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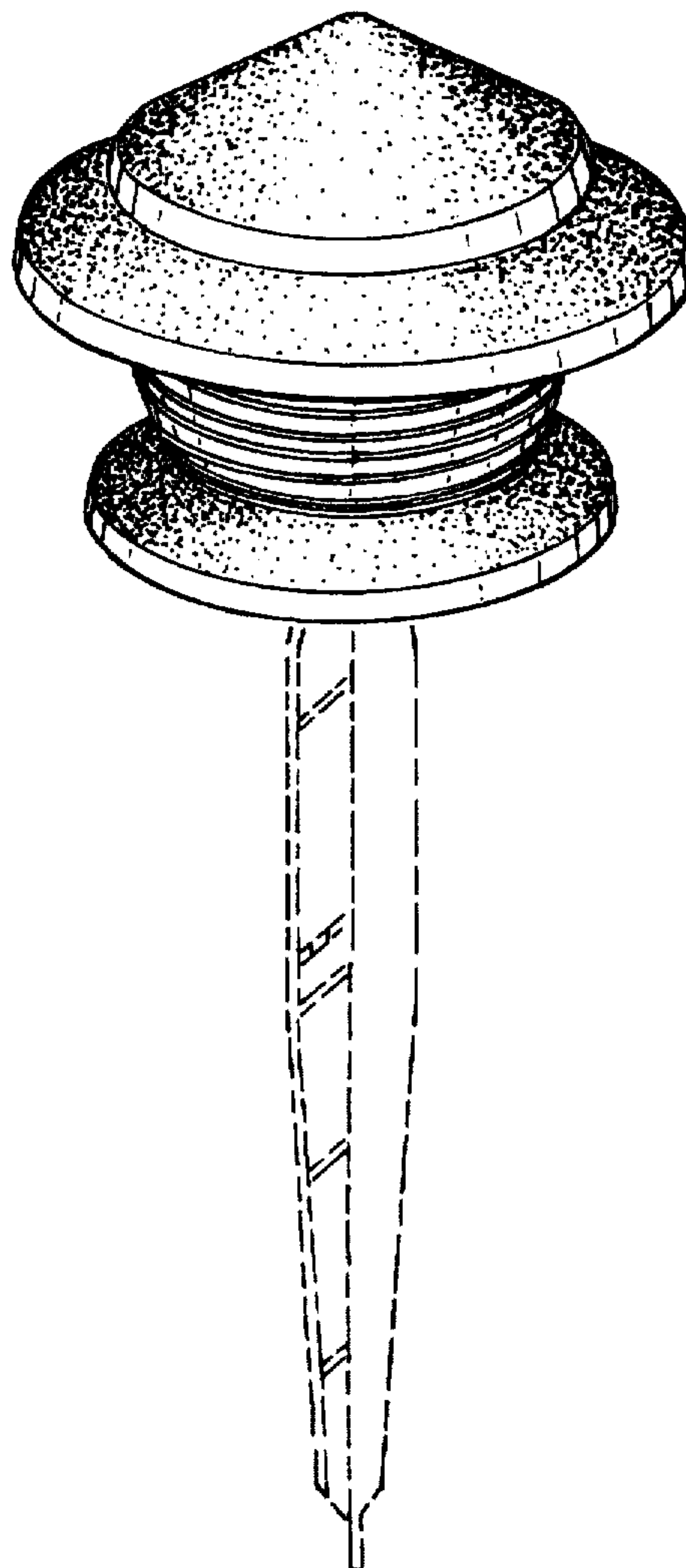
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an outdoor light fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an outdoor light fixture showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, all sides being identical;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

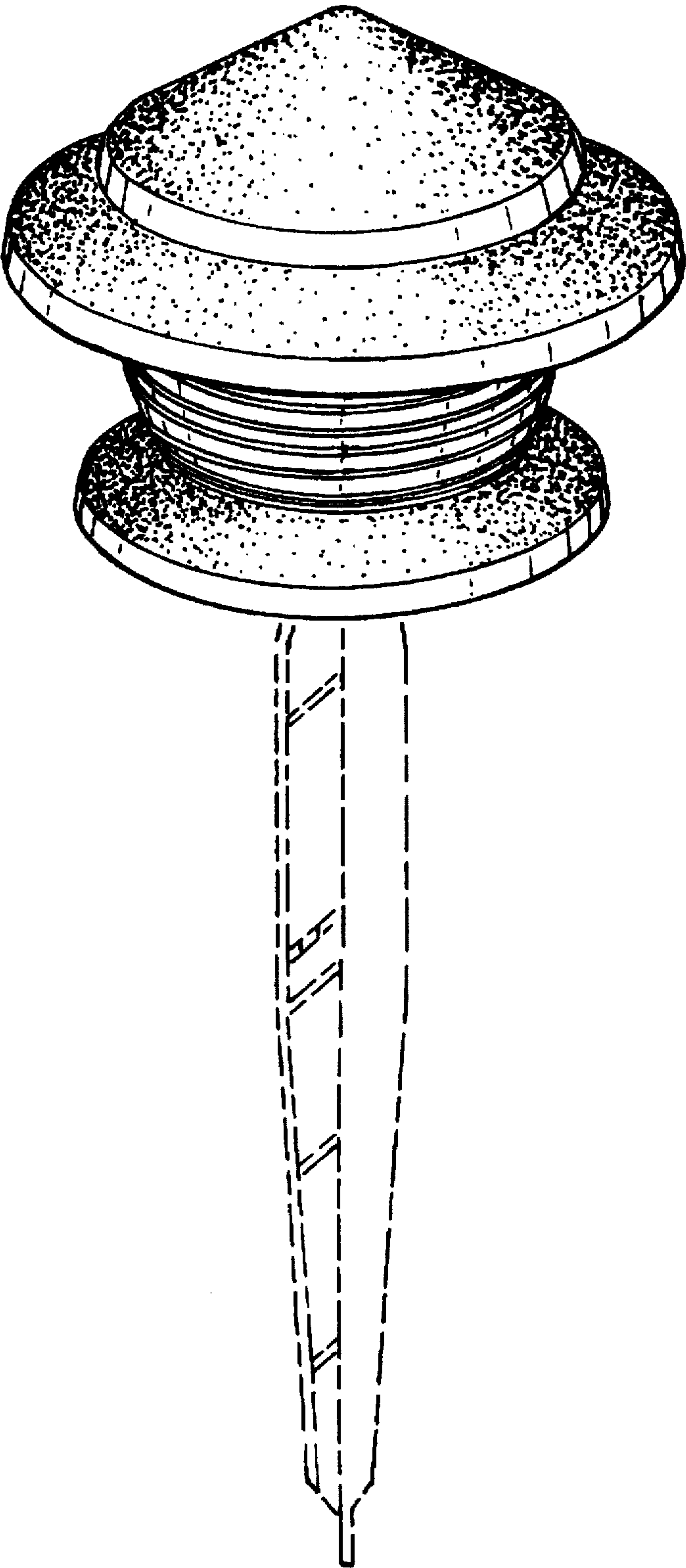

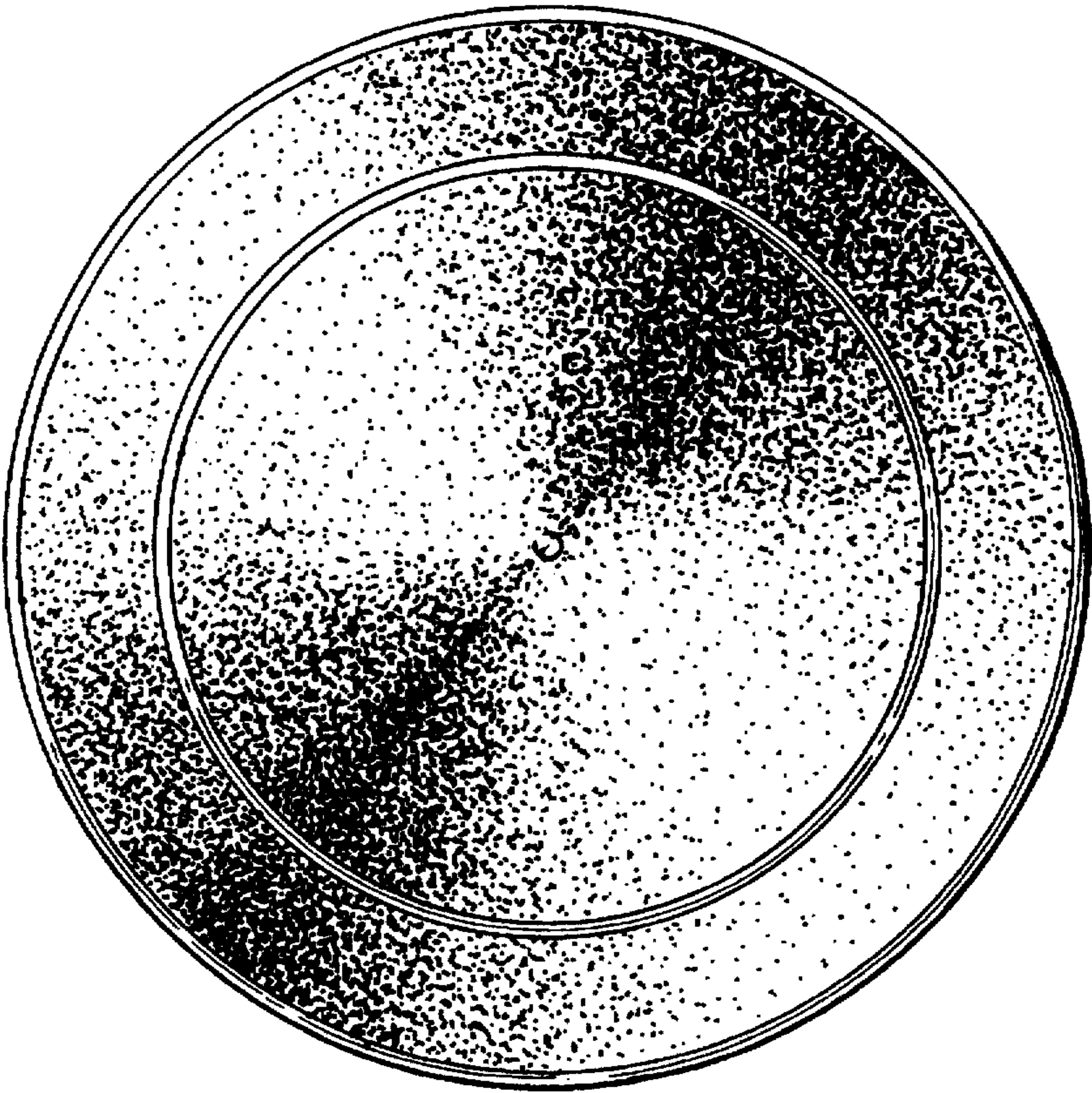

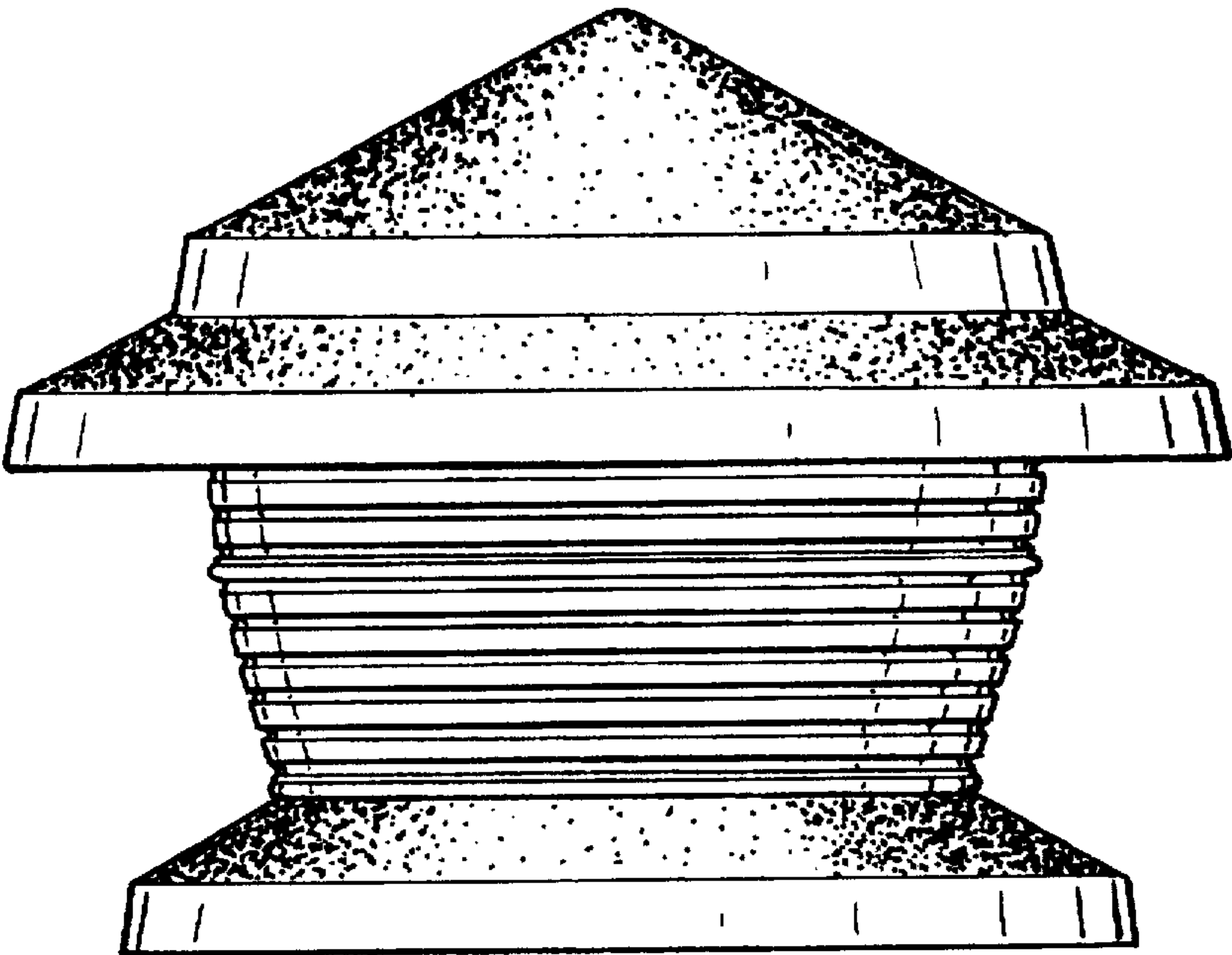

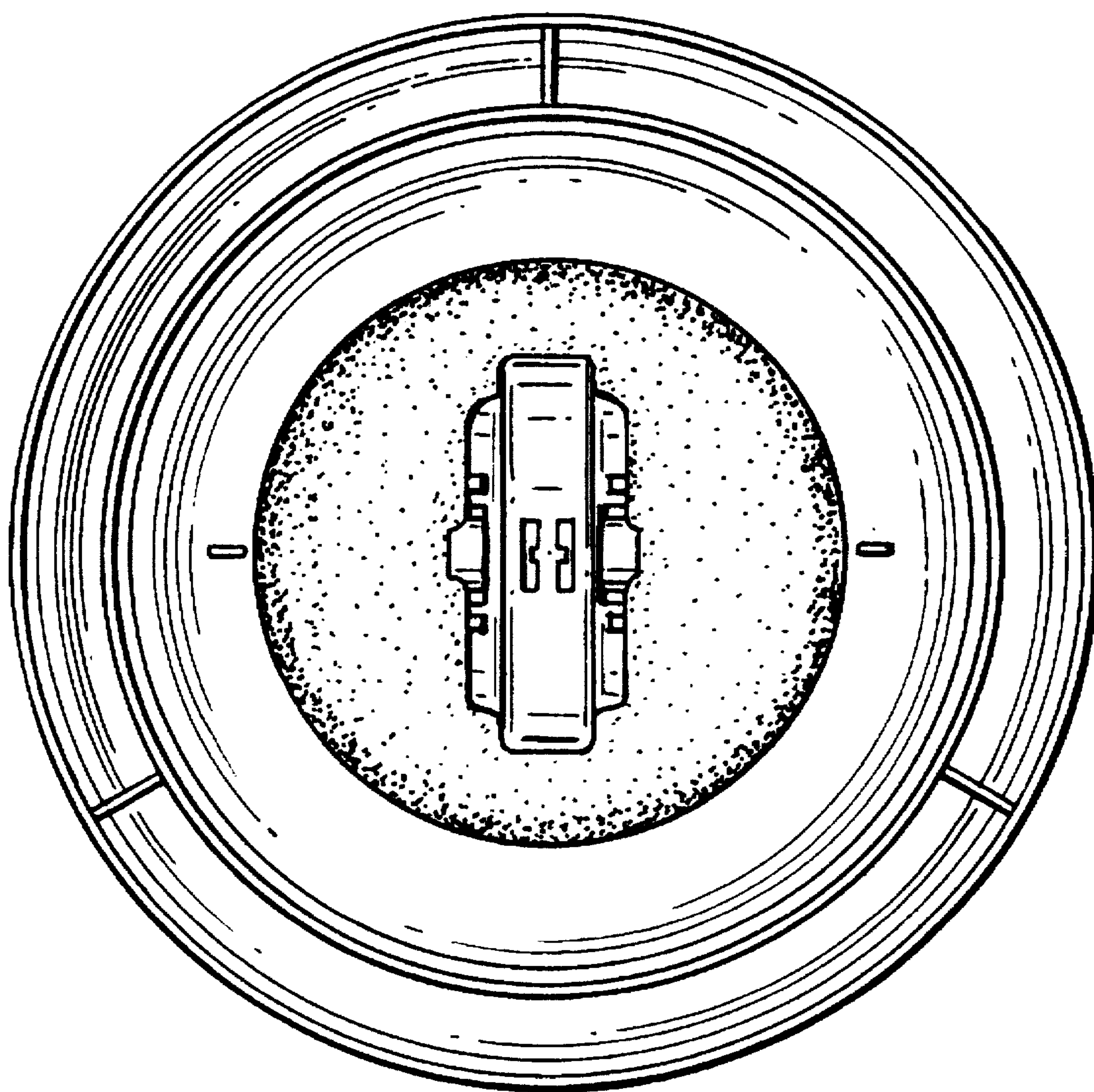
