DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a first embodiment of the lamp body comprising my new design, the lamp body being symmetric about its vertical axis;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

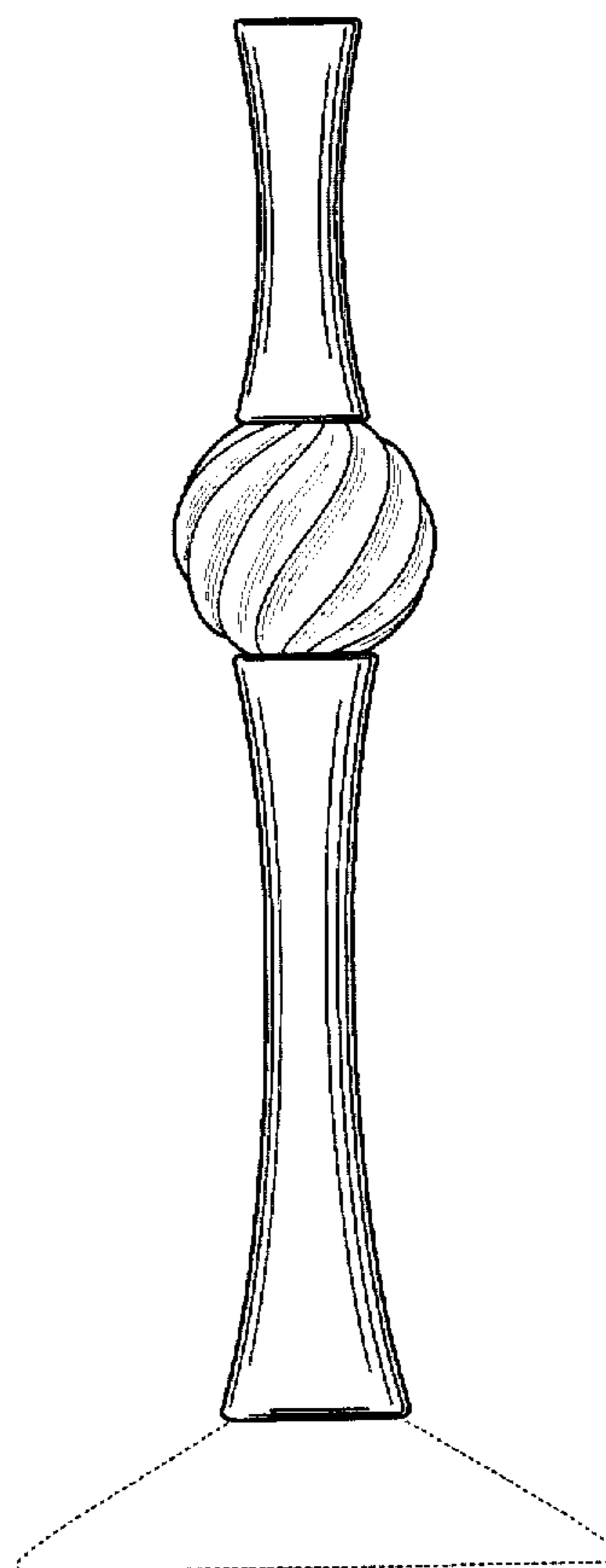
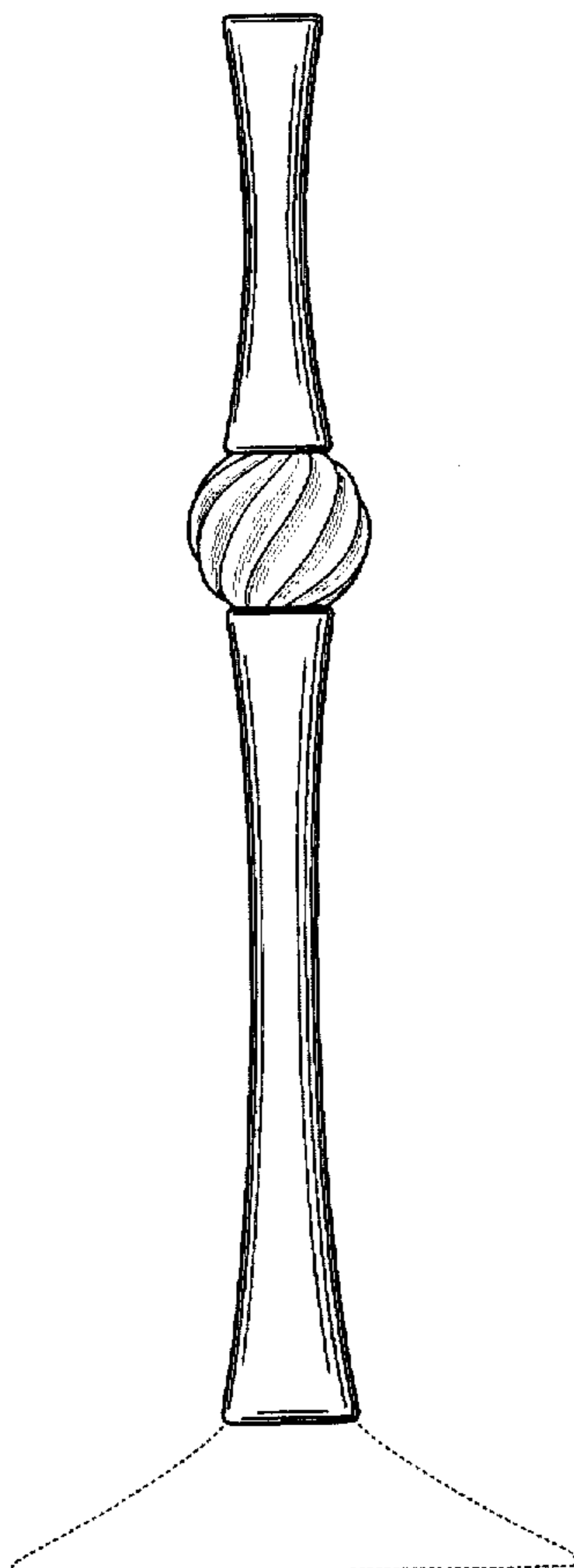
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a second embodiment of the lamp comprising my new design, the lamp body being symmetric about its vertical axis;

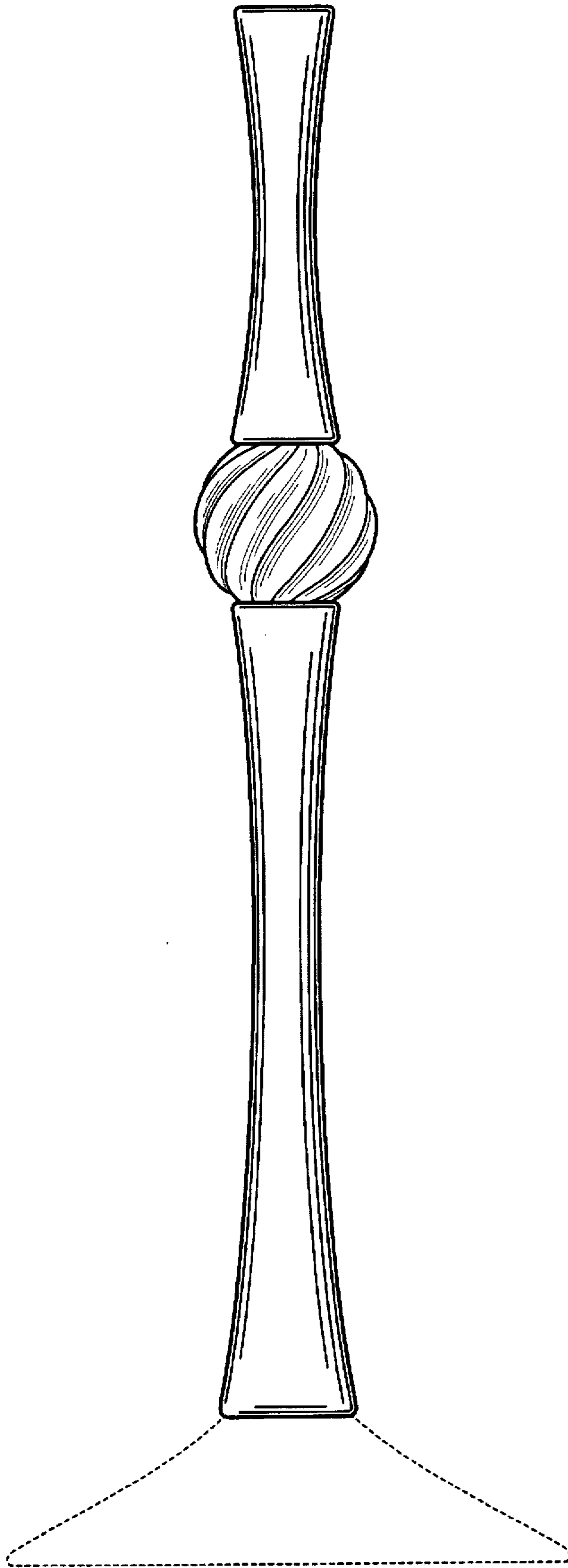

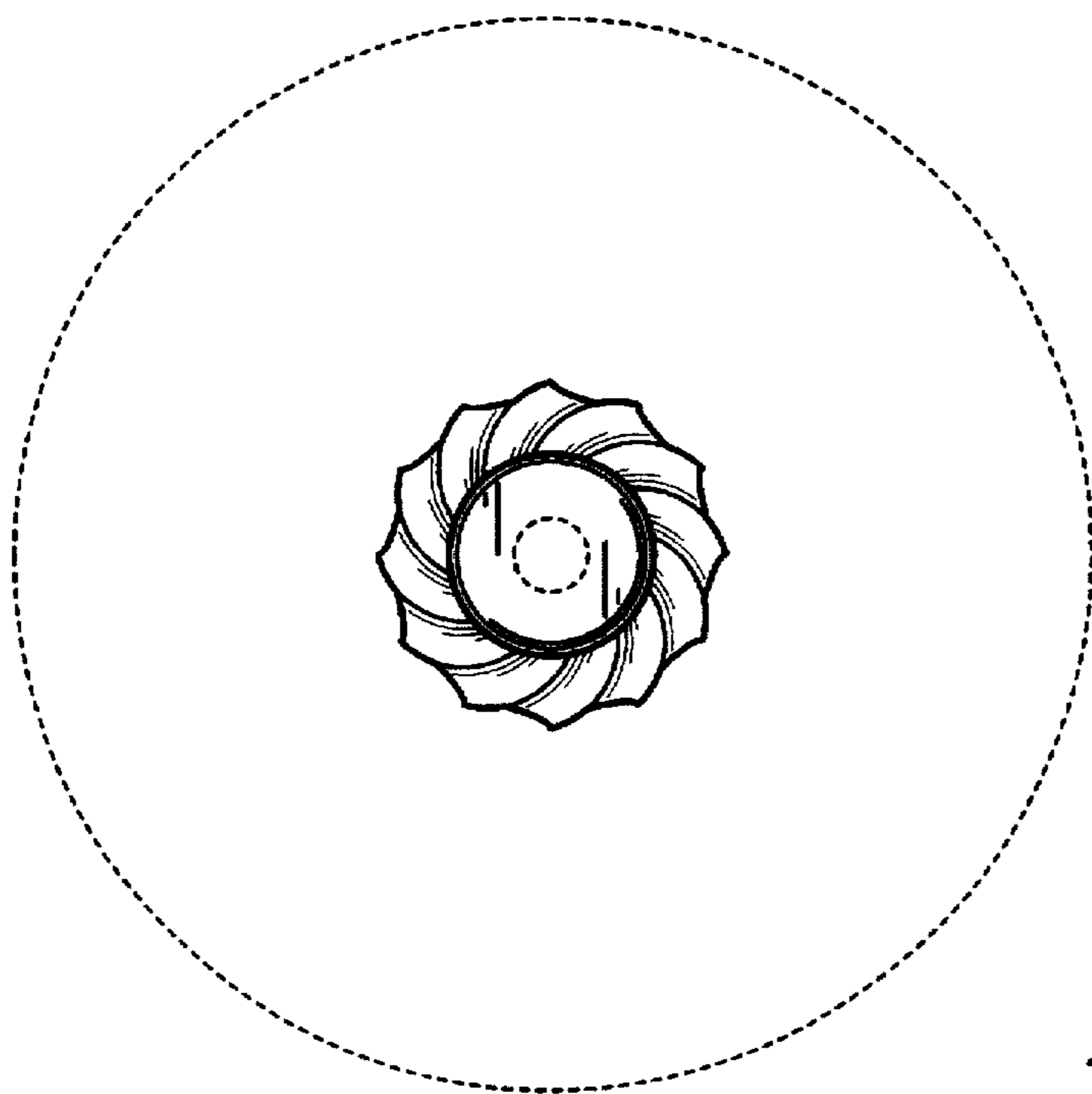

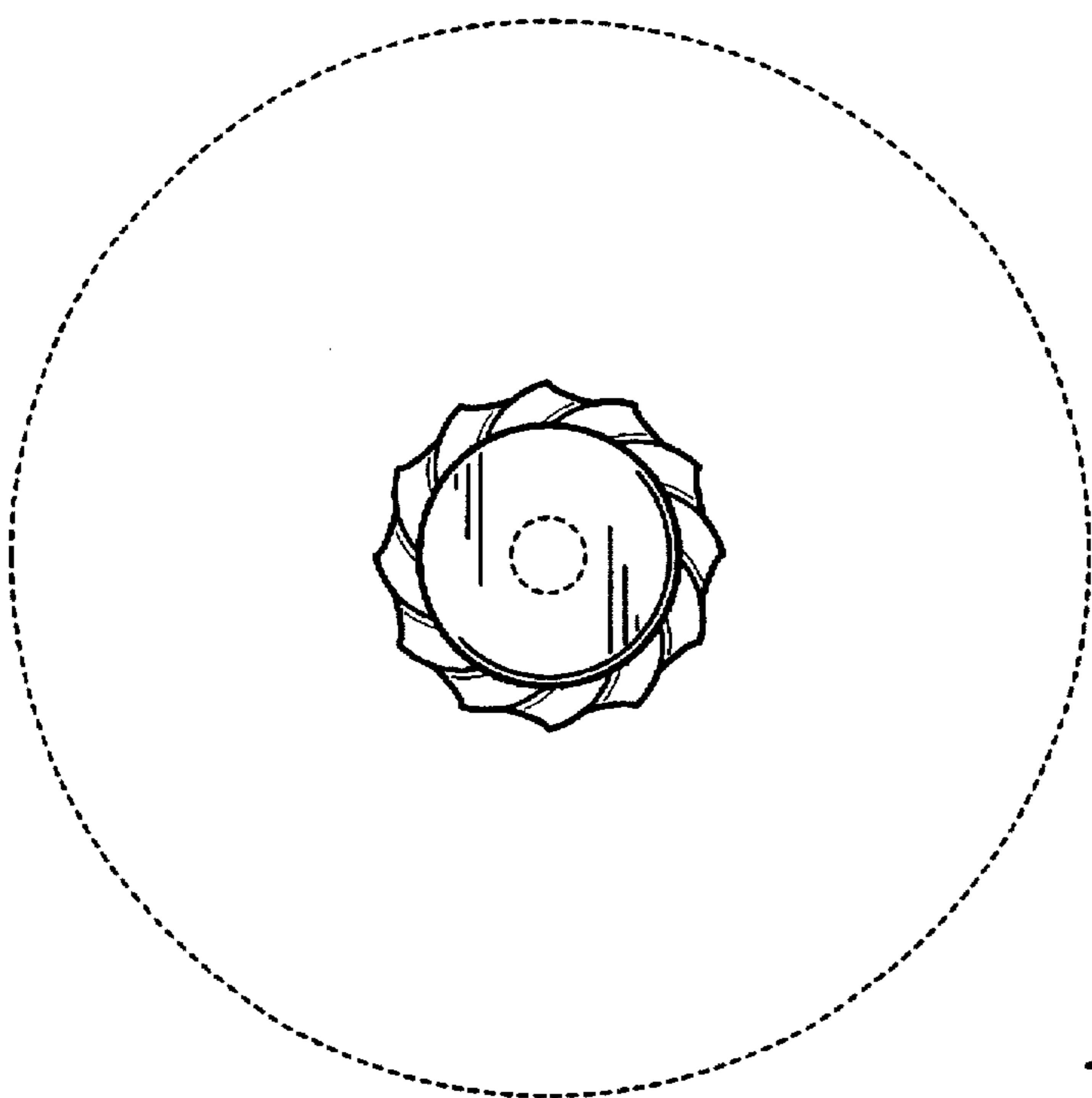

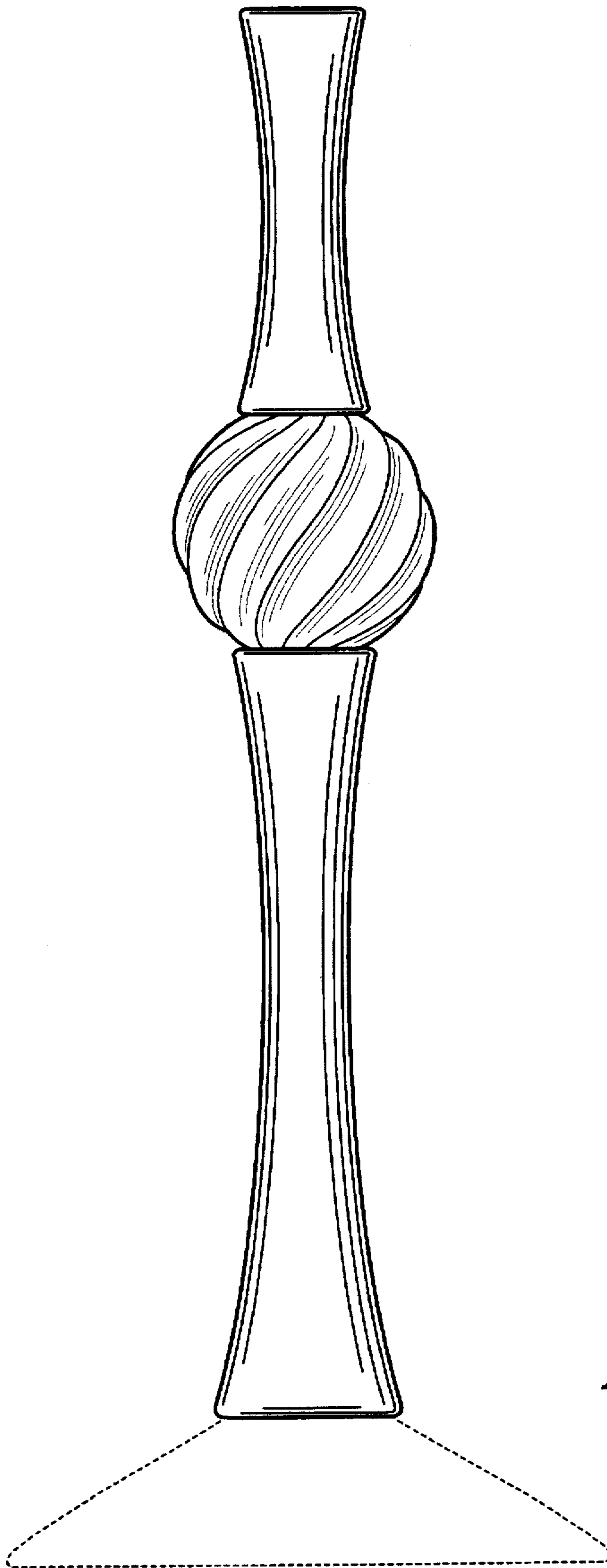

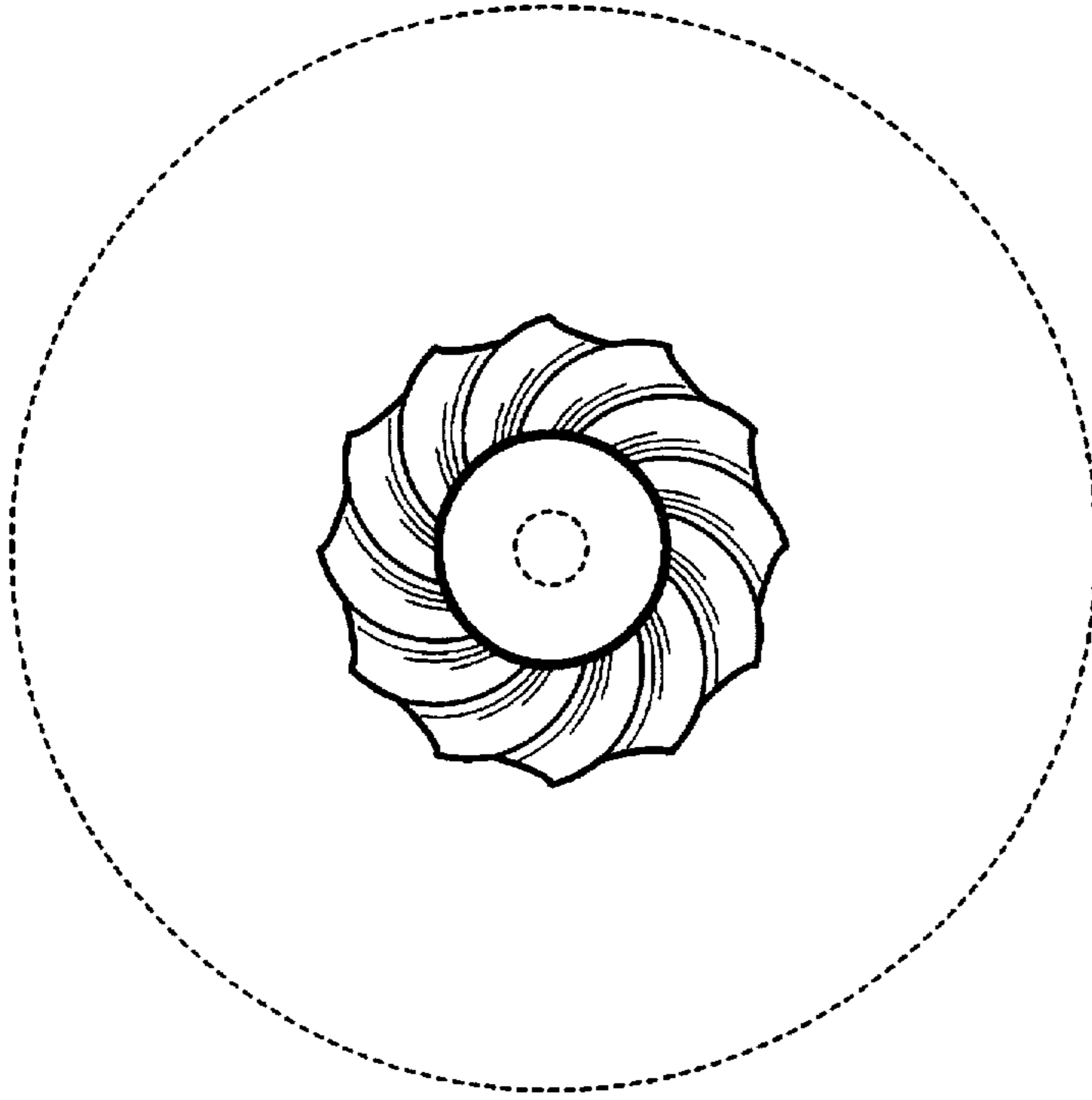

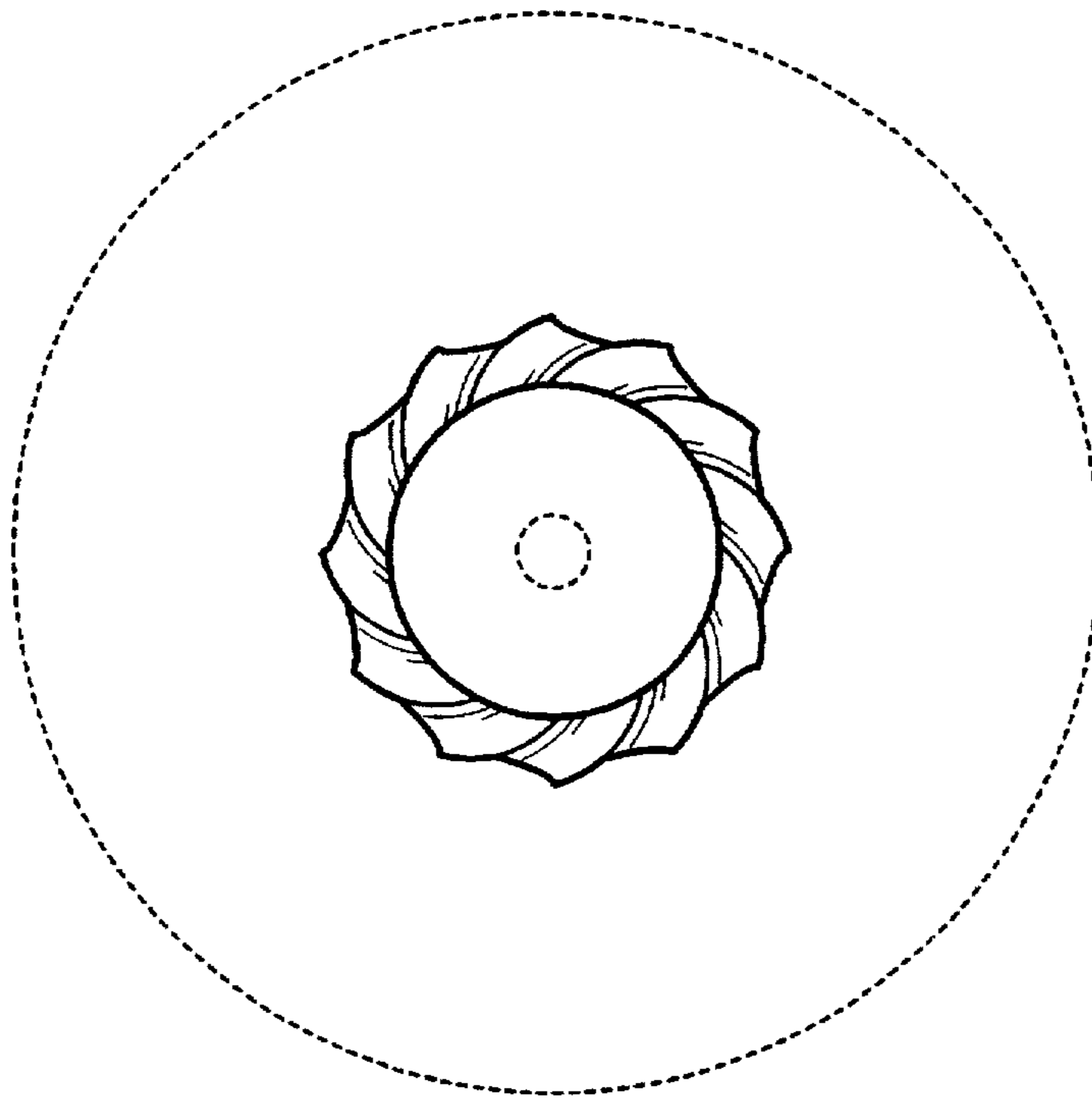
