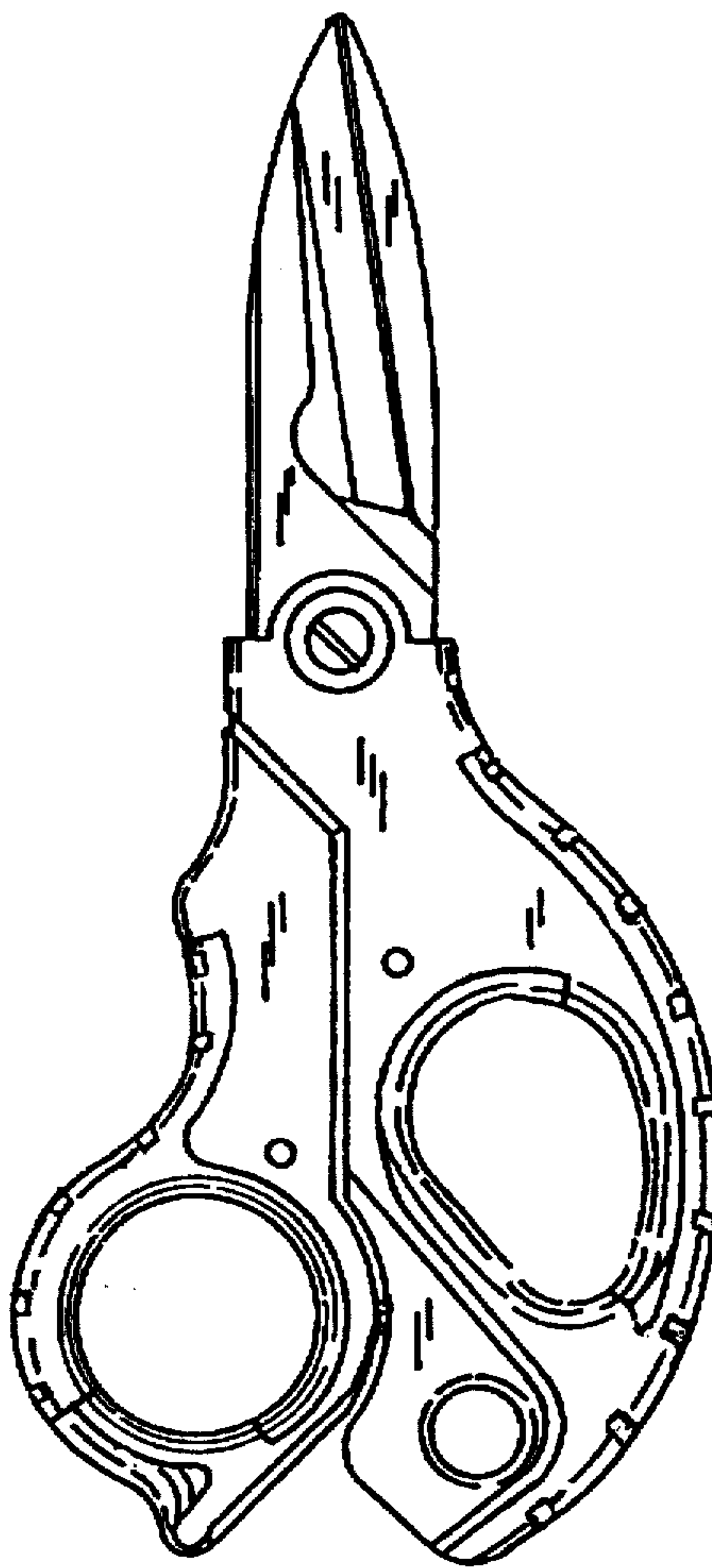

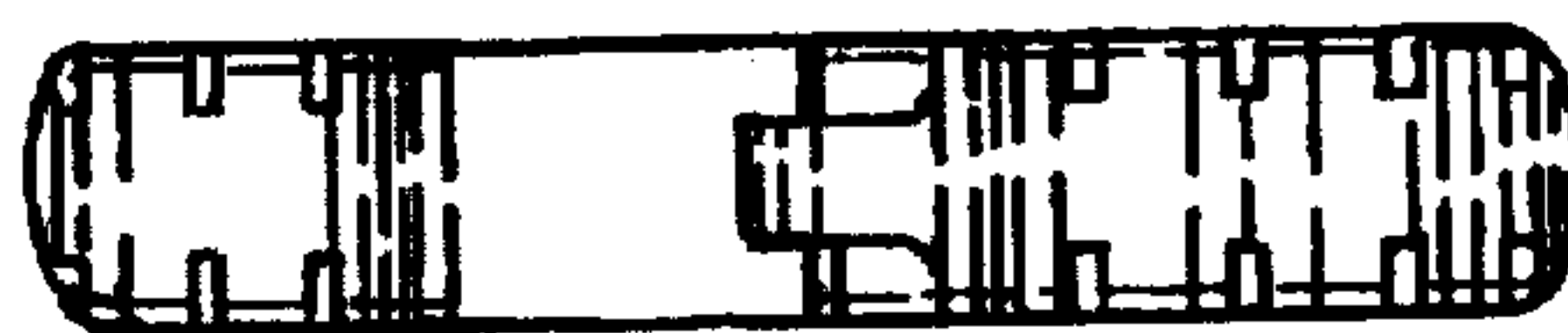

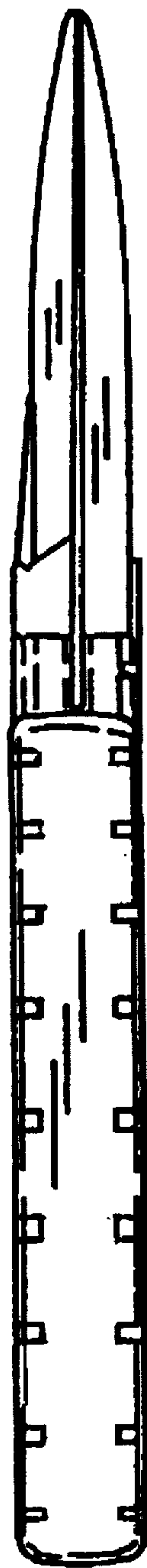

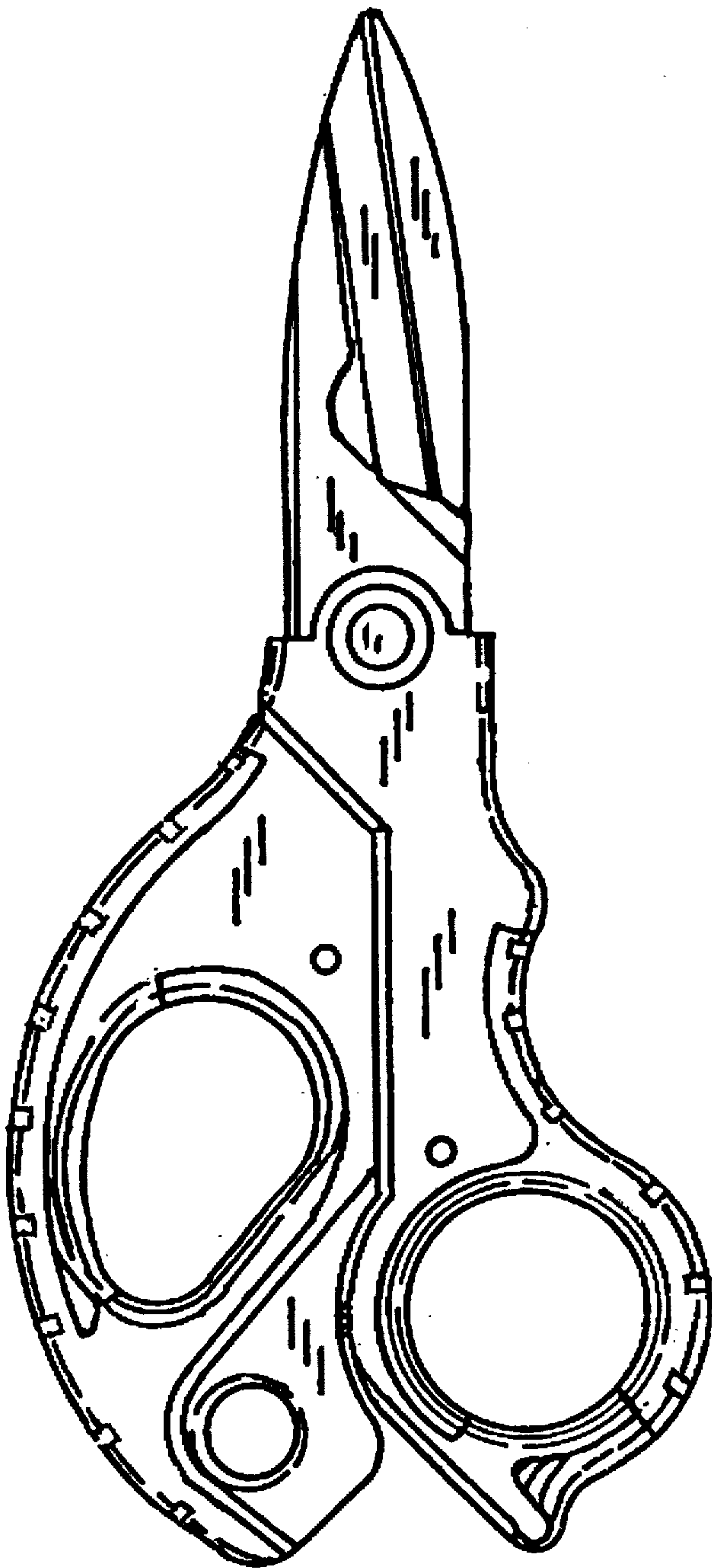
