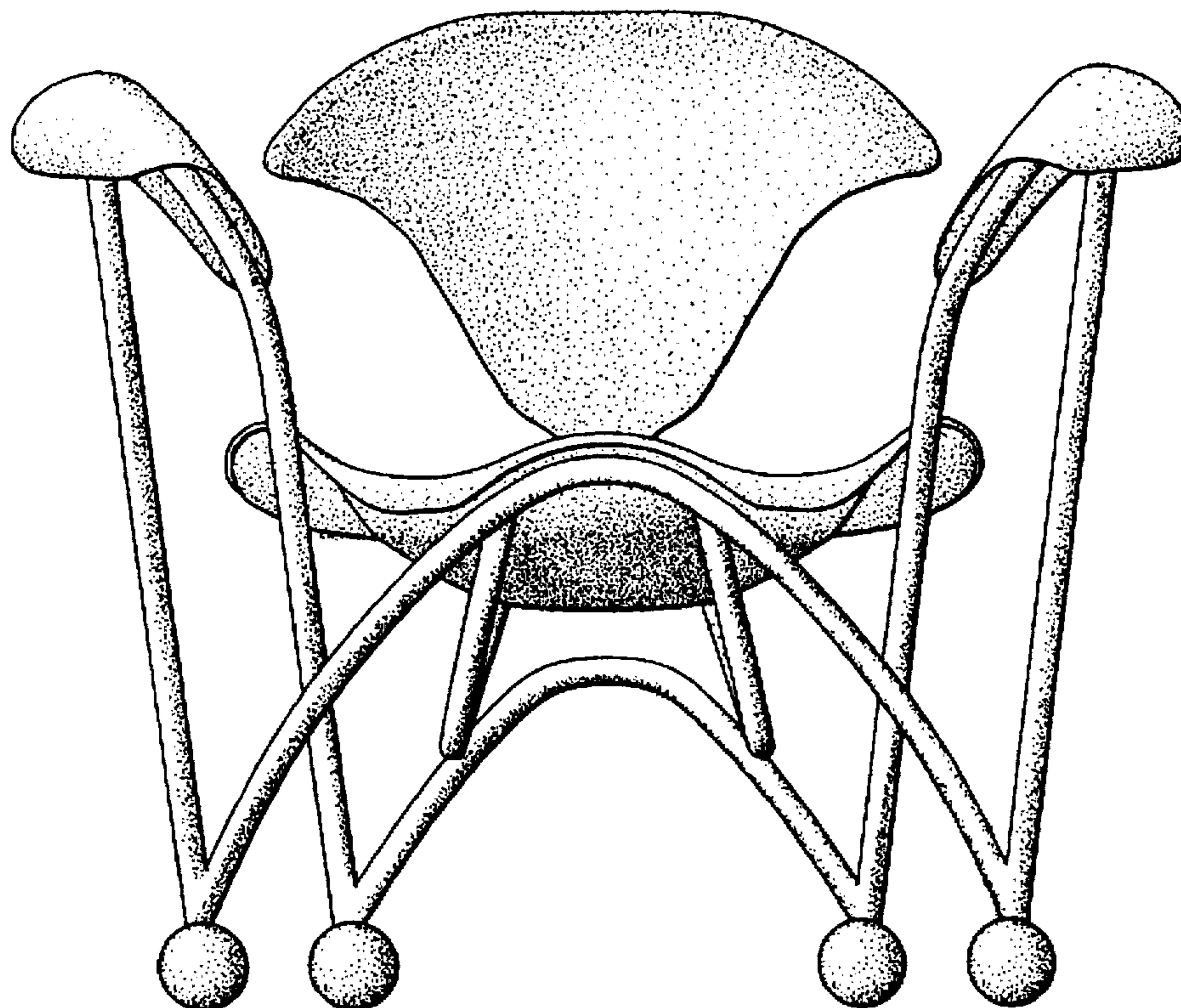
FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a lounge chair

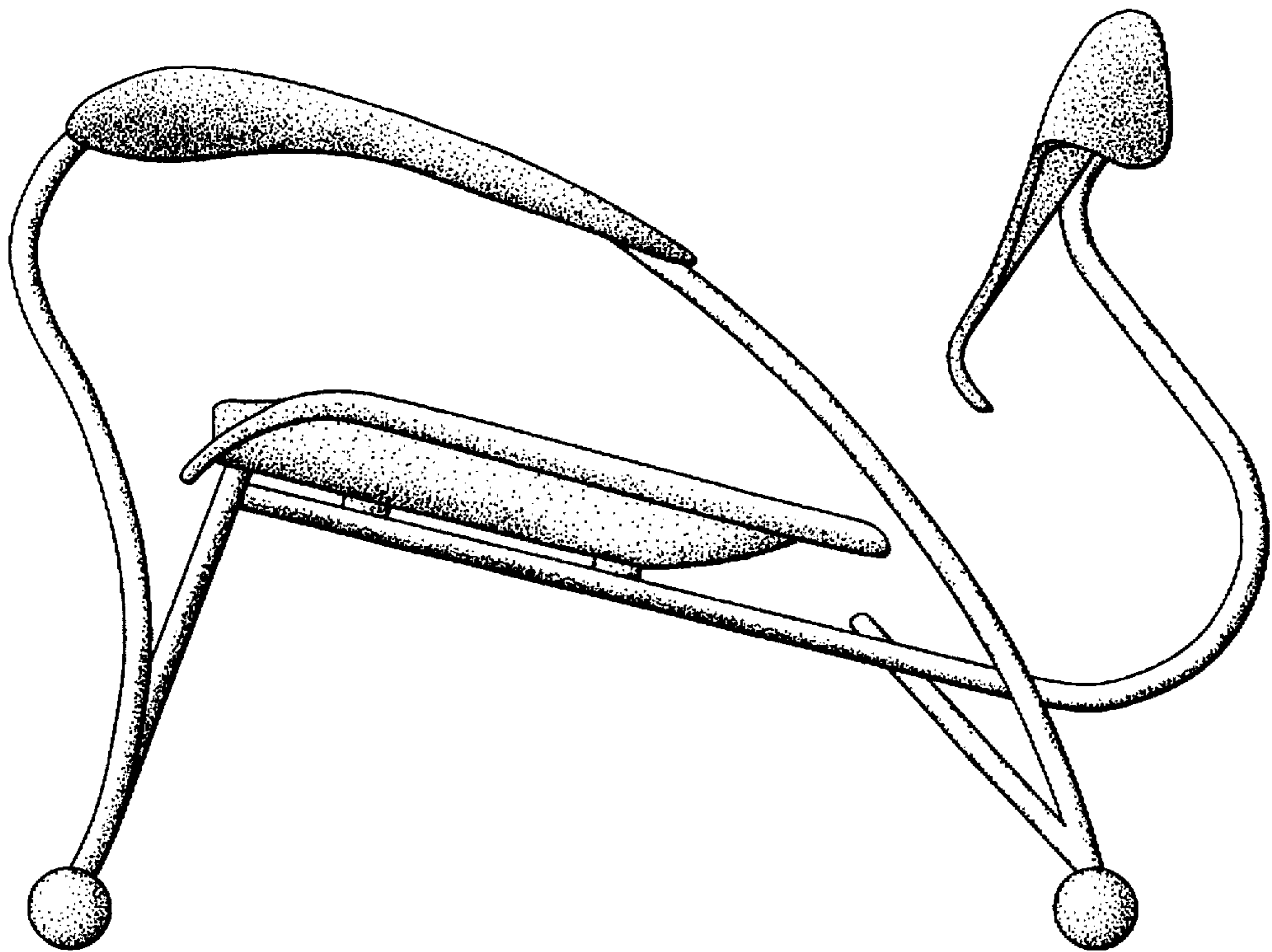

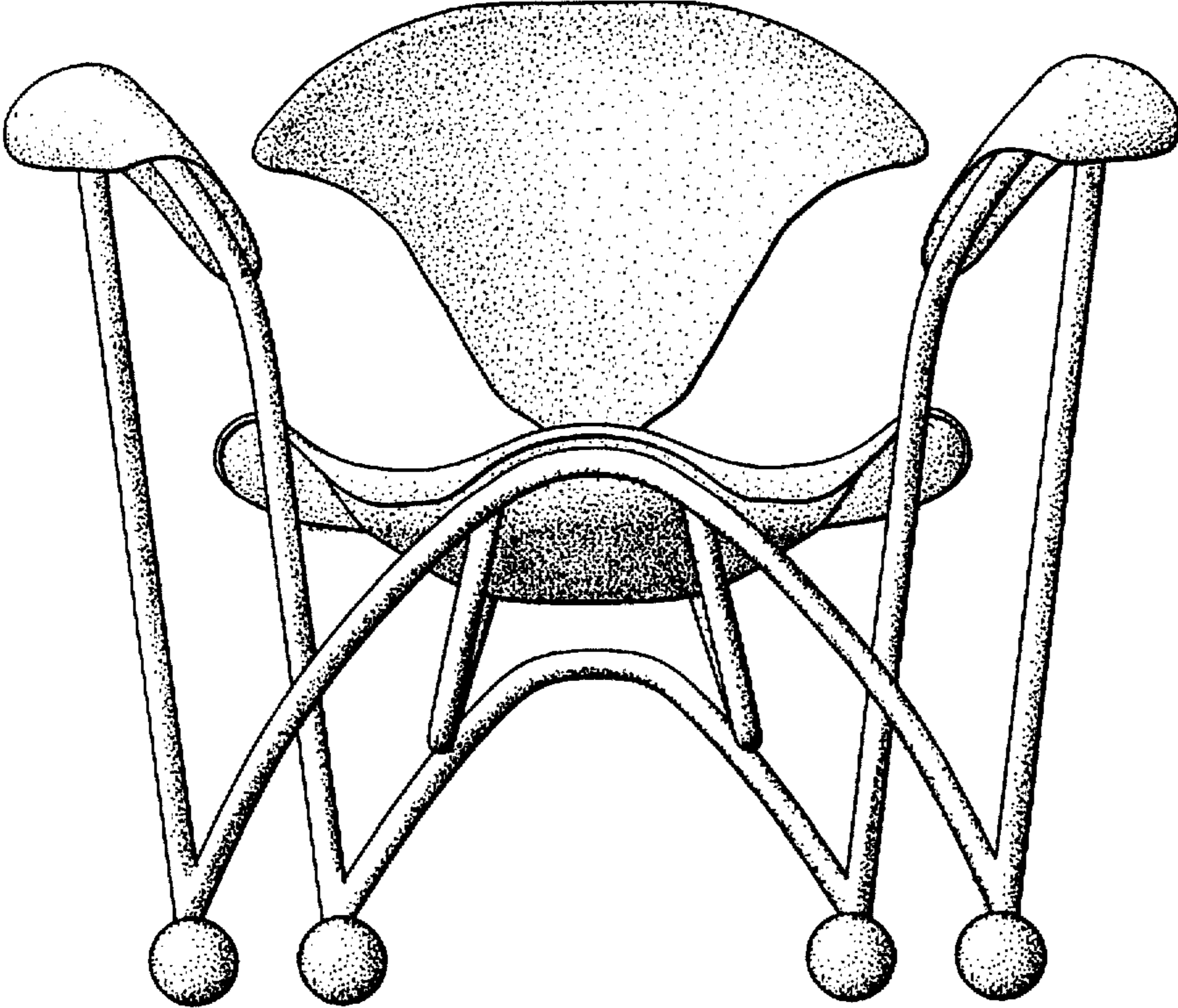

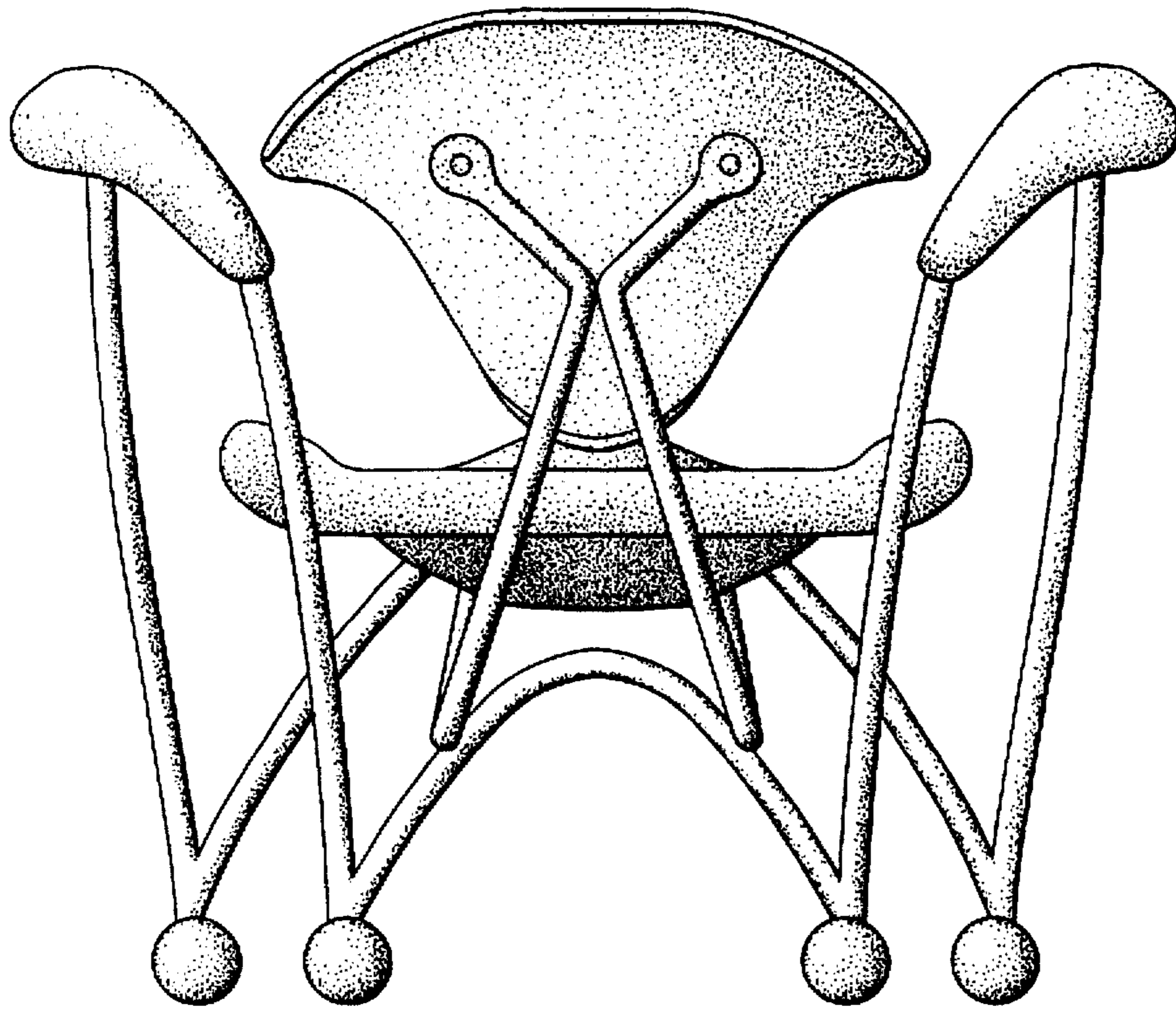

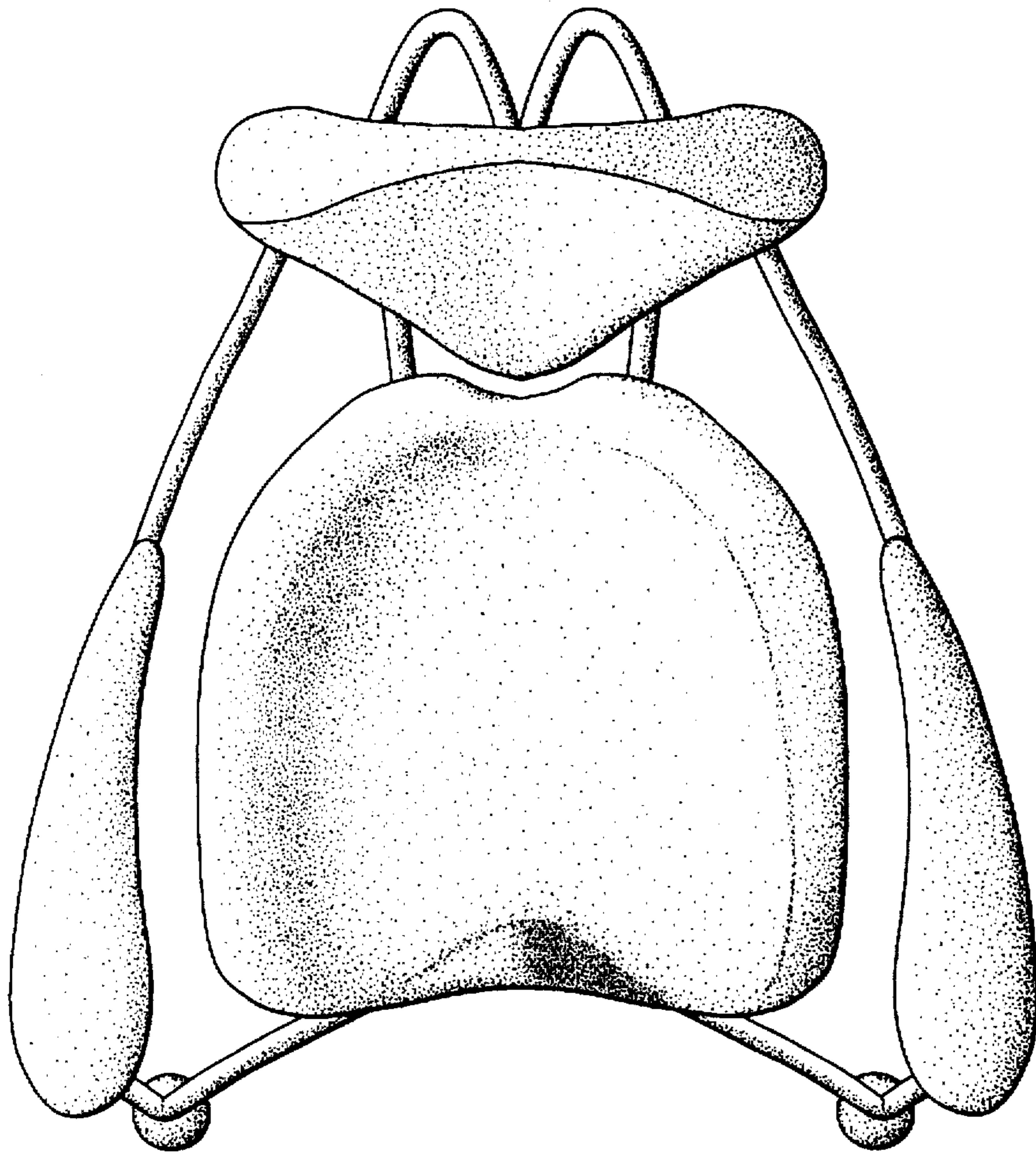
