**DESCRIPTION**

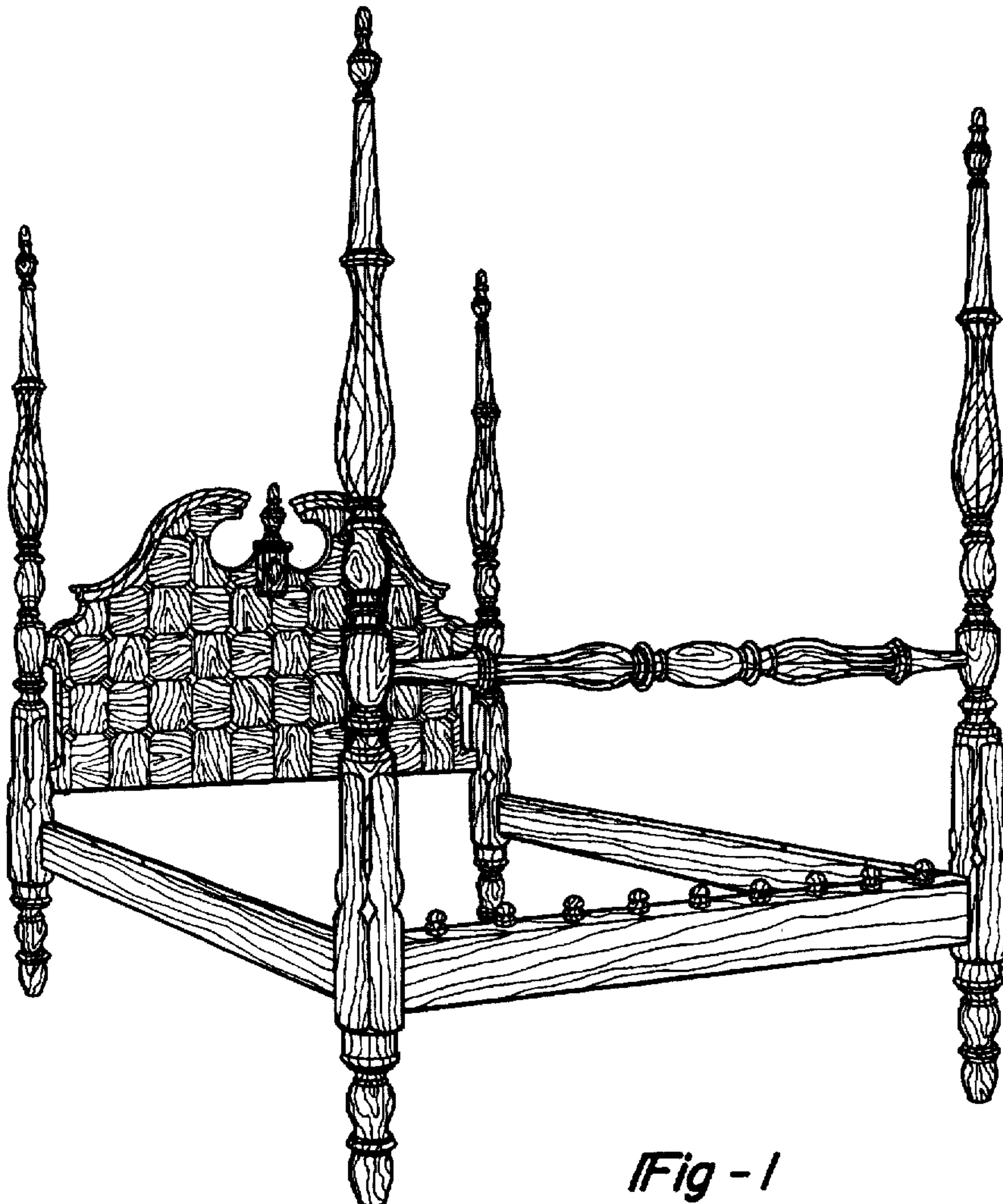
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bed showing my new

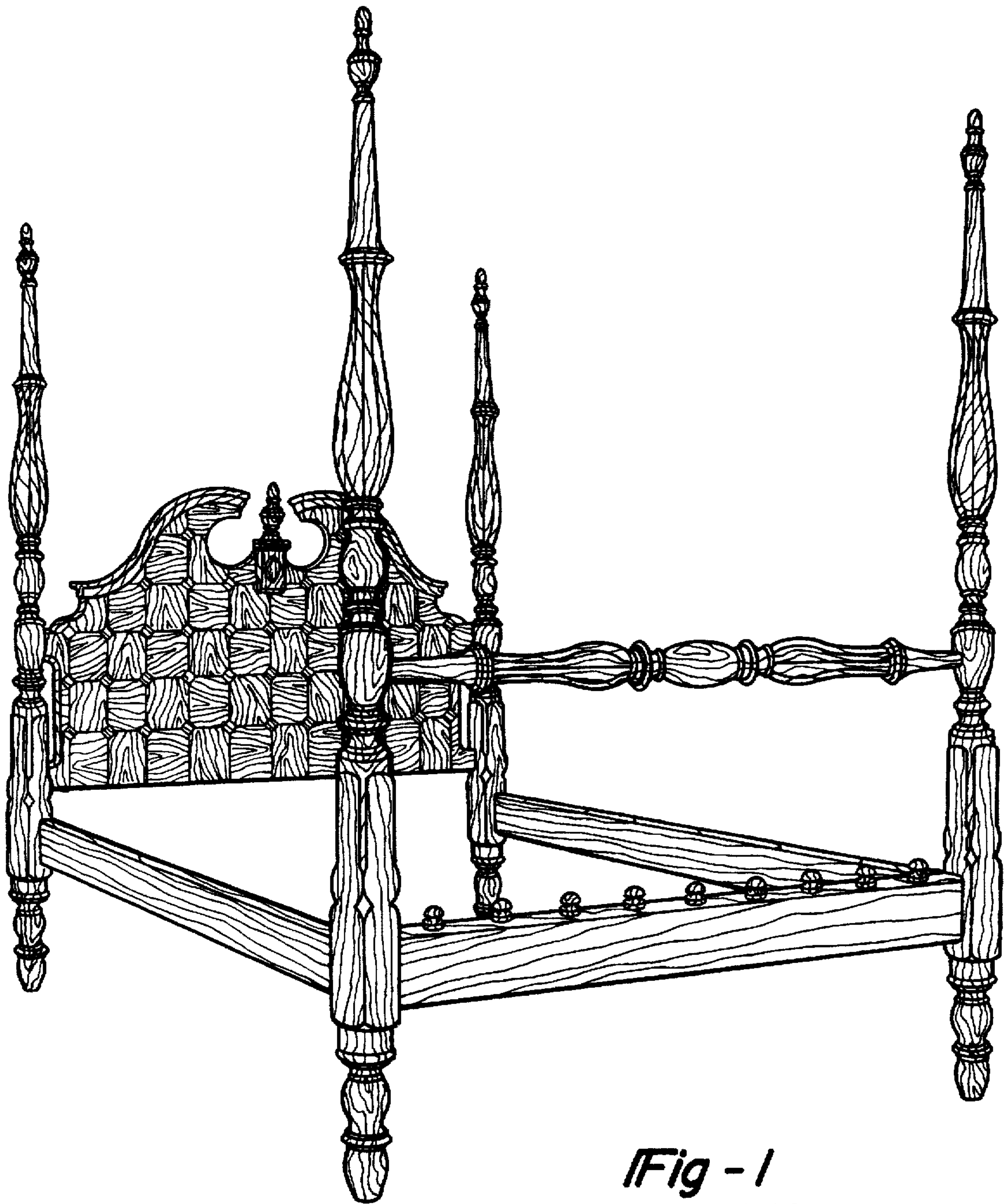

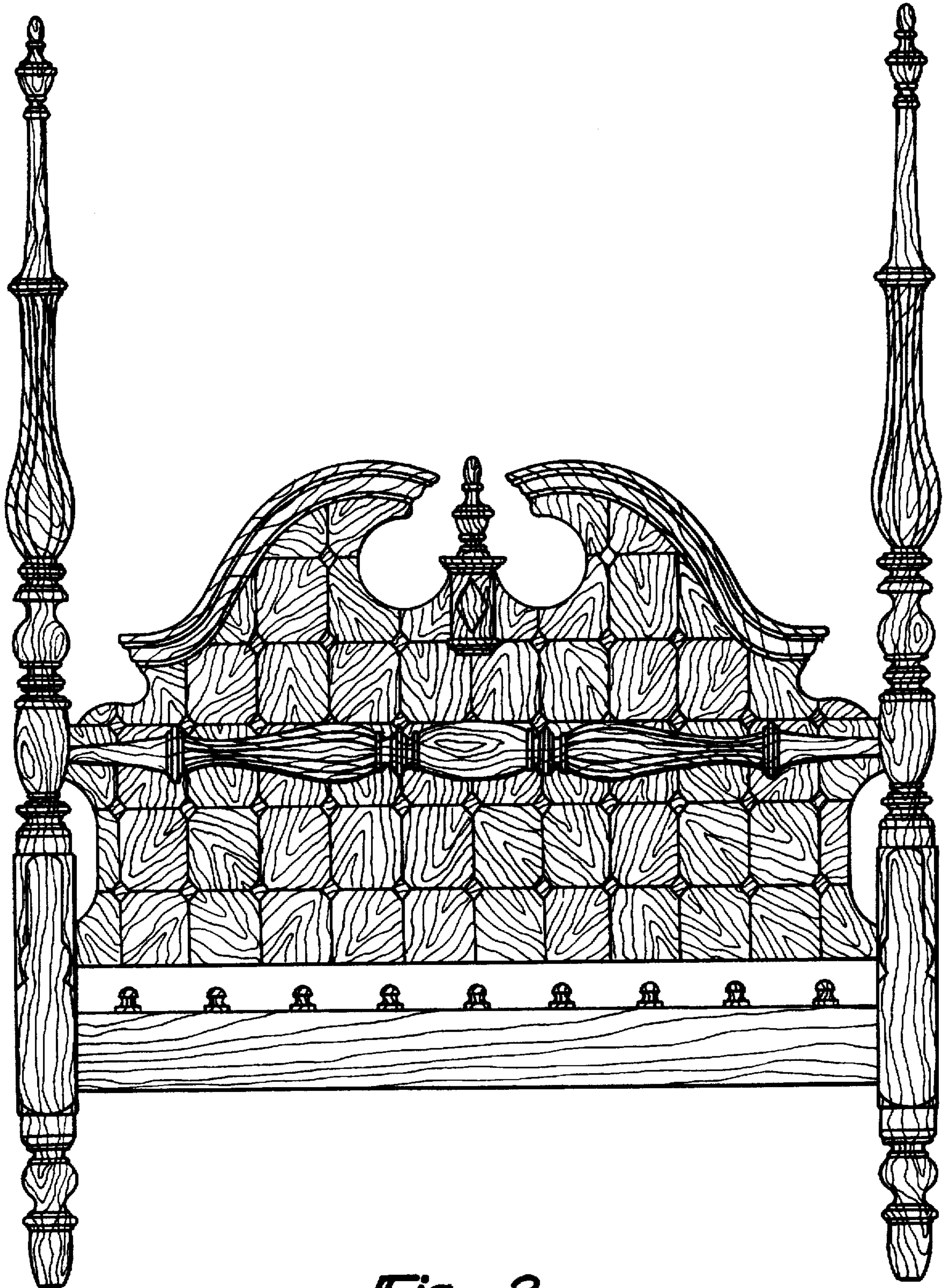

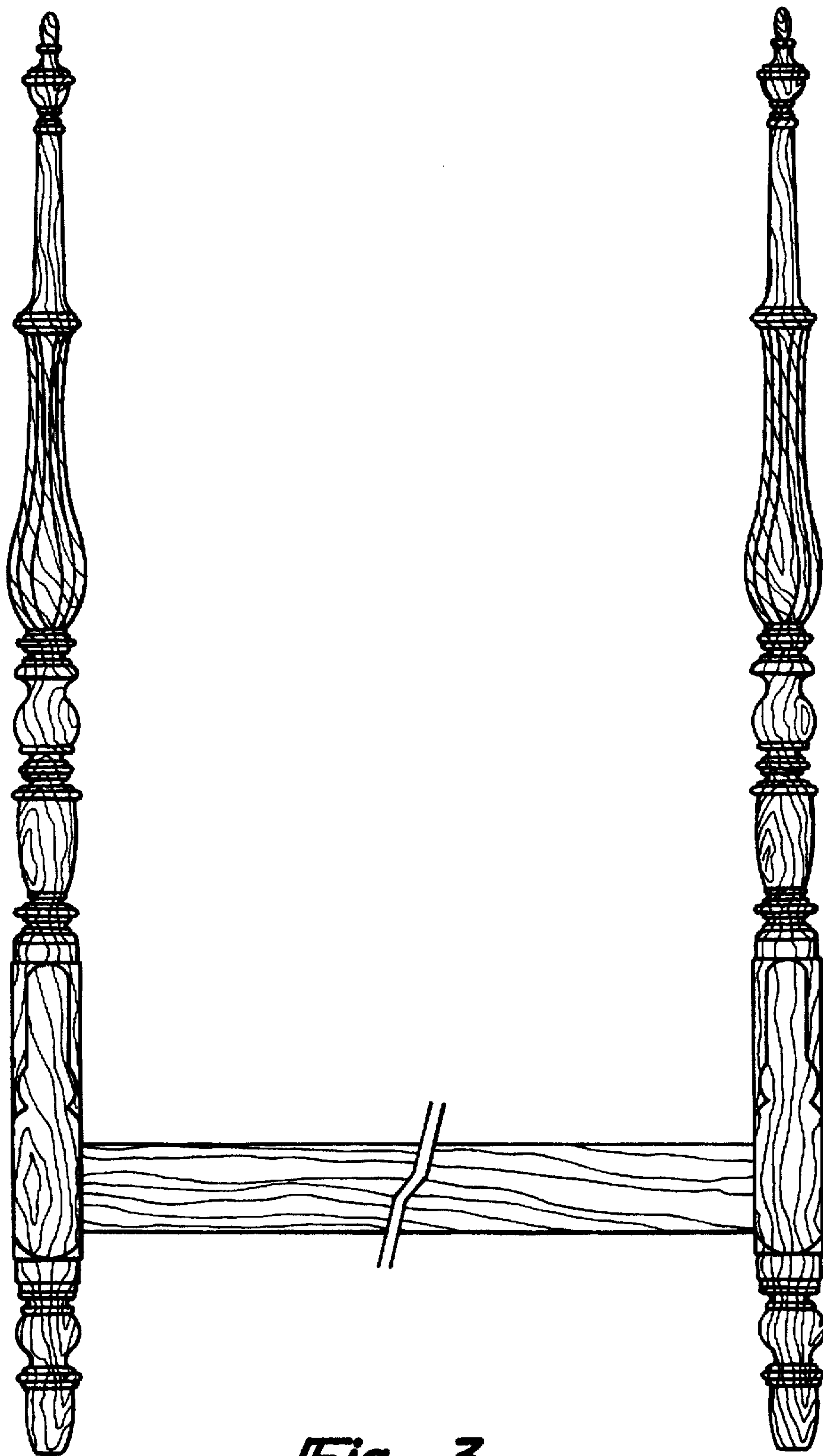
