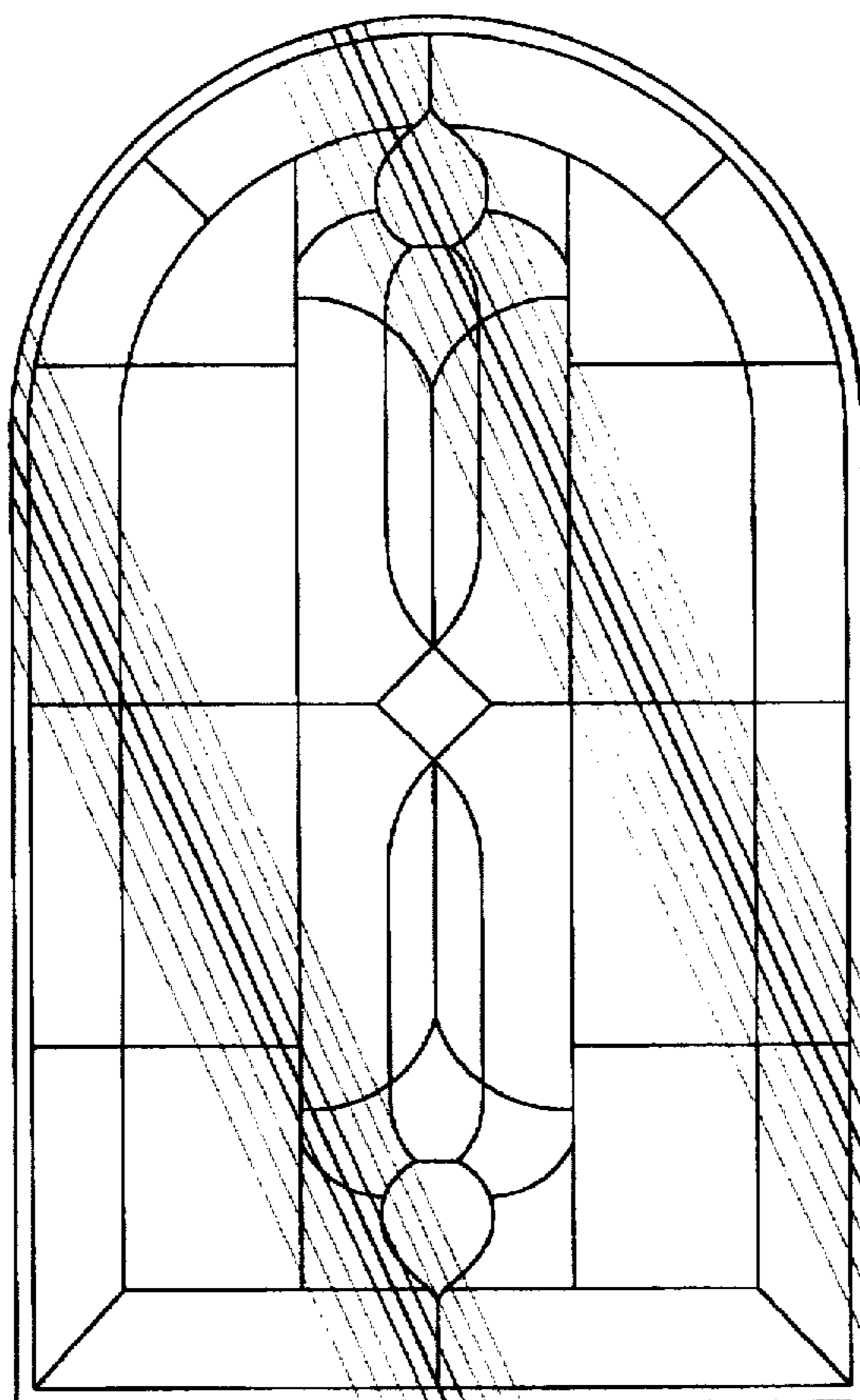
[57] CLAIM

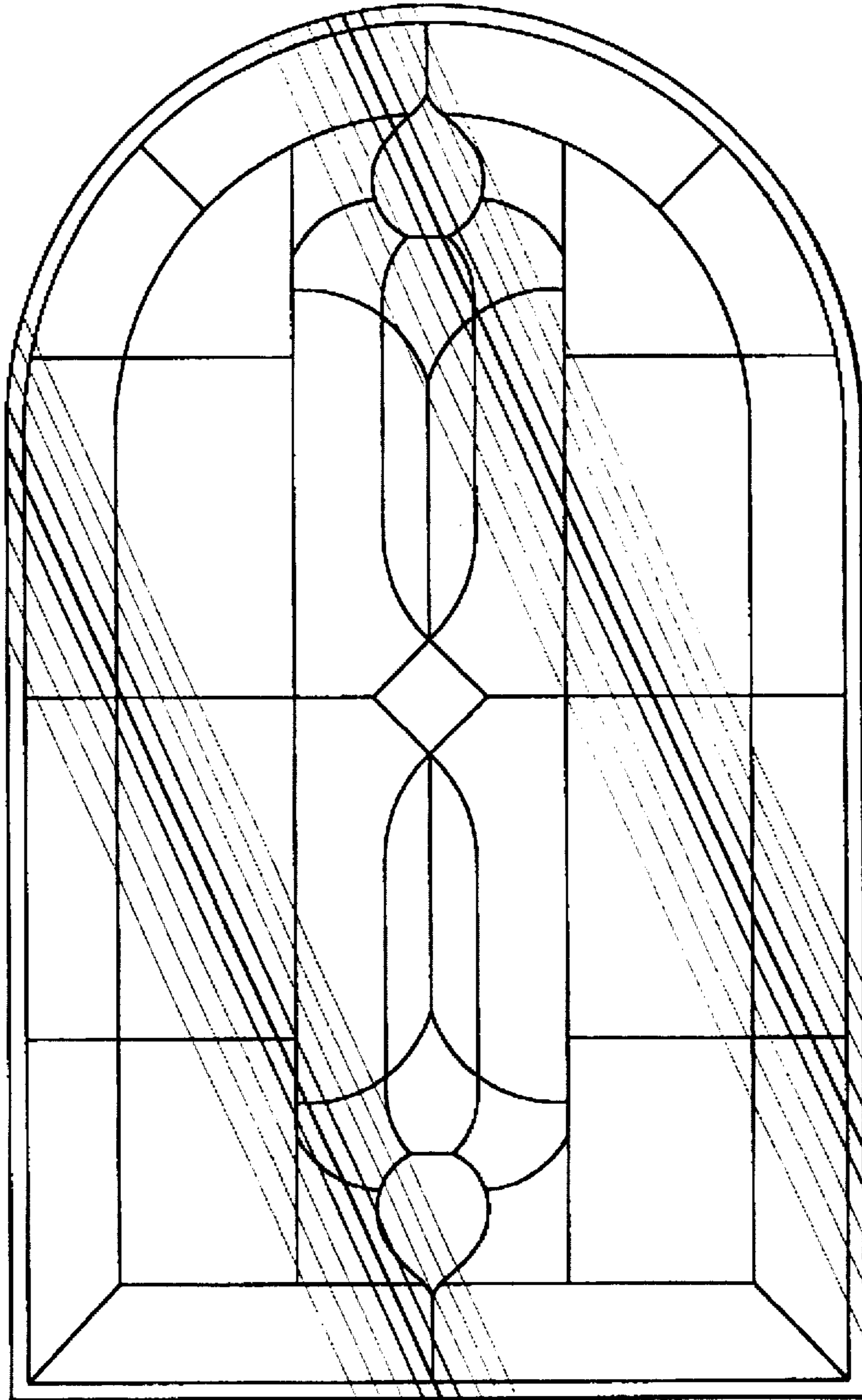
