DESCRIPTION

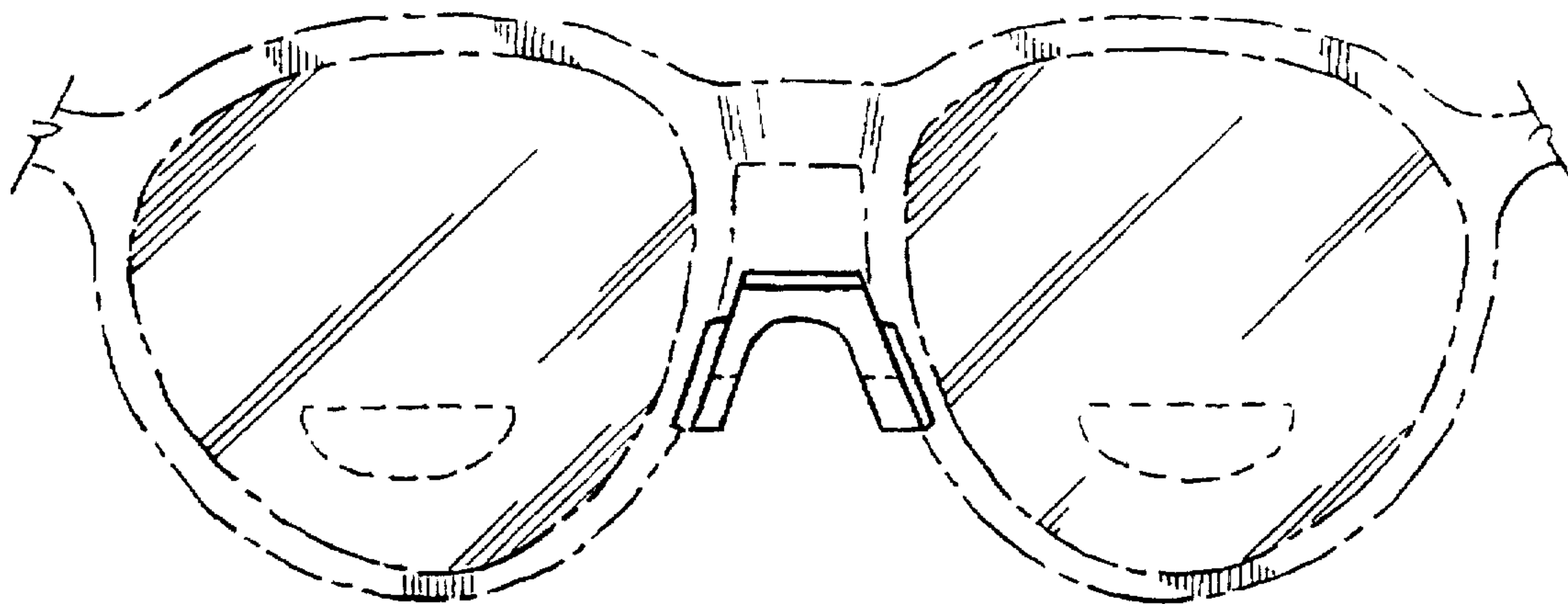
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an auxiliary nose piece for eyeglasses, showing my new design;

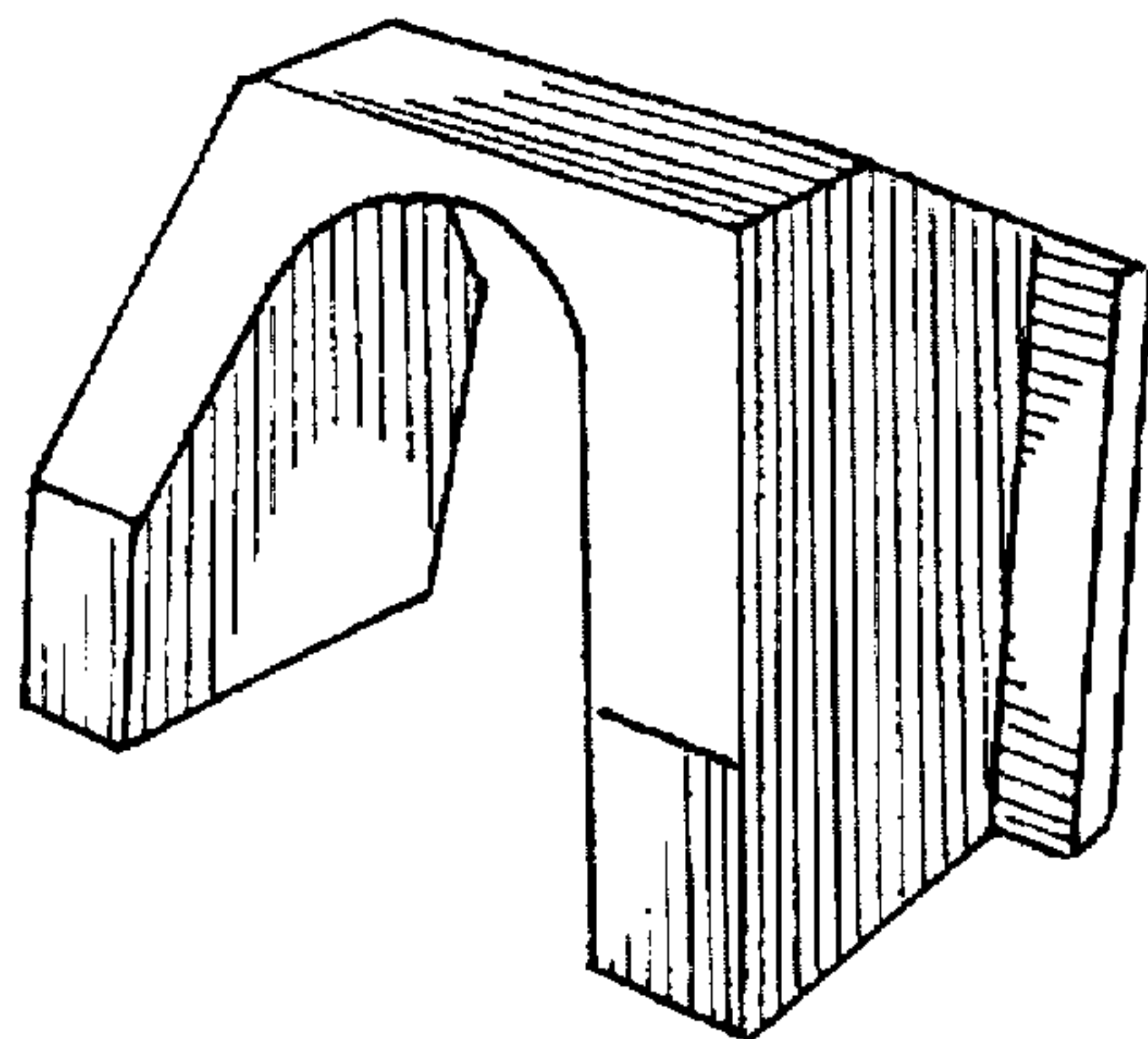

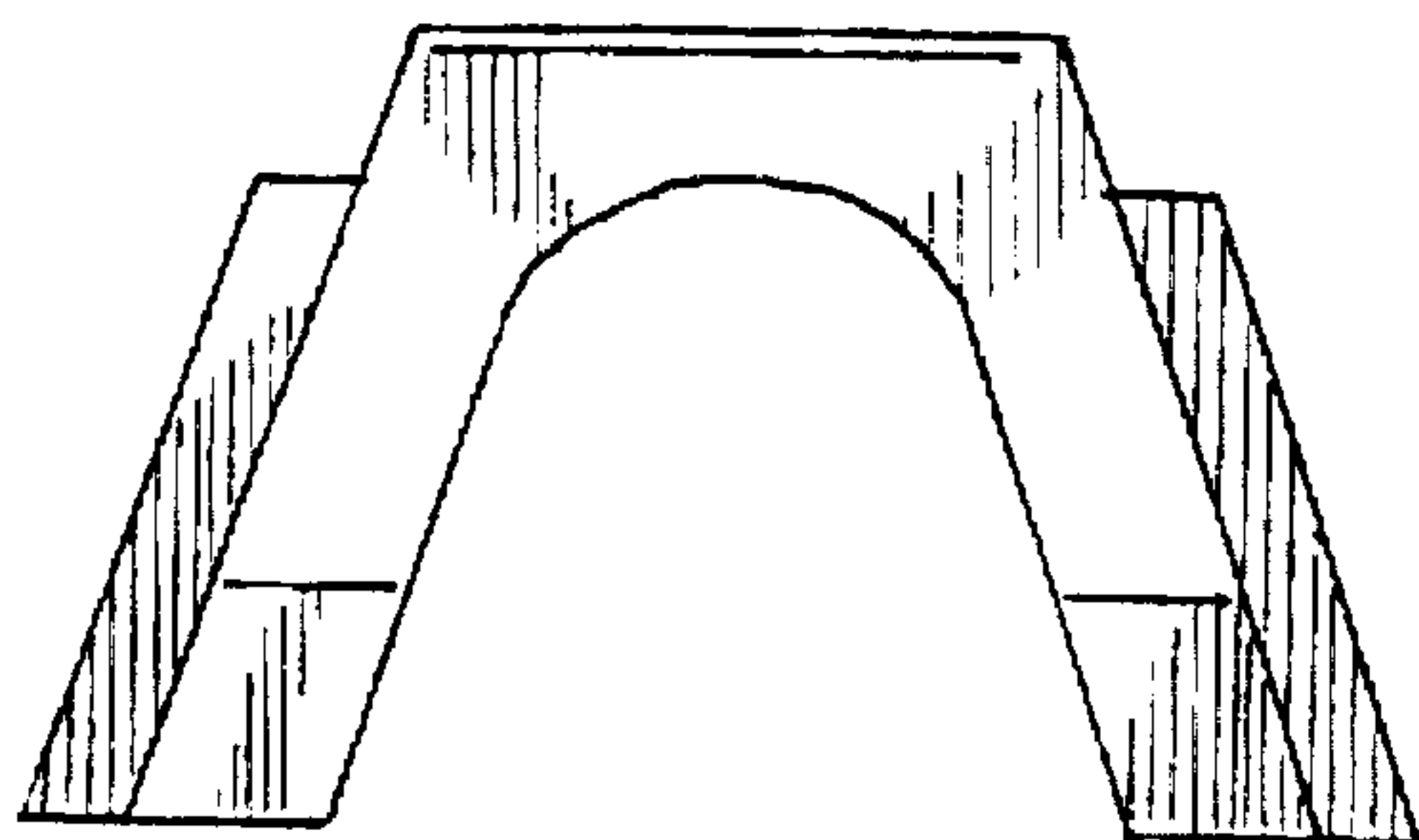

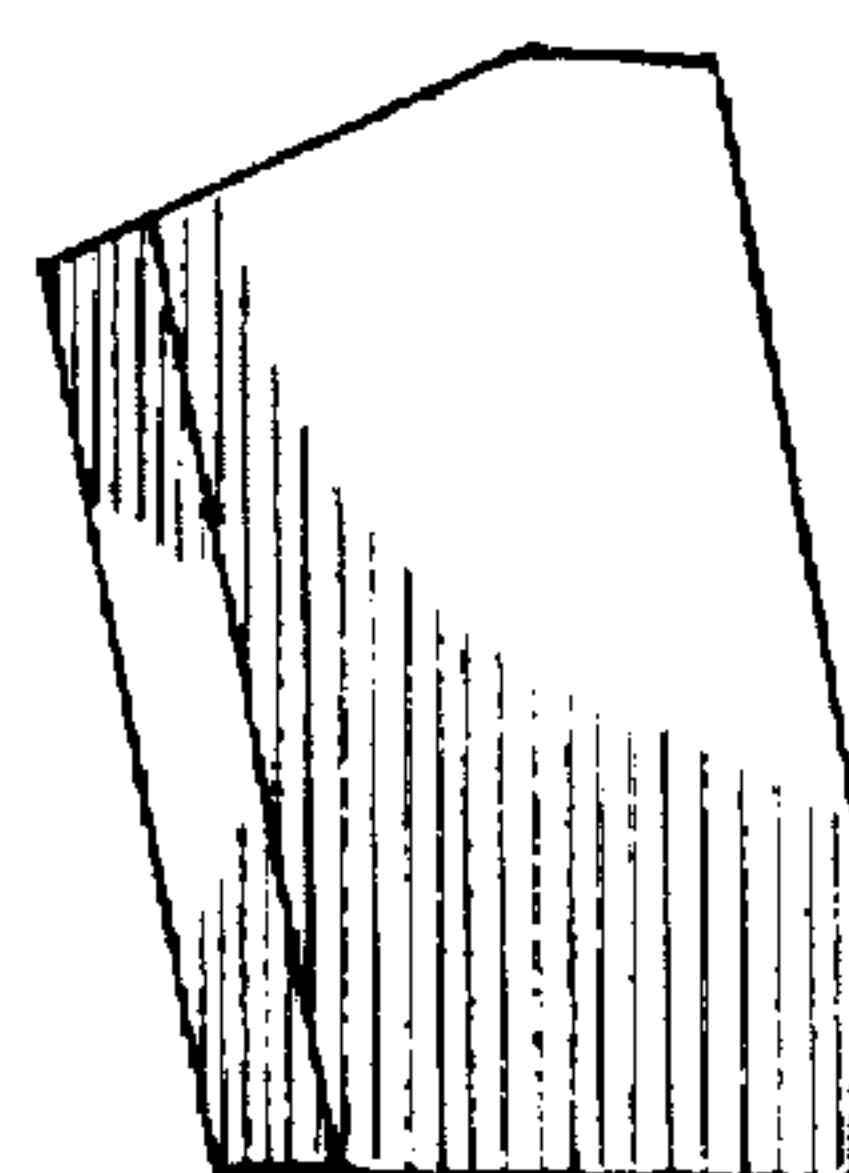

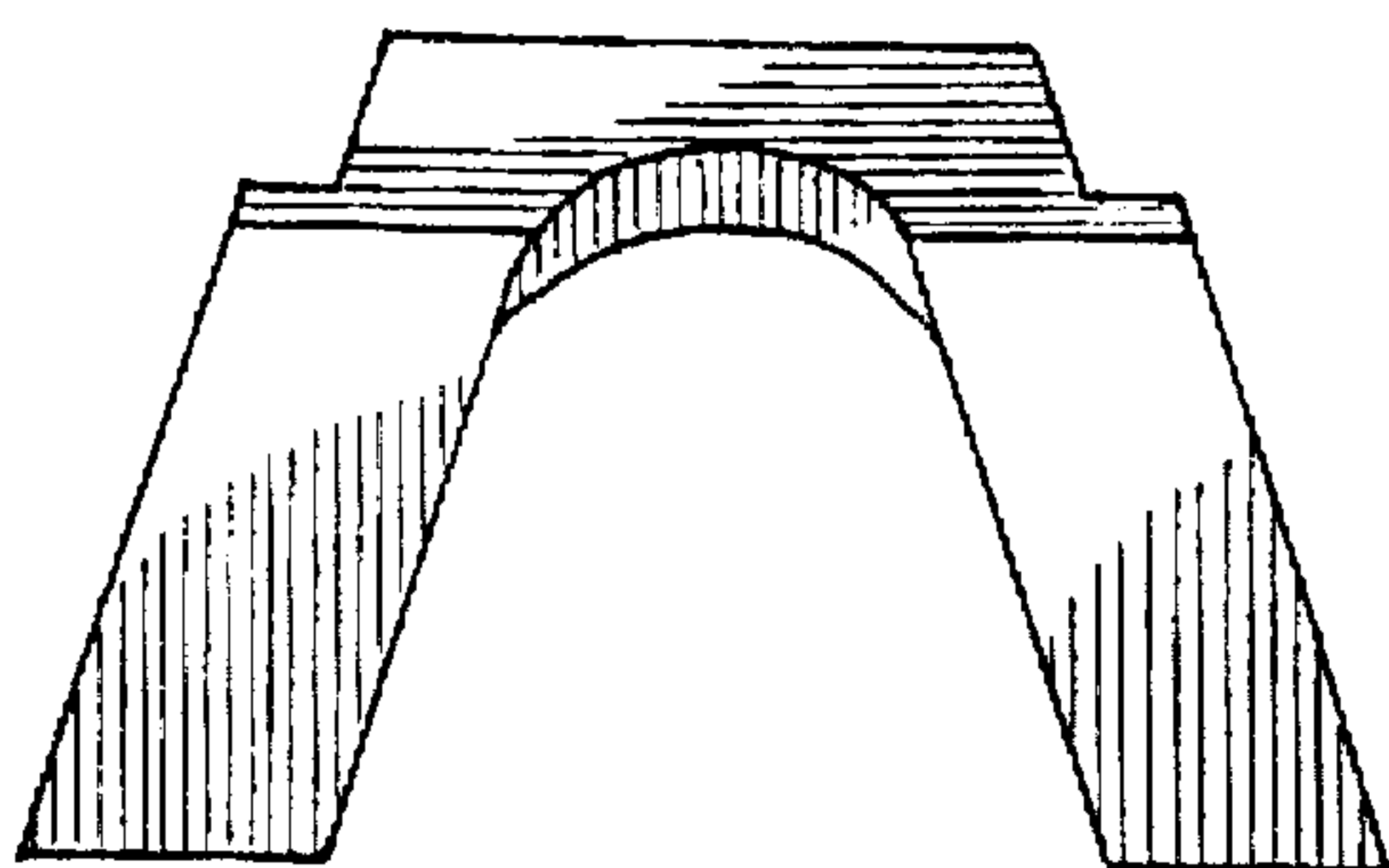

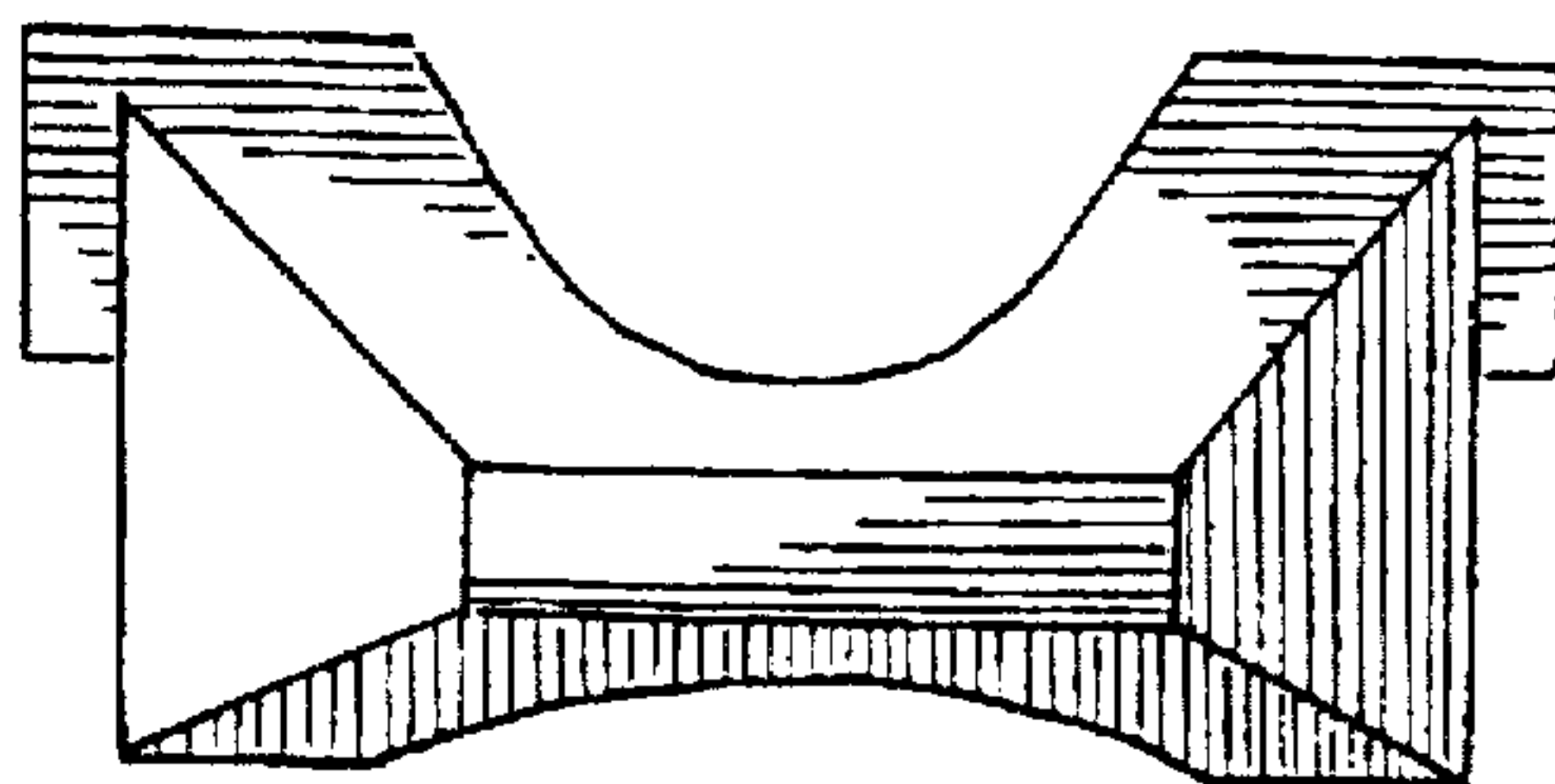

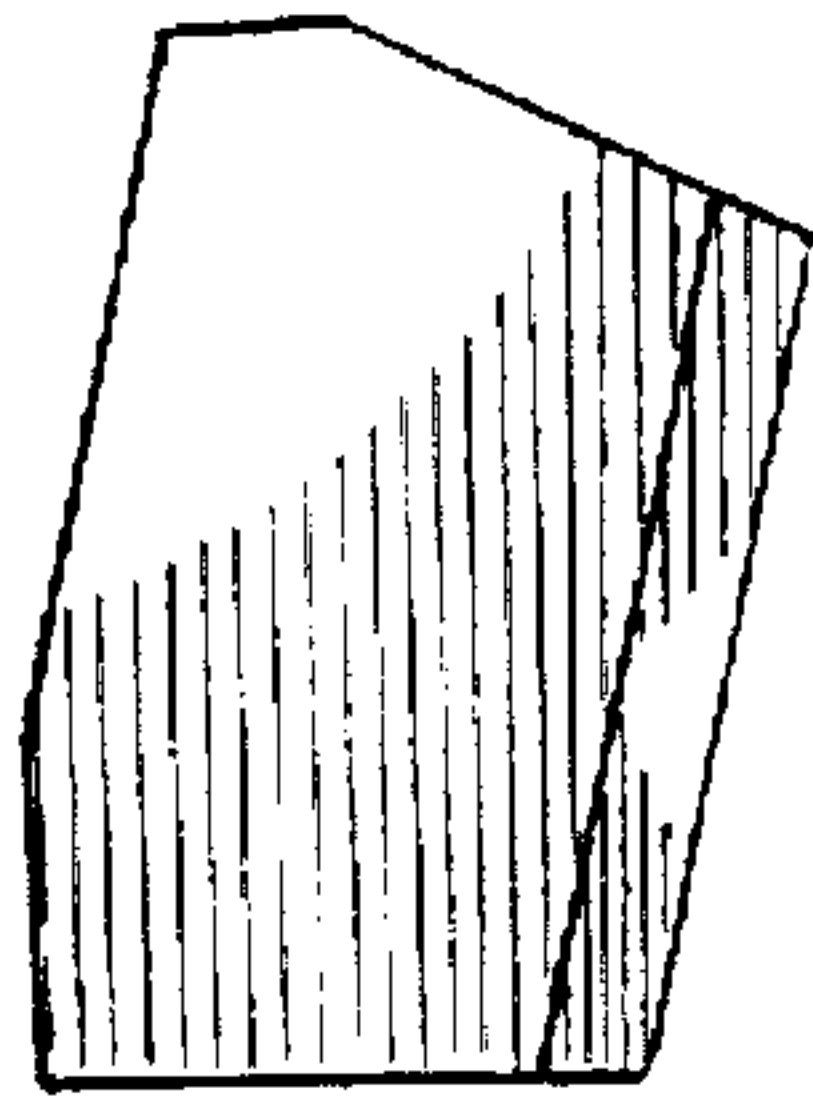

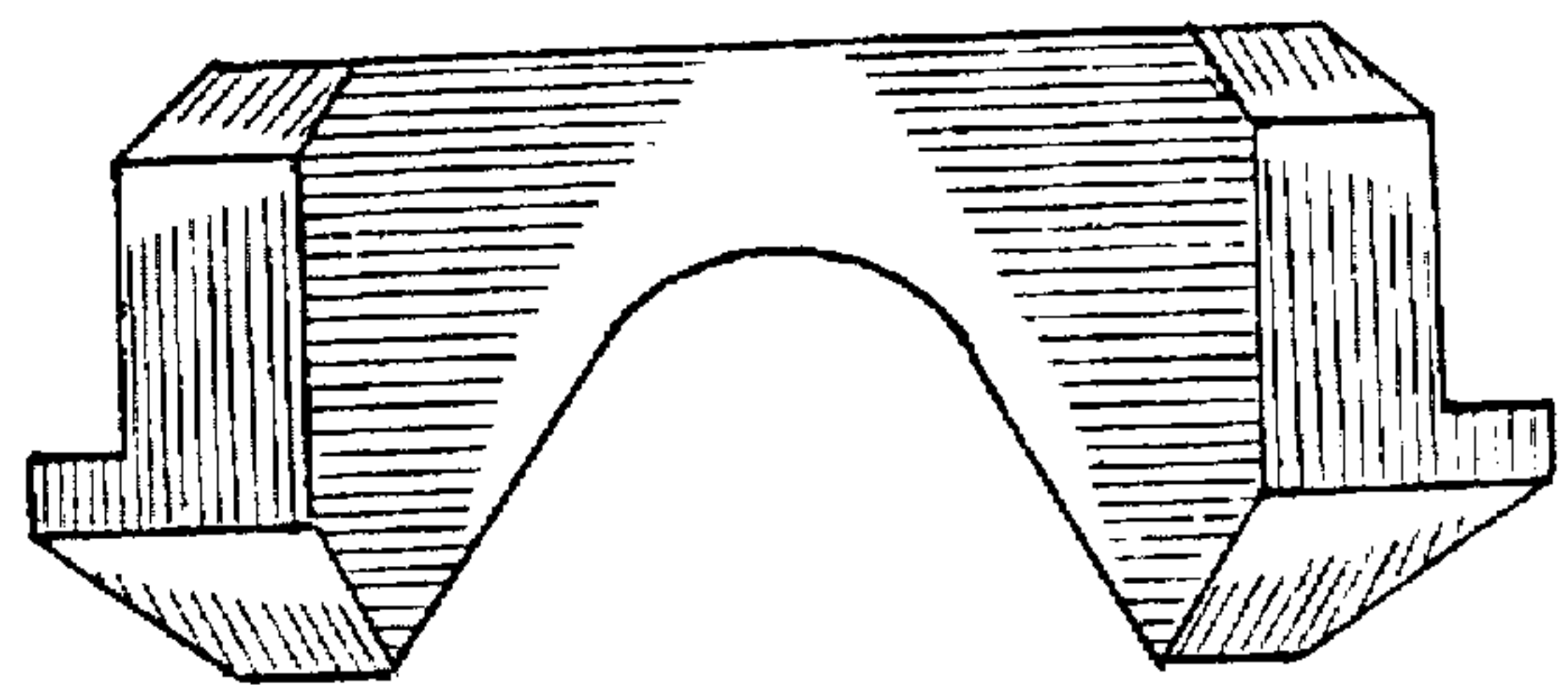

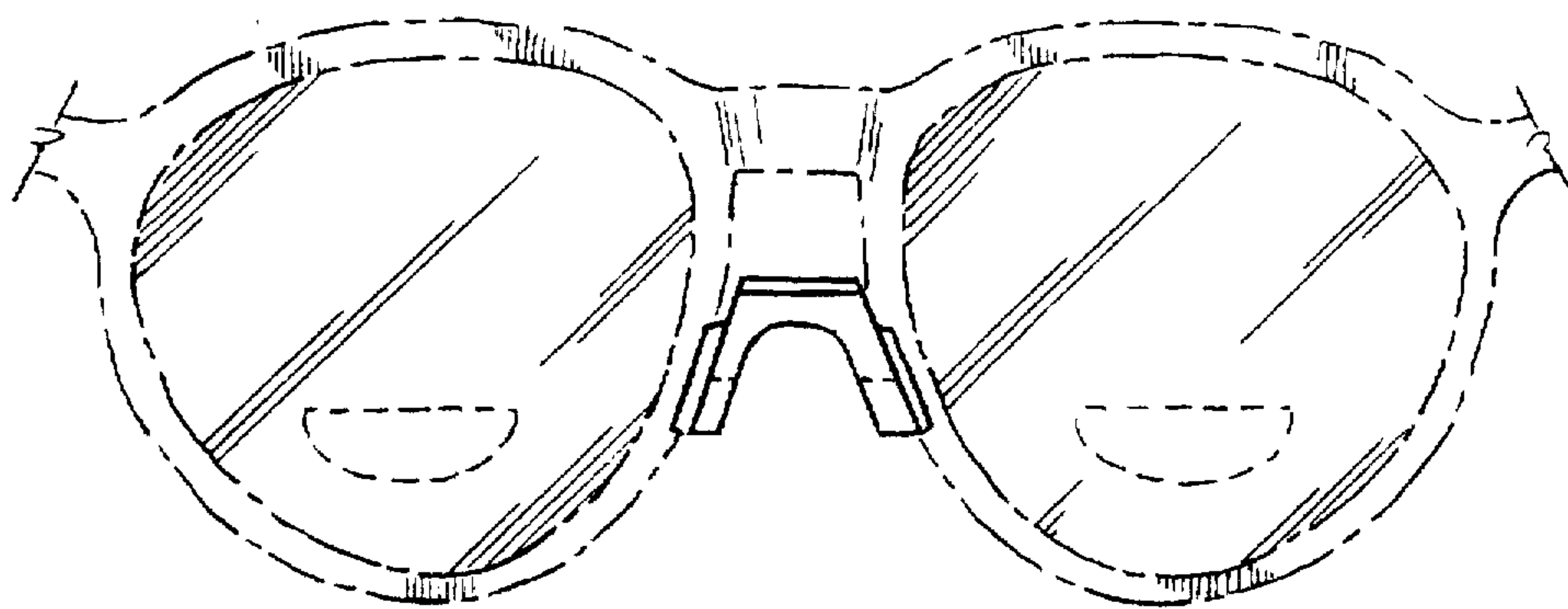
